

4★ Alabama over ARKANSAS - Bama is 7-0 SU and has covered 5 of the L/6 gms in this series The L2Y they have been a 20 pt road fav and 29' pt HF and won by identical scores of 52-0. Bama had a 438-137 yd edge here in '12 and a 532-256 yd edge at home LY. It was the first time Bama had shutout an SEC foe 2 years in a row since '73-'74. This is the 2nd straight big road test for the Tide while the Hogs are fresh off a bye. The Crimson Tide shockingly are only 4-3 in their L/7 gms as they are off a 23-17 (-4') upset loss to Ole Miss, a gm they led 14-3 at HT and 17-10 mid-4Q before having 2 costly TO's (1 after a fumbl'd KR, 1 in Miss EZ). They also missed 2 FG's in a big gm yet again. Prior to their bye LW, Ark blew a 14-pt 4Q lead vs A&M and lost 35-28 (+9) in OT. BU got 2 IR td's, one a 14 pt swing at the end of the 1H. TCU got to 41-38 at the start of the 4Q and was at the BU23 at the end but a pass was tipped and int'd in the EZ with :11 left. Remarkably TCU out-passed Baylor 267-206 in the gm. TY we thought coming into the yr that the Horned Frogs were one of the most improved trns in the country and they validated that claim LW in their 37-33 (+3') upset over OU. PU had a 231-171 yd edge after 3Qs. LTH '09, the Spartans trailed 34-23 w/11:52 left but got a 21 yd fg with 1:51 left to pull out the win 40-37 (-3). The visitor is 4-1-1 ATS in the series. LW the Spartans (-7) in the B10 showdown vs Neb found themselves up 27-3 in the 4Q but Neb got 2 td drives and a PR TD to pull within 27-22 w/3:22 left.

Meanwhile the Golden Hurricane are 1-4 SU/ATS losing 4 str gms. LW while they had a 18-17 FD edge, Col St had 310 yds on 6 plays and Tulsa was outgained 532-390 in their 42-17 (-17') loss cashing us a 3\* College Totals LPS. The offense has been the problem as they are avg 421 ypg, but their D has all'd 511 ypg. Temple is just +44 ypg vs our #125 sked and this will be their first DD conf fav role s/'they took the step up to the AAC. However, we feel it is deserved as they are 10-2 ATS with Walker as the st'g QB and they have a huge D edge (#65-113).

Massachusetts at KENT ST - First meeting. Both tms come in looking for their 1st win of the ssn. LW Kent St trailed NIU 17-14 and were at the 34-yd line. St'g QB Reardon was inj'd on a 4&1 conversion, then the bkp QB was inj'd on the next snap while taking a sack. The #3 QB threw an incomp pass and they had to settle for a missed 56-yd FG as we easily cashed our Top Weekly Coll Totals LPS on the UNDER. It was Kent's 1st cover of the ssn. GEORGIATECH by 10 over Duke - GT has dominated this series winning 10 straight by 21 ppg (7-3 ATS). LY GT DC Roof made his first trip back to Duke since being fired and his D held Duke to 254 yds. While Duke had an extra wk to prep for the option, the LTH ('12) Duke was also off a bye and lost 42-24 (+13') all'g 449 rushing yds. Raise your hand, if you thought GT would be one of the 10 remaining unbeaten teams in the country at this point. We didn't think so, but that is exactly where they are at 5-0 after LW's 28-17 win (-1') over Miami, Fl as they ran for 318 yds. That was the same Miami team that beat Duke by 12 in the Blue Devils L/gm 2 wks ago. While Duke is 4-1 TY, they have played our #119 sked and have all'd over 200 rush yds in each of their L/3 gms. Johnson takes care of business in ACC play as GT is 9-2-1 ATS as a conf fav and we think GT continues series domination here.

