#### KEY SELECTIONS

4★ MICHIGAN over Oregon St - Wolverines are 4-0 vs the Beavers but the L/gm (also LTH) was in '86 (31-12 win). In that '86 ssn UM started 9-0 and was ranked as high as #2 while OSU was in the midst of a 3-8 ssn. UM is coming off a 24-17 (+4') loss at Utah in the much anticipated debut of HC Harbaugh. UM had a 355-337 yd edge with the FD & TOP even, but they were done in by 3 TO's. OSU is coming off a 26-7 win over FCS Weber after leading just 6-0 at HT. True frosh QB Collins hit just 10-18-92, but finished with 152 rush yds, the most for an OSU QB s/'96! OSU, coming off a 5-7 (2-7 P12) yr LY & is led by former Wisconsin & Utah St HC Gary Andersen. Michigan is 48-25-1 all-time against teams from the Pac-12. OSU has won 3 str road openers but are 5-11 in away games vs non-conference foes s/'03. HC Andersen DN face UM the L2Y while at Wisconsin. UM is 22-3 in home openers and 18-1 L6Y at home vs non-conf foes. Michigan fans have been circling this date on their calenders for months as the home debut of HC Harbaugh will have the home fans buzzing and we think the 'Wolves will play inspired TW and easily take care of a not as talented Beaver squad.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 21

3★ AKRON (+) over Pitt - Pitt HC Narduzzi is breaking in a new defense which showed LW vs FCS YSU as the Panthers gave up 37 pts and 407 yds. Pitt's offense clicked from the start and despite the def issues, never trailed and won 45-37. Pitt RB Conner left LW in the 1H w/inj (knee CS). He did run for two TD's before leaving. RFr RB Ollison filled in nicely (16-207 1TD). Pitt star receiver Boyd comes back from susp for this gm. Akron failed to cover vs Oklahoma, losing 41-3. The Zips were outgained 539-226 and held to just 88 yds passing. This is just the 2nd time UA has hosted a P5 conf team since Infocision Stadium inaugural ssn ('09) when UA hosted Indiana (lost 38-21). LY UA got their first win over a P5 team s/'08 and that came at the expense of Pitt. LY's 21-10 upset of Pitt was Zips first win over P5 tm since '08. Led by a career day from RB Conor Hundley, Akron (posted 169 yards on the ground and 382 yards overall). Hundley finished with a career-high 148 yds on 19 carries (7.8 ypc). UA stacked the box with 8 or 9 men holding James Conner to 25 carries and 92 yds. UA got a td with 12:20 left to lead 21-10. Pitt was int'd at the UA9 and SOD at the UA31 in the 4Q. UA is just 6-15 as a HD in Infocision Stadium. It's easily foreseeable that Akron was looking ahead to this match up in their uninspired performance LW due to the way they pl'd Pitt a year ago in pulling the upset & we think Bowden & co keep this gm close.

FORECAST: Pitt by 3

3★ Lsu over MISSISSIPPI ST - LSU is playing with legit revenge here. They had won 14 in a row SU in the series. In fact, over the last 18 years, LSU is now 14-4 ATS. LY MSU upset #8 LSU 34-29 (+9), their first win vs the Tigers s/'99. MSU led 17-3 at HT & 34-10 early 4Q before LSU scored final 19. (2 td L/1:55). Their last drive got to the MSU 46 but they were int'd at the end. LTH ('13) the Tigers trailed 23-21 late 2Q (until td :17) but after an early 3Q MSU fg, LSU scored 31 unanswered pts in the 59-26 (-7') win, their 7th str in Starkville. LSU's opener against FCS McNeese St was cancelled after a 4 hour weather delay. We easily cashed a 2★ on these pages LW going against MSU in their 34-16 (-21) win over SM in a gm that was much closer than the score indicated. MSU had just a 442-413 yd edge while being outFD'd by 1. SM also had a 37:45-22:15 TOP edge & threw for 311 yds. The Bulldogs are 9-4 in home openers but just 3-4 vs FBS opp's. LSU typically matches up well with the Bulldogs and we believe that will be the case again this year as LSU will get their revenge on this SEC opener for both teams.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ WISCONSIN over Miami, Oh - First meeting. We won a 4★ LPS along with a 3★ on these pages LW going against UW in their 35-17 (+12') loss to Bama. The Badgers lost LY's leading tk'r SS Caputo early 1Q (conc) and were outgained 502-268 & outFD'd 27-17 in a gm more lopsided then the score indicated. RB Clement, taking over for #1DC Gordon, had just 16 (2.0) rush yds as the Badgers rushed for just 40 in the gm. That is lowest rush total since 40 yds rush in a loss to Mich St in '12. When that happened, we used Wisky the very next week as our College GOY (-7) at Indiana & won 62-14 as the Badgers rushed for 564 yds and 8.8 ypc! MU is off a 26-7 win over FCS Presbyterian. The Redhawks are 1-11 in road openers incl 7 str losses by 28 ppg. Overall Miami has dropped 24 of their L/26 AG's incl 17 str. MU does have 10 all-time wins vs B10 schools but L/in '03 at NW. UW has won 19 str Camp Randall openers by 21 ppg & have won 32 str non-conf home gms by an avg of 25 ppg, their L/loss suffered was in '03 vs UNLV 23-5 (almost a 3 td fav). UW is 9-5 ATS as a HF and while coming off a big game vs Alabama, only have Troy and Hawaii on deck and this is HC Chryst's first HG. LY UM all'd 240 ypg rush (5.6) on the road. Wisconsin will show no mercy this week & look for RB Clement to have a huge performance as they get back in the win column in a big way against the overmatched Redhawks.

FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 42

2 NEVADA (+) over Arizona - NV has covered both recent meetings but AZ is 2-0 SU. In the '12 New Mexico Bowl, AZ trailed 48-35 with 1:48 left but got td, onside kick and td to pull out a miracle 49-48 win (-8'). LY AZ was -19 at home. The game was tied at 21 and AZ got a pair of td's with NV getting a td with 6:01 left to cut it to 7 and their final drive was SOD at their own 26 with 2:23 left. LW NV won over FCS Cal Davis 31-17. Zona won vs UTSA 42-32 but struggled on D as UTSA had a 525-392 vd edge and the loss of AA LB Wright will not help.

NV won over FCS Cal Davis 31-17. Zona won vs 013A 42-32 but struggled on 2 as 513A had a 525-392 yd edge and the loss of AA LB Wright will not help.

