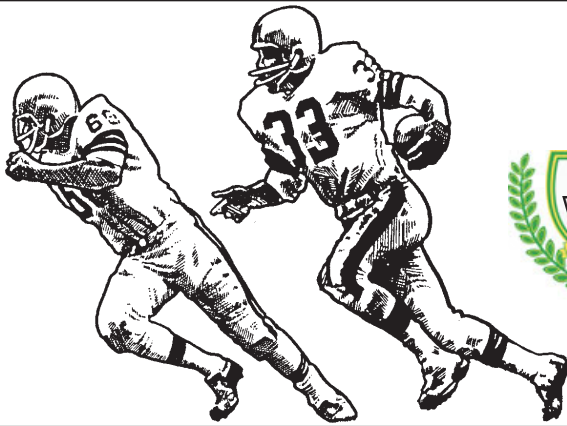

### NEWS AND NOTES

**LAS VEGAS BOWL** - If you look at a box score, Boise St dominated Utah with 23-8 FD and 543-200 yd edges. There were many key plays however which upon Utah could have made a game of it and in fact, Utah controlled the 1Q and could have been up as much as 20-0. The Utes were playing without starting QB Jordan Wynn and while Terrance Cain hit 10-24-93, he was plagued by dropped passes and pen's that wiped out long gains and could have easily had a 300 yd passing game. After rec a Boise fmb'l at the 20 Utah missed a 39 yd FG. Utah had a FD at the Boise 34 but Cain was sacked and fmb'l'd on their 2nd drive. On their 3rd drive, on 1&10 from the Boise 37, Smithson dropped a sure TD pass. On 3&16 Brooks dropped another TD pass and Utah punted. Utah's next pass resulted in a 44 yd FG and after 1Q Utah led 3-0 blowing opportunities for 17 additional points. The key play of the game happened 2 poss later. Boise was back at their own 16 when a simple handoff to Martin went 84 yds for a TD and stunningly Boise, which could have been down by 3 scores, led 7-3. Boise added a 29 yd FG on its next pass and then a 25 yd TD pass (2ptng) to lead 16-3 at the half. After rec a Utah fmb'l at the Boise 39, Boise had a pass that was going to be for a TD knocked out of the rec's hands for a TB. Boise scored a TD on its next drive to lead 23-3 (8:18 3Q). Two poss later Utah went on an 8pl drive but missed a 36 yd FG. Boise went on a 14 play drive for a 21 yd FG and Utah dropped consecutive passes which would have resulted in FD's from the Boise 40, and Cain was SOD on 4&9 at the BSU36 with 6:25 left. Kyle Brotzman became the NCAA's all-time leader in kicking points with a 29 yd FG in the 2Q but will probably be remembered more for his miss vs Nevada. He also dropped a 2 pt conversion on an open pass in the 2Q but had an outstanding career.

**BEEF 'O' BRADY'S BOWL** - Louisville and Southern Miss players got into it in some pregame festivities. SM felt disrespected and came out strong as UL (without starting QB Froman) went 3 & out on their first 3 series. SM went 57/4pl for a TD and then got a 62/1pl TD run by Johnson for a 14-0 lead. SM had a snap to the punter mishandled and he fell but UL fmb'l'd at the 3. UL got their first FD and punted but their next drive went 45/8pl for a TD. SM QB Davis made a great 1-handed catch on a WR pass for a 17 yd TD and SM led 21-7. UL went on an 80/9pl drive to make it 21-14 then with 3:16 left in the half. SM fmb'l'd at their own 27 and UL got a TD to tie it. At the half SM had a 217-159 yd edge. SM went on a 69/13pl drive but had a 29 yd FG blk'd. 3 punts. SM faked a punt for a FD and went 51/11pl for a TD with 14:55 left to lead 28-21 but UL got a 95 yd KR TD. UL went 68/12pl for a 36 yd FG with 6:30 left. After SM punted with 4:41 left, UL got 1 FD then on 3&7 another FD allowed them to punt with :07 left. UL won despite being outFD'd 24-15 and outgained 396-287 vs their old CUSA rival.