WISCONSIN by 31 over Illinois - It wouldn't be a 5★ Saturday w/out backing the Badgers as they have cashed multiple times for us incl three 5★ GOY winners s/00 with the last one coming in 2012, a 62-14 (-7) demolition of Indiana. UW is now 8-1 SU/5-4 ATS in this series and the HT is 6-2 ATS. IU is playing a 7th str wk and 3rd road gm in 5 wks and now taking on a physical Badger squad. Both teams have a bye on deck. LY we used a 4★ LPS and 4★ Key Selection on these pages on UW (-14) and they won 56-32. UW jumped out to a 21-0 led and led 42-17 and 56-25 with UI getting a td with :44 left. The Badgers had scored 20+ pts in 17 consec gms coming into LW but had just 14 pts in the upset loss to NW despite RB Gordon running for a career high 259 yds. The Badgers were -4 TO's as Stave and McEvoy struggled hitting just 12-29-138-1-4. On the other side, IL HC Beckman's seat is on fire as a feeble Purdue offense put up 551 yds on them incl 349 rush yds (7.8!) in the 38-27 (-9) loss. Remember Nebraska also ran for 458 yds (6.5) on ILL 2 wks ago and it wouldn't shock us if the Badgers approached that number this week as they are 11-3 ATS as a B10 HF, while III is 1-9 ATS as an AD. The closer for us is Wisky's 8-2 ATS as a 20+ conf HF and off a loss, we expect them to run over IL.

NC STATE by 10 over Boston College - BC is fresh off a bye while NCSt is playing their 7th str wk and off physical battles vs FSU and Clemson. LY BC RB Williams rushed 339 yds and BC had an amazing 420-35 rush edge in the game (could be embarrassing to HC Doeren who comes from runheavy Wisc). BC won 38-21 (-7'). The Wolfpack were #1 in the ACC in total off at 505 ypg, but were shut out LW in the 41-0 loss (+14') at Clemson as they were outgained 493-156. Prior to the bye, the Eagles were upset by Col St 24-21 (-8). This will be a matchup of former UF QB's as Brissett is the better passer (13-1 rátio vs Murphy's 3-6) but Muprhy is the better runner (579 rush yds vs Brissett's 172). While the situation looks like it favors BC (they actually have dropped 8 str gms following a bye by 16 ppg), the series history clearly favors NCSt as the HT is an amazing 8-1 SU/ATS with BC losing their last 2 trips here by 17 and 27 pts. The Eagles are also 1-7 ATS as an AD and we grabbed some extra value considering NCSt's poor showing LW.

MIAMI, FL by 24 over CINCINNATI - UM is 10-1, L/gm was a 38-12 win (-13') in '98 (only loss in 1947). LTH ('89) the Bearcats were shutout 56-0 & in the last 3 trips the Bearcats have been outscored by a combined 151-3. LW we easily cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages on Memphis (+3') as Cincy suffered their worst home loss s/'05 getting run over 41-14. After all'g an NCAA record 45 FD's to Ohio St and 710 yds, the Bearcats D all'd 610 yds to Memphis and it was 27-7 at HT when QB Kiel (ribs) sat out the 2H with bkp Legaux hitting just 5-13-39-0-0. After LW's 28-17 loss (+1') to GT, the Hurricanes are 3-3 and need wins. They are +82 ypg vs our #51 sked while Cincy is -130 ypg vs our #23 sked. The Canes have the huge D edge (#34-100) and it doesn't matter to us if Kiel is 100% or not, we think UM rolls here.

Buffalo by 13 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - This is just EM's 2nd HG of 2014 and their first HG vs an FBS foe with their brand new Gray Field Turf. EM won the F/5 meetings of this series SU and is 4-2 ATS. However, LY the Bulls were -13 at home and just dominated. They led 28-7 at the half and 42-7 into the 4Q. EM gained 143 yds on their final 2 drives incl going 79/2 for a garbage td with 1:20 left. LW EM was down only 10-6 at HT but Akron had a 387-152 yd edge in the 2H and won 31-6 (-25). EM QB Bolden was 17-30-185 for EM's best pass gm of the yr. On the other side, UB missed a 33 yd FG late 4Q and BG drove 80/4pl for a TD with 2:19 left in a 36-35 loss (+3). While it was UB's 3rd straight cover, what was shocking to us was them only managing 368 yds vs BG's D which came in all'g 619 ypg. Technical edges to UB here as they were 3-0 ATS as an AF LY and won those 3 by 30 ppg while EM's poor home field adv (just 9-19 ATS as a HD s/06) incl a 1-5 ATS run continues to show.

