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### NEWS AND NOTES - WEEK 15, 2010

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Tough loss for Arizona vs Arizona St. While both D's controlled matters in the 1H and ASU had a 136-83 yd edge, there were 5 key plays that hurt UA. ASU led 6-0 helped by the fact UA dropping four int's. Any one of those would have set them up and taken away QB Osweiler's confidence as he struggled early on. UA also had a zero yd punt and on ASU's final drive of the 1H they converted on 3&10, 3&8 and even 3&19. UA appeared to take control with two 3Q TD's and led 14-6 but fumbled at the 49 up 14-9. ASU got a couple of fortunate pen's. On 2&5 they took a 6 yd sk back to the 11 but a hands to the face on a DL was called for a FD at the 2. Then on 3&3, ASU's rec pushed the UA DB to the ground and caught the ball for the TD. A flag was thrown for the obvious pass interference but it was ruled def pass interference so it was a TD. The final 2 key plays that went against UA both involved xp's. They got a TD with :27 left in the game to pull out the win but the xp was blk'd sending it to OT. In the 2nd OT each team got a TD but ASU blk'd the xp again... Fresno St got their 2nd win over a BCS school this year after beating Cincinnati in the season opener. FSU dominated early with a 72/8pl TD drive then got a 78 yd TD pass and after a 6pl drive, a 45 yd FG to lead 16-0 after 1Q. IL got an 18 yd FG then a 35 yd TD run and it was 19-10 at the half and FSU had a 233-165 yd edge. There were 3 TD drives on the first 5 poss of the 2H, two by Illinois but after their 2nd TD which came with 14:55 left in the game they missed the 2 pt conversion and trailed 25-23. UI punted with 9:31 left and FSU on 3&13 fired incomplete from their own 7 but a pers foul late hit gave them a FD. They then converted on 3&10 and opted to go for it on 4&1 and got a FD to their own 47. After 1 more FD, they finally punted with just :18 left after a 50/15pl drive. IL brought McGee in at QB (bigger arm). After an incomplete he was sk'd at his own 4 on the final play...Northern Illinois once again lost a MAC Title game with a late 4th down conversion. In 2005 when after 4 FD's, Akron's Hixon hauled in a 36 yd TD pass with :10 left and on 1st & 15 NI's Hail Mary pass fell incomplete. This year Miami in the 1H had an xp and FG blk'd and trailed 14-13. They drove for a TD to open the 3Q to lead 20-14 but then faked a FG on 4&gl from the 5 and only gained 3 yds. It appeared those 3 points would come back and haunt them and perhaps the reason they did not try to the FG were the 2 blocks. NI led 21-20 and punted with 2:48 left and MU took over at its own 48. They faced a 4&20 and although a deep pass was underthrown and deflected by a Huskies defender and Givens hauled it in for a 31 yd play to the NI31. On 2&12 they got a 33 yd TD pass for a 26-21 lead. NI got down to the MU32 but on 3&8, Harnish scrambled and was tk'd and the clock ran out...West Virginia dominated Rutgers much more than the final score would indicate. The Mountaineers had 25-11 FD and 523-203 yd edges. In the 1H WV fumbled at the RU8 then RU13 costing them 2 scores. They also had a 37 yd FG blk'd and only led 14-7 at the half. QB Smith got a 10 yd run for an apparent TD but as he was going in, he fumbled. For their 3rd fumble inside the 15. WV got a TD with 4:32 left to lead 35-7 but RU on 4&2 got a 6 yd pass to the WV44 and then a 44 yd garbage TD pass to Harrison with 2:02 left to "only" lose by 21...UCF held the ball for 13:00 in the 1Q and UCF and SMU combined for just 10 points in the 1H, the lowest total in the 6 year history of the CUSA Title game. UCF had their opportunities to take charge. At the end of the half, they had a 1st & gl at the 3 but settled for a 29 yd FG and led 10-0. UCF opened the 3Q with an 85/8pl drive for a 36 yd TD run by Latavius Murray who had 2 TD's and was the game's MVP. SMU got a 22 yd TD pass with 9:15 left to get back within 10. UCF got an IR to the SMU28 but after a sk on 4&17 opted for a 52 yd FG and missed it with 3:41 left. SMU converted on 4&5, 3&12 and 4&7 but on 4&10 from the UCF25 was sk'd for an 8 yd loss...Pittsburgh's Dion Lewis rushed for 261 yards and 4 TD's on a snow covered field at Cincinnati. You could not see the yard lines and Pitt was wearing white uniforms which may have helped them as they blended into the surface. Finally Lewis was given the feature back role and was handed the ball 42 times and was very effective. Pitt had a 430-265 yd edge and while they won by 18, they also blew some opportunities including having a pass go through WR Shanahan's hands and was int'd at the UC1, they hit the upright on a 38 yd FG and fmb'l'd at the UC4 with 5:48 left...Boise St was coming off a rare loss but rolled over Utah St 50-14 in a game they led 43-7. Unfortunately, Kyle Brotzman only had 1 FG attempt in and he missed it. Utah St rushed for 250 yds but only threw for 41 on the blue turf. Utah St's Kerwynn Williams set a new FBS single season record for KR yards with 1,421 on the year breaking the previous mark of 1,410 set earlier this season by Taveon Rogers of New Mexico St...

