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NEWS AND NOTES

ROSE BOWL - TCU was the only undefeated team in the country that was not playing in the National Title game but they were excited to be playing in the Rose Bowl vs Wisc as they were the first non-AQ team to play in the big game. Their win in this one moved the non-AQ's record to 4-1 SU in BCS bowls vs AQ teams. This game capped a very poor Jan. 1 for the Big Ten as they went 0-5 in bowl games. The Badgers did have a 385-301 yd edge but trailed the entire 2H. UW actually held the ball for all but 3 plays in the 2Q which helped them compile the yardage edge. This one looked like it would be a score fest as UW opened with a 55/8pl drive and settled for a 30 yd FG. TCU converted on 3&10 twice on a 77/10pl drive and got a 23 yd TD pass to lead 7-3. UW went 67/6pl for a TD, 10-7 (3:14 1Q). TCU43 went 57/5pl for a TD, 14-10 (:16). UW went 55/13pl but missed a 39 yd FG. TCU went 3 & out. UW on 4&9 faked a punt for a FD then converted on 3&8, 3&12 and got a 37 yd FG on the final play of the half at the end of a 14pl drive. At the half UW had 234-131 yd and 38-18 play edges thanks to the 2Q. TCU opened the 3Q with a 71/6pl TD drive. UW started at their 5 and got 4 FD's but punted. TCU got 3 FD's and punted 38 yds to the 3. The next 3 poss each team got 1 FD & punted. UW took over with 7:32 left. They went 77/10pl and got a 4 yd TD run with 2:00 left. On the 2 pt conv they had an open rec in the EZ but blitzing LB Carder tipped the 2 pt pass. TCU rec'd the onside kick and on 3&4 got a 5 yd run for a FD with 1:52 left and took a knee.

CAPITAL ONE BOWL - Alabama came in with 3 losses while the Spartans had just 1. Despite the fact Bama was #15 and Michigan St was #7, the Tide were a big favorite. They lived up to their billing by absolutely dominating MSU with a 546-171 yd edge in a game they led 28-0 at the half and 42-0 after 3Q's. It was the largest MOV for the Cap One Bowl (formerly Florida Citrus and Tangerine). The previous high was E Texas St's 33-0 win over Tenn Tech in 1953. There were a couple of big plays early in the game which helped turn this into a rout. The Tide's opening drive went 79/13pl. On 3&gl from the 1 Ingram bowled in for the TD. MSU went on a 12pl drive but on 3&18 went int'd at the Tide 15 and ret'd 23 yds. Bama went 62/8pl for a TD, 14-0. MSU went on a long drive and had a 1st & gl at the Bama7. On 3&gl from the 8 Cousins was sk'd & fmb'l'd. The ball got kicked and MSU fell on it back at the Bama38 and actually punted after their 1st & gl. That loss of 30 yds helped MSU finish with -48 yds rushing. Bama went 80/7pl and 44/3pl for TD's on their next 2 poss and led 28-0. Bama took their 1st 2H poss 79/4pl drive for a TD and there were 4 punts on the first 5 poss. Bama then turned it over to the backups with McCarron taking over with 6:09 left in the 3Q and bkp RB Lacy getting a 12 yd TD run with 1:09 left in the 3Q then a 62 yd TD run with 8:58 left in the game to make it 49-0. MSU barely avoided the shutout. On 4&3 WR/QB Nichol who came in for the final 2 series, hit a 49 yd TD pass with 5:45 left. Bama gained 37 yds on the final 9 plays.