AKRON by 14 over Miami, Oh - MU is now 12-3 SU/7-5-3 ATS in this series. MU won last trip here 56-49 (-2) in '12. They led 45-35 after 3Q but AU got a td w/7:00 left, 49-48. MU got a td and 2pt conv w/1:04 left to win 56-49 and had an amazing 42-28 FD edge and 705 yds while AU had 629. LY UA won in Oxford for the 1st time s/'39 (snapped 20 gm MAC road losing skid). Zips led 24-7 w/8:19 left. MU cut it to 7 w/1:27 left but UA rec the onside and w/1:12 left (MU called TO 3x) conv on 4&2 from the MU24. LW the RedHawks snapped their schl-rec 21-gm losing streak as they rallied from a 41-14 2Q deficit to beat UMass 42-41 (-3'). The Minutemen had a chance to get the "W" but were tackled on a fake spike play at the Redhawk 2-yd line on the final play of the gm. QB Hendrix had by far his best gm in his career as he was 32-58-437-4-0 while also adding 91 rush yds (7.0). On the other side, Akron after their big upset over Pitt slept walk thru the 1H LW (165-127 yds) and led just 10-6 but would go on to a 31-6 win (-25) with a 387-152 yd edge in the 2H. The Zips who are now on a 6-2 SU run dating back to LY (only losses to Penn St and Marsh) are starting to learn how to take care of business and we think they do so here vs a MU tm that might take a few extra days to celebrate after breaking the long losing streak.

IOWA by 7 over Indiana - Indiana is 1-4 their L/5 trips to Iowa City incl a 45-24 loss (+23) the LTH (+11) Hoosiers never led but tied the gm 14-14 mid-2Q before all'g 21 str pts prior to HT. In the 2H IU never got closer than 18 pts. Hawkeyes are 7-3 s/01 vs the Hoosiers but did lose the L/gm ('12) 24-21 (+2). Iowa jumped out to a 14-0 lead & led 21-17 4Q. After all'g a td w/10:58 left, UI didn't cross the 50 their L/3 drives. The Hawkeyes come in off a bye as after an underwhelming 1st 3 gms, they started to find their mojo again in wins over Pitt and Purdue as they dominated the Boilers with a 420-156 yd edge. The up and down Hoosiers continued again LW as they had a dominating 49-24 (-12') win over NT w/a 593-348 yd edge. If they follow the script here like they've done all ssn long, they should be due for a loss here. While we like the Hawkeyes to win, it's tough laying over a TD w/a tm that is avg just 23 ppg on offense. OHIO by 3 over Bowling Green - BG won 5 in a row from '01-'06 then OU went 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS from '07-'11. Now BG has now dominated the last 2 years. LTH BG was +3 and led 19-7 at half and would go on to win 26-14. LY BG led 35-0 at the half and 49-0 with 13:05 left finishing with a 460-172 yd edge and 20-9 FD edge. LW the Falcons did it again as they drove down for a late TD for the win. Buffalo would miss a 33-yd FG and BG went 80/4pl for a TD w/2:19 left (36-35, -3). They did have a 508-368 yd edge. LW CM crushed the Bobcats 28-10 (-4) as they had 25-8 FD and 467-187 yd edges. Ohio QB Sprague was just 7-21-98-0-0 but could get healthy here vs a Falcon D all'g 699 ypg on the road TY. BG has the better offense, but Ohio has the better D (#89-121) and we love playing on defensive home dogs.

West Virginia by 7 over TEXAS TECH - LTH WV was on top of the world at 5-0 and #5 in the country

with an unstoppable offense. They travelled to Texas a 2nd str wk after upsetting UT the previous wk and were drilled by TT 49-14. Since the start of that game, WV is just 9-16 SU. Holgorson was on TTech's staff for 8 yrs and Kingsbury said he would not be a HC if it wasn't for Holgorson. LY TT was lech's start for 8 yrs and kingsoury said ne would not be a no in twash too more some in the and and trailed the game 27-16 but with 1:01 left, on 3&gl they got a 10 yd td pass for the front door cover (scored gm's L/21 pts). While you have a 3-2 tm travelling to take on a 2-3 tm, we feel these tms are far apart. WV is +194 ypg vs our #11 sked and has impressed us in nearly every gm while TT is 1-4 ATS and is -3 ypg vs our #38 sked. LW they were destroyed by KSt 45-13 (-14), their 3rd str DD loss and those came after they beat C Ark and UTEP by a combined 11 pts. Their QB Webb played w/a sore shld'r LW and threw 4 picks. On the other side, WV led 26-0 at HT and would finish with 25-9 FD and 557-176 yd edges in their win over KS. Two tms going in opposite directions and WV has the better off and better D.

