4★ USC over Arizona St - ASU is off a big HG vs UCLA and have to travel while USC is playing with legit revenge after their 62-41 (+4) trouncing on the road at Ast which HC Kiffin was fired when he landed in LA. USC had been 12-1 SU in this series prior. In the last 3, the HT has been an avg fav of 5 ppg but has won by 21 each time. LTH the Sun Devils led 17-14 early 3Q but USC scored the final 24 pts outgaining them 232-41 in that span. These two come in off opposite ends of the spectrum as USC mauled Oreg St 35-10 (-8) as they had a 461-181 yd edge incl 87 & 88 yd TD drives in the 4Q and the Beavers only td was a 97-yd KR. The Sun Devils are off a 62-27 trouncing (+4) at the hands of UCLA as they were outscored 42-3 in about 20 min of gametime after racing out to a 17-6 2Q lead. This will be Bercovic's 1st road start and Sarkisian is 9-4 ATS as a HF while Graham is 1-4 ATS as an AD. Trojans get revenge in a big way!

FORECAST: USC by 21

3★ KENTUCKY over South Carolina - SC is 13-1 SU in this series (8-5-1 ATS). UK is at home a 3rd str wk after having a bye 2 wks ago and SC's playing their 2nd road game in 3W and 6th str wk. Spurrier is now 20-1 SU vs Kentucky. LY SC jumped out to a 21-0 and 27-7 lead but UK got a td early 4Q then SC fmb'd the KO and UK added another td to pull within 6. Trailing 35-21, UK got a td with 4:02 left, kicked off deep. They were penalized for 12 men on the field but the SEC office later confirmed that the call was wrong and SC ran out the clock. In '12 SC trailed 17-7 at half and was outgained 194-98 but never punted in the 2H scoring on 5 of 6 poss and won 38-17 (-21). The 3-1 Cats are +143 ypg TY and LW dominated much more than the 17-7 final over Vandy as they had a 384-139 yd edge (fewest yds UK allowed vs SEC foe s/96) while Vandy's 13 yd IR TD was their only score. Another disappointing play for us LW was SC leading 20-7 mid-4Q allowing Missouri who at the time had just 169 total yds to drive 68 & 51 yds for TD's in a 21-20 upset (-5). SC is already 2-2 in SEC play and can ill afford another loss but UK has impressed us in nearly every game TY. Cats pull the upset!

FORECAST: KENTUCKY by 1

3★ Memphis over CINCINNATI - These 2 used to be conf rivals from '97-'04 with UC going 5-3 SU/ATS and the HT 5-3 SU but 3-5 ATS in that span. LY back in a conf together, they met for the first time s/'04 on a Wed Night at Memphis. UC had a 198-53 yd edge at the half but only led 14-7. UC finished with a 437-232 yd edge, 25-15 FD edge but did go 61/9 for a td w/1:26 left in their 34-21 win (-2). LW the Tigers possibly caught Ole Miss in a look ahead to Bama as they only trailed 7-3 after 3Q but did get outgained 426-104 in their 24-3 loss (+21). They are 3-0-1 ATS and nearly upset UCLA away from home earlier TY. Prior to LW Memphis has gained a FD or scored a TD on 88% of its drives this yr. (3rd best in the FBS) and now will be facing a Cincy D that is all g 546 ypg and LW was scorched for 710 yds and 45 FD's in a 50-28 (+17) loss to OSU. Besides 3 big passing td's, the Bearcats offense produced just 201 yds on their other 49 plays. While this is a conf HG for the Bearcats, it is sandwiched between Ohio St and Miami, FI and they could be a little flat for this one as we'll back the road dog Tigers who have the better D (#40-86) and ST's (#26-101). Upset!

FORECAST: Memphis by 1

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ EAST CAROLINA over Smu - This marks the inaugural AAC gm for EC. Tough to see any line value in this one as ECU is a perfect 4-0 ATS TY after demolishing UNC 70-41 (-2) setting a schl record for yds (789). The 0-4 SU/ATS Ponies could make a case for being TY's worst team as they have been outscored by 48 ppg and are -344 ypg, with their only offensive td being a Hail Mary at the end of the NT gm. It should be noted though that they have played our #1 sked incl Top 10 Baylor and A&M and a TCU tm (beat them 56-0 LW) that is one of the most improved in the country. We have cashed 2 str 2★ selections on these pages going against the Ponies and fully expect to go 3 for 3 here.

FORECAST: EAST CAROLINA by 45

2★ AIR FORCE over Navy - Not hard to figure the previous 17 winners here have gone on to win the Commander-in-Chief's Trophy! AF had won 6 in a row SU in this series but Navy has dominated s/'03 going 9-2 SU/9-1-1 ATS. Amazingly 6 of those times they were an underdog so there have been 7 outright upsets the L11Y incl their last trip here when Navy was +8. AF led 21-13 but Navy got a td & 2 pt conv on the last play and then won it 28-21 in OT. LY Navy had their most lopsided defeat of the Falcons s/'78, 28-10 and were -13 at home but the game was closer than the final score. AF had 19-18 FD edge while the yards were 327-313 for Navy. AF led 10-7 at the half. Trailing 14-10 they were SOD at the NV34 and NV went 66/11 for a td and then AF was int'd at its own 27 w/5:48 left and NV went 27/3 for the spread coverage td. Navy is off a 36-27 (-7) loss to WKU as QB Reynolds compl just 3-14-55-0-1, but did score 2 td's extending his td streak to a nation best 12 str gms. Despite this gm on deck, AF pulled the outright upset over Boise, winning 28-14 (+12) as the Falcons caused 7 TO's. The Falcons are a missed opportunity at WY away from being a perfect 4-0 while Navy is 2-3 and laying over a FG on the road. Take the Fly-Boys to sink the Middies!

OTHER GAMES

Thursday, October 2nd

Florida Atlantic at FIU - This is the 13 annual Shula Bowl and usually it's at the end of the year. Both teams are playing a 6th consecutive week but FAU does have a bye on deck. FAU had won 5 in a row SU/ATS in this series incl B2B outright upsets in '09 and '10. However, LTH FIU was -17 at home and won 41-7. The L2Y FIU has travelled to FAU winning 34-14 (+1) in '12 but LY lost 21-6 although they were +27 getting their 3rd str cover in the series. Both tms come off upset wins as FIU beat UAB 34-20 (+14) while FAU took down UTSA 41-37 (+5). FAU is the better tm but FIU has had their number recently. What tm moves to 2-0 in CUSA play?

UCf at HOUSTON - UCF is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS but the HT is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. LTH in '10 CF was -2 and led 40-27 with UH getting a td w/5:46 left to lose 40-33. LY UCF (-14) led 19-7 but UH got a td w/4:04 left and at the end had a 1&g! at the 10 threatening to pull the upset but had a pass bounce off the WR's hands and they were SOD at the 7. Both teams come in off a bye and this is their conf openers. UCF is 1-2 SU/ATS (-37 ypg) vs our #65 sked while UH is 2-2 SU/ATS (+51 ypg) vs our #107 sked. Both tms figure to be major players in the AAC champ race but who takes the first step?

Arizona at OREGON - Both come off a bye which negates the short wk and travelling for Ariz. Talk about legit revenge. LY the Ducks controlled their destiny to play in the P12 Title gm. UO players talked about the disappointment of playing in the Rose Bowl as they'd wanted the Nat'l Title game. QB Mariota had his first int of the year, on the first play on a tipped pass and that would be telling for things to come as the Cats would pull the shocker 42-16 (+18). Zona's last trip here in '12 was a bit misleading as they lost 49-0 in a battle of ranked teams (AZ #22, UO #3) as AZ had 5 drives in UO terr (2 SOD, 2 TO, missed fg). UO had been 12-2 SU in this series prior to LY's upset and not surprisingly the HT is 8-2-1 ATS. Both tms are 4-0 SU but 1-3 ATS and both are off thrilling conf wins. While the Ducks are clearly the better tm, will their OL and defensive issues keep Arizona in it until the end in a gm that figures to have a lot of pts?

Friday, October 3rd

Louisville at SYRACUSE - Former BE members from 2005-12. Schools last gm ('12) was also at the Carrier Dome. UL came in 9-0 (ranked #11) but trailed 38-13 late 3Q (45-19 w/1:14 left) despite only being outgained by 52 yds. Louisville is 5-3 SU but 2-6 ATS vs the Cuse. LW the Cards greatly disappointed us as

they were our FREE Sept 5★ and despite having dominant 21-7 FD and 421-100 yd edges they only beat WF 20-10 (-20) as they had 3 TO's, missed 2 FG's and Wake's only TD was a FR for a td in the EZ. The Cuse are off B2B losses but usually get fired up for weekday night gms in the Dome. This one looks like a toss-up. **San Diego St at FRESNO ST** - FSU has won 3 of the last 4 SU and is 2-1-1 ATS in this series.

