BCS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP Alabama (-2') 21 LSU 0 - LSU didn't cross midfield until 8:00 were left in the game as Alabama proved that they are one of the top defenses in NCAA history. They held LSU to 5 FD's and 92 yds. Jeremy Shelley tied a bowl record with 5 FG's and the game was somewhat of a replay of their 9-6 OT match except Bama completely dominated this one on offense, defense and special teams. Trent Richardson rushed 20 times for 96 yards and got the first TD in the 2 games with 4:36 left on a 34 yard run. AJ McCarron was the star player as they threw on FD all but twice and McCarron hit 23-34-234 yds. Bama even lost their top PR/WR Marquis Maze after a long PR in the 1Q and he DNR. Bama missed 2 FG's in the game with a 42 yd'r blk'd and a 41 yd'r being missed late 3Q and LSU when they crossed midfield with 7:53 left was actually still within 2 scores despite the domination but after Bama went up 21-0 LSU opted to punt on 489 from their own 24 with 2:47 left and Bama's final play ended at the LSU 40.

WILDCARD HOUSTON (-3) 31 vs Cincinnati 10 - Houston had its first ever playoff game and it was at home in front of a charged up crowd. Cincinnati was coming off a home game vs Baltimore which was like a playoff game but they had come up short and now had a rookie QB making a playoff road start. Foster rushed for 153 yards (6.4). Dalton did outstat TJ Yates hitting 27-42-257 while Yates hit 11-20-159. Each team went 3&out to open. HOU got 1 FD and punted and CIN went 74/5pl, the key a 52 yd PI down to the 20. The TD put the Bengals up 7-0. HOU answered with an 80/6pl drive and Foster's 8 yd td run tied it at 7. CIN went on a 14pl drive but on 3&8 was sk'd for a 9 yd loss and missed 50 yd FG (12:45 2Q). CIN20 went 61/8pl for a 37 yd FG, 10-7 (7:09). HOU went 59/13pl and settled for a 39 yd FG, 10-10 (1:48). The key play of the game happened after the Bengals got 1 FD to their 34. Dalton threw a short pass that was int'd by DL Watt and ret'd 29 yds for a TD and HOU led 17-10 (:52). CIN got 1 FD and was sk'd. At half the yards were even at 156. The first three 2H poss were punts. HOU took over with 5:45 left in the 3Q and went 83/9pl and got a 40 yd TD pass to Johnson, 24-10. CIN20 got 2 FD but on 4&3 were int'd from the HOU47. Joseph actually should have dropped the int as it cost them 23 yds of field position and HOU started at their 24. HOU got 2 FD's and punted with just 7:25 left. CIN was then int'd at their own 45 and HOU's Foster ripped off a 42 yd TD run down the right sideline where he barely stayed in bounds, 31-10 (5:15). CIN gained 71 yds on 13 plays getting to the HOU9 where they were SOD on 4&5 with 2:23 left.

WILDCARD NEW ORLEANS (-10') 45 Detroit 28 - If you check out the Power Plays forecast on this game it was almost a preplay of the game with the yards all within 50 yards and the points very close as PP called for a 40-23 win and the final was 45-28. DET rushed for just 32 yds and Drew Brees hit 33-43-466 as the Saints piled up a 626-412 yd edge. Two TO's in the 1H kept it close. DET opened with an 80/8pl drive and got a 10 yd TD pass. NO19 got 2 FD's but fmbl'd at the DET18. DET got 2 FD's to midfield and punted. NO went 89/11pl for a TD, 7-7 (14:01 2Q). DET went 87/9pl for a TD, 14-7 (9:11). NO20 got 3 FD's but fmbl'd at the DET38. After DET went 3&out punting with 5:03 left, NO went 78/14pl but settled for a 24 yd FG on the last play of the half on 3rd down. At the half the Saints had a 256-210 yd edge but trailed by 4. NO scored TD's on their first five 2H drives. The opened with a 78/4pl drive for a TD. DET got 1 FD and punted. NO went 92/13pl for a TD, 24-14 (4:03). DET went 80/8pl and got a 1 yd TD run, 24-21 (1:08 3Q). NO went 80/14pl for a 17 yd TD run by Sproles, 31-21 (9:53). DET was int'd on a deep pass and the Saints went 61/4pl for a TD, 38-21. DET got back under the number going 79/9pl and got a 12 yd TD pass with 4:40 left, 38-28. NO rec'd the onside kick then went 44/4pl for a TD with 3:36 left. DET20 got 1 FD and was int'd and ret'd 17 yds to their own 33. NO got a FD to the 7 and took a knee.

