Hudspeth has ULL 19-5 at home, but only 3-7 as a HF. **UTAH by 7 over California** - GameDay is corning to Utah. The Utes will be fired up and ready to go. Cal is 5-4 but Utah has won 3 of the L4. The HT is 4-0 in the series. UT is off a bye. Prior to the bye, UT had their best performance of the ssn at Oregon, trouncing the Ducks 62-20 (+10). UT outg'd UO 530-400 and knocked UO out of the AP rankings for the 1st time s/'09. Cal comes in undefeated, having won their L2 by 6 pts each. Cal won 34-28 LW vs WSt (+17). Cal outg'd WS 1469-403. Cal trailed late in the 3Q 28-20 but scored 2 TD's in a 1:39 span to take the lead. QB Goff threw for 390 yds/4 TD. Cal recorded 7 sks LW to put their total at 20 but UT has all'd just 1 sk, and none in their L3 gms. In '12 UT won 49-27 (-1). Cal is 17-31 as a Dog, but on a 5-1 ATS run. UT is 6-11-2 ATS as a P12 Fav. UT is 13-5 when off a bye.

Connecticut by 3 over UCF - After starting the ssn 2-0, UConn has now dropped 3 straight. The Huskies do enter this game with an extra day to prepare as they are off a 30-13 (+14') Friday night loss at BYU. The gm was tied 7-7 at HT and UConn had a 10-7 lead late 3Q but couldn't hang on as they were outg'd 539-230 & outFD'd 31-14. The Huskies are 3-9 ATS away from Storrs. UCF's QB's have struggled but this may be a good gm to gain some confidence as UCOnn ranks near the bottom of our pass eff D rankings. UCF was beaten 45-31 LW at Tulane (-1). UCF was outg'd 395-357 but did outFD TU 20-17. UCF trailed 24-7 in the 2Q and never got closer than 14. UCF has been outg'd in every gm this ssn. In '14 UConn won 37-29 (+9). UCF led 21-17 but all'd 20 unanswered. UCF is 0-6 SU/ATS s/the bowl LY. UConn is 4-13 ATS the L2Y.

FIU by 14 over Utep - UTEP won the only mtg in this CUSA series in '13 33-10 (-6). FIU is coming off a loss at UMass 24-14 (+3). FIU was outg'd 495-188 & outFD'd 29-13. Despite the poor yd totals, FIU trailed just 17-14 in the 4Q before giving up the last td. UTEP was defeated 25-6 (+3') by UTSA. UTEP was outg'd 335-275 & outFD'd 22-14. Both tms have struggled to run the ball. FIU has run for just 52-118 the L2 gms while UTEP has run for 53-140 (despite one of those gms vs an FCS). The only FBS tm that FIU has outg'd TY is UCF, who has yet to win a gm. UTEP is on an 0-6-2 ATS run, and Kugler is 3-11 ATS as an AD. FIU is on a 10-6-1 ATS run and this is just their 2nd HG in the F6W.

Louisiana Tech by 20 over UTSA - LT is 2-1 in this series, having won the last mtg in '12, 27-20 (-12). UTSA is 3-0 ATS vs LT. LW LT won in a blowout over ULL 43-14 (-16). ULL scored first to make it 7-0, then LT scored the next 36 pts. LT outg'd ULL 428-331 & outFD'd ULL 27-18. UTSA won LW at UTEP 25-6 (-3'). UTSA outg'd & outFD'd UTEP 335-275 & 22-14. LT outg's their foes by an avg of 127 ypg while UTSA is being outg'd by 37 ypg. UTSA's pass D may get exploited as they all'd 253 ypg and LT is putting up 313 ypg. LT is on a 14-5 ATS run and 12-6 as an AF UTSA is 3-6 ATS at home. Boise St by 17 over COLORADO ST - BSU is 4-0 SU vs CSU (3-1 ATS). BSU crushed UH LW