LY was a tough loss for the Aztecs as FSU got a 78 yd FR td on a play the Aztecs thought was dead and Sdst missed a FG on the final play of regulation losing in OT. LTH ('12) FSU led 36-27 but Sdst got a 96 yd IR td to take the lead 40-36 w/9:09 left. FSU scored the game's final 17 pts and won 52-40 (-7) as a 3★ LPS as FSU had 32-14 FD and 655-339 yd edges. Both tms are off DD MW conf wins after going a comb 0-5 vs the Power 5 conf tms. Fresno has the off edge (#43-94) but Sdst has the D edge (#58-109). Which team moves to 2-0 in conf play?

Utah St at BYU - LY was the first time USt was fav'd in a game (-6) vs BYU as far back as our records go (76). USt lost QB Keeton to inj early and would lose the game 31-14 as we cashed a 3★ on the Cougs on a Fri Night. BYU is 11-1 SU in this series but USt is 6-2 ATS. USt's L/win in Provo was in '78, 17 str losing trips incl a 6-3 loss (+6) the LTH on a Fri. The Cougs are a perfect 4-0 SU but after the 41-7 win over TX, their lines have been inflated and we cashed a Thur Night Marquee vs them (on UH +17) and a 2★ on UVA (+14) on these pages in their L/gm. Both tms are off byes and while BYU is the better tm, we'll pass until we get a firm status of USt QB Keeton (missed L/gm, ? here).

Saturday, October 4th

GEORGIA by 38 over Vanderbilt - LY VU got their first win over UGA in Nashville s/'91 as UGA had been 17-1 SU in this series. UGA was missing their top 2 RB's and 3 of their top 4 rec's and VU finished with a 337-221 yd edge. UGA is clearly playing with legitimate revenge as they led 24-14 at half and were in control of the gm. The key play happened when Vandy faced a 4th down and were stopped but UGA was flagged for targeting. The ejection was overturned but they got to keep the pen and went on to a td. VU pulled within 27-24 with 4:44 left then UGA fmb'd at their 13 and VU got a td w/2:46 left to pull out the upset win. UGA is in their 3rd str HG while VU is on their 2nd str AG. LTH UGA was a 4★ LPS (-14) and clubbed VU 43-0 putting up 567 yds. While UGA escaped with a 35-32 win (-17) over UT LW, they did give up 401 yds. Expect an angry DC Pruitt here as following the SCar poor D performance, they shutout Troy earlier TY. Vandy LW only had 139 yds (fewest yds all'd by UK s/96 in a SEC gm) as they were fortunate to cover in their 17-7 loss (+17) as their only td was an IR and they were outFD'd 23-8. Despite having a big gm vs Mizzou on deck, look for the Bulldogs to get revenge in a big way.

FLORIDA ST By 49 over Wake Forest - Here is a stat I'm sure will surprise you. WF is 4-4 SU/ATS in this series and had actually won 4 of 6 games from '06-'11. The L2Y it has been "Men against Boys" with FSU winning by a comb'd 111-3. You can look at LY's box score and think WF did a good job as they were only outgained 296-166 but 6 int's kept setting up FSU for a short field and they led 42-0 at the half and basically put it on cruise control in the 2H. This is WF's 3rd AG in 4 wks. While the defending champs are 4-0 SU, they have failed to cover each gm TY (mostly due to LY's dominating scores and 11-2-1 ATS record). LW despite the return of Winston they again were not that impressive in a 56-41 road win (-18) over NCSt as they fell behind 24-7 in the 1Q (most pts ever all'd by FSU in the 1Q) and also trailed 38-28 late 3Q. The yds and FD's were even. Our FREE Sept 5★ played out exactly how we thought it would except for the final scoreboard. The Demon Deacons were outFD'd 21-7, outgained 421-100 but benefitted from 3 UL TO's, 2 UL missed FG's while Wake's only td came via a recovered fumble in the EZ. They are getting outscored by just 9 ppg on the road despite being -246 ypg as they have scored 3 non-offensive td's. They are actually avg -17 rush ypg (-0.7) away from home and have given up 21 sks in those 3 gms. Not good news facing a Noles tm (particularly on D) needing a statement win.

Miami, FI by 1 over GEORGIA TECH - On a cold night in Atlanta in '08, UM all'd 472 ypg rush (8.4). They have a very athletic def front 7 and after that embarrassing performance, a gm UM lost 41-23. UM is now 5-1 SU/TS in this series. UM has all'd 210 ypg rush to GT in their L/6 gms which is the 2nd best in the ACC (VT 188 L/6). LY UM was -6' at home and won 45-30 in a somewhat misleading final as GT led 24-23 with only 10:38 left. LTH UM was +13' and won outright 42-36 in OT. GT led 36-19 mid-3Q before UM scored the last 23 pts of the game incl a td pass with :23 left to force OT. GT has the scheduling edge here as they are fresh off a bye while UM is playing a 6th str wk. LW the Canes played an overrated 4-0 Duke tm that had played a soft sked (UM's sked much tougher) and the Canes had a 426-264 yd edge in their 22-10 win (-6). Frosh QB Kaaya in the L/3 gms is avg 308 (64%) w/a 9-3 ratio. GT is 4-0 and in their L/outing upset VT 27-24 (+7). They are just +43 ypg vs the #104 sked, while Miami is +102 ypg vs our #61 sked. This one goes down to the wire.

INDIANA by 10 over North Texas - Indiana dropped the only prior gm in '11, 24-21 (-6) at NT. IU actually trailed 24-10 in the 4Q being outgained 430-194. After cutting the deficit to 3 w/1:05 left (87/8pt td) the Hoosiers inside K failed. The Mean Green will only leave the state of TX twice TY (here & next wk at UAB) and they are 3-9 SU s/'06 after a reg ssn bye wk and have failed to cover each of their L/3. In their L/gm they went to their most talented QB in Dajon Williams and he hit 11-14-176 but it did come against a very poor FCS Nicholls ST tm in their 77-3 (-38') win. The Jekyll and Hyde Hoosiers were upset by BG 45-42 (-7) 3 wks ago, then upset Mizzou 31-27 (+13') on the road. LW back at home they were upset by MD 37-15 (-3) despite the fact MD's QB Brown was inj'd and DNP the entire 2H. Indy QB Sudfeld has been disappointing w/just 2 td passes thru 4 gms and was just 14 of 37 LW vs a MD defense missing 3 str's. Can't lay too much here with a poor Hoosier D.

ILLINOIS by 10 over Purdue - PU is 7-2 SU/5-4 ATS in this series but the HT is 8-2 ATS incl 4 str ATS wins. The last 3 gms in the series have been decided by a td or less. LTH PU never trailed and led 20-10 in the 4Q with IL getting a td with 3:29 left and PU recovering the onside kick. IL III was in the rare role of being a B10 AF as they were -6' here despite coming in with a 20-gm B10 losing streak. IL had a 380-283 yd edge but only won 20-16 which incl taking a safety on the game's final play. LW Purdue (+8) got a 39-yd IR td and led 10-0 early 2Q with a 74-16 yd edge. The L/3 Q's were all low as they outscored the Boilers 24-0 and more impressively outgained them 404-82 in their 24-10 win. QG Eting continues to struggle and LW was just 11-26-61-0-1 while Appleby got some snaps late. Illini QB Lunt was a late scratch LW (O'Toole 17-38-261-1-3) and they would get run over 45-14 (+21') vs Neb incl getting outrushed 458-78 (outFD'd 35-16). Provided Lunt is back for this one (CS), we expect the Illini to move to 4-2 as Pur lost their 4 B10 AG's LY by 22 ppg.

Ohio St by 7 over MARYLAND - First meeting. Maryland is 1-12 SU their L/13 gms vs ranked opp's incl 8 str losses by 21 ppg (4-4 ATS). Under Meyer, OSU is 8-0 SU on the B10 road but in half the gms only won by a td or less and they finished LY failing to cover their L/4 B10 gms. While this is QB Barrett's 1st true road start (had crowd edge vs Navy), it is notable that this venue is just 31 miles from their opener. After the Bucks young OL and QB faced VT's blitzing D, nothing would surprise them anymore and the offense in the L/2 gms has exploded incl piling up 710 yards (most s/86) and 45 FD's (schl rec) LW in a 50-28 win (-17') over Cincy LW. The Pass D continues to be an issue though all g 352 yds. The 4-1 T-eps cashed us another outright Underdog POW winner (given out FREE every Tuesday by calling 347-677-1700 on Button #3) LW in their 37-15 (+3) win over Indiana. They accomplished this despite the fact QB Brown not playing the entire 2H. While they are outscoring their opp by 17 ppg, they are -17 ypg. Considering Brown is ? for this gm at presstime (Rowe was 12-18-198-2-0 in relief LW) we'll call for the Bucks by 7 and see if there is any value later in the week.