2★ SYRACUSE over Wake Forest - Syracuse is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS in this series while the home tm is 3-1 overall. UM is coming off a 45-0 win over an FCS tm, which was their 1st shutout under HC Golden. UM is 3-7 in road openers (2-1 L3Y). Incl bowls UM is 18-2 s/'04 (1st yr in ACC) vs non-conf in-state tms. FAU is 5-9 in home openers since starting its FB program in '01 incl 2-2 at FAU Stadium.

Utah State at UTAH - LTH ('13) was also the L/mtg. Aggies (487-450 yd & 27-24 FD edge) blew over a td lead in the 2H in HC Wells debut as the Utes won 30-26. Utah scored the go ahead fg w/6:38 left. Utah has won 12 of 13 in this series SU, 8-5 ATS with their avg win by 24 ppg. USU is 1-13 vs their instate rival and the L/winning SLC trip was in '97's ssn opener. LY was the first time s/'43 that USU didn't appear on the Utes slate. Home tm has won 3 str. Utah is coming off a 24-17 (-4') home win over Michigan. While the FD's were even at 20 apiece, UM had a 355-337 yd edge, but Utah benefitted from +2 in TO's. USU needed an 88 yd PR td late 4Q to squeeze past FCS Southern Utah

12-9. The Aggies were held to just 15 FD & 250 ttl yds.

FLORIDA ST by 31 over Usf - These tms have met just twice. In the L/gm ('12), FSU was on the road and won 30-17 while taking advantage of 3 USF TO's while also holding a 425-268 yd edge. LTH ('09) USF upset #18 FSU! The Bulls had a 14-0 advantage into the 4Q. FSU cut it to 7 off a 63-yd PR/25-yd td drive w/13:35 left. Seminoles L/3 poss ttl'd 2/10pl ending in a punt, sk/fmbl & SOD. USF had a successful debut of their uptempo offense in their 51-3 win over an FCS team. It was their most pts s/'11 & their 15 tfl's were the most in a gm s/'07. Our 'Early Bird' play (Button 9 comp on Mondays) won again as we had FSU & they easily cashed for us 59-16 (-30) over TXSt to improve our record to 163-90 (64%) the L/17Y! ND trans QB Golson threw for 302 yds w/a 4-0 ratio as the 'Noles ran 23 of the gms F/32 plays & led 21-10 at HT.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 1 over Western Michigan - First meeting. The Broncos have dropped

20 straight road openers by an avg 22 ppg but all 20 have been vs Power 5 conf teams incl 6 str vs Big Ten tms (L/win in '94 at Miami, Oh 28-25). Eagles have won 8 straight Home Openers by an avg score of 55-14 but this will be the first time vos an FBS foe. In fact this will be there first time hosting an FBS non-conf opp. WM is off a 37-24 (+17') home loss to MSU. The Broncos were down 27-10 at HT & were held to just 18 rush yds while all'g 196. GS avg 381 rush ypg LY, but were held to just 195 in their 44-0 loss to WV LW. WM was able to sneak in some extra prep time for GS (option offense) during the month of Aug. GS was 9-3 LY winning their HG's by an avg of 46-18 winning all 4 vs FBS foes and are 3-2 as a HF. PJ Fleck is 8-3 ATS as an AD and WM had the benefit of bowl practices. **PENN ST by 24 over Buffalo** - The visitor in this series is 0-2 w/the L/gm in '07 (PSU win 45-27). PSU trailed 3-0 until a fg w/6:29 2Q sparked 31 str pts into the 4Q (were outgained for gm). PSU is off a forgetable opening performance as they lost 27-10 (-6') at in-state rival Temple for the 1st time in 74 yrs. After taking a 10-0 lead, the Nittany Lions were outscored 27-0 as QB Hackenberg was sacked 10X incl on the gms L/2 pl's. They were outg'd 313-180 & outFD'd 15-9. Making matters worse is leading ret'g tkl'r LB Wartman was inj & OFY. UB is off a 51-14 home win over an FCS tm. The Bulls are 2-15 in road openers, 5 str losses by 19 ppg. New HC Leipold compiled a 109-6 rec w/6 DIII National Titles (34-1 playoffs) as HC at WI-Whitewater the L8Y. PSU had a 10 gm home opener win streak snapped in '12 (still 21-3). PSU does have their B10 opener on deck vs Rutgers and BU is 8-14 ATS as an AD with this being their first road game.

CONNECTICUT by 14 over Army - LY Army beat UC 35-21 (+4') in a gm played at Yankee Stadium. UC came in 4-0 SU/ATS vs Army with their avg win by 28 ppg. The Huskies were down 7 and driving deep in Army territory when the Knights got a 99-yd IR td with just :28 left for a misleading final. Army lost their LTH ('06) 21-7. UC is off a 20-15 win last Thurs over FCS Villanova in which they were a dog, having 19-18 FD, 307-303 yd edges & all'g 114 (3.2) rush yds. Army is off a 37-35 loss to FCS Fordham. They had a chance to tie the gm after scoring a td w/2:33 left but their 2 pt conv was NG. The Knights had a 22-17 FD edge, but were outg'd 445-389, rushing for 256 yds. They're just 3-24 in road openers and excluding their 2 wins over E Mich in '09-'10, they have lost 16 in a row by an avg of 22 ppg. Army did run for 327 yds (5.5) on Diaco's defense LY, but since this is the 2nd game of the ssn, CT had extra time to prep for the option during Aug.

FLORIDA by 21 over East Carolina - LTH (83, also only prior visit) EC lost 24-17. Pirates are 0-2 vs the Gators (ply'd in LY's Bowl). In the bowl gm UF won 28-20 (-7) despite being outgained 536-339 and outFD 32-15. UF led 21-7 at HT. EC settled for two 24-yd fg's & trailed 28-20 w/1:55 left. After 2 punts EC took over w/3:28 but was int'd in the EZ (from UF5) on 2nd&G w/1:20. EC is coming off a much closer than expected 28-20 (4 td fav) over FCS Towson. After losing proj'd st'g QB Benkert in Aug, JC trans Kemp went 29-37-230. Towson was driving late but was SOD at the EC16. The Pirates had only a 429-415 yd edge. UF is off a dominant 61-13 (-35') home win over NMSt. The Gators had 606-200 & 28-8 FD edges in new HC McElwains debut. EC is 2-11 in road openers & 5-12 s'07 in reg ssn road gms vs non-conf foes but 3-1 L2Y. They're also 7-10 ATS as an AD. UF entered LW on a 5-11 ATS run as a HF, before their SU/ATS win.