WILDCARD DENVER (+9') 29 Pittsburgh 23 OT - The story here was two-fold. Injuries to PIT and his plays in the passing dame for Tebow. PIT came in without their top rusher Mendenhall, for a TD, 14-7 (9:11). NO20 got 3 FD's but fmbl'd at the DET38. After DET went 3&out punting with

and big plays in the passing game for Tebow. PIT came in without their top rusher Mendenhall, C Pouncy and S Clark and a banged up Roethlisberger. During the game, their entire D-line was injured and out by mid-2Q and they also lost starting OT Starks. The Steelers game plan was to take away the Bronco rush and that left Tebow some deep passes. He had just 10 completions for the game but they went for an amazing 316 yards. PIT looked like they would dominate early. They opened with a 53/8pl drive for a 45 yd FG. DEN went 3&out on their first 2 poss. PIT punted on their 2nd poss but then went 47/12pl and settled for another FG, this one 38 yds and led 6-0

in a dominating 1Q where they had 119-10 yd edge. DEN went 80/5pl with a 30 yd TD pass to Royal. That was set up by a 21 yd pass to Decker and DEN led 7-6 (13:24 2Q). PIT went 3&out and DEN got a 58 yd pass to Thomas on its 2nd play and went 73/4pl for an 8 yd Tebow TD run, 14-6. PIT was int'd at their own 27 and ret'd 9 yds. DEN got 1 FD and settled for a 20 yd FG, 17-6 (7:30). PIT got 1 FD and punted (5:09). DEN31 went 59/8pl and got a 28 yd FG with 1:08 left in the half, 20-6. PIT got 2 FD's to the DEN 38 but on 3&4 from the 32, Roethlisberger fmbl'd the snap and was tkl'd for a loss and PIT punted. At half DEN had a 233-170 yd edge. DEN opened the 3Q (20) with 3 FD's to the PIT38 but punted 26 yds. PIT13 went 87/11pl for a TD, 20-13. DEN went 63/12pl and got a 35 yd FG, 23-13 with 13:10 left. PIT went 61/7pl but settled for a 37 yd FG, 23-16. DEN got 2 FD's but then McGahee fmbl'd and PIT appeared poised for the win. They went 55/7pl and got a TD to tie with 3:48 left. DEN got 1 FD and punted and PIT (24) once again got to the DEN45 but Roethlisberger was sk'd and fumbled for an 11 yd loss and they punted on 4&14. In OT DEN won the toss and on the first play, Tebow went deep and found Thomas for an 80 yd TD. Even in the new playoff OT rules, that ended the game.

WILDCARD NY GIANTS (-3) 24 Atlanta 2 - ATL was a dome team playing outdoors but it was 44° with 12 mph winds. The story here was two failed 4th down conversions which really set the tone for the game. The first 5 poss opened with punts and just 1 combined FD. ATL went 66/14pl but on 4&1 on the first play of the 2Q were SOD. Two plays later, however, Eli Manning was called for intentional grounding in the EZ on 2&21 from the 13 so ATL got a safety and the lead, 2-0. ATL38 got 1 FD and punted. NYG went 85/13pl with 9 runs on the drive. The TD made it 7-2. 2 punts. ATL took over with 1:08 left in the half (20) and got 2 FD's. At half NYG had a slim 128-127 yd edge. ATL opened the 3Q with a punt and NYG went 72/11pl but settled for a 22 yd FG after a 1st & gl at the 5, 10-2. ATL21 went 58/9pl but on 4&1 were SOD at the NYG21. Three plays later Manning found Hicks for a 72 yd TD pass where he was wide open over the middle then outraced the secondary in the EZ, 17-2. ATL went 3&out and the NYG went 85/10pl and got a 27 yd TD pass to Manningham to lead 24-2 with 9:55 left. ATL punted on 4&10 and the NYG went on a time consuming 71/12pl drive eating up 6:25 and missing a 32 yd FG with 2:57 left. ATL gained 54/10pl being SOD on 4&10 at the NYG17 with 1:01 left. NYG had a 442-247 yd edge.

