HANDICAPPING NOTES FOR THIS WEEK'S NFL CONFERENCE FINAL GAMES

Here are some questions you might have about this upcoming round of the playoffs and our researched answers:

How do the home teams fare in this round? You would expect the home teams to have an edge and they are 35-30-1 54% ATS in the Finals since 1977. Vegas has been giving some extra compensation for the home field advantage in this round. From 1977-'89 the home teams were 15-7 ATS. Since 1990 they are just 20-23-1 ATS and while they are 4-2 SU the L3Y they are only 2-4 ATS. There have been only 2 seasons when a #1 seed didn't advance which was 2010 & 2008. Remember, these teams do not have the advantage of an extra week of preparation like they did in the Semi's last week.

How often are the spreads over a td in the Finals? There have been 22 teams that have been favored by 7 points or more since 1990 in the Conference Final round. The big favorites are 10-12 ATS in that span, including just 4-8 ATS the last 12 occurrences incl NE failing to cover LY vs Baltimore. While this happened 14 of the 20 games in the '90's, it has happened in just 8 of the 20 games since 2000.

Is covering in the Semifinal round an advantage when your opponent failed to cover? Actually, it is just the opposite. There have been only 18 times since 1987 when a team has won in the Semifinal round but did not cover. The public has a short term memory and those teams usually fall out of favor and the spread compensates for their loss. These teams have actually gone 11-5-2 ATS in the finals. LY Baltimore failed to cover vs Houston and followed that up by covering again vs NE.

How do teams with the better SU record fare in this round? In the last 20 years, teams with the better SU records are 20-20-1 50% ATS. LY SF and NE both had better records and were HF but neither covered and SF lost outright to the NY Giants.

How do teams do after a tight, narrow win of 3 points or less? In the last 21 years there have been 20 Semifinal games decided by 3 points or less. The teams that survived these close battles have a record of 10-7-1 ATS, but are just 2-6 ATS since 2002. We did not count the '03 gm between CAR and PHI since both were coming off OT wins and faced each other. The last time this occurred was in 2009 as the Jets beat SD 17-14 but fell to Indy 30-17 as an 8 pt dog.

How do teams do after scoring 40+ points in the Semifinal round? Since 1977 a total of 16 teams have topped 40 points in the Semifinal round. Does this potency on offense give them an edge in the Finals? Teams that score 40+ are 12-4 SU but just 5-11 ATS as the linesmaker boosts the lines due to public enthusiasm. They are 2-8 ATS the last 10. In 2009 New Orleans beat Arizona 45-14 but needed OT to get past Minnesota in a non-covering

win. In 2010 GB pummeled Atlanta 48-21 and then traveled to Chicago and beat the Bears 21-14 and LY NE scored 45 pts vs Denver and failed to cover as a 7 pt HF vs Baltimore.

How do teams, after winning by 27 points or more straight up the week prior, fare the next round in the playoffs? Perhaps Las Vegas is forced to overcompensate the line or perhaps the team gets too full of itself. Since 1990, teams that win by 27 or more are just 5-12 ATS the next week. In the 2000 playoffs OAK waxed MIA 27-0 and then lost outright at home to BAL as a 6' point favorite. In 2003 IND whipped DEN by 31 and covered at KC the next week. ATL won by 30 in 2004 over STL and then lost in the next round. In 2009 Both New Orleans and Minnesota won their semifinal games by 27+ and faced off against each other. In 2011 the Packers did it in route to their Super Bowl win and LY NE beat Denver by 35 pts and while they beat Baltimore they failed to cover.

How do home underdogs in the AFC/NFC Title game rounds fare? Talk about RARE. Since 1986 there have been a grand total of FIVE home dogs in this round (26 years!!!). Amazingly in 1997 there were TWO and both lost as DEN and GB won as AF's. In 2000 the NYG's were +3 to the potent Minnesota Vikings. We had a 4★ in Power Sweep on the Giants and they were a great HD winning 41-0!!!! PIT was the 4th team to be a home dog in 2004 and lost by 14 getting 3 from the eventual SB Champ Patriots and Chicago again lost to the eventual SB champs in 2011.

How do teams do that are off an OT win? Since 1990, there have been 14 playoff games that needed overtime to decide it. Four of those were in the Conf Championships with the team winning in OT winning the Super Bowl 3 of the 4 times incl New Orleans in 2009 and the NY Giants LY. In 2003 both Carolina and Philadelphia went to OT and they faced off in the Conf Finals with the #3 seed Panthers pulling the upset. In the remaining 8 occurrences the team that won in OT covered 5 of the 8 games with 6 of the 8 going OVER the total.

How do #5 and #6 seeds fare in the Conference Finals round? The extra seeds came into being in 1990 and in 21 years only 3 teams have won the SB as a #5 seed or higher. However ALL 3 winners have been in the last 6 years with PIT in '05 and the NY Giants in '07 and the GB Packers in 2011. In 2009 the NY Jets were a #5 seed and lost to Indianapolis. There have been only four #5 seeds and they have gone 1-3 SU and 2-2 ATS incl the '07 NYG. There have been only four #6 seeds and in 2008 both PHI and BAL made it to the Conf Finals but both lost SU and ATS. In 2005 PIT won the SB XL giving them a 2-2 SU/ATS record.

No #1 seeds - S/'90 when the NFL made the switch to 6 playoff tms the only 2 ssns when a #1 seed did not advance to the CF was '08 and '10. In '09 it was the 1st time s/'93 that both #1 seeds advanced to the SB and only 3rd time s/'90.

Over/Unders - In the L11 years the Conference Finals has gone Over 15 of 22 games. Since 1988 when both teams went Over in their Conf Semifinals they are 7-3 Over in the Conf Finals. Also of note is that in the 5 games since 1993 when both teams went Under the total in the CSF's, they also are a perfect 5-0 Over in the Finals. LY both Conf Finals went Under the total which was the first time since 2003.