VIRGINIA by 7 over Pittsburgh - Both tms are playing their 6th straight game but both have byes on deck. The HT is 3-0 SU/ATS. LTH in '07 UVA won 44-14 (-6). LY the game was closer than the final. UVA PR fmb'd and Pitt had 19 & 18 yd "drives", both for td's in their 14-3 win (-5). Pitt only had a 199-188 yd edge. These tms look to be going in opposite directions as the Cavs are a perfect 5-0 ATS TY and LW rolled Kent St 45-13 (-27) as Matt Johns played for an inj'd Greyson Lambert (ankle, CS). Johns has actually gotten significant time in 3 of their 5 gms TY and there isn't much difference between the two. Pitt has now dropped 3 straight ATS and LW were upset by Akron 21-10 (-21). One of the more shocking stats of LW was Akron RB Conner Hundley (148) outrushing Pitt RB James Center (92) who came in leading the country w/699 yds. His heavy workload (135 carries TY) maybe taking a toll as his rushing totals have decreased each of the L/3 wks and now will be facing an UVA run D all g just 96 ypg (2.9). Cavs make it 6-0 ATS and continue the Panthers woes.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Ohio - Surprisingly CM is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS in the series. In that span, they've twice met for the MAC Title game ('06/'09) and the HT has lost 3 in a row SU. OU is playing with legit revenge as LY they were -18'. CM down 23-19 punted with 2:47 left but OU fmb'd the punt and CM went 39/8 for a td and the win w/22 left. OU did win here at CM 43-28 (-7) in '11. LW CM welcomed back both WR Davis (6-128) and RB Rawls (17-65) but they did lose 42-28 (+14) to UT. CM did fumble at the UT5 at the end of game. The Bobcats are off a somewhat misleading 34-19 win (-8) over FCS E III as they were outFD'd 21-20 and outgained 432-387. JD Sprague st'g in place of an inj'd Vick was just 15-28-143-0-2 but did have 69 rush yds and 2 td's. Ohio is only 2-8 ATS as an AD while CM is 5-1 ATS as a HF and we'll call for the HT by a FG.

WEST VIRGINIA by 28 over Kansas - The HT is 2-0 SU/ATS covering by 28.5 and 19 pts. LTH ('12) KU trailed 52-7 into the 4Q losing 59-10 (+20). LY KU was the Big Dog POW on button #9 on Thursday (did you call to get your Free Big Dog Play this week?) delivering yet another outright upset winner. KU led 31-7 w/6:24 left and WV went 75/5 for a garbage td w/4:54 left then KU fumbled at the WV 27 and WV went 73/10 for another brbg td w/28 left. Both of these coaches came into the ssn on the hot seat but only one remains as LW Kansas lost to Texas 23-0 (+12) and would fire Charlie Weis after just 2+ seasons (6-22). DC Clint Bowen will take over as interim HC (played LB for KU in 90's and been an asst here s/'98). Despite just a 2-2 record, the Mountaineers are a much improved tm TY only losing to our top 2 tms in Bama and OU and actually outgained the Sooners 513-510 2 wks ago as they come in off a bye. QB Trickett is avg 400 pass ypg (72%) w/a 9-3 ratio. KU has dropped 28 straight AG's (9-19 ATS) and we see no end in sight especially against a WV tm that is +147 ypg vs our #3 sked!

Toledo by 6 over WESTERN MICHIGAN - A back and forth series as UT won 5 in a row from '01-'05. WM then won 4 in a row SU from '06-'09 but UT has now won 4 in a row SU by an avg of 47-31. The visitor is 4-3 SU but 6-1 ATS and there have been 5 outright upsets the L8Y. LTH UT was +1', jumped out to a 20-0 lead and won 37-17. LY UT was up 47-7 (-22) when WM got 19 and 35 yd fg's then went 96/7 for a garbage td w/2:14 left. UT's Woodside has done well in his 3 starts (813 yds, 6-2 ratio) and LW UT did have a 339-89 yd edge at the half but CM kept it close in the 2H incl fumb'g at the UT5 late. WM was our Underdog POW on these pages and a lot of you must have played it because the line moved 5.5 pts during the week and it still didn't matter in a 35-17 (+21) loss to VT giving the Broncos 3 str ATS wins. They were outFD'd 26-10 and outgained 486-231 but did fumble the opening KO for a TD. We'll back the HD here getting over a TD but UT gets the SU win.

Marshall by 21 over OLD DOMINION - First meeting. MU is 5-10 SU their L15 gms after a bye wk (bowls incl) but over the L2Y are 3-1 SU/ATS. This gm will feature not only 2 of CUSA's best QB's but 2 of the nations as well in Rakeem Cato & Taylor Heinicke. The Herd are a perfect 4-0 and are +269 ypg vs the #127 sked. Their offense has topped 40 pts in each of the 1st 4 gms for the 1st time s/1938. 2 wks ago Akron figured to be a tough road test but Marsh led 41-3 in the 4Q (2 Zip TD 4Q). Keep in mind, that was against a Zips tm that just upset Pitt LW. While they have been known as a great offensive tm, the L3 yrs, their D has allowed only 2 FG's in the 1H of games (103-6). ODU after their upset over Rice couldn't handle success and lost 41-28 (-3') to MT in their 1st CUSA HG. Heinicke did throw 3 int's in a game for only the 2nd time in his career. We usually fade the Herd on the road but TY's team could be different and look for them to come away with an easy win.

NORTH CAROLINA by 4 over Virginia Tech - This is NC's 1st HG in a month but they are off of Clemson and have ND on deck. VT only had WM LW and has a bye on deck. VT is 8-2 SU in this series. 5-5 ATS. LY we had a 3★ Key Selection on these pages on VT -7 at home. It was 21-7 at the half with VT having a 277-147 yd edge. NC gained 89 of their yds on 13 plays for a garbage td w/1:09 left for a 27-17 final. LTH the Hokies led 7-0 and only trailed 21-17 mid-2Q but spent most of the 2H down DD's (one of their tms was a 93 yd KR) in a 48-34 (+5) loss. These two tms have disappointed TY as the Hokies are 3-2 SU but have dropped 3 str ATS after the upset win over Ohio St and LW we cashed our Underdog POW on these pages going against them in their 35-17 win (-21) over WM. QB Brewer continues to be a TO machine (9-10 ratio TY). We expected NC to fold LW after a 70-41 loss to ECU the wk prior and while we cashed a 3★ on these pages going against them in a 50-35 loss (+14) to Clemson, we were impressed as they didn't give up especially offensively. Look for the Heels to rebound here and give VT 4 str ATS losses.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 28 over Kent St - NI has now won 7 in a row SU/6-1 ATS in the series. These two met in the MAC Title game in '12 (both ranked with an Orange Bowl bid on the line) and KS suffered a tough 7 pt loss in OT. Since then the Golden Flashes are just 4-13. LTH ('11) NI was -16' and led 40-3 before KSU got a 35 yd FR td w/2:40 left. NI had a 344-64 yd edge and has held KSU to 260 yds or less in 4 of the last 6 meetings. LY KSU led 24-21 early 3Q but NI went 84/10, 94/15 td's 35-24 13:00 4Q. NI went 56/10 for a 31 yd fg w/7:25 left and KSU was SOD at the NI19 1:23. NI is off a bye and off a 52-14 loss (+13) to Ark snapping their 17-gm away win streak as we cashed a 3★ on these pages going against them. However, we were VERY impressed with their defensive front slowing down Arkansas's run game (held them to a respectable 212 rush yds). Kent has not been so impressive as they are 0-4 SU/ATS and LW were outscored 31-3 in the 2H in their 45-13 loss (+27') to UVA. The Flashes are getting outgained by 229 ypg while NI is +127. KSU has lost 10 str trips to DeKalb (L/win in '66) and we look for the Huskies to roll over them here as they have won 27 straight (17-10 ATS) at home.

Wisconsin by 4 over NORTHWESTERN - These two have only met twice the L4Y but both times the Badgers have dominated with UW winning 70-23 in '10 (-23). LY UW had a great situation as NU was coming off one of their largest HG's in sch'l hist vs Ohio St and had to go on the road vs UW with a big O-line that was fresh off a bye. NU hung tough for the 1H but we used UW as a 4★ Key Selection on these pages and 4★ Top Weekly LPS and they were -10 and rolled a to a 35-6 win finishing with a 527-241 yd edge. Interestingly, the HT has won 7 in a row SU in this series (6-0-1 ATS). Also, the Badgers have been favored by 10, 6 and 7 their last 3 trips to NW and lost all 3 outright. LW we figured the Badgers would continue to roll over inferior opp like they did vs BG 2 wks ago but USF only trailed Wisky 17-10 in the 3Q and held RB Gordon to 17-50 in the 1H. In the 2H Gordon had 15-131 and UW had 26-8 FD and 454-245 yd edges for the game in their 27-10 (-33) win. NW pulled a shocker beating Penn St 29-6 (+11') and the game could have been much worse if not for some ? calls by HC Fitzgerald incl a fake FG up 14-0 that was SOD. While the Badgers are the superior tm, series says to take the Cats here who should have renewed confidence after LW's win.

MIAMI, OH by 6 over Massachusetts - The HT has won both their meetings SU but UMass is 2-0 ATS. LTH ('12) Miami was -23'. They led 21-3 and 27-10 but gave up an 80 yd td drive w/3:21 left and only won 27-16. LY UMass was -5' at home and it was a battle of winless tms. Miami did lead 10-7 but UMass got a 25 yd fg w/11:49 left, 17-10 and Mia was SOD at the UM23 and their own 30 on the L2 drives. While their records don't show it (both tms 0-5), these two tms are much improved TY as Miami is only getting outgained by 69 ypg (LY -258) while UMass has lost 3 gms by 5 pts or less incl LW's 47-42 (+5') barnburner vs BG (1,306 total yds). The RedHawks have lost 21 str gms overall and are only 3-9 ATS as a HF but we think they break the streak here as they are +63 ypg at home TY while UMass is coming off 4 str Power 5 conf tms and played an emotional HG (1st in Amherst in 3 yrs) LW.