**NEW MEXICO BOWL** - BYU continued their impressive finish to the season with a 52-24 rout of UTEP. Jake Heaps became the first BYU frosh QB to start a bowl game and hit 25-34-264. This one was a demolition as at one point in the 1H BYU had a 228-(-1) yd edge and led 31-3. UTEP had a shot to get back in it trailing 31-10 as they had a FD at the BYU3 with :04 left in the half but their pass fell incomplete and their scoring opportunity was lost. Trailing 38-17 UTEP was int'd and BYU drove 46/5pl for a TD to make it 45-17. For the game BYU had 28-13 FD and 514-233 yd edges. Another key for UTEP was the fact that QB Trevor Vittatoe was playing on a left ankle in need of surgery which he postponed until after the game and clearly was hobbled. His ankle was taped and he wore a shoe 3 sizes bigger. Also RB Donald Buckram was supposed to be close to 100% but got only 6 carries for 10 yds.

**NEW ORLEANS BOWL** - Troy set a New Orleans Bowl record with 602 yds offense. Troy did not punt until the 4Q scoring on their first 8 poss. OU was int'd on their first series then each team went on a long TD drive to tie it at 7. After that Troy simply dominated. They finished their 1H with a 385-79 yd edge with almost all of OU's

yds coming on their 2nd series. Each team opened the 3Q with a TD then Troy added another to lead 48-14. OU took over with 10:47 left and gained 54 of their yds on a 9pl drive for a garbage TD with 5:07 left. OU QB Jackson did not come in until the 2Q after an off field incident which resulted in him not practicing with the team.

**POINSETTIA BOWL** - The grounds crew in San Diego did a wonderful job. The night before the Navy/San Diego St game the field was flooded with 1.5 million gallons of rain water. Not only did they pump all of the water out, the field was in remarkably good condition although there was some slipping throughout the game. SDS't frosh RB Ronnie Hillman ran for 228 yds and had 4 total TD's. The Aztecs jumped out to a 14-0 lead getting 3 FD's on their first drive on 13, 12 and 23 yd passes to Brown before punting then going 59/5pl and 93/6pl for TD's. Navy on 3&19 got a 30 yd TD pass with 14:10 left in the half. After the Aztecs drove for another TD with 3:15 left, Navy got a 40 yd pass play down to the 11 then with :07 left in the half got a 1 yd TD run to get back in it at 21-14. In the 3Q Navy was SOD at the SDS't 3 and the Aztecs got 2 FD's and punted. SDS then went 74/7pl. Lindley made a great play action fake hiding the ball behind his back and hit Hillman for a 15 yd TD pass with 14:56 left, 28-14. The Aztecs then went 80/13pl and had another TD with 6:07 left. SDS't's final drive started at their 22 and they would get 3 FD's to the Navy 19 yd line where they took a knee. Despite the fact this game was played in SDS't's home stadium, Navy may have had a slight crowd edge due to their area bases.

**HUMANITARIAN BOWL** - NI's interim HC Tom Matukewicz stepped into a tough situation as HC Jerry Kill left for Minnesota and took both OC and DC with him and he was coaching against Pat Hill. Things did not look great early as FSU marched 69/13pl for a TD and a 7-0 lead but after that NI played with more passion and fire and dominated FSU. They scored TD's on their next 2 poss. Their K had missed an xp but then nailed a 45 yd FG which would have been good from 60. FSU at the end of the half drove 54/6pl trailing 23-10 and missed a 43 yd FG. At the half NI had a 283-164 yd edge. K Michael Cklamovski hit a 51 yd FG to open the 3Q for NI making it 26-10 that once again would have been good from 60. FSU on 3&6 at the NI8 fmb'l'd and NI went 89/8pl for a 33-10 lead. After FSU was SOD at the NI38, NI went 62/4pl for a TD, 40-10. FSU went on a 71/13pl drive for a garbage TD with 5:31 left, 40-17. FSU's top RB Robbie Rouse played with a huge cast on his hand which made him largely ineffective as he had just 32 yds on 14 carries and only 1 rec.

