NEWS AND NOTES

TOUGH LAST SECOND LOSSES: Neb could have won a lot easier than the final as they had 543-301 yd and 26-14 FD edges. Big plays helped Northwestern lead 21-10 in the 3Q. Neb settled for a 27 yd FG after a 65/8pl drive. NW fmbld the punt but a PF on Neb overturned it. Neb fmbld 2 punts in the 1H, the first at their own 14 setting up a NW td and the 2nd at their own 38. Neb fmbld at the NW22 and only got off a 16 yd punt with 4:03 left 1H and NW converted on 4&1 to cont on a 52/8pl getting a 26 yd td pass to lead 14-10 at the half. NW got an 80 yd td run by Mark on 2&10, 21-10. Neb went 47/9pl and on 4&3 was SOD at the NW38. Neb got a td w/1:09 left in the 3Q but NW got a td w/8:31 left to lead by 12. Neb went 80/10pl and 76/6pl for tds with 2:02 left for the lead. NW missed a 53 yd FG with 1:10 left...Florida Atlantic led South Alabama for most of the game and had a 461-359 yd edge but missed FG's did them in. FAU went 64/8pl and 80/8pl on their first 2 poss to lead 14-7. They got a 23 yd FG on the final play of the 1H

to lead 17-14 but had a commanding 258-135 yd edge. FAU opened the 3Q with a 53/6pl drive but had a 39 yd FG blk'd. They led 31-17 at the start of the 4Q and SA got a td with 5:45 left to pull within 7. SA went 85/9pl with a 4&7 PI keeping their next drive alive and got a td with 1:09 left. FAU drove for the game winning 32 yd FG but it was blk'd as time expired. Each team got a FG in the first OT but FAU had a 44 yd FG blk'd in the 2OT and SA got a 35 yd FG for the win...WKU had 449-385 yd and 26-19 FD edges and appeared in control as they led 28-7 in the 2Q. Jakes hit 25-32-308 for WKU and ULM's Browning 22-41-308. Leading 28-14 WKU was SOD on 4&1 at the ULM36 with 1:07 left 1H. ULM went 64/8pl and got a 30 yd Hail Mary on the final play, 28-21. ULM faked a 20 yd FG and was SOD at the WKU3 in the 3Q but WKU fmbld at the ULM10 at the end of an 87/10pl drive. Early 4Q WKU's P went to a knee to pick up the ball and was ruled down and that set up ULM for the game tying 46/7pl drive for a td. 2 punts. WKU went

64/10pl and got a 2 yd td run with 2:29 left but ULM went 90/7pl and got a 12 yd td pass with :31 left to force OT. Each team scored a td and ULM went for 2 and got it... Maryland had 22-17 FD and 462-347 yd edges despite losing QB Perry Hills. Devin Burns and Caleb Rowe combined to hit 5-6-97 in his place as Hills was inj on an int at the NCS16 with :43 left 1H. MD trailed 10-3 at half despite a 200-156 yd edge. MD went 44/8pl for a td but had to chase a missed xp then failed on a 2 pt conv and trailed by 2. They got a FG with 13:39 left to lead 18-17 and forced 2 NCS1 to punts with 9:39 left but MD had a FD at the 50 but fmbld on the first play when they were trying to run the clock out. NCS1 fired incomplete at the MD44 with 3:34 left. MD came up a yard short on 3&4 and punted and NCS1 got a 43 yd FG with :32 left for the lead. With Rowe at QB, MD got 3 FD and then ran the ball in dead middle of the field to set up an easy 33 yd FG. Craddock's kick at the distance but banged off the upright and MD came up short.

After a fake P kept a drive alive MSU (+10) hit a 19 yd FG with 5:48 left but couldn't stop Michigan from driving 41/8pl for the GW 38 yd FG with :05 left to win 12-10. **We have been saying for wks now that the Badgers are a 'play on' tm down the stretch and have cashed 2 str 4★ Key Selections. Will we take it a step further as use them as our 5★ GOM?**

FORECAST: WISCONSIN 27 Michigan St 6

3★ † Florida over Georgia - Jacksonville, The World's Largest Outdoor Cocktail Party. LY Muschamp became the 1st person in series history to have played at one school and chd'd for the other. UF had won 5 of the L/6 meetings SU until LY as UGA had a commanding 23-11 FD and 354-226 yd edges but missed 2 FG's and gave up a 99 yd KR td in the 24-20 (-2) win. UGA is 4-18 SU and 7-14-1 ATS in this series and the SU winner is 26-3-1 ATS. LW the Gators became the 1st tm in this century to score 40+ pts w/less than 200 tti yds while QB Driskel also became the 1st QB in this century to throw for 4 td's w/less than 100 yds in their 44-11 (-3) win over SC, an easy 3★ Key Selection and 4★ LPS Winner. UF took advantage of 4 SC TO's but the gm could have been even worse if not for some ? calls in the 1H incl one that took a Gator td pass off the board. Things were not so easy for the Bulldogs who were sluggish off the bye LW in a 29-24 win (-26) at UK. QB Murray threw 4 td's and became UGA's career leader but he did so having to come from behind 3 diff times. UF has the huge edge on ST's again (#5-67) and with a win can wrap up the SEC East. UF has now covered 7 str TY while UGA has failed to cover its L/3. Series, talent and technical edges all favor the Gators who book an early trip to Atlanta with a DD win here.

3★ OKLAHOMA over Notre Dame - OU is 1-8 SU vs ND with its only series win in South Bend in 1956. The L/meeting was in '99 and ND's last trip here was in '66. OU comes in off KU and only has ISU on deck. Since the loss to KSU, OU has featured the run gm avg 5.9 ypc, the highest in Stoops' tenure and most s/'87. LW's 52-7 romp over KSt (-35) featured KR/PR td's (1st time in schl hist) and QB Jones who has put together his best stretch since WR Broyles departure avg 290 ypg (62%) with a 7-1 ratio in the L/3 gms. With Sanders elig the L2W, he now has a bevry of WR's to throw to and will be going vs a ND secondary that has not faced a legit pass attack TY. ND is off yet another close win (4 by 7 pts or less TY) 17-14 (-13) over BYU LW as they overcame a HT deficit for the 2nd wk in a row. QB Rees got the start and struggled (Golson out) but Kelly has announced that Golson will start here. After making his name as a spread off guru, Kelly has changed his tune here relying on his #5 D and the run gm which is avg 194 ypg (highest at ND s/'00). Stoops said in his postgame presser that this is the most anticipated gm in Norman s/'00 (#3 OU, +2' 31-14 over #1 Neb). While the Irish D gets much of the pub, the OU 1st string D had all'd just 1 off td in the L/4 gms and the Sooners have the off (#4-30) and ST's (#17-35) edges! **This is clearly the GOW as far as hype goes but could we also go to it as our 5★ College GOM?**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Texas Tech over KANSAS ST - TT had won 5 in a row SU/ATS by an avg of 30 ppg and +251 ypg incl 2 outright upsets. LY we used KSU as the NC Sportsline Comp Underdog POW and the Cats got a 24 yd IR td in the 1H and a 100 yd KR td as well as 2 blk'd FG's and jumped out to a 14-13 lead. TT led at the half 28-20 with a 387-94 yd edge but KSU controlled the 2H (led 41-31) and won outright 41-34 (+3). KSU is 17-5 SU and 14-8 ATS on HC while TT is off OU, WV, at TCU (1-3 ATS in 2nd B2B road gm). The Raiders nearly blew a 10 pt 4Q lead but regrouped to beat TCU 56-53 in 3OT. TT was outgained 516-389 but benefitted from 3 TCU TO's and also limited the Frogs to a B12 rec'd 6 FG's. With B2B big gms vs ranked tms Doege (#5 FBS pass eff w/316, 71%, 28-7) is now popping up on Heisman lists. The much imp'd D is #20 vs the run (111, 3.3) after finishing LY dead last (259, 5.3). KSU actually moved back a spot in the chh's poll to #4 after LW's 55-14 thrashing at WV. The Cats led 52-7 going into the 4Q with WV's only score being a KR td and they finished with a 479-243 yd edge. QB Klein (#2 FBS pass eff, 200 ypg, 71%, 10-2, 551 rush, 14 td) moved to the front of the Heisman pack. KSU is all'g 227 pass ypg (62%) with a 7-8 ratio and is #2 B12 in TO's forced (16). Kansas ST has proven to be profitable as an underdog but now the role is reversed with expectations at the highest in more than a decade and no one in Manhattan had this gm circled after the big road test LW.

2★ USF over Syracuse - This is one of our favorite series of all-time. In '07 we used USF (16' pt AF) as our Coll GOY and they delivered a 41-10 win. In '09 we used a 5★ on USF (-6') in the Carrier Dome and they won 34-20 in a gm they led 34-13. LY we used our Marquee GOY on USF in the dome again (-3) and they delivered a 37-17 win. USF has to be stinging after a narrow defeat at L'ville foll their bye wk for their 5th str loss (outgained and outFD'd UL). Syr on the other hand destroyed Conn on Fri night 40-10 putting up 502 tti yds and holding UC to -6 yds rush. This is Syr's 1st of 2 str AG's while the Bulls host B2B gms and have clearly owned this series with a 6-1 SU/ATS mark. With the Orange not covering as a true road tm in each of the L2Y (0-7 ATS), we'll back a hungry group of Bulls here desperate for a feel-good win.