South Alabama by 6 over APPALACHIAN ST - First meeting. LW South Alabama's offense had a season-high 429 yds and their defense held their opponent to a season low for the 3rd straight week in their 34-10 win (-4) at the Kibbie Dome. The Mountaineers had their chances vs GA Southern LW but down 24-14 in the 3Q they were SOD and then were picked off on their next drive while inside the GS redzone that ended up being key in a 34-14 loss (+19'). They are playing in their 1st ever SBC HG while S Bama is in a tough B2B road trip. Despite the situational disadvantage we like SA's big D edge (#69-115) and also they've won and covered their L2 AG's vs inferior tms.

ARMY by 1 over Ball St - Pete Lembo is a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS vs Army winning by an avg of 39-19. LY Ball St was the Early Bird POW on the NC Sports Comp line. BS was w/o RB Edwards, DE Newsome, LB Boyd and WR Shillings (all inj) but it didn't matter as they raced out to a 37-7 lead and cruised 40-14. Both tms have been disappointing TY as the Cardinals are 1-3 SU (incl a loss to an FCS sch'l) but do come in off a bye with an extra week to prep for the option. Army is 1-3 SU/ATS and LW were upset by Yale 49-43 in OT (-14') in a gm marking the 100th anniversary of the Yale Bowl. Army never trailed in regulation and was up 28-14 when QB Schurr was injured in the 4Q. For now we'll call for the HT by 1 until we see an injury report on Schurr later in the week.

BOWLING GREEN by 8 over Buffalo - BG is now 8-2 SU/6-4 ATS in this series. The visitor has won 6 in a row SU and is on a 7-0 ATS run with 4 outright upsets the last 6 years. This is the first meeting here s/'10 when BU (+3) led 28-13 and won outright 28-26. LY this was the game for the MAC East Title played in Ralph Wilson Stadium. BG had just 7 FD on 7 1H poss and trailed 7-3 at the half but had a 152-93 yd edge. BG went 71/6 and 93/7 for td's in the 3Q to lead 17-7 and added a td w/9:30 left for a 24-7 win. In '13 BG's D allowed 321 ypg. TY they are all g almost DOUBLE at 619 ypg. That's not good news considering Buffalo had 575 yds vs Miami Oh (2nd highest s/join FBS '99) in their 35-27 (-6') win. BG escaped UMass with a 47-42 win (-5') to move to 3-2. So far under new HC Babers they have been a much better home tm with a 41 pt win over WMI and an upset over Indy 3 wks ago. We will call for the visitor's streak of success to end here.

AKRON by 28 over Eastern Michigan - UA lost 31-23 (+8') in the L/gm ('11) which snapped a 3 gm series winning streak. UA never led & trailed 14-0 mid-2Q. Down 8, w/ the ball w/2:04 left the Zips drove to the EM34 but their 4th&14 pass fell inc. LTH ('09) EM lost 28-21, in fact EM has dropped 4 str Akron trips (L/win in '95). The Zips are coming off one of their biggest wins in sch'l history as they upset Pitt 21-10 (+21). The shocking stat of the week was unknown ZIP RB Conor Hundley running for 148 yds, out-rushing the NCAA leader James Conner (92 yds). A case could be made for EM to be the worst tm in the FBS TY as they are -283 ypg and incredibly on offense have just 331 pass yds on 104 attempts! Even though they are coming off a bye, and Akron is 2-7 ATS hosting MAC foes off a big upset, the Zips are clearly the better tm and EM is just 2-8 ATS their L10 AG's.

KANSAS ST by 17 over Texas Tech - TT won 5 in a row SU in this series from '01-'09 incl winning the L3 by 40 ppg but KSU has now won 3 in row SU/ATS with 2 outright upsets and have won the L2 by 31 and 23 pts. LY KSU was the Big 12 POW on the NC Comp Line (given out FREE every Friday on Button #9). KSU led 35-10 at the half with a 279-196 yd edge and 49-19 in the 4Q before TT got a td w/7:08 left. LTH KSU was -7' on the road and trailed 10-3 but then scored 52 of the next 59 pts. TT is 0-4 the L4Y in a 2nd str AG while KSU only had UTEP LW and has a bye on deck. Remarkably the Wildcats and Miners combined for 86 pts LW despite just a total of 26 FD's! Kan St had just 171 yds at the half but 31 pts. They benefitted greatly from their ST's as a blocked punt set up a 17 yd "drive," they had a 58 yd PR TD and then a 51 yd PR set up a 20 yd TD "drive." TT is now just 2-9 ATS as an AD and saw their st'g QB Webb get hurt in the 45-35 loss (+13') to OkSt on Thur Night. Webb is ? here and even if he can go, we think the Wildcats are better than the Pokes.

RICE by 7 over Hawaii - Played as WAC foes from '99-'04. Rice is 4-2 SU/6-0 ATS and the LTH ('04) won 41-29. The Warriors have lost 14 str off the island (7-7 ATS, all as dogs) and are 0-4 SU/ATS off a bye vs FBS foes, with an avg loss by 11 ppg. The Owls are 16-7 ATS as a HF but saw their 9-gm home win streak come to an end 2 wks ago vs ODU. LW they beat SMiss 41-23 (-8') as they benefitted from 3 SMiss TO's. They did have a 217-40 rush yd edge. Hawaii comes in a banged up tm at 1-3 and we cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages and 4★ Top Weekly LPS going against them in their L/gm vs Colorado. They have played our #38 sked and are only getting outgained by 27 ypg. Technical edges say go with the Owls here but tough to back them by more than a TD especially vs a UH tm that has lost to the likes of Wash, Oreg St and Col by 6 ppg TY.

COLORADO ST by 17 over Tulsa - LY they met for the 1st time s/'98. CSU was a Big Dog POW and should have won outright. TU was -10' at home. CSU led 27-17 after 3Q. TU was SOD on 4&4 at the CSU 36 w/2:16 left but CSU punted and TU got a 34 yd fg on the last play. TU had a 427-286 yd edge. One of the biggest shockers of LW was CST in their longest road trip ever beating BC 24-21 (+8) as they got a td pass w/1:02 left to move to 3-1. They are now 11-7 SU and 13-5 ATS in their L18 gms as they continue to improve. On the other side, it's beginning to get ugly at Tulsa as the Golden Hurricane are now just 4-12 SU/ATS their L16 gms after a 37-34 3OT loss to Texas St at home. TST actually led 17-3 in the 4Q before Tulsa rallied. McElwain is 7-2 ATS as a HF and we look for them to get a solid win here before a big gm vs Nevada next wk.

LOUISIANA by 20 over Georgia St - LY UL was a 21 pt AF but only had a 482-481 yd edge. In LY's inaugural mtg it was tied at 7-7 and 21-21. Elijah McGuire became the first ever UL player to top 100 yds both rush and rec in the same gm. After 2 UL td's GS was SOD 3x (@UL16, 32, 43). The Ragin Cajuns are pushing the reset button after the bye and 3 str blowout losses to La Tech, Ole Miss and Boise. Ga St is also off a bye. In their L/gm they led UW 14-0 at HT (231-73 yd edge) but were outscored 45-0 in the 2H (263-42 yd deficit). Shockingly, Ga St is +9 ypg while Louisiana is -94 ypg but there is a huge diff in sked strength as Ga St's ranks #126 while UL's is #53. TY's Sun Belt favorites need to start playing like it and this week we think they take the first step.

NOTRE DAME by 3 over Stanford - ND had won 7 in a row SU from '02-'08 but SU is now 4-1 SU in series but 2-4-1 ATS. ND only had a bye and Syr the L2W while Stanford is on their 2nd str AG off a trip to Huskie Stadium with a Friday night game on deck. SU's LTH had a controversial ending as RB Taylor was ruled down and progress stopped in OT and the Cardinal lost 20-13 (+7). LY they were -15' at home ply'g with legit revenge and ND came in a banged up team. SU had the P12 Title gm on deck. SU jumped out to a 21-6 3Q lead but the Irish got a pair of 3Q td's to pull within 24-20. SU got a 28 yd fg w/9:16 left. Tommy Turnover would then throw 2 costly picks in the final 5:30 both in Stanford territory. The Irish come in at a perfect 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS and LW QB Golson hit a sch'l rec 25 straight passes (1 off FBS record). ND had a 5-1 TO deficit but still won 31-15 (-8') over the Cuse as they had a 311-142 yd edge at the half. LW in a 13-13 gm UW failed on a fake punt on 4&9 and the Cardinal drove for the GW to 20-13 (-7'). Stanford did have a 364-179 yd edge. ND has the off edge (#27-54) but Stanford has the D edge (#1-21). This is a game with big time playoff implications and we expect it to go down to the wire just like the LTH while siding with the HD Irish.