Howard Schnellenberger coached his 300th career college game but it didn't go the way he would have liked it to as Troy dominated FAU. Leading 30-0 at the half with a 307-164 yard edge, Troy rolled to a 44-7 win. FAU lost their last 3 games of the season and finished 4-8 on the year...Colin Kaepernick tied an NCAA record for TD's rushing by a QB as he got his 59th on what was a designed pass play. He ties Nebraska's Eric Crouch for that mark. Kaepernick hit 13-17-159 passing while rushing for 155 yards on 20 carries. He has topped 100 yards rushing 16x in his career and became just the 3rd QB in NCAA history to top 4,000 yards rushing (4,090) trailing only Pat White (4,480) and Brad Smith (4,289). Louisiana Tech led 14-7. LT's Phillip Livas nearly set an NCAA record for KR TD's but Nevada K Ricky Drake tackled him in the 4Q when he was on his way to what would have been his 9th...Oregon struggled for most of their game vs Oregon St, trailing 7-0 early. OSU faked a FG and was int'd and the Ducks went 74/7pl for a TD. UO did miss a 25 yd FG on the final play of the half after a 73/13pl drive. UO had a 242-126 yd edge. The Ducks were SOD at the OSU32 early 3Q but went 79/7pl for a TD to lead 23-7. OSU went 65/11pl but settled for a 26 yd FG after a 1st & gl at the 2. On OSU's next drive they had a 1&gl again but settled for a 22 yd FG and trailed by 10, 23-13. UO got a 23 yd TD run with 12:16 left to go up by 17. OSU punted with 10:40 left, was int'd at the UO39 and then the Ducks clinched it with a 10 yd TD run by James with 4:27 left, 37-13. OSU got a garbage 12 yd TD pass with 1:18 left for the 17 pt final. UO did have a 491-319 yd edge...Idaho blocked a 26 yd FG by SJS on the last play of regulation to force OT and in OT SJS settled for a 39 yd FG while Idaho, on 3&8, got a 23 yd TD pass. SJS outgained the Vandals 496-421. SJS also missed an xp in the 3Q which would have given them the victory in regulation as well. Not only did they have problems with FG's, but in the 2H SJS went on a 72/9pl drive and had a 2nd & gl at the 1. La Secla was int'd in the EZ for a TB. At the end of the half, SJS had a FD at the ID13 with :43 left but La Secla was int'd at the 5 costing them even more points...Cam Newton wrapped up the Heisman and Auburn got the largest victory ever in an SEC Title game in their rout of South Carolina. Auburn scored TD's on their first 3 poss to jump out to a 21-7 lead but at 21-14 on the last play of the half, Newton threw a Hail Mary pass to the EZ which bounced off 1 receiver and was hauled in by Adams for a 51 yd TD to make it 28-14. Auburn had a 348-196 yd edge at the half. Auburn finished with a 589-349 yd edge with SC gaining 102 of its 349 yards on the final 2 drives trailing 49-14. Newton rushed for 73 yards and hit 17-28-335...The Apple Cup was interesting as Washington needed a win to become bowl eligible. Chris Polk had the 2nd best rushing total in UW history with 284 yards on 29 carries. Only Hugh McElhenny's 296 in 1950 (also vs WSU) is better. UW came into the year the 3rd longest drought of AQ schools of not getting to a bowl with only Baylor and Duke being longer. UW's last trip came in 2002. Big plays were the keys for the Huskies. On a fake punt they got a 30 yd pass down to the 7 in the 2Q and a TD on the next play made it 14-0. UW led 28-14 when WSU drove 70/10pl and 73/6pl for TD's to make it 28-28 with 4:26 left. With 1:21 left the FG unit was brought on for a 49 yd'r but changed their mind. They went for it and got a FD run to the 16. A pers foul forced a 2nd & 21 and UW needed just a FG for the win but opted to go for the EZ and got a 27 yd TD pass with :44 left on 2 & 21 to get the cover...Matt Barkley was questionable coming in but hit 15-26-198 yards. USC got a 68 yd FR TD to lead 14-7 in the 2Q and beat their crosstown rival for the 11th time in the last 12 meetings. USC did have a 474-358 yard edge and a 22-17 FD edge. Despite finishing 8-5, USC will not be in a bowl for the first time S/'07 due to NCAA sanctions and it would have been a Holiday Bowl berth this year. UCLA trailed 28-7 before getting a TD with just :23 left in the game as the Bruins lost their 6th game in the last 7. It was only the 4th time in the last 35 years neither is headed to post season so it was like a bowl for both. The crowd of 71,105 was well below capacity...Oklahoma won its 7th Big 12 Title, more than 2x as many as any other school and it was the 7th straight for the South Div. OU had 454-293 yd and 19-13 FD edges. The Huskers had 3 big plays to take a 17-0 lead. They got a 66 yd TD run by Roy Helu as they had limited success on offense in the 1H. They got a 53 yd FG by Alex Henery and then got a 33 yd IR to the OU12. At the end of the play, Sooner WR Broyles took the ball out of Osborne's hands and it was orig ruled OU rec'd a fmb'l but replays showed Osborne's knee could have been down and they gave the ball to NU. Two plays later they got a TB pass out of the Wildcat from TB Burkhead to Reed, 17-0. OU got the 2nd largest comeback in Big 12 Title history (CU came back from 19 down to beat UT in '01). NU has now lost the last 2 B12 Title games by a total of 4 points. Taylor Martinez was sk'd 7 times. OU was SOD at the NU34 on 4&5, SOD at the NU25 on 4&1, settled for a 26 yd FG after a 12 play drive, missed a chipshot 24 yd FG, settled for a 20 yd FG after a 59/8pl drive on a 1st & gl at the 3 and settled for a 27 yd FG after a 55/11pl drive.