FORECAST: USF 31 Syracuse 17

2★ N CAROLINA over NC State - LY NCSt knocked NC QB Renner out of the gm at the end of the 3Q and it was NCSt's 3rd shutout in 5 decades vs its rival (LY 290-165 yds, 13-0). It was also the 1st time NCSt had won 5 str SU/ATS over NC since 1988-'92 and during the wk HC O'Brien and Withers traded verbal jabs about graduation rates and investigations. The dog is 15-5 ATS with ELEVEN outright upsets in the L14! LW NCSt was fortunate to come out with a 20-18 win at MD as we cashed our Underdog POW on these pages on the Terps. NCSt won despite being outgained 462-347 and benefitted from +2 TO's. MD's st'g QB being inj'd and a missed 33 yd FG on the final play. NC was not so fortunate as they gave up a 4d td pass w/:13 left in the 33-30 (-10) loss to Duke. Fedora has been impressive at home in his career w/2 undefeated sns in his L3Y at SM and is already 4-0 SU/ATS TY. He has put an emphasis on ending the losing streak in the series and NC has all the talent edges and will be angry off a loss while NCSt continues to live a lie.

The Tigers come in with only 5 days rest off their 38-17 win (-7) over VT and travelling while Wake is also off 5 days rest after LW's 16-10 win (+3) over UVA. WF is 6-3 ATS in this series and 15-6 ATS as a HD. The home tm is 8-2 SU (-2 ATS) in the series. Nevada at AIR FORCE - 1st meeting. AF does have Army on deck but is 5-0 ATS in that role while UN has a bye on deck. The Pack are travelling on a short wk after LW's 39-38 (-6') OT loss at home to SDSU (led 31-21 4Q) while AF beat upstart NM 28-23 (-11) as we cashed our 4★ Oct CTOT GOM on the Under. Nev is a Pistol option tm and now takes on a tm that practices vs the option every day and has an option tm on deck. However, AF is just 4-13 ATS at home. The dog is a perfect 3-0 ATS in this series with 2 outright upsets and the LTH Navy set a single gm scoring rec'd with a 76-35 win (+3). Both tms come in confident as the Pirates beat UAB 42-35 (-2) on the road LW. QB Carden has been the diff as of late and LW threw for 386 yds and more importantly no int's. After a poor 1-3 start, the Mids have won 3 str and are now thinking bowl after LW's come-from-behind 31-30 (-2) win over Indy (1st win over B10 tm s/'79). Frosh QB Reynolds has won each of his 2 sts and gives them a pass threat as he has a 4-0 ratio. EC has all'd an avg 403 rush ypg (6.6) vs Navy ('06, '10 and LY). EC is in a CUSA sandwich but a win here gives them bowl eligibility. Expect a lot of pts in a gm that should come down to the wire again.

VANDERBILT 37 UMass 6 - 1st meeting. The Dores are a 5-1 ATS as a HF under Franklin (9-2 ATS overall at home but 0-2 L/2W). Vandy is off a 17-13 win (-6) over Aub as RB Stacy had 169 (6.3) and became the schl's all-time leading rusher. Vandy did have a 382-212 yd edge but was -3 in TO's. UM is 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS after losing 24-0 (+19) to BG LW as we easily cashed a 3★ CTOT on the Under. The off continues its struggles as LW it mustered just 118 yds. This is the largest line for Vandy to be fav'd vs an FBS foe s/'06 (Temple -34) and will be only the 5th time s/'98 that VU has been a fav of 20+ (-3-1 ATS). With VU needing wins to become bowl eligible for the 2nd str ssn, expect more focus than what you would normally get out of a BCS tm in this situation.

MIAMI, OH 31 Ohio 30 - OU has won 6 in a row SU (5-1 ATS) in the series which has been played every yr s/'45. LY OU had already clinched the MAC East and won 21-14 as 9 pt HF's. LTH OU led 27-7 into the 4Q as they forced 6 TO's (turned into 21 pts) and won 34-13 (-3). 7-0 SU darlings the Bobcats are in the AP Top 25 for the 1st time s/'68, the last yr they won the MAC Title. OU career pass td rec'd holder Tetteletto (224 ypg, 60%, 12-1) and the FBS's #3 rusher Blankenship (951, 4.8) lead the offense. While the Ohio D has given up 489 ypg the L/3 it does lead the MAC in TO's forced (18). This is the only HG for MU in a 6W span. MU had a -6 TO margin in B2B losses to Cincy and BG with rec'd setting QB Dysert (273, 63%, 14-8) throwing pick-sixes in both. MU is getting gashed on the ground all'g 244 (5.6, #116 FBS). Both are 2-0 SU vs conf weaklings Akron and UMass with OU 0-2 ATS (-11.5 ypg) and MU 1-1 ATS (-6.5 ypg). The Cats have 3 str wins by a td or less vs much weaker competition than what they'll face here and we think their dream season could come to an abrupt end.

Ball St 37 ARMY 34 - LY Army has struggled on the road vs MAC tms and Ball St was more dominant than its 48-21 home win (+4) would indicate. Lembo said in his 11 yrs as HC, the team had never played as good a half as they did with a 333-101 yd edge and led 31-0. The two tms look to be heading in opposite directions as the Knights' 48-38 loss at EM (-2) not only dropped them to 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS TY but they are also now 0-7 SU/1-6 ATS vs MAC tms the L2Y. BSU meanwhile is 5-3 SU/6-2 ATS after LW's 41-30 (-3) win over CM. They have had 3 common opp and while Army is 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS getting outscored 40-32 and outgained 486-473, BSU is 1-2 SU/ATS outgaining those same foes 572-447 and have been outscored by just 35-34. The situation does favor Army as they are not only playing with revenge but they catch BSU in the middle of a 3 gm road trip off of 4 MAC gms with a marquee Tues night gm at Tol on deck. However, Lembo came to BSU from Elon who played in a conf that featured several schls who ran the option so this isn't new for him to defend and they have the talent edges across the board.

C MICHIGAN 39 Akron 33 - CM has now won 5 in a row SU in the series but the HT is actually 2-5 SU (but 3-1 ATS). LTH ('09) UA lost 48-21 being outgained by 327 yds. LY the Chippewas led 20-0 late 3Q but the Zips down 7 went on a 56/9pl td drive (9 yd pass w/no time). Instead of OT UA elected to go for the win but its pass fell inc (CM -7, 23-22). CM is off a 41-30 (+3) loss to BSU but the yds were nearly even. QB Radcliff did have one of his best performances of the ssn with 339 yds and a 3-1 ratio. UA is improved TY but the rec'd doesn't show it as they are now 1-7 SU/4-4 ATS after LW's 37-7 (+17) loss to NI. The off was held to just 199 yds (1st time TY under 300!) and the D continues to be a problem as they are all'g 476 ypg. Both tms are even talent-wise so it's tough for us to back either here as CM is on a 2-19 ATS run and we wonder how much Akron has left in the tank after playing 3 of the MAC's best tms in the L3W.

BOWLING GREEN 31 E Michigan 17 - In the L/meeting ('08) BG (-20') lost 24-21, which snapped a 9 gm series winning streak. EM got a 16 yd GW td pass w/:36 left. BG is 5-12 SU hosting the MAC but EM is 6-19 SU in MAC AG's. With Ohio/Kent St receiving most of the publicity, BG has quietly won 4 str gms SU/ATS after LW's 24-0 (-19) win at UMass as we easily cashed 3★ CTOT on the Under. A case could be made that BG is the best tm in the East as their only losses are to #2 UF, UT and VT while it's clear their D is the MAC's best (#39). That D will be tested vs a rejuvenated EM off that has av'd 600 ypg and 47.5 ppg the L2W. The Eagles 48-38 (+2) win over Army LW was their first of the yr and RB Hill has come out of nowhere to avg 234 (8.7) the L2W. BG does have a bye on deck with this its 2nd most important gm in Oct and keep in mind the poor EM D has to switch gears from defending the option LW to BG's pro-style TW. We will continue to play on the red-hot Falcons.

N Illinois 30 W MICHIGAN 27 - LY WM (-1') appeared in control of the gm as they were up 15-10 late 1H. NI then scored 41 str pts rolling to a 51-15 lead with 9:13 left. NI has now won 3 in a row vs WM by an avg of 24 ppg. These tms look to be heading in opposite directions as NI has won 7 in a row (5-2 ATS) after beating Akron 37-7 (-17) LW. QB Lynch continues to lead the FBS QB's with 1,049 rush yds (7.0) and is #27 pass eff (13-3 ratio). WM dropped to 3-5 SU/ATS after LW's misleading 41-24 loss (+3) at Kent St. WM actually led 24-17 into the 4Q and had a 476-384 yd edge but like many times the L3Y, TO's were the issue and WM had 6 of them! LY Cubit had enough of being dominated by CM and put a huge focus on the gm and (-7) won 44-14! Expect a similar effort for this one but NI has been the far more impressive tm to date.

PITT 30 Temple 16 - Pitt has won 6 in a row SU (2-6 ATS) by 15 ppg (last met '04). TU's shocking 2-0 start in BE play TY looked like it was going to move to 3-0 LW as they led Rutgers 10-0 at HT but the Knights would go on to score 35 unanswered pts in the 2H as TU (+3) was outgained 371-191 for the gm. Pitt is off an uninspiring 20-6 (-9) win at Buff where they were outgained 334-254 and outFD'd 22-13. QB Sunseri who shockingly came in at #9 in the NCAA in pass eff was his normal inconsistent self as he completed just 9-17-128-0-0. Pitt has the clear edges on off (#52-105) and D (#52-80) but does have ND on deck (1-3 ATS prior) and TU is 6-2 as an AD. Pitt is 17-7 ATS vs BE and both tms desperately need a win here if they have any chance of making a bowl TY and we'll side with the HT.