LOUISVILLE by 17 over Houston - These two former conf rivals were together in CUSA from '96-'04 & the AAC in '13. UL is 6-1 s/'99 incl 3 str wins w/a avg score 50-28. L/gm in '13 UH was +17 on the road vs #19 UL and nearly pulled the upset. UH led 13-10 at HT and was throwing into the EZ at the end of the game. (UL won 20-13). UL is off a 31-24 (+10') loss to Auburn despite 405-327 yd & 27-21 FD edges in a gm that was played in ATL. HC Petrino cost himself 40 valuable seconds by calling an ill-advised TO near the end of the gm. True frosh QB Jackson relieved Bonnafon ("got tired"-Petrino) and went just 9-20-100-0-1, but did have 106 (6.6) rush yds. UH is off a 52-24 win over FCS Tenn Tech in HC Herman's debut. UL is 10-2 in home openers incl 4 str wins, while UH is 5-19 in road openers but 3 of the 5 wins have come instate. UH hasn't won here s/'97 and while UL is 5-1 SU, UH is 3-2 ATS. The Cards do have a bin Thurs night configment deck vs Clemson

abig Thurs night conf gm on deck vs Clemson.

MISSISSIPPI by 28 over Fresno St - UM is 2-0 SU/ATS vs FSt incl a 38-28 (-3') win in '11 (last mtg). The game had 8 lead changes. UM trailed 14-13 after 1Q & 28-27 into the 4Q before scoring 11 unanswered in 4Q. Last & only time here ('10) FSt lost 55-38. FSU led 7-0 but UM outscored them 41-3 until mid 3Q. FS got within 10 w/3:20 4Q but UM recovered the onside & scored on a 14 yd td run w/:35 for the 17 pt win (-2). FS is off a 34-13 win over FCS Abilene Christian in a dominant performance. UM is also off a dominant performance over FCS UT-Martin, winning 76-3. New st'g QB Chad Kelly (nephew of HOF'r Jim) went 9-15-211 in his debut as the Rebels had 662-290 yd & 28-13 FD edges. UM HC Freeze is 9-5 as a HF, while FSt HC DeRuyter is 5-3 as an AD, but the Rebels have a massive gm at Bama next week.

KANSAS ST by 14 over Utsa - First meeting. KSt is coming off a costly 34-0 win over FCS SD as new st'g QB Ertz was lost to a knee inj & is doubtful for this game (CS). Bkup QB Hubener led 5 scoring drives & finished with 185 ttl vds. UTSA is off a 42-32 (+31') loss at Ariz. They only trailed 21-20 at HT & had 525-392 yd & 29-25 FD edges as they all'd 2 def td's. WR Morgan was the 1st Roadrunner w/100+ rec yds s/12. UTSA is 2-2 in home openers incl 0-2 vs Power-5 conf tms, but LY they almost upset Arizona. Kansas St is 6-7 in road openers but 4-1 the last 5 yrs. The last time that the Wildcats played a non-conf away gm was in '11 at Miami, Fl winning 28-24 but in that role they're on a 2-5 run. Bill Snyder is just 5-11-1 ATS as an AF and this will be the first road start for whoever the QB will be. KSt just ply'd here in the Alamo Bowl LY, losing to UCLA 40-35 (+1') so they're very familiar with the site.

Marshall by 3 over OHIO - This is the Battle for the Bell between these former conf rivals. The HT is 10-3-1 ATS in this series. MU had won 6 in a row then the Bobcats won all 3 from '11-'13 incl a bitter loss for MU in '13 where OU +7' at home was outgained 482-335, outFD 38-19 but still prevailed 34-31 (17 pts off 4 MU TO's). LY MU got their revenge leading 41-0 mid-3Q at home and won 44-14 (-20'). Marshall is coming off a rare home gm against a B10 foe (Purdue) last Sunday. OU was up 21-3 mid 2Q at ID and held on for a 45-28 (-7) win last Thurs. The Bobcats had a 489-400 yd edge, but were outFD'd 25-23 and benefitted from +2 TO's & a def td. OU has covered their L/6 at home vs Marshall.

OHIO ST by 42 over Hawai'i - First meeting. Hawai'i is 4-16 in road openers including 4 straight losses by 19 ppg. The Rainbow Warriors have dropped 9 str non-conf road gms w/their last win in '10 at Army 31-28. OSU had won 35 str home openers until LY's loss vs VT (prior was in '78 vs PSU). Buckeyes have dropped 2 str Columbus openers once in program history (started in 1889), 1890 & 1891! The defending Nat'l Champs are coming off their revenge gm at VT on Monday night, while UH is off a 28-20 (+7) upset home win over Colorado despite being outg'd 373-302 & outFD'd 24-14. USC trans QB Wittek went 19-38-202-3-2 in his debut for UH & there was some controversy surrounding the playclock at the end but the officials were correct. UH did allow 215 rush yds & OSU avg 264 (5.7) rush ypg LY and they do catch the Buckeyes on a short week, while they've had extra time to prepare. Urban Meyer has a great record as a HF but is just 12-10 ATS in that role at Ohio St. UH HC Chow is 10-4 ATS vs non-conf foes. UH's D all'd just 24 ppg on the road LY but will be hard pressed to come near that total here as OSU avg 47 ppg at home LY.

CLEMSON by 21 over Appalachian St - The Tigers are 4-0 all-time in the series incl a 23-12 win in the L/gm ('97). CU is off a 49-10 win over FCS Wofford as they had commanding 533-213 yd & 27-9 FD edges. QB Watson ret'd (ACL LY) and went 18-22-194-2-0 in less than 1H. ASU is off a 49-0 win over FCS Howard, finishing with 663-172 yd & 33-8 FD edges. There are 2 Clemson products on ASU cch'g staff. 1st yr WR cch Justin Watts, one of 2 plr's ever to earn 5 letters from the Clemson FB program (med RS '97), he caught 51 passes from '96-'00. Also secondary cch Scot Sloan was a W/O from '88-'91 & grad asst from '92-'95. Clemson has won 12 str HG's vs non-Power 5 conf tms by an avg of 34 ppg (L/loss TCU '09 who was in the MW that yr). ASU is 3-11 in road openers but had its most memorable win at #5 Michigan in '07. ASU lost at Mich LY 52-14 (outgained 560-280) and to UGA in '13 45-6 (outgained 568-253). CU does have a key game at L'ville on Thurs night on deck.