† **Navy 23 Army 17** - Philadelphia. Navy has won an amazing series record 8 in a row SU vs their bitter rival Army by an avg of 36-9 (outgained Army by 150 ypg) and is 14-5 ATS. The favorite is 9-4 ATS. Over the last 3 years Army has been outscored 89-6. LY Army led 3-0 at the half (their first halftime lead in the series since 2001), but Navy shut them out in the 2H for a 17-3 win. Army forced 3 fumbles but a pair of missed FG's, a lost fumble and an int were too much to overcome. Army HC Ellerson recruited Navy HC Niumatalolo to play QB at Hawaii in the mid '80's. Navy QB Dobbs has missed 2 gms with injury this year (should be healthy now) but is still the team's top rusher with 806 (3.6) and is avg 119 ypg pass (55%) with a 10-4 ratio. Navy faced Georgia Southern earlier TY (also triple option) and only escaped with a 13-7 win (193-109 yd edge). When Army defeated Kent St they became bowl eligible for the first time since 1996. They had a game at Yankee Stadium vs Notre Dame on deck but after the KS win they chanted "beat Navy." The Army Sr class is trying to avoid becoming the 2nd straight class never to beat either Air Force or Navy. Army FB Hassin leads with 881 (5.6) while QB Steele is the #2 with 620 (3.7) and is avg 76 ypg pass (55%) with a 5-3 ratio. Navy has the edge on off (#52-87) but Army has the edge on def (#68-81) and ST (#51-106). Both teams lost to Air Force this ssn (Navy 14-6, Army 42-22) so the CIC Trophy is not on the line here. Navy beat ND 35-17 while Army lost to the Irish 27-3. Both tms have already clinched bowls and each has had 3 weeks to prepare, but this is the most important game of the year for both teams. With both teams running the same form of triple option, this gm should be close.

