4★ OKLAHOMA over lowa St - Series has been dominated by OU. Sooners are 43-1-1 SU incl 16 str by an avg score 36-9. OU has covered 8 of L/10. LY OU won 59-14 (-15', led 35-7 at HT) w/a 751-334 yd & 41-17 FD edge. LTH the gm was 10-10 at HT & ISU had a 198-110 yd edge but OU eventually won 48-10 (-23') W/a 618-490 yd & 44-23 FD edge. OU is coming off a dominating win over a struggling Kansas squad. The Sooners (-39) raced out to a 38-7 HT lead and finished w/710-216 yd & 35-15 FD edges. WR Shephard led the way with 11-183-1 and QB Mayfield was 27-32-383-4-0. ISU is coming off their best win of the ssn, a 24-0 (+3') win over Texas. The Cyclones are the 1st unranked tm s/ '61 to shutout the Longhorns. The 'Clones got a big effort from RB Warren (32-157-1). ISU had 426-204 yd & 28-11 FD edges! ISU will need an even bigger defensive effort to slow down the Sooners. OU is avg 533 ypg while ISU has all'd 433 ypg this ssn but OU has outg'd their L/3 foes by 377 ypg! OU is 36-22-1 as a HF. ISU is on a 5-8 ATS run & 5-8-1 ATS vs B12 foes. FORECAST: OKLAHOMA BY 35 3 * USC over Arizona - USC is 11-2 SU in this series but AZ is 8-2 ATS. USC followed up its win over undefeated Utah 2 wks ago with a 27-21 (-3') win on the road at Cal LW. The Trojans D is starting to heat up as they held Cal to ssn lows in yds (389) & FD's (23). AZ was manhandled in their 49-3 (+4) less on the road at LIW. The Wildrate D continues to be the issue as they are all'g 453 year overall. loss on the road at UW. The Wildcats D continues to be the issue as they are all'g 453 ypg overall & 480 ypg in P12 action. While they're +106 ypg at home, AZ is -1 ypg away & are -5 ypg vs P12 foes. USC is +112 ypg at home, but are just +9 ypg in P12 play. The Trojans are playing without pressure & can actually still win the P12 North if they win out & Utah loses another gm. USC is 17-9 as a HF. AZ is 8-14 as an AD. Going way back in history, we won our 1994 college GOY with USC in their 45-28 (-3') win over AZ. Could we use the Trojans as our GOY in 2015?

