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KEY SELECTIONS

4★ BAYLOR over West Virginia - Fourth str ssn playing and just the 4th all-time mtg. Revenge gm for Baylor as LY they were ranked #4 at 6-0 & traveled to WV but lost 41-27 (-7'). BU was held to ssn lows in pts (27), FD (22) & yds (318, 263 below ssn avg). LTH BU won 73-42 (-29.5) w/872 ttl yds (all-time high all'd by WV & 73 pts ranked #2 all'd). Baylor is off a blowout win over Kansas 66-7 (-46) who was playing with their 3rd string QB. BU led 52-7 at HT before pulling most of their starters. The Bears 321 pts this sen are the most ever by any tm through 5 gms! We cashed going against WV as they dropped their gm to OKSt LW 33-26 (-7) in OT as we elevated our $2 \star$ on these pages to a $3 \star$ LPS play on Saturday as part of our 5 * weekend that saw us go 5-1 on our college side selections! WV trail'd 23-9 in the 3Q but came back to force OT. BU avg's 725 ypg of offense while WV is only all'g 342 ypg. BU is 12-3 as a HF, and 17-7-1 as a DD Fav, while WV is 0-2 SU/ATS vs ranked foes, failing to cover by 13 ppg. The Bears are playing at an entirely different level then everyone else so far this ssn and will get their revenge in a major way! FORECAST: BAYLOR BY 35 3★ FLORIDA STATE over Louisville - UL is 1-8 in Tallahassee but LTH was in '00. FSU trailed 21-0 in the 2Q but had 374 yds in the 2H. FSU won in LY 42-31 (-3'). LW FSU won vs rival Miami 29-24 (-7) as we cashed our 2nd 5 t LPS play this yr! FSU led 20-10 at HT & RB Cook put the 'Noles on his back (22-222-2) scoring the game deciding td. In the series, Cook has rushed for more yds vs Miami than any other FSU player! The 'Noles outg'd UM 539-425. UL is fresh off a bye, after a 20-13 road win vs NCSt the wk prior. UL outgid & outFDd NCSt 306-228 & 20-11. FSU has outgid foes by 206 ypg at home while rushing for 264 ypg (5.7 ypc), while the Cardinals all'd 206 (4.5) rush ypg in their losses to Aub, Hou & Clem, FSU is off their big rival gm vs Miami and has to prep for GT's option next wk, but it won't matter this week as RB Cook will look to have another fine rushing day against a UL D that lost a lot of talent to graduation & to the next level. The 'Noles won us a 5 \star last week and we'll back them again as a key selection. FORECAST: FLORIDA STATE BY 17 3* San Diego St (+) over SAN JOSE ST - SJSt HC. SDSt is 2-0 SU/ATS in MW Play. SJSt has won the L/3 mtgs by 17 ppg. SDSt enters off a win on the islands vs Hawaii 28-14 (+2'). The Aztecs outo'd UH 402-251 and forced 3 TO's. This was the 3rd time SDSt held a tm to less than 300 yds of offense. SJSt won a back and forth gm vs UNLV 33-27 (-3) in OT. There was 4 lead changes and UNLV needed a fg to put the game into OT, but the Spartan's held on. SDSt is 18-7-1 ATS in MW play while SJSt is on a 4-8 ATS run. This gm features RB Ervin, who has rushed for 874 (6.2) with 11 td's vs SDSt's stingy run D who have all'd a total of just 137 rush yds (1.6 ypc) in the L/3 gms. The Aztecs are avg 180 (4.0) rush ypg and over their L/2 gms have rushed for 305 & 218 yds while SJSt is all'g 228 (5.1) rush ypg on the ssn. 2★ WISCONSIN over Purdue - UW HC. The Badgers have dominated the Boilermakers winning 9 str both SU/ATS. LY PU did get within 24-16 but was held to 24 ttl yds its L/5 drives in the 34-16 loss (+17). LTH PU only trailed 14-10 2Q but all'd 27 str in a 41-10 defeat (+22'). UW is off an emotional 23-21 (+2') come-from-behind win at Neb, hitting a 46 yd fg w/:04 left after missing a 39 yd fg a minute earlier, cashing a 2★ on these pages LW as we went a combined 5-1 on our Star Rated plays! The Badgers all'd Neb to take the lead w/3:38 remaining. UW did have 469-325 yd & 25-13 FD edges, but were uncharacteristic in their approach as QB Stave att'd 50 passes, just the 4th time in schl history a QB has thrown that many & it was their 1st win since the '07 Capital One Bowl they won when throwing more than running. PU remained winless vs FBS foes after their one-sided 41-13 (+3') home loss to Minn LW. The Boilermakers were down just 10-6 at HT but couldn't get anything going in the 2H and were outg'd 408-275 while turning the ball over 4X. PU is 4-2 ATS before a reg ssn bye & UW HC Chryst is on an 11-16 ATS run overall, but that doesn't deter us here as series history highly favors the Badgers and we will back them again.

