

There are 3 main methods of handicapping, Fundamental, Situation & Technical. Fundamental handicapping or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situation handicapping (analysis of letdown, look ahead, systems, etc...) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. Each week in Power Sweep we provide a system to add to your handicapping arsenal. This is done at the request of our subscribers who want handicapping tips & methods. Many times we will agree with the side that the system chooses. Sometimes the Fundamental & Technical aspects of a game will outweigh the system & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. **We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on.** If that is ever the case during a week, keep the system for future use, but be aware that the side we write-up in the Power Sweep Selections page is the side we are on.

• Week EIGHT 2012 PAST HISTORY MATCHUPS • Recaps of 2011 meetings (close games of 7 or less)

CONNECTICUT (-1) 28 Syracuse 21 - We used CT as a Top Wkly LPS. CT ret'd the opening KO 61 yds to the SU33 and 3P later they had a 10 yd TD pass, 7-0 (13:38). SU24 on 2&6 fmb'd. It was the first time in 209 plays SU turned it over. CT, however, would turn the ball over 5x in the 1H and starting at the SU27 on 2&13 they were int'd at the 11. CT13 got a 63 yd run by McCummings to the 24 but on 2&5 he fmb'd (7:04) the snap and SU rec'd at the 20. SU got a FD but was int'd at the 47 and ret'd 12 yds (5:33). CT40 got 2 FD's to the SU28 but fmb'd at the 27. SU was at the CT40 and got 1 FD and a 29 yd TD pass, 7-7 (1:48). CT got a 32 yd KR to the SU48 as their return game was dominant in this one. On 3&10, however, McEntee was sk'd and fmb'd back at the 49. SU went 3 & out punting 20 yds and they punted 20 yds OOB to avoid the PR (1:02). CT30 got 1 FD and was int'd at the SU38 and a 15 yd PF advanced SU to the CT36. They got 1 FD but missed a 34 yd FG with :03 left in the half. At the half SU had a 156-149 yd edge. SU opened the 3Q with a 75/10pl drive for a TD and CT went 60/9pl for a TD 14-14 (5:52). After each went on TD drives to tie it at 21, SU10 went 48/11pl but was int'd (9:05). CT38 went 62/8pl and got a 6 yd TD run 28-21 (4:51). SU20 got 1 FD, converted on 4&5 for a FD but their 4&6 pass was batted down at the line from their own 45 and CT took a knee 3x.

Northwestern (+17) 28 NEBRASKA 25 - We used a Big Dog POW on NW. After a Neb punt, NW went 49/9pl but Colter fmb'd at the Neb41 (8:11). NW went 80/4pl for a TD, 7-0 (2:09). Neb went 74/13pl but on 1&gl from the 5, fmb'd. NW went 3 & out but Neb fmb'd at the NW19 at the end of a long pass from the 43. 2 punts. NW20 got 1 FD and was int'd at their own 37. Neb got a 36 yd FG 5pl later to pull within 7-3 (2:26). At the half Neb had a 181-160 yd edge. NW41 went 59/6pl for a 3 yd TD run (12:13) 14-3. Neb39 got 1 FD but on 4&2 was SOD at the NW37 (9:59). NW went 48/8pl but on FD from the NW15 Colter was int'd in the EZ and ret'd 50 yds. The Huskers got back in going 50/8pl for a TD, 14-10 (3:52). NW24 got 3 FD's on a 48/10pl drive but missed a 45 yd FG (14:25). NW16 on 2&7 got an 81 yd TD pass to Ebert, 21-10 (12:16). Neb26 went 74/12pl and got a 1 yd TD run, 21-18 (8:55). NU34 answered with a 66/13pl drive and Colter's 1 yd TD run with 1:34 left put it away. Neb26 went 74/10pl and got a TD with :18 left but NW rec'd the outside kick.

BALL ST (-2) 31 Central Michigan 27 - CM finished with 569-455 yard edge but blew a 20-3 3Q lead. CM went 61/12pl settling for a 45 yard FG (8:08). CM went 93/8pl and on 3&10 got a 19 yd TD pass, 10-0 (2:38). BS went 51/9pl. They faked a punt for a FD to the 24 but after a FD to the 19 were int'd at the 9. CM went 91/7pl and got a 60 yd TD pass on 3&8 and looked firmly in control, 17-0 (10:25 2Q). 6 punts. BS18 got a 46 yd pass with :38 left and would get 2 more FD's to get a 25 yd FG to take momentum into the locker room. CM33 went 46/8pl for a 38 yd FG, 20-3 (11:09). BS went 88/12pl for a TD, 20-10 (6:35 3Q). CM41 fumbled and BS went 38/4pl for a TD to get within 20-17 (5:08). BS went 77/5pl for a TD (1:12 3Q) and the lead, 24-20. CM went 85/8pl and on 3&9 got a 10 yd TD pass, 27-23 (11:45). BS40 went 60/6pl for a TD, 31-27 (9:33). CM21 went 56/9pl and they had a FD at the BS27 but fmb'd on the play. BS23 got 3 FD's and punted (:56). CM20 got 3 FD's to the BS35 but was int'd on a Hail Mary.