**HAWAII BOWL** - Tulsa came in with the NCAA's #119 rank in pass D but opted to aggressively rush the def front 4 and drop their LB's back into coverage and the result was five 1H int's vs Hawaii which was the key to the game. In fact, at the half UH had 14-5 FD and 273-94 yd edges but trailed 27-14. Tulsa retd the first int 52 yds to the 3 setting up a TD. UH went on a 64 yd drive and was int'd in the EZ. TU had what looked like a TD pass to Clay but the ball was punched out from behind and into the EZ for a TB costing Tulsa 7 pts. After an 8 yd UH punt, TU settled for a 42 yd FG. UH had backup QB Austin in (Moniz inj'd back) and went 59/10pl for a TD, 10-7. TU then got a 54 yd IR TD by Flanders, 17-7 and LB Arnick added his own 54 yd IR TD to make it 24-7. UH got as close as 27-21 (7:28) and 34-28 (5:47) in the 3Q but TU got a 67 yd TD run, forced a punt, then drove 57/2pl for a TD to lead 48-28 and coasted. TU scored the game's final TD after UH was SOD at the TU26 with 4:47 left. WR Damaris Johnson had a career high 326 all-purp yds and broke the NCAA record for all-purp yds in a career. Johnson led the NCAA in all-purp yds raising his total from 191.8 to 202.2 ypg after the game.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ INDIANAPOLIS over Tennessee** - The home team has covered 4 of the L5. IND won the initial bout 30-28 just 3 Wks ago but allowed TEN to get the backdoor cover as a 3 pt dog on the final play. IND had a 399-288 yd edge before the final drive and int'd Collins with :49 left which was called off by a def offsides penalty. TEN has dropped 4 straight road games SU and ATS being outgained by 151 ypg (-4 TO's) with a 29-14 avg score in those. After a 5-2 start TEN has tumbled to a 1-7 SU and 2-6 ATS mark. IND is 5-2 SU and 4-3 ATS at home TY outgaining foes by 40 ypg (+2 TO's) with a 28-22 avg score. IND had a 370-290 yd edge vs OAK LW as they outruled the #2 rush offense 191 (4.9) to 80 (4.0) despite being without 3 def starters (CB Hayden, DT Muir, LB Session). IND has the #4 and #20 units (-4 TO's) while TEN has the #27 and #26 units (-4 TO's). Six of TEN's 9 losses have been by 8+ pts with 4 being by 11 or more pts. There will be serious talk about Fisher's status after the game but with the Colts holding their own destiny in their hands they won't let up and win big here.

**3★ NY Giants over WASHINGTON** - The Giants moved to 8-1 SU and 7-2 ATS vs WAS with a 31-7 as a 3\* LPS win as a 7 pt HF in the 1st meeting. The stats are misleading as while NYG only had a 20 yd edge in the game they physically dominated. The Giants had a 197 (5.5) to 74 (4.6) yd edge and 13 of WAS's 14 drives ended in TO's (6) or punts (7). WAS is off an OT win vs JAX LW where they were outgained 336-251 with a sorely depleted defense. Playing without OLB Orakpo (8.5 of tms 29 sk), their #2 and #3 safeties and losing #2 CB Rogers in the game WAS held a foe to under 100 yds rushing for the 1st time in 8 games (without Jones-Drew). WAS is at a disadvantage with the #19 and #32 units (-1 TO's) vs the Giants #3 and #5 units (-6 TO's) on the year. WAS is 2-5 SU and 2-3-2 ATS at home TY being outgained by 98 ypg (+1 TO) losing by a 24-20 avg score. The Giants are off B2B games where their defense was shredded as they gave up 500 yds for the 1st time S/80. Manning has been a liability with 24 int TY but look for the Giants to play power run ball (141 ypg 4.7) vs the #25 rush defense.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ HOUSTON over Jacksonville** - JAX beat HOU 31-24 in the initial meeting TY as a 1.5 pt HF moving to 3-0 SU and ATS vs the Texans. JAX had a 17-3 lead at the end of the 1H (15-5 FD 200-107 yd edge) but HOU had B2B 80 yd TD drives in the 3Q. With :03 left Garrard threw a Hail Mary pass which was knocked right into the arms of a JAX WR who stepped into the EZ for the TD. The Jags suffered a tough OT loss LW to WAS as they were forced to play without Jones-Drew. JAX had a 336-251 yd edge but Garrard's 2nd pass in OT was int'd which setup a 31 yd FG for the win. While JAX has only been outgained by 15 ypg on the road TY they are -7 TO's losing by a 27-24 avg score (3-4 SU 4-3 ATS away TY). HOU blew a 17 pt 1H lead to DEN LW being outgained 290-168 in the 2H being outscored 24-6. Even though Schaub had 310 yds without WR Johnson he couldn't make up for a def that gave up 6 plays of 22 or more yds to an offense with a rookie QB in his 2nd NFL start. JAX still has a window for the playoffs but with Jones-Drew being beat up, the Texans playing for their HC, Schaub at home vs a Jag defense with a 27-13 ratio TY we'll side with the home team in a higher scoring game.