BSU had a 554-170 yd & 29-12 FD edge. CSU lost LW at UTSt 33-18 (+4). CSU was outg'd 435-361 but did outFD UTSt 24-21. CSU trailed 26-18 in the 4Q and had the ball but was forced to punt. UTSt then scored a TD with 2:18 left. In '14 we had a top Wkly LPS on BSU (-9) at home. BSU led 37-10 after 3Q with CSU getting two late TD's to make it respectable. CSU will have a tough time with a BSU tm that has all'd 52 rush ypg (1.8 ypc) and 48% comp. BSU is 26-12 as an AF. CSU is 7-1 SU at home (6-2 ATS) and 13-6 as a HD.

Florida by 4 over MISSOURI - Missouri is 2-1 vs Florida (3-0 ATS) s/joining the SEC, having won the L2. UF is coming off a big home win over Ole Miss. UF (+6') jumped all over UM and led 25-0 at HT. UF held a 285-128 yd edge at HT. UF outg'd UM 355-328 but were outFD'd 23-18. UF forced 4 TO's which they converted into 20 pts. Lock filled in nicely for sspn QB Mauk (CS) in a 24-10 win over SC (-3). MU only had 299-298 yd & 18-17 FD edges, but forced 3 TO's. DE Brady had a huge gm with 2 sks on 3rd Downs and an INT. In '14 MU won 42-13 (+5'). LY MU had TDs on a PR, FR, IR, & 2 KR's. MU led 42-0 late in the 3Q, and won despite having just 7 FDs and 119 ttl yds! UF's D is near the top of our rankings TY and may welcome a gm against a true frosh QB. MU is 1-4 ATS, but 7-2 when a Fav vs SEC tims. UF is on a 9-2 ATS run.

ARIZONA by 10 over Oregon State - UA is 21-14-1 in this series but s/'99 OSU is 12-2 SU/ATS. The visitor is 7-2 ATS and their have been 5 outright upsets. LW vs Stanford, UA (+11') played w/o QB Solomon (Concussion, CS). UA fell behind 27-3 at HT. UA was outg'd 570-314 & outFD'd 30-16. OSU is off a bye, having also played Stanford prior to the bye. OSU was outg'd 488-386. The Beavers did hold it together better than AU did, trailing just 21-17 at HT. UA will need to get Solomon back as their rushing and passing gm were less effective w/o him. UA has all'd 453 ypg TY while OSU all's 331. UA is 16-26-1 as a P12 Fav. OSU is on a 3-13 ATS run, 0-4 as an AD. OSU is 14-6 SU/ATS off a bye.

Syracuse by 3 over USF - USF comes into this game having an extra day to prepare following their 24-17 (+7') loss to Memphis last Friday. They did have a 10-0 lead early 2Q and led 10-7 at HT, but couldn't hang on. They were only outg'd 425-377 and outFD'd by 1. The Visitor is 4-0 SU/ ATS winning by an avg of 10 ppg, but Cuse is 1-4 ATS off a reg ssn bye. Prior to the bye, Cuse lost to LSU 34-24 (+24). Under Taggart, USF is just 6-10 ATS at home. This is Cuse's road opener and they are 5-1 ATS covering 3 str. Tcu by 10 over KANSAS ST - TCU made a statement LW vs Texas and now goes on the road in a

Tcú by 10 over KANSAŠ ST - TCU made a statement LW vs Texas and now goes on the road in a dangerous spot vs Kansas St. LW TCU won in blowout fashion vs Texas 50-7 (-14'). TCU was up 30-0 in the 1Q and 50-0 in the 4Q before calling off the dogs. TCU outg'd TX 604-313 and outFD'd them 31-20 despite missing 6 starters on D. TX gained 126 of their yards and their only TD late in the 4Q. QB Boykin set the schl rec for TD passes by Dalton. KSt lost LW at OKSt (+7) on a FG with 0:32 left in the gm. KSt led 28-13 in the 2Q before OKSt scored 20 str. KSt was outg'd 490-351 and outFD'd 26-22. KSt held OKSt to 27-49 (1.8 ypc) rushing, but all'd 441 pass yds. KSt will have a hard time stopping the TCU pass attack which is near the top of our rankings. Snyder is now 19-4 as a Dog and 6-1 as a HD. TCU is 3-8 as an AF and are only outgaining foes by 126 ypg on the road (+321 at home).

