This marks the 3rd P5 conf road gm in 4 wks for BG, who snapped an 11 gm P5 conf losing streak against MD 2 wks ago.

RUTGERS by 21 over Kansas - First meeting & homecoming for Rutgers. KU is 3-15 SU in road open-ers and the Jayhawks have dropped 30 str away gms overall (last win at UTEP in '09's road opener)! They enter off a bye after losing 55-23 (+13') vs Memphis the wk prior. Rutgers is off a 28-3 (+9) loss at PSU as HC Flood was susp and not on the sideline and won't be here as well. He is all'd to cch the team during the wk however. KU has gone 1-6 SU/0-7 ATS after a reg ssn bye, with the avg SU loss by 39 ppg. RU is 13-5 SU, but is on a 2-4 ATS run prior to a reg ssn bye, but is also on an 8-4 ATS run vs non-conf foes. There's no real sked edge as Rutgers is off a physical gm with PSU and has a bye next wk, while the Jayhawks enter off a bye and have to travel to lowa St for their B12 opener next week.

TOLEDO by 17 over Arkansas St - UT is 3-0 SU in this series incl a 63-44 (-3') win in last ssn's Go-

Daddy.com Bowl. The tms comb for over 1000 yds (UT 541-468) incl 365 rush yds for UT, which led 35-17 at HT & 49-31 early 4Q despite allow a 94 yd IR td. The Rockets have won B2B gms vs P5 conf teams after their 30-23 (-7') OT win LW vs Iowa St. UT was up 20-10 4Q, but all'd ISU to tie the gm & send it into OT. The Rockets were outg'd 481-309, outFD'd 27-16 & lost the TOP battle 38:18-21:42. RB Hunt did rush for over 100 yds for an FBS high 12th str gm. Ark St was without their st'g QB Knighten, but still set a schl rec for pts in their 70-7 win over FCS Missouri St. Backup QB Tabary hit 21-24-255 with 3 td passes. The Red Wolves are 9-4 as an AD (0-1 TY), but under HC Anderson, they're just 2-5 ATS on the road overall. Indiana by 7 over WAKE FOREST - First meeting. Indiana is 3-0 SU for the 1st time s/10 after their 38-35 (-2) win over WKU. RB Howard is poised to fill the shoes of Tevin Coleman as he finished with 203 (6.6) rush yds as the Hoosiers came back from a 28-17 HT deficit. IU finished with 639-568 yd & 34-28 FD edges. WF won its 1st AG s/13 after nailing a 47 yd fg with no time left to beat Army 17-14 (-5). True frosh QB Hinton led the comeback, scoring two 2H td's after st'g QB Wolford inj'd his ankle (CS for this week). The Demon Deacons finished with 346-240 yd & 19-11 FD edges, but were -3 TO's. WF HC Clawson lost to Indiana while HC at BG in '13 42-10 being outg'd 601-409 but were only outFD'd by 1. WF is on a 5-1 ATS run as a HD, while IU is on a 1-3 ATS run in road openers. IU is also just 2-10 SU s/'96 on the road vs current P5 non-conf opp's (just 3rd such trip in L10Y). ILL is 21-2 SU hosting non-B10 foes but is just 3-8 ATS vs FBS foes as a fav. MT is 3-6-1 ATS as an AD. The Blue Raiders have their homecoming m vs Vandy on deck while Illinois has their B10 onengry vs Nah on deck gm vs Vandy on deck while Illinois has their B10 opener vs Neb on deck. New Mexico by 3 over WYOMING - NM has lost 3 str trips to Laramie. LTH NM trailed 21-0 late 2Q but

the gm was 24-24 w/13:16 left. After B2B Wyoming td's, New Mexico scored w/1:06 to cut the deficit in half but their onside failed. LY WY had a 29-10 FD edge, ran 94 plys vs just 39 by NM, 541-382 yd edge, was +1 TO's and held NM to 0-7 on 3D (0-2 on 4D). Thanks to a 19-yd IR td and 97-yd KR td all'd the Cowboys lost 36-30! NM is off a 34-10 (+28) loss at AZSt last Friday. The Lobos made it close as they were only down 3-0 late 2Q before talent took over. NM was outg'd 449-295, but only outFD'd 19-15. BU won in '11 (-20') at home 56-31. BU is 3-0 ATS SU and ATS in the series. BU is 14-7-1 ATS as a DD Fav but have not covered their L/2. Rice defeated North Texas LW 38-24 (-7) but led 38-10 in the 3Q before NT scored 2 late TDs. Rice is 11-5-1 ATS. This gm is sandwiched between two CUSA gms, including a big HG vs WKU, that may have more of Rice's attention while Baylor has had two weeks to prepare for this gm.

Texas A&M by 3 over Arkansas (Arlington) - These 2 have had 3 SEC meetings and A&M is 3-0 SU with the avg win 46-24 with the two teams combining for an avg of 1,081 yds. Ark is 3-1 SU in this series in Arlington winning all 3 from '09-'11 by an avg of 38-25. That puts them 5-1 ATS in this series as LY in their return to Arlington they were +9 and lost 35-28 despite leading 28-14 in the 4Q. A&M got 86 and 59 yd td passes to tie then won it in OT. UA is off B2B NC losses but hope to wipe the slate clean in SEC play. LW UA lost as HF vs Texas Tech 35-24 (-10). UA was outgained only 486-424 but could not get stops as TT did not punt once. A&M defeated Nevada LW 44-27 (-34). A&M outgained Nev 535-359 and Allen accounted for 5 TDs. UA has depth concerns at WR with Hatcher and Hollister missing the TT game and Cornelius suffering an injury in the gm (CS). A&M is just 1-7 as a fav in conf play while UA is 5-2. FLORIDA by 1 over Tennessee - LW Florida extended their streak vs Kentucky to 29 gms with a 14-9

win (-3). UF led 14-3 at HT but was shutout in the 2H. The O struggled again and one of their TDs was set up by a Hargreaves INT ret to the UK 19. These 2 met in '12 and NCSt was -30' at home and only won 31-7. They did lead the game 31-0 into the 4Q but SA was only outgained 384-314 as they were -3 in TO's. LW NCSt won vs ŎDU 38-14 (-10). NCSt has faced 3 low profile tms (wins over ODU, EKU and Troy) outscoring them 122-35 and gets a 4th vs USA. This is only USA's 2nd time hosting a P5 tm, LY they hosted Miss St losing 35-3 (+13). NCSt is 6-2 vs NC Opp but does have the ACC opener vs Louisville up next.

Georgia Southern by 13 over IDAHO - Georgia Southern comes into this having won B2B over an FCS and WMU. Idaho also won vs an FCS LW in a close affair 41-38. ID trailed 20-10 at the half LY as they were +24' on the road at GS. Down 33-10 they would score 2 td's to trail by single digits, 33-24 and had the ball but were int'd and ret'd for a td. GS would later score after ID was SOD on its own 43. GS drove 43/9 and got a td with :03 left for the 47-24 final. ID was an amazing 6-1 as a conf dog LY but has started TY 0-3 ATS. Florida Atlantic is 2-6 in CUSA road gms and its either been feast or famine as the wins are by 14 & 34 pts while the

losses are by 15 ppg. FAU is 1-11 prior to a bye week. FAU is now 0-5 as a Fav. Tcu by 14 over TEXAS TECH - TCU won The Iron Skillet LW vs SMU 56-37 (-37) and now must go on the rd for their conf opener. TCU's lead was cut to 42-37 with 8:20 left but added two late TD's.