AUBURN by 10 over Lsu - The purple-and-gold Tigers have consistently been more physical than the orange-and-blue Tigers, and it hasn't been close. There's only one SEC program that's beaten Auburn six times in the last 7 yrs. Auburn didn't score more than 24 points in any of those games while LSU got to 30 or more 4x. LY LSU had a big game vs UGA on deck and was -17 at home. They jumped out to a 21-0 lead as the rain effected Aub's offense in the 1H. Malzahn coming out of HT thought his offense would be in good shape with the rain letting up and Aub did put up 318 yds in the 2H in the 35-21 loss. LTH LSU was -20' but only won 12-10 despite a 351-183 yd edge. The HT is 4-1 ATS (12-2 SU) with the only non-cover being LY. TY Aub comes in 4-0 but has suffered B2B ATS losses after compiling 13 str. LW they beat La Tech 45-17 (-32). This will be the 1st true AG for many of LSU's young skill pos players. Don't be surprised if they don't go to the true frosh Harris here after Jennings had 3 TO's in the 1Q (2-5-11-0-2) while Harris had 7 series and led 7 TD drives. LSU had a 563-274 yd edge in their 63-7 win (-42') over NMST. Look for the Tigers from the Plains to take adv of a LSU run D that allowed 268 rush (6.9) to Wisc and 302 rush (6.2) to Miss St.

Oklahoma by 3 over TCU - OU is 4-1 SU but 4 of their 5 matchups s/'98 have been close. LTH OU was -5' & led 24-14 into the 4Q and TCU got to a 4&13 to the OU 15 down 7 w/2:55 left but fired incomplete & the Sooners won 24-17. LY was a flat spot for OU as they were off ND and had the Red River Rivalry on deck. OU dominated the 1H w/an amazing 191-16 yd edge & TCU opened the gm w/10 str 3&outs, not getting their 1st FD until mid 3Q. TCU got a 25 yd fg then conv'd an inside kick & went 35/6 for another td, 13-10 (:08 3Q). OU got a 76 yd td run w/4:37 left & TCU went 75/5 for a td w/2:26 left, 20-17 (+8). This is the Sooners' 3rd AG in 4 wks (off a bye LW) & TX is on deck. TCU had a bye and SMU the L2W & will be highly motivated for this HG. TCU had no trouble shutting out SMU 56-0 (-32) cashing us another 'Early Bird' winner (given out FREE every Monday by calling 347-677-1700 on Button #9). Great battle in the trenches as the Horned Frogs are all g just 92 (2.1) rush ypg while the Sooners deep backfield is avg 223 (5.9) rush ypg. To the wire here.

TENNESSEE by 3 over Florida - UF's last trip here they delivered as a 3★ for PS/LPS as they were actually a 3 pt dog and won 37-20. They trailed that game 14-10 at the half but dominated the 2H. LY UT made the unusual move of giving rFR Peterman his first start and the Vols offense struggled in the 1H as they were outgained 199-31. UF QB Driskel threw an int which was re'd 62 yds for a td in the 1Q and was inj'd and OFY on the play. Bkp QB Murphy led them to 199 yds in the 1H and a 17-7 lead as they all'd just 31 yds. UT brought str Worley off the bench in the 2H and ply'd much better with 189 yds and UF won 31-17 (-16). UF is off their blowout loss to Bama & a bye with LSU on deck. UT travelled to Athens & gave UGA all they could handle in the 35-32 (+17) loss, their 21st str on the road vs ranked tms. QB Worley was hit and inj'd his throwing elbow but did return and hit 23-35-264-3-0. UF has now won 9 in a row SU in this series (7-2 ATS) but we look for that to come to an end TY and make Muschamp's seat even hotter.

UAB +13' over WKU

These tms haven't met s/97. The Blazers are 0-2 in Bowling Green, incl a 32-18 loss as IAA foes the LTH ('95). WKU HC Brohm was the QB cch/OC at UAB in '12. WKU is off a 36-27 (+7) outright upset win at Navy with 30-22 FD & 551-467 yd edges & has a bye on deck. QB Doughty is much impr'd after finishing LY with a 14-14 ratio he already has 14 td's TY with just 3 int's. UAB is off a shocking 34-20 (-17) loss to FIU despite having 21-9 FD & 380-297 yd edges as they were done in by 6 TO's incl 2 int's ret'd for TD's. UAB JC tran QB Clements had been playing well compl 68% of his passes but was just 16-29-188 (1-2 ratio). The UAB offense looked nothing like the one that had 548 yds & 34 pts vs MissSt. The Hilltoppers are all g 498 ypg so a shootout is possible and don't overreact to LW's results as WKU had a 43 yd IR td under a min left while we already outlined UAB's misleading final.

Baylor by 14 over TEXAS - UT had beaten BU 12 str yrs winning by 37 ppg, all by DD from 1998-'09 but BU is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS since. LTH UT was -8' and won 56-50. They led 56-43 when BU got a 94/15pl drive for a td w/1:57 left. LY when OSU led earlier in the day, this was basically the de facto Big 12 Title game. UT QB McCoy had a horrific game. On a cold and windy day he hit 12-34-54. Petty hit 21-37-287. The game was tied at 3 at half. BU with the wind at their back in the 3Q, converted on 3&9 and 3&11 on their opening drive for a td and would go up 20-3 after 3Q. BU's 30-10 (-16') win secured their 1st ever B12 Title & 1st title s/'80 (SWC). UT is off a 23-0 (-13') shutout over KU as they forced 4 TO's. BU is off a 49-28 (-21) win at ISU. Heisman hopeful QB Petty threw for 336 yds w/3 tl td's and they had the ball inside Iowa St's 10-yd line at the end. The home team has won 3 sir by 17 ppg. This is BU's 2nd of B2B true road gms & they are on a 2-5 ATS run in that situation. Horns play inspired but Bears are too good.

OKLAHOMA ST by 17 over Iowa St - In the L5Y OSU is 4-1 SU/ATS with their 4 wins coming by 30 ppg with an avg line of -16 in those wins. Their lone loss came in '11 in Ames when they were #2 in the country and lost on a Thurs night, 37-31 (-27) which cost them a berth in the Nat'l Title game. LY in a return trip to Ames, they jumped out to a 21-0 lead on their first 3 drives. ISU battled back to only trail 28-20 HT and had a 247-171 yd edge. OSU got a 58 yd FR td 6:38 3Q to lead 45-20 and won 58-27 (-12). The Cyclones have lost each of their L/3 Stillwater trips by 21+ pts (avg loss by 31 ppg). OSU enters with 2 extra days to prepare as they are coming off a 45-35 (-14') win over TT on Thurs night. The Pokes were outFD'd 32-22, but did outgain the Red Raiders 528-512 as the tms comb'd for 1,034 tl yds. Former w/o & BU QB Garman is a much better passer than inj'd QB Walsh & hit 17-31-370 (4-2 ratio) and each of his 8 td passes TY have come on throws from 15+ yds. OSU's rush offense has struggled TY & it may be time for the jet quick JC tran RB Hill (6.0 ypc) to get more involved. ISU is off a 49-28 (+21) loss to Baylor in which they all'd 357 pass yds against their 1st true pass offense they've faced TY. Their DL is also banged up & they can't play ball control as they are avg just 104 (3.4) rush ypg. Despite the ATS loss LW, OSU is 27-14-1 as a HF & are on a 10-4 run.

Alabama by 7 over MISSISSIPPI - The Tide has won 10 in a row SU in this series but Ole Miss is 6-4 ATS. The last 2 trips here Bama has had a 474-157 yd edge winning by a comb 74-10. LY MU QB Wallace thought they could put up pts on Bama and the Tide were being disrespected and the line kept dropping to under 2 td's. We pounced with a 4★ LPS on Bama and the Tide finished with a 434-205 yd edge in the 25-0 win becoming the first #1 ranked team to shutout a ranked team s/'01. The Rebels ended their 12 drives with 6 punts, 3 SOD, 2 TO's and a SAF. Wallace hit just 17-31-159 and had 5 yds rush. It was Ole Miss' first shutout s/'98 (34-0 vs Ark). Bama comes in fresh off a bye, this is their first road game of the season & they have a trip to Ark on deck. Ole Miss is off a 24-3 (-18') win over Memphis. They held Memp to just 104 tl yds & have all'd just 2 td's thru 4 gms TY, least in the nation. Ole Miss is just 5-11 SU/7-9 ATS the L4Y hosting SEC foes & just 5-9 as a HD. Bama is 8-5 as an AF. The visitor in this series is 6-2 ATS and we expect the Tide to make it 7-2.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 4 over Texas A&M - A&M has won both SEC matchups & MS hasn't beaten A&M in the reg ssn s/'1915! LTH MS came in #16 and A&M #17 and the Aggies absolutely dominated the 1H leading 31-0 and with 12:40 left in the 3Q had a 466-89 yd edge in their 38-13 (-7) win. LY A&M was -19 and led 51-27 mid-4Q with MSt getting td's w/6:45 and 2:19 left for the cover, 51-41. We cashed our Sat College 900 POD Marquee going against A&M as they had a hard fought come-from-behind 35-28 (+10) win over Arkansas. They were down 28-14 4Q before sending the gm into OT on a 59 yd td pass w/2:08 left 4Q as QB Hill threw for over 200 yds & 3 td's in the 4Q & OT. The Aggies are 5-0 SU for the 1st time s/'01. MS is fresh off a bye & a statement win in Death Valley over LSU. The 570 tl yds the Bulldogs gained in their L/gm was the most under Mullen in SEC play breaking the 556 tl yds they had vs A&M in LY's loss. QB Prescott deserves to be in the Heisman race as he is avg 336 tl ypg with 14 tl td's. This will be A&M's 3rd str AG & has Ole Miss on deck. A&M's rush D had its 1st real test LW (SC's Davis was limited in opener) and they all'd 285 yds (6.1) while the Bulldogs potent rushing attack led by RB Robinson is avg 271 ypg (5.6) incl a ssn high 302 vs LSU! MS is 10-4 as a HF while A&M is 2-3-1 as an AD. Bulldogs knock the Aggies from the ranks of the unbeaten.