Off the New England game the Jets should handle Miami, but then have B2B road games against 2 potential division leaders. They may be in position to rest starters in the season finale.

The Steelers could challenge for homefield especially in they upset the Ravens. Cincy and Carolina have combined for 3 wins and they host the Jets in what could be the seasons most physical game.

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## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Cleveland (+) over BUFFALO** - Mangini got his 1st win as the Browns HC LY beating BUF 6-3 as a 6 pt AD. Great special teams play by CLE (7 of 9 punts inside 20), the start of their power run game (171 yds 4.2), 13 penalties by BUF along with 2 TO's set up CLE's win. BUF muffed a punt on their 16 with 3:00 left to set up a game winning 18 yd FG as they were outgained 288-193 with only 2 completions. Both teams are close statistically the L4W with CLE having the #27 and #18 units (+5 TO's) vs BUF #23 and #26 units (-1 TO's). CLE played small ball BUF vs a tough MIA defense as Delhomme stuck to the short and intermediate routes completing 71% of his passes (6.4 ypa) with a TD. CLE harassed Henne consistently holding him to 50% comp with 3 Int and BUF has struggled with stout 3-4 defenses. BUF is 1-3-1 ATS at Ralph Wilson Stadium being outgained by 125 ypg with 181 ypg (4.6) given up on the ground. After upsetting CIN and putting a scare into PIT, BUF gave up their 15th 150 yd rushing effort in 28 games. Look for CLE to once again feature Hillis (80 ypg 4.4) who has four 100 yd games TY to take the pressure off Delhomme (2-6 TD/Int TY) who catches a break vs a BUF's #11 pass defense allowing a 22-8 ratio.