CONF SEMI-FINALS SAN FRANCISCO (+3) 26 New Orleans 32 - Turnovers, turnovers, turnovers. There has been a grand total of one team that has ever won a playoff game giving up 5 TO's and that was back in 1977 when the Oakland beat the Baltimore Colts. The TO's kept the Saints from dominating No had 26-14 FD and 472-322 yd edges and led by 3 but Alex Smith hit a huge 47 yd pass to Vernon Davis which got him in scoring position and they got a 14 yd TD pass while in FG range to tie it with :09 left. Had that pass been incomplete, the game would have gone to OT. NO opened with a 78/12pl drive but fmbl'd at the 2. Each team punted and SF got a 49 yd TD pass to Davis to go up 7-0. It was a 54/2pl drive. NO14 got 1 FD and then were int'd and ret'd 41 yds to the 4.5F got a TD 3pl later, 14-0. NO then fmbl'd the KO at their own 13 and SF got a 25 yd FG to lead 17-0 giving them scoring drives of 3 and 4 yds. The Saints went 80/9pl for a TD. SF went 3&out and the Saints went 66/7pl for a TD, 17-14. SF punted but the Saints were int'd at the SF29 with 1:54 left in the half. Each team punted and then SF fmbl'd at their own 45 but NO could not capitalize on SF's lone TO as they fired incomplete 3 times. NO fmbl'd the punt at their own 26 and SF got a 3 yd drive for a 41 yd FG. 4 punts. NO went 47/9pl getting a 48 yd FG to pull within 20-17. 2 punts. SF36 got a 42 yd run by Gore to the 22 and got a 37 yd FG to go up by 6, 23-17 (7:36). NO went 79/9pl and got a TD for the lead with 4:02 left on a 44 yd pass to Sproles. SF answered. On 3&8 it appeared they were going to settle for a FG but Alex Smith ran around the left end 28 yds for a TD and the 2 pt failed and SF led 29-24 with 2:11 left. NO12 got 2 FD's then a 66 yd TD pass to Graham appeared to give them win. The 2pt conv made it 32-29 with 1:37 left. SF got 1 FD and then a 47 yd pass to Davis and on 3&4 in FG range for OT, took one final shot at the EZ and their wish was granted as it was a 14 yd TD to Davis for the outright win. **CONF SEMI-FINALS NEW ENGLAND (-13') 45 Denver 10** - Tim Tebow, Tim Tebow, Tim Tebow.

The media focus on Tim Tebow all week and Tom Brady made sure folks didn't forget about him. He hit 26-34-363 yds and tied an NFL Playoff record with 6 TD passes. The record was set by Daryle Lamonica in 1969 and tied by Steve Young in the 1995 Super Bowl. The outcome was decided by halftime. NE rolled up 31-15 FD and 509-252 yd edges. NE opened with a quick 80/5pl drive for a TD. DEN got a pair of FD's to the NE37 but Tebow was sk'd and fmbl'd. NE guickly went 59/7pl for a TD, 14-0. DEN17 got 1 FD and punted. NE13 got 1 FD and was int'd and ret'd 17 yds to their own 24. They set the Broncos up for a 24/4pl drive and McGahee's 5 yd TD appeared to make a game of it, 14-7. NE got 1 FD to midfield and punted but DEN went 3&out and NE went 52/8pl for a TD, 511, 14-7. NE got 1 F D infidited and purited bit DEN wellt 3&ott and NE wellt 52/5pi for a 1D, 21-7 (7:42). 3 punts. NE took over with 2:27 left in the half and got a 61 yd TD pass to Branch with just 1:57 left. DEN threw the ball twice and punted with 1:09 left. The Pats made them pay with a 58/5pl drive for a TD with :05 left, a 19 yd pass to Gronkowski, 35-7. At the half NE had 19-7 FD and 351-120 yd edges. DEN went 3&out and NE went 44/4pl after a 15 yd PR by Edleman, 42-7. DEN went 3&out and NE(49) got 2 FD's to the DEN23 but fmbl'd. DEN went 58/14pl and got a 41 yd FG with 2:14 left in the 3Q, 42-10. NE went 78/11pl for a 20 yd FG, 45-10 (12:39). DEN went 77/14pl and were SOD on 4&gl at the NE3. NE got 2 FD's and punted with 2:56 left and DEN was happy to run the clock out taking over at their own 5 and getting 1 FD with 5 runs.