UCLA by 14 over Utah - The story of LY's gm was 6 int's by QB Wilson which led to 17 UCLA pts. UCLA was -5' and escaped 34-27. There was a pregame snow squall. Utah led 14-7 and it was tied at 24 after 3Q's. LTH LA's PR field it to the 1 and fmb'd into the EZ for a td and Utah got a td w/3:16 left for the backdoor cover 21-14 (+9). The HT is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. This is Utah's 2nd road trip in 3 wks but LA is in a large Arz St/Oregon sandwich. UAB is 3-10 SU/ATS in P12 AG's with the losses being by an avg of 16 ppg. UCLA is coming off a 62-27 (-4) blowout over ASU. They were outFD'd by an incredible 38-19 margin & outgained 626-580, but forced 4 Sun Devil TO's. The turning points of the gm were right before HT & the 1st pl of the 3Q. ASU was driving down 20-17 when UCLA CB Adams ret'd an int 95 yds for a td w/0:2 left. QB Hundley hit a wide open Jordan Payton for an 80 yd score on the 1st play from scrimmage in the 3Q to make it 34-17. Hundley showed no ill effects on his inj'd elbow as he finished 18-23-355 (4-0 ratio). Utah blew a 21-0 2Q lead (24-7 HT) allowing a GW 81 yd td pass w/4:58 left 4Q in their 28-27 (-10) home loss vs WSU. They were out FD'd 27-18 & outgained 495-357. Bruins move to 5-0 but don't see a lot of value here considering LW's results.

LOUISIANA TECH by 10 over Utep - These two actually met 4x from '01-04 with LT going 3-1 SU but UTEP going 3-1 ATS & the HT is 1-3 SU/ATS. LY they met for the 1st time in 10Y (WAC foes). LT was -2' at UTEP. LT had leads of 24-7 and 31-21 and 38-28 with UTEP getting a td w/1:03 left and LT rec'g the outside kick and covering by 1/2 pt. TY LT is playing a 6th str wk with a bye on deck but UTEP is on their 2nd str road game after having a bye 2 wks ago with ODU on deck. LT is off an expected 45-17 (+32) loss at Aub. UTEP greatly disappointed us in their 58-28 (+28) loss at Kan St. Kan St had 171 yds at half but 31 pts with a blocked punt setting up a 17 yd "drive," a 58 yd PR TD & a 51 yd PR setting up a 20 yd TD "drive." UTEP is 4-1 ATS TY after being just 6-17-1 ATS the L2Y comb'd. HC Kugler is showing his background (former Steelers OC) as UTEP is avg 253 (5.5) rush ypg & look for them to rebound after being held under 277 for the 1st time LW and keep it under the number. LT is also 2-6 as a HF incl getting outright upset by FCS tm.

MIDDLE TENN ST by 17 over Southern Miss - First ever trip to Murfreesboro for SM. LY was such a bad year for SM that they were actually a 23 pt HD to MT. MT DC Nix ply'd at SM and was a longtime DC there. MT led 42-14 getting a td w/6:36 left to get ahead of the spread but SM went 75/19 with a 4&6, 13 yd td pass with 2:33 left for the backdoor cover 42-21. Each team is playing for a 6th str wk, but SM has a bye on deck while MT has a tough gm at CUSA fav Marshall on the docket. MT is off a 41-28 (+3') win at ODU on Friday. They got their gm back on track after being held to just 88 yds 2 wks ago vs Memp, they went for 280 LW. QB Grammar's compl % has impr'd from 46% LY to 70% TY. SM is off a 41-23 (+10) home loss vs Rice but they were outFD'd just 20-18 & outgained by just 72 yds as 3 TO's did them in. QB Mullens threw for a car high 283 yds (2-1 ratio) but did have 2 costly TO's. MT is 6-3-1 as a HF incl 2-0 TY covering by a tl of 15 pts and we think they get a comfortable win here.

Oregon St by 4 over COLORADO - Both have a bye on deck but the Beavers are travelling a 2nd str wk & are off a tough road trip to USC. Only recent meeting was LY and OSU led 44-11 before all'g CU to go 80/4 for a garbage td w/12 left in the 44-17 (-11) final. CU had 181 yds (60%) in the 4Q vs mostly backups. Colorado is 2-12 SU/5-9 ATS hosting Pac-12 tms (SU wins vs UA & Cal). The Beavers are 7-11 SU/12-6 ATS their last 18 Pac-12 road gms. The Beavers are off a 35-10 (+11) loss at USC that wasn't as close as the score indicated. They were held to just 17 FD & 181 tl yds & their lone td came on a 97 yd KOR td. The Buffs nearly pulled the upset at Cal LW as they were up 28-14 at HT before falling 59-56 (+11) in 2OT. QB Liufau went wild throwing 46-67-449 (7-1 ratio) while adding 72 (7.2) rush yds. Look for this one to go down to the wire.

California by 1 over WASHINGTON ST - Homecoming. Cal had won 8 in a row SU (4-4 ATS) in this series (avg score 35-14) incl 31-17 (-7) their LTH ('12). LY in a battle of new HC's, Cal was a +1' at home. Dykes was an asst for 7Y under Leach at TT. Cal had a 356-297 yd edge at the half but trailed 21-15. The Cougars went on to a 44-22 win. Wazzu was down 24-7 at HT before mounting a comeback to win 28-27 (+10) at Utah LW & has a tough trip to Stan on deck. The Cougars had 27-18 FD & 495-357 yd edges as QB Halliday went 39-61-417 (4-2 ratio) incl the GW 81 yd td pass to Mayle w/4:58 to play. Cal is off a thrilling 59-56 (-11) 2Q win over Colo that snapped a 15 gm P12 losing streak. After outscoring their opposition 56-0 in the 1Q coming in the Golden Bears were down 21-7 1Q. Cal all'd the gm to go into OT after all'g a 30 yd td pass w/21 left 4Q & was outFD'd 39-24 & outgained 629-576 as they were fortunate to get the win. The gm marked the 1st in FBS hist that both tms threw 7 td passes as QB Goff went 23-41-449 (7-1 ratio) to improve his ratio to 17-3 on the ssn. The Golden Bears were 2-7 ATS as an AD but are 2-0 TY pulling 1 outright upset win & were seconds away from a 2nd and we think they pull one here.

TEXAS ST by 10 over Idaho - These two meet for the 3rd str yr. TXST is now 2-0 SU/ATS winning 38-7 (-2') LTH in '12. LY ID was down to 3rd string QB Taylor Davis. Leading 17-14 TXST went for it on 3&2 with :06 left 1H and got a 4 yd td run which ID HC Petrino said was a major turning point. The final was 37-21 (-11') with TX ST having only a 336-326 yd edge. ID remained winless after their embarrassing 34-10 (+4') loss at home vs SA. They are now 1-15 SU under HC Petrino. They were down 27-0 3Q & while they only had 1 less FD, they were outgained 429-269. Promising young QB rFR Linehan (Son of Cow-boys asst) went 25-40-239 (1-2 ratio) but threw a costly pick 6 in the 1Q. TXST is off a 37-34 (+3') 3OT win at Tulsa. The Bobcats did led a 17-3 4Q lead slip away, all'g the tying td w/10 left. Tough to lay more than 2 td's here as the Bobcat D is all'g 463 ypg their L/3 gms and ID had 3 400+ yd gms prior to LW.

RUTGERS by 3 over Michigan - First meeting. While the HC at Ball St, Hoke lost to Rutgers 52-30 (+10') in the '07 International Bowl. UM lost for the 3rd time in Sept for the 1st time in sch'l history (135 yrs!) after their 30-14 (-11) setback to MN LW. QB Morris made his 1st reg ssn car st & went 7-19-49 before being rep'd by Gardner late. A new OC was supposed to help the Wolverines offensive woes TY but their struggles cont'd as they had just 12 FD's & 171 tl yds. RU is off a 31-6 (-12) win over Tulane. QB Nova needed to step up after RB James was OFY LW & did so going 14-21-291 (4-1 ratio). The RB duo of Peoples & Goodwin comb'd for 165 (5.0). This is the beginning of a tough stretch for RU as after the bye they travel to OSU & NU before returning home vs Wisky. UM is 8-17 ATS in cont AG's & under Hoke UM is 3-6 as an AD. Look for their struggles to continue while Rutgers remarkably nears bowl elig.