**Oklahoma St by 17 over KANSAS** - From '06-'11 OSU avg 568 ypg on offense but only 365 ypg the L/2 yrs. LY the Cowboys won 42-6 at home (-30') but only had a 359-316 yd edge. Thanks in part to a 100 yd KR td, OSU led 28-0 at the half with only a 233-183 yd edge. In '12 OSU was -27' here and led 20-0 in the 4Q but KU pulled within 20-14 w/8:52 left and only lost by 6 in rain-soaked conditions. Both tms are coming off misleading gms as lowa St led the Pokes 6-0 but OSU got 13 pts in the last 2:57 of the 1H incl ISt fumbl a KO and OSU got a very ? TD on last play of the 1H. On the other side, WV led KU 26-0 at HT & had a 557-176 yd edge for the gm. The Jayhawks 2 TD's were a 18 yd drive after a fumbl'd punt and Harwell getting a 76 yd PR with 2:23 left. This will be the 1st HG after the Weis firing (also 1st true AG for OSU) but there is a huge edge to OSU on off (#33-114).

MEMPHIS by 3 over Houston - These two were former CUSA rivals and have met 12x s/97. Memp opened those going 5-3 SU but UH has now won 4 in a row SU (3-1 ATS) and the HT is 3-1 ATS UH had outgained MEM by 345 and 330 yds in '09 and '10 winning 55-14 and 56-17. LY UH was -7' at home and was actually outgained 349-247. We had a 3★ Key Selection on UH -7' and they won 25-15. MEM did settle for 5 fg's but UH had a 10 pt lead the final 10:21. We thought Memphis was a much improved tm TY and they have done nothing to dispute that as they are 3-2 SU/4-0-1 ATS and LW easily cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages in their 41-14 (+3') win over Cincinnati. That was Cincy's worst home loss s/05 and the Tigers put up 610 yds of offense. On the other side, UH should have beaten UCF last week as they had a 331-228 yd edge but settled for 4 FG's and fumbled into the EZ for a TB at the end when QB Ward was diving for a winning TD. UH is 4-0 ATS as a conf AD while Memphis did lose outright both times as a conf HF LY.

UAB by 7 over North Texas - Only meeting was in '95, UAB won 19-14. The Blazers were still a FCS program while the Mean Green had started their FBS transition. LW we used the Blazers as our Underdog POW on these pages and a lot of you must have played it because the line moved 4 points and it still didn't matter in UAB's 42-39 outright upset win (+9'). They had 32-25 FD and 591-503 yd edges and even survived the dreaded 14 pt swing of an 85-yd IR td. On the other side, Indy led NT 42-10 into the 4Q as the Mean Green were outgained 593-348 in their 49-24 loss (+12'). While the Blazers are 4-10 ATS as a HF, new HC Clark has this program heading in an entirely different direction as they are +110 ypg and are only a very misleading gm vs FIU away (-6 TO's) from being 4-1 this year (only lost to Top 5 Miss St by 13 and outgained them 548-516). **Auburn by 3 over MISSISSIPPI ST** - After the visitor had won 3 in a row both SU/ATS from '06-'08

the HT is now 4-1 SU and ATS. AU is off a big HG vs LSU but has a bye on deck. MSU had a bye 2 wks ago, is off a HG vs A&M and has a bye on deck. AU is 11-2 SU/8-4 ATS in this series. LTH AUB led 10-7 but turned the ball over 3x in the 4Q and lost 28-10. LY AUB was fortunate to escape with the win. They were -6' at home and needed an 88/12 drive getting an 11 yd td pass w/:10 left to pull out a 24-20 non-covering win. That drive gave them the yardage edge for the game (459-415). LW we used both of these tms as LPS and both easily cashed for us in big gms. Aub was a 4★ LPS and they cruised over LSU 41-7 (-7') as they led 31-7 at HT and slowed the pace in the 2H. Miss St was a 3★ LPS and they crushed an overrated Aggies tm 48-31 (-2') which even incl 2 late A&M td scores. Dak Prescott is a legit Heisman cand and maybe the best ply'r on the field in this one w/19 total td's and 1,678 total yds but Aub is the more complete tm. Two more things also separate these tms. First, Auburn has been on the big stage repeatedly the past few yrs and thrived while every wk is new ter-

ritory for the up and coming Bulldogs. Also Aub has the D edge (#6-29) as they are all'g just 307 ypg (just 285 and 280 to KSt and LSU) while Miss St is all'g 426 ypg.