FORECAST: USC BY 28 3★ Marshall over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - Marshall is 3-1 but 1-1 in CUSA mtgs. LY MU jumped out to a 14-0 lead but MT was down just 28-17 at HT. MT could do little in the 2H and MU rolled to a 49-24 win (-23'). The HT is 3-1 in this series. MT enters fresh off a bye & a 45-16 (+7') loss on the road at LT the wk prior. The Blue Raiders trailed 35-10 at HT, but were only outg'd 470-414 as they were -3 in TO's & all'd an int ret td. RFr QB Stockstill (son of HC) had a car high 381 yds & on the ssn is avg 306 pass ypg, compl 67%, with an 18-6 ratio. MT is +207 ypg at home vs -124 ypg on the road and are +90 ypg in CUSA action. LW we easily cashed a 3★ LPS play (college sides went 4-1, now 17-6 L4W!) with Marshall in their 34-10 (-16') win over Charlotte! The outcome was never in doubt as MU jumped out to a 31-3 HT lead and led 34-3 in the 4Q. MU held 630-307 yd & 31-22 FD edges. QB Littén threw for a car high 486 yds and 2 tds. WR Allen also set car highs with 12-232-1. The key matchup in this gm will be MT's pass gm which avg's 309 ypg (66% comp) vs MU's pass D which all's just 177 pass ypg (47% comp). MT is 0-4 ATS. is 16-5 SU, SC has won 3 of 5 SU, but have been upset the L2Y. UT followed up their strong effort at Bama 2 wks ago w/a dominant 52-21 (-9) road win at UK (easy 4.5★ Power Plays Newsletter Winner). The outcome was never in question as the Vol's led 24-14 at HT & scored 2 quick td's to open the 2H. Not only did UT have a 482-349 yd edge, they also scored td's on a KOR & PR. We easily cashed a 3* LPS play on Sat (LPS side pl's went 4-1, now 17-6 the L4W!) with SC as they had their best offensive performance of the ssn in their 35-28 (+16') road loss at A&M. The Gamecocks pulled to within 7 late 3Q, but couldn't find any success in the 4Q. SC finished 1 yd short of their best rushing performance 3Q, but couldn't find any success in the 4Q. Sc. Inilsned 1 yd short of their best rushing performance of the ssn, but their D continues to be their downfall as they are all'g 462 ttl ypg & 248 (5.7) rush ypg in SEC action. Ohio at BOWLING GREEN - BG has won 3 str by an avg of 26 ppg despite being +3, -9' & Pick (4-0 ATS). BG enters this gm fresh off a bye & a 48-0 (-14) win on the road at Kent St the wk prior. The Falcons all'd a ssn low 166 yds & are #1 in the FBS avg 205 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Johnson threw 5 td passes for the 3rd str gm and threw for 400+ for the 6th time TY! He's avg 415 pass ypg, completing 70.1% w/a 29-3 ratio! What was the Falcons became just 1 of 5 tms to start 4-0 on the road (TCU, Temple, Houston, Memphis) & are 4-0 in MAC play for the 1st time s/'03. Ohio is also off a bye following a 41-17 (-2') road loss at Buffalo the wk prior. The Bobcats have rushed for 100 yds or less in 3 of their L/4 gms, but are only all'g 198 pass ypg on the ssn. WKU led 48-30 and scored a td in the 4Q to give Hilltopper backers the cover. UTSA is 1-4 as a HF. ODU is 1-5 as an AD and are on a 2-14 ATS run incl 0-8 ATS TY!

Notre Dame by 10 over PITTSBURGH - ND is 3-1 SU but 0-3-1 ATS. L/gm (also LTH) Pitt won 28-21 pulling the outright unset as 3' of thD over #24 ND ND led 14-7 at HT & for the gm had a 456-355 vd edge.

Down 20-3 w/ under a min before HT, the Panthers drove to the NC 18 but their final pass into the EZ fell incomplete. Pitt finished with 25-17 FD & 35:15-24:45 TOP edges, with the yds nearly even. Panthers RB Ollison had been avg nearly 19 carries/gm over the L/4 and was given just 10, as they chose to go with the smaller RB James, who avg'd under 4.0 ypc in the gm. ND is coming off a 24-20 win (-10') against Temple in the most hyped gm in their schls history with Gameday on hand. ND held 467-295 yd and 20-16 FD edges but had trouble in the RZ as QB Kizer threw 2 int's and ND settled for a 23 yd fg. ND found themselves trailing in the 4Q before QB Kizer found WR Fuller for the GW td. ND is +132 ypg on the road while Pitt is only +12 ypg at home. This is just Pitt's 4th HG this ssn and they are 1-2 (0-3 ATS). ND is 7-2 ATS, but 8-13 ATS on the road.

MISSISSIPPI by 4 over Arkansas - Revenge spot for Ole Miss. Arkansas is 7-4 SU covering the L2Y. LY the Razorbacks upset #8 Ole Miss 30-0 (+3, led 17-0 at HT). Ole Miss did have a 316-311 yd edge +2 FD) but were -5 TO incl all'ing a 100-yd ÌR td. LTH Ole Miss won 34-24 (-17) w/a 531-389 yd edge (+3 FD). Ole Miss is off a revenge win (-7') over Auburn 27-19. WR Treadwell broke his leg LY and played determined TY, going 7-114 and the game deciding td. Treadwell became the 1st SEC WR to have 4 str 100 yd gms s/ '01 (UF, Reche Caldwell). Ole Miss outg'd UA 558-427 & outFD'd them 27-18. Arkansas hou beat FCS UT Martin 63-28 (-37). These two have 3 common foes (Bama, Aub, A&M). Ark is 1-2 (2-1 ATS) with -6 ppg and -54 ypg vs common foes while UM is 3-0 SU/ATS with +12 ppg & +113 ypg. Ole Miss has outg'd foes by 304 ypg at home while UA has been outg'd by -4 ypg on the road! UA is 1-10 on the SEC road (5-6 ATS) and is 6-9 as an AD. Freeze is 12-6-1 as a HF and 17-8-1 ATS at home.