**FORECAST: Cleveland 34 (+) BUFFALO 23**  
**3★ PITTSBURGH over Cincinnati** - The Steelers were firmly in control of the 1st meeting TY for 3Q with a 27-7 lead :10 into the 4Q with a 252-118 yd edge. On their next 2 drives CIN posted 14 pts and were SOD on the PIT 12 with :40 left. Roethlisberger is 9-4-1 ATS vs CIN but hasn't covered the L3 and PIT is 1-5 ATS as a DD fav. After BAL's #8 defense on SNF which prides itself on being just as physical as PIT's Roethlisberger gets the injury depleted #19 defense over the L4W. Only the LB unit has escaped major injury TY for CIN as they are giving up 133 ypg (5.0) on the ground, pulling in 1 sack every 18 pass att's while allowing 64% comp with 33 ppg the L4W. PIT's #6 offense L4W is avg 141 ypg rushing (4.5), 62% comp (8-2 ratio) and 26.8 ppg prior to SNF. Their 1 sack every 11 pass att allowed the L4W prior to BAL is a concern but CIN only has 1 player with more than 2 sacks (rookie DE Carlos Dunlap 4.5). PIT is only 2-4-1 ATS prior to SNF with Roethlisberger at the helm but both wins were at home (CLE and OAK) where they logged an avg 404-255 yd avg winning by 18 and 32 pts. If PIT is off a loss they will be very angry and focused for a Div win. If they won they won't let up to keep momentum as they have the Jets game on deck with seeding implications.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ JACKSONVILLE over Oakland** - This is the 3rd meeting since realignment with JAX winning and covering both. This is the 3rd road game in 4 wks for OAK who are 7-17 ATS away vs a NDIV foe (28-13 avg score). Both teams are off big Div wins with OAK getting their 1st sweep of SD since 2001 in a 28-13 victory as a 13 pt AD. OAK dominated the ground game with a 251 (4.8) to 21 (2.6) edge and had a 17:18 TOP edge. Campbell didn't have to do much and minus the DEN, SEA, KC games he's only avg'd 107 ypg (51%) with a 2-5 ratio with 13.8 ppg. While JAX has been outgained by 36 ypg at home they are 4-2 ATS losing to PHI and a TEN team used to playing on MNF. The Jags enforced their will vs TEN as 24 of their 1st 29 plays were run plays. JAX had a 258 (4.9) to 57 (4.1) rush edge with a 19:48 TOP edge. JAX has #8 and #10 units (-4 TO's) the L4W vs OAK's #31 and #23 units (-4 TO's) the L4W. JAX only has 2 starters on IR at this point and are avg 25.4 ppg the L5W despite WR Sims-Walker (36 rec 12.9) missing 2 of the L3 games. JAX has RB Jones-Drew (133 ypg 5.3 L5W) vs OAK #23 rush defense, consistency, momentum and travel edges as road teams off a SU win as a 13 pt dog are 1-9-1 ATS.

**FORECAST: JACKSONVILLE 30 Oakland 20**  
**2★ Tampa Bay over WASHINGTON** - This is the 4th meeting in 5 years with the Bucs covering 3 straight. TB is 7-0-1 ATS as an AD with Freeman at the helm while WAS despite always being sold out is 5-13-2 at home. These teams are close offensively over the L4W with TB at #22 and WAS at #16 but TB has a huge edge with their #5 D (+3 TO's) with WAS at 29 (-8 TO's). McNabb (58% comp 12-15 ratio 7.2 ypa) simply hasn't looked comfortable running Shanahan's offense with an Int in 10 straight games. The run defense has crumbled giving up 169 ypg (5.3) rushing the L5W which has been compounded by a secondary missing CB Rogers (hamstring) and SS Landry (Achilles) who may not play again TY. WAS has only won the yardage battle in 1 game TY vs TEN who had QB issues during the game (-78 ypg in rest). TB's 7 wins have been vs foes with a losing record where they have outgained foes by 35 ypg (+9 TO's) with a 24-16 avg score. Freeman has been very efficient with 204 ypg (62%) with an 11-2 ratio in those. We'll call for TB to rebound after LW's tough loss to ATL vs a WAS team that isn't on the same page as the coaching staff.