BALL ST by 3 over Western Michigan - BS is now 9-4 SU in this series and is 10-3 ATS. However, the visitor is 6-3 SU/7-2 ATS. LTH BS was -3 and trailed 21-7. They got a td w/:50 left to lead 24-21. WM got a 52 yd fg for OT but BS won it there. BS only had a 433-424 yd edge. LY BS was -20 at home. BS had a 301-168 yd edge at the half with WM being called for 12 pen's for 102 yds, some at crucial times. BS led 38-10 w/WM getting a FR td w/:14 left for the 38-17 final. Freq going 19-7 the LY ssy's it's a bit of a surprise the Cardinals come in at just 1-4 TV as they clearly miss OB Wenning L/2 ssn's, it's a bit of a surprise the Cardinals come in at just 1-4 TY as they clearly miss QB Wenning (avg'd 324 ypg LY vs 189 ypg TY). LW they fell behind 27-10 to Army but rallied to within 2 before Army closed them out. Ball St was outgained 473-330. On the other side, WM is much improved TY and have covered 4 str gms but LW lost a heartbreaker to UT 20-19 in OT (UT FG on L/play of reg to force OT) as the Broncos missed the xp in a gm played in driving rain. While WM has been the more impressive tm, we can't back them here considering their 3-13 road record the L/3 yrs.

TROY by 4 over New Mexico St - Homecoming. The only prior mtg was in 2004 in Las Cruces which

was Troy's first season in the Sun Belt and New Mexico St's last before coming back TY. NMSt won was Iroy's first season in the Sun Beit and New Mexico St's last before coming back IY. NMSt won 22-18 (+10). We easily cashed a 4★ LPS on NMSt LW in their 36-28 (+19) home loss to Ga Southern. The Aggies had 30-21 FD & 517-437 yd edges but were done in by 4 TO's. While QB Rogers threw for 329 yds, he also was picked off 3X. Troy is fresh off a bye & while they are winless on the ssn, they nearly beat ULM on the road in their L/gm, falling 22-20 (+13'). There were 4 lead changes and the Trojans had a 20-19 lead 4Q but gave up a GW 29 yd fg w/2:08 left. Troy is just 4-14 as a HF incl getting upset by an FCS tm earlier TY while NMSt is 3-10-1 as an AD but did pull the outright upset win over GSt earlier this ssn. Tough to lay over a td w/a winless tm here.

IOWA ST by 3 over Toledo - Homecoming. The L/gm ('07) had 7 lead changes. ISU led 35-24 w/5:25

low S1 by 3 over 10ledo - Homecoming. The Light (V7) had 7 lead critariges. ISO led 35-24 wi3.25 left but all'd a 82 yd KR td & the GW td came after a fmbl in punt formation (Toledo rec in EZ). ISU had a 38 yd fg blk'd w/:11 left as UT won at home 36-35 (+3'). The last/only time here ('06) ISU won 45-43 (-8') in 3OT. Down 8, UT went 79/11pl forcing OT w/a td & 2pt conv w/3:28 left. In the 3OT ISU got a 25 yd td pass (2pt) while UT went 25/5pl getting a 2 yd td run but their 2pt att was no good (inc pass). ISU is off a 37-20 (+17) loss at OSU where they were outFD'd 25-17 & outg'd 400-322. There was a ? replay reversal just before HT that gave OSU a td (13-6 lead instead of 6-6 tie) & momentum which they carried into the 2H. UT survived 3 TO's to defeat WM 20-19 (-6) in OT. UT needed a 37 yd fg w/no time left to force OT, and after taking a 7 pt lead, WM would miss the gm tying PAT in OT. ISU is 2-5 as a HF while UT is 7-2 as an AD.

UCLA by 3 over Oregon - Both tms come in off huge upset losses. UO lost for the 2nd str yr, this time at home to UA 31-24 (-23). They were outFD'd 29-25 & outg'd 495-446. Their OL remains a mess. UCLA meanwhile fell to UT 30-28 (-13) despite 24-18 FD & 406-342 yd edges. The Bruins took their 1st lead of the gm w/4:50 remaining, 28-27 & then all'd a 29 yd fg w/:34 left. UCLA had a chance to win but K Fairbairn missed a 50 yd'r on an untimed down after he missed a 55 yd'r as time expired but a running into the K pen all'd him another shot. UO is 10-2 SU but UCLA is 8-4 ATS in this series. The HT is 6-1 SU but the visitor is on a 7-4 ATS run. There were 5 outright upsets in 6Y from '01-'07 but none the L/5 meetings. LTH ('09) the Ducks trailed 3-0 HT but got a 100 yd KR td, 32 yd IR td & 20 yd td pass in the first 3:54 of the 2H and won 24-10 (+3'). LY UO was -24 & UCLA was w/o their top RB & had a banged up OL. Surprisingly UCLA ran for 219 yds. The 42-14 final score was misleading as it was 14-14 HT & UO didn't take the lead until 2:47 3Q. Both tms are struggling on D, both have great QB's but are running for their lives because of young OL's. The Ducks have the slight offensive edge (#6-10) but the Bruins have the slight D edge (#33-39). So why are the Ducks favored by more than a FG here? Take the home dog!