**FORECAST: HOUSTON 28 Jacksonville 24**

**2★ San Diego over DENVER** - SD is 7-2 SU/ATS vs the Broncos with a 36-18 avg score. They dismantled DEN 35-14 in the 1st meeting TY as an 8.5 pt HF on MNF. SD had a 400-235 yd edge with 69 of DEN's yds coming on the 1st drive. SD then forced DEN to punt on 8 of their next 9 drives (int on other) while SD scored 28 unanswered points. The injuries finally caught up with SD in LW's loss to CIN knocking them from a playoff berth. They can now throw it in or more likely play not only loose but angry against a D rival to ensure a winning season. The Chargers D is a prideful unit and finishing #1 in the NFL will still be goal and doing that against Tebow, a QB they may be seeing for several seasons will keep them motivated. Denver snapped a 5 game losing streak coming back from a 17-0 HT deficit but it was against the Texans #32 pass D which will surely give them some false hope. SD has the #2 off vs DEN's #31 D and on the flip side the NFL's best D takes on the Broncos #12 offense. Add in the better team off a loss as an AF vs a team that pulled the upset as a HD and SD is the play.

## OTHER GAMES

**KANSAS CITY 28 Oakland 20** - The Dog/Pick has covered 7 straight in this series. The Raiders came away with a 23-20 OT win vs KC in the 1st meeting TY. Both teams were guilty of poor play as they combined for 5 TO's and 27 pen's. KC won the OT toss but went 3 and out with Campbell tossing a 47 yd pass to set up the game winning 33 yd FG. OAK has a chance to be the 1st of 29 teams in NFL history to go unbeaten in div play but not make the playoffs. OAK has outgained Div foes by 81 ypg (+4 TO's) with a 37-19 avg score and is +14 yds (+0 TO's) on the road TY. These teams are fairly even statistically with OAK having the #2 and #18 units (0 TO's) the L4W vs KC's #15 and #9 units (+5 TO's). KC rolled TEN LW with 458-270 yd edge and both teams have had stellar seasons with their run games (KC #1 OAK #2) but KC has the edge with more consistent play out of Cassel (214 ypg 60% 27-5) vs Campbell (171 ypg 59% 12-8) who has been in and out of the lineup. In KC's L4 games with Cassel at the helm KC has outgained foes 341-206 holding teams to 61 yds rushing (4.3) with a 5-6 ratio. OAK deserves to be commended for their improvement TY but don't look for KC to letup here even though they have clinched the AFC West for the 1st time S/03.

**Miami 23 NEW ENGLAND 20** - The road team is 6-1 ATS. In the 1st meeting NE thumped MIA 41-14 as a road Pick as while MIA had a 400-265 yd edge they imploded via ST's and TO's. NE opened up the 3Q with a 103 yd KR, added a 35 yd return off a blocked FG with the D pulling in 4 int. After a disappointing effort vs GB at home, NE obliterated BUF 34-3 with 7 takeaways which setup 21 pts as the Patriots secured the #1 AFC seed. Brady has not thrown an int in 10 games or 309 pass att and has a 31-4 ratio. MIA blew a 10 pt 4Q lead vs a DET team travelling to Florida for the 2nd straight week with a QB that hadn't played in 3 games. MIA had 3 giveaways turned into 13 pts for DET in the loss. With a bye wrapped up its unknown if NE will rest starters at some point here especially after a poor showing vs GB 2 Wks ago. MIA is only allowing 299 ypg on the road TY, Sparano and several off asst are playing for jobs in 2011, Henne needs another strong game if he hopes to remain MIA's starter next year and while weather will be key here we'll call for the road team by a FG vs a NE team with nothing to play for here.

