3★ Northern Illinois over Bowling Green - Friday. These two DNP earlier TY but this is a rematch of LY's MAC Title gm where the Falcons pulled the outright upset 47-27 (+4) over 12-0 NIU ending the Huskies' B2B BCS bowl hopes and also their MAC-record 25 str conf wins. The two tms have split their L/6 meetings ATs wise and BG leads the series 4-3 SU in MAC meetings. The dog has covered 6 str MAC champ gms incl 3 outright upsets and since it moved to Ford Field in 2004, the dog is 8-2 ATS (4 upsets). It is also notable that in MAC Champ gms, NIU is 0-5 ATS (BG 1-1 ATS). LW we cashed a 3★ Key selection on these pages on NIU as despite winning 4 str MAC West Div Titles, they found themselves a td-plus dog to WM (42-pt line swing from LY). It didn't look good early as they were down 21-7 but the tm who has "been there and done that" scored the gms final 24 pts. On the other side, after wrapping up a MAC East division title 2 wks ago, the Falcons limp in losers of 2 str. LW after jumping out to a 21-7 lead, they were outscored 34-3 in the final 3Q's in an upset loss to Ball St at home. Neither tm is as good as LY's edition as BG is -4 ypg in MAC play while NIU is +0 ypg. However, the diff is the MAC West is a much better div (15-3 record over MAC East TY) and BG lost all 3 of their gms to MAC West opp TY. Vs 5 common foes, BG is 2-3 SU/1-4 ATS (-1 ppg, -39 ypg) while NIU was 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS (+7 ppg, +13 ypg). The Huskies have the better offense, better D, much better QB and we'll call for them to easily get revenge here.

CUSA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - JOAN C. EDWARDS STADIUM - HUNTINGTON, WV

2★ Louisiana Tech (+) over MARSHALL - LT won 26-0 way back in 1942 in the only prior meeting. The dog is 2-1 L/3 CUSA Title gms w/2 outright upsets but the HT is 6-2 SU/ATS the L/8. MU just played in this gm LY and suffered a 41-24 loss (-6) to Rice as we were shocked the Owls got to host the gm after Marshall was receiving votes in the AP/Cchs poll. This will be LT's 1st CUSA Title gm appearance but their HC Holtz won 2 CUSA champ while HC at ECU. These two tms come in on opposite ends of the spectrum here as LT improved to 9-3 ATS TY after a dominating 76-31 win (-7) over defending CUSA champ Rice to claim the West div title. The Bulldogs had 28-17 FD and 677-371 yds edges. On the other side, the Herd saw their unbeaten and major bowl hopes dashed in a 67-66 OT loss (-23) to WKU as they lost at home for the 1st time in 14 yrs. The Herd rallied from a 42-21 deficit to take a 66-59 lead in OT but WKU opted to go for a 2 pt conv after their td and got it. While QB Cato set schl records w/7 td passes, he also threw 4 picks and the Herd D which was the best in the conf all'd a schl-rec 738 yds and 8 td passes. Both tms are in their preferred roles as LT is 4-0 ATS as an AD TY w/2 outright upsets while Marshall is 9-2-1 ATS as a HF. While prior to LW, no tm in the country besides Baylor had been more dominant on their home field the L/2 yrs than the Herd, we wonder if they will be suffering after having their Bubble Burst and LT, besides the ODU gm 2 wks had been just as impressive in CUSA play TY as the Herd (LT +25 ppg in CUSA play, Marsh +24 ppg). Take the points!

Thursday, December 4th

E CAROLINA by 3 over Ucf - A share of the AAC Champ is on the line here for UCF. EC has won 9 of 12 all-time meetings (3-5 ATS run) & the HT has won 4 str (5-1 ATS run). LTH ('11) the gm was tied at 31 & EC (+7) got a 56 yd td run w/2:10 left for the win. In the L/gm ('12) EC lost 40-20 (+11). EC only trailed 23-20 w/8:30 left 3Q but all'd the gms L/17 pts. The Knights are off a 16-0 (-11) win over in-state rival USF, holding the Bulls to just 200 tll yds incl just 5 rush yds (0.2). At the end of the gm, USF had a 1st and GL at the 1 but a pers foul and incomplete pass on 4th Dn preserved the shutout for the Knights. The Pirates are off a 49-32 (-17) win at Tulsa as QB Carden passed for 338 yds while accounting for 5 td's. Both tms have been impressive in AAC play as EC is +155 ypg while UCF is +145 ypg. Both rush D's have been excellent in conf play as EC is holding their opp to 94 rush ypg (3.1) while UCF is also all'g 94 (3.3). The Pirates are 8-2 SU/ATS in their FHG and have won 8 str overall HG's (6-2 ATS). However, they have struggled going 1-6 ATS in AAC play TY. UCF is 2-0 ATS as a conf AD the L2Y w/2 outright upsets and have covered 7 of their L/9 gms overall as they have been playing their best ball of the ssn after an 0-2 start. Vs 6 common opp's EC is 5-1 SU/1-5 ATS (+13 ppg and +183 ypg) while UCF is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS (+18 ppg, +186 ypg). With these two tms so similar statistically, we'll take the HT by 4 and put the lean on the away dog who has the better D (#24-73).