OHIO ST by 28 over Minnesota - OSU has won 9 str SU (6-3 ATS). OSU's L/series loss was in '00. LY OSU won 31-24 (-13) w/489-303 yd & 22-17 FD edges (OSU was off a huge showdown vs MSU). LTH ('09) OSU led just 7-0 at HT but won 38-7 (-16') w/a 509-286 yd edge. OSU does have the sked edge coming in off a bye while Minn just faced a tough UM defense. The defending Nat'l Champ Buckeyes finally dominated for a complete gm (QB Barrett's 1st start) in their 49-7 (-21) road win at Rut the wk prior, easily cashing us a 3★ LPS winner. OSU had 528-293 yd & 27-12 FD edges & gave up the shutout w/a gbg td w/:12 left. Barrett is suspended for this gm (OVI), so it will be back to Cardale Jones. The Buckeyes have scored at do n just 22% of Jones' drives, compared to 46% with Barrett under center. RB Elliot has rushed for 100+ in 13 str gms. UM played as an inspired unit LW (+13) versus Michigan after HC Kill was forced to retire due to health concerns. Minn outplayed Mich for most of the gm but trailed 29-26 late in the 4Q. Minn drove all the way to the Mich 1. Poor clock management left Minn with 1 play and Interim HC Claeys rolled the dice but Minn was stuffed and time ran out. Minn outg'd Mich 461-296 but settled for 4 fgs which made the difference. OSU is 1-6 as a HF while UM is 6-3 as an AD and 10-3 as a Dog vs B10 foes. Going back to his days at Florida, HC Meyer is 18-2 SU (15-4-1 ATS) off a bye.

WASHINGTON STATE by 4 over Arizona St - WSU is 1-10 SU/4-7 ATS incl 0-3 SU/ATS the L3Y. LY #13 ASU won 52-31 (-16) despite WSU w/622-330 yd & 30-16 FD edges. The Cougars had 5 TO incl 4 int's. LTH WSU was outg'd 557-302 (-19 FD) in a 55-21 (+10') loss. Sun Devils will have 2 extra days rest as they are off a Thur Night gm, lost 61-55 (-2') in 3OT vs ÚO. ASU had a 742 (1 yd short of school rest as they are off a I hur Night gm, lost 61-55 (-2') in 3O1 vs UO. ASU had a 742 (1 yd short of school record)-501 yd & 37-19 FD edge, led by DD's late 3Q, gave up a td w/:12 left, led 55-48 in 2OT & down 6 tossed a int on 2nd&G from UO3 in 3OT. QB Bercovici threw for 398 yds & had 6 till td's. WSU (+10') had their chances to upset Stanford LW. WSU led 15-3 on 5 fg's and 22-10 in the 3Q. SU took a 27-22 lead but QB Falk led WSU on a 81/15pl drive to go back ahead 28-27 but missed the 2 pt conv. Stanford took a 30-28 lead and WSU missed a 43 yd GW fg. WSU outg'd SU 442-312 & outFD'd them 26-15 but was ineffective in the redzone. The Cougar D kept constant pressure on the SU offense and held QB Hogan to 10-19-86-0-1. ASU has been outg'd by 41 ypg on the road while WSU has outg'd foes by 86 ypg at home. WSU is 5-0 ATS and 19-13 ATS vs P12 foes. ASU is 2-8 ATS.