Missouri by 13 over ARKANSAS ST - First trip to Jonesboro for MO, who's 3-0 in the series, scoring no less than 41 pts in any gm. Last meeting ('13) Ark St lost 41-19 (+21'). They led 16-14 3Q but MO scored 27 of the gm's final 30 incl a 21-pt 4Q. MO is off a 34-3 win over FCS SEMOSt, limiting them to just 191 till yds & 10 FD. Ark St is off a 55-6 (+27) loss at USC. The Red Wolves were only outg'd 509-401 & outFD'd 22-19, but were -4 TO's. They all'd 320 pass yds while MO threw for 319 in their win LW. A-St has won 10 str home openers, but the L/time they hosted an SEC foe was '01, losing 35-17 vs Ole Miss. MU is 8-2 in road openers, but did drop a road opener to SBC foe Troy in '04. Having just pl'd an FCS foe with CT on deck should have them focused for a team that's been to 4 str bowls. MO is an outstanding 13-3 ATS on the road and are one of 3 teams in the FBS to win all of their true road games the L2Y SU. They are 26-9 ATS on the road overall, while Ark St is 21-3 SU/15-9 ATS the L4Y at home, but 0-2 during that time as a HD and just 2-6 ATS as a HD in their L/8 gms in that role.

WYOMING by 8 over Eastern Michigan - First meeting. These HC's were 2 of the 4 that were hired in '14 from previous FCS HC positions (Jeff Monken-Army & Bill Clark-UAB). UW lost to FCS ND 24-13 LW. The Pokes were outg'd 429-330, outFD'd 23-14 & only held the ball for 22:46. After jumping out to a 24-10 3Q lead, EM eventually lost to ODU 38-34 (+5). The Eagles had slight yd & FD edges but were done in by -3 TO's. RB Jackson ran for 117 yds, but EM all'd ODU RB Lawry to rush for 223 yds. The Eagle's are 2-2-1 vs current MW, winning their L/gm 51-6 over UNLV in 1995. EM has dropped 16 straight road openers by 28 ppg and will be making a rare trip dealing with the altitude. EM is 5-14-1 ATS on the road the L3Y & was 0-7 SU on the road LY losing by 34 ppg and the closest loss was 14 pts in a downpour at ODU.

COLORADO by 10 over Massachusetts - First trip to Boulder for UMass. LY (1st mtg), CU trailed 31-20 w/12:24 3Q. From that pt they scored 21 str outgaining UMass 275-32 until all'g a td w/2:55 left. UMass elected to KO deep & never saw the ball again in the 41-38 loss (+18'). CU is off a 28-20 (-7') loss at Hawaii despite 373-302 yd & 24-14 FD edges. There was some controversy surrounding the playclock at the end but the officials were correct. UMass had a bye to open the season so this is their first game of the year. The Minutemen are 6-17 in road openers (0-8, avg loss by 20 ppg vs FBS). Since UMass moved up to FBS status ('12), each yr they have faced 2+ P-5 foes (incl ND) so they are used to this level of opposition, but they are making a rare trip West. CU is 3-6 in home openers and while they are off a trip to Hawaii, that game was on Thurs but they have rival CSU on deck.

Minnesota by 6 over COLORADO ST - In the last meeting ('05), CSU lost 56-24. The Rams were off a tough 3-pt loss to instate rival CU and found themselves down 10-0 in the 2Q. CSU trailed 42-10 into the 4Q and for the gm were outgained 545-421 (-9 FD). Last/only time here ('04) UM never trailed and led 24-3 late 2Q. From that pt CSU never got within 14 pts. UM had just a 504-424 yd edge but 4-0 TO advantage. UM is off a 23-17 (+17) home loss to TCU, where they were outg'd 449-341 & outFD'd 25-18. CSU is off a 65-13 win over FCS Savannah St. UM is 10-3 in road openers with an avg score of 33-19. CSU does have rival Colorado on deck but should be excited over a visit from a B10 team. UM is at its best when it can establish the run and LY CSU all'd 201 ypg (4.9). LY CSU was 6-0 SU at home and are on a 12-6 ATS run at home but that was under McElwain. CSU won their HG's by an avg of 22 ppg and were +195 ypg and on the road they were -3 ppg and -63 ypg. UM HC Kill is just 2-2 as an AF here.

GEORGIA TECH by 31 over Tulane - This is just the 2nd mtg s/schools ply'd every yr from 1952-'82. LY the Yellow Jackets trailed 21-14 w/9:38 2Q. GT led 24-21 at HT and turned 3 Tanner Lee int's into 21 pts. GT blk'd a punt and ret'd it 46 yds to the TLN1 setting up a td with 9:05 left to get ahead of the spread and win 38-21 (-10) and did finish the game at the TLN 12 yd line. The Green Waves L/6 poss ended in 2 int's & twice each punted/SOD. GT is coming off a 69-6 home win over FCS Alcorn St, where they rushed for 476 yds. TU is off a 37-7 (+7) home loss to Duke. The Green and 41. SJSU does get two extra days to prepare for the option as they played last Thurs.

Wave were down 23-0 4Q, all'd 206 rush yds and were outg'd 530-271 & outFD'd 29-14. Tulane is 3-6 in road openers (0-8 vs current Power-5 tms). TU will face 3 option attacks TY including Navy and Army so they should have done a lot of prep in spring and Aug, meanwhile GT does have a huge road game at ND on deck. Johnson is 20-6-1 as a HF.

Georgia by 17 over VANDERBILT - UGA has owned this series going 45-5-1 but the home team is 4-0 SU/ATS. LTH ('13) UGA led 27-14 into the 4Q but VU scored 17 4Q pts to pull off a 31-27 upset vs a banged up UGA tm allowing VU a 13/1 pl drive after a high punt snap for a td with 2:53 left. Since '59 when UGA is off a VU loss/tie they are 8-0 the next yr getting revenge (avg win by 13 ppg) so you knew what to expect LY. UGA was -33' at home and while they got revenge, they only won 44-17. UGA only had 20-15 FD & 445-320 yd edges. VU trailed 21-0 into the 2Q and driving for a chance to cut the deficit to 10 pts in the 3Q threw an int that was ret'd 63-yds for a td ending any comeback. UGA is off a 51-14 (-36) win over ULM, finishing with 435-251 yd & 19-12 FD edges. RB Chubb had his FBS leading 9th str 100 yd rush gm. We won a 3★ LPS & our System play on these pages LW on Vandy in their 14-12 (+2') loss to WKU. The 'Dores had 385-246 yd & 20-11 FD edges but were done in by -3 TO's. They had a chance to tie it at the end but their 2pt conv was NG & they also held WKU to just 23 (1.6) rush yds. Situational edge favors VU as they only have Austin Peay on deck while UGA has S Carolina and VU is actually 3-1 ATS here at home vs UGA.