Friday, December 5th

PAC 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LEVI'S STADIUM - SANTA CLARA, CA

Oregon by 11 over Arizona - This will be the 1st time the Pac-12 Title gm will be played at a neutral site. Ore is 1-0 SU/0-1 ATS in Pac-12 title games while this is UA's 1st appearance. The Ducks did play at this site earlier TY in a 59-41 (-17) win over Cal. These two tms also met earlier TY with the Wildcats pulling one of the biggest upsets of the ssn in their 31-24 win (+24) as we cashed a Thur Night Marquee. While there was a ? call at the end of the gm that aided the Cats' final score (celebration after UO stopped UA on Dns), it was the 2nd str time UA out-played the Ducks as they pulled the big upset LY 42-16 (+18). The Wildcats come in fresh off a 42-35 win (-2) over in-state rival ASU as they reached 10 wins for the 1st time s/'98. Despite their 7-2 Pac-12 record, they are -4 ypg in conf play while Ore is +97 ypg. On the other side since that loss to the Wildcats, the Ducks have won and covered 7 str gms incl LW in their 47-19 win (-20) over in-state rival Ore St as they had a 565-362 yd edge and jumped out to a 30-0 lead. QB Mariota accounted for 6 td's and locked up a visit to New York for the Heisman Trophy ceremony. Vs 6 common opp's TY, Zona is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS (+11 ppg, -15 ypg) while UO is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS (+20 ppg, +103 ypg). While you have to think Mariota and Co won't allow for a 3rd str upset, we can't lay 2 td's here against a tm that has their number.

Saturday, December 6th

CONNECTICUT by 10 over Smu - In 1989, SMU's 31-30 comeback win over Conn was one of their most memorable games since their return from the Death Penalty. LY was their 1st meeting since then. SMU was -14' at home & CT st'd 3rd string QB Cochran. SMU led 21-7 at HT w/a 297-141 yd edge & went onto win 38-21 as we won our almost College 5★ LPS GOY. LW the Ponies remained the only winless FBS tm in the nation after their 35-9 (+21) home loss to UF. They did have a 9-7 HT lead but were outgained 185-28 in the 3Q and were limited to just 10 FD and 223 tll yds in the gm. They are getting outscored by 33 ppg (-261 ypg) for the year. Conn is off a 41-10 loss (+20) at Memphis. They were outFD'd 28-14 as Tim Boyle saw his most action of the yr (13-24-160-1-1). The Huskies are -15 ppg (-99 ypg) in HC Diaco's 1st yr. This is their FHG where they are 3-1 SU/ATS while SMU is making the rare trip to the NE. However, it is tough backing a Conn tm that is 2-9 ATS as a HF and avg just 14 ppg in AAC play TY.

TCU by 35 over Iowa St - The visitor has won both meetings as B12 rivals in this series. The LTH ('12) ISU pulled the outright upset 37-23 (+7) as they never trailed. LY ISU was +7 at home and while TCU had a 368-283 yd edge, ISU led 17-14 in the 4Q, but fmb'd at the TCU30. TCU was int'd at the ISU22 w/5:18 left but got a 1 yd td run with :38 left to escape with a 21-17 non-covering win. The

Horned Frogs enter full of confidence as they're still in the hunt for their 1st B12 Title & remain in the CFB Playoff discussion after routing Texas 48-10 (-7). They limited UT to just 12 FD's & 290 tll yds while forcing 6 TO's incl 4 int's by QB Swoopes. Other than a 4Q collapse at Baylor, there hasn't been a more impressive tm besides Alabama TY than the Frogs who are +24 ppg and +157 ypg. ISU is off a 37-24 loss (+13) to WV as they blew a 21-7 early 2Q lead (actually would trail 27-21 at HT). They are are -12 ppg and -126 ypg on the yr. In Big 12 play they are 0-8 SU/2-4-2 ATS getting outscored by 15 ppg (-154 ypg). On the other side, TCU is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in B12 play (+19 ppg, +98 ypg). This is the Horned Frogs 1st HG in a month, they are 5-0 ATS TY as a HF w/an avg cover of 16 ppg and need another blowout win to make a statement for the CFB playoff committee. We think they do so here.