**Pittsburgh 17 CLEVELAND 14** - PIT won the 1st meeting TY 28-10 as a 14 pt HF as Roethlisberger made his 1st start since his susp (after a bye week) and CLE was forced to start McCoy due to injuries. PIT brought lots of pressure on McCoy (5 sk and 9 QBH's) and shut down Hillis (41 yds 3.4). McCoy tallied 281 yds (70%) with a 1 TD and both int were off dropped passes. PIT was balanced with a 35-27 run-pass mix as they didn't want to put too much on Roethlisberger (257 yds 59% 3-1). PIT has secured a playoff berth but need a win here to secure the 3rd AFC North Title in Tomlin's 4 years as well as a 1st RD bye. They have extra rest after beating CAR 27-3 with a 408-119 yd edge. Like CAR who was held to 74 yds rushing (3.4) LW, CLE is a run 1st team with a young QB that needs the run for balance. McCoy (149 yds 52%) had his worst game with 3 ints vs BAL and the Browns only TD came on a trick play. CLE is 1-6 ATS since upsetting NE and have the #31 and #10 units (-2 TO's) vs the Steelers #12 and #1 units (+3 TO's) over the L4W. That said seeding need will inflate the line here and we'll side with the home team to put up a valiant effort and stay within the number here.

**BALTIMORE 34 Cincinnati 13** - The fav has covered 8 straight in CIN games. CIN pulled a 15-10 upset as a 2.5 pt HD in Wk 2 improving to 9-3 SU and ATS vs BAL. CIN hit 5 FG's as Flacco threw 4 int vs a vastly different CIN secondary (16 DB's have had 1 snap TY) due to injuries. Since then Flacco has avg'd 238 ypg (65%) with a 2-4 ratio. CIN is 1-6 SU and 2-5 ATS on the road TY as while they are just -1 ypg away they are -11 TO's losing by a 26-19 avg score. BAL does have something to play for here as they are tied with PIT for the AFC North though they need the Browns to pull off the upset.

BAL is 6-1 SU and 3-4 ATS at home TY outgaining foes by 36 ypg (+6 TO's) with a 25-18 avg score. They have the #26 and #19 units (+6 TO's) over the L4W vs CIN's #16 and #21 units (-1 TO's). Palmer's performance LW (269 yds 76% 4-0) vs a SD team in playoff elimination mode will have the Ravens on high alert here. With the cold weather they have recommitted to the run with 208 (5.3) and 161 (4.2) yds rushing the L2W. Look for BAL to play a physical but clean game vs CIN as officiating has played a part in 3 straight Ravens losses as they overcome the large line here.

**DETROIT 20 Minnesota 14** - DET is 2-8-1 ATS vs MIN losing TY's meeting 24-10 as an 11.5 pt AD. Peterson dominated with 160 yds rushing (7.0) overcoming another erratic game by Favre (201 yds 68% 1-2) as well as 12 pen. MIN's D had 3 takeaways and held DET to 164 total yds before their 2 final drives. The Lions have won 3 straight for the 1st time since Nov 2007 coming back from a 27-17 deficit with 9:44 left in the 4Q. DET had a 53 yd TD by Best, a 47 yd FG off Henne's 1st int and a 30 yd pick six to steal the win. DET was outgained 425-275 losing the TOP by 14:30 but has the leagues best ATS mark at 11-3-1 despite cycling thru all 3 QB's. MIN has played more recently at Ford Field (by 1 day) than DET with weather having affected 3 straight games. This will be their 4th straight non-Metrodome game after facing PHI on the 1st NFL Tues game since 10/11/1946. MIN has been held to 300 yds or less in 5 of their L6 games since earning 507 vs ARZ. They have gone 1-5 SU and 2-4 ATS being outgained by 36 ypg (-5 TO's) with a 24-15 avg loss since. DET is a team with an up arrow for 2011 that has a lot going for it while MIN copes with a season that has gone completely wrong facing a large roster TO in the offseason.

**GREEN BAY 27 Chicago 24** - CHI snapped a 4 game ATS losing streak with a 20-17 win as a 3 pt HD on MNF in Wk 3. GB had a 379-276 yd edge but self-destructed with a franchise record 18 pen and gave up a 62 yd PR to Hester. CHI's game winning FG with :08 left was helped along by a 24 yd DPI on GB which put the ball on the GB9 with 1:44 left. The Bears clinched the NFC North 2 Wks ago but are playing for the #2 seed. GB dismantled the Giants LW with a healthy Rodgers with a 515-386 yd edge scoring TD's on 7 of 14 drives. Their D came to play as 10 of NY's 14 drives ended in TO's (6) or Punts (4). CHI has made the most of lucky breaks and situations in their sked TY but they have only faced 3 top 10 offenses TY (2-1 ATS) and 5 teams with a winning record (2-2 ATS) not inc GB. The Packers are 4-1 ATS vs teams with a winning record and 4-1 ATS vs a top 10 defense. Both teams have something to play for here as CHI is out to seize the #2 seed and GB is holding on to the #6 seed here. We'll call for the home team by 3.