A&M is fresh off a bye and beat MSU 30-17 (-4') the week prior as they had a 516-406 yd edge. The Aggies are avg 480 ypg & QB Allen has eclipsed 300 pass yds in each of their past 3 gms. Bama however, is still as dominant as ever on D as they are all'g just 265 ttl ypg & just 51.1% completions. The Tide is also #3 in the FBS all'g 203 ypg less then what their foes are avg. 2★ Michigan State (+) over MICHIGAN - The Paul Bunyan Trophy will be at stake here. MSU has dominated this series of late going 6-1 SU/7-0 ATS. The HT has gone 4-0 SU and the LTH ('12) the 12 pts MSU all'd were the fewest in a loss s/'93 (up 10-9 all'd GW fg w/:05). LY #8 MSU won 35-11 (-17) w/a 446-186 yd & 22-13 FD edge. UM is on an epic defensive run after their 3rd str shutout victory LW vs NW 38-0 (-10). The Wolverines all'd less than 200 yds for the 4th time TY as they outg'd NW 380-168. The 38 pts all'd are the fewest through 6 gms for the Wolverines s/'85 when Harbaugh was their st'g QB! UM has more td's during their 5 gm win streak than pts all'd. LW MSU held on to beat RU 31-24 (-13). The Spartans had a commanding 489-349 yd edge but needed a td with :43 left to win. MSU has only outg'd foes by 25 ypg while UM is +181 ypg. Sparty realizes the importance of this rivalry and while they haven't played up to their talent level in recent weeks, they will put forth an all out effort this week. AU was outg'd & outFD'd but were +4 TO's. The bye week wasn't all quiet on the Plains, however, as they dismissed oft troubled WR Duke Williams after a bar brawl. The Tigers are 0-2 in SEC play, and the L/11X they've started that way, they've gone a combined 6-62-1 in conf play & 1954 was the only yr they won more than 2! UK needed OT to survive FCS EKU the week prior, winning 34-27 (-31'). Down 27-13 40, the 'Cats scored 2 td's in the last 5 min incl the tying one w/:52 left to send it into OT. UK had just 384-363 yd & 24-20 FD edges. AU has put an emphasis on the run as they are avg 218 (4.4) rush their L/2 gms while UK is all'g 171 (4.2) rush ypg on the ssn and all'd 247 vs ULL in their opener & 180 in their last gm. TEMPLE by 31 over Ucf - Just the 3rd all-time mtg. UCF has won each of the L2Y incl a 34-14 (-7) win LY outgaining Temple 466-182 (+16 FD). HT has covered both gms. UConn snapped their 3 gm losing skid, pulling off the outright upset on the road, 40-13 (+2') over UCF. The Huskies had a 433-315 yd edge and were +4 TO's. GS is fresh off a bye and beat ULM 51-31 (-6) on the road the wk prior. They had 26-16 FD & 503-279 yd edges incl 455-47 rushing! NMSt is winless on the season and is off an expected 52-3 (+45) loss at Ole Miss in a money gm. The Aggies have among the worst rush D's in the nation as they allow 274 (6.0) rush ypg, which obviously is not a good thing when taking on an efficiently run triple option based offense. NMSt is 2-11 as an AD & is on an 11-27-1 ATS run overall.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 10 over Fiu - MT is 6-4 (played L10Y) and the HT is 5-3 ATS incl B2B covers. The Cardinals will be looking to snap a 3 gm skid and are off a 59-41 (+10) loss at NIU. BSU had a 10-0 lead early 2Q & were down just 28-20 at HT, but were outscored 31-21 in the 2H, getting outg'd 636-503. They are all'g 68.3% completions on the ssn. GSt is off a 37-3 (+15') home loss to App St as they were outg'd 498-225 & outFD'd 24-14. QB Arbuckle was held to a ssn low 166 pass yds. BSU is 0-5 as a HF, while GSt is 14-8 as a dog vs FBS foes. The unbeaten Tigers were in a letdown spot LW, but that clearly wasn't the case as they got a 43-24 (-7') home win over GT, leading 33-10 at HT and had 24-12 FD & 538-230 yd edges. CU set a schl record with their 13th str home win. BC is off a gut-wrenching 3-0 (-7') home loss to WF despite all'g JUST 5 FD's & 142 ttl yds! The Eagles had a chance at the end after recovering a fumble at the WF 11 w/:56 remaining, but mismanaged the clock on 1&GL from the 1 and couldn't spike the ball in time to stop the clock and get their fg unit on the field. BC is the 1st ms/89 to lose B2B gms when all'g 9 pts or fewer, which ironically, was also the Eagles. UVA is off a 26-19 (+8) loss at Pitt. The 'Hoos had an opportunity to tie the gm at the end, but were SOD at the Panther 42. UVA is 7-2 ATS at home vs FBS foes.