COTTON BOWL - There was no doubt heading in that LSU had 2 distinct advantages over Texas A&M. One on defense and the other on ST. Amazingly, A&M ret'd the opening KO 69 yds to the LSU31. No team had even got past the LSU30 on their opening poss of a series all season long but A&M went 31/8pl for a TD to lead 7-0. In the game, A&M punted just twice. At half LSU led 28-17 but A&M had a 258-253 yd edge. LSU finished with a 446-373 yd edge and was taking a knee inside the A&M20 at the end of the game after having an IR TD called back. Ryan Tannehill came in with 127 consecutive passes without an int but threw 3 vs the ball hawking LSU D. LSU took its opening 58/11pl but on 3&7 from the 25 was int'd at the 2. A&M went 76/9pl and got a 39 yd FG to lead 10-0. LSU then went 80/8pl for a TD. A&M was sk'd forcing a 4&22 and their 52 yd FG bounced off the upright. LSU went 65/9pl for a TD, 14-10. A&M answered with a 78/7pl TD drive, 17-14 (7:44 2Q). LSU went 67/7pl for a TD then got an int at their own 40. LSU punted 58 yds for a TB but then Reid cut in front of the WR and raced 34 yds to the 2 with another int. LSU got a TD on 3&gl from the 2 with 1:27 left to go up 28-17. LSU opened the 3Q with a 67/5pl drive for a TD, 35-17. A&M went on a 13pl drive to the LSU29 but after a sk and delay, punted on 4&18. LSU missed a 44 yd FG after a 60/12pl drive and A&M went 73/13pl for a TD to get back to 35-24 early 4Q. LSU rec'd the onside kick and Jasper tied a bowl record 50 yd FG, 38-24. Mathieu, 2pl later got an int at the A&M28 and LSU got a 26 yd FG with 3:04 left, 41-24. Mathieu got an int which he ret'd 37 yds for a TD but a pers foul wiped it out. LSU got a FD to the 19 and took a knee. This was the 50th game between the 2 schools but the first since the 1995 season opener.

ORANGE BOWL - The Cardinal will finish in the Top 5 for the first time since their unbeaten 1940 team finished #2. This game came just 4 years after the team was 1-11 and hired Jim Harbaugh. Stanford had a commanding 534-288 yd edge. The final score made it look like this game was a mismatch but VT played well in the 1H and had a 198-181 yd edge. Each team punted to open then SU was SOD on a fake punt on 4&4 at the VT45. After a VT punt, SU went 86/4pl with a 60 yd TD run by Stewart making it 7-0. VT got

1 FD and punted and SU at their own 5 had a strange play. A pass was tipped and an OL in the EZ opted to catch the ball but went down for a safety, 7-2. After the free kick, VT went 75/10pl. Taylor made an incredible play being chased by two DL and at the sidelines threw it into the EZ for an 11 yd TD pass and VT led 9-7 (10:22 2Q). SU went 79/8pl with a 25 yd TD pass on 3&8, 13-9. VT went 3 & out and SU was int'd at the VT46. VT got 1 FD but on 4&1 was stuffed at the SU30 (2:26 2Q). SU got 1 FD & punted with :47 left and VT, after 2 FD's on 2&10,

got a 32 yd pass with :03 left and a 37 yd FG had them trailing 13-12 with a 198-181 yd edge. VT punted to open the 3Q and SU went 59/9pl for a TD. After a 42 yd pass, VT was int'd on a deep pass at the SU3. SU got a 56 yd run by Taylor then a 41 yd TD pass to Fleener to make it 26-12 (5:49 3Q). VT punted and SU went 87/8pl with a 58 yd TD pass to Fleener, 33-12. VT went on a 10pl drive and was at the SU33 when a chopblock and sack forced a 4&42 and a punt. SU got a 34 yd Taylor run and 2pl later a 38 yd TD pass to Fleener made it 40-12 (6:05). SU recorded 8 sacks.

