NEWS AND NOTES

Another Big East unbeaten done in by a MAC tm. There's nothing fluky about Kent St's win over Rutgers as each team had 21 FD's and KSU led throughout. KSU had been 0-22 vs ranked teams but moved to 7-1TY and likely wrapped up a bowl bid. Gary Nova threw an amazing 6int and RU also lost a fmb1 with KSU was +5 in TO. Perhaps the biggest play came in the 2Q when RU, down 7-3, threw a quick flanker screen but Fackler had a 1 handed int and took it 25 yds for a td and a 14-3 lead. RU trailed 21-3 but got a 19 yd td pass with :04 left in the half but RU punted on their first 3Q poss and Kent went 56/7 for a td and a 28-10 lead. KSU led 35-17 in the 4Q with RU getting a td with 10:35 left and KSU's final drive went 46/11pl taking a knee at the RU29... Miami, Oh pulled the big upset. If you looked at OU's last 3 games, they played 3 of the worst teams in the NCAA and were actually outgained by all 3 (Buff, Mass, Akron). OU had :09 and no time-outs and could kick the tying FG and go to OT or try for the win. OU opted for running 1 more play but was sk'd and it proved to be costly as the time ran out and they did not get another play off. QB Tetteleton did not realize the team did not have a time-out left. OU finished with a 464-424 yd edge but MU had scored on the first 3 poss going 50/14 for a 40 yd FG, 54/3pl for a 54 yd td pass and 65/7 for a 22 yd FG and led 13-0. OU

pulled within 20-14 at the half and MU on 3&7 from the OU10 was int in the EZ with :29 left in the half. UM had a 309-218 yd edge at the half. OU's 38 yd FG with 4:41 left tied it up MU went 59/8pl for a go ahead FG with 1:24 left of 31 yards. OU went 65/9 and ran out of time from the MU7... Matt Scott hit 27-50-369 yds and rushed for another 100. USC WR Marqise Lee set a Pac-12 record with 345 yards receiving on 16 receptions and USC led by 15 in the 3Q. LY Matt Barkley set a schl rec with 468 yds passing vs AZ and topped that TY hitting 31-49-493. On 3&24 USC was int'd and ret 26 yds on their first drive and AZ went 60/6pl for a td then after USC was SOD on 4&2 at the UA15. AZ went 76/11pl for a 25 yd FG and led 10-0. USC fumbled at the UA10, was int'd at the 34 and UA was SOD at the USC35 then int'd at the USC10. UA missed a 37 yd FG on the final play of the half and USC led 21-13 with a 395-285 yd edge. USC opened it up to 28-13 and surprisingly the next 4 poss were punts. UA got a td with 3:56 left and USC fmb1 and UA got a td but failed on the 2 pt conv after driving 37 yds for the score, 28-26. On 4&2 Lee got a 1 yd run and was stopped short and UA went 72/7pl and got a 7 yd td run, 32-28 (2ptng). The Cats went 49/9 for an 11 pt lead with 5:36 left. USC got a td with 4:30 left but UA got 2 FD before punting with just :55 left. USC got to the

UA48 but fired incomplete on their final 2 plays... Florida had 6 turnovers and Georgia 3. UF had an early fmb1 set up UGA for a 20 yd td drive. It was like a TO when UF was SOD on 4&1 at the UGA36. In the 2Q UF went 70/15 but settled for a 38 yd FG then on 3&4 had an open receiver but a bad snap had Driskel's pass off the mark and they settled for a 22 yd FG, 7-6. Another TO had them 2&gl at the 5 when Driskel was int'd in the EZ. An int set up UGA for a 13 yd "drive" for a 29 yd FG then trailing 17-9, UF drove to the UGA18. Driskel hit Reed with what appeared to be a td but has Reed leaped from the 4 to the EZ, he was hit and fmb1'd into the EZ for a td with 2:05 left. On 2&11 UF was called for a pers foul face mask giving UGA FD and another PF gave UGA another FD and they were able to win and take control of the SEC East... Arizona St had 535 yds as UCLA/ASU comb for over 1,000 yards. ASU jumped out to a 14-0 lead but UCLA battled back to lead 21-17 at half, the key a 2 yd IR td with 1:19 left in the half and Franklin got a td on the next play. LA did have a 218-197 yd edge at the half. They led 35-26 and then 42-33 when ASU got a 22 yd FG with 5:17 left. LA punted with 3:36 left and ASU went 56/6pl and their 7 yd td pass with 1:33 left looked to pull out the win but UCLA25 went 62/12pl and got a 33 yd FG for the 2 pt road win.

THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on **Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings**. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

Strength of Opponent: Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, in 1992, Washington's defense vs the rush was rated at a "110" (From 1-100). They faced Colorado and allowed 183 yds rushing and **dropped 12 spots** in the national rushing defense ratings. However, Power Plays took into account the potent Buffalo run attack and had forecasted the Huskies yielding 225 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Another example was Michigan vs Purdue in 1989. Michigan held Purdue to just 45 yards rushing and improved their ratings in rushing defense in the national statistics. However, our ratings had them rated at a 102 and moved them down to 99, as they should have yielded just 32 yards to an impotent Purdue rush attack. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run **you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have!** The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

Garbage yards: These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are **counted** into national ratings, **but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!**

Weather: If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the defenses.

Injuries: When South Carolina played NC State in 1989, South Carolina QB Todd Ellis was injured on the third play of the game. His backup, who had seen very little action all year, was not prepared and hit on just 4 of 13 passes for 65 yards. The offensive coordinator did not risk any passes. In the national statistics NC State's pass defense **MOVED UP 14 NOTCHES**. In Phil's Power Ratings they **stayed the same**, as the low yardage WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

Home Field Edges: The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

Successful Unbalanced Attacks: In 1989, Ohio St was held to 127 yards passing vs Northwestern. This dropped OSU in the national passing offense ratings & RAISED the Wildcats in the pass defense ratings. In our ratings the two units **remained** rated the same. Why? OSU rushed for 456 yards & DID NOT HAVE TO PASS & when they did they hit 9 of 11 passes, which is VERY effective. While Northwestern's pass defense looked good in the national ratings, only Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings reflected the TRUTH!

There you have it. More than just numbers, THESE RATINGS REFLECT the true strength of each unit and allow them to have **the most accurate forecast of yards gained and points allowed in the country!** No other rating system takes into account all the previous factors.