BYU by 1 over Boise St - Boise is 4-1 SU/2-3 ATS in this series. The HT has won 4 in a row SU

but is 2-3 ATS. LY BS crushed the Cougars 55-30 (-6') with a 637-322 yd edge at home. LTH ('13) BYU ended Boise's 50 gm win streak in games played during the month of Oct as they were +4 in TO's in their 37-20 (-7') win. BYU is coming off a costly last second 42 yd 'Hail Mary' td pass to win at Neb 33-28 (+6') as QB Hill is OFY (foot). True frosh QB Mangum was the hero after connecting with WR Mathews. The stats were nearly even as BYU had a 511-445 yd edge, but Neb had 25 21 FD & 32:53-27:07 TOP edges. BS is off a 16-13 (-13) win over former HC Peterson & the UW Huskies. The game was closer than it should have been as BS was up 16-0 at HT. The Broncos had 337-179 yd, 21-11 FD & 34:22-25:38 TOP edges, but were nearly done in by ST miscues in the 2H. This is BYU's only HG in Sept and with road trips to P5 conf in their other 3 wks, this would be an

important win. BYU has covered its L/2 as a HD and are in the role for just a 2nd time L5Y.

Notre Dame by 10 over VIRGINIA - The Only meeting between these two was in the '89 KO Classic when #2 ND beat UVA 36-13. UVA was 6-1 ATS at home LY. The Cavaliers are 25-9 hosting nonconference foes but have lost their L/4 hosting ranked non-conf tms. ND is just 4-14 in their first 'true' away gm since '96. UVA was thoroughly defeated by UCLA LW 34-16. The Cavs' were outgained 503-336. ND looked much better in their opnr vs Texas winning 38-3. ND outgained Texas 527-163! While both are off big games, UVA only has W&M on deck while ND has to face GT's option. Iowa by 6 over IOWA ST - Hayden Fry crushed ISU on a yearly basis but surprisingly Kirk Ferentz is just 7-9 SU in the series and ISU is 13-4 ATS. LY ISU was +13 on the road but pulled out their 8th outright upset in the last 17 years. ISU trailed 14-3 at HT (-2 FD/-26 yds). With the score 17-17 the Cyclones took over w/4:08 left and went 51/11pl nailing a GW 42-yd fg w/:02! For 4 str yrs the Cy-Hawk Trophy has been decided by 6 pts or less.IU won in L/trip to Jack Trice Stadium -21 & did so w/an exp'd set of LB's that kept ISU QB Richardson in check. Richardson ply'd that gm on a sore ankle. If he's healthy, & if the ISU line can give him time to find an underrated group of rec's, it will be up to IU's OFF to keep up in what could be a high-scoring gm. LW IU defeated Illinois St (#2 in FCS) 31-14. ISU won 31-7 over FCS Northern Iowa but held just 310-302 yd edge. L6Y ISU has 19 TO's that resulted in 51 (32%) of lowa's 161 pts.

CALIFORNIA by 10 over San Diego St - These 2 last met in '96, Cal won 42-37. That ssn the Golden Bears started 5-0 and ranked #19. The visitor is 6-0 SU all-time in this series but SDS is 2-20 in road openers. Aztecs are 2-20 and the L/time they won a road opener vs a current Power-5 conf school was in '86 at Utah. LW both Cal and SDS won vs FCS teams. Cal beat Grambling 73-14 (52-0 lead at HT). SDS won over San Diego in a local rivalry gm. SDS forced 6 TO's. Cal is 17-4 s/'04 hosting non-conf foes but have dropped 4 str when doing so vs a FBS NC opp. Cal is just 3-10 SU and ATS at home under Sonny Dykes. Last year Cal was 0-3 vs FBS as a HF incl 2 SU losses. SDS is 7-6 ATS as an AD.

Memphis by 10 over KANSAS - First meeting. KU is 29-2 SU in HG vs non-conf. KU dropped their opener vs FCS South Dakota St 41-38. KU trailed 31-14 at HT but came back to get within 3. KU fmbld a snap that cost them a chance at a tying FG. Memphis won easily vs FCS Missouri St 63-7. The L/time UM beat a current Power-5 conf foe on the road was in '04 (Ole Miss 20-13) dropping 10 str. Memph has just 11 ret st'rs but do return QB Paxton Lynch and Memp was 10-3 LY incl their bowl win over BYU while KU was just 3-9. This is the first time Memph hasn't been favored on the road vs a P5 school s/'89.

ARKANSAS by 24 over Toledo (Little Rock) - First meeting. Ark is off a 48-13 (-33) win over UTEP as QB Allen had a car high 308 pass yds & tied his car high w/4 td passes. The Hogs had a 490-204 yd edge and were +3 TO's. Toledo was expected to come into this game also 1-0, but their opener against FCS Stony Brook was cancelled due to inclimate weather. Arkansas is 3-0 all-time vs MAC tms (avg 48-23) incl a 52-14 (-13) win last year over a Northern Illinois team that later went on to beat Toledo 27-24. The Rockets are 0-3 vs SEC opponents (avg 37-18) incl a 49-24 (+3') loss at home last year to a Missouri team that later went on to only beat Arkansas 21-14. Ark is 7-1 ATS at home with their avg score 38-14. UT is 9-3 ATS as an AD.

ALABAMA by 35 over Middle Tennessee - Alabama has won both prior meetings but only out-scored MT by an avg of 12 ppg. MT lost 26-7 (L/meeting) in '05, being outgained 345-157, their last and only prior trip to Tuscaloosa. We won a 4★ LPS & a 3★ on these pages with Bama LW after their 35-17 (-12') win over Wisc. The Tide had commanding 502-268 yd & 27-17 FD edges with RB Henry rushing for a car high 147 (11.3) & 3 td's incl 37 & 56 yd paydirt runs. Bama also limited the Badgers to just 40 rush yds after Wisc avg 320 rush ypg LY. QB Coker st'd the gm & went 15-21-213-1-0 with Soph Bateman also getting in the mix going 7-8-51. MT is also off a big winn, albie a much lesser foe, 70-14 over FCS Jackson St. The Tide is 52-10-2 vs current CUSA trus with winning records vs every tm except Rice (0-3). The Blue Raiders are just 3-33 vs current SEC with all 3 wins vs Vandy ('01, '02 & '05). Bama is just 6-10 ATS vs non-conf but 10-5 ATS as a HF and this is their home opener.