**Indianapolis at TENNESSEE** - IND has won 5 of their L7 here by an avg of 26-17 and LY Indy dominated with 23-12 FD & 367-245 yd edges. LW despite the return of QB Collins, TEN was outFD'd 23-11 & outgained 377-220 by JAX and are on an 0-5 SU and ATS run. IND has lost 3 straight (Manning 11 int) for just the 7th time under Manning and are in danger of missing the playoffs for the first time S/01. Can the Colts keep their playoff hopes alive or will TEN relish the role of spoiler here? **Call the NC Debit Card System for the winner on tonight's PPH Play for \$9. Updated Thur at 3:00 pm EST!**  
**New England 24 CHICAGO 17** - The Bears have the situational edge after a short road trip to DET and catching NE off a huge MNF game vs the Jets with a SNF game vs GB on deck. Cutler has only faced NE once in a 41-7 MNF loss (3 pt AD) in 2008, passing for 168 yds (65%) with a 1-2 ratio. While CHI only has the #24 offense the L4W, Cutler has been playing good ball with 219 ypg (68%) with a 8-3 ratio with the Bears incorporating an impressive 34-27 run-pass mix on avg. While CHI's #4 defense has benefitted from facing a 3rd string QB in 2 of its 3 games vs Romo, Rodgers, Eli, Favre and Vick they are 4-1 SU and ATS. They allowed 278 ypg (66%) with a 5-7 ratio in those with 6 sacks (1 every 34 att's). NE is 4-2 ATS on the road TY being outgained by 69 ypg but are +6 TO's. They are also 5-1 ATS vs a top 10 defense (61 yds) with Brady passing for 228 ypg (64%) with a 9-4 ratio prior to MNF. CHI is under the radar in the NFC thanks to how bad the NFC West is, with ATL, GB, NO and PHI getting the publicity. NE has faced the Cover 2 regularly vs IND and will be prepared to beat it as their NO inspired diffusion passing game is a good matchup here.

**NY Giants 27 MINNESOTA 20** - This is the 5th meeting in 6 years with the Vikings being 4-0 SU and 3-1 ATS. Leslie Frazier's defense has stifled Manning who has avg'd 206 ypg (52%) with a 2-9 ratio in the series. MIN went into LW's game shorthanded without LG Hutchinson (hand) and WR Harvin (migraine) losing Favre (shoulder sprain) 3 plays into the game. Jackson had a rough start getting Int'd on his 2nd drive but was decent from there as he passed for 139 yds (68%) with a 2-2 ratio. MIN had a 17-2 FD and 246-41 yd edge at the half up 28. The Giants dominated WAS LW with a 16-8 FD and 37-135 yd edge at the end of the 1H with a 21-0 lead. They held the Redskins to 10 drives of 30 yds or less (6 takeaways) and are 13-6 ATS off Div win and 12-4 ATS as a NDIV AF. While 3-2 ATS the Giants have outgained foes by 90 ypg on the road TY with their 2 losses to a then healthy IND in Wk 2 and PHI on MNF when they lost their cool on 3 key plays. MIN has looked good but that has been vs 2 weaker teams and we'll call for the road team by 7 and watch the injury report.

**Green Bay 31 DETROIT 16** - The Lions are 0-4 SU and ATS hosting the Packers with a 38-22 avg score being outgained 438-334 on avg. Rodgers has logged 5 straight games with a QBR of 105 or better vs DET avg 305 ypg (70%) with a 14-3 ratio for a 5-0 SU and 3-2 ATS mark. GB's stat edges aren't as big as expected over the L4W with the #4 and #2 units (+6 TO's) vs DET's #13 and #12 units (-2 TO's). SF built on ATL's gameplan vs GB dropping as many defenders as possible into coverage as they didn't fear the Packers #23 run game which has been under 100 yds in 6 of the L7 games. However, GB's yards after catch West Coast offense is essentially the same as when Holmgren took over. Rodgers ended with 298 yds (70%) 3-0 vs SF pulling away in the 3Q when he got into a rhythm.

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DET had extra time to prep for CHI LW and played them tough as the Bears underestimated Stanton (178 yds 67% 1 TD with 1 rush TD) in his 2nd career start. Even with LW's win the Packers are the #7 seed and won't take DET lightly here as DIV wins (3-1 vs CHI 4-0) are at a premium.