Utah St 24 NEW MEXICO ST (+15) 21 - NMS got Christians back at QB. The first 3 pass were punts. US20 got a 48 yd Morrison run going 70/7pl but on 4&1 was SOD at the 8. US went 53/10pl but was SOD on 4&1 at the 3 (1:40). After a punt US(NMS44) was int'd at the 11. NMS got 2 FD's and punted. US went 68/9pl for a TD, 7-0 (8:52). NMS40 went 60/7pl for a TD, 7-7 (6:43). US went 68/4pl for a TD, 14-7 (1:33). NMS30 went 69/10pl but on the key play of the game, on 3&1 was int'd at the 1 with :09 left in the half. At half US had a 272-200 yd edge. US fmb'd to open the 3Q and NM got a 51/1pl TD pas, 14-14 (13:32). 6 punts. US19 (1:23 3Q)

went 75/15pl for a 23 yd FG, 17-14 (11:11). NMS went 66/4pl for a TD, 21-17 (8:29). 2 punts. US17 (5:04) went 83/13pl converting on 4&2 at the 12 and got a TD with :35 left, 35-21. NMS fell on a squib kick back and on the first play threw a deep pass that was int'd at the 30 (:28).

STANFORD 31 California (+17) 28 - The big game was played in a rare late start under the lights in a rain soaked stadium. Cal got a 42 yd pass on the first play to the SU29 but was sk'd and fmb'd (14:22). SU went 63/3pl and got a 34 yd TD run by Montgomery (13:42). Cal25 went 67/13pl but settled for a 25 yd FG(5:53). SU35 on 3&10 had Luck int'd and ret'd 45 yd to the 4. An illegal blk brought it back to the 19 but Cal went 19/3pl for a TD, 10-7 (5:53). Cal went 81/13pl but settled for another 19 yd FG and their 3 long drives only had them ahead 13-7 (10:40). SU22 went 78/10pl for a 6 yd TD run by Gaffney, 14-13 (7:10). SU18 went 67/8pl and missed a 33 yd FG (:50). At half SU had a 223-210 yd edge. SU opened the 3Q with a 68/9pl drive for a 4 yd TD pass (10:12). SU22 went 78/6pl and got a 10 yd TD pass to Hewitt, 28-13 (5:42). Cal20 got 2 FD's and on 4&3 was sk'd back to the 50. Cal17 got a FD but fumbled' at their own 39 (:00). SU was SOD on 4&2 (13:25) Cal went 68/6pl and got a TD and 2 pt conv, 28-21 (10:53). SU26 went 57/14pl and got a 35 yd FG with 3:07 left, 31-21 (3:07). Cal26 went 74/10pl and got a 1 yd TD run by Anderson, 31-28 (:15). SU rec'd the outside kick.

PURDUE (+7) 26 Ohio St 23 OT - We used OSU as a 4* Key in PS and 3* LPS. PU dominated the 1H. OSU went 3 and out on their first 3 drives and PUR went 57/10pl for a 19 yd FG (10:30), 60/11pl for a 4 yd TD run (4:09) punted 2x then OSU went 68/8pl for a TD, 10-7 (11:42). 2 punts. PU (8:42) went 88/13pl and got a 7 yd TD run with 3:19 left. It was the 2nd longest drive vs OSU this year, 17-7 (3:19). 2 punts. OSU (P49) got 1 FD and missed a 50 yd FG on the final play of the half that had the distance. At half PU had a commanding 242-97 yd edge. OSU opened the 3Q with a 58/8pl drive and a 7 yd TD run by Miller, 4 punts. PU, after a 35 yd punt, started at the OSU45 and got 1 FD and nailed a 44 yd FG, 20-14 (13:06). 2 punts. OSU (6:15) went 66/10pl for the apparent game winning TD but the xp was blk'd (:55). PU39 got 1 FD to the OSU46 but was int'd at the 12. OSU got a 33 yd FG on 4&2 and PU got 1 FD and converted on 3 & 12 for a FD to the 1 and got a TD on the next play for the win.