**Dallas at PHILADELPHIA** - At this point there are too many variables to favor a side as DAL. QB Kitna's status is ?, PHI will be on just 5 days rest not knowing their playoff need and the situations are unknown. DAL has covered 4 straight in this series with a 30-27 loss as a 3.5 pt HD on SNF just 3 Wks ago. DAL did a decent job of keeping Vick off balance holding him to 270 yds rushing (62%) with a 2-2 ratio with just 16 yds rushing. However, they were burned by McCoy (149 yds rush 9.3) and WR Jackson (210 yds 52.5) on big plays as PHI had a 429-349 yd edge. After going 5-0 ATS in Garrett's first 5 gms as interim HC, DAL has come back to earth the L/2 weeks nearly blowing a 20 pt 2H lead against WAS and LW lost to a hapless ARZ team on a last second FG (DAL did have a 382-271 yd edge). While DAL has a major edge in terms of rest after playing on Sat LW while PHI is short 2 days facing MIN on Tues again we will pass for now as we get more details on injuries/situations later in the week.

**NY JETS 23 Buffalo 17** - LY the Jets took advantage of IND and CIN resting their starters the final 2 wks and got into the playoffs. TY despite their 1-3 record the L/4 wks with the 25 and 3 units (0 TO's) have clinched a spot again thanks to JAX losing LW. The Jets embarrassed the Bills 38-14 as a 6 pt AF in the 1st meeting moving the visitor to 6-0 ATS. After giving up 445 yds to NE with 200 yds rushing (5.3) to NE the week prior, the Bills gave up 444 yds to the Jets who simply followed the same gameplan with 273 yds rushing (5.6). Sanchez wasn't asked to do much but was effective with 171 yds (62%) with 3 TD's. HC Ryan has never been in this situation of choosing between resting starters or grabbing some momentum heading into the playoffs. He is not happy with his D that allowed 38 pts LW to CHI and will be looking to take advantage of Bills offense that committed 7 TO's LW in the 34-3 loss to NE. Ryan will also probably want QB Sanchez (if healthy) to build off his solid performances the L/2W and div HF's in Wk 17 off 2 road games are 5-0-1 ATS S/07.

**Carolina at ATLANTA** - If ATL beat NO on MNF then we'll call for ATL by 7. If ATL lost to NO then they will still be playing for the NFC South as well as the #1 seed and we'll call for ATL by 21. ATL has won and covered 3 of the L4 with a 31-10 win as a 7 pt AF 3 Wks ago. ATL dominated the 1H with 13-2 FD and 202-33 yd edges forcing CAR to punt on 5 straight drives after they fmb'd on their 1st. ATL has solid stat edges with the #12 and #14 units (+14 TO's) vs CAR with the #32 and #17 units (-7 TO's) on the year. ATL's biggest edge is at QB with Ryan (221 ypg 63% 25-9) with a balanced offense (510 pass 443 run) to back him up. Clausen (125 ypg 52% 2-8) has arguably been the worst rookie QB since Alex Smith (109 ypg 51% 1-11) in 2005. CAR has been outgained by 124 ypg on the road TY (+0 TO's) with a 26-14 avg score (2-5 ATS). ATL has only outgained foes by 25 ypg at home TY but are +11 TO's with a 32-24 avg score prior to MNF vs NO (4-2 ATS). CAR will be a very different team in 2011 after Fox leaves due to ownership making a money play (\$77 million payroll) TY while Falcons fans have a bright future.

**NEW ORLEANS 38 Tampa Bay 17** - The Saints improved to 4-1 ATS vs TB with a 31-6 victory as a 4 pt AF in the 1st meeting. NO's 1st 3 drives went 94, 80 and 77 yds for TD's while TB's combined for 67 yds with 3 punts. NO had a 475-277 yd edge with a season high 212 (6.6) rushing yds vs 42 (2.3) for TB. Both teams will be playing hard as TB still has an outside shot at the playoffs (after steam rolling SEA LW) and while the MNF results are unknown for NO, they will need another victory regardless of the outcome for playoff positioning. The Bucs have been impressive TY on the road going 5-2 SU and 5-0-2 ATS outscoring foes 22-18 but those 5 SU wins all came against losing teams with a comb 22-53 record. The Saints after a slow start have won their L/3 home gms SU/ATS outgaining foes by 43 ypg with a 28-16 avg score. While it is well noted that NO is 0-4 SU/ATS in the reg ssn finale under Payton, TY the starters will be full go and they have much more to play for and reg ssn HF's off an away game are 17-8-1 the L/3 yrs. TB has struggled getting pressure on the QB (#29) and that does not bode well against Brees and Co.