ILLINOIS 34 Indiana 27 - The HT is 10-4 SU but just 3-7 ATS in this series, however the fav is 13-6 ATS and IL is 4-1 SU/ATS. LY Indy ret'd the opening KO 99 yds for a td but IL (-14) had a 280-119 yd edge at the half and tacked on a td with 1:20 left for the cover, 41-20 on the road. IL has lost 9 str B10 gms (2-7 ATS) since that win over the Hoosiers LY and has lost its L4 gms overall TY being outscored 163-45. The OL woes (23 sks all'd) have led to the B10's worst ground gm. Banged up QB Scheelhaase (133 ypg, 61%, 3-5, 129 rush) left the Mich gm in the 2Q with a concussion but is exp to ret here. The veteran D has also battled inj's and is all'g 219 pass ypg (62%) with a 13-5 ratio. Indy is on the 2nd of B2B road gms after LW's 31-30 loss to Navy (+3). The Hoosiers led 30-21 mid-4Q but couldn't seal the deal as they all'd Navy to drive 74/17pl for a FG and 72/9pl for a td before being int'd on their final drive. QB Coffman (220, 64%, 7-3) went the distance. Hoosiers are #109 FBS all'g 226 rush ypg (4.9). Indy is 13-27 ATS in B10 AG's. We expect a healthier Illinois tm to put forth their best performance of the ssn here.

MINNESOTA 24 Purdue 23 - PU is now 10-3 SU/ATS in this series. Two of those losses did come in '08-'09 and the fav is now 12-1 ATS as Minny was fav'd in both. LY PU (-14) at home, off a big loss to ND, rolled to a 45-17 win. The Boilers lost a 29-22 OT heart breaker at OSU who scored with :03 left as bkp QB Guitton drove the Bucks 70/7pl for a td and 2 pt conv. The Boilers had a 4-1 TO adv, scored on the gm's 1st play (83 yd pass) and had a 100 yd KR td but also had an xp and a FG blk'd and were int'd in the EZ which ended an 85/19pl drive. QB TerBush (159 ypg, 62%, 10-7) went the distance vs OSU after splitting reps the L/2. Boilers D held OSU's Miller in check (113 pass, 47 rush, KO'd 4Q) before all'g the late 4Q drive for the 2nd time TY to an undefeated tm (also #5 ND). UM also lost its 3rd str as we won a 4★ Key and 4★ LPS on Wisky (-15), 38-13. UM surprisingly burned QB Nelson's RS as Gray (ankle) and Shortell (neck) DNP and he hit 13-24-149-2-2 with 16-67-0 rushing. The shorthanded Gophers trailed just 14-6 at the half before wearing down and getting outtrashed 337-96 and outFD'd 24-12. After strong starts these tms are a combined 0-6 in B10 play so someone stops the bleeding here.

NORTHWESTERN 24 Iowa 23 - HC. NU HC Fitzgerald reportedly dislikes Iowa and NU is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series. The series had actually had 6 str outright upset wins heading into LY (dog 12-2 ATS). Iowa (-6) did get the cover, 41-31 but NU had 495-379 yd, 29-17 FD and 38:23-21:37 TOP edges. NW is just 9-18 ATS as a HF (but 3-0 TY winning by an avg of 18 ppg, but only covering by 3.7 ppg). Despite being outgained 543-301 and outFD'd 26-14 the Cats led Neb 26-18 mid-4Q before Neb rallied driving 80/10pl and 76/6pl for td's to take a 29-28 lead. NW drove to the Neb36 but Budzien missed a 53 yd FG with 1:10 left. QB Siemian has struggled in B10 play avg 142 ypg (54%) with a 3-1 ratio but RB Mark (915, 6.1) got his 5th 100 yd rushing gm of the yr vs Neb. Just :27 into the 2H Iowa trailed PSU 31-0 at home. The Hawks missed 2 1H FG's (49 and 37 yds) and failed to score until a 4Q KR td (PSU 504-209 yd, 28-14 FD edges). QB Vandenberg's (189, 56%, 3-5) struggles continued esp without RB Weisman (640, 6.1, CS) as the Hawks #1 rusher Garmon had 27 (3.4) vs the Lions. Take the dog.

FLORIDA ST 52 Duke 17 - FSU has never lost to Duke (17-0 SU) w/the avg score 50-16 (closest gm 19 pts). Duke came in on a 3 gm win streak LY and FSU had just dropped out of the Top 25 after its 3rd str loss. An angry FSU dominated winning 41-16 (-12) on the road and it was 27-3 at the half with a 286-108 yd edge. The Noles are off rival Miami (0-4 ATS in that role). Mistake prone FSU (-20) rallied from a 10-0 1Q deficit to beat UM for the 3rd straight ssn despite 12 pen's and 5 fmb'l's (2 lost). FSU lost #1 rusher Thompson (687, 7.6) but QB Manuel (254, 72%, 14-4) calmly guided the win. FSU leads the ACC in most D categories and is #2 FBS in tit D (227 ypg). Duke drove 87/14pl to score a td with :13 left (on 4D) to become bowl elig for the 1st time s/94. Duke led 20-6 at HT and withstood NC's 4Q rally finishing with a 510-414 yd edge. QB Renfree (256, 69%, 11-7) leads the off. FSU all of the edges esp on D (#3-76) while the Devils may still be celebrating their historic win.

Maryland 23 BOSTON COLLEGE 20 - BC is 6-2 SU (4-3 ATS) run vs MD but the HT has dropped 3 str (1-2 ATS) by just 5 ppg. LY there was a surprise snow storm with 20 mph winds. We used a Big Dog POW on BC (+7) and they delivered the outright upset as less than 10,000 fans were in the seats. BC finished w/a 372-197 yd rush edge and led 28-10 while MD drove 68/12pl for a td with 2:07 left. BC (+14) lost its 5th str gm 37-17 to GT who finished with 563-296 yd, 30-15 FD and 43:45-17:15 TOP edges. The Jackets also missed FG's of 22 (blk'd), 28 and 41 yds and an xp or it could've been worse. QB Reiting (274, 56%, 13-5) is BC's offense. MD trailed NCSt 10-3 when they lost QB Hills (191, 57%, 8-7) forcing the Terps to go to untested bkps Burns (3 career plays) and Fr Rowe. After the Pack hit a 43 yd FG with :32 left, Rowe burned his RS and nearly pulled off a miracle driving the Terps 60/5pl but Craddock missed his 2nd FG, a 32 yd'r on the last play (MD did cover as our Underdog POW). BC is 1-6 and this is likely HC Spaz's last shot to stay in the bowl hunt but MD needs this as well as they're unlikely to be fav'd in any of their L4 gms.

Utah St 37 UTSA 13 - 1st meeting. LW USt threw a 76 yd td pass on the 1st play of the gm in a 41-7 (-30) win over NMSt which made them bowl elig for the 2nd str ssn. The gm was a little closer than the final (NMSt 21-20 FD edge) as NMSt had a 42 yd FG blk'd and was int'd at the US14 in the 1H but went to the lockerroom trailing 28-0. QB Keeton (252, 67%, 16-4) and RB Kerwynn Williams (#18 FBS all-purp w/153 ypg) pace the off while the D leads the WAC in rush D (102, 2.7) and has all'd just 1 rush td ty. UTSA suffered its 1st WAC loss 52-24 to SJSt (-11). UTSA had the 412-374 yd edge but lost 6 TO's incl 3 fmb'l's in the 1H which set up 17 SJSt pts and they also all'd a 92 yd KR td to trail 38-10 at the break. QB Soza (180, 59%, 11-1) DNP (hip) and Polite hit 20-32-302-2-1 in his 1st FBS start and is expected to get the call here. USt is 7-1 ATS TY with their only loss coming by 0.5 pt in their least fav'd role (HC Andersen 1-6 as AF).

COLORADO ST 30 Hawaii 23 - Meeting of MW cellar dwellers as the duo are a combined 0-6 SU/ATS in conf play with the Rams losers of its L6 overall while the Warriors have lost 4 str. HT is 10-3 SU (1st meeting s/97). CSU is 20-8 ATS off a bye but UH also comes in off a bye which helps with the long travel but this is just its 2nd gm TY in altitude. CSU is 6-19 SU hosting MW (W's by 19 ppg and L's by 17 ppg). Both have serious QB issues as the Rams will go to rFr Smith who played the 2H vs SDSSt after 2nd string McPeek was inj'd. UH's offense has suffered growing pains with the move from the run-&-shoot to Chow's pro style. QB Schroeder (181 ypg, 54%, 8-5) is last in MW in pass eff and the run gm is avg 84 ypg (2.8) vs FBS tms. Both tms have been gashed at the LOS with CSU outtrashed by 115 ypg and UH by 127. With both tms similar talent-wise and situation-wise, we'll go with the HT playing in what could be inclement weather.

IOWA ST 38 Baylor 35 - HC. ISU had won 4 in a row SU in this series but BU has won 3 of the L4 SU and is on a 4-1 ATS run with the L4 being decided by DD. LY at home RGIII ran for a ssn high 107 and Ganaway for 200. BU got an 86 yd FR td (14 pt swing) and finished with a 603-425 yd edge in the 49-26 win. BU is 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS on the road but ISU is just 5-9 SU in HC gms. We used revenge minded OKSt (-13) over ISU as our Top Weekly LPS LW as the Cowboys spotted ISU a 10-7 1Q lead before scoring the gm's final 20 pts. ISU was outgained 625-341. QU Barnett (19-39-206-1-1) was benched for Jantz (4-9-34-0-0) and after the gm HC Rhodes said he didn't know who would start here. BU (+8) lost at Texas in typical fashion (56-50). BU outgained UT 607-525 but settled for 3 FG's scoring their final td with 2:00 left but the Horns rec'd the onside K and ran out the clock. QB Florence (371, 65%, 20-10) is #1 FBS tit off and #3 pass eff with Williams (1013, 21.6) the FBS's #1 rec. After feasting on opp's TO's LY the Bears have forced 0 in B12 play TY while all'g 58 ppg and 614 ypg. The duo are a combined 1-6 in B12 play with staying home for the postssn a possibility for the loser of this gm. We'll side with the HT.

