NEWS AND NOTES

W Michigan had been eliminated from a bowl and finished a disappointing season with a disappointing loss. The loss mirrored their season as they outgained E Michigan 443-369 and had a 24-20 FD edge but had numerous blown opportunities. WM was SOD at the WM36. They trailed 17-14 at the half with WM having a 220-212 yd edge. Each team got a FG to open the 3Q and then EM got a td to lead 26-17. EM was int'd at the EM28 and went 81/16pl but on 4&gl from the 1 opted for a short 19 yd FG to get within 6 since they were 2 scores down with 7:59 left. EM got a 34 yd FG to go back up 2 scores with 2:33 left and WM got a td with :49 left capping a 78/10pl drive. EM rec'd the onside kick and WM fired HC Cubit... Memphis only had a 333-213 yard edge but not only won a road game in CUSA play, they beat UAB 46-9. They went 66/9pl, 70/6pl and after blocking a punt, 24/2pl all for td's. Their 4th pass was 75/9pl for a td and they led 28-3 at the half with a 222-106 yd edge. UM went on a 49/12pl drive for a 51 yd FG and a 31-3 lead then after

a 57 yd PR, missed a 42 yd FG. On the next play they recovered a fumble and went 18/2pl for a td and after a 21 yd PR went 49/3pl for a 44-3 lead. Their last score of the game came after giving up a td with 6:00 left, they blk'd the xp and rec'd it for 2 for the 46-9 final... All 7 of Michigan St's Big Ten games have been decided by 4 points or less and MSU is now in danger of not making a bowl as they fell to 5-6. MSU had a 419-303 yd edge and a 23-17 FD edge but much like their game vs Boise, blew numerous scoring opportunities and this time it actually came back to bite them. After just missing a td pass MSU settled for a 35 yd FG to lead 5-3. On their next pass MSU came close to a td on 3&gl from the 1 as it looked like the ball broke the plane but was spotted short and on 4&gl lost 3 yds. MSU missed a 37 yd FG with :02 left 1H and despite a 191-128 yd edge they trailed 6-5. Northwestern got a 43 yd IR td to open the 3Q. MSU fumbled at the NW35 and was int'd at the NW16 in the 3Q. Trailing 23-20 they punted on 4&8 with 2:46 left and after NW got 2 FD they

got it back with 1:29 left and no time-outs. On 4&10 they were SOD at their own 20... Rutgers' Jawan Jamison, the leading rusher and 3rd leading receiver, was questionable coming in. He rushed for 37 yards on 7 carries but it was Savon Huggins who got the bulk of the work and he rushed for 179 yards on 41 carries. RU had a 420-341 yd edge. Butch Jones spent the week lobbying for fans to fill the stadium which only seats 35,000 and 34,526 were on hand. RU blew an opportunity as they were int'd at the 7 on their opening drive but UC missed a 34 yd FG. RU got a 71 yd td pass to Harrison to lead 7-0 but then went 57/10pl and on 3&8 with :25 left, floated the ball into double coverage in the EZ for an int and came with no points. At the half RU only led by 7 despite a 285-146 yd edge. UC was SOD at the RU8 and int'd at the RU38 but RU went 39/10pl and had a 22 yd FG blk'd. RU went 62/12pl for a 42 yd FG, 10-0. UC was SOD at the RU44, RU was SOD at the UC28 and UC got a 36 yd FG with :11 left to avoid the shutout. RU rec'd the onside kick.

THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on **Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings**. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

Strength of Opponent: Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, in 1992, Washington's defense vs the rush was rated at a "110" (From 1-100). They faced Colorado and allowed 183 yds rushing and **dropped 12 spots** in the national rushing defense ratings. However, Power Plays took into account the potent Buffalo run attack and had forecasted the Huskies yielding 225 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Another example was Michigan vs Purdue in 1989. Michigan held Purdue to just 45 yards rushing and improved their ratings in rushing defense in the national statistics. However, our ratings had them rated at a 102 and moved them down to 99, as they should have yielded just 32 yards to an impotent Purdue rush attack. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run **you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have!** The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

Garbage yards: These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are **counted** into national ratings, **but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!**

Weather: If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the QBs.

Injuries: When South Carolina played NC State in 1989, South Carolina QB Todd Ellis was injured on the third play of the game. His backup, who had seen very little action all year, was not prepared and hit on just 4 of 13 passes for 65 yards. The offensive coordinator did not risk any passes. In the national statistics NC State's pass defense **MOVED UP 14 NOTCHES**. In Phil's Power Ratings they **stayed the same**, as the low yardage WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

Home Field Edges: The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

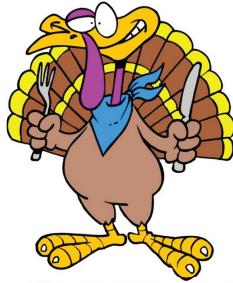

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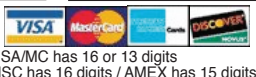
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