AIR FORCE by 4 over San Jose St - MW opener for both. These 2 have not met since they were both in the WAC in '96-'97. LY AF was 4-0 SU vs MW foes at home but was actually outgained in 3 of them (-75 ypg). SJS was 0-6 ATS as an AD LY and their avg road game they lost 37-17. Both schools come of wins over FCS Schools in opener, LW AF defeated Morgan St 63-7 while SJSU beat a solid New Hampshire team in dominant fashion 43-13. The Spartans had a 707-186 yd edge & unlike last year when SJSt typically outgained their foes and lost, if they continue on this trend could be a dangerous team TY. Caragher did take on the option in Navy each of the last 2Y and was 0-2 SU and ATS but they were close losses by 6 and 10 pts although they did give up 58

The only other recent time they lost to Kentucky was '10 and the next year they buried them 54-3 (-21). LTH ('13) UK trailed 27-7 into the 4Q but after a 81/8pl td drive pulled within 7 w/4:02 left. SC ran out remaining time w/2 FD's in the 35-28 (-21') win. UK gave up a 23 pt 2H lead, before scoring the GW td w/:57 left in their 40-33 (-17) win over ULL LW. The Wildcats were outg'd 479-435 & outFD'd 27-18, but did benefit from +3 TO's. True frosh QB Murray also relieved Allen & showed off his incredible speed, but he still needs work on his passing. BSU is 2-17 incl 6 str losses by 14 ppg in road openers but LY only lost 17-13 (+19) to lowa & HC Lembo is 12-5 ATS as an AD. They did covered at ACC Clemson (+27'), 27-52 in 12. The Cardinals are 0-9 vs SEC tms losing by 30 ppg incl a 54-30 loss to Auburn in their most recent gm. A&M is 25-2 in home openers (losses in 2008 vs Arkansas St & in 2012 vs #24 Florida)

TEXAS TECH by 21 over Utep - Naturally UTEP has dropped 6 in a row SU in this series but they last played here in '07. UTEP actually led that game 28-14 and it was tied 31-31 in the 4Q. TT won 45-31 (-25). UTEP had an awful matchup last week vs Ark and it showed as they were beaten 48-13 and outgained 490-204. Washington St is 1-11 in non-conference away gms s/'06 (only win at UNLV in '12, 35-27). LW Rutgers won vs FCS Norfolk St 63-13. RU had a 539-196 yd edge. WSU lost to FCS Portland St 24-17 in a driving rainstorm that hampered their high powered O. WSU lead 10-0 in 2H and outgained PSU 411-294. The Cougars have lost 9 str road openers SU by an avg of 38-16. RU does have their B10 opener on deck (at PSU) while WSU has just WY/bye and can't afford to start 0-2 with a tough P12 slate ahead.

Oklahoma by 1 over TENNESSEE - OU is 2-1 vs Tenn but this marks their 1st trip to Knoxville. Prior to LY these tms last ply'd in the '68 Orange Bowl. LY OU (-20') led 13-0 into the 2Q and after UT cut the deficit to 6, the Sooners kicked a fg 1:33 before HT & scored on a 75/6pl td drive 2:35 into the 2H. Down 27-10 & driving in the 4Q, UT had their pass int'd & ret'd 100 yds for a td, which was the gms final score, 34-10. OU is coming off a 41-3 (-33) route over Akron as the Sooners had 539-226 yd & 26-10 FD edges, while QB Mayfield threw for 388 yds & 3 td's. UT is off a 59-30 (-21') win over BG, but they had just 604-557 yd & 29-24 FD edges as they all'd BG QB Johnson to throw for 424 yds. The Vols have won 20 str home openers (L/loss in '94 vs #1 Florida 31-0), while OU has won 5 str non-conf away gms. OU is 14-3 since '98 in their road opener.

TEXAS by 17 over Rice - Texas is going to be looking to rebound after an embarassing opener. These two used to be in the SWC together. Texas is 11-0 SU, 5-1 ATS in this series with Rice being outgained by 286 ypg the last 10. In the L/gm ('11) UT won 34-9 but led just 13-6 at HT. UT was coming off a 5-7 '10 ssn as Rice was their '11 ssn opening opp. Rice has not won SU in Austin s/'65 losing 22 straight and they are just 5-18 SU in road openers. LW UT was dropped by ND 38-3, giving up 527 yds and 30 FDs. QB Swoopes was just 7-22-93. Rice won easily over FCS Wagner 56-16. Rice is 8-4 ATS as an AD and UT 3-6 ATS vs non-conf. Rice has lost 24 in a row SU to ranked teams and UT hasn't started a ssn 0-2 s/'92.

NMSt went 83/12pl incl a 4&2 to steal the win. Unfortunately after a 2-0 start, the Aggies dropped their next 10 gms. Both teams enter this 0-1. LW GSt was outright upset (-8) by Charlotte at home 23-20 in the 49ers' first game as FBS school. Charlotte lead wire to wire, scoring on a FR on GSt's 1st drive. GSt trailed 23-6 before scoring two 4Q TD's. NMSt was dominated LW by Florida 61-13 (-31). NMSt was outgained 606-200 and UF held a 28-8 FD edge. tm's at Spartan Stadium s/#2 MSU & #1 ND tied, 10-10, in '66 "Game of the Century." The Ducks are 11-3 in their 1st away gm from Autzen Stadium s/01. MSU has won 16 str home openers. HT is a perfect 5-0 incl 3-0 SU the L17Y with MSU winning the LTH 27-20 (-10) ('99 ssn opener). LY UO jumped out to a 11-0 lead but MSU 4:05 into the 2H was up 27-18. UO scored the gms final 28 pts outgaining MSU 289-137 during that span. In the L6Y in true road games vs ranked teams Oregon is 7-1 SU and ATS winning by an avg of 19 ppg. LW MSU lead WMU 27-7 in the 2Q but won just 37-24. Oregon defeated FCS Eastern Washington, putting up 731 yds. This will be UO QB Vernon Adams' first big test vs FBS opp.