Texas A&M 31 AUBURN 24 - Last met in 1985 Cotton Bowl. A&M is just 1-5 as an AF the L2Y while Aub is 5-1 under Chizik as a HD (3 outright upsets). It's hard to imagine that just 1.5Y removed from a nat'l title, Aub HC Chizik finds himself on the hotseat as the Tigers are off to their worst start s/52 at 1-6 (2-5 ATS). LW they were a 7 pt AD to perennial doormat Vandy and lost 17-13 getting outgained 382-212. Chizik, who was 14-0 w/Cam Newton on the C, is now 22-35 w/him. Naturally the problem starts w/the QB spot and Moseley was just 14-20-98-0-0 LW. A&M has not had many issues at QB TY as Manziel has dazzled w/his scrambling ability but LW after an early 12-0 lead vs LSU, Manziel and the off imploded w/5 TO's in the 24-19 loss (+3). It was the 7th time in the L2Y that the Aggies blew a DD lead (most in NCAA). Aub is 5-1 ATS as a HD under Chizik, and while we expect a good effort, A&M has a huge off edge (#6-96).

California 17 UTAH 16 - The visitor is 0-3 ATS in this series. LY at home we had a 3★ LPS on Cal (-1) as well as a 3★ on the Under. Cal had a 384-178 yd edge and led 34-0 in the 4Q with Utah having just 2 FD's and 27 yds in the 1H. The Bears are 8-19 SU/9-18 ATS in P12 road gms. Cal is in a unique situation off the Big Game in the month of Oct which they lost 21-3 as Stan dominated the LOS with 252-3 rush yd and 23-12 FD edges. QB Maynard (219, 62%, 10-8) has been inconsistent behind an OL which has all'd an FBS-worst 33 sks. Cal's D has also had issues up front all'g 161 rush ypg (4.2). The Utes had 19-15 FD and 307-226 yd edges vs #8 Oreg St but were doomed by mistakes as they missed a 43 yd FG, had TO's set up OSU for td drives of 10 and 16 yds, fmb'l'd at the OSU3 and committed a D pen on 38:13 which prolonged OSU's final td drive. QB Wilson (15-28-172-1-2) was hurt by the drops of 2 sure td passes. UT has the altitude edge and this one should come down to the wire.

Texas 49 KANSAS 24 - UT is 9-0 SU in this series winning by 31 ppg and they have outgained KU the L7 by 345 ypg! LY at home UT (-28) won 43-0 with amazing 590-46 yd and 35-3 FD edges as they rushed for 441 yds and KU set a B12 rec'd with just 36 offensive snaps. KU is just 10-24 ATS as a 20+ pt dog in B12 play while UT is 4-1 ATS as a 20+ pt fav. The Horns ended their 2 gm losing streak but probably failed to silence their critics with a 56-50 win over Baylor. UT led 42-31 at HT and was able to run out the clock after rec an onside K with 1:57 left for the win. QB Ash (238, 70%, 12-3) played well despite LW's wrist inj while RB Bergeron (418, 4.5) ran for 5 td's. The D however all'd 600 yd for a 2nd str wk and 48+ for a 3rd str gm. KU (+35) trailed OU 52-0 in the 3Q on just 46 off snaps as the Sooners had PR and KR td's for the 1st time in the same gm in schl hist. It marked the 1st time TY that the Hawks trailed by more than 10 at the half. QB Cummings (10-21-111-0-2) got his 1st start of the yr but Crist (3-6-13-0-0) also saw action. Hawks D is actually ahead of Horns in most stat categories and the Horns need a feel good gm.

OREGON 58 Colorado 13 - UO is 26-4 SU and 19-9-2 ATS hosting conf foes while CU is 9-25 ATS as an AD (3-10 ATS AD vs conf). UO has a couple of extra days to prep off a Thur night win over ASU (43-21, -7) while CU is on a 2nd str road gm off a USC beatdown (50-6, +40). This one is easy to call. The Ducks have the huge gm vs USC on deck so expect them to jump out to an early 40+ pt lead in the 1H (outscored opp's 234-56) then cruise in the 2H (outscored opp's just 123-85) like they've done all yr leaving the backdoor open for CU to cover the huge line.

Boise St 27 WYOMING 13 - LY, while we didn't get the outright upset win by the Big Dog on the PPH, we did get a comfortable cover as WY (+35) only lost 36-14 on the road. BSU is just 2-8 ATS in the MW and the Pokes are 6-1 ATS as a DD dog incl 2 outright upsets. The visitor is 5-1 ATS with the only non-cover by a half point. BSU has quietly won 6 str SU after their opening loss to MSU. LW after racing out to a 25-0 HT lead they beat UNLV 32-7 (-28). QB Southwick has been efficient but unspectacular avg 211 ypg (65%) with a 9-5 ratio while they remain conservative in the post-Moore era. WY continues to struggle at 1-6 SU and LW despite QB Smith ret'g from inj, the Pokes fell behind Fresno 35-0 at HT and lost 42-14 (+17). Boise has huge edges on D (#28-100) and ST's (#21-86) and should pull out a DD win here.

HOUSTON 34 Utep 21 - LY this gm was one of UH's closest wins on the ssn. Both offenses appeared unstoppable at times and UH (-16) only won 49-42 on the road. The HT is 5-1 ATS and UH is 5-1 SU (just 2-4 ATS) with UH being +172 ypg in those but the avg score the L7 meetings is just UH 48-36. After a shocking 0-3 SU start the Cougs looked like they had corrected their issues with 3 str SU/ATS wins but that came to an abrupt end LW in a 72-42 (-5) loss at SMU. The final was somewhat misleading as UH lost st'g QB Piland (CS) but still had 30-20 FD and 560-384 yd edges as SMU took advantage of 9 UH TO's incl 4 ret'd for td's! If Piland can't go, Crawford Jones (17-33-252-3-2 LW) will most likely get the start. LW a UTEP tm that came in avg just 16 ppg was a huge 16 pt fav vs a Tulane tm that is much different w/st'g QB Griffin under C. We easily cashed a 3★ LPS against the Miners who only eked out a 24-20 win. QB Lamaison was inj'd in the 2Q and DNR (CS). With both st'g QB's out we'll call for the clearly more talented Cougs off a misleading gm to get the win here but will wait for a line later in the week.

GEORGIA TECH 24 BYU 21 - Last met '03. GT should be well rested off a bye and a HG vs BC while BYU is making its 2nd trip East in B2B wks and playing a 9th str wk. In what HC Mendenhall called his tm's best performance TY, BYU nearly pulled the shocker over ND LW (+13) in a 17-14 loss. BYU became the 1st tm to score a tda(2) against the Irish D in 4 gms but a missed 2H FG (BYU K's just 5-10 TY and 3 PAT misses) and the inability to stop the Irish run gm (20 yds all'd) led to the 14-7 blown lead. GT off a bye and a DC firing, whipped BC 37-17 (-14) with 30-15 FD and 596-296 yd edges (43:37-16:23 TOP edge). The score would have been worse if not for 3 missed GT FG's. While Mendenhall knows how to shut down the option (held AF to 331 ypg L/5 gms), the situation does favor GT here.

MISSOURI 34 Kentucky 10 - MO is 7-3 SU/ATS on HC. The Cats have gone 0-10 SU/2-7 ATS on the SEC road (avg score 38-12). MO is fresh off a bye while UK (9th str gm) is off Ark and UGA. The Tigers have found the move to the SEC difficult as they are 0-4 SU/ATS in conf play getting outscored by an avg of 33-14 (-97 ypg) while going 3-0 SU/ATS in their non-conf gms. The reason for their difficulties is the result of 5 diff OL missing gms due to inj while st'g QB Franklin has missed all or parts of 4 but he should return here. After getting embarrassed 49-7 in just 40 min of play 2W ago at Ark, UK put forth an inspired effort LW in a 29-24 loss (+26) to UGA. Shockingly the one-dimensional Cats who are st'g a frosh QB were able to rush for 206 yds vs one of the better front 7's in the SEC. With a bye, VU and Samford on deck, this could be HC Phillips last chance to keep his job but the Tigers also need a win just as badly and have all the talent edges.

Ucla 31 ARIZONA ST 28 - HC. LY we used UCLA (+8) at home as the Underdog POW and they delivered yet another outright upset win. The HT is 9-2 SU (5-0 ATS) in the series and UCLA is 1-8 ATS after a bye (incl bowls). After a strong 3-0 non-conf start to the Mora era the Bruins find themselves 2-2 SU/1-3 ATS in P12 play beating cellar dwellers Colo and Utah. The bye came at a good time as QB Hundley's production has slipped (274 ypg, 67%, 14-7) along with the P12's #1 rusher Franklin (878, 6.8). ASU is off 2 str Thursday contests incl LW's 43-21 loss to #2 Oreg as a 7 pt HD. Thanks to a FF by star DT Sutton (FBS's #2 skr) who was inj'd on the play the Devils scored a td on their 1st touch of the gm. However, UO scored td's on their next 6 poss to take a 43-7 HT lead before coasting. ASU QB Kelly came into LW's gm #3 FBS pass eff (242, 67%, 15-4) but threw 2 int which set up UO td 'drives' of 6 and 1 yds. The D had been #1 P12 in tit D but all'd UO 406 rush yds, 48 more than their opp had in the previous 4 gms comb. We'll back the healthier and more rested tm here as Sutton's value can't be overstated.