TEXAS TECH by 10 over Iowa St - TT is 8-3 SU (7-4 ÅTS) in this series. The visitor is 4-0. There have been 3 outright upsets in the L5Y. ISU was a 2★ selection LW over Kansas on these pages and cashed in (-17') with a 38-13 win. RB Warren set a frosh schl rec with 175 yds. ISU had 512-288 yd & 24-15 FD edges. TT ran out of steam LW at Baylor (+17) losing 63-35. TT was only outg'd 680-636 but was -3 TO's which BU converted into 14 pts. TT won in '14 34-31 (+1). TT took the lead lead for good with 4:07 left and ISU was SOD at the TT31. TT against their 4 FBS opps fielded the #1 offense that those foes faced so far in '15. TT is 6-2 ATS but Kingsbury is 2-5 as a HF. ISU is 15-12 as an AD but 3-11-1 as a DD Dog vs B12 foes.

Michigan St by 15 over RUTGERS - This series is surprisingly tied 3-3. MSU won the only recent mtg LY 45-3 (-22). LW MSU won a close gm vs Purdue 24-21 (-21'). MSU led 21-0 at HT. PU pulled within 3 with 6:44 left and had one shot but were SOD. MSU outg'd PU 406-301 and forced 3 FH TO's. The MSU O-Line had a rough time without LT Conklin (CS) and then lost backup LT Finley. RU is off a bye, having beaten Kansas the wk before 27-14 (-14). RU was outg'd badly in their two losses TY but outg'd lowly Kansas and an FCS. MSU will look to exploit an RU defense that is at the bottom of our rankings. MSU is 0-5 ATS TY but 17-5 as an AF. RU is 12-6 as a Dog. MSU does have Michigan on deck.

NEVADA by 7 over New Mexico - The L/mtg was in '12 in the schools inaugural MW gm. UN won 31-24 (-11). LW UN lost as a HF vs UNLV (-5'). UN had awful field position in the FH, starting on their own 2,3,7, and 8. UN outg'd UNLV 343-301 (+6 FD). UN pulled within 3 but threw an INT for TD in the 4Q. NM won 38-29 (-12') in a rivalry gm over NMSt. NM actually trailed 29-14 but scored 24 str. NM outg'd NMSt 446-401, and rushed for 401 yds in the gm. This could be a bad matchup for UN as they all'ing 188 rush ypg (5.0 ypc) while NM's option avg's 410 ypg (6.6 ypc). NM is 9-3 as an AD. Under Davie, NM is 13-7-1 ATS as a visitor. UN is 3-10 as a HF.

San Jose St by 3 over UNLV - SJSt has dominated this series lately, winning the L5 by 17 ppg. LW SJSt went into SEC country, losing to Auburn 35-21 (+20'). SJSt actually outg'd the Tigers 406-342 and outFD'd 22-15 as AU went with a conservative game plan (only 10 pass att's). SJSt was undone by 4 TO's which led to 14 pts. UNLV won at Nevada LW 23-17 (+5'). UNLV jumped out to a 13-3 HT lead, partly thanks to their punter who pinned UN on the 2,3,7, and 8. QB Decker had to leave the gm at the end of the FH (CS). UNLV was outg'd 343-301 and out FD'd 24-18 but an INT TD in the 4Q sealed the deal. LY SJSt won 33-10 (-10). On avg UNLV has been outg'd on the ssn 417-378 ypg. SJSt is 10-3 as an AF while UNLV is 25-17-1 as a HD.