Temple by 3 over TULANE - These schools have just one previous meeting which was all the way back in the 1935 Sugar Bowl! The Green Wave enter fresh off a bye and lost 34-6 (+19) at EC in their L/gm. RfR QB Lee did throw for a career-high 301 yds but Tulane was outFD'd 30-15 & outgained 497-325 (was just 20-6 mid-4Q). The new Yulman stadium hasn't been as friendly as the folks in NO would like as after going 8-2 ATS as a HD the prev 2Y, the Green Wave are 0-3 ATS TY. Temple is off a 14-6 loss (+7) to Cincy despite having a 267-255 yd edge. After going 2-10 a yr ago, the Owls are 5-6 despite the regression of QB Walker who has seen his comp % drop from 61-53% and his TD-Int ratio go from 20-8 to 12-14. After a 4-1 start, they are now -1.5 in their L/6 gms but all 6 of those tms will be heading to a bowl TY. Vs 7 common opp's TY, Temple is 3-4 SU/ATS getting outscored by 1 ppg (-90 ypg) while Tulane is 2-5 SU/3-4 ATS (-12 ppg, -38 ypg). Tough backing a road tm here that hasn't topped 300 yds of offense in their L/5 and hasn't topped 20 pts in their L/6, however the Green Wave offense hasn't fared much better avg just 16 ppg in AAC play. Look for a low-scoring snooze fest.

CINCINNATI by 7 over Houston - UH lost 5 str trips to Cincinnati (L/win in '71) incl a 47-14 loss the LTH ('02). LY these two met for the first time s/'02. UC won their 4th in a row SU in the series and are on a 5-1 ATS run. The game was in Houston, but was played in a chilly 48' with rain and mud and the conditions benefitted the cold weather Bearcats. UH never led & lost 24-17 (-2) and UC did have a 573-278 yd edge. The Cougars are off a 35-9 (-21) win at SMU. The Ponies actually led 9-7 at HT, but UH had a 185-28 yd edge in the 3Q to take control of the gm and finished with 25-10 FD and 433-223 yd edges. This is their 2nd str AAC road gm but are on a 6-0 ATS run as an AD w/2 outright upsets. The Cougars are also on an 8-0 ATS run in reg ssn gms outside the state of Texas. UC is off a 14-6 win (-7) at Temple and they can share the AAC title w/a win here. Their D has been the major reason why they've won and covered 6 str gms as after all'g 41 ppg and 574 ypg their 1st 5, they all'd just 14 ppg and 318 ypg since. Against 5 common foes the Cougars are 4-1 SU/ATS (+14 ppg & +87 ypg) while the Bearcats are 4-1 SU/ATS (+12 ppg, +74 ypg). Two similar teams but Cincy does have the edge on offense and w/an ever improving D, we'll call for them to grab a share of the conf title.

BAYLOR by 10 over Kansas St - The winner here will at least grab a share of the B12 Title. BU has won 3 of the last 4 incl their LTH when KSt came in with the Nat'l Title gm in their grasp at #2 in the country and BU not only upset them, they slashed them 52-24 and now the Wildcats could return the favor here. LY KSt was playing with a vocal crowd and with revenge. BU was avg 780 ypg and 71 ppg but was held to 446 and just 15 FD's. BU led 21-10 at the half and KSt blk'd a punt setting up a 19 yd td drive then rec'd a fmb and went 44/10 for a td and led 25-21 after 3Q's. KSt missed a 41 yd fg with 6:49 left and were int'd at their own 39 with 3:48 left and BU got a td w/1:16 left for some breathing room but KSt easily covered in the 35-25 loss (+17). LW the Wildcats do what they always do against in-state rival Kansas, they win and they cover as their 51-13 win (-27) gave us another Early Bird POW winner (given out FREE every Monday by calling 1-347-677-1700 and hitting button #9). They moved to 17-1 SU/ATS in the series under Snyder as the Wildcats had 27-12 FD and 505-197 yd edges. On the other side, BU found themselves in a shootout w/huge underdog TT as they held on for a 48-46 win (-26) after leading 42-17. The story of the gm was QB Petty leaving midway thru the 3Q w/a mild concussion (said after gm he will def play here) and a BU pass D that all'd an incredible 609 pass yds. Both tms are in their preferred technical roles as KSt is 12-2 ATS as an AD while BU is 16-4 ATS as a HF. In conf play TY KSt is +15 ppg (+82 ypg) but is getting outscored by 3 ppg (-43 ypg) on the road TY while BU is +16 ppg (+135 ypg) in B12 play and at home TY are an incredible +36 ppg (+394 ypg!). Bears grab a share of the Big 12 title but will the margin be enough to pass TCU in the CFB playoff rankings?