Usc 38 ARIZONA 35 - LY at home USC's Barkley passed for a schl rec'd 468 yds and Woods had 14 rec for 255 yds. USC (-12) was on its way to a rout leading 34-12 in the 3Q but would allow UA a 4 yd td pass with 1:00 left for the backdoor cover (48-41). USC is 9-1 SU with 5 str W's in Tuscon by 16 ppg and the visitor is 10-4 ATS. UA has been very impressive TY under Rich Rod and LW crushed UW 52-17 (-7) with a 533-380 yd edge. Coming off a P12 rec'd performance vs Stan, Scott hit only 14-22 but did throw 4 td's while Carey (172 yds LW) is one of the more underrated RB's in the country (#14 rush ypg, 11 td). As we ended our USC/Colo writeup LW, we noted that Barkley could get back in the Heisman race w/a big gm and that's exactly what he did hitting 19-20-298 with a 6-0 ratio while setting a schl career mark for td passes in a 50-6 (-40) win over hapless CU. USC does have huge edges on D (#10-73) and ST's (#31-109) but amazingly UA has the slight edge on off (#7-16). The Cats are 6-1 ATS vs the Trojans and are 10-3-1 ATS as a HD incl an outright upset (+10) win over OKSt earlier TY.

We did win our 1994 College GOY in this series with USC (-3) rolling to a 45-28 win. With USC having clear look-ahead to next week's gm vs UO will we come back to it for another winner? RUTGERS 26 Kent St 13 - RU is 2-0 SU (0-2 ATS) vs KSU incl a 29-21 win as a 12 pt HF in '04 (L/ meeting). RU is off Temple and has a bye on deck while Kent is off WM with its rival Akron on deck and this is its 4th AG in 6W. Both tms have had surprising ssn as RU is off to its best start s/06 at 7-0 SU (5-2 ATS) while KSU is off to its best start s/73 at 6-1 SU (6-1 ATS). LW RU fell behind 10-0 at HT but scored 35 unanswered in a 35-10 win (-3) at TU. RB Jamison continues to be the star (114 rush/81 rec LW) while QB Nova has a solid 15-3 ratio. Kent is off a misleading gm as the final reads 41-24 (-3) but the Flashes were down 24-17 into the 4Q before benefitting from 3 WM TO's (6 on day). Their star is all-purp man Archer who avg 212 ypg (#1 NCAA). The off and ST's are close but RU has the home and D edges and we like their situational edge as well.

4★ NY JETS over Miami - MIA is 0-5-1 ATS off a bye vs a DIV foe and dogs that were outgained by 200 or more yds in a win are 5-13 ATS in their next game (-270 vs STL). The Jets have a tactical edge after facing the Patriots "Oregon Ducks spread attack" offense as the Dolphins are one of the league leaders in a sugar/no-huddle style offense. MIA's lack of a quality 3rd receiver and the fact that this is the 2nd time around for the Jets vs Tannehill after beating him 23-20 in OT (2 pt AF) is a bonus. Tannehill only had 196 yds (44%) with an int that was returned for a td in the 1st meeting as RB Bush (61 yds rushing 6.1) was KO'd of the game. Sanchez had 306 yds (47%) with a 1-2 ratio but the Jets defense carried the day. The Jets are built for physical matchups that allow them to beat on weaker teams as shown by their wins vs BUF/IND earlier TY. With offenses needing a 1.5 Qtrs to get up to speed after a bye and the Jets knowing what they're getting vs Tannehill we'll call for the home team by double digits.

FORECAST: NY JETS 26 Miami 10

3★ PHILADELPHIA over Atlanta - This is the 5th year in a row these teams have met with the Falcons pulling off a 35-31 win as a 2' pt HD. Vick (242, 68% 2-1) was KO'd in his 1st game in the Georgia Dome S/06 while Ryan tallied 195 yds (61%) with a 4-2 ratio. PHI had a 447-318 yd edge but Vick gave ATL 3 TO's which set up 14 pts. It's not a big surprise that PHI changed DC's over the bye week as despite having the #12 defense they have only pulled in 7 sacks (30th) and the unit collapsed vs DET prior to the bye. Reid is a sterling 14-4 ATS off a bye inc playoffs holding foes to just 304 ypg and 13 ppg. PHI's borderline top 10 off/def have struggled to overcome Vick's 13 giveaways and they will be looking for a fast start after being outscored 26-7 in the 1Q TY. While ATL is undefeated they only have 1 win over a quality foe (SD) and Smith is 6-15 SU vs teams with elite coaches like Reid, Coughlin, McCarthy etc. They needed a Newton TO in the final 2 min to beat CAR, were struggling vs WAS before RG3 was KO'd with a concussion on the ATL 3 and barely got by OAK. Completely different mind-sets here as the Falcons are undefeated leading their division by 4 full games while the Eagles can not afford to fall behind with trips to NO and WAS and a game vs the Giants in the next 3 weeks.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ NY Giants over DALLAS - The Cowboys didn't have to wait long to avenge both losses LY as they kicked off the 2012 season outgaining NY 433-269 in a 24-17 win. Since that time the Cowboys have beaten only TB and CAR who each only have one win when not being matched up. The Giants meanwhile have won 5 of 6 incl a win at SF with the only loss coming at PHI on a FG while under 2 min left. The Cowboys have struggled holding on to the ball as they have 12 giveaways while the opportunistic Giants are among the leaders with 14 takeaways. Also favor a Giants run D that held SF's #2 rush offense to a season low 80 yds (96 below avg) against a Dallas rush attack that has gained 40 ypg (2.1) at home and has inflated numbers the L2W vs BAL's #26 and CAR's #24 D's. Eli loves to travel as evidenced by his 19-8 ratio (21-13 at home) and in his L/3 trips here he's led the Giants to 478 ypg throwing for 345 ypg (64%). NFC East teams are 24-9 ATS as Div AD's and with DAL Ctr Costa (ankle) getting hurt LW we'll call for the Giants to get revenge.

OTHER GAMES

Tampa Bay at MINNESOTA - Thursday. TB comes into this game at 4-2 ATS thanks in part to a rush D all'g 76 ypg (3.1). They are also already 2-0 ATS on the road covering vs the Giants and DAL. MIN comes in 2-5-1 ATS at home when playing as a fav of 3 or less or as a dog. That incl's the Vikings home opener LY as the Bucs trailed 17-0 at HT but Freeman led them back incl 61/8pl and 61/9pl 4Q td drives the latter with .31 left. Can MIN cover the largest number they've laid in 2 years or will the Bucs cover again on the road? This game will be part of the Thursday Night Marquee package.

New England 34 St Louis 20 - This is the 6th game in London and weather won't be a factor with a dry week and a forecast of mid 40's and sunny on game day. Huge edge to the Pats and Brady having just played here in 2009 as they beat TB 41-7 with a 414-240 yd edge. While the offense has avg'd 470 ypg the L4W with their only loss self inflicted as Brady threw 2 int's after having just 1 in 185 att's while also having several questionable time management issues. This week on a world stage we expect New England's offense to be the smooth running machine we've grown accustomed to seeing. The Rams under Fisher have looked competitive as they are 5-2 ATS only getting outgained by 9 ypg, but LW 8 of 18 FD's (42%) and 186 of their 354 yds (53%) came in the 4Q. NE's young D has been vulnerable vs the pass (#29 8.1 ypg, 6-7 ratio) but STL has a lack of talent at the receiver spot making them predictable has been held to 15 FD's or fewer 4 times TY and they won't keep up with a D that's already let Rogers and RG III to throw for a combined 76%.

TENNESSEE 24 Indianapolis 16 - The home team is 8-3 ATS taking both games LY. IND's rebuilding defense has been beset by injuries with Freney limited (high ankle), Mathis (knee) and DE Moala out and they've been worn down in the 2H being outscored 77-49. LW vs CLE they scored td's on their 1st 2 drives but were held to 3 pts the rest of the way but thanks to numerous drops by CLE WR's had enough to hold on. The Titans went up to BUF for a 2nd straight ssn and for the 2nd time came away with a road win. They looked like LY's group led by CJ (195, 108) which opened the passing lanes for Hasselback (205, 71%, 1-0) but it was against the Bills #32 rush D. The Colt's rush D however was only ranked #29 (5.0) before holding CLE to 55 yd (3.2) as the Browns were without Richardson (8 att) for a majority of the game. On offense Luck has struggled on the road (50.6%, 1-5) and the Titans D when aided with a TOP edge due to a strong rush game has only allowed 340 ypg vs 446 ypg in their other 5 games. IND has lost both games after a win TY (failed to cover by 31 pts) while TEN has already knocked off DET and PIT at home.

GREEN BAY 38 Jacksonville 6 - The Packers return home from a 3 game road trip and after avg 402 ypg in the L4W with Rogers having a 15-1 ratio the critics of the offense have been silenced. While a home game vs JAX may be a flat spot for most with ARZ and a bye on deck they'll just keep rolling. The Jaguars are in the unenviable position of a second straight road game after traveling to the West Coast and blowing two 14 pt leads vs OAK. They now limp into Lambeau with the forecast calling for mid-40's and non-conf DD AD's are 15-30 ATS. GB will always try to please their fans and LY they

SAN JOSE ST 38 Texas St 17 - 1st meeting. Texas St is fresh off a bye but SJSt just had one 2W ago and is off an easy 52-24 (-15) win at UTSA. UTSA had a 17-15 FD edge, but the Spartans led 28-0 taking advantage of 6 UTSA TO's. It was 38-10 at the half and SJSt coasted. 3Y HC MacIntyre has them thinking bowl at 5-2 SU (6-1 ATS) and they are led by QB Fales who is avg 307 ypg (74%) with a 15-3 ratio and is #10 in the NCAA in pass eff. TSU is 3-3 SU (4-2 ATS) in their inaugural FBS ssn and in their Lgm destroyed Idaho 38-7 (-2). QB Rutherford has taken over the st'g QB role and is avg 170 ypg (70%) with a 9-2 ratio but HC Franchione does prefer the run (57/43 run/pass mix) with his Pistol option off. SJSt just saw the option 3W ago and held Navy to decade lows (0 pts and 144 yds). With all of the talent edges SJSt easily gets to bowl eligibility.