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HANDICAPPING NOTES FOR THIS WEEK'S NFL CONFERENCE FINAL GAMES

Here are some questions you might have about this upcoming round of the playoffs and our researched answers:

How do the home teams fare in this round? You would expect the home teams to have an edge and they are 35-28-1 56% ATS in the Finals since 1977. Vegas has been giving some extra compensation for the home field advantage in this round. From 1977-'89 the home teams were 15-7 ATS. Since 1990 they are just 20-21-1 ATS but are 5-1 SU and 4-2 ATS the L3Y. LY was only the second time no #1 seed advanced to the conf championships (2008 the other). Remember, these teams do not have the advantage of an extra week of preparation like they did in the Semi's last week.

How often are the spreads over a TD in the Finals? There have been 21 teams that have been favored by 7 points or more since 1990 in the Conference Final round. The big favorites are 10-11 ATS in that span, including just 4-7 in ATS the last 11 occurrences although Indy did cover the last time it occurred ('09). While this happened 14 of the 20 games in the '90's, it has happened in just 7 of the 18 games since 2000.

Is covering in the Semifinal round an advantage when your opponent failed to cover? Actually, it is just the opposite. There have been only 17 times since 1987 when a team has won in the Semifinal round but did not cover. The public has a short term memory and those teams usually fall out of favor and the spread compensates for their loss. These teams have actually gone 10-5-2 ATS in the finals. In 2008 NE did not cover after also failing to cover in the Semi's. In 2006 this applied to 2 teams as NO and CHI both won and did not cover in the Semi's and then faced off in the NFC Finals. In 2004 PIT did not cover in the Semi's vs the Jets but then lost at home to NE. In 2003 NE only beat TEN by 3 at home and did not cover (-6) but then beat IND 24-14 (-3). PHI was a rare non-cover as they needed OT to beat GB in the '03 Semi's and then were upset by CAR in the Finals. In 2001 NE only won by 3 at home vs OAK and was -3 so they did not cover and went into PIT as a 10 point dog and won outright.

How do teams with the better SU record fare in this round? In the last 19 years, teams with the better SU records are 20-18-1 53% ATS. LY Pittsburgh had a better SU record and won and covered but GB finished behind Chicago yet won and covered despite being an AF.

How do teams do after a tight, narrow win of 3 points or less? In the last 20 years there have been 20 Semifinal games decided by 3 points or less. The teams that survived these close battles have a record of 10-7-1 ATS, but are just 2-6 ATS since 2002. We did not count the '03 gm between CAR and PHI since both were coming off OT wins and faced each other. In '08 BAL beat a better TEN team 13-10 but was tired and injury depleted when they went into PIT. They would lose 23-14 as a 6 pt AD. In 2009 the Jets beat SD 17-14 but fell to Indy 30-17 as an 8 pt dog.

How do teams do after scoring 40+ points in the Semifinal round? Since 1977 a total of 15 teams have topped 40 points in the Semifinal round. Does this potency on offense give them an edge in the Finals? Teams that score 40+ are 11-4 SU but just 5-10 ATS as the linesmaker boosts the lines due to public enthusiasm. They are 2-7 ATS the last 9. In 2009 New Orleans beat Arizona 45-14 but needed OT to get past Minnesota in a non-covering win. LY GB pummeled Atlanta 48-21 and than traveled to Chicago and beat the Bears 21-14

How do teams, after winning by 27 points or more straight up the week prior, fare the next round in the playoffs? Perhaps Las Vegas is forced to overcompensate the line or perhaps the team gets too full of itself. Since 1990, teams that win by 27 or more are just 5-11 ATS the next week. In the 2000 playoffs OAK waxed MIA 27-0 and then lost outright at home to BAL as a 6' point favorite. In 2003 IND whipped DEN by 31 and covered at KC the next week. ATL won by 30 in 2004 over STL and then lost in the next round. In 2009 Both New Orleans and Minnesota won their semifinal games by 27+ and faced off against each other. LY the Packers did it in route to their Super Bowl win

How do home underdogs in the AFC/NFC Title game rounds fare?

Talk about RARE. Since 1986 there have been a grand total of FIVE home dogs in this round (26 years!!!). Amazingly in 1997 there were TWO and both lost as DEN and GB won as AF's. In 2000 the NYG's were +3 to the potent Minnesota Vikings. We had a 4★ in Power Sweep on the Giants and they were a great HD winning 41-0!!!! PIT was the 4th team to be a home dog in 2004 and lost by 14 getting 3 from the eventual SB Champ Patriots and Chicago again lost to the eventual SB Champs LY.

How do teams do that are off an OT win? Since 1990, there have been 13 playoff games that needed overtime to decide it. Three of those were in the Conf Championships with the team winning in OT winning the Super Bowl 2 of the 3 times incl New Orleans in 2009. In 2003 both Carolina and Philadelphia went to OT and they faced off in the Conf Finals with the #3 seed Panthers pulling the upset. In the remaining 8 occurrences the team that won in OT covered 5 of the 8 games with 6 of the 8 going OVER the total.

How do #5 and #6 seeds fare in the Conference Finals round? The extra seeds came into being in 1990 and in 21 years only 3 teams have won the SB as a #5 seed or higher. However ALL 3 winners have been in the last 6 years with PIT in '05 and the NY Giants in '07 and the GB Packers LY. In 2009 the NY Jets were a #5 seed and lost to Indianapolis. There have been only four #5 seeds and they have gone 1-3 SU and 2-2 ATS incl the '07 NYG. There have been only four #6 seeds and in 2008 both PHI and BAL made it to the Conf Finals but both lost SU and ATS. In 2005 PIT won the SB XL giving them a 2-2 SU/ATS record.

No #1 seeds - Since 1990 when the NFL made the switch to 6 play-off teams the only 2 seasons when a #1 seed did not advance to the CF was 2008 and LY. 2009 was the first time since 1993 that both #1 seeds advanced to the SB and only third time since 1990.

Over/Unders - In the L10 years the Conference Finals has gone Over 154 of 20 games. Since 1988 when both teams went Over in their Conf Semifinals they are 7-2 Over in the Conf Finals. Also of note is that in the 5 games since 1993 when both teams went Under the total in the CSF's, they also are a perfect 5-0 Over in the Finals.

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Even though they avenged their loss in 2010, the 33-14 home loss in the 2009 Wildcard round still stings the Patriots. BAL was simply the more physical team that day as they dominated all phases. This led to NE altering their offensive package to be 2 TE heavy and more physical. Both teams took advantage of inexperienced QB's LW's to advance. NE exerted their will vs DEN (509-252 yd edge) while BAL capitalized on HOU's mistakes. Seventeen of BAL's 20 pts were off TO's with only 2 drives over 40 yds on the day. NE is now 8-1 SU/5-4 ATS at home TY outgaining foes by 70 ypg (+7 TO's) for a 32-18 avg score. BAL went 4-4 SU/ATS on the road w/a +14 ypg mark (-5 TO's) for a 20-18 avg score. SD, NYJ, PIT, and IND are the common foes with BAL going 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS w/a 331-287 yd edge (+6 TO's) for a 26-18 avg score. NE went 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS being outgained 393-394 but was +9 TO's for a 30-21 avg score.

BAL's best finish on off has been 13th with Joe Flacco at QB so TY's #15 ranking is within the norm. After having a career best ssn in 2010, Flacco's #'s are a bit disappointing esp his 57.6% comp rate. Part of this is due to having a rookie #2 WR and a pair of 2nd year TE's seeing more time in the passing game. OC Cam Cameron generally emphasizes the pass to start the year to get more snaps for Flacco in warmer games while keeping Ray Rice fresher down the stretch. TY was no different as Rice avg'd 62 ypg (4.1) in the 1st 9 gms vs 115 ypg (5.3) over the final 7 finishing 2nd in rushing to Jones-Drew. Under Flacco the biggest issue with BAL's off has been a lack of spd on the perimeter. They upgraded that with Torrey Smith who finished 3rd in rec yds and 4th in ypc for rookie WR's with more than 10 rec's. Boldin missed the L/2 with a knee injury but is expected to ret for the playoffs along with Lee Evans who missed almost all of the ssn with an unspecified foot injury. TE Ed Dickson had a solid impact in the passing game but he was tasked with more blk'g in the L/7 which coincides with Rice's surge. BAL's OL had an excellent yr as they started all but 1 gm together due to RG Andre Gurode's toe inj and were 12th in sks all'd. The Ravens #3 def also had an excellent yr finishing in the top 10 for the 9th straight ssn. BAL is one of the few teams with the luxury of being able to plug in DC's, though 1st year DC Chuck Pagano was more aggressive with the blitz than in previous ssns. BAL only had 8 games missed by def starters TY with 4 coming via Ray Lewis' turf toe injury. While BAL allowed 8 gms of 100 yds rushing (120 ypg, 3.7) they also held foes to 93 yds or less (65 ypg, 2.1) 8 times. They are 1 of the 5 teams with more int than TD passes allowed TY and allowed 200 or fewer yds passing in 9 gms TY. BAL's biggest issue is their special tms which after being 12th LY tumbled to 25th due to poor play by the return units.