OKLAHOMA by 20 over Oklahoma St - Bedlam. OU has dominated this series of late going on a 10-1 SU/7-3-1 ATS run. There have been 2 outright upsets the L4Y incl LY's 33-24 Sooner win. OSU is playing w/legit revenge as they were -10 at home and needed a win to wrap up the B12 Title & the Fiesta Bowl. The Sooners lost QB Knight in the 1H (3-7-28) & Thompson played the 2H (2-9-17) before Blake Bell guided the come-from-behind win. It was one of the worst weather games in Bedlam history. Both schools are fresh off byes. In the Sooners last gm, they routed KU 44-7 (-25) as true frosh RB Perine re-set the 1 wk old single gm rushing rec with 427 yds to go along w/5 td's. Their D limited KU to just 103 tll yds. QB Thomas was just 3-13-39 and has struggled all yr (20-49-222-1-4) as he will most likely make his 3rd start here as Knight is expected to miss (bye wk should benefit Thomas). On the other side, in a driving rain storm, OSU lost to BU in their L/gm 49-28 (+29) as they took the RS off true frosh QB Rudolph who was 13-25-281-2-2. The Pokes have lost 5 str for the 1st time s/'05 (Gundy's 1st ssn). The matchup (or mismatch) to look for here comes at the LOS as OU is avg 265 (6.3) rush ypg on the ssn incl an astonishing 394 rush ypg their L/4 gms while OSU is all'g 201 (4.7) rush ypg on the road. The Pokes are also -20 ppg and -216 ypg away from home while OU is +140 ypg at home. The Sooners have only had one bad performance all yr (BU) as they lost to KSt and TCU by a combined 5 pts and when they play their "A" are one of the top 10 tms in the country while OK St's 5-1 start to the ssn was fool's gold.

SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - GEORGIA DOME - ATLANTA, GA

Alabama by 10 over Missouri - Just one prior gm s/'1978 between these two as Alabama won 42-10 (-22) at Mizzou w/a dominating 533-129 yd edge. The favorite is 4-2-1 ATS in SEC Title gms and the much stronger West Division has won the L/5 SEC Title gms (4-1 ATS). Mizzou is playing in their 2nd str SEC Title gm after losing 59-42 (E) to Auburn LY while the Crimson Tide are playing in their 9th (4-4 SU/3-4-1 ATS and 0-2 ATS as a fav). The Crimson Tide come in w/7 str wins after LW's thrilling 55-44 (-8) defeat of Aub in the Iron Bowl. The Tide were fortunate to only be down 36-27 in the 3Q as Auburn remarkably settled for 4 FG's of 33 yds or less. However, the Tide would proceed to score the gm's next 28 pts as WR Cooper deserves an invite to NY after compiling 224 yds and 3 td's. On the other side, the Tigers pulled their 3rd str outright upset win LW over Arkansas 21-14 (+3) as they are now 5-1 ATS as a dog TY w/5 outright upsets and dating back to LY are 8-1 ATS as a dog pulling the upset ALL EIGHT times. They were out-played (like many of their other gms TY) for most of the gm as they trailed 14-6 entering the 4Q. However, kudos to HC Pinkel and Co as they make the plays when they need to and after rushing for just 57 yds prior, they had 90 yds rushing on their final scoring drive. Mizzou in SEC play TY is only out-scoring their foes by 5 ppg and are only +33 ypg, however, in their L/5 conf gms they are +144 ypg. Bama, on the other end is outscoring its conf foes by 14 ppg (+103 ypg) but in their L/5 gms, they are "only" +71 ypg and that includes a +399 yd adv over FCS W Carolina. The Crimson Tide are clearly the better tm here (best tm in the country in our opinion) but we're leery of laying too many pts as the Tide are on a 4-9 ATS run (lines inflated) and their D is a notch below recent Saban editions (17 ppg all'd TY is at least 3 more ppg than any unit s/Saban's 1st yr).