Utah St by 16 over FRESNO ST - Fresno St has won the L/6 in this series. UTSt got a home win LW vs Colorado St (-4) 33-18. UTSt outg'd CSU 435-361 but was outFD'd 24-21. QB Meyers filled in for Keeton (out 4-6 wks) and rushed for schl qb rec 16-191! UTSt led 26-18 and scored a td with 2:18 left in the 4Q to pad the lead. FSt lost 21-7 at SDSt LW (+7'). FSt was outg'd 409-89, outFD'd 19-6! The score was 7-7 at HT, but FSt managed just 1 FD in the 2H and went 3&O 5 times. These two last met in the '13 MW Championship here. FSt led 24-7 into the 4Q but needed a SOD & INT at the FS 17 on USt's L/2 poss only up 7. FSt is 4-9 as a HD and 19-27 as a HF. UTSt is 15-4 as a MW Fav and Wells is 5-1 as an AF. UTSt has Boise on deck (Friday).

OCT 13 (TUE) Arkansas St at SOUTH ALABAMA - ASt has won all 3 meetings (2-1 ATS). ASt won 49-35 over ID LW (-22'). RB Gordon was 26-221-3 and ASt racked up 333 rush yds and 6 tds. ASt outg'd ID 521-338. SA won outright LW (+7) and outg'd Troy 365-265. ASt (-10) had an all around effort LY, beating SA 45-10 (400-201 yd edge). It was 45-3 before SA gained 59% of their yards (120) and their only td of the game. ASt will look to expose SA's poor run D which has all'd 204 ypg (5.1 ypc). ASt is 4-10 on the road, 5-9 ATS. The HT is 13-4 ATS. ASt has failed to cover 5 str AG's being outright upset 2x's in SB play. SA in 2 of the L3W has pulled outright upsets. KEY SELECTIONS

4★ GREEN BAY over St Louis - While 17 pts is a bit lower than expected from this dangerous GB offense, their solid play on the defensive side of the ball was more than enough against the 49ers as they held SF to just 8 FD's and 196 ttl yds on a short wk and traveling out West. The Rams meanwhile went into ARZ and handed the Cardinals their 1st loss of the ssn as they forced 3 TO's and held on late for a 2 pt win despite being outFD'd (26-13) and outgained (447-328) by substantial margins. STL is now in their 3rd RG in 4 wks and showed us earlier in the ssn how they handle big wins (24-10 loss at WAS as 3 pt fav following ssn-opening win over SEA) while the Packers (8-1-1 ATS as a HF) have now won an NFL-best 11 consec home games (incl playoffs) behind QB Rodgers and his 486 pass att's w/o an int at Lambeau (43 TD passes in that span)

FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 16 3* CINCINNATI over Seattle - CIN has posted some pretty impressive ATS marks over the past few ssns at home with a 15-3-1 record including our Weekly 3.5★ LP Top Play Winner over KC, a game in which their defense held the Chiefs to a few FG's early on while RB's Bernard and Hill combined for 102 rush yds and 4 TD's. They now take on a Seahawks tm that heads out East on a short wk (MNF vs DET) with an 0-2 ATS record away from home so far in '15. While the return of S Chancellor has the SEA defense back to their expected high level, the main culprit for their struggles thus far has been an OL that has surrendered 12 sks thru 3 games (QB Wilson struggling with just a 4-2 ratio). While there is no line as of presstime, it is worth noting that this undefeated Bengals team has gone an amazing 21-4-1 as a dog of 3 or less if the situation occurs. They have trailed for just 1:58 all ssn long and are clearly a contender in the AFC. FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 6

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Arizona over DETROIT - After dominating their 1st 3 opponents by a 126-49 margin, the Cardinals ran into some TO (3-0 deficit) & RZ issues against the Rams as they had to settle for 5 FG's (21, 27, 42, 38 & 29) in their 2 pt loss (outgained STL 447-328). The Lions meanwhile are more than likely off to an 0-4 start (at SEA on MNF) following their 3rd road contest over the 1st month of the ssn. The biggest concern so far for DET has been a rushing offense that is dead last in the NFL at just 45 ypg. With the Lions now carrying just a 2-9 ATS mark as a dog and ARZ continuing to roll on the road (12-5 ATS) and as an overall favorite (13-4-1), there's no question where we're leaning as Arians is a solid 7-2 ATS off a SU loss. FORECAST: ARIZONA by 10 OTHER GAMES