**Atlanta 27 CAROLINA 14** - This is the 3rd road game in 4 Wks for ATL who also have a long trip to SEA on deck. The home team is 4-0 SU and ATS in the series but CAR is off B2B road trips to CLE and SEA. CAR is 1-5 SU and ATS at home with their only win being vs SF who were coming cross country off a Bay area rivalry game vs OAK with a road game to London on deck. CAR has been outgained by 60 ypg at home TY with -7 TO's being outscored 26-10 on avg. ATL has decent stat edges the L4W with the #21 and #15 units (+3 TO's) vs the Panthers #28 and #25 units (+4 TO's). Ryan has only been avg vs CAR avg 215 ypg (60%) with a 4-3 ratio. Ryan has been outstanding over the L6 games avg 251 ypg (67%) with a 12-3 ratio with a 6-0 SU and 5-1 ATS mark. RB Turner has avg'd 111 ypg (5.5) in 2.5 games of work vs CAR leaving the 2nd game of LY's matchup with an ankle injury. CAR is 0-5 SU and 2-3 ATS with Clausen at the helm for a full game and blew a 14 pt lead vs SEA LW being outgained 356-76 with 31 straight points given up from there. CAR lacks the weapons on both sides of the ball to compete (given up 31 pts in 4 of 5 games) with a Falcons team playing for home field advantage.

**NEW ORLEANS 34 St Louis 14** - The Rams got the Saints at just the right time LY as a big HD (+14) off a bye week. NO was off B2B Div home games vs ATL and CAR with a road game vs TB on deck. STL had a good gameplan for containing Brees (223 yds 69% 2-2) but a 97 yd KR to open the 2H and a solid game by Bush (98 yds 12.3 from scrimmage) did them in. STL had a 434-420 yd edge but NO was without both starting CB's for the 2H. NO has the stat edges the L4W with the #2 and #17 units (+1 TO's) vs STL with the #18 and #21 units (+2 TO's). STL is dramatically improved over LY's team on both sides of the ball but this is their 3rd straight road game. NO has outgained foes by 55 ypg at home with a 27-14 avg score. In their L4 games STL has covered vs a SF team with an inexperienced QB that they didn't know how to utilize, been handled by a balanced ATL team, upset a DEN team with a feeble defense and won by 13 vs arguably the 2nd worst team in the NFL with just 64 yds difference (+1 TO). In their L2 games on the road NO has failed to put away both DAL and CIN but won't make the same mistake here vs Bradford and the overachieving Rams.

**SAN FRANCISCO 24 Seattle 14** - SEA is 5-2 SU and ATS vs the 49ers with 31-6 win in the season opener. SF had a 136-11 yd edge after each team's 1st 3 drives but settled for 2 FG's and were SOD. SEA then scored 28 straight points and Qwest Field quickly took on a CFB atmosphere as the 49ers only converted one 3rd Dn on the day. After losing 34% of their offense in RB Gore in MNF's win vs ARZ the 49ers had a good gameplan vs GB. SF played GB tough for 3.5 Qtrs as they dropped as many defenders as possible into coverage to limit Rodgers. After SF made it 21-16, Rodgers went 7 for 8 with 77 yds and a TD being sacked twice. It should have been much worse but GB opted for 2 late FG's with the game in hand. SF had a very balanced 22-25 run-pass mix but were outgained 410-269 on the day. SEA (2-12 ATS as AD) got off to a slow start vs CAR finding itself down 14-0 in the 2Q but adjusted and posted 31 straight points from there. The Seahawks have been outgained by 68 ypg on the road (-5 TO's) upsetting CHI thanks to a bye week along with the woeful Cardinals. We'll call for SF by 10 due to their home edge (+58 ypg) and #9 defense the L4W.