record for most td's responsible for in a single ssn with 45. The new QB is soph Cardale Jones, who is more of a dropback passer and he wasn't recruited by Urban Meyer. Wisconsin punched its ticket here & claimed Paul Bunyan's Axe in the process with their come-from-behind 34-24 (-13) win over Minnesota. The Badgers were down 17-3 late 2Q but clawed their way back to 17-13 at HT before taking control in the 2H. Gopher HC Kill lost for the 1st time when leading at HT as he had been 20-0 before LW. Heisman hopeful RB Gordon passed former Badger & Heisman winner Ron Dayne for the most single ssn rush yds in B10 history & is now 4th all time in FBS history w/2,260. He did suffer a minor ankle inj, but will be fine for this gm. OSU DC Fickel has been under scrutiny in Columbus due to the lackluster effort of the D the L2Y, but against UW his L3Y as DC (not counting '11 as he was the interim HC) the Buckeyes all'd 365 tt yds incl 165 (4.0) rush ypg while UW avg'd 440 tt yds incl 255 (5.8) rush ypg. HC Meyer is a cash cow when the odds are against him. When even or a dog, going back to his days at Utah, his F/3 yrs at UF & his 3Y tenure in Columbus, he's an incredible 12-0 ATS w/7 outright upsets incl earlier TY vs MSU & the dog in the B10 Champ gm is 3-0 ATS w/B2B outright upsets! OSU is also on a 6-1 SU/ATS run in this series. Originally we were thinking there was going to be some value on the Badgers being a possible TD dog here, but with the inj to Barrett we're a bit leery going against the QB injury system and Meyer's track record as a dog.

MW CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BRONCO STADIUM - BOISE, ID

BOISE ST by 20 over Fresno St - LY in the inaugural MW Champ gm, Fresno beat Utah St 24-17 (-2). This game is not only significant due to the crowning of the Mountain West Champion but there is also a major bowl bid at stake for the Broncos. Needing a win to advance to the MW Championship, the Broncos crushed Utah St LW 50-19 (-9) as the Aggies' tough defense was no match for the Broncos offense, led by RB Ajayi, who rushed for a career high 229 yds & 5 td's. The Bronco's had 26-16 FD, 498-268 yd & 35:38-24:22 TOP edges for their 13th straight home win (7-6 ATS). During their 7-gm win streak QB Hedrick has a 17-4 ratio after struggling early in the yr (5-9 ratio 1st 5). Fresno St earned its bid to play here w/3 str wins to finish 6-6 after hanging on to defeat Hawaii 28-21 (-10). The Bulldogs were in total control and led 28-0 in the 4Q before allowing the Rainbow Warriors to score the final 2 pts, the last with :45 seconds for the backdoor cover (much to our dismay). FSU had a slight 23-22 FD edge, but UH had a 353-333 yd edge. These 2 schools met back on Oct 17th in Boise with the Broncos winning 37-27 (-17). BSU had a 20-10 HT lead but the score was tied early 4Q before the Broncos scored the final 10 pts. Boise had 24-12 FD, 492-313 yd & 35:33-24:27 TOP edges. FSU hasn't won on the Blue Turf s/1984, going 0-7 SU/1-6 ATS but that lone cover was earlier TY. While BSU is 99-4 SU at Bronco Stadium s/99, they are currently on a 9-16 ATS run at home as the Vegas oddsmakers have adjusted their lines greatly. In MW play this ssn Boise is +14 ppg, +160 ypg, avg 253 (5.3) rush ypg on offense while FSU is +3 ppg but are -14 ypg and allow 209 (4.8) rush ypg. The Broncos are clearly the better tm and we'll call for them to win more comfortably than the Louing.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