MIAMI, FL by 14 over Virginia - Miami is actually 1-4 SU (0-4-1 ATS) being outg'd in each of the L4Y. LY UVA won 30-13 (+5') w/341-327 yd & 18-15 FD edges. LTH UM won 45-26 (-20') but UVA had a 483-304 yd & 28-11 FD edge (UM had 19-yd IR & 72-yd FR td's). UM is coming off the biggest miracle win in the program's history on the first gm after the firing of HC Golden. Duke had just taken the lead 27-24 and UM) received the KO with just :06 left. 8 laterals (and a few illegal blocks) later Miami found its way into the EZ. After a 9 minute review, refs determined that there was no penalties and the td stood. UM won despite being outg'd 440-391 & outFD'd 34-21 while also adding 23-194 in penalty yds! UM led 24-12 late despite being outg 0 440-391 & outr-D 0 34-21 willine also adoing 23-194 in penaity yds: UM led 24-12 late in the 4Q but all'd Duke to go 74/14pl & 80/10pl to take the lead before the chaos started. UVA pulled an upset of their own (+6) over GT. The Cavs' led 27-14 but GT got a td late in the 4Q then caught an onside kick but GT was SOD at the UVA34. UM is 14-8 ATS at home and 6-2 as an AF but UVA is 3-0 as an AD. SOUTH ALABAMA by 7 over Idaho - LY was the only prior mtg. SA won 34-10 (-4, led 20-0 at HT) at the Kibbie Dome w/a 429-269 yd edge. The Jaguars are off a bye & this marks just their 2nd gm in 25 days. The wk prior they lost 36-18 (+1') at TXSt but did have slight 468-424 yd & 22-19 FD edges. ID was an AF LW for the 1st time s/'10 (-7) at NMSt. The Vandals led 30-7 in the 3Q when the wheels fell off and NMSt came back to win 55-48 in OT. ID all'd NMSt to score 41 2H pts and RB Rose ran for 4 4Q/ OT tds. ID was outg'd 641-569 but outFD'd NMSt 30-24. RB Penny had an excellent gm going 35-192-2 and 3-58-1. SA will have to stop ID's pass attack which avg's 323 pass ypg (62% comp) but SA has all'd just 175 pass ypg (57% comp). ID is ply'ing the 2nd of B2B AG's & 3rd in the L4W. All-time SA is 3-8-1 as a HF being upset 3x's. ID is in their famililar AD role but 8-1 the L2Y w/a outright upset TY.

4★ MINNESOTA over St Louis - With an impressive 11-3 ATS record vs NDIV foes and a pair of consecutive 4★ winners in this newsletter, the Vikings are the easy pick again this week as they continue to be disrespected by Vegas during their 14-3 ATS run. They actually went into 2-4 Chicago as just a 2 pt favorite a week ago and delivered a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner scoring 10 points in the final 5 minutes for the 23-20 victory. MIN now returns home where they have covered 7 of their L/9 to take on a Rams squad that may be getting a bit more line value than they deserve after a pair of wins against CLE (outgained 364-308) and SF (held 49ers to just 11 FD's & 189 yds). While STL has been able to take care of business at home with a 3-1 SU/ATS mark (RB Gurley's 566 rush yds thru 1st 4 sts is most by any player s/'70 merger), keep in mind that they've had their share of struggles away from the dome as a dog with just a 6-12 ATS mark.

FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 10

3★ Atlanta over SAN FRANCISCO - The Falcons have been sputtering in each of the past 2 weeks with a narrow victory against TEN and LW's home OT loss against the Bucs as 4 TO's was too much to overcome despité a significant 496-290 yd edge. The 49ers meanwhile continued their struggles a week ago in STL (3-11 ATS run), a game in which they were held to just 6 pts, 11 FD's and 189 ttl yds (4th time held under 200 yds this ssn!). While both teams have a week off following this matchup, this appears to be a good spot for the Falcons as they have gone 7-3 ATS prior to a bye and should be well prepared for the SF offense with HC Quinn serving as the DC for the Seahawks the past 2 ssns holding the 49ers to just 8 ppg and 234 ypg during that span (3-0-1 ATS).