**St Louis 23 SEATTLE 20** - It's winner take all in the "powerful" NFC West. The Rams snapped a 6 game SU/ATS losing streak to SEA in the 1st meeting with a 20-3 win as a 2 pt HD. The Rams had a 349-257 yd edge as their D held SEA to under 39 yds on 12 of 13 drives, allowing 4 FD's and 83 yds in the 2H. Bradford had 289 yds (56%) with a 2-1 ratio while Hasselbeck was held to 191 yds (56%) with an int. Despite dropping 3 straight and 5 of the L6 SEA is at home and have beaten the teams they faced with a losing records by 25 pts (SF), 12 (ARZ) and 17 pts (CAR). STL snapped a 2 gm losing streak behind the arm of Bradford (292, 76%, 1-0) as he showed great poise leading his team from a HT deficit going 16 of 20 in the 2H. That poise and the recent experiences of winning at Arizona (19-6) and Denver (36-33) have us leaning with the Rams. STL is now 5-2 ATS on the road and the 2 games they failed to cover were at DET (had 341-322 yd edge) and at the SB Champ Saints (only outgained 345-327). The Rams are better on both sides of the ball and with a young QB are a team on the rise versus a declining Seahawks unit with Whitehurst starting.

**SAN FRANCISCO 24 Arizona 14** - The 49ers have covered 4 straight vs ARZ including a 27-6 win as a 2 pt AF on MNF TY. SF manhandled ARZ with a 386-203 yd edge despite losing RB Gore (fractured hip) in the 1Q. SF moved the ball at will on the ground with a 261-13 (5.6-1.2) edge with a 19:00 TOP edge. ARZ's 1-4 SU/ATS record in div play is bad but they've also dropped 6 straight away (1-5 ATS) losing by 18 ppg getting outgained by 148 ypg. ARZ has committed to going to rookie Skelton at QB and while he's won 2 of 3 games he's started he was 15-37 in the win vs DEN and 11 of 25 in the win vs DAL with a combined 4 off TD on drives of 24/5, 41/3, 79/8 and 80/2. SF's QB situation is no better with Singletary (may not be here) not committing to either Smith and LW he started Troy (7 of 19, 153) and pulled him for Alex (10 of 15, 120) and SF has now been held to 12 or fewer FD's in 5 of their last 6 games. With 2 poor offenses will look to the defense side of the ball where SF has a large edge. Despite being put in bad spots the 49ers D is allowing only 302 ypg at home inc holding the Saints to 287 yds (their 2nd lowest) and PHI to 3rd lowest total (352 yds). SF can be a bully and is now 4-0-1 ATS as a fav of 6+ points the L3Y.

### PRO ANGLES

There are 3 main methods of handicapping, Fundamental, Situation & Technical. Fundamental handicapping, or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings, is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situational handicapping (analysis of letdown, look ahead, systems) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. For more complete analysis you should read Ten Keys To A Winning Season. Each week in Power Sweep we provide the angle section to add to your handicapping arsenal. Many times we will agree with the angle plays. Sometimes the Fundamental & Situational aspects of a game will outweigh the angles & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on. We are NOT Technical handicappers, but we do use them in our handicapping analysis. Each week in Power Sweep we provide pro angles for the current week's games. For the angle plays the number in the ( ) indicates how many angles apply to that team. The higher the number the stronger the angle play.

There are 3 main methods of handicapping, Fundamental, Situation & Technical. Fundamental handicapping or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situation handicapping (analysis of letdown, look ahead, systems, etc...) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. Each week in Power Sweep we provide a system to add to your handicapping arsenal. This is done at the request of our subscribers who want handicapping tips & methods. Many times we will agree with the side that the system chooses. Sometimes the Fundamental & Technical aspects of a game will outweigh the system & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. **We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on.** If that is ever the case during a week, keep the system for future use, but be aware that the side we write-up in the Power Sweep Selections page is the side we are on.