Florida St by 3 over Georgia Tech - The last meeting between these schools was in the 2012 ACC Champ gm, which the Seminoles won 21-15 (-14). FSU is on a 13-2 SU run in this series but GT has covered the L/4 meetings. In the L/7 ACC Champ gms, the fav is 3-2 (E lined in '08 & '09) & there have been 3 outright upsets overall in the 9 title gms. This will be FSU's 5th appearance in this gm while this will be GT's 4th appearance. The 'Notes are 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS (1-1 as a fav) while GT is 1-2 SU/2-1 ATS (1-0 as a dog). FSU survived yet again LW, getting all they could handle from Florida, winning 24-19 (-7) cashing our underdog POW on these pages as Jameis Winston threw a car high 4 int's incl 3 in the 1Q (while still ridiculous, we're wondering if those 1H rumors of Winston point-shaving are true at this point). The Gators had a chance to win as they had the ball w/under 2 min left but were SOD on 4&8 from midfield (also missed 2 2H FG's). GT enters after pulling off a 30-24 (+11) OT outright upset win over UGA that gave us an incredible FIVE outright upset winners for our Big Dog plays LW (available for just \$9 on your VIP Debit system). It appeared the gm was over after the Bulldogs scored a td w/:18 left to go up 3, but the Yellow Jackets got a 21 yd run from QB Thomas & kicked the game tying 53 yd fg to send the gm into OT. GT finished with 32-21 FD & 463-388 yd edges as they beat UGA for the 1st time s/08 & just the 2nd time in 14Y. The gm incredibly featured 3 fumbles at the 1-yd line and 3 blk'd kicks. Technical advantages to GT here as FSU is on a 3-10 ATS run, GT is on a 7-2 ATS run & is 4-0 TY as a dog, pulling the outright upset all 4 gms! Against their 4 common ACC foes, while FSU went 4-0 SU/1-3 ATS (+10 ppg & -8 ypg) while GT has played more like the Top 5 tm as they went 4-0 SU/ATS (+23 ppg & +122 ypg). FSU's avg MOV is the lowest of any unbeaten tm in the L/10 yrs and we'll call for a similar script here as they will fall behind early and rally for the outright win.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN

Wisconsin by 3 over Ohio St - Not only is the B10 Championship on the line, but also a potential playoff berth is on the line for Ohio State. It will be a bit tougher as the Buckeyes are down to their 3rd string QB after JT Barrett fractured his ankle during their 42-28 (-20) win over rival Michigan in The Game. Barrett had been in the running for the Heisman Trophy & he broke Drew Brees' B10

4★ Indianapolis over CLEVELAND - The Browns are 4-0 SU/ATS off a loss under Pettine but that's come vs teams that own a combined 13-35 record. The magic may have ended for Hoyer who has completed 53% with a 1-6 ratio and 5 sks in his L4 games as Manziel got his chance LW. CLE went quick tempo on his 1st drive for a score to compensate for being down to their #3 Ctr. Manziel went 1-2 for 4 yds and a fumble on his next drive. CLE has only outgained 1 foe at home TY (PIT) gaining 342 ypg in the other 5 games. Luck has surpassed that in each road game TY avg 373 ypg (63%) 16-5 with a 102.7 QBR. This is also the return of Chudzinski who was the HC for the Browns LW, former stalwart LB D'Qwell Jackson and KR/PR Cribbs to CLE. The Browns have done an excellent job of holding it together in 2014. They now face a playoff level team with personal reasons to win with a week of distraction at the QB play and we'll take the visitor here.

FORECAST: Indianapolis by 13

3★ NEW ORLEANS over Carolina - CAR is 2-6 ATS on the road and while Newton has regressed since the CIN game avg 227 ypg (55%) 6-9 and he's been taken down 25 times in 201 pass att's (12.4%) with a 67.2 QBR. The defense has been exposed giving up 248 ypg (66%) 10-2 for a 102.4 QBR with 13 sks in 194 pass att's (6.7%). They've only scored more than 17 pts once in the span but gave up 45 pts when they did. They now get a NO team that got a huge win at PIT after losing 3 straight at home. The Saints don't have a problem moving the ball outgaining foes by 40 ypg (7th) but are their own worst enemy with -7 TO's. This is just NO's 5th game vs a foe w/a losing record right now and have won their L3 by 11, 6 and 18 with a +163 ypg avg. The Panthers only have the role of spoiler to embrace at this point but the Saints are being pushed by the Falcons for the NFC South and can't afford a let down with CHI on MNF on deck.