Indianapolis at HOUSTON - TNF - The Colts are back to .500 on the ssn as QB Hasselbeck made his 1st start since Nov of '12 for an ini'd Luck (CS for this one) and guided a GW 27 vd FG in OT for the victory despite a 421-326 yd deficit (IND outgained in each game TY by 55 ypg). The Texans meanwhile struggled mightily in their trip to undefeated ATL as they trailed 42-0 entering the 4Q behind a struggling QB Mallett. IND has delivered against the AFC South with 15 consec SU wins (IND 11-2-2 vs DIV foes) although it is worth noting that the Texans are a completely different animal on the offensive side of the ball when Arian Foster (1,200+ rush yds in 4 of L/5 yrs) is in the lineup (should be a full-go here after just 8 rush att LW in 1st game back from inj). We'll have one of our Red-Hot Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk (NFL marquees are 16-4, 80% on the ssn!).

TAMPA BAY by 1 over Jacksonville - Rough spot for both tms heading into this matchup as neither squad has found success in their respective away and home situations. JAX is in the midst of a 3-game road trip (11 straight road losses overall) although they did nearly pull out the win LW in IND against a Colts squad missing QB Luck (JAX outgained IND 431-326 in 3 pt OT loss). The Bucs meanwhile have now dropped 11 consec home contests following LW's 37-23 defeat to CAR, a game in which the Panthers delivered a 3★ LP Winner after forcing 5 Buc TO's incl 4 int's from QB Winston (TB had a big 411-244 yd edge). While we'd prefer to play against both teams in this spot, we'll take JAX and the points as a FG may be too much for the Bucs to cover as they are just 3-7 ATS before a bye while posting a poor 4-14-1 mark as a NDIV HF including a 42-14 (-3) defeat by TEN in the opener.

Buffalo by 5 over TENNESSEE - Bad memories for the Bills fanbase (Music City Miracle) as BUF heads to Nashville to take on a rested Titans team off a bye. Following their domination a wk earlier of MIA, the Bills came out flat at home against the Giants as their offense posted just 2 FD's and 77 yds on their 1st 9 possessions in the 24-10 defeat (17 Bills penalties). Despite their 1-2 mark the Titans have to feel pretty good as they've outgained each of their 1st 3 opponents by 68 ypg while getting some consistent play out of rookie QB Mariota who is avg 278 ypg (64%) with an 8-2 ratio. BUF on the other hand has exchanged good performances (IND/MIA) with bad performances (NE/NYG) and if you go with that trend, this will be their week to shine against a TEN squad that is just 2-12 ATS off a SU loss the past 2 ssns.

BALTIMORE by 11 over Cleveland - Despite a substantial 356-263 yardage edge against the Steelers, the Ravens were fortunate (two missed FG's in 4Q by PIT) to escape Heinz Field with their 1st victory of '15, a 23-20 OT win. BAL now enters this home matchup with extra rest (TNF) against a Browns team fresh off of their West Coast battle with SD, a game in which CLE nearly pulled the outright upset all'g SD 2 chances to hit the GW FG as time expired (CLE's 432 ttl yds against the Chargers was 115 over their ssn avg). While BAL's overall recent history against their DIV has been less than stellar (6-13-1 ATS), they have been victorious in 12 of their L/13 meetings against CLE which bodes well for them delivering in this one as they try to climb back into the AFC North race.