SUGAR BOWL - The Big Ten needed a win in a bowl after going 0-5 on NY's Day. The story here was Ohio St had 5 key players who were susp'd for the first 5 games of 2011 but allowed to play in the bowl. Ironically, all 5 made key plays including the only non-starter of the group in DE Solomon Thomas who recorded a game saving int at the OSU18 with :58 left. OSU led the game commanding, 28-10 at the half but had to hang on. Herron and Posey (2 other susp) each had a TD and Pryor hit 14-25-221. Arkansas dropped 6 passes which hurt them during the game. After a UA punt (2 dropped passes) OSU went 74/8pl for a TD, 7-0. UA went 51/5pl for a TD, 7-7. OSU went 68/7pl for a TD, 14-7 (7:17 1Q). 2 punts. UA on 4&1 were SOD at the OSU30. OSU lost AA CB Checkwa to inj and lost a couple other def players which hurt their coverage in the 2H as he DNR. OSU went 70/8pl and on 3&8 got a TD pass, 21-7. UA got 1 fd & punted and OSU went 49/8pl but missed a 50 yd FG (5:15 2Q). UA went 3&out and OSU went 68/6pl getting a TD with 1:59 left and led 28-7. UA on 4&15 got a 20 yd pass to the OSU24 with :16 left in the half and got a 20 yd FG with no time left, 28-10. OSU got 1 FD & punted go open the 3Q. UA went 52/11pl for a 46 yd FG, 28-13. OSU45 got 1 FD and nailed a 46 yd FG, 31-13. UA went 75/7pl and got a TD and 2pt conv with :58 left 3Q, 31-21. 2 punts. OSU was pinned at their 2 and Herron was hit at the 2 as progress was stopped. Amazingly after he was brought down in the EZ they ruled it a safety to make it 31-23. UA got 1 FD & nailed a 47 yd FG to get within 5. OSU made a gutsy call going for it on 4&1 at their own 38 and Herron dove over the line for the FD but fmb'l'd. It was the first fmb'l of his career. UA lost 6 yds and punted. OSU got 2 FD's and punted and UA blk'd the punt and rec'd at the OSU18 with 1:09 left but on 2&10 Thomas got the int dropping back into coverage.

NFL WILDCARD ROUND New Orleans vs Seattle - For the first time ever a defending Super Bowl champ was up by 10 pts in a playoff game and lost. NO was a depleted team coming in playing without their top 2 RB's and a banged up D missing 2 starters. NO took their opening drive to the SEA8 and on 3&2 Breese could have run for the FD but opted to just toss it to Bush but Bush dropped the pass and NO settled for a FG. NO got an int and drove 35 yds for a TD, 10-0. Each team went on a long TD drive and NO led 17-7 with 13:38 left 2Q. Julius Jones became the first player in NFL Playoff history to score a TD vs a team that released him earlier in the year. SEA went 70/5pl for a TD, 17-14 and NO had the first punt of the game at 9:55 of the 2Q. Jones fmb'l'd on the first play of their next drive at their own 18 and SEA got a 29 yd FG to tie it (7:03). After the Saints went 3 & out, SEA went 76/9pl including a 3&11 to open the drive. They were draining the clock as they didn't want to give NO any time to get the ball back when on 3&3 Hasselbeck took a shot and found Stokley behind the secondary for a 45 yd TD, the key play of the game, 24-17. NO went 77/11pl and got a 22 yd FG to pull within 24-20 at the half. SEA opened the 3Q with a 79/7pl drive and another deep pass went to Williams for a 38 yd TD and a stunning 31-20 lead. The Saints got 1 FD & punted and SEA went 33/9pl for a 39 yd FG, 34-20 (5:27 3Q). Each team went 3 & out and NO went 87/12pl for a 4 yd TD run, 34-27. SEA went 3 & out and NO went 53/8pl. On 3&3 from the 4 the Saints passed for 1 yd and settled for a 21 yd FG, 34-30. SEA got 1 FD & punted pinning NO at the 6. NO got 1 FD & punted. SEA, trying to run the clock on 2nd & 10 handed it to Lynch who broke 17 tkls in one of the most incredible playoff runs and went 67 yds for the clinching TD to make it 41-30. NO drove 70/9pl getting a TD with 1:30 left. The 2 pt failed & the onside kick just floated back to the NO47 where it was easily caught. Hasselbeck threw for 4 TD's but the Saints had 32-19 FD and 474-415 yd edges. The loss drops NO's record to 0-4 in road playoff games.