2★ Houston over JACKSONVILLE - The Jags won and covered both games LY by 7 pts in a 3 week turnaround. HOU sustained bad losses prior to each game losing to OAK at home before the 1st and losing by 3 to NE at home before travelling on Thursday. HOU is now 4-1 SU/ATS vs foes with a losing record and reinforced the offense with Foster (79 yds 4.2). Their #29 pass defense did lose its top CB Joseph (Achilles) but the heart of the defense remains Watt (11.5 sk) who gets a huge plus matchup vs the Jags OL that's allowed 50 sks TY (11.9% sk rate). JAX dominated the Giants in the 2H holding them to 6 FD/75 yds scoring 14 pts off a pair of TO's with 4 sks. Bortles led just the 3rd 21 pt comeback by a starting rookie QB since 1970. JAX is 2-9-1 ATS off a SU win and DIV HD's off a non-conf win are 11-22-1 ATS. Dallas at Chicago - Thursday. Both teams are off Thanksgiving Day losses to division foes however the Bears' basically sealed their doomed playoff hopes. Romo and the Cowboys have preformed better on the road with an avg score of 30-22 compared to getting outgained at home (23-21). The concern is trusting the Cowboys as a non-div favorite as they are only 4-12 ATS the L4Y. Grab this Thursday Night Marquee on the VIP Debit System or with your Marquee 7pk after Noon EST gameday.

Baltimore by 1 over Miami - This is a tough spot for MIA coming off MNF with a road game vs NE on deck (4-1 ATS prior). BAL beat MIA 26-23 LY as a 2.5 pt AD as the Ravens logged a 20-10 FD and 384-294 yd edge based on a 133 (3.3) to 22 (2.0) advantage on the ground. Since the GB loss MIA has gone 5-1 ATS losing SU at DET in their 3rd road game in 4 Wks and giving DEN a good challenge losing by 3 on the road. MIA has either been very good (60 ypg 3.3) or very bad (157 ypg 4.5) in run defense TY with BAL avg 134 ypg (5.1) rushing on the road. BAL is 1-3 SU/ATS on the road vs foes that own a winning record right now with the only win coming vs CLE on a last second FG. MIA has rushed for 100+ yds in all but 3 games and they lost all 3. TW they face BAL's #6 rush D and we'll take the road team off a sour loss getting points.

Pittsburgh by 7 over CINCINNATI - CIN improved to 3-11 ATS hosting the Steelers with a 20-10 win on MNF LY as CIN had a 22-14 FD and 407-278 yd edge. Dalton has only avg'd 200 ypg (54%) 7-5 vs the Steelers and vs foes with a winning record TY he's only avg'd 207 ypg (55%) with a 3-4 ratio (2-3 ATS). Compare that to Roethlisberger who has produced 339 ypg (66%) 14-2 TY with a 111.6 QBR (69.3 for Dalton). The Steelers are 13-6 ATS off a loss getting points beating CAR 37-19 in that role earlier TY. They are also getting good value having dropped 3 straight ATS with their loss LW coming largely due to Roethlisberger injuring his throwing hand in the 1H on a helmet. The barely got past the Bucs LW as Dalton tossed 3 ints and the coaching staff went to trick plays to keep TB off balance. We'll take the more experienced road team getting points off a loss but still in the AFC North hunt.

NY Giants by 4 over TENNESSEE - The Giants are going to be in a foul mood here after blowing a 21 pt lead (inc a 19 pass/96 yd TD drive) vs one of the worst teams in the NFL. After being embarrassed vs DAL with no play rush the Giants pulled in 7 which was more than their previous 7 games combined (6). Manning had a decent day as a passer with 247 yds (71%) 1-0 but the Giants 3 fumbles broke the game in the Jaguars favor. TEN is 1-10 ATS at home with their only cover vs PIT on MNF and are -69 ypg (31st) at home TY having been outgained in 9 straight games. TEN has been outtrashed by an almost 2-1 mark (143 ypg 4.2 vs 73 3.6) in that span and are giving up a whopping 47% conversions on 3rd Dn which would be 29th on the year. Mettenberger (shoulder) left LW's game but is expected to play here. The Giants are now reduced to playing for Coughlin's job and pride at this point and we'll call for them by four as the Titans are 2-10 ATS on the year.