USU is off a huge outright upset over rival BYU 35-20 (-20'). The FD's & yds were nearly even but BYU lost their star QB Hill to a broken leg & USU forced 4 TO's. QB Garretson repl'g Keeton went 19-25-321-3-0. We easily cashed a 2★ LW on these pages as AF pulled the outright upset over rival Navy 30-21 (+3'). AF is 11-3 SU/8-6 ATS L14Y the gm after facing Navy (4-1 SU/2-3 ATS after a win) and they should be 5-0 coming into this game if not for a late blown lead vs WY in Wk 2. Not afraid to back the Falcons again here as they are used to staying even keel each wk while Utah St will still be celebrating LW's win.

ARIZONA by 3 over Usc - USC is on a solid 10-2 SU (29-8 all-time) run in this series but UA is 7-2 ATS. LY USC was ply'g their first game under interim HC Orgeron & we cashed a Thurs night Marquee winner on USC -5'. The Trojans led 38-17 and UA got a couple of late td's to lose 38-31. LTH marked USC's first loss in Tucson s/'99. USC led 28-13 late 3Q but lost 39-36 (-6'). USC is off a stunning 38-34 (-12) loss vs AZSt. The Trojans appeared in control but all'd 3 td's in the final 3:53 incl the GW 46 yd 'Hail Mary' with no time left. AZ meanwhile is 5-0 for the 1st time s/'98 after shocking Oregon for the 2nd str yr, this time on the road 31-24 (+23). The win was no fluke as UA had 29-25 FD & 495-446 yd edges. While AU is off Oregon that game was last Thur, they had a bye the week before and have a bye next week. From '02-'08 Cal was 6-1 SU and 4-3 ATS in this series but the Huskies have now won 5 in a row SU (4-1 ATS). LY there was a huge adjustment in the line as UW went to -30 at home vs a banged up Cal team. UW had a 642-483 yd edge & Cal RB Muhammad got a 73 yd td run w5:04 left for the backdoor cover, 41-17. LTH ('12) the Huskies trailed 13-7 late 3Q but Cal missed a 41 yd fg, had 2 TO's and was SOD in the 4Q and UW won 21-13 (+4). Cal is off to their best start s/'08 after their 60-59 (+3') win over WSU. There was over 1,400 yds of ttl offense & the Golden Bears were fortunate as WSU's K missed a 19 yd fg w/:19 left. QB Goff threw for 527 yds (5-0 ratio) but Cal all'd WSU QB Halliday to throw for an NCAA rec 734 yds. Look for a lot of pts again here and we're not afraid to continue to ride the Bears here

Georgia by 7 over MISSOURI - These 2 met here in '12 in MizzOU's inaugural SEC gm. MU (+1') led 17-9 in the 3Q then lost some OL to inj and UGA would outscore them 32-3 down the stretch for a misleading 41-20 win as MU had a 371-355 yd edge. LY UGA came in missing 2 RB's & 3 of their top 4 rec's then suffered 4 TO's in their 41-26 (-7) loss. UGA is off a 44-17 (-33') win over Vandy in which Heisman hopeful RB Gurley rushed for 163 (6.5) & compl the longest pass for the Bulldogs TY (50 yds). MU is fresh off a bye & in their last gm won 21-20 (+5) at SC in stunning fashion as they were down 20-7 mid 4Q. QB Mauck had compl just 9-29 passes before going 3-5 in their final 2 scoring drives. Facing similar sked's, UGA is +124 ypg & +23 ppg vs our #46 sked while MU is +18 ypg & +14 ppg vs our #39 sked. With that in mind, we like the Dogs here who just got back a couple of WR's LW and they take a huge step in the SEC East.