Much like GB, NE has taken a bit of heat TY for their #31 D. Belichick flipped the unit to a 4-3 due to the lockout but inj's took their toll with only 5 def st'rs playing all 16. NE's "bend don't break" scheme relies a lot on situational FB which is where Belichick excels. NE is a healthy 14th in sks despite not having a marquee pass rusher, is tied w/SEA for 3rd in takeaways (34) and are an avg 15th in ppg allowed. NE's #31 pass def has only all'd 3 more TD's than int which is 8th best TY. NE has given up 8 gms of 300 net yds passing TY but since their bye week on Oct 23rd they have all'd only 2 games with an opposing QBR of over 100 with 1 vs IND when they toyed with them in the 4Q. NE also seems to be mentally tougher than the L/2Y on D as they have solid leaders in Vince Wilfork, Jerod Mayo and the defenders are used to this style of ball. The Patriots also quietly got Patrick Chung back in the ssn finale as well as Brandon Spikes to help shore up the run defense. NE's best def player is Tom Brady as he sets the tempo with his command of the game. Along with Brees he also broke Dan Marino's NFL passing record and his 39 pass TD's was 2nd only to his 50 in 2007 and his 8.57 ypa was 2nd only to Rodgers TY. 2010 offered a glimpse of how versatile NE's 2 TE spread off could be as Gronkowski and Hernandez are starting to max it out. NE is the only team with 3 ply'rs over 900 yds rec and just Welker and Hernandez comb have more rec yds than DEN (by 188 yds) or JAX (by 386 yds). Brady's success eats into the #20 run gm and keep in mind it had finished 12th or better the L/3Y. NE's RB's get playing time depending on the situation/foe and are a "hidden asset" in this off. The top 3 RB's have comb for 1,459 yds (4.2) which would be 2nd behind Jones-Drew in rushing TY. The fact that Brady has been sk'd just 32 times TY (9th) is quite impressive as only FA addition Brian Waters has started all 16 gms TY. NE also has also improved on ST's as after being 11th LY they are 6th thanks to their punt units.

A classic off vs def battle as well as a rematch of 2009's Wildcard game (BAL +3' 33-14 at NE). The

Patriots as a whole are on a mission and the playoff sked sets up perfectly being under the radar vs Tebowmania LW and they now get a rematch in front of the fans that booed them 2 years ago. "I'd have been booing us, too, the way we played," Brady said. "Playing the way we played today, we weren't going to beat anybody." We know Brady can beat any def and while BAL's stop unit looked solid it was vs a rookie QB playing on the road with a 17-3 1Q deficit. The Ravens off LW totaled just 227 yards and 11 FD's getting TD's on 2/3pl and 34/5pl "drives". Don't discount NE's D as they've played bend but don't break with their def ypp #2 in the NFL and they've had 16 sacks the last 4 games.

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Both teams capitalized on stout defensive play to turn the tables against two of the NFL's premier QB's to advance to the NFC Championship. Earlier this year SF caught the Giants at an ideal time as they were off a big road win vs NE with B2B primetime events vs PHI/NO on deck. The Giants pulled to within 7 halfway thru the 4th Qtr and were threatening to tie at the end but DE Justin Smith deflected the pass on 4th&2 on the SF 10. The Giants had a 395-305 yd edge holding the ball for 34:37. Manning had 311 yds (65%) w/a 2-2 ratio while Smith hit for 242 yds (63%) w/a 1-1 ratio. SF is 16-1-1 ATS at home with Alex Smith and while they have only outgained foes by 12 ypg TY they are an amazing +23 TO's for their 29-13 avg score. The Giants are 6-3 SU/ATS on the road TY (inc SF) where they have been outgained by 7 ypg (+7 TO's) with a 27-26 avg score. There are plenty of common foes TY with the divisions facing each other and NO was the 1 NDIV foe that both teams faced. The Giants were outgained by 8 ypg (+2 TO's) overall for a 26-24 avg score but 4 games were at the start of the year when the OL was adjusting and the secondary was beat up. SF was outgained by 4 ypg but were +25 TO's for a 26-18 avg score.