IU is 27-13 s/'05 (8 losses L4Y by just 5 ppg) in reg ssn non-conference action (3x's sweeping the non-conf slate). LW IU held on to beat FCS Southern Illinois 48-47. SIU missed a 2pt to win the gm. IU allw'd 659 yards of offense. FIU upset UCF (-13) LW 15-14 to win their first road opener since '11. FIU hasn't won B2B road gms since '12 but Turner here is 4-1 ATS off a SU win (only non-cover by a half a pt).

USC by 45 over Idaho - Vandals are 1-14 in road openers (only win in that span in '09 at NMSt 21-6). Úl has dropped 22 str road gms overall (L/win in '11 at SJSt 32-29). Trojans have never lost to the Vandals going 8-0 winning by 28 ppg. The L/meeting was in '07, 38-10. USC led 21-0 & 38-3 into the 4Q before all'ing a gbg td, USC had a 420-253 yd edge (+10 FD). Lobos are 2-4 overall vs the Golden Hurricane incl B2B losses by an avg of 38 ppg (L/series win in '97). NM coach Davie is taking care of business when expected to win as he is 6-2-1 ATS as a fav.

STANFORD by 17 over Ucf - First meeting. Both teams suffered outright upsets as a DD Fav LW. UCF was a 12' pt HF but was outgained 391-295 (GW FG blkd). SU lost to Northwestern 16-6 as a 10' pt AF. SU's running game will need to get going after being held to just 85 yds/3.1 ypc.UCF has just 9 ret st'rs TY but are 31-10 the L3+Y. They are 3-20 SU in reg ssn road games vs current P5 schls. UCF is 5-14 s/96 (first ssn w/FBS status) in road openers but 3-2 L5Y. SU's won 7 str home openers by 27 ppg and have won 13 str non-conf home games SU. They are 6-3 ATS as a HF (L/loss in 07 vs ND 21-14). LY they went 2-0 outscoring following Salney School (+277 ypg). Hard to believe one of these tms will start the year 0-2. **Ucla by 28 over UNLV** - First meeting. The last 2Y UNLV has taken on 3 P5 teams and lost those

by an avg of 56-16. UNLV cch Sanchez 1-0 vs UCLA QB Rosen. Sanchez was cch at Las Vegas Bishop Gorman HIgh. Rebels are 4-7 in home openers vs FBS programs incl 2 str losses involving Power-5 conf foes (MInnesota & Arizona). LV is 13-9-1 as a HD but 1-4 LY with 2 conf games, BYU and UVA, this is UCLA's least important game in the first six wks but UCLA has won its last 3 road openers by 18 ppg. LW LV was 21 pt dog but played well in cch Sanchez debut, losing to N Illinois 38-30. UNLV lead 17-3 in 2Q but was outscored 35-13 rest of the way. UCLA won over UVA last week 34-16. Bruins are 7-4 in road openers incl 3 str wins by 18 ppg. UCLA is 6-2 s/09 in non-conf AG's (L/loss at Hous, 38-34 to open '11).

4★ Minnesota by 8 over SAN FRANCISCO - MNF #2 - Not much has gone right for the 49ers since the middle of LY as they finished '14 with a 6-gm ATS skid. They've also suffered some major attrition from the roster due to retirement, FA departures and most recently the release of troubled LB Smith. MIN on the other hand covered 5 of their final 6 LY, have consistency at QB for the 1st time in nearly a decade and get the return of a very well-rested RB Peterson. Schedule edge also goes to MIN as they return home following this matchup while new SF HC Tomsula and company travel East to take on PIT on a short week. MIN (3-0 run vs SF) is a chic pick to make a playoff run and is expected to begin that journey with a victory here.

3 ★ NY JETS vs Cleveland (under 40) - The Browns have lost each of their previous 2 meetings

against the Jets ('10 & '13) and have now dropped 10 consec ssn openers (2-7-1 ATS) being outscored by 11 ppg in the process. The Jets meanwhile open at home for a 6th straight year with some success in that span including 4 consec victories. Offense will be at a premium in this matchup as the Browns and Jets finished 27th and 28th respectively a ssn ago in scoring while each will be breaking in a new starter at QB now that Smith is expected to miss the start of the year w/a broken jaw. The Browns finished last ssn going under the total in 11 of their final 12 contests while the Jets are clearly defensive-oriented with the addition of new HC Bowles and a FA/Draft period that was clearly dedicated to that side of the ball.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Green Bay by 10 over CHICAGO - The Packers have owned this series over the past 4 ssns covering 7 of the past 8 while outscoring CHI by a 32-18 avg score in the process. The Bears are breaking in a new coaching staff with a bigger emphasis in the run game on offense to steer away from QB Cutler and his poor decisions which have resulted in 44 int's over his past 41 games (big inj questions among the Bears WR unit). CHI is on a 1-4 ATS run as a HD while GB is on a 17-7 ATS run vs NFC North opponents, have a healthy Rodgers now under center and are clearly one of the SB favorites in 2015 despite the ssn-ending loss of WR Nelson.

OTHER GAMES

Pittsburgh at NEW ENGLAND - Thursday - The defending SB champ is 9-2-2 ATS when opening the ssn at home in Wk 1. In their last meeting (\*13) NE took the Steelers to task posting 55 pts and 610 ttl yds, the most ever all'd by a PIT defense. While suspensions are looming for both squads in this one (NE RB Blount, PIT RB Bell and WR Bryant), the main storyline is that QB Brady will now be available after having his 4-game ban lifted. His ability to potentially expose an unproven PIT secondary will likely help decide how close this contest will truly be. HOUSTON by 3 over Kansas City - If this matchup is anything similar to their '13 meeting when the Chiefs escaped at home with a 1 pt victory, this may go down as the biggest toss-up game for Wk 1 as while the Texans have delivered 5 consec home opening victories (4-1 ATS), their run game takes a hit early on with the inj to Foster. The Chiefs have meanwhile dropped 3 of their past 4 road openers although they have covered each of the past 2. After failing to produce a TD pass to a WR all of LY, KC bolstered the unit with the signing of Maclin which will face a HOU secondary that finished 21st in pass D a ssn ago. The Texans front 7 and their ability to deliver as favorites in HC O'Brien's inaugural year of 14 (6-2 ATS) has us narrowly siding with

the home team, especially with KC going home to take on rival DEN 4 days later.

