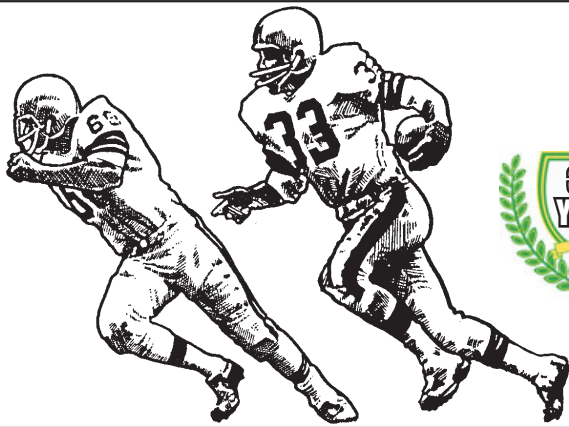

4★ GEORGIA TECH over Pittsburgh - The L/mtg was '76. Pitt has a situational edge having played Navy LW giving them a full game's work vs the option (also faced NM earlier TY). GT is playing for an 8th str wk with a bye on deck and this is HC. GT playing at home though gives us warm and fuzzy thoughts as 2 wks ago they were a **4★ Top Weekly LPS** and **3★ Key Selection** on these pages and won 56-0 (-7) over Syracuse covering by 7 tds. LW they beat UVA 35-25 (-10) on the road despite being outFD'd 32-18 and lost the TOP battle 34:44-25:16. However, amazingly GT had 5 TO's and despite the large FD discrepancy, had the yardage edge (507-444). They are now one win away from their 17th consec bow appearance. LW Pitt completely dominated the 1H having edges in total plays (44-22), TOP (22:07-7:53) and ydg (252-135) but only led 13-7. That would come back to bite them as they lost 24-21 (-5) at Navy. We have had a pretty good pulse on these tms TY, going 4-0 on Weekly LPS. We like what we're seeing from GT these L/2 wks while Pitt could be caught looking ahead to their HG vs ND next wk (always play Irish tough). For the 2nd time in 3 wks, we think a tm goes into Atlanta and gets stung in a big way.

FORECAST: GEORGIA TECH by 21 over Pittsburgh

3★ TULSA over Utsa - First meeting. Tulsa's 1st HG in 4 wks and it's HC. In the preseason you would be thinking the Golden Hurricane might be looking ahead with CUSA East powers E Car and Marsh on deck but now at 2-5 on the year, every game and every win is critical. Tulsa had a 344-301 yd edge in LW's 14-7 loss (-3) to Tulane but couldn't overcome 4 TO's. Frosh QB Evans was only 13-30-139-0-3 LW, but st'g QB Green should be back for this one (missed LW w/minor knee inj). His prev gm vs UTEP was arguably the best gm of his career going 14-17-226-2-0 in the win. Utsa is off a 52-31 win (-8) over UAB but they were outFD'd 29-26. It's now or never for the Hurricane and in the preseason this line may have been 3 tds. Grab the value while you still can.

FORECAST: TULSA by 13 over Utsa

3★ HOUSTON over USF - Thursday. L/meeting came in '02 a 32-14 USF win (-13). UH comes in off successful road trip to Rutgers cashing another **3★ Key Selection** on these pages (that's 6 winners in a row on the Cougs this year!) UH is the only team in the country this year to remain unbeaten ATS at 7-0! UH was also a **3★ LPS** winner LW and QB O'Korn had a 5-0 ratio in their 49-14 win (+7, a 6 td cover!). While USF only has 2 gms in a 4 wk stretch, the other came 5 days ago and they now travel on a short week. Taggart said after LW's 34-3 loss (+20) to Lville that frosh Mike White will become the 4th diff st'g QB for the Bulls TY and he will do so in hostile territory. Dare we make it Lucky #7 for the Cougs this year? You better believe it!

FORECAST: HOUSTON by 28 over USF

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MICHIGAN ST by 8 over Michigan - In '07 RB Mike Hart made a comment about MSU being UM's "little brother" and MSU would win the next 4 years (1,318 days) SU by 12 ppg (also covered 4 str). LY it was a focus for UM at home to finally get the win but MSU covered a 5th str year in a def struggle that they could have easily won. Had MSU punched in a td late 4Q they would have won but instead on 4&gl from the 1, they settled for a 19 yd FG and only led 10-9 with 5:48 left. UM got it back with 2:00 left on their 38 and got a 38 yd FG w/0:57 left for the win. UM is off a bye for this gm for the first time s/1919 and prior to the bye won a shootout over Indiana 63-47 (-9), as their offense topped 40+ for the 5th time TY! This wk that mark will be in jeopardy big time as MSU again showed why their def is among the nation's elite holding Illinois to just 128 yds in their 42-3 win (-8) LW. The tm with the most rushing yds has won 40 of the L/43 meetings which obviously favors MSU as they have our #1 ranked rushing D in the nation all'g just 55 ypg (2.1) and UM has had several inj's and lack of production on their OL this yr. Sparty gets another win over Big Brother!

FORECAST: MICHIGAN ST by 10 over Michigan

2★ FLORIDA ST over Miami, FI - The last time these two faced off as undefeated top 10 teams was in 2003. Both teams were ranked in the top 20 nine straight years from '99-'06 and this marks the 1st time in 6Y (were #23 and #13 in '10). The visitor is now 6-1 ATS and there were EIGHT upsets in 9Y thru 2010 (every line -7 or less) but FSU has been a 10 and 21 pt fav the L2Y and while they won both Miami covered both. LY TO's set up UM for a 10-0 lead then FSU would dominate outscoring UM 33-3 but UM got an 8 yd td pass with :47 left to "only" lose 33-20 (+21). FSU got their revenge on NCSt LW as they are determined to put the "underachiever" label to rest. UM, meanwhile, had to feel fortunate to escape for the 2nd wk in a row beating WF 24-21 (-25) as we easily won our NC Sports College Comp POW on the Demon Deacons. FSU just may be the best team in the country this year and are certainly well balanced (our #4 off, #7 def, #2 ST's) while UM is not quite at the top 10 level. Florida St is now 7-0-1 ATS at home the L2Y when laying more than 14 w/an avg cover of 18 ppg and we think they make another statement here.

FORECAST: FLORIDA ST by 31 over Miami, FI
OTHER GAMES

Wednesday, October 30th

Cincinnati at MEMPHIS - These 2 were CUSA foes until '04 with Memphis dropping 4 of the L/5. In their last meeting in '04 Cincy (+6) at home won outright 49-10. The Bearcats did play here in the '11 Liberty Bowl. While Cincy comes in at 5-2, the combined record of the 4 FBS tms they have beaten is just 2-28. Here they face a Mem tm that while just 1-5 is only getting outscored by 3 ppg and are outgaining their opp's by 29 ypg. However, the Tigers are off a misleading gm vs SMU as they were down 34-3 but got 2 def tds and also a td pass on the last play. Do the Bearcats clinch bowl eligibility or will the Tigers get their 4th upset at home in the L/2 yrs?

Thursday, October 31st

Rice at NORTH TEXAS - Met in '08 and '10 with Rice winning and covering both. Rice comes in 6-0 ATS as an AD in true AG's but NT has gone 5-1 ATS as a HF under McCahey. Both tms also come in red hot as Rice has 5 str wins and 4 str covers after LW's 45-7 win (-18) over UTEP, NT on the other hand has 3 str wins/covers for the 1st time s/'04 after their 55-14 win (-12) over SM. Both tms remain in the hunt for a CUSA West Title and the winner here also positions themselves for a better bowl.

Ulm at TROY - ULM's 38-10 win here in '11 was their first ever at Troy (now 1-5) and prior to that the HT had won and covered 4 straight. The loss was also Troy's WORST ever at home under HC Blakeney (1st ssn '91). Both tms should be playing w/some confidence as ULM comes in winners of 2 str and LW saw the return of QB Browning in their 38-10 win (-14) over Georgia St. Troy, meanwhile has won 3 str gms incl LW 32-26 as a 10' pt AD vs WKU giving us another Comp Big Dog POW outright upset winner (get it FREE every Thur on button #9 1-347-677-1700)! Winner here remains in the hunt for the SBC champ.

Arizona St at WASHINGTON ST - While ASU is 8-1 SU in the series, 2Y ago here Wazzu QB Halliday threw for a Pac-12 frosh record 494 yds in an outright upset. The home team has covered 4 straight and WSU has covered 3 straight here. LY ASU was playing with legitimate revenge and rolled to a 46-7 win (-22'). Both teams are off bye but WSU also has a bye on deck. I will the Sun Devils continue their march towards a Pac-12 South Div Title or will Wazzu take one more step towards a possible bowl (6-2 ATS this yr)?

Friday, November 1st

Usc at OREGON ST - USC has to cringe making this trip as they were upset the L/3 times here. They lost by 29 as a 3 pt fav in '10, lost as the #1 tm as a 25 pt fav in '08 and lost by 2 as a 10 pt fav in '06. However, they will be a dog this time around. The home team is 11-1 SU with OSU covering 3 straight and 5 of 6. While series says take the Beavers, OSU is off a physical game vs Stanford while USC has shown a lot of heart under interim HC Orgeron incl LW's impressive 19-3 win (-4) over Utah. The gm easily cashed us **4.5★ Totals LPS GOM Winner** on the UNDER (covered by 30 pts!). Will Oreg St continue their dominance over USC here or will the Trojans continue to play extremely hard for Coach "O"?

Saturday, November 2nd

Clemson by 14 over VIRGINIA - These 2 haven't met s/'09 when #18 CU won 34-21 (-21). UVA only trailed by 3 at HT but were shutout in the 2H. The home team is 4-1 SU and while the series has had 5 outright upsets in 7 yrs, CU has won the last 3 SU as a favorite (2-1 ATS). UVA is 3-8 as a HD under London. LW CU got a 40-27 win (-17) over MD as they had 30-19 FD and 540-364 yd edges. MD did go 61/8pl getting a backdoor cover td w/'09 left but the Tigers were playing a banded-up Terps tm and only led 19-13 entering the 4Q. WR Watkins did set a sch-rec w/14 catches. UVA continues to find ways to lose as LW they got 0 pts off 5 GT TO's and despite QB Watford having a career-day going 43-61-376-2-1, the Cavs lost their 5th str gm 35-25 (+10). Clem does have a bye on deck but is on B2B road while UVA is on 3rd str home.

Virginia Tech by 6 over BOSTON COLLEGE - VT has won 4 straight but failed to cover the L/2. LY VT was -9' on the road and trailed 13-3 at half. VT battled back to lead but BC got a td with 4:11 left to take the lead, 23-20. VT had a 42 yd FG bounce off the upright good with 1:05 left and won in OT, 30-23. VT went 15-4-1 ATS as an AF thru '10 but is 3-7 ATS since. Both tms are off byes 2 wks ago and disappointing losses LW. The Hokies came into LW riding high after winning 6 str gms but were shockingly upset 13-10 (-12') by Duke at home. The Hokies dominated the game statistically as they had a 387-198 yd edge, a 39:27-20:23 TOP edge and held Duke to 0-11 on 3rd down. However, they couldn't overcome QB Thomas' 4 int's and 2 more missed FG's. BC, off a bye, playing a UNC tm that had lost 4 str gms was surprisingly a no-show as they lost 34-10 (+6) getting outFD'd 21-12 and out-gained 392-261. The offenses are relatively close but the diff is VT's #1 D all'g just 249 ypg while BC's D is all'g 417 ypg and the Hokies are 14-2 SU/13-2-1 ATS in their last 16 reg ssn November AG's.

TOLEDO by 31 over Eastern Michigan - The two teams are actually separated by just 59 miles. Toledo is 12-1 SU/8-2-1 ATS despite not covering LY. Rockets have covered 5 straight at home with an avg line of -18 and an avg score of 45-14. LY EM had 624 yds, their 3rd best effort in schl history but gave up 655. UT led 21-0 at the half but the 2 tms then combined for 5 td's in a span of 1:51 all by EM's Hill and UT's Reedy in the 3Q. EM's Hill rushed 283 yds. While UT is off BG, EM is on their 4th away in 5 wks. After jumping out to a 21-0 lead over BG LW, the Rockets lost RB Fluellen (ankle, CS) for the gm and saw the Falcons score 25 unanswered. All looked lost as UT was facing a 3&26 but after Owens scrambled 17 yds, he then hit a 11-yd td pass on 4&9 w/1:22 left giving them their 4th str win over their rival. The Eagles on the other hand, come in losers of 7 str after their 59-20 (-31') defeat at the hands of N Ill LW. They did finally turn to true frosh QB Roback (highest-rated EM recruit ever) as he got his 1st start going 7-17-109-0-0 but the D gave up 658 yds and is all'g 498 ypg on the ssn. It doesn't get any easier TW for a rush D all'g 256 (6.5) vs a UT rush off avg 274 ypg (6.6) their L/6 gms. Rockets continue their series dominance.

Northern Illinois by 27 over MASSACHUSETTS - LY was their first meeting and NI (-35) won 63-0 pulling QB Lynch after the first series of the 3Q up 42-0. Lynch had 348 yds of offense in just 34 plays. NI went 4-0 ATS on the MAC road LY covering by 12.5 ppg and TY are 2-0 ATS but the linesmakers were adjusting as they are covering now by 6 ppg. A wk after setting a FBS QB rush rec, Lynch in just 2.5Q's of action was 16-20-223-4-0, added 99 rush yds and a td and also caught a td in a NI's 59-20 (-31') win over EM. The Huskies are now off to their best start s/'65 and their D since all'g 577 yds to E Ill in wk 3 has all'd less yds than the prev wk in each of the L/5 gms. LW Umass missed out on an opportunity to show they were making progress under HC Molnar as they loss to W Mich 31-30 (-3'). The Minutemen scored a td w/:22 left but the 2 pt conv failed, however prior to that drive they were out-played getting outFD'd 21-12 and outgained 393-260. While NI should be able to name the score.

AKRON by 3 over Kent St - The dog has covered 5 of 6 and while UA has lost 3 straight they've covered 3 of 4. The visitor has covered 3 in a row which makes sense as they are just 12 miles apart (Battle for Wagon Wheel). LY KSU was -20 at home but UA had 23-18 FD and 442-364 yd edges and led 14-0 after 1Q and 21-7 in the 2nd. At the half UA had a 307-164 yd edge. KSU took their first lead with 6:13 left in the 3Q and KSU went 35/6pl and on 4&1 got a 15 yd td run with :38 left to win by 11. LW we went against a beat-up Golden Flashes tm taking on a confident Buffalo tm and we easily cashed a **3★ LPS** in a 41-21 (+1) UB win. QB Reardon after missing the USA gm was 20-32-260-1-2 but had 2 costly TO's. While UA lost 42-24 (+10) to Ball St LW, they actually had the yardage edge 437-434 but had 3 TO's, were SOD and missed another FG. Both of these tms are playing their 10th str gm and both have a bye on deck. This one goes down to the wire and we'll take the home tm.

RUTGERS by 11 over Temple - While RU has won 3 str, the visitor has covered all 3 and prior to LY the prev mtg was '04. LY in their return to the Big East, Temple was held to a ssn low of 10 pts, 9 FD's and 191 yards. The Owls actually led 10-0 at HT but Rutgers exploded with 5 straight 2H td drives. This year the situation favors the Knights as they play only 2 games in 4.5 wks and it's their 2nd str HG while Temple is in 2nd str away, 3rd in 4W and 4th in 6W. LW we went against both of these tms on these pages. The Knights were laying a td to a Houston team that was a perfect 6-0 ATS and we easily won a **3★ Key Selection** as UH won 49-14 (covered by 42 pts!) dealing the Knights their worst loss s/'05. We also went against Temple with a **3★ Key Selection** on these pages and it was a very rare loser (see Newsletter Contest page 2) as SMU piled up 728 yds, had a 34-23 FD edge but Temple got a backdoor cover td w/1:34 left. One positive continues to be the play of frosh QB Walker who was 26-37-293-4-0 and added 92 rush yds. The Knights, should also get a lift offensively w/RB James (573 rush 1st 4 gms) likely to return here. Look for RU to take adv of their situational edge but we have liked what we've seen from the Owls the L/2 wks.

PENN ST by 13 over Illinois - The dog is 6-1 ATS and the visitor is 12-2 ATS. There have also been 4 upsets the L/6Y. LY UI was -1' at home. While Scheelhaase ref'd and hit 28-46-270, PSU led 21-0 at HT (only 199-187 yd edge) and went on to a 35-7 rout. PSU was upset that UI went on campus to recruit PSU players and played with an extra chip on their shoulders and Beckman and O'Brien did not chat on the field prior to the game. After PSU lost the home opener LY they have gone 7-1 ATS as a HF. LW's 63-14 loss (+16') to OSU was their worst loss in 114 yrs and the PSU D has now all'd 40 pts or more in 3 str gms for the 1st time since 1899! The Illini's 42-3 (+8) loss to MSU wasn't much prettier LW as they were outFD'd 29-8 and outgained 477-128. Almost half of their offense came on their opening 53/12pl drive that resulted in a FG but it was only a 7-3 gm late 2Q. The Illini have now lost 17 str B10 gms and will be facing a PSU tm that is 6-0 ATS off a loss under O'Brien covering by 12 ppg. Illini are 0-6 SU/ATS (-245 ypg) in true road gms the L/2 yrs and lose another here.

Wake Forest by 3 over SYRACUSE - While most ACC teams are making their first trip to Carrier Dome, Wake opened the '11 ssn here losing 36-29 in OT (+6'). SU trailed 29-14 w/1:02 left in the 4Q but forced OT w/a 53 yd td run. In OT SU got a td and held WF to 4&out. Wake is on 2nd str away off Miami who they haven't faced since '09. Syracuse is off a bye and in their L/gm we easily cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages and a 4★ Top Weekly LPS going against them in a 56-0 (+7) loss to GT (a 7 td cover!). We loved GT's situation as they needed a win while Cuse was on B2B ACC road and hadn't played the option s/'96. QB Hunt is really struggling as after avg 223 ypg (79%) w/a 7-0 ratio in gms vs Wagner/Tulane, he is avg just 65 ypg (41%) w/an 0-6 ratio in his L/3 gms and the opening day str Allen has gotten some work. LW we gave the Demon Deacons (+25) out FREE on Sat as our NC Sports College Comp P and they almost gave us one of the biggest upsets of the ssn in a 24-21 loss to Miami, FL (still covered by 3 tds). WF was either tied or led for all but 2:27 of the gm as they all'd a td w/:53 left. While the situation favors the Cuse here, we like what we've seen from WF these past 3 wks.

Wku by 17 over GEORGIA ST - Ga St HC Trent Miles held the same position at Indiana St and 2Y ago, his Sycamores squad traveled to WKU and pulled the upset (44-16 +12). ISU finished with 436-369 yard edge. Ga St is off B2B away with a bye on deck. Prior to LW's 38-10 loss (+14') to ULM they had covered 5 str gms. WKU is off a HC game vs Troy and has at Army on deck but in their history they are 5-1 as an AF. LW they lost 32-26 (-10) to Troy giving us another Big Dog Outright Upset FREE Comp Winner (Did you get your Big Dog Plays This Week? Just \$9 on Your VIP Debit). Their AA RB Andrews did have 144 rush and 125 rec. Petrino is coaching in the Georgia Dome for the first time since leaving the Atlanta Falcons during the '07 season. Look for the locals (all 15K of them) to give him a rude welcome back but the fact is WKU needs a win for any remaining bowl hopes and get one although the line may be too steep for our liking here.

KANSAS ST by 21 over Iowa St - Kansas St has won 5 str SU although the L/5 in this series have been decided by 8, 1, 7, 6 and 6 pts. LY KSt was -6 on the road and had 25-12 FD and 364-231 yd edges but only won 27-21 on a windy day in front of a record crowd of 56,800. KSt had a bye 2 wks ago and hosted WV LW while Ist is away for a 3rd gm in 4 weeks. LW we cashed a 3★ LPS Totals play on the UNDER in KSt's 35-12 win over WV. It was a much-needed win for KSt's bowl hopes as after 3 str losses, they now can build some momentum against an Ist team that is 1-6 and has gotten blown out in each of their L/2 gms. LW their QB Richardson was KO'd (CS) and Rohach was just 12-23-97-1-0 in his place. The FD's were even at 20 and it was only 28-20 at HT but the Cyclones ended up losing 58-27 (+12). While he is known mostly as an underdog HC, it should be noted that Snyder is 8-3 ATS as a HF incl 5-0 ATS as a B12 HF.

MARSHALL by 35 over Southern Miss - Marshall is a fav for the 1st time in this series. They have pulled the upset in the L/2 mtgs and 3 times in 5 gms. LY SM (-4) was at home in desperate need of a win but MU steam rolled them with a 629-331 yd edge and QB Cato was 31-42-340 in the 59-24 final. LW MU gave up a td pass on the final play and lost 51-49 (-8) at MT meaning they need to take care of business down the stretch or their lofty preseason goals of winning CUSA will be for naught. On the other side, SM is now not only losing gms (19 str), they have been completely non-competitive in their B2B 41 pt losses. LW's loss guaranteed them their 1st B2B losing seasons s/1933-34. Marshall has won their last 7 Nov HG's SU by 14 ppg and no doubt will take their anger out on a SM program that has fallen farther than any in the L/2 yrs.

TEXAS A&M by 38 over Utep - A&M won both prior mtgs ('84 and '00). In the L5Y UTEP has gone 0-8 vs BCS teams losing by an avg score of 42-14. LY they played 3 (all went to bowls incl 1 BCS) getting outscored 30-14 and outgained on avg 463-301. While A&M is in an SEC sandwich it is between home games vs Vandy and Miss St. What a difference a year and half makes as in the summer of 2012, UTEP QB Showers was listed as the st'r over Manziel at A&M. LW we loved A&M's situation vs Vandy. They were coming off an upset loss playing at home for a 2nd str wk while Vandy was coming off an upset win and were now travelling. Despite having 5 TO's, the Aggies still cruised 56-24 (-17) piling up a 558-329 yd edge. Manziel was ? mid-wk but was 25-35-305-4-1. The Kuglar era at UTEP has gotten off to a rocky start as after LW's 45-7 loss (+18') they are now 1-6 SU/ATS and have failed to cover 5 str gms by an avg of 9 ppg. Showers was hurt (shld'r) and DNR and it looks like he will be out for an extended period. Even w/a bkp QB however, this is one of the biggest FBS vs FBS lines of the yr and A&M's D is fully capable of all'g a backdoor td.

Middle Tenn by 2 over UAB - First gm s/'00. This is UAB's only home game from Oct 5th thru Nov 21st. LW MT got a miracle 51-49 win (+8) over Marshall converting on several 3rd and 4th downs and got a 9-yd td pass on the final play. That win put them at 4-4 on the yr and you have to think with FIU, S Miss and UTEP still left on the sked, they are thinking bowl. UAB, on the other hand is off a misleading 52-31 loss (+8) to UTSA as they scored the gm's final 2 tds but were -3 in TO's and did have a 29-26 FD edge. MT is on a 9-3 ATS run as an AF but we can't lay too many pts here vs a dangerous UAB offense that is avg 38 ppg at home TY while MT's D is all'g 30 ppg and 450 ypg TY.

AIR FORCE by 1 over Army - Prior to LY AF had won 6 str, 14 of 15 and 7 in a row SU at West Point. Army snapped all those streaks with their biggest series win s/1980! (47-24, +7). AF was also 12-3 ATS prior and amazingly lost B2B games ATS for the first time s/'80-'81. REVENGE - the last 5 times AF lost SU in this series ('05, '96, '88, '86 and '84), they have gone 5-0 SU/ATS the next year with an avg line of -10' and an avg score of 34-5! Army is fresh off a bye and AF is off ND but AF has altitude edge and had a bye 2 wks ago. LW's loss ensured their first non-bowl ssn s/'06 so this game is no doubt their most important gm for the rest of the ssn. As of press-time there is no line on the gm due to Army's QB situation, which is ironic because AF has had arguably the most injury concerns at the QB spot of any team in the country. TY we'll take the Falcons here by 1 and see where Vegas tells us to lean later in the week after getting an updated injury report.

TCU by 13 over West Virginia - LY WV (-3') led 24-14 when they mishandled the punt snap and TCU fell on it for a td. Tied at 24, WV got a 76 yd PR td with 3:19 left to lead 31-24 but then TCU on 2&19 got a 94 yd td pass where the WR slipped behind the D. TCU went for 2 at the end of the 2nd OT and got it in the 39-38 win. TCU is off a 30-7 (-2') home loss to Texas as we not only easily cashed a 3★ LPS against the Frogs, we also cashed a 3★ Totals LPS on the UNDER. The gm was delayed more than 3 hrs but the Horns controlled matters before and after. Frog QB Pachall did see his 1st action in 7 wks but was only 13-34-139-0-1. Speaking of cashing plays, LW we won 3★ Totals LPS on the UNDER between WV and Kansas St and it was just 14-12 entering the 4Q before KSt pulled away. From '05-'11 TCU was 39-3 at home but now they are only 1-5 here vs the B12. However, they are sitting at 3-5 for the 1st time s/1997 and need a feel-good win. This is WV's 1st ever visit to Fort Worth and they are making B2B long road trips.

Georgia by 4 over Florida - Jacksonville. Both teams enter the former "World's Largest Outdoor Cocktail Party" off a bye and stark contrast to LY when both teams came into the game ranked in the top 15 and now neither are in the top 25. Georgia went 2-11 SU vs Florida thru '10 but has won and covered B2B gms. Florida is out for revenge as their loss LY cost them a shot at the SEC and Nat'l Champ. "It's not going to be a long winning streak, I can assure you," said Muschamp, a Georgia grad. In LY's gm UF turned it over SIX times as the two tms combined for 29 FD's, 539 yds, 5 sks and 9 TO's. The difference was Georgia had all 5 of the sks and were +3 in TO's. Despite having SEC record holder QB Murray, inj's have started taking their toll on the Bulldogs as they have lost B2B gms incl a road loss to VU where there was some home-cooking by the officials. The Gators have injury issues of their own and also limped into the bye having lost B2B gms. Look for pts to be at a minimum here and the gm could come down to TO's once again as in the L7Y the tm that's won the TO battle has won the gm.

★★★ COLLEGE TOTALS GOY GOES SATURDAY ★★★

Arizona by 14 over CALIFORNIA - New HC Dykes was the OC/QB cch at UA from 2007-'09. The home team has won 6 straight and had covered 5 straight prior to the last game in '10. Cal (+6') lost 10-9 but covered on the road. The Bears led 6-0 at HT and 9-3 until all'g a 77/7pl GW td drive w/1:11 left. Arizona is just 7-15-2 ATS their last 24 Pac-12 road gms. Cal had lost an incredible 13 str ATS prior to LW's 41-17 loss (+29') to Wash but they have still not beaten an FBS opp since last Oct. Arizona was not an AF LY, but has been twice this year (3-0). This is a 2nd str AG for the Wildcats after defeating Colorado in Boulder LW 44-20 (-12') as they scored the gm's final 17 pts. Arizona has lost 4 straight trips here by 21 ppg (last win was in '02), but the Cats have a top-notch rushing attack led by RB Carey. However, we fade the Cats here as Cal always has backdoor potential.

Wisconsin by 10 over IOWA - These two border rivals have campuses 175 miles apart. First mtg since '10 and the visitor has covered 5 of the L/6. In the L/meeting #13 Iowa lost 31-30 (-6) to #10 UW. The gm featured 8 lead changes as Iowa allowed a 15pl GW drive and a td w/1:06 left (UW twice conv on 4D). Wisconsin comes in off a bye and they are now 6-0 ATS in that role as their big OL and deep RB corps just wear teams out (see 4★ Key Selection Winner vs NW earlier TY). This is just their 3rd gm in 5 wks while Iowa is off another tough B10 gm with NW where they pulled out a 17-10 OT win (-3'). This is the 4th gm of a stretch that also incl MSU and OSU. The key matchup in this game will be the rushing attack of the Badgers, led by RB Gordon who has rushed for over 1,000 already while avg a "pedestrian" 9.5 ypc compared to his 10.0 ypc a year ago against an Iowa rush def that has all'd 200 rush yds plus in each of their L/2 gms. We have had a good pulse on both of these tms TY incl multiple Key Selection winners but the fact is UW is just a bigger, stronger, faster version of the Hawkeyes (+229 ypg vs +77 ypg) and will come away w/a DD win.

Ohio St by 35 over PURDUE - OSU is 25-4 SU on the B10 road excl '11 (interim HC) with 2 of those 4 losses at Purdue! PU is also on a 6-2-1 ATS run in this series. The LTH the Boilers upset OSU 26-23 (+7). LY also went down to the wire as OSU was playing with legitimate revenge but PU got an 80 yd td pass on the first play and later a 100 yd KR td and with Braxton Miller out in the 4Q, appeared to lock the game up with an int with 2:18 left up by 8. OSU got the ball back with :47 left, drove 61/7pl for a td and 2 pt conv with :03 left to force OT where they won it. New PU HC Darrell Hazell was on the OSU staff from 2004-'10 as a WR/asst HC. Purdue is off a bye as Hazell went 2-0 SU/ATS w/reg ssn bye at Kent covering by 18 ppg, but wet the bed in that role 3 wks ago against NU (lost 44-7, +13'). OSU is confident off their 63-14 (-16') blowout win over PSU at The Shoe LW as QB Miller/RB Hyde led the way as OSU topped 50 pts for the 7th time in the Meyer era (1.5 yrs) after only doing so 6x in Tressell's 10Y. Ohio St is 10-2 SU/8-3-1 ATS the last 11 yrs in Nov AG's. Bucks proved LW they are capable of running it up to impress the voters.

INDIANA by 10 over Minnesota - First mtg since '08. The home team is 7-1 SU/ATS (10-1 SU!). Indiana was a conf HC once the L5Y and it was LY (-2 to Iowa, 24-21). They are off a bye and this is HC (LY Mich St, 27-31, +15). Similar situation to 4 wks ago off a loss and a bye and playing at home, IU took out their frustrations on PSU pulling the outright upset 44-24 (+3)! While IU's D can't stop anyone (all'g 498 ypg), the Gophers off may be just what the doctor ordered as prior to LW's emotional 34-23 win over Neb (+10), they were avg just 248 ypg in their prev 3 gms. The last time Sufeldt/Roberson ply'd a similar pass D (Navy) they went off for 363 yds, (74%) with a 4-1 ratio. Expect similar numbers here as Minn continues to struggle on the road in the B10 (3-6 ATS as a B10 AD under Kill) and LY went 0-3 SU/ATS failing to cover by 11 ppg.

UCLA by 27 over Colorado - The Bruins have won and covered both P12 gms by 8 and 28' pts (46-10 avg win). LY UCLA was -20 on the road and won 42-14. At the half UCLA had a 336-127 yd edge but only led 21-7. LA led 42-7 when CU went 80/9pl and got a 32 yd td pass w/2:43 left. Colorado is coming off a loss to Arizona 44-20 (+12') as they only trailed 27-20 in the 3Q but were outgained 670-349. UCLA is 13-4 ATS in Nov/Dec HG's and has to be happy back home at the Rose Bowl and will be looking to take their frustrations out on CU after losing B2B gms during arguably the toughest two game road stretch in all of CFB.

NOTRE DAME by 21 over Navy - After ND lost B2B gms they've put up 50+ the L2Y covering by 35' and 19. ND has failed to cover nine straight at home when not playing with revenge in the series (ND 6-2 ATS away from home, 1-7 ATS at home). LY in Ireland they took on Navy in the opener giving them extra time to prep for the option and ND dominated winning 50-10 (-14') with a 490-341 yd edge. LTH ND led 49-7 in the 4Q. ND does have the large edge of having faced the option LW vs Air Force (won 45-10, -19') and now faces it for a 2nd straight wk. Navy meanwhile in on the 3rd away in 4 wks but did gain a confidence-boosting 24-21 (+5) win over Pitt LW after losing 3 of their prev 4 gms. ND is a poor home fav (19-33-2 ATS L/11 yrs) but like we wrote LW, the Irish after getting embarrassed by Navy in '10 (1st time HC Kelly seeing option), they have now gone 5-0 SU/ATS w/an avg score of 47-15 and an avg cover of 17 ppg.

Auburn by 3 over ARKANSAS - There have been EIGHT OUTRIGHT upsets in the L/12 meetings incl LY. The Razorbacks have also won and covered 4 of 5. Bielema won and covered his L/4 reg ssn gms at Wisc off a bye. While Auburn has ply'd 5 str weeks they only faced FAU LW and WCar 3 wks ago. LY Aub was -7 at home despite coming in 1-3 as their losses were to Clemson, Miss St and LSU and Ark was struggling even more. Aub Fr OT Patrick Miller got his first start and Ark had 8 sks and delivered the outright upset as a Big Dog POW. In Aub's L2 trips here they have lost by 21 and 24 pts incl a 3★ LPS winner in '11 when Ark won 38-14 (-10). These tms look to be going in opposite directions as Aub has 4 str wins and 5 str covers while Ark has 5 str losses and is on a 1-5 ATS run. However, this is the Hogs last chance to rally the troops and make a possible run at a bowl while Auburn has been getting too much love after pulling the upset over an overrated A&M tm 2 wks ago. This goes down to the wire.

NEBRASKA by 14 over Northwestern - NW has covered both B10 gms. LTH #9 Nebraska was looking ahead to PSU were upset 28-25 (-17) (NW unranked). LY the crowd was split at NW. Neb was off a loss, with revenge off a bye from the prev yr's game but actually trailed 28-16 mid-4Q thanks to a couple of fmb/d PR's. Neb went 80/10pl and 76/6pl (GW td w/2:08, 2ptng). NW missed a 53 yd FG w/1:10. Neb did have commanding 543-301 yd and 26-14 FD edges. Huskers are 10-3 ATS as a HF while NW is 12-6 ATS as an AD but have lost their L/2 gms in that role. Wildcats are on B2B away and 3rd in 4 weeks while Huskers are off a bye and at Minnesota LW. Both of these tms and these HC's are in desperate need of a win. Neb HC Pelini deserves to feel some heat after LW's 34-23 loss (-10) to Minny while NW after starting the year 4-0 (were on a 14-3 SU/13-3-1 ATS run) has now lost 4 str gms (6 str covers) and peeking ahead to their upcoming sked (Mich/MSU) will have to pull an upset just to make a bowl. Even after the Huskers disappointed us LW, we're not afraid to back them here.

Arkansas St by 1 over SOUTH ALABAMA - LY was their first meeting as ASU won on HC for the 9th time in 10Y. ASU only led 14-13 at HT but opened the 2H with 3 straight td drives (73/5pl, 68/6pl, 65/9pl). USA got a td w/:17 left to only lose 36-29 (+21). ASU is off a bye and went 6-1 as an AF the L2Y despite 2 diff HC's but is 0-1 TY losing 31-7 as a 3' pt fav at Mem under new HC Harsin. The Red Wolves come into this gm failing to cover 6 str gms as they were dominated at home by UL 23-7 (+2') L/Tue. In LW's issue we said Vegas had finally over-compensated for USA's 5 str covers and made them an AF at TXSt. The gm went down to the wire like all of USA's gms as they saw TXSt kick a 42-yd FG w/:04 left to in the 33-31 loss (-1'). It was their 4th loss of the ssn by a comb 11 pts. This week look for the trend to continue.

Over 32 years this play has been a reader favorite hitting 213-159. The last 14 years the Underdog Play of the Week has recorded numerous **OUT-RIGHT UPSET WINNERS (50!)** to the incredible record **INCLUDING 4 TY** including 3 straight outright winners!!!! Here is TW's Underdog Play:

TENNESSEE +12 MISSOURI

The Tigers got their only SEC road win vs the Vols LY. It was a tough loss for UT as they dominated the 1H with a 383-64 yd edge and 20-4 FD edge. MO had an 87 yd KR td and UT missed a 43 yd FG and only led 21-7 at the half. MO got a 77 yd td on the first play of the 2H. MO faced a 4&12 with :47 left and got a 25 yd td pass to force OT. UT was SOD on 4&3 in the 2OT. Tenn is on a 2nd straight away gm and off a loss at Bama 45-10 (+28). The Vols were down 35-0 at HT and went to frosh QB Dobbs in the 2H (Worley inj'd). Getting blown out to your rival who is vastly superior is one thing, however blowing a 17-0 4Q lead at home with huge championship implications is another as the prev unbeaten Tigers lost 27-24 (-2) in 2OT to S Car. While they still control their own destiny in the SEC East, a win over the Gamecocks would have all but assured a trip to Atlanta and you have to wonder what frame of mind they will be. Two wks ago, the Vols beat that same S Car tm who beat MO LW and it wouldn't shock us if they pulled another upset here.

FORECAST: Tennessee by 1 over MISSOURI

UTAH ST by 17 over Hawaii - Last mtg was in '11 as Utah St got their first win on the Island in 4 tries. It was THE game that sparked their transformation into a bowl team. Utah St came in just 2-5 and appeared headed for their 14th consec losing season. Frosh QB Keeton was hurt and bkp QB Kennedy led their largest FBS come-from-behind win s/'01 (trailed 28-7 5:00 into 3Q). The dog is now 4-1 ATS in the series. Warm weather Warriors do have to deal with altitude and the early forecast calls for temps in the mid-40's. They are 0-4 ATS in the 1st gm of staying on the mainland for 2 str wks, failing to cover by 20 ppg. LW it was the same old story for them as they all'd CST to jump out to an early big lead before UH rallied in the 2H in a 35-28 loss (+1'). We did cash a 4★ LPS Totals play on the OVER. UH is now 0-7 on the yr but 4-3 ATS. Meanwhile the Aggies are fresh off a bye and have renewed confidence after beating NM 45-10 (-11) in their L/gm. Look for USt to continue UH's losing ways here but the Warriors can get another cover.

San Jose St by 3 over UNLV - Last mtg was '97. Rebels are now 18-6 1-1 ATS at home under Hauck but SJSt counters that with an 11-2 ATS road mark in MacIntyre's L2Y and Caragher has continued their winning ways at 3-1 ATS outgaining their opp's by 33 ypg despite playing Minny/Stanford. The Spartans have some momentary winners of 3 str gms and QB Fales after struggling for much of the year is now 55-72-913-8-1 in his L/2 gms and had a 5-0 ratio LW in their 51-44 win (-8') over WY as they rallied from a 30-14 3Q deficit getting a Fales td sneak w/:08 left. The Fremont Cannon is changing colors for the 1st time in 9 yrs as UNLV is now just 1 win away from their 1st bowl appearance s/'00 after beating Nevada LW 27-22 (+6'). The star continues to be QB Herring who is avg 263 ypg (68%) w/a 13-1 ratio in the L/6 gms. Both tms are red-hot, both tms have hot QB's and both tms are in their preferred technical roles. Look for this to go down to the wire.

LOUISIANA by 35 over New Mexico St - Ply'd '01-04 as SBC rivals with the dog going 4-0 ATS incl outright upsets the last 2. UL was a large fav 3x LY beating Lamar (-36', 40-0), Tulane (-28, 41-13) and S Ala (-18', 52-30) and TY they have picked up where they left off beating Nicholls St (-26, 70-7) and put the wood to TXSt 48-24 as an 11 pt fav. They are in a sandwich facing 2 of the other top 3 SBC tms on the road (won both in convincing fashion) and now having short week before Troy. NMSt is off a HC win vs FCS transitional Abilene Christian 34-29 snapping their 18-gm losing streak. They did need a game-saving tackle at the 6-yd line to do it, however. This could be the matchup POW (or mismatch of the wk) as UL is avg 269 rush ypg (5.2) their L/5 gms while NMSt is all'g 325 rush ypg (6.9). Look for UL to roll to bowl elig for their 3rd str yr.

Texas St by 3 over IDAHO - LY this was the first WAC game for TXSt and they were -2' at home and finished with 519-315 yd and 25-15 FD edges. In the 1H they led 14-7 despite being SOD at the ID33 and missing a 37 yd FG. They won 38-7 covering by 4 td's. While TXSt is off 2 SBC gms they have a bye on beck. LW they pulled out a 33-31 win (+1') over USA getting a 42-yd FG w/:04 left. They are now just 1 win away from bowl elig but are -53 ypg on the yr. ID is off a 59-14 loss to (+41') to Ole Miss as 3rd string QB Davis was 12-30-166-1-0. St'g QB Chalich and bkp McCain are both ? here. If one of them can go, keep in mind, ID only lost to undefeated N Ill by 10 (+29) and we used them as our Underdog POW on these pages w/a 26-24 win over Temple (+7') earlier TY. The Kibbie Dome is always a dangerous place for new foes.

North Carolina by 1 over NC STATE - We've had our share of tough losses through the years but LY we had a 3★ LPS on NC -7 and this time had one go in our favor. NCSt had won 5 in a row SU/ATS in this series with 4 consec outright upset wins. In fact, the series has had an amazing ELEVEN OUTRIGHT upset wins in the L15Y. UNC HC Fedora had the lockerroom decked out in red and white streamers and balloons with photos of NCSt players celebrating a win during the wk. NC appeared on its way to a route as they led 25-7 in the 2Q but NCSt scored 28 unanswered. NC tied it w/1:24 left on a 34 yd FG, then forced a punt and Bernard ret'd the punt 74 yds for a td w/:19 left. The xp they fumbled the snap but the holder picked it up and threw it for a 2 pt conv and the cover. 43-35. NCSt is off an expected blowout loss at Florida St and this is HC. NC has looked much better in each of their L/2 gms nearly pulling out an upset over Miami and LW they impressed against a physical BC tm 34-10 (-6'). As usual we feel UNC is the better team but are always leery of the underdog Wolf Pack.

TEXAS by 35 over Kansas - Texas has won all 10 as conf foes (8-2 ATS). LY Texas was -19 at KU and was fortunate to escape with the win. They needed a 1 yd td pass with :12 left to go up 21-17. It was played in 41', the first time s/'08 UT has st'd a gm below 50'. KU QB Cummings only att'd 9 passes, the fewest att's s/'92 (3-9-39) but KU rushed for 234 yds. KU's D had 8 consec shutout poss with UT's largest drive in that span being 27 yds. This is Texas' HC and first home game in 6 wks and what a diff 6 wks makes. The Longhorns have now won 4 str gms after LW's 30-7 win (+2') over TCU cashing us not only a 4★ LPS but also a 3★ LPS Totals play on the UNDER despite a 3-hr weather delay. The diff between now and their poor 1-2 start is two-fold. First, the UT ground gm is running on all cylinders and the OL has not all'd a sk in each of the L/2 gms. On the other side, the D is getting better each wk and now has 16 sks the L/4 wks after only having 2 the 1st 3. That's not good news for a KS tm that has all'd 200+ rush yds each of the L/3 wks and has all'd 14 sks the L/4 gms. Look for UT to continue their improbable march towards a B12 champ.

Tulane by 3 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - First meeting. While FAU has been as good as gold as an AD (11 str covers prior to LW's 45-10 loss +24 to Aub), they have been equally as bad as a HF going 0-9 ATS. Meanwhile all Tulane has done this yr is become bowl elig for the 1st time s/'02 before the month of November has st'd. LW they finally broke their long losing streak to Tulsa getting a 14-7 upset win (+3). Now they continue to get no respect as despite being 6-2 SU/ATS TY they are an underdog to a tm that is 2-6 SU and is coached by a Pelini. We have been riding the Wave all year long and have enjoyed 5 outright upset winners...ahem make it 6 here.

Oklahoma St by 1 over TEXAS TECH - The home team is 12-3 SU but OSU has won twice here in the L3Y and has won and covered 4 straight (covered L/3 by 30 ppg). In Lubbock in '11 they won 66-6 with a 637-270 yd edge. LY was the FHG for OSU (-9'). OSU led 35-7 when TT got a td with :15 left in the half to make it 35-14 but OSU extended it to 59-14 in the 4Q with TT getting a td with

TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK..... TULANE REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK.....MICHIGAN ST SITUATIONAL PLAY OF THE WEEK.....ARKANSAS

2:51 left and OSU gave us an EASY LPS covering by 4 td's! LW the Red Raiders were knocked from the ranks of the unbeaten as they lost at OU 38-30 (+6'). After trailing 21-7 in the 3Q, the Red Raiders scored 17 str pts but couldn't hold on in the 4Q. We have been waiting all yr for OSU's offense to appear and LW they got it in gear but it was the ground gm that carried the way w/a ssn high 342 yds in their 58-27 win (-12') over hapless Ist. QB Chelf was only 10-26-78-1-1 but HC Gundy said he would get the start here as he managed the gm well and is an effective runner (85 yds). Tough for us to go against the Pokes here as they have looked so dominant in this series.

East Carolina by 27 over FIU - The Pirates have an obvious weakness and that is when they are overmatched on the LOS as in their 2 losses they have all'd 13 sks while allowing 9 in their other 5 gms. That won't be a problem this week vs a Panthers D which has yet to have 2 sks in any game. EC has a 56/44 run/pass ratio but they still use play action to open the passing lanes and not only does RB Cooper have 513 (4.4), he's an invaluable asset as a receiver with 289 (9.6). FIU only has 2 main faults on defense and that is a front 7 allowing 195 ypg and 5.0 ypc and the other is allowing 68% completions but EC's 7 point win at MT and a loss in their last 2 road games ensures their focus. Vs their 4 conf foes this season the EC defense has dominated allowing 290 ypg and under 16 FD's per game. FIU's L/3 opponents were a combined 5-17 SU, yet FIU was dog in each by an avg of 10 ppg and now they return to a bowl caliber opponent much like the first 3 that beat them by a combined 153-10.

FRESNO ST by 21 over Nevada - LTH the HC's had a combined 41 ssn's under their belt, now they have a combined ONE. Nevada had won 4 in a row SU in the series but Fresno was -3 on the road LY and won 52-36 despite the gm being tied at 21 at HT. The visitor is actually 5-2 ATS (4-3 SU). DeRuyter was 7-0 ATS as a conf fav but is 0-2-1 ATS TY. This is an important game for recruiting as NV has snagged QB Kaepernick, TE Green and RB Jefferson out of the San Joaquin Valley the last few years. The Cardiac Bulldogs are starting to remind us a lot of the 2007 Hawaii Warriors who made it to the Sugar Bowl despite close win after close win. Fresno's mantra all yr as been, jump out to a large lead and then hang on for dear life as LW despite being up 14 pts in the 4Q, they had to pull out a 35-28 win (-7) over SDSU in OT. That makes now 4 wins TY holding on in the final play. On the other side, it will be interesting to see how the Wolf Pack reacts to their 1st loss to their arch rival UNLV in 9 yrs. Bulldogs are clearly the better team but like we write every week, Vegas has caught up to Fresno TY (11-2 ATS LY) as they are 1-5-1 ATS despite their lofty ranking. They get a win but we don't see much value as the line is close to ours.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 16 over Miss St - South Carolina has won 6 str and had covered 5 straight before their last gm '11 (14-12, -3). In the L/4 mtgs SC has held MSU to 247 ypg. This is the Gamecocks HC as they return home from 3 straight SEC road gms (Ark, Ten, Mizzou). They especially QB Shaw should get a rousing welcome as LW they rallied from 17 pts down to undefeated Mizzou in the 4Q and eventually won 27-24 (+2) in 2OT. Shaw was supposed to be out for the gm but asked HC Spurrier if he could play late in the gm and sparked the offense throwing for 201 yds and 3 td's. While the Mizzou still controls its own destiny, SC has any easier conf sked down the stretch and only needs to win their final 2 gms and have MU lose once more. Meanwhile Miss St has not played on the road for SEVEN weeks and only ply'd BG and UK the last 2 wks and greatly disappointed us in both of those gms despite winning them SU. Miss St is 1-7 ATS as an SEC AD and we look for that trend to continue.

Boise St by 4 over COLORADO ST - They met the L2Y which were the first in the series. Taking the average of both gms, CST lost 53-14, got outFD'd 29-11 and was outgained 623-230 but covered LY by a 1/2 pt (+28'). LTH Boise led 35-0 after 20:00 and played their bkps the last 1.5Q's. Boise is on B2B road and are in a unique position of already having 3 losses on the yr (1st time in reg ssn s/'05). LW we easily cashed a Fri Night Marquee game against them as BYU won 37-20 (-7). With QB Southwick probably out for the reg ssn, bkp Hedrick made his 1st career start against a great D and was 25-42-232-1-1 but the Broncos did suffer 4 TO's. CST continues to impress as they have won 4 of their L/6 gms incl LW 35-28 (-1') over Hawaii cashing a 4★ Totals LPS on the OVER. While Boise still has the talent edges, the Rams and the rest of the MW have really closed the gap in the L/2 yrs and look for the Rams to keep this under the number.

SAN DIEGO ST by 21 over New Mexico - How's this for bizarre - Rocky Long has won 11 in a row SU in this series (3 here, 8 NM) BUT is just 1-10 ATS!! This is Long's 1st look at Davie's option but played AF 17 days ago and Long's D are usually among the best vs the option. Long is 4-1 ATS as a conf HF but LW found themselves a conf HD to undefeated Fresno. The Aztecs had 22-20 FD, 507-341 yd and 35-11-24:49 TOP edges and despite rallying from a 14-pt 4Q deficit lost to the Bulldogs 35-28 (+7) in OT as they were -2 TO's. The kicking gm continues to be a huge issue as they missed a 40-yd FG and had a 37-yd FG blk'd on the last play of regulation. Lobos are off a bye but do struggle vs the bigger, stronger, more physical tms and that is what they will be facing here. Long still will put a priority on this vs his old team and we like his D vs the option as in '11 SDSU was -35 at home and while they did not cover (35-7) they did have a 486-162 yd edge over the Lobos.

Tuesday, November 5th
Ohio at BUFFALO - These 2 have met 14 times as MAC foes and Buffalo has only been a fav once (-1', '09). The dog is 5-1 ATS (4 upsets). LY Ohio trailed 14-0 but led 24-14 3Q. After UB tied it at 24 Ohio pulled away 38-24 before a garbage td w/:08 left gave UB the cover (+14). Both tms are red-hot as OU has won 6 of 7 gms (5-1-1 ATS) incl 41-16 (-26) over Miami, Oh in their L/gm while UB has won 6 str gms (5 str covers) incl an easy 3★ LPS over Kent St 41-21 (-1) in their L/gm. Winner here controls their own destiny in the MAC East.

Bowling Green at MIAMI, OH - BG had a 15 yr drought at home vs MU known as the Miami Whammy as MU had won 6 in a row SU/ATS. LY BG ended that jinx with 27-12 FD and 486-256 yd edges in a 37-12 win (-7). BG is 3-1 SU/ATS here with the visitor is 10-4 ATS. Both tms are off losses to their rivals as BG lost a heartbreaker to Toledo 28-25 (-4) while MU lost 41-16 (+26) to Ohio. The Falcons are a much better team but will there be a hangover from the loss to UT?

4★ New Orleans by 17 over NY JETS - Both Ryan brothers deserve a ton of credit for turning around bad teams from 2012 but the Jets have been aided by their schedule. Outside of the injury depleted Patriots the only team they've faced above .500 was CIN LW. The Bengals showed NYJ how they can be exposed in their 49-9 win sending Geno Smith to the bench after he tossed a pair of TD's to Cocker and Jones, who happen to play for CIN. Both teams rank in the top 10 in sks but the only difference is that the Jets are #28 in sacks all'd with a rookie QB lacking confidence after getting pulled while the other side has a 7-time Pro Bowler and 2-time NFL MVP that has already played at NE and CHI getting sacked a total of 3 times. Brees has plans to return to this stadium in February and also played here LY in December in a 52-27 loss that still upsets him. Saints 15-3-1 ATS as a non-div AF under Payton and rookie Stills (3 rec, 43.0, 2 td's) now allows TE's Graham and Watson (comb 6 rec, 13.7, 2 TD's) to roam the middle as opposing D's contend with Colston (324, 13.5) and Sproles (593, 16.0).

3★ Pittsburgh by 1 over NEW ENGLAND - NE's offense is now equal with the pack. The Patriots have finished each of the last 3 seasons outscoring their opponents by double digits. This season they have only beaten one opponent by over 10 points and that was a winless TB team. New England has been OUTGAINED on the season (-16 ypg) and in their last 4 games (-54 ypg), all as a fav, they've been outgained in 3 of them and Brady has thrown for 203 ypg (52%) and a 2-4 ratio!! Looking back at 3 top 10 D's they've already faced you'll see even less production avg 258 ypg and 15 FD/gm. The Steelers are on the road for the third time in 4 weeks and off a West Coast trip but off a SU loss they went 8-0-1 ATS prior to LY's inj plagued season and this years start. Pittsburgh also has played 5 defenses that are in the top #14 and versus the other 2 (CHI & MIN) they've avg'd 448 ypg and 25 FD/gm and NE falls into the bottom half.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ SEATTLE by 26 over Tampa Bay - Being off a loss is tough but travelling to SEA after a loss results in a 3-13 ATS record by a 26-16 avg score. This however is a letdown spot for the Seahawks off a MNF Div game with a road trip to ATL, the team that KO'd them out of the playoffs, on deck. The term letdown, however, never applies to Seattle's defense especially at home. In CenturyLink the Hawks are allowing 12 ppg their L/14 going 11-3 ATS (one L resting starters LY). The Bucs had a few extra days to mull over how pitiful their 0-7 season has been and with Glennon getting sacked 10 times in 4 starts and facing a Seahawks teams avg 3.8 sks/gm the L/6 there will be pressure. While the rookie played at Atlanta (Falcons #25 in sks) the noise will be at a different level and expect the Seattle secondary to improve on their 11 int's which is #3 in the NFL as this gets out of control fast.

OTHER GAMES

Cincinnati at Miami (Thursday Night) - The Bengals look for quick payback after LY's loss (-3, 13-17) as then rookie Tannehill (223, 8.6 ypa, 0-0) came into the game with a 2-6 ratio off B2B OT losses and outplayed Dalton (234, 5.4 ypa, 1-2). Now CIN plays on a short span while traveling for the third time in 4 weeks with a road game at BAL on deck. The Bengals came into this season going 6-0-1 ATS an AF but the dog had covered 5 straight prior to the NY Jets. This is the Dolphins first prime time home game in 2 seasons but can they snap out of a 4 games SU/ATS losing streak?

CAROLINA by 10 over Atlanta - The Panthers are above .500 for the first time in 71 games and are favored for the 1st time since Wk 4 2008 vs ATL. They also have extra rest, are at home vs at team off a bad loss across the country and own the #3 defense. CAR has won the yardage battle in 4 of the L5 games and are +6 FD/+85 ypg/16 ppg in that span albeit all vs losing teams. ATL may not have WR White who has avg'd 8 rec's (15.4) the L3 vs CAR and RB Jackson was woeful LW vs ARZ with 6 yds (0.5). The Falcons have allowed 23 pts or more in each game TY, have allowed 141 ypg rush (5.1) the L4W and Newton rushed for 86 (9.6) and 116 (12.9) vs a better defense LY. Add in the fact the Falcons #20 pass defense is allowing a 115.0 def QBR over the L4W with a 9-1 ratio and the Panthers cruise to their 4th straight win vs a foe ranked 23rd or lower in our NFL Power Ratings.