UTSA by 17 over New Mexico - LY was their first meeting & NM had a post game fireworks set up but UTSA went in & pulled the 21-13 (+3) upset with a 394-277 yd edge. UTSA has had beefy 300 lb DT's that were able to take away the dive option in the middle, limiting NM's attack. NM has an extra day to prepare coming off their Fri night 35-24 (+6) loss to Fresno. The Lobo's were outFD'd 30-18, outgained 593-382 & have all'd 30+ pts a nation high 11 str gms. QB Gautsche DNP (hamstring) & he remains ? here. UTSA is off a 41-37 (-5) loss at FAU & have FIU at home on deck. The FD's & yds were nearly even but they all'd a 76 yd int ret td and led by 10 late 4Q. This will be NM's first gm in a dome. The Roadrunners were in their final FBS transitional yr LY and TY are bowl eligible & after LW's loss are in must win mode now and we like the D edge (#50-119).

ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Ulm - Homecoming. ASU is now 9-3 SU in this series winning the last 4 both SU/ATS. Prior to the current 4 gm streak, ULM had actually gone 5-0 ATS. LY ASU turned a couple of TO's, a blk'd punt & blk'd fg all into td's & rolled to a 42-14 (+3) upset win w/a 494-328 yd edge. ULM is off a tougher than expected 22-20 (-14) win over Troy & has to travel to KY next. The Warhawks were up 13-0 mid 2Q, but found themselves down 14-13 at HT. Down 20-19 4Q, ULM kicked a GW fg w/2:08 left. They did force another TO, extending their nation best streak to 30 str gms. ASU is fresh off a bye and travels to GaSt next. ULM hasn't won in Jonesboro s/'06. ULM is 8-5 as an AD & is 8-2 ATS in their L/10 conf AG's and we'll call for this to go down to wire.

CLEMSON by 14 over Nc State - CU is an outstanding 9-1 SU in this series but NCSt is 6-2 ATS & the dog is 9-2. The key play in LY's game was when WR Underwood raced 83 yds for a td to give NCSt the lead, 14-13 but the ref wrongfully ruled him OOB at the CU47. NCSt was sk'd & fmb'd and CU would get a 30 yd td pass 5pl later for a 14 pt swing, 20-7. CU rebounded from their tough loss to FSU with a 50-35 (-14') win over NC cashing as a 3★ winner on these pages LW & a LPS winner. True frosh QB Watson was the 1st true frosh to start for the Tigers in 20Y & all he did was set a sch'l rec w/6 td passes to go along with 435 yds which was 2nd most in sch'l hist (Boyd). NCSt was up 24-7 2Q & 38-28 3Q but couldn't hang on, losing 56-41 (+20) vs FSU. They had a 29-28 FD edge & were outgained by just 11 yds. QB Brissett finished 32-48-359 (3-0 ratio). NCSt under Doeren LY was 1-6-1 ATS off a SU loss while CU is on a 13-8 ATS run as a HF.

MICHIGAN ST by 10 over Nebraska - Neb is 3-1 SU/ATS. In '12 NU had been 7-0 SU in the series until MSU won for the 1st time LY. LTH ('12) NU had a 473-361 yd edge but trailed 24-14 early 4Q and got a GW 5 yd td run w/0:6 left, 28-24 (E). LY the Huskers had a 392-361 yd edge at home (+6) but NU's 5 TO's led to 24 of MSU's 41 pts. NU was also missing 3 key OL to inj's but still rushed for 182 yds (5.7). The key play came right before the half when NU fumbled at their own 22 with 1:00 left and MSU got a td for a 20-7 lead (169-165 HT). NU is off a dominant 45-14 (-31) HC win over Ill & have a bye on deck. NU's band spelled out "Fear Ameer" at HT & all the AA RB & Heisman candidate did is rush for 208 (9.5) in 2+ Qtr's w/Pelini limiting his touches due to this physical matchup. He's rushed for 200+ in 3 of the Huskers 5 gms TY. MSU is off a 56-14 (-31) HC win over WY. The Spartans have arguably the best rush D in the nation all'g just 78 (2.8) rush ypg. MSU's offense is capable of putting 30-plus on a Huskers D that is a bit overrated (faced ILL LW w/o their QB, gave up 30 pts to a Miami frosh QB).

4★ SAN DIEGO by 13 over NY Jets - This is a good spot for SD in their 2nd straight home game vs the Jets off 3 straight pass oriented NFC North teams coming cross country with DEN/NE on deck. The Jets have covered 3 straight on the road but Geno Smith only has 2 road games with a QBR over 80, one being vs the reeling Falcons and the other vs MIA who had checked out in LY's finale. He's only avg'd 180 ypg (55%) with a 6-14 ratio (6.47 ypa) in that span and while they can run the ball TY (151 ypg 4.9) the Jets have 3 straight games of a QBR of 71.5 or less. Their "#11" pass defense has yet to earn an int (104.1 opposing QBR) while Rivers has 12 games over 100.0 working with Mike McCoy. SD has acquitted themselves well vs 2 teams in the NFC West, Rivers is playing very well (leads NFL 119.9 QBR), the #9 defense is tenacious while the Jets saw another 2 DB's come off the field LW and with SD being undervalued they are the play.

3★ DENVER by 13 over Arizona - The favorite is 18-6 ATS if both teams are off a bye. Manning has an extra week to stew over facing SEA again and the Broncos are 5-0 SU/ATS off a loss winning by a 38-18 avg score with a 472-301 yd edge. DEN is one of 5 teams to not have won the yardage battle in a single game despite the slew of talent on both sides of the ball. ARZ has done a great job of going 3-0 with DC Bowles masking their issues but they had to rally to beat SD, got the Giants still trying to figure out their offense off a beatdown on MNF and SF simply imploded. ARZ does get Palmer (shoulder) back but he's now 3 weeks from seeing live action and ARZ's #21 ground game and #28 pass rush isn't inspiring. Look for the Broncos to play their first complete game of the season here and they are 12-5 ATS as a single digit fav with Manning.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ DETROIT by 11 over Buffalo - Despite a string of injuries at CB/LB the Lions are finally playing up to their talent level & own the #1 defense right now and are outgaining foes by 96 ypg. They are allowing an old school PIT/MIN 81 ypg (3.4) rush which goes right against the strength of the Bills who live off the run (#13 122 4.4). Manuel's comp % has steadily decreased from 72.7% vs CHI to 47.7% vs HOU and if his 80 yd bomb in the 4th Qtr is removed he had just a 3.4 ypa LW. Yes, the Bills defensive front is solid but their 37 yd (1.5) effort LW was more due to injuries on the Texans part. Vs 2 pass oriented QB's with Cutler and Rivers the Bills have allowed 69 and 72% comp (101.5 combined QBR) and even with a less than 100% Megatron that is trouble. We have more faith with Stafford at home with a defense backed by the home crowd with BUF on the road for the 2nd week in a row with NE on deck behind an inaccurate QB in a pass friendly league.

OTHER GAMES

Minnesota at GREEN BAY - Thursday - The Packers rolled the Bears LW as our September NFL GOM LW as it was just the 2nd time in NFL history neither team punted. GB score on 6 of 7 drives missing a FG and while CHI had a good 1st 3 drives their final 5 drives were basically 2 ints, 2 SOD and a ran out of time drive. MIN hung 558 yds on ATL overcoming their injuries and showing how unpredictable the NFL can be. GB will likely be heavily favored but they are 0-6 ATS at home but with no line we'll wait on making a call here.

Chicago by 4 over CAROLINA - This is the 3rd meeting in 4 years with the road team covering all. This is a bad spot for CAR who was shredded by AFC North pass oriented teams for 384 yds (66%) 3-0 the L2W. CAR is likely to be without RB's Stewart, Williams, Tolbert and Newton isn't 100% himself. As a result we have a run designed team with a 39-61 run-pass ratio (50-50 LY). CAR simply isn't built for an aerial game and are very one-dimensional now. While this is CHI's 3rd road game in 4 Wks with another road game on deck this is a favorable matchup for them. CHI was out of sync vs GB after B2B road prime time games but still tallied 496 yds. Cutler has always done poorly vs GB and have covered 3 of 4 afterwards. The Bears are 9-4 ATS away vs NDIV foes, get a manageable line and look for a much better effort vs a depleted CAR team after going against them as our NFL GOM LW.

Cleveland by 3 over TENNESSEE - CLE is coming in off a bye and a win here gives them momentum vs PIT. They also have the edge of knowing how DC Horton's defense works after fielding it in 2013. One of the most improved units in the NFL is the CLE ground game avg 132 ypg (4.5) vs 86 ypg (4.0) LY. This has helped take the pressure off Hoyer who has a very respectable 97.5 QBR after facing 3 playoff caliber teams in PIT, BAL, NO and stabilizing the position. TEN was in an awful spot LW fielding Charlie Whitehurst on the road vs an IND team fighting for .500. They've had QBR's under 75.0 for 3 weeks straight as they lack the vertical threat to make the offense go. CLE's rush defense is a concern (154 yds 5.2) but TEN's best individual rushing effort was 71 yds (4.7) by RB Greene vs KC. CLE will have a healthy TE Cameron and RB Tate here and we'll side with the Browns by a FG here as they've gained confidence each week while Whisenand admitted after the game that he "overestimated" his Titans.