ATLANTA by 13 over Washington - Following their final minute come-from-behind victory over PHI a wk ago (3* LP Winner on Under 45), WAS has now outgained each of their 1st 4 opp by 96 ypg. ATL meanwhile enters this matchup trying to achieve a NFC East SU/ATS sweep for the 2nd time in 4 ssns. Their previous meetings against PHI, NYG and DAL TY have resulted in a pair of outright upsets as a 2' pt dog and an 11 pt road win against the Cowboys as a 1 pt favorite. New HC Quinn has ATL at 4-0 for just the 4th time in franchise history delivering a Top 4 + Winner in Power Sweep against HOU, a game that they actually led 42-0 heading into the 4Q. Despite playing better than most expected so far in '15, the Redskins are just 9-18 ATS as a dog and may have some issues against a resilient Falcons team that now has a game-breaking RB in Freeman (342 ttl yds, 6 TD's L2W) to go along with one of the more dangerous QB/WR combos in the eague today in Ryan and Jones.

KANSAS CITY by 17 over Chicago - Despite substantial FD (23-16) and yardage (371-243) edges the Bears needed a 49-yd FG w/:02 remaining to claim their 1st win of the ssn against a Raiders squad that entered play as an AF for just the 2nd time in the past 10 yrs. The Chiefs have fallen on hard times since their ssn opening win over HOU as they've now blown a late lead at home against DEN, were dominated worse than the final score at GB and then gave up 36 pts and 445 yds in their loss LW in Cincy. Fortunately KC returns home where they went 6-2 a ssn outscoring their opponents by 17 ppg in those victories. This doesn't bode well for a Bears team that has gone 8-18 as a dog while being outscored by nearly 24 ppg in their past 7 road defeats.



PHILADELPHIA by 1 over New Orleans - The Eagles return home following another headscratching offensive performance in their final minute defeat to WAS as they were outgained for the 3rd consec game and have now seen their defense on the field for 58 minutes longer through 4 gms. The Saints got into the win column a wk ago against a pesky Cowboys squad as QB Brees returned from inj following a 1 game absence to throw for 359 yds and 2 TD's (incl an 80-yarder in OT). While the Eagles have been pretty solid as a HF covering 6 of their L/7, the Saints have the momentum heading to Philly to keep this contest within the spread (covered previous 2 meetings by 18 ppg). New England by 14 over DALLAS - The Patriots return from their bye following a massive 3-game offensive outburst to start the ssn that has them ranked 1st in the NFL in ypg (446) and scoring (39.7). Despite a late TD pass in the final minutes to force OT, DAL's streak of 10 consec road wins ended following an 80-yd TD pass by the Saints on their 1st drive of the extra period, 26-20. While the Cowboys can go all out in this matchup with a bye on deck (CS of LB Lee who left LW w/a concussion), Belichick and company have feasted on QB's making their 1st career start against them (Weeden 239 ypg, 73%, 1-1 ratio in 2 sts TY). This NE team is beginning to resemble their undefeated '07 squad that began the year at 8-0 ATS before some ridiculous spreads started to appear (-18 avg over L/7 gms that ssn). Until Vegas starts overcompensating again, we'll continue to ride the Patriots.

Denver by 7 over OAKLAND - Despite a few miscues by QB Manning and the DEN offense, the Broncos were able to move to 4-0 on the year following their 3 pt home win over MIN. A late FG (:07 left) by the Bears spoiled a potential 2-game road sweep for the Raiders (ended 11-game road losing streak the wk prior vs CLE) as they entered their contest against CHI as an AF for just 2nd time s/'06. While the Raiders have a bye on deck and do have a new HC in Del Rio that spent the previous 3 ssns as the DC of the Broncos, keep in mind that they've gone just 7-17 as a DIV HD. This doesn't bode well against a DEN squad that has outscored them by 18 ppg in their L/4 trips

to "The Black Hole" while going 13-2 ATS vs AFC West opponents. San Francisco at NY GIANTS - SNF - SF's offensive wees continued LW at home against the Packers as they posted just 8 FD's and 196 yds in the 17-3 defeat. The 49ers now head back on the road where they've been dismantled so far in '15 against PIT and ARZ by a 90-25 combined margin (outscored 60-10 in 1H).