CLEMSON by 10 over Louisville - First meeting. The Tigers are 20-2 SU/15-7 ATS the L/5+ ssns hosting ACC foes incl 2-0 SU/ATS TY. CU dismantled NCSt LW 41-0 (-14'). The shutout was their first s/'08 & first in ACC play s/98 (23-0 vs MD). True frosh QB Watson delivered again with 267 pass yds & 4 ttl td's as the Tigers held 25-12 FD & 493-156 yd edges. QB Brissett, after opening eyes vs FSU LW, was held to just 4-18-35. Louisville is off a 28-6 (-3') win over Syracuse, which was kind a slap in the face to us as we liked them vs a weaker WF tm at home the wk prior and despite having "just" a 352-255 yd edge, they won by 22 (only beat WF by 10 despite a 421-100 yd edge!). UL is 9-1 as an AD the L4Y (first time in role TY) & Petrino was 3-1 in that role his previous stint with UL. CU is on a 6-2 ATS run as a HF incl 3-0 already TY. While we respect the job Watson has done the L/2 wks, look for LVille's D to give him some different looks. NOTRE DAME by 21 over North Carolina - ND lost the L/gm ('08) 29-24 (+8'), just their 2nd series loss (16-2, only other in 1960). ND led 24-22 but all'd a GW 4 yd td run 5 sec into the 4Q. ND's L/3 drives ended in a SOD at NC23, an int at NC15 & a fmbl at NC7! The Tar Heels are 0-11 all-time (3 shutouts) in South Bend w/an avg score of 28-10. LTH ('06) North Carolina lost 45-26 (+24') as they were in the midst of a 3-9 season. They have had 6 str winning seasons but that could be in jeopardy TY as they are 2-3 SU/0-5 ATS and have lost their L/3 gms by a combined 61 pts. On the other side, it is starting to feel like 2012 again, as the Irish are 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS and are fresh off a thrilling win over Stanford in the rain 17-14 (+3) as they got a 23-yd TD pass on 4&11 w/1:01 to play. ND actually should have won the gm by DD's as they had a 21-14 FD edge and outgained the Cardinal 370-205, but missed a couple of FG's, threw an int at the SU 2 and then also fumbled at their own 10, giving SU a 10-yd TD drive. CLEVELAND by 3 over Pittsburgh - Roethlisberger may be 17-1 SU vs CLE but the Browns are a decent 8-6 ATS in the series losing by a FG in the season opener. CLE rolled out 191 yds (6.2) on the ground with a 20-8 FD and 289-139 yd edge while forcing PIT to punt on 5 of their 1st 6 drives in the 2H. CLE struggled to run LW vs TEN and have given up 153 ypg (5.1) which is 42 ypg more than LY's #18 rush defense. CLE was late to the game vs TEN but dominated the 2H with a 16-6 FD and 278-126 yd edge as their 25 pt comeback is the largest in NFL history by a road team. PIT struggled to put away the Jags LW until they logged a 22 yd pick-six after Roethlisberger fumbled the ball although they won the yardage battle for the 4th time in 5 games TY. We'll take the home team to keep the momentum going as their strengths backed by a true home edge here matches up well vs a defensively limited Div foe in its 4th road game in 5 weeks.

ATLANTA by 4 over Chicago - Both teams have taken big hits due to injury and the Falcons find themselves in the same situation they were on the OL LY. ATL was down 4 starting OL from opening day LW and had a 10 pt lead vanish on 3 straight drives by the Giants. ATL has been outrushed 136 (3.9) to 78 (4.8) and they only had 1 sks, 1 QBH vs the Giants. The good news is that they are back in their element at home where they're +184 ypg vs -77 on the road. Even more lopsided is Ryan's QBR of 135.8 at home vs 72.8 away. CHI blew a 21-7 lead vs CAR as the Panthers turned 4 TO's into 10 pts. Cutler puts up decent numbers (94.9 QBR) and in the 2 games TY without an int the Bears have covered while dropping the other 3 It also needs to be noted that Alshon Jeffery is the only player with double digits ypc in the passing game which makes it easier on defenses. We'll side with the home team by 4 as Bears do have some backdoor potential and let the line decide.

GB is allowing a 62.7 defensive QBR with just a 6.3 ypa and a 3-7 ratio. Some of that is inflated off the Vikings game but keep in mind GB has started the L3Y slowly. This is a letdown game for GB after facing 3 straight NFC North foes, and they do have CAR/NO on deck. We'll take the road team with the better QB that's played a deeper slate of games here.