FLORIDA ST 23 Miami, FI (+10) 19 - Each team opened with a punt. UM1 went 84/14pl but on 3 & 14 from the 15, was int'd in the EZ and ret'd 10 yds. UM fmb'd the punt at their own 28 and FSU got a 38 yd FG :45. 2 punts. UM after a 16 yd PR went 47/9pl for a TD, 7-3 (7:53). FSU went 66/6pl and got a 21 yd TD pass, 10-7 (4:42). FSU got an 83 yd PR by Reed with :51 left in the half for a 17-7 lead (:51). UM19 on 3 & 12 fmb'd at their own 19 and FSU missed a 37 yd FG. UM had a 203-79 yd edge at the half but trailed 17-7. FSU opened the 3Q with an 83/11pl drive for a 21 yd FG, 20-7 (9:15). 3 punts. FSU28 went 47/12pl for a 38 yd FG, 23-7 (11:07). UM went 80/10pl and got a 1 yd TD run, 23-13 (6:27) and missed the 2pt conv, 23-13. FSU got 1 FD and punted with 3:07 left and UM went 80/12pl and got a 1 yd TD run by fmb'd the snap on the xp, 23-19 (1:27). FSU rec'd the outside kick at the UM44 and took a knee.

SOUTH CAROLINA (-3) 17 Florida 12 - UF33 on 2&3 Brantley was hit as he threw and fmb'd and SC rec'd at the UF35. On 4&11 in no man's land they fired incomplete. UF36 went 3 and out and only got off a 27 yd punt. SC on 3 & 7 was int'd at their own 48. UF went 45/8pl and had a 1st & gl at the 2 but settled for a 21 yd FG, 3-0 (6:01). SC10 went 68/13pl but missed a 40 yd FG. SC went 62/11pl and got a 10 yd TD run, 7-3 (7:07). UF22 got 1 FD and fmb'd. SC went 46/11pl for a TD incl a 4&1 at the UF27. The TD made it 14-3 with :31 left and at the half SC had a 198-84 yd edge. UF opened the 3Q with a 58/8pl drive for a 24 yd FG, 14-6 (7:17). UF went

45/12pl but punted. UF went 49/3pl with a 47 yd run by Rainey to the 2 setting up Brissett's 2 yd TD run (11:23). The 2 pt was ng. SC42 got a 46 yd pass to Sanders and a 28 yd FG got them ahead by more than a FG, 17-12 (9:14) 48/5. UF33 got 2 FD's and on 4&21 punted 55 yds for a TB (5:34). SC would get 3 FD's and finally punted with :42 left and UF11 got to their 42.

MARSHALL (+7) 26 Southern Miss 20 - SM was plagued by 6 TO's vs MAR and blew a 17-3 lead. 2 punts. MU went 64/12pl for a 32 yd FG. SM went 72/13pl for a TD, 7-3. SM went 41/4pl for a 36 yd FG, 10-3. MU45 had a TD called back on a hold. They got a FD to the SM33 but were int'd at the 27 and ret'd 22 yds. SM fmb'd it back 3pl later at the MU43. After a MU punt, SM got a 90 yd TD pass to lanos to open it up 17-3. 2 punts. MU after a 27 yd punt with 1:53 left in the half went 42/7pl for a TD with just :27 left to get within 17-10. SM's Hail Mary on the final play of the half from the MU46 was int'd in the EZ. At half MS had a 247-182 yd edge. SM fmb'd on the 2nd play of the 3Q and MU went 35/3pl for a TD. SM had a punt blk'd but MU missed a 41 yd FG. 3 punts. MU went 50/6pl for a TD and the lead, 24-17. MU was int'd at the SM22 and ret'd 26 yds but SM was int'd at the MU27 on the next play and ret'd 29. MU punted 41 yd to the 1 and SM ran to Hardy for a 1 yd loss and a safety, 26-17 (9:16). SM went 57/8pl but fmb'd at the MU27 and it was ret'd 19 yds. SM went 50/7pl but settled for a 28 yd FG on 4&10. SM rec'd the outside kick but was int'd at the 43 for their 6th TO.

IOWA ST (+27) 37 Oklahoma St 31 - This was the Friday night ESPN play and ISU came in 0-56-2 vs teams ranked 6th or higher and Paul Rhodes was the DC at Pitt when they upset #2 W Virg and kept them from the Nat'l Title game. OSU would play in the Title game if they won out and Brandon Weedon became the Heisman favorite during the week. ISU played a good game as they went 65/12pl and missed a 34 yd FG. OSU fmb'd at the 50 and was int'd at the ISU20 and ISU went 52/11pl but on FD at the OSU28 was int'd and ret'd 70 yds for a TD and despite controlling matters, with an 8-3 FD edge, ISU trailed 7-0. OSU went 80/10pl for a 29 yd FG, 10-0 (10:43). ISU went 72/7pl for a 16 yd TD pass, 10-7 (7:22). OSU went 75/8pl for a 27 yd TD pass, 17-7 (5:18). OSU23 went 42/9pl and on 4&2 fired incomplete. ISU went 56/9pl getting to the OSU9. There was a PF but it was ruled after the play and tacked on at the start of the next play. ISU ret'd the KO 50 yds and went 50/6pl for a TD, 24-14 (10:05). ISU rec'd a surprise outside kick at their 41. They got a 31 yd pass to the 28 and then Barnett ripped off a 19 yd run by fmb'd at the 4. OSU fmb'd it back 3pl later at the 26.