NY Jets vs Indianapolis - IND finished the season with 18 players on IR after CB Haden was put on the list prior to the game as they were a very banged up team. It was a defensive struggle with the teams combining for 2 FD's on the first 6 poss. IND got 4 FD's on their next drive but punted from the NYJ40. NYJ got 2 FD's and punted with 8:09 left in the half. IND went 80/5pl with a 57 yd pass to Garcon making it 7-0. NYJ took over with 5:25 left at their own 21. They converted 4 FD's to the IND19 but were int'd at the goal line and ret'd 23 yds with :45 left. At the half, the Jets had 8-7 FD and 153-147 yd edges. NYJ opened the 3Q with a strong 63/10pl drive and in the 2H kept it mostly on the ground and tied it at 7. IND went 45/9pl but on 3&1 ran for a loss of 1 and settled for a 47 yd FG, 10-7. NYJ then went 87/17pl. There were 5 passes out of the 17 and Tomlinson's 1 yd run put the Jets up 14-10 (9:59). IND went 67/13pl. On a 3&7 early in the drive, a handoff to Rhodes went 9 yds for a FD to the NYJ41. After getting a 3&8, 21 yd pass, this time on 3&7 from the NYJ15 they tried the Rhodes play again and were tk'd for a 1 yd gain. They settled for a Vinatieri 32 yd FG and trailed by 2. NYJ took over with 4:37 left and went 3 & out. Earlier a NYJ player wiped out the IND P but it was ruled that he was pushed into the P, although replays didn't show a push. The Colts touched the P and he took a dive but the Colts rusher was pushed towards the P. They called a 5 yd pen and gave NYJ a FD. The Jets only took off additional :16 and punted on 4&5 after a deep pass was incomplete. It appeared Peyton Manning would pull his magic off again and he went 48/8pl. This time on 3&6 the pass was incomplete to White and they settled for a 50 yd FG which was good. The NYJ ret'd the KO to their 46 and after 1 FD, the Colts surprisingly called time-out with :29 left giving the Jets time to regroup. Sanchez convinced the coaches to attempt a long pass and hit Braylon Edwards for an 18 yd comp to the 14 making it a much easier FG for Nick Folk for the win.

The Steelers own 19 division titles S/79 with 4 in the AFC North since realignment. Mike Tomlin's Steelers are 26-9 SU/19-15-1 ATS at home going 5-3 SU/ATS TY. PIT outgained foes by an avg of 47 ypg (6th) at home TY (+10 TO's) with a 23.1-16.6 avg score. Omitting BAL, PIT went 2-3 SU/ATS vs foes with a winning record TY with a +36 ypg avg (7th) being -1 TO's for a 21.2-20.6 avg score. Counting playoffs, Tomlin is 6-3 SU/ATS/O/U vs BAL with a 21-16 avg score. They split the series TY with BAL getting a 17-14 win vs PIT (2' pt AD) without Roethlisberger in Wk 4. With Roethlisberger, the Steelers came away with a 13-10 win as a 3 pt AD. BAL had a 10-6 lead with 3:00 left but Flacco was sk'd and fmb'd and it was re'd to the BAL9. PIT scored 3pt later and forced BAL to go 3&out then ran out the clock. BAL is 6-3 SU/ATS on the road TY where they have outgained foes by just 27 ypg (+1 TO's) with a 22-16 avg score. Not counting the PIT games BAL is 4-2 SU/3-2-1 ATS vs winning foes outgaining them by 90 ypg (+1 TO's) with a 26-20 avg score.