Indianapolis by 1 over BUFFALO - The Colts have struggled in road openers the past 5 ssns going just 1-4 SU (2-3 ATS). They do however enter '15 as one of the AFC's elite after QB Luck and the #3 IND offense made it all of the way to the AFC Championship and have retooled the group with the FA signings of RB Gore and WR Andre Johnson. BUF (#4 Def LY) is fielding their 4th DC in as many years under new HC Ryan who had success in his only matchup against Luck in '12 holding the Colts to just 9 pts and 298 yds. The Bills have had some solid success in their home openers with victories in 6 of the past 7 years (5-2 ATS) but do have some lingering concerns at RB with Jackson being released and FA addition McCoy battling a hammy. The Colts clearly have the better roster but the Rex Ryan-factor could keep them within reach of the line. Miami by 10 over WASHINGTON - The Dolphins have one of the easiest schedules to begin the ssn with a realistic chance to start off at 6-0. Their most recent matchup came back in '11 when MIA took home a 20-9 victory (-4) in South Beach. The Redskins have dropped 2 of their L/3 home openers while going just 7-16 ATS the past 2 years as a dog. HC Gruden may be able to keep them out of the NFC East basement in '15 after ending the QB carousel by anointing Cousins the starter but that may not translate in a victory here as the Dolphins have added sufficient talent to both sides of the ball this offssn and should find themselves heading to JAX next week with a win under their belt.

Carolina by 5 over JACKSONVILLE - Despite taking home the NFC South crown a ssn ago the Panthers actually went the entire ssn not being a road favorite. This may have been a blessing however after posting just a 2-6 ATS mark in that situation the prior 2 ssns. In their most recent matchup in '11 the Panthers took home a 16-10 victory as a 3 pt HF. The Jaguars run of poor play continues following a 9-39 SU record over the past 3 years including just 5-17-1 ATS during that same span as a HD. The biggest edge for CAR and our lean with them in this matchup comes with their #10 defense matching up against JAX's 31st ranked offense of a year ago that saw their QB's sacked on 71 occasions (worst in NFL s/'06).

Seattle by 4 over ST LOUIS - The Rams have covered 4 of the L/6 vs the Seahawks which includes SEA's last visit here where STL used 2 trick plays on ST's (SEA 463-275 yd edge) to take home the outright upset (28-26, +6') scoring their most pts in the series S/06. SEA ended their '14 regular ssn with a 20-6 revenge (-11') victory against the Rams and now enter '15 on a 6-game ATS regular ssn winning streak covering those contests by 10 ppg. While they do have a pivotal meeting at GB on deck, QB Wilson was locked up this offssn with a lucrative contract extension although their 1st string saw some struggles in the pressn after reaching the EZ on just 1 occasion. They do however continue to boast one of the NFL's best defenses after consec #1 performances. STL meanwhile finished '14 on a 3-gm ATS skid, have numerous questions on the offensive side of the ball, and appear to be looking at a battle with SF to elude the NFC West cellar for the 1st time in 3 ssns.

ARIZONA by 7 over New Orleans - The Saints are on a road opener skid going 0-5 ATS while ARZ has delivered 5 consecutive home opener victories (2-2-1 ATS). In their last meeting in 13 the Saints held the Cardinals to just 7 pts and 247 yds in their 24 pt victory (-7). While NO finished with the #1 offense in the NFL LY, their #31 defense continues to be suspect with the hope that a handful of FA's will help Rob Ryan's scheme. ARZ now has a healthy QB Palmer, weapons at his disposal and a solid 7-2-1 ATS record as a HF the past 2 seasons.

SAN DIEGO by 7 over Detroit - The Lions have struggled in non-div play the past 3 ssns with just a 9-19-2 ATS mark including dropping each of their L/3 SU and ATS in road openers. The Chargers meanwhile have been strong in non-conf play in each of the past 2 years with a 13-6-1 ATS mark while covering each of their past 3 home openers. The matchup to keep an eye on in this one is the revamped SD running game taking on a DET DL that lost both Fairley and Suh in FA. The Chargers have come out victorious SU & ATS in 4 of their past 5 tilts with the Lions

giving them some confidence entering this matchup. **TAMPA BAY by 1 over Tennessee** - The top 2 picks of the 2015 Draft square off in this one as Winston and Mariota are both expected to begin their respective ssns as the starter (also met in LY's FBS playoffs). In their last meeting the Titans took home a 23-17 home victory as a 3 pt favorite. TEN has actually impressed in their L/2 road openers with wins at PIT and KC as 6' and 3 pt dogs while TB has meanwhile dropped 3 of their L/4 home openers SU (2-2 ATS). The Bucs enter the year with a clear edge in playmaking ability although questions on the OL and their 0-3 mark as a HF a year ago may keep the Titans within a FG in this one.

OAKLAND by 1 over Cincinnati - The Bengals have actually had some success on the West Coast the past 4 ssns with a 3-0 SU/ATS mark. Their most recent matchup vs OAK came in '12 when they knocked off the Raiders 34-10 (-8') in CIN. After starting off last ssn at 0-10, the Raiders finished the year with a 3-3 SU mark and may have some continued momentum with the hiring of HC Del Rio and the addition of some playmakers for QB Carr in the passing game. CIN hasn't fared well as an AF over the past 2 ssns with a poor 1-5 ATS mark which has us calling for the Raiders to deliver the outright upset here.

**DENVER by 7 over Baltimore** - The Broncos host the Ravens in the opener for the 2nd time in 3 ssns with QB Manning's 7TD passes highlighting DEN's 49-27 (-7') victory in '13. The Broncos have covered well at home the past 3 yrs with a 16-7 mark as a HF while the Ravens closed out the '14 regular ssn failing to cover in 3 of their L/4. New DEN HC Kubiak spent LY as the OC in BAL and while the DEN offense should be in contention for another Top 5 finish despite some question marks on the OL, they due have a Thur Night game at KC on deck which could prevent them from going full-throttle late in this matchup if they are sitting on the lead.

NY Giants at DALLAS - SNF - This marks the 3rd time in 4 ssns that DAL/NYG open the ssn against each other. The Cowboys have covered 3 of their L/4 vs the Giants but the Giants have a well earned reputation for being a spoiler when their backs are against the wall which fits that situation to a tee in '15 with HC Coughlin clearly on the hot seat after consec losing ssns. Call

Philadelphia at ATLANTA - MNF #1 - The Falcons have won and covered each of the past 2 meetings ('11 & '12) against the Eagles while also delivering 7 consecutive home openers both SU at ATS. PHI meanwhile made a plethora of roster changes this offssn and have now finished with a Top 5 offense the past 2 years, a substantial edge in this one against an ATL defense that was dead last in the league a year ago. While the Falcons are expected to be improved in '15 under new HC Quinn, it remains to be seen whether that will translate into yet another homeopening win.
