Who played the toughest schedule?

Once the schedules are finalized in spring we like knowing "how tough" our favorite teams schedule is. Most fans and media outlets use the records of their opponents previous years to rank them, but we like to use our power ratings on each team to get a better gauge. As you can see USC, Mississippi, California, Colorado and

Stanford played OUR 5 toughest schedules!

If you base it on the win % of a teams opponents the 5 teams that played the toughest schedule were: Mississippi, Arizona, LSU, Tennessee and Florida St.

The LARGEST difference between our Strength of Schedule compared to the opponent win % is Kent St. The Golden Flashes faced the #17 toughest schedule ranked by opp win % while facing only the #86 schedule in our rankings. Let's look below at Kent St's Schedule this year:
