4★ WISCONSIN over Bowling Green - Badgers are 3-0 SU/2-0 ATS vs the Falcons winning 35-14 (-10') in the L/meeting ('06). UW trailed 7-0 and only led 21-14 mid-3Q. After that BG was SOD at the W20 & punted their L/2 drives (UW 2 td drives). BG is 0-2 in Madison incl a 56-42 loss (+1') the LTH ('05). BG led 20-7 after a 63 yd td pass but at HT the gm was tied 35-35. BG all'd B2B2B td drives to open the 2H being outgained 185-1 the first 17:27. LW the Falcons faced off against another Big 10 foe and came out w/a 45-42 (+7') upset win over a pitiful Indiana defense. QB Knapke in just his 2nd career start, set schl records for att (73) and comp (46) as BG ran an amazing 113 plays while notching 39 FD's. It is worth noting however, that their D continues to struggle as they are all'g 567 ypg (just 309 ypg L/2 yrs) and their run D all'd 235 (6.4) LW. That's not good news facing a Wisky tm fresh off a bye (7-0 ATS in reg ssn) w/an avg cover of 3 td's per game in that span! The Badgers also have lowly USF on deck meaning LY's MAC champs will clearly have their attention. Look for them **FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 31** to roll here.

3★ COLORADO over Hawaii - HT is 3-0 all-time. L/gm ('11) CU lost 34-17 (+6'). CU trailed 17-0 but cut the deficit to 7 early 4Q only to have UH score the L/10 pts in a 1:25 span. Last/only time here ('10) UH lost 31-13 (+13'). UH led 10-0 at HT w/a 232-89 yd edge. In the 1st 7:51 of the 2H CU had 80 & 60 yd td drives while forcing a safety. UH did cut it to 4 but all'd a 4Q 73 yd td pass. Hawaii is off a 27-24 win (-3') over N lowa in a game they led 24-10 entering the 4Q. Col is off a 38-24 (+15) loss to Ariz St but the Buffs did manage 28-18 FD and 545-426 yd edges. WR Spruce has been a revelation with 346 (14.4) and 6 td while QB Liufau is avg 279 ypg (64%) w/an 8-3 ratio. While Hawaii already gave 2 Pac-12 tms all they could handle TY (lost to Wash/Oreg St by a combined 9 pts) both of those gms were at home and now the Rainbow Warriors are playing w/o their best offensive (RB losefa) and defensive (LB Garcia-Williams) players and now must travel for the 1st time TY to the elevation where Colorado was 3-0 ATS as a HF LY and need all the wins they can get.

FORECAST: COLORADO by 14 3★ ARKANSAS over Northern Illinois - The only prior meeting between these schls came here in '94, which the Hogs won 30-27 (-21). NIU is 1-9 all-time vs the SEC w/the win coming vs #21 Bama in '03, 19-16 (avg loss by 17 ppg) but they are 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS s/'08 before a reg ssn bye. Talk about streaks. There are number of amazing ones following these 2 tms. After snapping their 10 gm losing streak 2 wks ago, Ark went on the road and ran over TT LW 49-28 (+1). The Hogs had 7 rush td's and commanding 32-20 FD, 499-353 yd & 40:39-19:21 TOP edges. After leading 28-21 at HT, Ark began the 3Q with a 75/13 pl td drive that lasted 7:03! The gm was still a toss up entering the 4Q (35-28) before Ark scored the final 2 td's. This will be NI's 3rd str AG, but they continue to win. After upending NW 2 wks ago, they went to Vegas and beat UNLV 48-34 (-10). They had 35-26 FD & 616-499 yd edges and were up 28-5 3Q, before allowing the Rebels to storm back and tie the gm at 34 mid 4Q, but then scored the gms final 2 td's incl the final one with under 2 min left. The Huskies have won an amazing 17 str in true road gms (14-3 ATS) as well as 26 str reg ssn gms (19-7 ATS). Meanwhile Ark HC Bielema is 25-0 at home vs non-conf opp's incl 4-0 (2-2 ATS) here. 2★ Texas A&M over SMU - A&M is now 4-0 SU/ATS vs SMU winning by an avg of 51-10 with the avg line -20 and A&M having a 230 ypg edge. In the only meeting here, A&M won 48-3 (-10'), LY the Mustangs trailed 42-6 after 3Q's. SMU gained 35% (151) of their yds in the 4Q. Also A&M HC Sumlin was 4-0 SU vs SMU covering the L/3 by 17 ppg. SMU has an interim HC (Tom Mason) as former offensive witzard June Jones quit as the Ponies only pts of the ssn so far came on a Hail Mary pass at the end of the North Texas gm. Their st'g QB Neal Burcham is out for the ssn (elbow) and rFr Kolney Cassel will probably make his 1st start. Pts and QB issues certainly aren't the problem for A&M as they are 3-0 for the first time since 2010 after a so-so 38-10 win (-31') over Rice. QB Hill threw for 300 yds and now has an 11-0 ratio on the ssn (69%). Despite the 28 pt win after the gm HC Sumlin said, "Guys weren't very happy with how they played tonight. The dog has won the L/3 meetings. It's a rare trip to altitude for UVA and they will enter sky high off their conf opening 23-21 (+6') win over L'Ville. The win snapped an 11 gm ACC losing streak & 10 gm losing streak against FBS foes. Their D continues to shine as they held the Cardinals to just 282 yds, their lowest s/12. BYU, meanwhile, is fresh getting 2 extra days to prepare as they are coming off a 33-25 (-17) win over Houston on Thursday. A gm we cashed a Thurs Night marguee on UH as BYU lines have been inflated since the 41-7 win over Texas. The Cougars were up 23-0 2Q before allowing UH back into the gm. They had commanding 32-18 FD & 523-325 yd edges and QB Hill had 160 rush (6.2) to go along with 200 pass yds. While we think the Cougars are the better tm, we love playing on defensive dogs and have FORECAST: BYU by 13 already cashed twice on UVA TY (incl a 4★ LPS vs UCLA in opener).

Auburn at KANSAS ST - One of the best Thurs night matchups of the entire season and KSU announced it as a sellout over 3 months ago. Tigers are 3-0 SU vs the Wildcats incl a 45-32 win in '78, which was last/only time here. In the L/meeting ('07) KSU (+13') led 13-6 w/7:31 3Q. From that point they were outgained 163-45 and on KSU's L/6 drives they punted 4x's and the L/2 ended in TO's (lost 23-13). Rare reg ssn non-conf 'true' AG for the Tigers as they have dropped 5 str to Cuse, USC, GT, WV & Clemson (last win at UVA in '97's opener). Aub comes in with the longest ATS win streak (13) for a Power 5 conf tm in the L/20 yrs and cashed us a 3★ LPS in their 59-13 win (-33) over SJSt 2 wks ago. On the flip side, Bill Snyder is one of the greatest underdog coaches of all-time and dating back to late 2010 has gone 14-2 ATS in the reg ssn as a dog incl 10 outright upsets! However, USF has now won the L/2 SU despite CT having a 327-283 and 356-228 yd edges. LY Conn was in the 1st gm with an interim cch and was starting a true frosh at QB and would lose 13-10 (-4). Not much to like from either tm here technical wise as USF has failed to cover 11 str as a HF while Conn is 3-9 ATS as an AD. Both tms come in at 1-2 with their wins coming against FCS competition and are coming off DD home losses. Which team takes the first step to respectability by grabbing an early conf win? Saturday, September 20th MISSOURI by 10 over Indiana - IU is 6-3-2 vs Mizzou w/LY's 45-28 loss (+2') a series first s/54. The gm was tied 14-14 late 2Q but Mizzou scored the next 24 pts. L/2 trips to Columbia ('88 & '91) the gms ended in ties (28-28 and 27-27). IU is on their 2nd str AG with their Big 10 opener on deck. MO does have SCar on deck (huge gm with SEC East implications) but is playing their 3rd HG in 4 wks. After annihilating BG 42-10 LY and facing a Falcons tm playing w/a bkup QB, the Hoosiers greatly disappointed their backers LW in a 45-42 loss (-7'). The key play of the gm came w/9:04 left and Indy driving up 35-32. Arguably the Hoosiers best player RB Tevin Coleman (437 rush yds, 9.3 ypc in 2 gms TY!) fumbl'd at the BG12. Later on, BG would drive 88/11 pl getting a td pass w/:09 left as the Hoosiers D all'd 571 yds and HC Wilson's seat should be getting warm. On the other side, while Mizzou beat UCF 38-10 (-11), the gm was much closer than the final as UCF had a 22-19 FD and 34:57-25:03 TOP edges but were done in by 4 TO's. QB Maty Mauk is tied for the FBS-lead w/12 td passes and the Tigers D has forced a TO in 47 str gms (longest streak in FBS). While Mizzou has been the more impressive tm, they are only +48 ypg TY and Indy is fully capable of getting a backdoor here. **PENN ST by 28 over Massachusetts** - First meeting. PSU is 12-3 vs MAC tms and they have

covered their L/3 incl a 21-3 win (-14) over Akron 2 wks ago. Penn St is in a sandwich here off the emotional road trip to Rutgers and have Franklin's first B10 HG on deck but UMass does have their 1st home gm at Amherst s/11 on deck. We have been in business in 32 yrs and we can't find too many cch's that have caught as many breaks as Nittany Lions HC Franklin has dating back to his Vandy days. LW the PSU program received a jolt midweek when the NCAA announced their bowl ban and scholarship reduction had been lifted. Then after finding themselves down 10-0 late 3Q on the road in a hostile environment, the Lions rallied for a 13-10 win (-3'). It was their 2nd late come-back win of the yr and it should be noted they benefitted from a +4 TO adv. UMass has not been so fortunate the L/2 wks dropping B2B gms vs Power 5 conf tms by a FG. LW they blew a 31-20 4Q lead and then missed a chipshot FG late while also all'g 2 non-offensive td's in their loss to Vandy. The Dores were starting a true frosh QB. It should be noted that Franklin while at Vandy LY prepped for this UMass squad LY and look for the hometown locals to be extra excited considering this is the first HG since the bowl ban was lifted.

Marshall by 8 over AKRON - From '97-'04 these schools were MAC East rivals. Home team is 10-2 SU all-time. UA won 31-28 (+9) in the L/gm ('04). The Herd actually led 28-7 in the 2H but all'd 24 unanswered in the final 18 min. Huge sked edge to the Zips here as they are off a bye while the Herd are coming off their rival Ohio who they desperately wanted to beat. It definitely showed LW as after 3 str losses to the Bobcats MU raced out to a 41-0 3Q lead and won 44-14 (-20') while piling up an impressive 705-377 yd edge. The Herd are now +297 ypg on the yr (#5) but are clearly a diff tm on the road as they are now 1-9-1 ATS as an AF under Holliday and was outFD'd at Miami, Oh earlier TY (a tm that's lost 19 str FBS gms). Akron is 1-1 SU/ATS and prior to the bye lost 21-3 (+14) to PSU. QB Pohl does have a 4-0 ratio and actually leads the tm in rushing w/56 as the Zips are avg just 93 ypg (3.4) while MU is all'g just 102 (2.9). The Herd are clearly the better tm but it's tough backing hem at any pt on the road and especially this wk considering the situation.

PITTSBURGH by 7 over lowa - Third meeting s/'53. Pitt lost the L/gm ('11) 31-27 (+3). Pitt led 27-10 w/12:09 left but all'd a td w/2:51 left. LTH ('08) Iowa lost 21-20 (E). ŬI led 17-14 into the 4Q but down 1 was forced to punt 2x's & fumbled (UI20) on their L/3 drives. The Panthers are 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS for the 1st time s/'09. LW in a flat spot and in their largest AF role s/'89, they found themselves down 16-0 after 1Q vs FIU. They would dominate the gm from that pt forward and finished w/a 422-293 yd edge incl a 321-57 rush yd adv. The story has been their ground gm led by RB James Conner who now has 544 rushing yds, breaking Tony Dorsett's schl record for most rush yds in the 1st 3 gms of a ssn. Overall, the Panthers have dominated the LOS w/an incredible 1,033-232 rush yd edge thru 3 gms. Iowa is usually a tm that controls the LOS and while they are all'g just 66 rush ypg (2.3), they shockingly are avg just 131 ypg (3.6) on offense (180 LY) and are now 0-3 ATS TY after a 20-17 loss (-13) to in-state rival ISt LW (we're outgained 337-275). It doesn't help that tms can stack the LOS as the Hawks don't have a deep-threat (avg just 9 yds per comp, #122). Thru 3 gms Pitt clearly looks like the superior tm here, but keep in mind lowa tms under Ferentz usually fare better when not much is expected of them and after being a DD fav in each of their 1st 3 gms, they now find themselves a dod

TOLEDO by 8 over Ball St - It's been a topsy-turvy series as BS won 3 in a row both SU/ATS from '06-'08 then UT won 3 in a row (2-1 ATS) from '09-'11. BS has now won the L/2 SU/ATS. LY UT down 24-17 went 34/6 for a td to tie it w/6:20 left but BS went 71/8 for a td w/3:01 left and the win. Visitor is 5-1 ATS and 4 of L/5 have been decided by exactly 7 pts. LTH UT (-6') led 27-24 and BS tied it w/9:41 left. UT had the ball and fmbl'd at the BS14 and BS went 86/11 for a td and the win. After blowing a 4Q lead vs lowa 2 wks ago, the Cardinals were upset by Indiana St LW 27-20 (-20). UT, meanwhile is off a 58-34 loss (+10) to Cincy as they fell behind 34-0 in the 2Q before shockingly cutting it to 41-34 early 4Q. QB Woodside who lost a close battle to Phillip Ely (OFY) in fall camp was 27-40-322-3-0 but the UT pass D has all'd 11 pass td's in the L/2 wks. Tough to lay DD's here in a series that has been so back and forth.

Maryland by 1 over SYRACUSE - SU has now won 5 in a row SU in this series with MD's last win back in the 1985 Cherry Bowl. However, only 1 of those matchups came in the last 17 yrs and MD's last trip here was 1994. Ironically, these two met as conf foes LY. MD was at home but came in banged up w/o their top 2 WR's. MD missed a 42 yd fg and was int'd in the EZ in the 1H. MD fumbled at their own 38 with :58 left in the half and SU got a 37 yd FG to lead 10-0. SU did have a 382-292 yd edge for the gm and won 20-3 (+5). After struggling vs an FCS tm in wk 1 (beat Nova 27-26 2OT), the Orange were impressive in LW's 40-3 win (-4') over CM. A big reason for the blowout was the return of QB Hunt (missed 2H of Nova after throwing a punch) as he ran for 3 td's. Also playing a part was the diff in 3rd Dn conv as Cuse were 8-15 while CM was 1-10. LW MD found themselves down 28-6 in the 2Q but rallied thanks to several big plays to tie it at 37. However, WV hit a 47-yd FG on the final play to win 40-37 (-3). The Terps were outFD'd 33-16 and outgained 694-447. Will the Big Ten notch just win #2 this year over a Power 5 non-conf tm?

OHIO by 10 over Idaho - They split the only previous mtg's in '72 & '76. In the L/3 trips to MAC opps Idaho has upset NIU, beat WM & lost to BG by 8. The Bobcats are 9-2 SU s/03 in Athens openers incl 4 str wins (3-1 ATS) by 21 ppg. OU is a perfect 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS the L4Y hosting non-conf foes. The Bobcats are coming off a 44-14 (+20') loss to Marshall as they were outgained 705-377. After struggling big time vs UK (0-6), Derrius Vick got the start and was 18-29-200-1-1 but clearly the Bobcats miss QB Tettleton and RB Blakenship. After a solid wk 1 performance at ULM, we thought ID was ready to take the next step in Yr 2 under HC Petrino at home but we clearly were wrong as they lost to WM 45-33 (-2'). One bright spot continues to be the play of QB Linehan who is avg 343 pass ypg (61%) w/a 6-3 ratio but the D is all'g 509 ypg. Gotta think after 3 str AG's that the Bobcats will be happy to be home in front of the locals but beware of the backdoor with these Vandals.

KANSAS by 4 over Central Michigan - In the only prior gm with the Chippewas, Kansas won 52-7 (-7') in 2007. However, that was the year the Jayhawks went to the Orange Bowl and their program hasn't been the same since. KU is 28-2 SU in HG's vs non-conf opp's but have failed to cover each of their L/5 and only beat FCS SEMO by 6. LW Charlie Weis thought his Jayhawks matched up well with Duke, but we have learned dating back to his days at ND, when "Mr. Schematic Advantage" makes such claims, it's best to go in the opposite direction as the Blue Devils rolled them 41-3 (+14) as the Jayhawks were outgained 511-297 cashing us a 3★ LPS on the UNDER. Speaking of getting rolled, CM after a 38-17 win over Purdue, was buried by Syracuse at home 40-3 (+4') LW. The key play of the gm occurred in the 2Q withe gm tied at 3. The Cuse got a ? fumble ret for a TD after it looked like CM QB Rush's arm was going forward. It also was disconcerting to see UM trans RB Rawls who was off B2B 100-yd gms to be a late scratch (elig ?). Tough to "Rock Chalk" with these Jayhawks but CM did disappoint us LW and they could be playing w/o RB Rawls and WR Davis again this week.

GEORGIA by 31 over Troy - In the only prior gm (*07), UGA won 44-34 (-15) but was outgained. UGA trailed 10-7 into the 2Q and only led 34-27 w/12:54 left. Gm was not decided until mid-4Q as Troy got a td w/:05. In the L4Y vs BCS tms Troy tied Duke (3Q), led Tenn 48-41 (4Q) & led Clemson (16-13) & Okla St (27-20) at HT. However, that was a Troy tm that had Corey Robinson (SBC's all-time pass leader) and TY they clearly are not as good as recent additions. So far they are 0-3 and LW were beaten by Abilene Christian 38-35 (-14'). QB's Brandon Silvers and Dontreal Pruitt have combined for just 1 td pass while leading rusher Branddon Burks only has 104 yds (3.9). Offensive production isn't a problem for UGA as they are avg 40 ppg and 434 ypg despite facing Clemson and SCar so far TY. The problem LW was their defense all'g 447 yds and 38 pts, their reliable K missing 2 chip-shot FG's (had made an SEC record 20 str), and some ? goal-line play-calling along with a few home-cooking calls from the officials in their 38-35 loss (-6') that made the SEC East race wide open. While UGA clearly has the significant talent edges, it should be noted they have Tenn on deck and "Religious Richt" is just 1-6 ATS as a 20+ pt fav.

DUKE by 20 over Tulane - These two have one recent meeting. In 2011 Tulane had just upset UAB on the road and had to travel to Durham the next week. Duke jumped out to a 31-10 lead at the half with a 334-128 yard edge and TU's only TD was on an IR return. Duke led 48-13 before allowing a couple of late TD's in their 48-27 (-10) home win. Tulane played one of the FCS's best teams LW and they beat SEL 35-20 (-2) thanks to QB Tanner Lee who missed a couple of pract LW (inj) but came on to throw 3 td passes. It was their 1st win ever in their new stad after losing their home opener to another ACC tm GT 38-21 (+10). The Blue Devils are 3-0 for the 1st time s/'94 after LW's 41-3 (-14) beat down of Kansas. The star was frosh Shaun Wilson who ran for a schl-rec 245 yds (20.4!) incl 3 long td's. Their QB Boone also has a perfect 7-0 ratio. Duke does have their ACC opener on deck vs Miami, Fl but we can't overlook their 9-0 SU/8-1 ATS home record vs non conf tms and look for them to continue their winning ways here.

North Carolina by 3 over EAST CAROLINA - NC is 6-2 SU/ATS in this series. This is a great situation

for NC. They are playing with legitimate revenge. After getting thrashed by EC LY 55-31 (-12') and outgained 603-465, they only had Liberty and SDSt to open and are fresh off a bye. EC just ply'd SC and VT and are in their 3rd tough game in a row. The schools' are also just 110 miles apart so NC should be well represented crowd wise and won their last trip here in '11, 35-20 (-6'). The Heels are 2-0 SU but are 0-2 ATS and were nearly upset in their L/gm beating the Aztecs 31-27 (-15') as they benefitted from a 100-yd IR td and then int'd SDSt again in the EZ in the closing seconds. Speaking of last second wins, EC LW jumped out to a 21-0 lead vs VT but had to get a td w/:16 left to win 28-21 (+9) marking their 1st win over a ranked tm on the road s/96. QB Carden threw for 427 yds (18.6 ypc) vs one of the nation's best secondaries and now will face a NC secondary that all'd 341 pass yds to the very avg Quinn Kaehler. Tough to make NC a favorite here after what we saw in this gm LY. However, we love the situation with EC off a big win and we saw how those tms off big wk 2 wins (USC, VT, ND, Oreg) did LW (0-4 ATS, all failing to cover by DD's). Heels get revenge

MINNESOTA by 10 over San Jose St - LY UM won 43-24 (-3') but was outgained 486-424. UM did have a 353-47 rush edge and a 41:07-18:53 TOP edge. SJSt QB David Fales threw for 439 and the Spartans had a 329-239 yd edge at HT but trailed 20-17. The Gophers wore them down in the 2H going 75/9, 46/11, 58/9 for td's to lead 43-19 before SJSt got a 75 yd td drive w/5:37 left. TY the situation may favor the Spartans who come in off a bye after their 59-13 loss (+33) to Aub cashing us a 3★ LPS. However, they played that gm w/o their top 2 RB's (Lawson & Tucker) who HC Caragher calls "Thunder Edwever, mey played that grif w/o trien top 2 hbs (Lawson a toucher) with the Stategins Sale Manual & Lightning". Both will be back here. Minny is in a TCU/Mich sandwich and were outgained by both E Ill and MT at home earlier TY. LW they were dominated by TCU 30-7 (+16°) cashing us a 2★ selection. on these pages as they were outgained 427-268. Minny's st'g QB Leidner left the gm in the 4Q (CS) and he was pretty much ineffective prior going 12-26-151 with 3 int's and a fumble. While Minny's likes to play bully with their size edge over inferior tms (OL outweighs SJSt DL by 40 lbs per man), the Spartans situation edge and 9-4 ATS mark as an AD makes them the call.

MICHIGAN by 6 over Utah - Both prior gms have taken place s/'02. The L/gm (Rich Rod's debut in '08) UM lost 25-23 (-3). UM trailed 25-10 into the 4Q and cut the deficit to 2 w/6:26 left but their L/3 drives ended in 2 punts & a SOD. Utah was in the midst of a 13-0 ssn. TY the Utes come in off a bye at 2-0 SU/ATS outscoring their 2 fees by 37 ppg (+220 ypg). QB Wilson has a perfect 6-0 ratio while the offense is also avg 248 rush ypg (5.0) under new coord Dave Christensen. UM rebounded off the 31-0 loss to ND (still outgained Irish 289-280) LW by beating Miami, Oh 34-10 (-32). The Wolves got their run gm back on track with 276 yds (6.1) as they outgained the Redhawks 460-198 and outFD'd them 23-8. TO's are still an issue and they are -7 (next to last in FBS). The D, however, is all'g just 253 total ypg (#7) and just 80 rush ypg (2.6). Hoke is 21-2 SU at home while the Utes are 2-9 SU/3-8 ATS away from home the L/2 yrs and are making their first road trip of ssn.

MICHIGAN ST by 49 over Eastern Michigan - Michigan St is 9-0 SU vs E Michigan w/the avg score 36-7. In the L/gm ('12), MSU trailed 7-3 at HT and only led 9-7 into the 4Q despite the Spartans 21-8 FD and 428-183 yd edges. They would win 23-7 (-32) but that was a MSU tm that struggled mightily on offense (avg'd just 20 ppg). The Spartans come in off a bye after their 46-27 loss (+13) to Oregon. The final score is a bit misleading as the Ducks scored the last 28 pts and only outgained the Spartans by 25 yds. The Eagles, on the other hand, are 1-2 and are off a 17-3 loss (+19) loss to ODU. One of the more remarkable stats of the ssn is the Eagles feeble passing attack that is avg just 72 ypg, 5.5 ypc and just 2.9 ypa, which is nearly 3 yds less than the #127 tm in the FBS. When you score just 3 pts against one of the worst D's in CFB that their own fans label themselves as "No D U", how do you think they will fare vs a Top 10 defense? The only question here is not if the Eagles can keep it close but if there offense can outscore the Mich St defense as the Spartans are off a loss and a bye and are itching to show that they are still worthy of Top 10 consideration.

South Carolina by 27 over VANDERBILT - SC LY came in off a loss vs UGA and expected to be in

a letdown spot but off a loss they were angry. They went 42/6, 98/11, 76/8, 92/8 all for td's to lead 28-0 5:00 into the 2Q. SC finished the game with a 579-268 yd edge and 31-14 FD edge but VU actually got the backdoor cover. SC has now won 5 in a row SU in the series and is 12-2 since 2000 but VU is 8-3 ATS and the visitor is 8-3 ATS. LTH was the opening gm of the season on a Thur night and SC barely escaped with a 17-13 win (-6'). TY SC is in a UGA/MO sandwich and it is their first road gm. LW HC Spurrier continued his mastery over UGA dating back to his days at Florida as they upset the Bulldogs 38-35 (+6'). They were aided by 2 missed FG's by UGA's usually reliable K, some ? play-calling and a couple of favorable calls in the final minutes. Still it was shocking to see their offense go thru UGA's D like a hot knife thru butter with 27 FD's and 447 yds. Vandy has been downright terrible under 1st yr HC Derek Mason and last wk they needed a late comeback win over lowly UMass 34-31 (-16'). He st'd true frosh Wade Freeback (1-2-3-0-1). Still the Dores had 2 non-offensive td's, were outgained 342-310 and UMass missed a chipshot FG in the final seconds. Even in a clear flat spot, look for the Gamecocks to roll.

WYOMING by 6 over Florida Atlantic - In '09 FAU lost at home 30-28 as a 3.5 pt HF (only prior gm). Owls led 7-0, 14-7 and 28-24 w/under 10 mins to play. FAU was forced to punt & all'd a 91/12pl drive & 15 yd td run. On the next poss their 4th&3 pass fell inc (W47) w/1:56. A great situation here for the

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Pokes. Sea level FAU is in their 3rd AG in 4 wks, off a dominating 50-21 win (E) over Tulsa and now have to travel to the cold (had snow LW in WY) and altitude. Wyoming cashed for us a 3★ LPS LW as they caught Oreg off their huge gm vs MSU. They still got beat 48-14 (+43) but did only get outgained 556-439 and led 7-0 after 1Q. They are a perfect 3-0 ATS under new HC Craig Bohl but his 26-gm win streak as a HC dating back to his days at NDSt is now over. Bohl said he will use the elevation to his adv TY and wear tms out in the 4Q with their ground gm. Look for the Pokes to make it 4-0 ATS under Bohl. MEMPHIS by 7 over Middle Tennessee - These 2 instate rivals are still 232 miles apart. The HT is 4-2 SU but 2-4 ATS and MT is 5-1 SU but has failed to cover 3 of their L/4. LY Mem led 15-14 with

MT getting a 40 yd fg w/1:49 left to pull out the 17-15 (-9) win. Memp had a 350-284 yd edge. LTH MT trailed 10-7 early but took control and led 41-17 late 3Q and 48-23 before Memp got a td w/1:20 left to "only" lose 48-30 (+4). MT is on their 2nd road game in 3 wks and are off a 50-47 3OT win (-1') over their rival WKU. They were outgained in the gm 718-541 but are now 3-0 ATS on the ssn. They do feature a powerful run gm avg 247 ypg (4.9) and already has 4 players w/more than a 100 yds. Memphis has the situational edge as they come in off a bye after their near shocking upset of UCLA 42-35 (+23). Look for a lot of pts as both offenses are avg 40+ ppg and 500+ ypg but Memp D edge (#52-97) proves to be the difference.

WASHINGTON by 38 over Georgia St - First mtg and first trip west of Texas for this young GSt program. The Panthers have played 3 Power 5 tms in their short history going 0-4 SU (Tenn, WV & Bama 2x) losing by an avg score of 50-8 (outgained 529-206) but are 3-1 ATS. The Panthers are off a 48-38 loss (+12) to AF, a gm they trailed by as many as 21 pts in the 4Q. After 2 so-so performances vs Hawaii and EW, the Huskies finally won and covered vs Illinois LW 44-19 (-13) as LB Shaq Washington had 2 return td's. The offense is completely diff w/Cyler Miles at QB as they have avg'd 52 ppg and 500 ypg the L/2 wks after a rough opener vs Hawaii (Miles suspd). While the Huskies have the huge edges here, they do have a huge HG vs Stanford on deck and it's tough laying too many pts especially w/Ga St avg 524 ypg, 36 ppg and QB Arbuckle #5 in the nation avg 382 pass ypg. SOUTHERN MISS By 7 over Appalachian St - SM beat App St 7-0 in 1937's Doll and Toy Charity

SOUTHERN MISS By 7 over Appalachian St - SM beat App St 7-0 in 1937's Doll and loy Charity gm (only prior mtg). The Mountaineers have the situational edge here coming in off a bye as they are 1-1 SU/ATS defeating FCS featherweight Campbell 66-0 (+37) in their L/gm after getting trounced by Michigan 52-14 (+32) in the opener. Meanwhile the Golden Eagles are off bruising Bama. The Tide rolled to a 52-12 (+46') win as the Eagles were outFD'd 31-13 and outgained 547-263. Their run defense has been gashed TY as they are all'g 276 rush ypg (6.6) and even allowed 295 rush yds (9.2) to FCS Alcorn St. That's not good news facing an App St offense that had 145 career starts back on the OL coming into TY (most in FBS) and is avg 223 rush ypg (5.4) incl a very respectable 153 (4.3) vs Michigan. However, they need all the wins they can get after going 1-23 the L/2 yrs and actually have a shot at winning their 3rd gm in the L/4 after lossing 23 str.

Georgia Southern at SOUTH ALABAMA - First mtg. The Jaguars treated LW's home gm vs Miss St as their Super Bowl as they had their 1st sellout crowd in the history of their program but all of that hype was squashed after the Bulldogs ran them over in the 35-3 loss (+13') as they were outrushed 288-57. Ga Southern, on the other hand continues to impress us each wk despite their 1-2 record as they are a perfect 3-0 ATS and have nearly pulled off upsets over the likes of NC State and Ga Tech. LW they deserved much better as after rallying from a 35-10 deficit, they led 38-35 and were driving when bkp QB Upshaw (st'r Ellison hurt) had the gm's only TO on an errant option pitch (? call as it looked like it was going forward). GT would then hit a td pass w/:23 left for the 38-35 win (+17). Their rush offense is avg 376 ypg (7.4) and they threw for 245 yds LW. Tough to side w/a tm here as we wonder what their mindset will be in this gm coming off emotional gms and will also have to check the injury report on Ellison later in the wk. **NAVY by 7 over Rutgers** - The HT is 7-1 SU s/01 incl 3 str wins. In the L/gm ('11) Navy lost 21-20 (+3'). Navy blew a DD 2H lead and down one had a 34 yd fg blk'd w/4:43 left. Navy has won 6 str home openers but 5 were vs FCS tms. This is Navy's home opener and they went 4-1 ATS at home LY. If you told us before LW's gm that we would be getting DD pts at home off a bye with time to prep for the option vs a Navy tm on their 3rd str AG and QB Keenan Reynolds (knee) would be a late scratch, Texas St might have been in the mix for our GOM, but in the end, Navy proved to us that this is clearly HC Niumatalolo's best fm yet as they won 35-21 (-10). However, the Bobcats did have a 23-17 FD edge and were only outgained 469-442 although it was 28-0 in the 2Q. It will be interesting to see if Reynolds will be back here but his replacement Tago Smith (former RB) was 5-7-117-2-1 and also added 85 rush yds and 2 td's. The Scarlet Knights are off their "GOY", a 13-10 loss (+3') as they blew a 10 pt 2H lead as 5 TO's did them in. Will be interesting to see what their mindset will be here and we'll just call for the HT by 7 here and watch the injury report on Reynolds later in the wk.

ALABAMA By 16 over Florida - The Tide have won 22 str SEC openers dating back to 1992 and have covered 7 of their L/10. In the L/meeting ('11) #3 UA beat #12 UF 38-10 (-4). The gm was tied 10-10 after 1Q but UA limited UF to just 114 yds & 6 FD the L3Q. Florida has lost 3 str by 24 ppg incl the last time the Crimson Tide were a dog (2009 SEC Champ gm, 58 gms ago). Gators last win in Tuscaloosa was in '98. LTH ('10) UF lost 31-6 (+8'). UF trailed 24-0 late 2Q and for the gm had a 281-273 yd edge but 4 TO's turned into 21 UA pts. The Crimson Tide come in at 3-0 but are 1-2 ATS due to inflated lines. LW they beat SMiss 52-12 (-45') as WR Cooper continues to be the star w/3 str 100-yd efforts. UF is 2-0 but had to hang on for dear life over UK LW 36-30 (-18') in 3OT. WR Demarcus Robinson could be the SEC's breakout POY as he had 216 yds (14.4) and caught a td pass on 4&gl in the 1st OT. There could have been a little bit of a look ahead here as they had come into the UK gm as large favorites and have now won 28 str gms over the Wildcats. Bama QB Sims looks like he is the st'r for now but he has yet to face an elite (even good) defense and his limited talent ability could be exposed a bit here as we'll call this one near the line.

HOUSTON by 28 over Univ - This game was added because UH originally had 2 FCS tms on their sked, but then dropped them in favor of UNLV (paid the Rebs \$\$\$). UNLV at the time was ineligible for a bowl (low APR) and could add a 13th game because they were playing at Hawaii. However, later in the summer they were deemed bowl eligible and now have to win 7 gms. Now that we got all that settled, this matchup involves two 1-2 tms but that is where the similarities end as UH is just -5 ypg vs our #65 sked while UNLV is -176 ypg vs our #71 sked and barely beat an FCS tm. LW UNLV was at home vs a NIU team off a huge upset win and travelling again but still lost 48-34 (+10). After trailing 28-5 in the 3Q, they rallied to tie it at 34 before all'g the gm's final 14 pts. UH meanwhile, rallied themselves after being down 23-0 to BYU LW only losing 33-25 (+17') cashing us our Thurs Nite Marquee. The Rebs were on a 0-20 SU away run but did go 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS LY. However, they failed to cover by 23.5 pts in their first AG TY and you can bet UH at 1-2 won't be looking past them here as they need wins and were already upset at home in the opener.

VIRGINIA TECH by 11 over Georgia Tech - Hokies are 6-1 SU incl 4 str wins by 7 ppg. VT and Bud Foster do extremely well vs GT and in the L2Y they have all'd GT's vaunted rush attack just 96 (2.7) and 55 (2.0) yds rushing. The underdog is 7-1 ATS and there have been 4 outright upsets the L8Y. LY VT (+7) on the road led 14-3 at the half and controlled the game in a 17-10 "upset." LTH the gm was tied 7-7 into the 4Q and after GT went 72/13pl and got a td to lead 17-14 w/:44 left. VT hit a 41 yd fg as time exp'd. In OT after an int, VT hit a GW 17 yd fg. After one of their biggest wins in schl hist, the Hokies despite having a raucous home crowd, slept walked thru the 1st 20 min of the EC gm LW and fell behind 21-0. They rallied to tie it at 21 but the Pirates scored a td w/:16 left for the 28-21 upset. It was shocking that VT's vaunted pass D allowed 427 yds passing but they won't have to worry about that too much here vs the GT option. The Yellow Jackets were nearly upset LW as after blowing a 35-10 lead, they found themselves down 38-35 to Ga Southern and had to recover an errant option pitch to set up their GW td in the final seconds. With VT only having W Mich on deck, look for them to play angry off their loss as they notch their 5th straight win over GT here.

16 years the Underdog Play of the Week has recorded numerous OUTRIGHT

ARMY +2' over Wake Forest

Grobe did a good job vs Army as WF went a perfect 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in his tenure. In fact, WF has won 7 in a row SU in this series. LY WF rushed for 228 you on 45 carries holding Army to a respect able 271 yds. Army led 11-10 but WF went 54/11, 75/5, 62/9 for td's to win 25-11 (-2'). LTH WF won 49-37 (-7'). WF led 42-30 and up 42-37 got the cover with a 68/9 drive with a td 2:50 left. Obviously TY there will be some different dynamics as both tms have new HC's. Army is off a game vs a physic cal Stanford team and traveling a 2nd str wk. LW they had their chances for a cover but 2 key plays happened spread wise. 1st Army fumbled at their own 15 in the final min of the 1H and Stanford got a td. At the end of the gm Army had a 4&1 at the Stanford 2 and were SOD in their 35-0 loss (+28) On the flip side, WF found itself down 29-7 at HT LW and were outgained 391-232 but somehow covered losing 36-24 (+14') to a Utah St tm that had QB Chuckie Keeton on the sidelines in the 2H. Tough to make Army a fav on Power 5 road (1st time s/97) but it is deserved and we grab some extra value considering LW's misleading finals. FORECAST: Army by 3

Oregon by 27 over WASHINGTON ST - WSU pulled an upset at home in '06, but since then, the Ducks have won 7 in a row SU. However, WSU had covered the last 4 as dogs of 35.5, 35, 30.5, 39.5 losing by an avg of 20.8 ppg. LY UO jumped out to a 62-24 lead in the 4Q but Connor Halliday hit 58 of a remarkable 89 passes setting a P12 record for att's and comp but had 4 int's. He led two 4Q garbage td drives incl one with :11 left. This year's line is much more reasonable as it comes as kind of a shock to us considering the fact Oregon has looked so impressive in their 3-0 start while the Cougars are 1-2 SU (beat FCS Portland St 59-21, -23) and have losses to the likes of Rutgers and Nevada, two solid but very avg tms when compared to ÚO. LW we cashed a 3★ LPS going against the Ducks off their big win over MSU and while they won 48-14, they failed to cover the ridiculous 43-pt spread. This is the Ducks first road game of the yr but they only had WY LW and have a bye on deck and should cruise here with the clincher being their 11-2 ATS run as an AF.

FLORIDA ST by 28 over Člemson - Both teams come in off a bye. LY CU had one of its biggest HG's ever and despite being #3 and FSU #5, CU was a home dog. The linesmakers knew what they were talking about as FSU dominated with a 565-326 yd edge and Jamies Winston stepped to the forefront in the Heisman Trophy race hitting 22-34-444. FSU led 27-7 at the half with a 312-141 yd edge and led 51-7 before bkp QB Stoudt led a 71/16 pl drive for a garbage td with :13 left. Despite that home loss LY, CU is 5-4 SU and 7-2 ATS in this series but the HT is 10-2 SU/8-4 ATS. While the Seminoles have failed to cover their 1st 2 gms of the ssn by a combined 46 points, we fully anticipated a sluggish effort out of them vs The Citadel's option as we cashed a 3★ Small College play against them in their 37-12 win (-58'). Winston has forced the issue a bit with just a 3-2 ratio but is still comp 70% of his passes. Clemson's struggles vs a UGA D in the 2H of their opener (1 FD, 15 yds) now look that much more feeble considering what SCar did to that UGA defense LW. This again is not the place for inexp'd QB's (Stoudt and Watson) to be making their 2nd significant road appearance vs an angry Noles defense. The Noles need to make a statement for the first time TY as tms like Oreg and Oklahoma have stolen a bit of their spotlight and we look for them to do so here.

ILLINOIS by 10 over Texas St - First meeting. Illinois is coming off their 1st loss of the ssn, 44-19 (+13') at Wash that saw them down 38-12 at HT. They were outgained 465-351 incl 246-72 rush & outFD'd 26-15 and have their conf opener at Neb on deck. Despite coming off an FCS win, a bye with extra time to prepare for the option and going against a backup QB, TXSt started slow out of the gate as they were down 28-0 2Q to Navy. They ended up with a 23-17 FD edge and were slightly outgained 469-442 in the 35-21 (+10) loss. This is the 1st of B2B road trips for the Bobcats as they travel to Tulsa next wk. After 2 wins to open the ssn TY, Illinois is now 18-2 SU/8-11 ATS (1 NL) the L7Y hosting nonconf opposition, while TXSt is a perfect 4-0 ATS in non-conf AG's s/joining the FBS in 2012 and we're not afraid to back them for the 2nd straight wk even after disappointing us LW.

RICE by 7 over Old Dominion - First meeting. This will mark the inaugural CUSA gm for the Monarchs and the last time they pl'd a conf gm was in '12 as a FCS CAA member (13-3 overall in conf play in 2011-'12). OD extended a 7-0 HT lead into a 17-3 (-17) win over EM LW as they had 16-14 FD & 367-215 yd edges. They held EM to just 215 ttl yds easily their best effort since joining the FBS LY. Even FCS member Hampton was able to gain over 400 yds of offense against them in the opener. Rice is off a 38-10 (+31') loss at Tx A&M. The Owls were down 21-7 at HT but did finish the gm with 28-23 FD & 481-477 yd edges. This will be Rice's home opener, where they are just 3-6 the L9Y (4-4 ATS, 1 gm NL) with the avg

win by 13 ppg (avg loss 15 ppg). Tough to lay too many pts vs the always dangerous ODU offense. Louisville by 24 over FIU - While this is a home gm for FIU, UL has 23 players hailing from South Florida. UL found themselves down 20-7 4Q LW at VA before taking a 21-20 lead, only to give up the GW FG w/3:42 left. While UL had a 17-13 FD edge, the yds were nearly even 285-282 in favor of VA. After taking an early 16-0 lead LW vs Pitt, FIU all'd 26 str pts and went on to lose 42-25 (+26). They were outFD'd 21-17 & outgained 422-293 incl 321-57 on the ground. Despite the distance and non-conf affiliation, this is the 4th str ssn they are meeting. LY 4 of UL's 8 1H poss st'd at midfield or in FIU terr & the gm was so lopsided that they went to a running clock in the 4Q as UL won 72-0 (-42). UL finished with a 464-27 yd edge as FIU had a grand total of 2 FD's. UL is in an ACC sandwich and are 0-4-1 ATS as a DD fav.

CINCINNATI by 24 over Miami, Oh - The Rivalry for the Victory Bell is the longest running non-conf series in the country. This will be the 119th gm & it's been ply'd every ssn s/1909 except 43 & 44 (WWII) as these schis are just 36 miles apart. Despite being the last FBS schi to play a gm (B2B byes to open the ssn) UC showed no rust early on opening up a 34-0 2Q lead before allowing Toledo to go on a 34-7 run. The Bearcats closed out the gm by scoring the final 17 pts to win 58-34 (-11). ND trans OB Kiel had a remarkable debut tying the schl rec w/6 td passes (Tony Pike '09) finishing 25-37-418 (6-0 ratio). UC finished with extremely slim 28-27 FD & 584-563 yd edges. Miami is coming off a 34-10 (+30) loss to Mich. They were tied at 10 2Q, but Mich went on to score the final 24 pts and the Redhawks were held to just 198 ttl yds with 8 FD's. UC has won 8 in a row SU (6-2 ATS) in this series with UC +150 ypg. Prior to LY's 14-0 (-24) win, UC had won the previous 3 games by an avg of 41-6. UC had 24-4 FD and 369-87 yd edges LY. It was somehow 0-0 with 5:00 left in the game. The Bearcats do have

in-state rival Ohio State on deck (bigger dreams) which could have them sleep walking a bit here.

OREGON ST by 9 over San Diego St - Both tms come in off a bye, but OSU has their PAC12 opener with a trip to USC on deck while SDSt has a home date with UNLV. In their last gm, the Beavers had a commanding 38-7 4Q lead before surrendering 23 str pts to hang on and slip past Hawaii 38-30 (-9'). They did have 22-20 FD, 464-336 yd & 35:40-24:20 TOP edges. The Aztecs nearly pulled the outright upset in their last gm at UNC, falling 31-27 (+15'). They were up 24-14 4Q but were then outscored 17-3 and QB Kaehler was int'd in the EZ w/:14 left. SDSt had 23-20 FD, 509-394 yd & 37:26-22:34 TOP advantages, but were done in by 3 TO's. LY these two met for the first time s/'00 and the situation greatly favored the Aztecs as they were off a bye while OSU had just gone to OT on the road to beat P12 foe Utah and was travelling again. SDSt had 24 pts in the 1H, the most vs a Power-5 s/'99 (31 vs KU in '99) and at one point this gm appeared hopeless for OSU. The Aztecs led 24-14 at HT and looked on their way to delivering another outright upset winner as the Big Dog POW (+8). With SDSt up 27-14 4Q, OSU got a td w/12:27 left but fumbled and SDSt got a 30 yd fg w/5:18 left to go up 2 scores, 30-21. OSU went 81/10 for a td w/2:40 left and then got a stunning 16 yd IR td w/2:23 left and SDSt was int'd at the 50 with 1:44 left during OSU's 34-30 comeback win. We'll call for this one near the number as SDSt should have the Beavers attention considering LY and the NC near upset.

TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK.....AKRON REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK...... NORTH CAROLINA

LSU by 11 over Mississippi St - Talk about series domination. LSU has won 20 of the L/21 incl 13 str in this series. The Tigers are also 18-4 ATS incl 4 str in the series. LY's game was a lot closer than the final score. LSU only had a 27-23 FD edge and 563-468 yd edge but their 59 pts was the most they've scored in the rivalry s/69. MSt led 23-21 w/LSU getting a td with :17 left in the half to take the lead. Trailing 31-26 MSt missed a 42 yd fg w/1:24 left 3Q and then it became a misleading final as LSU went on a 31-0 run incl td "drives" of 5 and 25 yds after TO's. LSU cruises into SEC play off a 31-0 (-31) shutout over in-state foe ULM, as they all'd just 93 ttl ydsl After being down 24-7 3Q against Wisc in their opener, LSU has responded with 108 unanswered pts and their B2B shutouts is a program 1st in more than 20 yrs. After being given a test 2 wks ago by UAB, MSt responded by going on the road and easily dispatching an overmatched SA squad 35-3. While the FD were close (24-22), the Bulldogs had a sizeable 514-345 yd edge and caused 4 TO's. In MSt HC Mullens first 5 ssns, the Bulldogs have dropped their first game as a dog both SU & ATS. SU is only in a ULM/NMSt sandwich and look for them to continue series domination here.

ARKANSÁS ST by 1 over Utah St - After tough B2B road trips (Tenn & Miami) ArkSt will be happy to be back home, as the home team has won all 5 prev meetings (4-1 ATS), but the last meeting was in '04. That '04 matchup was also pl'd here as both were SBC members. The Aggies lost 16-7 (+7) despite their D not allowing a td. ArkSt kicked 3 fg's and had a 61 yd PR td while holding UTSt to just 266 ttl yds with 148 (56%) coming in the 4Q. UTSt QB Keeton was inj'd & DNP the 2H LW (CS). The Aggies built a 29-7 HT lead at home over WF LW and held on for a 36-24 (-14) win with 23-16 FD & 391-232 yd edges. They have a bye on deck before their rivalry gm at BYU. Ark St all'd True frosh QB Kaaya to throw for 342 yds in their 41-20 loss at Miami LW. The Red Wolves surprisingly had the FD edge 24-20, but were outgained 488-329. With no line at presstime due to Keeton's inj we'll call for the home team by 1 and wait for a line. Keep in mind though, Utah Sr won a MW div champ LY with Garretson at QB and he has plenty of exp. New Mexico by 3 over NEW MEXICO ST - This will mark the 105th all-time meeting in the Rio Grande Rivalry (Pl'd every yr s/46). The visitor is 4-2 SU and 5-1 ATS and there have been 3 outright upsets the L5Y.LY NM was -11 at home and dominated the game rolling up 541 rush yds (9.7). In fact the last 2 years they've outrushed NMSt 843 (7.8) to 260 (4.0). NM led 42-14 at HT, but surprisingly only had a 282-238 yd edge. The Aggies scored DD pts in every qtr and scored 17 pts off 3 MNSt TO's in the 66-17 drubbing. LTH NM was a 6' pt dog but led 27-7 until NMSt got a late td w/3:54 left to "only" lose 27-14. That win snapped a 24 gm road losing streak. NM had won 6 str of these I-25 gms under former HC Long, then lost all 3 under former HC Locksley, but have won their first 2 under HC Davie. NM is fresh off a much needed bye after losing 58-23 (+23') at home against AZSt. NMSt meanwhile was run over by UTEP LW 42-24. They were outFD'd 26-20 & outgained 470-425 incl allowing 344 rush yds (5.9). On the ssn they are allowing 255

rush ypg (5.2) which is bad news considering the Lobo's option attack is avg 309 rush ypg (5.7).

NEBRASKA by 7 over Miami, FI - NU is back in Lincoln after LW's trip out west where they earned a dominant victory over Fresno 55-19 (-10). The Huskers led 27-5 at HT and for the gm had 22-20 FD & 562-346 yd edges. Miami cruised to a 41-20 (-16') win over Ark St despite being outFD'd 24-20, but they did outgain the Red Wolves 488-329. True QB Kaaya had his finest day in his young car throwing for 342 (67%, 4-1 ratio) & WR Dorsett became just the 3rd Hurricane WR to ever have 200+ rec yds in a gm (Eddie Brown '84 & Wesley Carroll '90) despite only 4 rec's (50.3 ypc)! UM has never won in Lincoln (0-3) but their LTH was in '76. The L/5 meetings have all come in bowls (UM is 4-1). L/gm took place in '01's ssn Rose Bowl (#1 vs #4). UM finished that yr 12-0 w/a Nat'l Title after their 37-14 (-8') win. NU is 51-4 SU s/'96 hosting non-conf opp's (L's vs SMiss '04, USC '07, VT '08 & UCLA LY) incl á 6-3 ATS run s/12 and look for them to pull out the win here.

Oklahoma by 10 over WEST VIRGINIA - WV is a perfect 3-0 ATS vs the Sooners, all as large dogs LY OU was -21 at home but after the 2 comb for 1,440 yds and 99 pts in 12 OU only won 16-7, their lowest pt total in a home win since '67! WV went 85/3 for a td and an early 7-0 lead, but after a fumbled punt early 2Q OU went 32/5 for a td to make it 10-7 and the Sooners never trailed from that point on. LTH ('12) OU jumped out to a 31-17 HT lead and led 38-24 but needed a td pass w/:24 left to pull out a 50-49 win (-11'). There may not be a tm playing better in the nation right now than the Sooners. HC Stoops backed up his 'SEC propaganda' talk with a 34-10 (-21) win over Tenn LW. OU had 21-18 & 454-313 yd edges and forced 3 TO's, returning an int 100 yds for a td making many Sooner backers happy. Thanks to 4 TO's, WV kept MD in the gm before kicking a GW 47 yd f with no time left to win 40-37 (+3'). They held sizeable 33-16 FD & 694-447 yd edges while QB Trickett is vastly improved and his 511 pass yds LW were the 2nd most in WV hist (656, Geno Smith 12). WV was up 28-6 2Q, but all'd MD to tie the gm in the 4Q. Tenn QB Worley entered the OU gm avg 260 pass ypg (65%, 5-1 ratio), but he was limited to just 201 yds (48%, 1-2) and it will be interesting to see if the OUD can continue to put pressure on opposing QB's as Trickett is now fully capable of running Holgersen's system.

ARIZONA by 8 over California - P12 opener for both schools. AZ outlasted NV LW 35-28, outgaining

the Wolfpack 507-429 while converting 1 more FD. While Cal is off a bye and AZ is playing a 4th str wk this is the Cat's 3rd home gm in that stretch. LY Cal was +16 at home, but only trailed 19-14 at the half (269-212 yd). Trailing 33-21, Cal was int'd in the EZ for a TB. 2 drives later the Bears went 80/7pl for à td with 1:42 left but AZ rec'd the onside kick and held on for a 33-28 win. LTH ('10) Cal led 9-3 (+6') but gave up a 77/7pl GW td drive w/1:11 left. AZ has lost 3 str P12 openers by 27, 49 & 18, but the HT is on a 6-1 ATS run in this series. Cal HC Dykes was the OC/QB cch at AZ from 2007-'09 and has his team playing well early on this ssn as they enter 2-0 SU/ATS incl an outright upset at NW 31-24 (+10) in wk 1. Look for them to continue that ATS run here.

BOISE ST by 24 over Louisiana - Boise returns to the comfy confines of the Blue Turf after making a long trip to the East Coast LW, where they beat Uconn 38-21 despite being outFD'd 18-13 and outgaining the Huskies by a slight 292-290 edge. Boise didn't run a single play the 1st 8 min, but had a 7-3 lead thanks to a fumble rec td. Boise did force 3 TO's, returning 2 of them for td's. UL is making their 2nd str road trip after LW's 56-15 blowout loss at Ole Miss, the elevation at BS will be an adjustment. UL was outFD'd 27-18 & outgained 554-322, turned the ball over 4X and all'd 14 str completions to start the game. While this is the schools first ever meeting, the cch's are familiar with one another as HC Harsin was the HC during Ark St's 23-7 home loss to the Ragin Cajun's LY. Harsin's Red Wolves were held to a ssn low 168 yds in that gm, but with upgraded talent and a sizeable home field edge, that won't happen TY. BS hasn't lost a non-conf HG s/01 (28 str wins) and are on a 3-1 ATS run the L2Y. Bronco cash their 3rd str gm while the Cajuns drop their 3rd str.

4★ Green Bay by 7 over DETROIT - The Packers have dominated the series w/a 12-3-1 ATS mark and DET destroyed GB LY 40-10 as a 6 pt HD. GB didn't have Rodgers (collarbone) and the Lions teed off on Flynn w/7 sacks and a 30-7 FD/561-126 yd edge on Thanksgiving. After rolling the Giants on MNF the Lions shot themselves in the foot repeatedly missing 2 FG and having 3 TO's that CAR turned into 10 pts. Their paper thin secondary lost its 2nd starter of the year (4th RD DC Nevin Lawson) and CAR with a sub-par receiving unit moved the ball quite well in the air (281 yds 65% 1-0 18 pass 1st Dns). Despite a rough 1st Qtr Rodgers put 346 yds (54%) 3-0 on a physical Jets defense with a similar DB situation. We'll take the road team with a better secondary getting a manageable line in a

3★ NEW ORLEANS by 17 over Minnesota - This is NO's 1st home game TY where they are 15-3 at home off SU loss and outgained foes 443-270 at home LY. While they did lose to CLE LW they improved from 568 to 324 yds allowed. The real issue are the TO's which gave ATL 10 pts and CLE 7 pts. The offense is operating decently otherwise converting 62% vs ATL and 54% of 3rd Dns vs CLE The Vikings deactivation of Peterson LW blew up their offense as Cassel struggled with 202 yds (53%) 1-4 ratio which along with a blocked FG set up 24 pts for NE. On the surface MIN's #9 pass defense is improved (#31 LY 37-12 ratio) but look at the big picture. They faced a STL team with a bad QB situation and Brady didn't have to do much LW as they had favorable field position all day (avg start NE 42). They now go on the road vs an elite QB off B2B losses and will be dealing with the media all week. It's unknown what Peterson's situation will be here but this is a prime spot for NO to post a blowout win to get back on track as the Vikings limitations hold them back.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ CINCINNATI by 12 over Tennessee - TEN came back to earth after posting 405 yds on a beat up KC defense as they were held to just 68 yds in the 1H vs DAL at home. TEN was forced to abandon the run (13 rush w/ 5 in 2H) and DAL pounded the run 220 yds (5.1). TEN was worn out defensively by 76 plays by DAL and now have to travel to CIN who beat ATL on the ground with 170 yds (3.8) with AJ Green (toe) inj'd. CIN made the most of their home crowd and the fact that ATL was playing with backups at both OT spots. Ryan was held to 218 yds less than his Wk 1 effort and were lucky that just 1 of his 3 ints set up 7 pts for CIN. The Bengals aren't quite clicking offensively yet (3 FG att's inside ATL 31 after 5 of 6 FG's vs BAL) but they have covered 10 straight at home with a 10-18 ratio (59.2 opposing QBR!) with 26 sacks in that span. CIN did put 41 pts on Horton's defense in their rematch vs opposing QBH!) will 20 sacks in that spain. One did political part of the CLE LY and we'll take the better defense at home again.

OTHER GAMES

Tampa Bay at ATLANTA - Thurs. A Week #3 "must win" for ATL? Well, a loss would could put them 3 full games back of the Saints and 0-1 head to head. Falcons sure need a feel good win on Nat'l TV as they've lost 6 of their L/8 at home outright. The Buc's are making their first road trip and in the L3Y they are just 1-7 ATS as a div AD but can Lovie change that? The favorite has covered 6 of 7 in this series and this play will be available as a Marquee Thursday after Noon EST.

BUFFALO by 3 over San Diego - The situation clearly favors the Bills at home for the 2nd straight vs SD off a MNF matchup at ARZ, losing their starting Ctr prior to SEA and now having to fly to the East Coast in 25' cooler and windy conditions. SD has the clear edge at QB with Rivers (287 ypg 63% 9-4 L5 road) here and the OL held up well vs SEA giving up 2 sks, 4 QBH and 2 tfl. AF are 3-8 ATS after facing SEA and RB Mathews (MCL sprain) is very doubtful here. SD has given up 112 ypg (4.9!) on the ground their L9 road games and BUF thrives in that area. The Bills defense and special teams stepped up again with a 102 yd KR, blocked a punt and held MIA to 80 yds rush (3.8) which forced Tannehill (49 att's) out of his comfort zone as MIA went 6 of 20 on 3rd/4th Dns. This is a letdown spot for BUF but we'll call for them by 3 as they have the momentum and the AFC East lead.

Dallas by 3 over ST LOUIS - This is the 3rd meeting in 4Y with the Cowboys rolling 31-7 LY and 34-7 w/a 420-248 yd avg. Romo has thrived vs STL w/ 238 ypg (64%) 8-1 in his 3 matchups but not as much as RB Murray (214 ypg 8.4). The Cowboys get another favorable matchup here vs a 1-dimensional offense for their defense. Vs SF their defense wasn't that bad (316 yds) despite Romo's blunders and LW they took TEN's run game out of the game (13 rush att) and Locker was forced to win in a new system. STL was forced to start UFA rookie QB Davis vs TB LW (235 yds 76%) and after a lengthy weather delay came away with the win and it won't be a surprise to see Davis get another start as there isn't enough film on him yet. Romo has better skill players to work with but their inconsistency (7-17 ATS off SU win) has us call for them by a FG and watch the line.

PHILADELPHIA by 10 over Washington - PHI is 5-2 ATS in the series covering both LY but WAS has the situational edge here as PHI is off a MNF game vs IND and have a road trip vs SF on deck. PHI (5-14 ATS as a fav) faced IND down 3 OL and keep in mind they gave up 5 sacks, 4 QBH, 11 tfl vs JAX The Redskins rallied LW after losing WR Jackson (shoulder) and Griffin (ankle) with Cousins (250 yds 66% 2-0) beating on a depleted Jags team that didn't prep for him. WAS now hits the road dealing with the emotional baggage of their franchise QB inj'd again with PHI's coaches jumping on the tape last Sun to get ready. We'll call for the home team by a 7 here as we want to see how Kelly adjusts the OL for an offense that is vastly superior to the Jags and the line fallout for the Griffin injury.

Houston by 1 NY GIANTS - The Giants have the situational edge being home for the 2nd week while HOU

had to fly out to OAK, come home then fly out to NYG for this. The Giants again self-destructed with 4 TO's while giving up a 71 yd PR for TD. Manning simply isn't comfortable in the WCO with vertical threat WR's struggling to get open right now. After rushing for 83 ypg (3.5) in 2013 the Giants have followed it up with 53 yds (2.4) and 81 yds (3.0) to start TY. Equally alarming is that they gave up 124 yds (4.4) on the ground at home to a team w/a QB making his 1st start since 2010. HOU has had a pair of lower tier foes to ease into the season keep in mind that the core of the 2014 team is from a unit that was expected to go deep into the playoffs in 2013. The line has shifted 5 pts, the Giants outgained ARZ 341-266 LW and Coughlin is 8-2 ATS as a dog off B2B losses so we'll call for the road team by 1 and take the points here.

Baltimore at CLEVELAND - The Ravens got back on track LW with their win vs PIT as their 20 pt win was backed by a strong 2H where they outFD PIT 15-7 and outgained them 215-118. Flacco was efficient but not dominant (166 yds 72% 2 TD) but he didn't need to be with a ground game that picked up 157 yds (4.4). They now have extra rest in a venue where they are 5-1 SU/ATS with their loss coming LY which ended an 11 game win streak. CLE knows what's coming as OC Shanahan is a disciple of BAL OC Kubiak, are healthier than the unit that upset BAL LY and are steeped in confidence. Over the L6 Qtrs the Browns held Roethlisberger to 95 yds (58%) and Brees to 237 yds (68%) 2-1 despite starting a rookie CB and a new safety. Hoyer is 4-1 SÚ/5-Ò ATŚ as a starting QB and he has the pocket discipline for Shanahan's system. Look for the Browns to channel the offense thru RB's West and Crowell again (122 yds combined 4.1 LW) and they should get TE Cameron (shoulder) back again but we are taking dog here esp if a FG or more. Indianapolis by 10 over JACKSONVILLÉ - This is a good situation for the Jaguars w/ their 1st game in their renovated stadium vs an IND team off a SNF game vs DEN and a MNF event vs PHI. That's about it for them as IND has won the L3 meetings by 17, 34 and 20 pts with a 392-298 yd edge. Over the L6 Qtr's the Jags have been stomped getting outFD 44-17, outgained 740-266 with just 58 yds on the ground (3.1). Henne has been bad but the real reason is his supporting cast as the OL is very raw and an already green WR unit has been under siege by injuries since the start of training camp. Their most exp'd WR (Shorts) is dealing w/a hamstring injury, the top WR from Wk 1 (Hurns) left w/a ankle injury and Gerhart (50 yds 2.0) has his own issues. IND has a massive talent edge with the skill positions but they honestly don't have the pass rush that WAS does. JAX is 0-4-1 ATS since their coach killing run LY avg 14.6 ppg, are 4-12 ATS at home but without seeing the Colts on MNF we'll call for a 10 pt loss and wait for the line.

NEW ENGLAND by 23 over Oakland - NE's success and role in the public spotlight has them a woeful 5-13 ATS as a DD favorite off a SU win. They also have a MNF game at KC on deck but DD HF in that role are 6-2 ATS winning by 18 ppg. This is the Raiders 2nd trip to the East Coast (lost 11 straight 1 pm est games) in 3 Wks but the home opener for the NE. After the opening drive NE held MIN to 137 total yds (2 of 9 3rd Dns) and feasted on 4 TO's and a missed FG for 24 pts. Normally with a team off that big a win vs a team off as bad a loss as OAK would be bad but the Raiders made a big mistake in fielding Carr (5.6 ypa 63% 3-2) behind a bad OL with no run support (69 yds 2.6 TY w/o Carr rushes). OAK's 1st score LW was set up by 31 pen yds by HOU and the 2nd was in garbage time. Now they get a Patriots team that is still steamed over the MIA loss and up to BUF. Look for this to get ugly fast as the Patriots stump a rookie QB in a limited offense.

San Francisco by 1 over ARIZONA - The 49ers are 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS vs ARZ but are coming off LW's SNF where they opened their new stadium vs a depleted CHI offense. ARZ gambled by resting Palmer (shoulder) and as Drew Stanton had his 1st start since 2010. ARZ simply let the Giants self-destruct with 4 TO's (6 pts), a 71 yd PR for a TD and 9 penalties. ARZ has had a lucky break to start the season rallying to beat SD late in the 4th Qtr and getting a Giants team struggling to find its identity. The situation certainly favors them again here with SF having a home game vs PHI on deck off in a letdown spot. The NFC West teams are on a 20-7-2 ATS run as a dog vs anyone and we'll lean with ARZ to keep it closer than expected here.

SEATTLE by 6 over Denver - Super Bowl 48 rematch!! SEA is 11-4 ATS after a SU loss as they were

done in by 95+ heat and humidity at SD. The Seahawks have to be livid for giving up 284 yds passing (76%) and 3 TD's to SD as they couldn't stop TE Gates (96 yds 13.7 3 TD). SEA was forced out of their game as Lynch was held to 36 yds (6.0) and Wilson was forced to pass 25 times which is at the high end of what Carrol prefers. Manning continues to be brilliant but we haven't been overly impressed with their ground game which allowed IND and KC to hang around as Moreno was their closer LY. SEA knows exactly how to defend the DEN system and while the Broncos are stronger defensively they are essentially the same as LW. The Broncos could get Welker (susp) back but SEA is back in their element with the 12th man where inc playoffs they've outgained foes 344-273 (+14 TO's).

MIAMI by 6 over Kansas City - Inc playoffs the Chiefs are 3-7 SU/4-6 ATS losing the yardage battle

in 8 of 10 games. They deserve a ton of credit for playing DEN tough LW driving down to the Broncos 2 as time expired and actually outgained DEN by 55 yds and held the ball almost tying the game up. It was a costly effort as RB Charles and SS Berry both left the game with their status uncertain here. MIA was down all 3 starting LB's LW and now have to replace RB Moreno (elbow) who played well the 1st 2 Wks despite missing training camp. Tannehill (4 sks, 5 QBH) was beat up by a very good BUF DL playing inspired ball honoring Ralph Wilson and celebrating keeping the team in BUF. They now have the weather edge (5-1-1 ATS hosting NDIV) with the visitor off a brutal loss and we'll call for the home team by 2 FG's as we wait for the injury list here.

Pittsburgh at Carolina - Sunday - The Panthers have become a force at home winning 10 of 11 with the only loss coming in LY's opener to SEA. They've also gone 9-1-1 ATS in that span. PIT meanwhile has totaled 3 FG's on offense in the last 90 min and is lucky to be 1-1. With that said the Steelers have extra rest of a Thursday Night'r and they are a perfect 6-0 ATS playing on them when they fail to cover vs their rival BAL and playing against them when they do cover.

Chicago at NY Jets - Monday - You first get upset by the Bills at home, then you travel to face SF in a new

Stadium for their home opener then you get to travel to face a NY Jets squad off a loss. The Jets meanwhile are playing their first Sun/Mon night game at home since Oct 2012. Figuring out the Bears is easy: They are 7-1 ATS on the non-conf road if they score over 28 pts or allow under 20 pts. Will they do that this week?