DETROIT by 13 over Tampa Bay - The Bucs beat the Lions 24-21 as a 7.5 pt AD LY as Stafford threw 4 ints which TB turned into 10 pts missing a FG. DET had a 25-10 FD and 390-229 yd edge go to waste but now the Lions have extra rest and confidence after beating CHI with HF's being 23-11 ATS after a Thursday Nite win. DET is 6-1 SU/4-2-1 ATS vs foes with a losing record with a 365-289 yd edge (+5 TO's) as Stafford has logged a 304 ypg (63%) 12-4 ratio. This is a plus matchup for DET as the Bucs can't run the ball (#24), can't pass protect (#27 sks) and keep self-destructing via special teams or TO's. TB has given up more penalty yds in 5 games than how many yds rushing TY inc the L3. The Bucs are simply desperate to win and playing undisciplined ball at this point with a 97.0 QBR allowed (22-11 ratio). The Lions own the #2 defense in yards, #1 scoring defense and while the offense hasn't been very explosive the defense should have a field day vs a poor TB OL.

St Louis by 5 over WASHINGTON - The Rams are off their 2nd biggest win in franchise history scoring TD's on their 1st 5 drives before opting to try and run the clock out. Teams that win by 6 TD's or more in a shutout win are 8-2-1 ATS their next game. STL simply played to its strength on defense with 6 sks, 7 QBH and 7 tfl on 75 plays by the Raiders. STL has held foes to 80 yds or less in 4 of their L5 games (49 ypg 2.7) with 22 sks going 4-1 ATS. WAS did get LT Williams back LW but the OL gave up 6 sks, 9 QBH and 6 sks. 168 of WAS 425 yds came in the 4th Qtr with IND trading space for time and WAS played most of the game with just 3 CB's. MINNESOTA by 6 over NY Jets - The Jets are off MNF vs the Dolphins and its unknown how the team responded to Geno Smith being forced to start against the wishes of the coaching staff. The Jets are -66 ypg (#25) on the road TY with a 30-12 avg score with their lone cover on the road being vs NE on Thursday Nite. The Jets have faced 9 straight teams without a losing record and their lone win vs a foe who has a losing record was vs OAK in Wk 1. The Jets have struggled greatly in pass protection (#27) though much of that is on the QB's. The one thing the Vikings can hang their hat on is a solid pass rush going 5-1 ATS when the log 4 or more sacks TY. Bridgewater has quietly put together a respectable 86.7 QBR over the L5 games with 203 ypg (61%) 7-2 as OC Turner is forced to use more 3-step drops to protect him. MIN is off a misleading game vs CAR logging their 1st blocked punt for a TD in 2 years (2 overall) but we'll call for them by 2 FG's as we want to see how Geno Smith fares first.

DENVER by 13 over Buffalo - The Broncos are off LW's SNF game vs KC and have covered 4 of their L5 after SNF under Manning. DEN is 15-7 ATS at home and are +103 ypg (+3 TO's) there with 3 of their L4 wins being by 14 or more. The Broncos are 6-2 SU/3-5 ATS vs foes that own a winning record outgaining them by 80 ypg (+1 TO's) with a 32-26 avg score. DEN has had issues with their run game due to inj's and the OL hasn't given Manning the same protection as 2013. They now get Bills team off a bit of a misleading win vs CLE. The Browns Int'd Orton twice but came away with no points as the Bills had just 6 FD/91 yds at the half. BUF is 3-4 SU vs foes with a winning record but their only covers were vs MIA off their upset win vs NE in Wk 1 and at DET who DC Schwartz knew well. Beating the Jets in a neutral site and Browns at home doesn't carry much weight in this game and the home team is the play.

Kansas City by 3 over Arizona - Similar teams as both are clearly in the playoff hunt while ranking in the mid 20's on offense and in the upper third on defense. Edge however to KC QB Smith whose 14-4 ratio (prior to SN) is solid but on the road his experience shows as his ratio is 7-1. The Chiefs have stepped it up versus opponents close in strength as they are 9-2 ATS when the line is between the 4's. Can still grab value fading the Cardinals who despite B2B losses are still tied for the NFC's best record but the inexperience of QB Drew Stanton who threw 2 int's and was only 1 of 7 on 3rd down will get magnified as the play off pressure increases. The Cardinals offense was tailored towards Palmer throwing deep and running play action to Fitzgerald but that won't happen if your new QB has a 4.9 ypa in his 3 starts and the team is rushing for 49 ypg and 2.7 ypc in that span.

San Francisco by 17 over OAKLAND - Both teams are off humiliating losses with the 49ers owner having to apologize to fans after their loss to SEA. SF is 11-2-1 ATS after losing SU as a favorite and 11-2 ATS as an AF.
