DEN came into BAL and pummeled them 34-17 as a 3 pt AD winning our NFL GOY easily. BAL didn't earn its initial FD until there was 8:00 left in the 1H. BAL was outgained 300-146 when DEN went up 31-3 midway thru the 3Q. DEN holds a 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS record at home TY where their +158 ypg edge is the best in the NFL (+0 TO's) for a 33-16 avg score. BAL went 4-4 SU/3-4-1 ATS on the road TY being outgained by 37 ypg (+5 TO's) w/an avg scoring deficit of 21-18. The common NDIV foes here are HOU/NE with PAL coins 1.1 SU/0 ATS and DEN price 2.0 SU/470. with BAL going 1-1 SU/0-2 ATS and DEN going 0-2 SU/ATS but that was before Manning was fully settled in. It must be noted that Manning has avg'd 298 ypg (68%) w/a 22-3 ratio at home TY while Flacco has avg'd 203 ypg (57%) w/a 7-5 ratio on the road.

2012 was supposed to be the yr that Flacco, in a contract yr, broke out but the off had become quite predictable and Rice wasn't being utilized to his fullest (2 100 yd gms vs 6 LY). Flacco has a solid 15-5 ratio (8.3 ypa) at home but just 7-5 ratio (5.9 ypa) on the road. Rice does have a solid amount of rec's but that's coming off checkdowns. Boldin remains a solid #2 type w/Smith being a dangerous deep threat. BAL likes to use the 2 TE sets but they are much more conservative than NE's in scheme. The OL is above avg (#20 sks, 4.7 ypc) which is a disappointment w/the talent. 2002 was the last time BAL wasn't in the top 10 for D for ydg but they remain top 10 in ypp. Inj's have hit

every level here but they should have 9 of 11 opening day st'rs (CB Webb/LB McClain) here. The fact they have only given up a 14-13 ratio shows their quality of depth. BAL has our #1 ST's unit thanks to Jones work comb w/a great yr by Koch.

Despite missing a year it can be argued that '12 was Manning's best ever. Working w/a new roster/coaches/hybrid scheme, his +26 ratio was 2nd only to 2004 which he bested in att, comp, comp % and yards. With Manning at the helm, Decker and Thomas became the 1st tandem of 1,000 yd rec's s/'04. Stokely has been a reliable 3rd Dn option while Dreesen and Tamme have excelled working in similar styles at IND/HOU. Over the final 6 games which Moreno started DEN has the #11 rush off and as a team they outgained foes by 150 ypg (+2 TO's) which is an NFL best. Including the '07 Colts, this is the best/deepest D Manning has had. While labeled an OLB, Miller rushes on over 70% of his snaps and is one of the best all around LB's in the league. Many of DEN's 52 sks (#1) are the result of their top 5 secondary which has allowed 203 ypg (54%) w/an 11-8 ratio over the L8 games once they settled into Del Rio's system. They are the only defense to not give up a 300 yd passing game TY (PIT/NYJ 1) with only 3 games over 100 yds rushing. DEN also has our

#5 spec teams unit w/top 10 coverage units and Colquitt's net avg is the 3rd best TY.

Baltimore lives and dies by the rush attack led by Ray Rice and they finished the regular season ranked #9 in that category. That causes a matchup problem here as the Broncos have the #2 overall defense and #3 against the rush while also causing havoc on opposing OL's as they lead the NFL in sacks. Flacco has not felt that type of pressure and now on the road with a short week and in altitude, the Ravens offense will struggle. Power Plays calls for almost a 2 td win and we agree.

NE blasted HOU on MNFTY 42-14 as a 4'pt HF. HOU had rattled off 6 straight wins and Belichick used the Texans varsity jackets picures as motivation. NE had a 419-279 yd edge when HÓÚ conceded defeat mid-4Q by putting Yates on the field down 42-7. Brady only nad 296 yds (70%) w/1 td as the Patriots def held Foster to 46 yds rush (3.1) and rattled Schaub (232, 59%, 1 int). The Texans went 6-2 SU/4-4 ATS on the road TY w/a +45 ypg margin (+7 TO's) and 23-21 wg score. NE went 6-2 SU/4-4 ATS at home TY (+57 ypg, +5 TO's) Both teams played similar skeds w/the only diff being HOU caught he NFC North (1-2-1 ATS) while NE had the NFC West (1-3 ATS) NE is 1-8 ATS in the playoffs but HOU's inexperience and Belichick v/extra rest plays into the Patriots hands.