DALLAS by 13 over Minnesota - DAL is happy to return home after losing in the last seconds at DET. They now host a Vikings team travelling off B2B prime time games with a Thursday Night home game vs WAS on deck. Add in the Vikings fielding a different QB each of the L3W with Ponder starting vs GB LW and you have a huge challenge for a team that's been outgained by 84 ypg on the road and outscored 29-20. Romo has been great at home w/a 271 ypg avg (69%) and 11-3 ratio for a 4-0 ATS record as he faces the #29 pass def w/a 14-7 ratio prior to facing GB and Rodgers Sunday night. The Cowboy's have yet to allow a 100 yd rusher and while their rush D ranks near the bottom their issue has been mobile QB's (159, 8.0). With that not expected to be an issue here the Cowboys rush D is allowing 87 ypg & 4.0 ypc. Yes, the Cowboys are 1-6 ATS as a fav of 7 or more but we're not going to step in the way of their 7-2 ATS run as they've taken to Kiffin's defense well and should be able to handle a tired and potentially reeling Vikings team. Dallas also 3-0 ATS of a SU loss TY covering by 14 ppg and they beat WAS by 15 after losing at DEN 3 Wks ago.

Tennessee by 13 over ST LOUIS - Emotions have to be high for Fisher who looks across the field at a team he took over in 1994 and coached 17 season which was then the Houston Oilers while his current team is the LA Rams. This is also the first game for TEN since the passing of AFL co-founder Bud Adams. Kellen Clemens takes over for the inj'd Bradford and the results are unknown how he handled the Seahawks pressure on Monday night making his first start since gm #16 in '11 and only his 4th since 2009 (0-3 as starter, 182 ypg, 53%). One thing is for sure is that the Rams offense was already struggling avg 299 ypg with an OL allowing 17 sks the L5 gms. Now after facing the physical Seahawks they get a physical #12 defense. The St Louis defense has been serviceable but expect a drop off with the added TOP they'll be on the field with an offense not moving he chains. By looking at TEN's 312 ypg and 3.8 ypc you may give the Rams a chance but the Titans have faced SIX defenses ranked in the TOP 8 and versus the only team outside of it (SD #23) they put up 452 yds and 170 (5.9) rushing. The Titans are only 1-3 ATS as an AF under Munchak but are 3-0 ATS TY away covering vs 3 teams that avg a #13 rank on offense and a #3 rank on D (STL #30 & #22).

Kansas City by 3 over BUFFALO - This is the Chiefs 1st road game in a month and AF's off B2B home games with a bye on deck are 10-1 ATS. BUF is off B2B close losses followed by a game where they were simply outclassed on the road by the Saints as a 4★ **Key Selection LW**. KC held off the Browns but it came at a price as RB Charles (knee) who accounts for a whopping 39% of the offense was dinged up. KC has fully taken advantage of their #32 sked having only faced 1 team (DAL) that is currently ranked in the upper half of our Power Ratings. BUF has only played 1 team in the bottom third of our Power Ratings and this is their 3rd matchup vs a top 10 team in 4 Wks. Their loss to NO isn't really a bad thing as the Saints knew what Marrone was trying to do (he was their OC prior to HC Syracuse) and they simply had more horses than the Bills. A conservative gameplan plays to Buffalo here as they are better than their #26 ranking (#2 sks 58% comp 7.4 ypa) and with Charles status uncertain we'll side with the road team by a FG. Reid is 4-8 ATS prior to a bye.

San Diego at Washington - Have to believe the Skins lobbied hard for a bye today as they haven't won a football game on the Sunday preceding election day in 20 years (1992, Clinton over George H.W.). also stepped up and after totaling 234 yds the first 5 games he's topped 100+ each of the L/2 (4.9 ypc) helping the D stay off the field (26 ppg F/5, 7.5 ppg L/2). In their L/5 non-div away games SD is 4-0-1 ATS pulling 3 upsets. The Skins meanwhile are now 3-9-1 ATS home vs non div with their only covers vs Chicago w/out Cutler LW, in OT covering by 1/2 pt and losing by 7 pts getting 8. Not yet ready to make the Chargers a non-div AF as they are 1-7 ATS vs teams not called Jacksonville so we'll wait on this one for now as we want to see how Griffin's knee fares in practice this week.

OAKLAND by 3 over Philadelphia - College rematch as Pryor's final OSU game was a Rose Bowl win over Kelly in his first season at Oregon. May have to give Philly a "home field edge" as the Eagles are 0-4 SU/ATS at home getting outscored (23-14) and outgained by 45 ypg. Put them on the road they are 3-1 SU/ATS with an avg score of 30-30, incl a 52-20 loss but they are still outgaining foes 439-397. The Pryor transformation is far from a success as the offense is avg just 18 ppg on the season while avg just 288 ypg the L4W but he has led them to 2 wins the last 3 games. He is having a very Tebow-like impact the L2W with a 45.7 QBR vs KC and a 25.7 QBR vs PIT as defenses keep him in the pocket best they can. The eye-popping Raider start is that the OL has allowed 30 sks which is 15.6% of his pass att's despite having a mobile QB. Now both teams have defense that practice against similar systems and while Pryor is healthy, Vick looks to be out again giving Matt Barkley his first start. Vs the Giants LW he finished with 2 TO's, 2 SOD and 3 punts on the day. With that said we'll also back the better defensive squad that has traveled only one week the last 6 vs PHI on a long trip with a 3-12 ATS record off a SU loss having yet to relearn how to bounce back off a loss.

CLEVELAND by 3 over Baltimore - Technical edge to the Ravens who are 5-0 SU/ATS off a bye w/a 28-11 avg score, have beaten CLE 11 straight while covering 5 straight in CLE by 8 ppg. However, a look at the Ravens recently shows they are 1-5 SU & ATS in their L/6 road games and they clearly went into their bye emotionally drained with all 4 games decided by 3 points or less and with BAL losing 3 of them. Cleveland's #7 D was rattled in the 1H as the Browns were outgained 281-130 (FD's 16-3) but they let the offense get back into the game by holding them to 50 yards and 4 FD's in the 2H. The Browns went to Jason Campbell LW and he was exactly what they needed throwing for 293 yds (61%) but more importantly a 2-0 ratio. Now with Campbell making his long awaited first start at home since gm #6 2011 and another week of practice he should stretch the field even more with the receivers adjusting to a third starting QB in their L/4 gms. Flacco has had a wide disparity on his road/home performances hitting only 57% (64% at home) with a 5-8 ratio (3-0 home) while the Browns have picked off a pass in each home game and are allowing only 56% comp in front of the Dog Pound.

Indianapolis at HOUSTON (Sunday Night) - Can't find a series that has been more dominated by the home team than this one. The host has won 6 straight covering each by 11 ppg. Houston returns from their bye and we expect Keenum to get a few more games under his belt. Also how do the Colts adjust their offense with Reggie Wayne out for the year? There are one or two routes for the Texans. They can refocus knowing that if they win here they are 2 games back while having the tiebreaker on both teams ahead or even with them. Or, perhaps they did what the Colts did after just 2 years ago with their QB injury and go from multiple season with DD wins to 2-14 finish.

Chicago at GREEN BAY (Monday Night) - Going into Lambeau is tough enough with a healthy QB but now Josh McCown makes his first road start since Christmas Day 2011 which was also here in GB (Chi +11, 21-35). McCown (204, 70%, 1-0) was also incredibly successful filling in at WAS with 5 full drives scoring 3 TD's, a FG and getting them to the W16 (missed FG) and their bye week couldn't have been placed any better. On the flip side is GB's D (#17) is far from the Skins and the Packers have now covered 7 straight vs NFC North teams at home. Monday Night Magic plays are 4-1 80% at press time and this play is only \$20 on the VIP Debit System or \$30 with a \$back+ guarantee!