STANFORD 37 Wash St 16 - This gm will feature two contrasting off styles with Stanford based on the power run with multiple TE's while Wazzu is in the 1st yr of the Air Raid TT off under HC Leach. Flat spot here for the Cardinal as they are off of 2 OT gms and a very early Big Game matchup with Cal (won 24-3 delivering a 3★ CTOT Under winner!) while the Cougs are fresh off a bye. WSU is 4-2 SU/ATS on The Farm but the Cardinal have won 4 str vs WSU by an avg score of 45-14. The Cougs covered (+36) in their last trip vs #12 Stanford in '10 never trailing ATS and judging by the tough month the Cardinal have already partaken in, expect Stan to lay off of the gas pedal here if they find themselves with a solid lead.

were a DD HF 6 times (5-1 ATS) covering by 13 ypg and scoring 39 ypg. The Jag's may have the #32 offense and the #28 defense but to put it into perspective they have been outgained by 175 ypg which is 84 ypg worse than #31. Add to the fact that both QB Gabbert (left shoulder) and MJD (foot) got banged up and Henne's performance as a replacement (71 yds, 45%) much left to be desired. The main reason for this selection can be found in the standings which has GB trailing BOTH CHI and MIN so no foe can be overlooked.

San Diego 24 CLEVELAND 13 - There's not much of a worse feeling heading into your bye week off a pair of prime time nationally televised losses. The Chargers are hearing it again at 3-3 so hitting the road will be welcomed where they've covered 5 of 7 as an AF. While most thought that SD had few worries at QB, Rivers has already turned the ball over 14 times (9 int's & 5 fmb) incl 6 on MNF directly leading to DEN's comeback win. The Browns are off yet another close loss (4 by 7 or less) but they're not the team to look for to pull the upset as they have 5 wins in their last 27 games with all 4 LY vs losing teams that avg'd 4 wins on the season and this years vs CIN as a 2' pt HD. CLE's D hasn't been helped playing in front of the Dawg Pound as they've allowed 418 ypg to PHI, BUF and CIN and while they are only getting outgained by 37 ypg on the road they are at -153 ypg here. The bye will help SD get LT Gaiter back and after missing the first 2 gms Matthews is returning to form (232 tt yds the L2, 5.3) and when he tops 100 yds on the road SD is 3-0 SU/ATS. With the Browns new owner already taking over, GM Holmgren on the way out. A 1-7 start and a probable new HC is not far behind.

DETROIT 24 Seattle 20 - SEA's long road trip here is negated by the extra rest off a Thursday game. This is their 4th road game in 5 weeks and they have a home game vs MIN on deck. DET is 2-5 ATS as a HF but have a quality stat edge with the #2 and #9 units at home vs the #30 offense helmed by a rookie backed by the #6 defense. DET has outgained foes by 95 ypg (#2) TY but have been done in by B2B games with bad special teams play. While SEA has logged a trio of quality wins at home they have only covered 1 game on the road TY vs pass challenged teams like ARZ (26th) STL (25th), CAR (23rd) and SF (29th). Wilson has been rather Gabbert-like with 164 yds (59%) with a 2-7 ratio on the road but has been bailed out by his defense and RB Lynch (93 ypg 4.4). While Stafford has been slow to get into his groove TY (6.85 ypa 4-5 ratio) much of that has been due to defenses not respecting the run (83 yds or less in 3 gms) and teeing off on Megatron (35 rec 15.9 but 1 td). We'll call for the home team by 4 and make a final decision after MNF.

CHICAGO 38 Carolina 20 - CAR has played only 1 road game in the L6W with home losses to SEA and DAL sandwiched around a bye in the L3W. The Newton led offense that excited the NFL and was only held to under 16 pts in one game LY has already been held to 14 pts or less 4 times. The Bears meanwhile have been the polar opposite as they finished LY not topping 21 pts in their final 6 games and never reaching 40 pts on the season while TY they've topped 23 pts in 4 of 5 and already topped 40 twice. Chicago is off a div Mon Nighter but a bye prior clearly negates the short week. The Bears have been a fav of 6+ three times TY and not only are they 3-0 SU/ATS but they've won by 25 ppg outgaining them by 166 ypg. CHI's #3 def is all'g only 291 ypg but against the 3 lowest ranked offenses they faced (#15 GB, #28 STL & #32 JAX) they're only all'g 223 ypg. The D also has 3+ sks in 4 of the 5 games which has allowed the secondary to put up a league leading 60.0 QBR and an awesome 5-13 ratio. Da Bears #3 scoring offense and #1 scoring D get it done again.

PITTSBURGH 33 Washington 17 - PIT is off of CIN on Sun Night and will be happy to play in front of their home crowd for only the 2nd time in 6 weeks where they've won 10 of their last 11. Included in those wins they've gone 8-0 vs non-div foes covering 6 by an avg of 17 ppg. While PIT's D has faced some attrition they went into LW's game ranked #4 and they still show excitement vs a marquee QB as TY they held both Peyton Manning and Vick to season lows on offense. LY they faced a rookie QB in 3 games (Dalton 2X) and as you would expect from this prideful D all'd only 48% comp and only 14 FD/gm. RG III is now off a div road game, traveling for a second straight week and playing in his 8th straight game incl 5th on the road and the wear and tear will become a factor as he had been rushed/k'd & taken QB hits 30 times in the last 2 games. The Skins D (#29) meanwhile has allowed a season high in FD's to 4 foes TY and allowed NY to convert 8 of 12 FD's LW while celebrating a 23-20 "win" prior to allowing a 77 yd td pass with 1:13 left. Griffin's mobility has kept him to 1 sack or less in 4 games but when they've allowed multiple sacks (incl LW) they've lost and now he faces a D which has multiple sacks in 4 of 5 games.

Oakland 17 KANSAS CITY 16 - KC is 0-4 SU/ATS as a HF losing by a 27-9 avg score and in this series the AD has not only covered 10 straight but the last 9 have been outright upsets. The Chiefs are 1-5 and off a bye and with HC Crennel having a clear QB conundrum it will clearly cause a rift amongst the ranks. KC's #8 off and #16 D are solid numbers but thanks to their -15 in TO's (-10 at home) they are #29 in scoring off and #30 in scoring defense. OAK comes in 2-4 and now hit the road after rallying from 14 pts down to beat JAX in OT thanks to both Gabbert and MJD getting hurt. It's no secret the Raiders want to run the ball which they couldn't last week trailing 17-6 at HT but against the Chiefs rush D allowing 4.7 ypc (#27) we'll look for 100+ which they had covering at ATL and upsetting PIT as Palmer has thrived in those 2 games completing 70% of his passes with an 8.4 ypa. The AD pulls the upset for a TENTH straight time!

New Orleans at DENVER - The situation clearly favors the Broncos being off a bye after knocking off a division rival on the road before a MN audience. The Saints had a bye prior to LW's win vs Tampa but are now traveling for a second week. The new Manning led Broncos offense has put up extraordinary HT splits as they been outscored 98-42 in the 1H and outscored opponents 128-40 in the 2H. The Saints come in with the #4 off and a quick check of the logs shows that the Broncos are 0-3 ATS vs the 3 top offenses they faced in Atlanta (#13), Houston (#12) and NE (#1). Brees vs Manning will be a Marquee game and a Marquee play available on the PPH and Marquee 7-pack after 11am ET game day.

San Francisco at ARIZONA - SF has won and covered 5 of 6 in this series but lost their last trip here (-3', 19-21) despite a 3-0 TO edge. The 49ers are off a non-covering division win and are only 3-3 ATS on the road the past 2 seasons. ARZ has already pulled 3 upsets this season beating SEA, NE and PHI and with a #1 ranked opponent D that has allowed only a 6-8 ratio with 7 fumble rec's they have the potential for another upset. A win for the Cards would create a tie at the top of the West or will SF take control?

Ohio St 31 PENN ST 17 - OSU had dropped 4 of 5 in Happy Valley but have won their L/2 trips here 37-17 (-3') and 24-7 (+5) and are playing with legit revenge. LY it was PSU's 3rd win in 11 gms in Columbus and each time came vs a true frosh QB (Schlichter '78, Pryor '08 and Miller '11). PSU never trailed winning 20-14 (+6'). With QB Miller (173 ypg, 59%, 11-5, #15 FBS rush 959, 6.8) KO'd in the 3Q (neck/shld inj) the lucky Bucks drove 70/7pl for a td with :03 left, got a 2 pt conv to tie it, then scored on their 1st OT pass to beat PU 29-22 despite a -3 TO margin. PU had a FG and an xp blk'd, missed a 52 yd FG and was int'd in the EZ. Bkp QB Gupton has led OSU to 5 td's in 8 poss in the L4 gms when Miller has been lined up. After the bye PSU won in Iowa City for the 1st time s/99 dominating the Hawks 38-14. The Lions led 31-0 after the 3Q's 1st poss and finished with 28-14 FD & 504-209 yd edges. B10's #1 passer McGloin (255 ypg, 63%, 14-2) looks like a diff QB. **OSU is 16-9-1 ATS as an AF and delivered two 5★ winners for us in that role in the L5Y vs Mich St and NW in '08 covering the gms by a comb 59 pts!** Much respect to PSU who has covered 6 str (5 SU W's) under O'Brien but as long as QB Miller is healthy he's the X-factor which the Lions D hasn't faced in their win streak.