**NY JETS 20 Miami 17** - The Jets are off LW's huge MNF game vs NE for the AFC East title. After being swept by MIA in 2009, Sanchez was crisp vs the Dolphins with 256 yds (54%) with 3 TD's. Despite trailing 14-0 in the 2Q and only leading for :18 in the game, Henne led the Dolphins downfield and had them in position to tie on the final drive of the game but was Int'd on a 5 yd pass into the EZ. WR Marshall (right hamstring) is slated to return after missing 3 games and had 166 yds (16.6) with a TD in the first game. MIA is actually 8-4 SU and 10-2 ATS on the road with Henne as the starter where he avg's 211 ypg (61%) with a 9-13 ratio. TY they've outgained foes on the road (5-1 ATS) by 34 ypg (+0 TO's) with a 20-16 avg score. MIA struggled vs a strong interior rush LW as Henne only completed 50% with 3 Int and the Jets who blitz ruthlessly will do so here. The Jets have been inconsistent at home as while they have outgained foes by 45 ypg (+6 TO's) they are only 4-2 SU and 3-3 ATS with a 20-15 avg score. We'll call for the home team by 3 here as we want to breakdown the MNF game and see if Marshall actually returns for MIA.

**Denver 23 ARIZONA 17** - After flat out embarrassing the Chiefs just 4 weeks ago off the bye week, DEN has lost 3 str and LW were outgained 357-247 as KC got some revenge. QB Orton had his worst performance of the season completing just 32% for 86 yds and HC McDaniels' job security will remain a hot topic (5-17 S/6-0 start). While DEN has the #12 and #27 units (-5 TO's) the L4W ARZ has actually fared worse with the #31 and #28 units (-10 TO's). LW the Cardinals fielded all 3 QB's vs STL in a losing effort. Anderson (1 int every 32 att) is likely to get the start and as much as Whisenunt would like to get Hall some snaps he's logged 1 int every 13 att's the L4W. ARZ is just 1-5 ATS vs the AFC and just 1-6 ATS at home TY (-123 ypg 31st) and while DEN has the better QB it will be interesting to see if the Broncos will put forth any sort of great effort with their coaches job on the line.

**SAN DIEGO 28 Kansas City 13** - The Chiefs are 2.5 games ahead of SD in the AFC West right now. KC (who hasn't been favored in 9 games in the series) snapped a 5 game losing streak to SD on MNF in Wk 1 with a 21-14 win as a 4.5 HD. SD had a 389-197 yd edge but the Chiefs dominated on special teams with 219 KR/PR yds including a 94 yd PR for a TD. KC has been playing respectable over the L4W and have the #3 and #16 units (+1 TO's) vs SD's #19 and #11 units (+3 TO's). KC is off a misleading game vs DEN where they had a 359-247 yd edge with good field position for the 1st 3 Qtrs. Odd coaching decisions (going for it on 4th and 2 on the DEN 2 with only a 7 pt lead in the 3Q), fumbling on the DEN 32 two drives later then playing the field position game kept it closer than it should have been. Cassel has quietly put up Pro Bowl #5 avg 209 ypg (60%) with a 23-4 ratio. SD had their 18 game Dec win streak crushed by OAK LW falling behind 14-0 in the 1Q after a muffed punt set up an 25/8p drive and a Rivers Int set up another score. OAK's defense pinned their ears back and kept Rivers off balance (4 sacks) with SD being outrushed 251 (4.8) to 21 (2.6). SD (5-2 ATS at home off SU loss) is now in playoff mode as they are 7th in the seedings (prior to SNF), at home and will be playing angry here.

**Philadelphia at DALLAS** - DAL won all 3 meetings LY inc consec home games 24-0 (wk 17) and 34-14 (WC). The Cowboys have been impressive since Garrett has taken over with 4 straight covers (3-1 SU) and have the #10 and #30 units (+6 TO's) L4W. The Eagles do have some extra rest for this game after playing 4 games in 18 days and while the Eagles are looking like this year's Cinderella team in the NFC they now get the unfortunate task of having to play a "hot" Cowboys team twice in the final 4 weeks. **Get the Sunday Night winner on the NC Debit Card System for only \$9 after 11:00 am EST on Sunday.**

**Baltimore at HOUSTON** - The Ravens have won their L2 trips to HOU incl a 41-13 win in '08, a game they only led 19-13 in the 4Q.