MINNESOTA by 2 over Detroit - The Vikings are 8-2 ATS vs the Lions and get a DET team that lost to their former HC who was carried off the field in victory. DET was just 1 of 11 on 3rd Dns, lost Megatron (ankle), RB Bush (ankle) and OG Warford. The Lions do have the #1 defense but the Lions are still one dimensional with the #21 rush attack (84 ypg 3.1) and they are 31st in sacks allowed (17 vs 23 sks LY). The Vikings are not as good as the team that scored 41 pts vs ATL or as bad as the one that gave up 41 pts to GB. The extra rest will help Bridgewater get up to speed and HD's off a Thursday Nite loss are 6-2 ATS prior to last MNF. While MIN hasn't been truly challenged by a passing foe (Brady and Rodgers had short fields to work with) they are getting DET at a good time as they deal with injuries, bad special teams play and a crushing loss. MIN's stats from the QB spot (68.6 QBR) aren't ideal but there isn't much film on Bridgewater at this point and we'll take the HD vs a dinged up dome team that doesn't travel well (6-16-1 ATS).

The Bills are off a huge road win vs DET which they had circled since OTA's for DC Schwartz as the Lions missed 3 FG's on the day. Orton was rusty in his 2nd start since 2011 (308 yds 70% 1-1) but did enough to keep the offense together as the run game was held to under 100 yds for the 3rd straight week. After their last A-level game (vs MIA) they were held to 10 pts and 292 yds vs SD. This is a poor matchup for NE's struggling OL (3.7 ypc 10 sks) vs a Bills defense that has 17 sacks so far. BAL was outgained 422-287, went 1 for 11 on 3rd Dns and lost the TOP battle by 17:26 (gave up 80 plays). TB on the other hand over achieved as a DD dog taking NO to OT despite giving up 511 yds. The Bucs turned 3 Brees int's int 14 pts but were done in by 15 pen's for 113 yds which froze their momentum. In their L3 games the Bucs have been hammered on the ground getting outrushed 123 (4.0) to 64 (3.3). Another concern is that their #30 pass defense is giving up a 103.9 QBR with a 10-4 ratio TY. While Glennon has a good grasp of the offense and is not the problem the lack of depth on defense is hurting them. This is BALs 3rd road game in 4 Wks and dogs off an OT game with a bye on deck are 19-6-1 ATS and the Bucs know what to expect facing Steve Smith.

San Diego by 1 over OAKLAND - The Chargers are just 3-7 ATS vs the Raiders who made the big switch to Tony Sparano over the bye. Its unknown who will be the OAK QB at this point with Carr (knee/ankle) inj'd vs MIA, Schaub having not been with the team for 2 weeks and McGloin (129 yds 63% 1-2 vs MIA) is just bad. Sparano had a good reputation for getting most out of players in MIA and vets know they won't be able to simply soak up playing time. OAK has only won the yardage battle in 8 of their L21 games while having a better QBR just twice. SD has won the yardage battle 14 times with a better QBR 16 times in their L21. This is SD's 1st road game in 3 Wks and they have a KC and DEN on deck and DIV road teams off shutout victory are just 0-9-1 ATS. Rivers only has a 91.3 lifetime QBR vs the Raiders, 0-4 or worse teams off a bye are a solid 25-7-1 ATS so we'll call for the Chargers by 1 as the Raiders get a surge with an interim HC with a decent 14-9-1 ATS record in Div play.

Washington at Arizona - The Redskins are off LW's MNF game and its not known how they fared vs SEA or what if any adjustments Gruden did with Cousins at the helm. They are 0-8 SU/2-6 ATS on the road being outgained 396-322 losing by 10 ppg. The Redskins #12 pass defense has given up opposing QBR's of 109.3 or more in 3 of 4 games TY with the only exception being vs JAX. ARZ was outgained 488-100 after their 1st 2 drives but they were down to #3 QB Logan Thomas for the final 1.5 Qtrs as Palmer's shoulder is uncertain here and Stanton (concussion) was KO'd of LW's game. The Cardinals also lost DE Campbell (MCL) for 3 Wks for an already thin defense. There are too many unknowns here so we'll pass on this for now.

NY Giants at Philadelphia - The Giants opened this season 0-2 avg 269 ypg but have reeled off 3 straight wins as their new offense clicks in avg 392 ypg. The Eagles meanwhile are the exact opposite as they avg 419 ypg LY plus the F/2 games TY but now in their last 3 are avg 315 ypg. Does the pattern continue or does the Eagles offense rebound?

San Francisco at St Louis - Monday - Rams HC Jeff Fisher has gone 8-2 ATS as a division HD incl 3-1 ATS here but that loss was also in primetime and also vs the 49ers LY (SF-3, 35-11). SF, however, has played their best under the midweek lights as they lost their first under Harbaugh but have won the next 6 by 17 ppg with the only ATS loss laying 14' to ATL in game #15 LY. 