Statistically, Eli Manning isn't that far off from what you'd expect from him but he's had arguably his best season ever. Working behind 5 different OL combos, 2011 was another year with skill players being dinged up, yet Manning managed to throw for a career-high in passing yards. The Giants have their 1st 1,000 yd duo of receivers in Hakeem Nicks and Victor Cruz. Nicks has been a reliable but not overly splashy as the #1 WR while Cruz has been the 2nd best slot WR in the NFL TY behind Welker. Mario Manningham is now the possession WR and when healthy Jake Ballard is a solid receiving TE. Bradshaw and Jacobs each have a single 100 yd rushing game TY due to injuries to themselves and the OL. They are built to be a power rushing team and are much better than their #31 rush off ranking. The best player on the Giants #27 defense TY has been Jason Pierre-Paul whose 16.5 sks is quite impressive as he entered 2011 as the #3 pass rusher for the team. The LB's are avg even behind a strong DL, but the secondary has been a major liability TY due a lack of depth. They've given up five 300 yd passing games avg 335 ypg (58%) w/a 15-3 ratio in those. This is another unit getting healthier late in the ssn though and SS Kenny Phillips has been excellent when healthy. The Giants spec tms aren't much better than 2010's #29 unit as they've struggled on both sides of the ball on punts and are below avg on KR's.

At the start of the year Alex Smith was viewed as being on borrowed time. Having been a 15 year NFL QB himself, Harbaugh has took to the practice field and tutored Smith how to run his straight forward offense. SF's 2 TE set to allows them to control the LOS and give variety to the ground game. While the 49ers have yet to have a 1,000 yd receiver since they drafted Smith, Frank Gore has run for 1,000 yds in 5 of the L/6 seasons. Only DEN/HOU ran the ball more times TY than SF, as Gore had 5 straight 100 yd games in Oct/Nov as OC Greg Roman started to adjust for more passing from that point. WR Michael Crabtree finally started to mature into an NFL player TY and he likely would have had his first 1,000 yd ssn if not for another foot injury. The real #1 option in the passing game is TE Vernon Davis as 40 of his 67 rec's were for FD's. SF's passing game is muddled after that as while Kyle Williams has shown some flash they don't have another dependable quality option. This has led to their #30 red-zone finish as out of 193 off drives only 32 ended in a TD and only CIN's 30 had fewer among the playoff teams. SF's OL was much more stable with Anthony Davis and Mike lupati in their 2nd ssns as the 49ers started their L/13 games with the same unit. Pass protection is still an issue as they gave up 1 sk for every 10.3 att's. SF's #4 def is he best finish for an NFC West team since realignment thanks to their elite def front 7 TY. DE Justin Smith played at an NFL MVP level TY and sets the tone for the entire unit. Smith's 7 sks is actually impressive for a 3-4 DE and he often was the setup blk'r for Aldon Smith who came in for pass rush situations. Smith was a part of the best LB unit in the NFL TY along with All-Pro LB Patrick Willis and NaVorro Bowman who dominated in his 1st ssn as a starter. With SF having the #1 rush def TY (69 ypg, 3.2 at home), their #16 pass def is a bit misleading as they are 1 of 5 tms with more int than pass TD's allowed. SF simply owns the best spec teams unit TY thanks to picking up one of best STC coaches in Brad Seely.

The Giants remind us of last year's Packers squad using late season momentum and being in better health than earlier in the season. The Giants have proven to be road warriors pulling upsets at PHI (+8.5, 29-16), at NE (+9, 24-20) and at DAL (+4.5, 37-34). They also benefit from an earlier meeting here in which they outgained SF 395-305. The 49ers needed 5 Saints turnovers to survive last week and you can't expect the emotion to match LW's first playoff game at home since 2002. Since 1990 only 2 teams have won as a HD in the semi-final round going 0-2 SU/ATS the next week. SF has allowed a staggering 27 sacks their last 7 games and expect the now healthy NY D-line (17 sacks L/4 games inc 4 vs GB) to take over.