Oregon ST 27 WASHINGTON 17 - OSU is one of the biggest surprises so far TY marching out to a 6-0 mark (5-1 ATS) incl a 21-7 home win (-9') vs Utah behind #2 QB Vaz for a 2nd consec wk (outgained by the Utes 307-226). Starting QB Mannion (340 ypg, 7-4 ratio) should ret here after serving as the bkp LW (knee surg 2W ago). His matchup is favorable vs a UW tm that was thrashed in Tucson LW (outgained 533-380 in the 35 pt loss). LY at home OSU (+1) beat UW for the 7th time in 8 gms (8 str covers) and judging by the recent trend for HT's in this series (6-12 ATS), expect OSU to continue its series domination.

Way back in '92 we used MSU (+11) at home as our GOY and the Dogs delivered the win. LY the situation favored MSU as Bama was off of a bubble bursting loss to LSU in the gm of the century. Bama still finished with a commanding 386-131 yd and 20-9 FD edges and MSU's only score came on a 21 yd drive after a 69 yd KR. Bama is 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) only failing to cover LY by half pt on the road (-17, -24-7). Bama has the huge showdown at LSU on deck. LW MSU in a flat spot predictably got off to a slow start as they led just 17-3 midway thru the 3Q but exploded for 28 pts in the final 20:00 for a 45-3 win (-18) over MT. QB Russell is one of the MIP QB's in the country and has a 15-1 ratio. Bama has been AP #1 for a schl rec'd 8 str wks after their 44-13 win (-20) at Tenn. The Tide had dominating 23-11 FD and 539-282 yd edges and QB McCarron is now #1 in the NCAA in pass eff with a 16-0 ratio. The Tide D is also #1 in scoring and tld D for a 2nd str yr. This is uncharted territory for the Bulldogs while the Tide are used to the spotlight, playing at home and have all of the talent edges.

OKLAHOMA ST 41 TCU 20 - 1st meeting s/'93 (OSU 1-3 SU/1-2-1 ATS). OSU is 30-13-1 ATS as a conf fav. The Frogs got to ease their way up the B12 ladder but now face the league's top 6 to end the ssn. TCU had 28-21 FD and 516-389 yd edges vs TT but settled for a B12 rec'd 6 FG's and lost 3 TO's in a 56-53 3OT loss. QB Boykin (288 ypg, 62%, 9-5) is 1-2 SU/ATS as a str with TO's playing a huge role in each gm (-7 TO margin in Ls to ISU and TT; +6 in win over BU). OKSt won a 4★ Top Weekly LPS with their 31-10 win over ISU in which they had a 625-341 yd edge. After trailing 10-7 at the end of the 1Q the Cowboys shut down the Cyclones for the rest of the gm and QB Walsh (244, 66%, 10-3) had 415 yds despite playing on what was later revealed to be a serious knee inj (OFY) without 2 of his top WR's. With Walsh out, Lunt (436 yd vs Ariz) is exp to return. OSU's D is statistically imp'd all'g 366 ypg vs LY's 457. The young Frogs and WV are starting to learn there are no 'off wks' in the B12 as almost every tm is capable of winning on a weekly basis so depth is the key and the Frogs don't have it.

UCF 45 MARSHALL 35 - A matchup of contrast with MU avg 598 ypg (low of 572) vs CUSA foes while UCF is all'g only 361 ypg (high of 362). Definite conf implications as UCF leads the East at 3-0. LY in a heavy downpour UCF dominated with 21-6 FD and 387-130 yd edges but only won 16-6 (-19). UCF ended the gm at the MU4 taking a knee raising the visitor to 5-1 ATS in this series with UCF winning the L/3 here incl pulling a pair of upsets. MU's off is #1 in the NCAA running 91 pl/gm and while many opp's have wilted, the 3 conf teams they faced have an avg D ranking of #85 making UCF (#56) by far the best D they've faced. What makes the Knights D even more respectable is that they've held SIX foes scoreless in the 1Q and have played all those gms with the lead which means prevent D late and keep in mind UCF has only lost to Missouri and Ohio St.

Toledo 30 BUFFALO 27 - The HT is 7-1 SU. In the last meeting ('07) UB won 43-33. UT is 1-3 SU here with its only win back in 1970 but is 9-1 SU on the MAC road. UT is off yet another Glass Bowl upset of a BCS tm as they beat the undefeated #21 Bearcats 29-23 (+5) LW. They did so despite being outgained 478-355 and failing to score an off td as they got a 75 yd IR td, a 91 yd KR td and 5 FG's. UB meanwhile outgained Pitt 334-254 and had a 22-13 FD edge but lost 20-6 (+9). One of the more amazing stats that we came across TW was UT (7-1 SU/6-2 ATS) is actually getting outgained by 17 ypg TY vs the #112 sked while UB (1-6 SU/3-4 ATS) is outgaining their opp's by 10 ypg vs the #73 sked. With the Bulls at home for a 2nd str wk and UT in a clear flat spot, we wouldn't be surprised if this one came down to the wire.

S CAROLINA 34 Tennessee 24 - UT had won 12 in a row SU in this series from '93-'04 but SC was on a 5-3 ATS run. The L7Y SC is 4-3 SU but UT is 4-3 ATS. The HT had won 4 in a row SU but LY on the road SC (-3) won 14-3. UT started true Worley (10-26-104) and he threw 2 crucial int's. The visitor is a solid 12-2-1 ATS and Tenn is 5-16 SU but 12-9 ATS in SEC road gms (0-6 SU, 1-5 ATS L2Y). SC is finishing up a killer Oct sked (off UGA, at LSU, at UF) and LW was destroyed 44-11 at UF (+3) as we cashed a 3★ Key Selection and a 4★ LPS on the Gators. Four key SC TO's led to 28 UF pts and QB Shaw (9-20-72-0-0) was benched in the 2H for Thompson (8-20-83-0-1) while RB Lattimore was limited. The SC D did hold UF to under 200 yds but a short field plagued them. UT is off a 44-13 loss (+20) to #1 Bama as Dooley fell to 0-14 SU vs Top 25 tms and is clearly on the hot seat. Both tms are reeling and while SC has the D edge (#7-62) UT has the ST's (#44-97) and off (#18-36) edges and how much does SC have left in the tank?

ARKANSAS 41 Mississippi 27 - Little Rock. Houston Nutt will not be a part of this series for the 1st time s/'98. The HT is 14-4-1 ATS in this series while the fav is 14-5-1 ATS. LY we used a Big Dog POW on Ole Miss (+16) at home and they jumped out to a 17-0 led (250-128 yd HT edge) but Ark won 29-24. Ark is 13-7-1 ATS as a HF but 0-3 TY incl upset losses to ULM and Rutgers. The Hogs seemed to have righted the ship prior to the bye winning at Aub and vs UK. SEC's #1 passer Wilson (326 ypg, 60%, 14-5) is back connecting with the conf's #1 rec Hamilton (754, 16.4). The Rebs are led by QB Wallace (196 ypg, 64%, 9-8, 225 rush) and RB Scott (562, 6.1). The pass D is all'g 211 ypg (68%) with a 10-8 ratio. LY we used the Hogs (-14) at home vs Tenn as our College GOY and they won 49-7! Could we go back to the Hogs for another 5★ here?

Louisiana Tech 58 NEW MEXICO ST 27 - HC LY LT accepted a bid to the Poinsettia Bowl after winning the WAC with a 44-0 victory over NMST. LT played the 1H distracted but found out mid-2Q when it was announced Nev had lost to Utah St that they had won the WAC and leading just 9-0, they went 96 yds for a td with '28 left in the half then got a 45 yd IR td with :07 left to blow it open 23-0. LT has won 3 in a row SU/ATS with the avg score 43-9! LW the Bulldogs off (our #1!) continued to put up video gm numbers with a 70-28 (-30') win over Idaho in a flat spot as their 839 yds was a schl rec'd

and FBS high TY. NMST was beaten by the WAC's other power Utah St LW 41-7 (+30'). The gm was much closer than the final as they had a 21-20 FD edge but -2 TO's did them in. The HT is 9-2 SU all-time in the series but LT was 4-0 ATS on the WAC road LY, clearly has the better personnel (QB Cameron has an incredible 20-0 ratio TY) and just covered a large spread LW vs Idaho.

TULANE 28 Uab 27 - TU is 5-2 ATS vs UAB. LY we used TU (+13) as a Big Dog POW and they won the gm by 39 covering by 52 pts!!! TU dominated with 540-193 yd and 28-10 FD edges on the road. There have been 4 outright upsets the L/5 with the dog having a +167 ypg edge. TU is 5-16 ATS hosting CUSA (1-8 ATS hosting CUSA East) while UAB is 6-20 SU in CUSA AG's. Both tms are off close losses as despite being outgained 600-401 UAB led 28-27 early in 4Q before EC scored 15 pts in less than 2:00 to put the gm out of reach. The Wave looks like a new tm with QB Griffin back in the lineup as they've covered all 3 that he's started and finished TY incl LW's 24-20 loss to UTEP as we used TU (+16) as a 3★ LPS. These tms are close statistically with Griffin being the difference maker.

SMU 27 Memphis 13 - HC. The visitor is 2-1 SU/3-0 ATS in the series with UM winning 31-26 in its last trip to Dallas (2008, E). LY it was HC for UM but SMU got the shutout win as a 24 pt fav, 42-0 with a 519-139 yd edge leading 28-0 at the half and Mem had 12 punts on 50 (SOD/fmb) with none over 7pl. SMU is 12-1 SU in CUSA HG's but just 4-15 ATS as a HF. Mem is 1-12 SU and 5-8 ATS on the CUSA road. SMU is off the misleading final of the yr as they capitalized on 9 Houston TO's ref'g 4 for td's in a 72-42 Thursday night win. QG Gilbert (237 ypg, 51%, 11-13) has struggled but RB Line (717, 4.8) is conf's #2 rusher. The Tigers lost 35-17 to UCF thanks in part to TO's as they fmb'd on the UCF1 and had a fmb'l ret'd 79 yds for a td. SMU is a one pt loss away from being undefeated in CUSA play and wins to keep pace.