2★ TAMPA BAY over NY Giants - The Giants and Bucs have been hard teams to get a vibe on so far in 2015 with inconsistent play from both squads during periods of the ssn. Despite all'g 614 ttl yds against the Saints in the Superdome, the Giants nearly pulled out the mild upset w/NO scoring 10 pts in the final :36 of the 4Q for the 52-49 win (NYG just 2nd tm in NFL history to score 49+ pts and lose!). While TB did blow a 17 pt lead in ATL all'g the Falcons to force OT, the Bucs came out victorious in the extra frame as QB Winston accounted for a pair of TD's and failed to throw an int for the 3rd consec game in the process. Despite going just 3-9 ATS at home and being a clearly stronger road team in '15 with wins over NO and the previously mentioned Falcons, the Giants inability to hold onto late leads has us leaning with the home underdog in this one. FORECAST: TAMPA BAY by 3

OTHER PLAYS

Cleveland at CINCINNATI - TNF - LY's TNF matchup in Cincy between these 2 saw the Browns leave town with a huge 24-3 upset (+6) and a spot atop the AFC North standings at 6-3. Things haven't been the same for either squad since as CLE has dropped 12 of their past 15 games (incl a 30-0 blanking by the Bengals late last ssn) while CIN has been victorious in 13 of their L/15 (8-1-1 ATS run) incl their come-from-behind win at PIT a week ago. Will the Browns (7-3-1 ATS as an AD) be able to deliver an upset over their rival again this ssn with major inj issues (CB Haden and S Whitner out w/conc) in their secondary? Find out with one of our very special NFL Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee Packs.

PITTSBURGH by 8 over Oakland - Despite a solid defensive outing from the Steelers that saw them hold the Bengals to a ssn-low 16 pts and 296 yds, QB Roethlisberger was clearly rusty in his return to the lineup as he threw 3 int's and saw RB Bell lost to a ssn-ending knee inj in the 6 pt loss (1st B2B losses for PIT since wk 13 & 14 of 2013). Meanwhile the OAK offense delivered their most impressive game of the ssn LW against the Jets behind QB Carr and his 333 yd, 4TD performance. The Raiders have seen a mixed bag of results in their 1st 2 trips East so far this ssn however as while they did go in and knock off the Browns as a 3' pt dog, they followed that up the next week with a 2 pt loss against the Bears as a 3 pt favorite. While this matchup

could be labeled as a flat spot for a Steelers squad that has a home meeting with CLE on deck, they'll need to establish a considerable winning streak soon if they're planning to get back into the playoff mix.

NY JETS by 13 over Jacksonville - After allowing 18 ppg and 283 ypg thru their 1st 6 gms of the ssn, the Jets defense was taken to the woodshed LW by OAK as they all'd 4 TD passes and 451 ttl yds in the 34-20 loss. They now return home with some potential questions at QB (Fitzpatrick inj'd, CS) to take on a rested Jags team (off a bye) that has struggled against NDIV foes with just a 14-31-1 ATS mark. Despite LW's hiccup against the Raiders, the Jets are on a solid 7-2-1 ATS run and remain 3rd in the NFL in ypg all'd (307) on the year. This doesn't bode well for a Jaguars team that has gone just 13-23-2 as a dog and has failed to deliver a true road victory in nearly 2 calendar years.