Under OC Cameron BAL has established its approach to the season as they emphasize the pass until early Dec. Cameron noted that he does this to push Flacco's development as much as possible so when the weather turns bad he can field healthy RB's and a hot QB. After a rough 1st 2 gms, Flacco settled in and finished the year with a 24-5 ratio (7.82 ypa) using 137 str passes without an int. In the L/3 of reg ssn though he failed to hit 200 yds, avg 133 ypg (62%) with a 4-2 ratio. RB Rice has logged B2B seasons of 1,200 yds rush/500 yds rec. He joins WR's Boldin/Mason with 60+ rec's, but BAL did not have a 1,000 yd rec for the 1st time S/06. Boldin's 837 yds (13.1) are a career high and though they have three rec with 600+ receptions on the roster, the unit isn't especially fast. BAL has been fairly stable on the OL with the same starting combo for 13 of 16 TY all g 1 sk for every 12.8 pass att. The truth is BAL has a good but not great D at this point with solid leadership (Lewis/Reed) that has made up for shortcomings in the secondary. Ngata is a dominant force on the DL who can play any spot up front for a unit that has given up 94 ypg (3.9) rush TY. BAL has had the advantage of a healthy Suggs after a down '09 and he's posted 11 sks for a D that earns 1 every 22 att. In the 1st 6 gms without FS Reed, BAL only had 3 int but with Reed who leads the team with 8, BAL pulled in 16 the rest of the way. BAL has our #12 ST's with a good year by Koch (39.2 net, 39 punts in20).

PIT opened 2010 3-1 SU/ATS without Roethlisberger thanks to some great defensive work which held foes to 289 ypg with a 21-12 avg (+7 TO's). With their QB, PIT outgained foes in 10 of 12 gms (NO/NE) in the reg ssn by 98 ypg (2nd overall) with a +9 TO mark (24-15 avg score). Thanks to the bye week and easy lead in gms vs CLE/MIA Roethlisberger finished with a 17-5 ratio not throwing more than 1 int in a game. PIT has been very balanced with a 348-398 run-pass mix since his return thanks to Mendenhall who is the team's first 1,200 yd rusher S/07. Mendenhall had 26% of PIT's offense TY with Moore being a standout 3rd Dn back again. Wallace has evolved into the primary rec option finishing 5th in rec yds and 2nd in ypc in the NFL. Ward is now the possession WR here with excellent blocking skills and Miller is the prototype rookie TE. PIT is used to dealing with a patchwork OL in recent years with only LT Adams and star rookie C Pouncey starting all 16 gms for a unit that gave up 1 sk every 12 att's with Roethlisberger. PIT missed being the #1 overall D by 84 yds but finished 1st vs the run (62.8, 3.0), sks by with 48 (1 every 12.4 att's) and pts all'd (232). PIT's DL is geared to occupy the opposing OL and allow the LB's to flow to the ball with DE Smith (triceps) being regarded as one of the top 5 of the last decade. PIT has long set the standard for 3-4 LB's with Woodley and Harrison again combining for 20 sks. After giving up a 22-12 ratio LY, PIT's #12 pass D is one of 3 to have more int than TD TY. PIT finished 18th in our ST's rankings TY improving their coverage units from LY but the PR is weaker.

Two of the top defensive teams in the AFC matchup and recent history shows that the defenses have dominated. The L/3 gms between these rivals have been decided by exactly a FG and in the 2 gms TY they've totaled 530 and 571 yds. Both tms prefer to run the ball which will, of course, shorten the game and while the early forecast calls for temps above freezing, Jan weather always helps the Under.

Belichick is the 1st NFL HC with four 14 win seasons and NE was the only team to go 8-0 SU (5-3 ATS) at home TY. NE only outgained foes by 13 ypg (15th) at home but led the NFL with +11 TO's (34-20 avg score). Vs winning tms (not incl Jets) NE went 6-0 SU/4-2 ATS being outgained by 15 ypg (10th) with an amazing +12 TO's (PIT #2, +5 TO's) with a 31-21 avg score. The HT is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series the L2Y TY the Jets (-3) won the 1st gm 28-14 as Sanchez passed for 220 (70-0) with a 3-0 ratio (TY's best). The Jets had a 196-80 yd edge in the 2H holding Brady to 69 yds (44%) with 2 int. In the rematch NE exploited a Jets D that had just lost FS Leonhard (shin) and Brady had the 12th 4-0 ratio gm of his career (326, 72%, outstanding 11.2 ypa). NE had a 405-301 yd edge holding Sanchez to 164 (52%) with 3 int. The Jets are now 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS on the road thanks to LW's win vs IND. They are also 2-3 SU/ATS vs winning foes (no NE) with a 7 ypg edge (-3 TO's) being outscored 23-21 ppg.