HOU continues to work off the ground game of Foster who has ver 1,200 yds in each of the L3Y. Schaub only has a 61-30 ratio over hat time but it has minimized Andre Johnson's wear and tear. Daniels s at the top of the 2nd tier of rec'g TE's as the Texans spread the ball around after that. Walter is a decent, but not standout, #3 option but he lack of impact from rookies Martin and Posey (16 rec's, 10.8) is lisappointing. HOU has a borderline top 10 OL provided RT Newton is nealthy. JJ Watt's historic season for HOU (80+ plays at/behind LOS) nakes the Texans defense what it is. He has 15 more sks than the starting OLB's (Barwin/Reed) which is unheard of in a 3-4. The rest of the DL is solid but more valuable in run support. HOU has a very formidable

CB tandem with Joseph/Jackson but it's a concern that they have given up a 16-4 ratio in the games. HOU has our #23 spec tms as they have been poor on both sides of KR's.

For the 4th time in his L5Y of full starts, Brady has finished with 24 more td's than int. NE's ability to effortlessly shift from the spread to 2 TE to a power running game (3 out of 4Y w/ top 12 rush offense) sets them apart from other offenses. Ridley is the 1st 1,200 yd rusher for NE since Corey Dillon in 2004 and he hasn't fully grown into the system yet. NE has the best 2 TE set in the NFL w/Gronkowski being a stronger receiving TE and Hernandez being more well rounded. Welker is the 1st player in NFL history w/5 100 rec seasons and Lloyd has been a strong, but not dominant, addition. The OL has been dinged a bit due to injuries to Mankins/Vollmer but it's still a physical system oriented unit. NE's #25 def ranking is wildly misleading as they are 4th in yds per pt and tied Belichick's record w/41 takeaways. Wilfork continues to be the fulcrum of the DL with rookie Chandler Jones making a strong impression. The strength of the defense is versatility with Mayo being a rare 3 Dn LB. NE's secondary is a concern but picking up Talib was a great move and McCourty has been stellar moving around. NE's #17 spec teams is due to a mediocre net avg by Mesko who doesn't get to boom it like other P's but NE has excellent coverage/return units.

Talk about an overadjustment as just a month ago, Houston came here and was a 4' pt dog. The numbers actually lean with the Texans as they have top 8 units on both sides of the ball while the Patriots lead the NFL in offense but are #25 on D. With the overadjustment we'll continue to look at this game and pass on any selection for now

The 49ers pulled an opening week upset beating GB 30-22 as a 5 pt AD. SF quickly shut down GB's attempt at a run game (45 yds, 3.2) and by forcing them to be one-dimensional they were able to bottle up the passing game. 107 of Rodgers 303 yds came midway thru the 4Q after GB was down 30-15. Six of GB's 1st 7 drives ended in punts. SF went 6-1-1 SU/4-4 ATS at home TY with a +105 ypg (#2) and +4 TO's mark for a 25-14 avg score. GB went 4-4 SU/ATS on the road for +15 ypg (+3 TO's) but a 25-24.5 avg score. Rodgers has logged 281 ypg (67%) w/a 22-3 ratio on the road TY however. Including playoffs, Green Bay is 18-7 ATS as a dog.

After a slow start Rodgers has dominated the passing game again finishing w/less than 10 int in 3 of the L4Y (11 in 2010). The only bad thing that can be said about the Packers off is that the run game is once again very limited. Part is due to Rodgers (8 100+ QBR's TY), part is due to design (often just an extra pass blk'r) and part is due to injury (Benson IR foot). Even though GB lacks a 1,000 yd receiver TY this is still a top 3 unit in depth/talent. GB's biggest weakness on offense is the OL which has had 4 diff OL combo's the final 7 gms. Despite being one of the most beat up def's GB's #11 rank is a sign of depth and the fact they've only played 1 team w/a top 10 off in the L10 gms (DET). Raji is the cornerstone of the DL, Matthews for LB's but GB is also quite deep in the secondary. The fact they allow 4.5 ypc is due to 2 strong gms by Peterson and ini's up front They are

ypc is due to 2 strong gms by Peterson and inj's up front. They are better than their #11 pass def rankings (#4 def QBR) as they allow just 55% comp w/a 6.7 ypa (7th). GB has our #16 spec tms unit thanks to Randall Cobb on returns.

Prior to Kaepernick SF avg'd 366 ypg/215 ypg pass/23.7 ppg. Since he took over it's 356 ypg/230 ypg pass/26.3 ppg but he is much more aggressive with the ball as SF uses more of the Pistol off. Gore has quietly logged his 2nd str year of 1,200 yds rush thanks to the best OL in the NFL TY giving up 1 sk every 16 pass att's w/Kaepernick vs 1 every 8.4 w/Smith. Crabtree has finally taken to being a #1 WR here and is the 1st WR w/1,000 yds rec s/ 03 while Davis has admitted he's not as comfortable w/a new QB at the helm. Losing Manningham (knee) creates an unknown as it's a ? to how much gas Moss has left. SF's OL is one of 3 to start every game together TY (MIN/NYJ). SF's D ret'd all 11 st'rs from LY's #4 unit and they didn't miss a start until Justin Smith tore a tricep. He is the key cog in the system setting up the majority of Aldon Smith's 19.5 sks to a stop unit that all'd 91 ypg (3.6) rush w/him in the lineup. The 49ers also have the best LB unit in the NFL w/Aldon, Willis and Bowman locked up longterm. They own the #5 pass D and their 6.1 ypa is 2nd best. SF has our #10 ST's TY despite Akers struggles.