BUFFALO by 4 over Miami - The Bills enter their home matchup off a much needed bye week according to HC Ryan following their narrow 34-31 loss to the Jags in London, a game in which they actually trailed 27-3 in the 2Q. While the change in leadership during their bye week saw the Dolphins deliver a pair of convincing wins against the Titans and Texans (outscored them by a combined 82-36), reality set in last Thur in their matchup at NE as the Patriots jumped out to a 19-0 HT lead and finished w/a 437-270 yd edge with MIA losing their top sackman Wake in the process (OFY w/Achilles). MIA now heads to BUF with a 31-17-1 ATS mark as an AD and seeking revenge following their Wk 3 dismantling by the Bills at home where they found themselves trailing 27-0 heading into the 3Q. This may a difficult feat to overcome

however as BUF has now won and covered each of the past 3 meetings in Orchard Park by 14 ppg. NEW ORLEANS by 14 over Tennessee - The Saints survived the mother of all shootouts LW against the Giants (63 comb FD's and 14 ttl TD's were 2nd most in NFL history) behind a 40-50, 511 yd passing performance from Brees who also tied the NFL single gm record w/7 TD passes in the process. The Titans meanwhile continued their struggles a week ago against the Texans as bkp QB Mettenberger (Mariota out for 2nd consec wk) guided the offense to just 15 FD's and 211 ttl yds in the 20-6 defeat (Titans 3-0 TO deficit, all'd 7 sks, 6th straight loss). This is a rough spot for the visitors in this one as TEN is now 6-15-2 ATS as a dog and have failed to cover in 14 of their past 17 following a SU loss. The Saints meanwhile have begun to fire on all cylinders (23-9-2 ATS at home vs NDIV foes) following a rough start and should have no problem winning a 3rd straight here as they look to climb back into playoff contention.

NEW ENGLAND by 17 over Washington - The Patriots scorched the earth again last Thur against the Dolphins in their 36-7 victory, a game in which they outgained MIA at ease with a 437-270 yd advantage while moving their #1 scoring offense up to 35.6 ppg in the process. The Redskins meanwhile made the Bucs offense look similar to NE's in their 1 pt come-from-behind victory prior to their bye as they all'd a ssn-worst 479 ttl yds incl 190 (6.3) on the ground. It doesn't get much tougher for WAS this weekend as they've been outscored by 10 ppg in their 3 road defeats so far in '15 while also routinely struggling as an outright dog (9-19 ATS). With a 10-4-1 ATS mark against NDIV foes, the Patriots could potentially name the final score at Foxboro in this one.

Denver by 7 over INDIANAPOLIS - "The Peyton Manning Farewell Tour" makes a stop at his old stomping grounds this week (spent 1st 14 yrs here) against the Colts who have now dropped 5 consecutive regular ssn contests to NDÌV foes (outscored 30-15). DEN is 7-0 for just the 2nd time in franchise history following their impressive outing on SNF against fellow undefeated GB as their #1 defense (16 ppg, 261 ypg) held the Packers to just 140 ttl yds (224 yds under ssn avg) while they finally got some offensive help of their own putting up 29 pts against the top scoring D in the NFL (DEN's 500 ttl yds was +174 ypg over ssn avg). Despite IND delivering well as a HD with an 11-4 ATS mark, they might not fair well here as they find themselves on a short week (MNF vs CAR, outgained in every gm TY heading in!!) and matching

up against a Broncos squad looking for revenge following their early exit in LY's playoffs.

Philadelphia at DALLAS - SNF - The Eagles have been a frequent visitor to primetime evening matchups so far in 15 with a pair of MNF battles along with a 2nd trip to SNF in the past 3 wks. They return from by seeking revenge against a Cowboys squad that handled them with ease at "The Linc" in Wk 2 of the ssn (PHI just 10 pts & 226 ttl yds) as a 5" pt dog. Coincidentally DAL hasn't seen the right side of the scoreboard since with 5 consec defeats (all without Romo) including LW at home vs SEA, a game in which they failed to reach the EZ settling for 4 FG's in QB Cassel's 2nd start with the team (just 14 FD's and 220 ttl yds). Chicago at SAN DIEGO - NNF - While the Bears head out West carrying a 10-19 ATS mark as a dog,