After having the most rush att's in '09 (607), NYJ trimmed them to 534 TY as they opened the playbook to take adv of Sanchez being in the system for the 2nd yr and the FA pickups. The result was a mixed bag as Sanchez hit 54% (6.7 ypa) with a 12-20 ratio LY vs 55% (6.5) with a 17-13 ratio TY. He has had D's better, but his progress was slowed by a shldr inj vs PIT. Tomlinson is an asset on 3rd Dn's and in blitz pickup with Greene failing to make an impact there. LY the Jets had the #31 pass attack (149 ypg) but had a decent improvement TY (22nd, 209 ypg) although they still haven't had a 1,000 yd rec S/07. They have spread the ball around more as 4 players have 52 rec's. The Jets have had the same OL for 13 gms TY and they get RT Woody (knee) back vs the Colts. Ryan cut his teeth on D and after finishing 1st LY (+1 TO), they were 3rd (+9 TO's) TY. NYJ are all g an impressive 91 ypg (3.6) rush TY. The muscle of the D is its LB unit with Scott setting the tone and Harris being a drastically underrated ILB. The Jets use a 3-man OLB rotation to stay fresh for pass rush sit's with Thomas, Pace and Taylor comb for 16.5 sks (20 ideal for OLB's in 3-4). LY the Jets were fearsome in pass D all g 52% (5.4 ypa) with an outstanding 8-17 ratio but TY Revis hasn't been himself. They've all'd 51% (6.5) with a 24-12 ratio as offenses have more tape to study. NYJ have our #5 ST's unit with P Weatherford having a strong year (50% punts in20) and Smith (28.6) having a great year on KR's.

NE quickly adapted its offense after releasing Moss, going for a more diffused Saints style. Since the CLE loss, NE has outgained foes 403-347 with a 37-16 avg score thanks to a +23 TO margin. Brady hasn't had an int since 10/17 with 8 str gms of a QBR of 107 or more. NE is often criticized for lacking a run game but they've finished 13th or better in each of the L5Y (9th TY) without a feature back. Green-Ellis is NE's 1st 1,000 yd RB S/04 (Corey Dillon) and is the power back while former Jet Woodhead is an ideal fit as the 3rd Dn back. NE's 2 rookie TE's, Hernandez and Gronkowski, comb for 87 rec (12.7) which was just about what Moss had LY (83, 15.2). Welker remains an elite slot WR, Branch fit right back in after being reacquired from SEA and Tate has been a decent deep threat in limited snaps (ST's). NE's OL is built for the scheme and is better than its parts all g 1 sk for every 19.7 att. NE's #25 D had its worst finish S/05 (26th) as it had one of the youngest secondaries in the NFL at the start of the yr and the DL has been decimated by inj's. The DL has been held together by one of the top 3 NT's in the NFL, Wilfork, and the solid play of Warren who has found a niche in NE's system. NE's pass rush is avg at best (16th) but the plyrs have 2 sks TY (1 sk every 17 att's). NE's #30 pass D is a mixed rating as foes are forced to pass more to keep up with Brady and they led the NFL with 25 int with a respectable 7.1 ypa. NE finished 10th in our ST's rankings TY thanks to their return units.

This team backed up HC Ryan's words LW that the Indy game was personal and it'll be tough to carry that emotion for a 2nd straight road game. While there certainly is no line value laying this price with the Pats we have to feel they have the edge after dropping their road opener to NY 28-14 this year. The edge goes to Brady seeing this defense for a 3rd time this year and the 405 yds they gained at home was the Jets 2nd highest total. NE was embarrassed in LY's home playoff game and can't see that happening for a 2nd straight season.