Southern Miss 30 RICE 27 - LY at home SM (-14) dominated even more than the final score with a 654-229 yd edge. At the half SM did only lead 20-17 with Rice getting a 17 yd FR td and Rice got a 96 yd FR td (14 pt swing) early 3Q to lead 24-20 but SM went 44/7pl, 75/9pl, 63/7 and 94/7pl for td's to blow it open. SM is 1-2 SU/ATS in its history vs Rice and the HT has covered 2 str. SM continues its march towards the worst ssn in schl hist (0-7 SU/2-5 ATS) as they were crushed 59-24 (-2') and outgained 629-331 at home to a 2-4 Marshall tm. SM thought they had finally fixed their QB issues after a couple of good performances but frosh Alford was just 9-21-65-0-0. Rice doesn't have QB issues as the underrated McHargue can beat you with his arm and legs (8-4 ratio, 490 rush yds). The Owls played valiantly in a 28-24 loss (+19) at Tulsa LW as they led late in the 4Q before dropping their 3rd gm TY by 4 pts or less. SM does have the talent edges and will finally get its 1st win here.

NEBRASKA 37 Michigan 27 - LY NU was making his 1st trip to the Big House s/'62. At the half UM led only 17-10 but had a 230-125 yd edge. NU fmb'd the opening KO of the 3Q then had a P blk'd and UM used a fake FG for a td to blow it open 31-10 and rolled 45-17 (-3', 418-260 yd). Both tms used late rallies to win LW as the Huskers rallied from 12 pts down in the 4Q to beat NW 29-28. Neb had 3 TO's incl 2 fmb'l'd P's but Martinez had his best performance as a B10 QB hitting 27-39-342-3-0 in the win. RB Burkhead (knee) left early again. NU is all'g 188 rush ypg (4.4). The Wolves got a huge monkey off their backs as they ended their 4 gm series losing streak to MSU by driving 41/8pl for a 38 yd FG with :05 left for a 12-10 win over their instate rivals. D-Rob had 259 of UM's 326 ttl yds and only has 1 TO in the Wolves' 3 gm win streak. The D has been the difference as they are all'g 231 ypg and 9.8 ppg in the L/5. NU beat Mich St at home LY 24-3 (-4) the wk after MSU had won a big HG (very similar spot) and NU becomes the new Legends leader.

SAN DIEGO ST 34 Univ 24 - LY UNLV (+16') jumped out to a 14-0 lead and the gm was much closer than SDSU's 31-14 win. At the half LV led 14-7 (233-167 yds). SDSU got a td with 5:45 left and then blk'd a punt and drove 31 yds for the frontdoor cover with 1:11 left. LV is 1-10 ATS and 1-30 SU in MW AG's and are 3-15 ATS overall as an AD. SDSU is on a 6-0 ATS series run and LTH LV (+23') trailed 48-7 into the 4Q. The Rebs 2 td's were set up by a 73 yd KR and 64 yd FR (SDSt 588-234 yds). LW SDSt w/a bkp QB (Katz hurt 1H, out indef) overcame a 10 pt 4Q deficit to win 39-38 in OT (+6) at Nev. They were outgained 480-349 but bkp Dingwell played well going 14-23-177-3-0. LV off its disappointing DD blown lead to instate rival Nev found themselves down 25-0 at HT to Boise LW in their 32-7 loss (+28). QB Sherry was knocked around so often that at the end of the gm he needed help from teammates to get to the lockerroom but should be okay here. With both str'g QB's beat up, we will wait for a line later in the wk but the Aztecs should be in a large fav role in a Nev/Boise sandwich which has us favoring the Rebs.

Fresno ST 26 NEW MEXICO 20 - NM is 1-6 SU (2-4 ATS) vs FSU but the L/gm was in '98. NM entered '12 with just 3 SU wins comb the L/4Y (all 3 at home in MW gms). TY they have 4 so far incl 1 on the MW road, and ply'd Boise close in a loss (32-29, +25) at home. Davie should be getting consideration for MW COY even after the 28-23 loss (+11) to AF LW which cashed as our 4★ CTOT GOM on the Under. RB Carrier ran for a FBS high 338 (8.7). They did lose QB Holbrook to a concussion in the 1H (CS) and ran for most of the 2H. FSU rebounded from the tough loss to Boise by jumping out to a 35-0 HT lead over WY LW and cruised. RB Rouse became the 1st FSU RB to top 4,000 rush yds in a career and S Thomas continues his run to an AA ssn with his NCAA-leading 7 int incl a 20 yd IR td. FSU has the large talent edges. They also travelled here in both '08 and '09 for the bowl and are 6-2 ATS as an AF. Both tms are covering machines TY under their new HC's as Fresno is 7-1 ATS while NM has easily covered 4 str. This is FSU's 3rd AG in 4W and HC DeRuyter does not have much exp defending the option.

ULM 41 South Alabama 17 - 1st meeting. The 5-2 Warhawks (6-1 ATS) are now in the driver's seat for the SBC Title and 1st ever bowl bid after LW's thrilling 43-42 (+3) OT win at WKU. They found themselves down 28-7 in the 2Q before rallying thanks to QB Browning's 377 ttl yds and 6 ttl td's. After scoring their td in OT, ULM went for 2 and got it. USA (2-5 SU/3-4 ATS) is also off a thrilling come-from-behind win in OT as they trailed FAU 31-17 in the 4Q before eventually winning 37-34 in 2OT (-4'). They were outgained by 102 yds. ULM does have rival Louisiana on deck so it could be the biggest flat spot in SBC play TY but keep in mind earlier TY ULM was off 3 tough gms vs BCS tms that all went down to the wire and easily covered a huge spread at Tulane (-20) 63-10.

FIU 31 Wku 30 - LY WKU (+3) snapped a 4 gm series losing streak winning 10-9 with commanding 22-8 FD and 324-180 yd edges. LTH WKU trailed 21-0 but pulled within 7 w/5:47 in the 4Q. After forcing a short punt WKU got a FD at the FIU24 but fired inc on 488 w/33 left (FIU -9', 28-21). The most impressive ATS streak in at least a decade (15 str covers) came to an end LW as WKU lost 43-42 (-3) in OT to ULM despite 26-19 FD and 449-385 yd edges. The Hilltoppers led 28-7 in the 2Q but couldn't hold on but Jakes continues to impress throwing the ball as he was 25-32-308-4-1. FIU is off a tough 1 pt loss as well as they also blew a DD lead LW. They led Troy 37-21 late 3Q before all'g the L/17 pts. Medlock has played well in his ret from inj and was 18-29-316-3-1. While WKU may be suffering from bubble burst, FIU is playing with legitimate revenge, at home and is much better than their record indicates.

MIDDLE TENN 30 N Texas 28 - Prior to LY's gm, Stockstill, whose team was 2-9, talked as if the ssn was already over prior to the gm and MT's effort showed that mindset. The gm was 52-0 in the 3Q as NT won at home 59-7. LTH NT led 14-0 w/a 193-76 yd edge into the 2Q but needed an int at its 35 w/46 left (up 6) to seal the win (NT +11, 23-17). Prior to those two wins MT had won 4 in a row in the series by an avg of 43-15.5 and they are playing with legitimate double revenge after a home upset loss as a DD fav and an embarrassment. NT is off a Tues Night win over UL as they overcame a 10 pt 1H deficit to win 30-23 (+5) as we cashed a Marquee Play on them. MT was down just 17-3 in the 3Q LW before MSU exploded for 28 pts in the final 20:00 in a misleading 45-3 (+18) gm. The off is playing w/o its best player in RB Cunningham (OFY) but they still has the off edge (#78-98) while NT has the D edge (#82-107). With both tms close talent-wise, we will go with the HT here.

Troy 33 FAU 20 - LY it was Troy's FHG (-11') and they snapped a 5 gm losing streak with a commanding 34-7 win. The Owls have never won hosting the Trojans and Troy has won 4 str with the avg score 39-13 (483-342 avg yd edge). Both tms come in off down to the wire gms with diff results. Playing w/o st'g QB Robinson (CS), Troy found themselves down 37-21 in the 3Q but kicked a FG w/11 left for the win over FIU (-6) as bkp Anthony hit 29-41-245-3-1 and added 115 rush yds (most by a Troy QB s/'89). FAU, on the other hand, led USA 31-17 in the 4Q but couldn't hold on eventually dropping it in 2OT 37-34 (+4') for their 6th consec loss. Troy is 3-0 ATS as an AF and has the talent edges.

PRO ANGLES

There are 3 main methods of handicapping. Fundamental, Statistical & Technical. Fundamental handicapping, or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings, is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situational handicapping (analysis of letdown, look ahead, systems) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. For more complete analysis you should read Ten Keys To A Winning Season. Each week in Power Sweep we provide the angle section to add to your handicapping arsenal. Many times we will agree with the angle plays. Sometimes the Fundamental & Situational aspects of a game will outweigh the angles & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on. We are NOT technical handicappers, but we do use them in our handicapping analysis. Each week in Power Sweep we provide pro angles for the current week's games. For the angle plays the number in the () indicates how many angles apply to that team. The higher the number the stronger the angle play.

There are 3 main methods of handicapping, Fundamental, Situation & Technical. Fundamental handicapping or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situation handicapping (analysis of letdown, look ahead, systems, etc...) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. Each week in Power Sweep we provide a system to add to your handicapping arsenal. This is done at the request of our subscribers who want handicapping tips & methods. Many times we will agree with the side that the system chooses. Sometimes the Fundamental & Technical aspects of a game will outweigh the system & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. **We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on.** If that is ever the case during a week, keep the system for future use, but be aware that the side we write-up in the Power Sweep Selections page is the side we are on.