When you think of these two legendary teams QB is the first position to come to mind. The Packers still have that tradition and now travel to face a young San Fran QB in his first playoff start. The 49ers "dominating defense" from LY is actually ranked #9 over their final 8 games while the Packers improved stop unit is actually ranked #13. With defenses close, we'll back a veteran QB who will clearly benefit from seeing the same team twice in a season against Kaepernick who hasn't had the luxury of facing this blitz-happy unit which is markedly better with the return of Woodson.

OVERALL -SEAHAWKS by 3 ✓'s ATL snared a 30-28 win at SEA in 2011 as a 5 pt AF in the last meeting. ATL had a 27-7 lead after the initial drive of the 2H but SEA rallied and missed a 61 yd FG as the game ended. Ryan had 291 yds (67%) w/a td while they held RB Lynch to just 24 yds (3.0). ATL hasn't won a playoff game since 2004 (0-4 ATS) and is 7-1 SU/4-4 ATS at home TY where they are -10 ypg (+7 TO's). They have a massive situational edge at home for the 2nd straight game off a bye vs a SEA team that just flew out to WAS. SEA is 5-4 SU/ATS on the road TY (+37 ypg +0 TO) and 7-2-1 ATS away vs NDIV foes. ATL is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS vs the common foes of CAR/WAS/DAL/ARZ/DET with +15 ypg mark (-3 TO's) and a 25-21 avg score. SEA went 3-2 SU/ATS holding a +54 ypg entry (+1 TO) and 21-16 avg score. Moving to a rookie 3rd RD QB over the touted FA pickup was a

Moving to a rookle 3rd HD QB over the totted FA pickup was a surprise move by SEA but it's paid off. From the NE gm on, Wilson has avg'd 209 ypg (65%) w/a stunning 21-4 ratio. Vs top 10 D's he's avg'd 180 ypg (60%) w/a 12-4 ratio thanks to a stellar power run gm behind Lynch who has ten 100 yd rushing gms TY. Despite this being the 1st 16 game ssn for WR Rice, not having a 1,000 yd receiver is more a function of Wilson spreading the ball around and the success of Lynch. SEA has started 6 diff OL combo's TY but LT Okung earned his Pro Bowl berth as he's the only LT to not allow a sk TY. SEA's Tampa-2 style D is built around lean, quick twitch defenders that have missed just 7 gms via st'rs w/4 coming via CB Browner's 4 gm susp as the Seahawks have the leagues best secondary. The LB unit is solid w/ Wagner and

Hill locking down the middle and they are very mobile. SEA's DL is designed to be aggressive and they accept giving up yds on the ground (4.5 ypc) to get to the QB (#14 sks by). SEA has our #9 ST's unit TY thanks to one of the best returners in Leon Washington.

ATL took a big risk replacing its OC/DC prior to the year but it paid off very well. The offense now goes thru Ryan instead of supporting him. Ryan put up career numbers across the board but faced just 3 teams that finished w/a top 10 def avg 301 ypg (68%) w/a 10-3 ratio (3-1 SU/2-2 ATS). Ryan has helped White and Jones become ATL's 1st 1,100 yd rec tandem since 1998 with Gonzalez being 70 yds short of ATL's 1st 1,000 yd trio since 1995. ATL's run game hasn't had much if any impact TY as RB Turner has slowed down (3.6). ATL's OL has been ultra-reliable w/ 4 of 5 OL playing 98.7% of the snaps TY as they had their 5th year of under 30 sks allowed. While ATL's #24 def is a bit misleading (#5 def pts/#2 def ypp) they have struggled for sacks (#27) and have been mauled vs the run (4.8 ypc 29th). On the flip side, ATL's 14-20 ratio is the best in the NFL TY w/a very formidable secondary when healthy. Overall, DC Volan has this def playing better than the sum of its parts on all levels. Despite a strong year by Bosher (40.7 net, 37% punts inside 20), ATL has our #16 spec tms unit due to avg return units.

Power Plays cashed with the Seahawks as a 4★ Best Bet. The forecast was for SEA to win by 11 but unfortunately they were way off as SEA only won by 10. Check out this week's forecast and not only will you see another projected outright upset, but this time PP has the Seahawks by 14. When you have a defensive dog projected to outgain its foe while having played a tougher schedule and having a better ST's unit, we'll stop short of B2B 4★'s but will side with them as a Key Selection here.