PHILADELPHIA by 10 over St Louis - The Rams are off a brutal loss where they blew a 21 pt lead to a team that beat them by 24 the year prior. STL has surprisingly good rankings (#8 off #12 def) but are -3 TO's and after pulling in 53 sacks LV have just 1. Its not known if Shaun Hill will start but Austin Davis has been good avg 281 ypg (73%) 3-2 with a respectable 7.9 ypa. STL pass defense #3 but has given up 75% with a 8.2 ypa for a 105.1 opposing QBR. Foles was held to a stunning 42.3 QBR LW as the 49ers didn't allow PHI's offense to score a single point LW. In his previous 11 games he's avg'd 295 ypg (63%) with a 27-4 ratio (107.5 QBR). Aside from their 15 pt/90 yd drive PHI was held to 2 or less FD/35 or less yds on each drive in the game. STL does have a solid defense but after a showing like LV we'll take the angry Eagles at home here.

NY Giants by 6 over Atlanta - The light seemingly has gone on for Manning the L2 games with 267 ypg (73%) 6-1 as he's faced a HOU team that just went to the West Coast and was out of its game plan and a WAS defense that was without its top CB and #1 SS on a short week. The Giants did what you are supposed to with +5 TO's vs WAS turning them into 31 pts. They now catch a Falcons team that ran out of OL LW and were forced to field a TE at RT to protect Ryan. ATL gave up a whopping 241 yds (5.5) on the ground to MIN as they were outgained 351-198 in the 1H and taken back by the rookie QB's posse. ATL had given up 139 (5.0) and 170 (3.8) rushing in the 1st 2 weeks and their effort vs TB is in question. We'll call for the Giants with extra rest to keep their momentum going here at home vs a Falcons team that is allergic to sunlight on Sundays.

NEW ORLEANS by 14 over Tampa Bay - NO is 16-0-1 ATS at home with Sean Payton as HC and this is only the 3rd time since 1990 a team with a bye on deck catches a team in their 3rd straight road game. In their L9 home games NO has outgained foes 438-268 (+6 TO's) with a 30-14 avg score. In his 8 home games vs TB Brees has avg'd 262 ypg (71%) with a 34-10 ratio (118.1 QBR). TB stunned a depleted PIT defense with Glennon at the helm LW with 302 yds (50%) 2-1 ratio with minimal help from his run game (63 yds 3.2). On the flip side they've given up an opposing QBR of 117.6 TY with a whopping 76% comp rate (8-1 ratio) with the only STL game being under 100 (99.1). TB deserves credit for their win LW but they've been outscored 72-17 in the 1H TY and their victory will only ensure that NO takes them seriously after their SNF game at DAL.

DALLAS by 7 over Houston - DAL is off LW's SNF affair vs NO but are just 7-15 ATS hosting a NDIV foe prior. This is the 3rd time ranked 22nd or lower in our position talent for DAL who covered the 2 previous matchups vs TEN and STL. RB Murray (128 ypg 5.1) gets a good matchup vs a HOU run defense giving up 130 ypg (5.0) and the Cowboys OL is quite underrated. HOU's offense struggled for the 2nd straight week as if they can't run the ball then Fitzpatrick struggles to move the team (61.5 and 75.1 QBR the L2W).

Georgia Southern by 10 over NEW MEXICO ST - First meeting. S/07 GS has only traveled out of the South to play 4 gms and lost all 4. Three were in the FCS playoffs at Newark, DE in '10 and Fargo, ND in '11 & '12. They also lost 42-34 at Colorado St in '07. NMSt has not had a winning mark in Las Cruces s/07 (4-3). Since then they are just 11-28 SU/13-22-1 ATS at home. The Aggies are coming off a 63-7 (+43) loss at LSU & travel to Troy next. The only positive was they weren't shutout & they surprisingly forced 4 TO's. GS snapped a series tying 3 gms losing streak by beating rival App St 34-14 (-19) on Thurs. While they only had a 22-20 FD edge, the Eagles had 496-330 yd & 38:08-21:52 TOP edges. GS is avg 374 (7.5) rush ypg while NMSt all g 312 (6.3) rush ypg. This will be already the 3rd option offense the Aggies will see TY (all g 346 rush ypg, 7.1). Georgia Southern is a perfect 4-0 ATS this year but did barely cover vs App St as linesmakers are starting to catch up to them and this wk considering the long trip and NMSt's altitude edge, we fade them here.

SAN JOSE ST by 14 over Univ - Homecoming. LY these two met for the 1st time s/97. SJSt led 24-3 at HT w/a 324-74 yd edge. Key play of the gm happened early 4Q w/UNLV down just 7. Herring tossed an int at the SJSt40 & then SJSt went 56/6pt to gm up 14 & would go on to win 34-24 (-4). SJSt is off a 21-10 loss to NV despite 24-16 FD & 446-256 yd edges as 3 TO's did the Spartans in. SJSt QB Gray made his 1st car st going

HOU has failed to win the yardage battle in any game TY and the main reason they beat BUF LW was the monster play by JJ Watt (5 tkls, 9 QBH 1 pick-six) to shift the momentum. With Foster (hamstring) being a major question mark and not seeing the results of the SNF vs NO we'll call for DAL by 7 at this time.

Baltimore by 3 over INDIANAPOLIS - HF's with a Thursday Night Dive road game on deck are 8-17-1 ATS. IND has had quite favorable matchups the L2W with the Jags (#31) and Titans (#26) but are now giving points to our #7 rated team on page 7. The Colts are only 1-4 SU/0-5 ATS as a NDIV favorite as they don't have the depth to back that up defensively (#19 yds #17 pts). Yes, Luck has tallied 763 yds (75%) 8-1 the L2 games but he should be considering what he's faced. BAL OC Kubiak also knows what to expect from IND having been the Texans OC. While they are off a last second win vs CLE and a charged up game vs CAR, they didn't have to travel far for that and the Ravens only have a road game at TB on deck. IND stats are inflated & now have to face a playoff level team while BAL has played a tougher sked TY and are getting points.

Pittsburgh by 9 over JACKSONVILLE - Proceed with caution as the Steelers are 0-8 ATS AF of 6 or more and have a rematch at CLE on deck. That said Tomlin is livid at the lack of discipline in LW's loss to TB with 13 pen for 125 yds and they are avg 11 per game. That negated an outstanding effort by Roethlisberger who has 3 games of 103 QBR or better TY and hasn't thrown an int since Wk 1. Their #17 pass defense gets a needed break vs the Jaguars as while Bortles overall stats were good SD shut him down in the 2H holding him to 104 yds (74%) 0-2 ratio. PIT has outgained foes by 59 ypg (-2 TO's) vs a team playing at an expansion level with -172 ypg (-6 TO's). JAX is giving up a 115.0 opposing QBR and 131 ypg (4.2) on the ground. Look for the Steelers to be more focused here and while Bortles is an improvement he and the rest of the offense are young so we'll simply continue to go against them.

Kansas City at SAN FRANCISCO - Teams off a MNF game are 12-4-1 ATS if they have a bye on deck and this is Alex Smith vs his former team. SF is off a tougher than it should have been battle vs PHI as they dominated the game statistically with a 20-5 FD and 400-137 yd edge prior to the final 6:35. They had a staggering 218 (5.2)-22 (1.8) edge on the ground with a 24:34 TOP edge. The 49ers gave up 21 pts off a blocked punt, 82 yd PR for TD and a 53 yd int return but the defense showed shades of 2012-13 with their goal-line stand. While the defense did its part Kaepernick wasn't as good as his stats (87.9 QBR) getting called for several delay of game penalties. KC's defensive injuries are starting to show as prior to NE they are giving up 130 ypg (5.1) on the ground and a 103.1 opposing QBR with a 6-0 ratio. Without seeing how KC did on MNF though we'll pass on this game for now and revisit later in the week as we want to see TE Vernon Davis' status also.

Cincinnati at New England - Sunday Night - CIN beat NE 13-6 as a 1 pt HD LY as the Bengals sacked Brady 4 times, limited him to 197 yds (47%) 0-1 stopping NE on a goal line stand to end the game. NE didn't have Gronkowski but CIN didn't have DT Atkins or CB Hall as they outruled the Patriots 162 (4.2) to 82 (4.6). Check out these conflicting angles as the Bengals are 10-2-2 ATS away vs non-div foes while NE is 9-1 ATS as a single digit HF!

Seattle at Washington - Monday - The NFL schedule makers certainly looked kindly upon the Seahawks and this cross county trip comes after a bye week and their other at Philadelphia comes off a Thursday night. SEA is also in a great spot technically as Monday Night non-div favs off a bye are 10-1 ATS. Washington however, is desperate at 1-3 and how much can you lay with a Seattle offense that avg'd under 18 FD's away from home LY and had only 14 at SD earlier this year.