NORTHWESTERN by 3 over lowa - Series has been dominated by the HT L5Y going 5-0 SU/ATS covering by 15 ppg. L/2 times hosting lowa, NW has pulled the outright upset incl LTH in '12 (28-17 +5). LY lowa won 48-7 (-4) w/a 483-180 y/d & 24-13 FD edge. lowa remained undefeated (4-2 ATS) after their 29-20 (-10) home win over Illinois as RB Canzeri set a schl record with 43 carries while rushing for 256 y/ds. The Hawkeyes win was costly however, as they lost Sr DL Ott, their leader on D. NW was humbled in their 1st loss of the ssn LW, 38-0 (+10) at Michigan. After all'g just 35 pts & 3 td's in it's F/5 gms, the Wildcat D all'd 38 pts & 5 td's. NW is still all'g 134 yds less then their foes are averaging, good for 9th best in the FBS. Strength vs strength as lowa is avg 201 (4.8) rush ypg while NW is all'g 102 (3.3) rush ypg at home incl limiting Stanford to just 85 (3.1). lowa is 5-2 ATS before a reg ssn bye, but NW is 3-1 as HD and won outright in that role earlier this yr vs Stanford. **NORTH CAROLINA by 14 over Wake Forest** - NC is just 1-3 but the HT has won & covered 3 str. WF pulled the outright upset in the LTMtg 28-27 (-9') w/the yds/FD almost even. LTH ('11) NC won 49-24 (-6', +231 yds). NC is fresh off a bye and went on the road at GT and pulled off the outright upset, 38-31 (+7) the week prior. The Tar Heels were down 21-0 late 1H, but scored 2 td's in the final 1:29 & were down just 21-14 at HT. WF is off a 3-0 (+7') win at BC. Yes that score is correct, 3-0. The Demon Deacons were limited to just 142 yds & 5 FD's, which was the fewest in a win by an FBS team in 20Y! WF survived a fumble at their own 11 yd line with just under a minute remaining as BC couldn't spike the ball in time to bring their fg unit on the field. WF is 3-7 as an AD, while NC is 14-7 as a HF.

Texas Tech by 35 over KANSAS - KU is 1-15 incl 8 str losses by 18 ppg (1-4-1 ATS). LTH TT trailed 10-0 but scored 54 unanswered in the 54-16 (-16') blowout (518-271 yd & 31-15 FD edges). LY after trailing 17-0 KU cut it to 6 twice in the 2H but lost 34-21 (+13). TT is off a 66-31 (-10') home win over lowa St as they had 33-19 FD & 776-495 yd edges. The 776 yds was a schl record. QB Mahomes threw for 428 yds with a 5-0 ratio in just over 3Qs. The Red Raiders are 1 of 3 teams in the FBS that avg 50+ ppg and they all are from the state of TX and in the B12 (TCU & Baylor). KU is still in search of its 1st win of the ssn (1-4 ATS) following their 66-7 (+46) home loss to BU. It was essentially over after the 1Q as the Jayhawks were down 24-7. KU was outFD'd 33-14 & outg'd 644-227. On the ssn they are averaging 134 yds less on offense then what their foes are all'g, which ranks #124 in the FBS and reall' g 575 ttl ypg incl 257 (5.6) rush ypg and over 70% completions! TT meanwhile, is #11 in the FBS averaging 279 yds more per gm then what their foes are all'g! KU is on a 1-6 ATS run, while the Red Raiders are 8-1 as an AF.

Nevada by 14 over WYOMING xx - This is just the 3rd mtg'ing s/'00. UN has won the L/2 incl the L/ gm ('12) 35-28 (-19) in OT. LTH ('00) ironically UN won 35-28 but pulled the outright upset as a 16' pt AD. Wyoming is still searching for its 1st win of the ssn (3-3 ATS) following their 31-17 (+21') loss to AF in the Front Range Rivalry. The Pokes were only down 7-3 at HT and were outg'd just 379-307 and did have a 19-16 FD edge, but were done in by 4 TO's incl a backbreaking one on 2&GL from the AF5 late 3Q when a td would've put them just 4 pts down. UN is off a dominating 35-17 (-4') home win over NM, having 517-273 yd & 30-14 FD edges. QB Stewart had 4 ttl td's. Wyoming is all'g 230 (5.5) rush ypg while the Wolf Pack are avg 222 (5.3) rush ypg and had a ssn high 351 rush yds LW. This is Wyoming's lone home gm in a 5 wk span, but they're just 7-16-1 as a HD, while UN is 7-1 ATS on the road incl 3-0 as an AF.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 10 over Louisiana Tech - MSU HC. MSU is 8-3 but LT has won 2 of the L/3 covering all 3. In the L/gm ('11, also LTH) MSU escaped in OT 26-20 (-19') being outgained 359-340. LT enters this contest on a 3 gm winning streak following their emotional 34-31 (-12) win at UTSA as they kicked the GW 32 yd fg w/:10 left. LT was 24-10 at HT, but all'd the tying td early 4Q. LT did have 444-300 yd & 24-15 FD edges. MSU is off an expected 45-17 (-30') home win over Troy. QB Prescott ply'd just 1 series (sick) but it didn't matter as the MSU Bulldogs were up 38-0 at HT and backup QB Fitzgerald made the most of his opportunity with 170 ttl yds & 3 td's. LT is 6-0 as an AD & 7-1 ATS vs non-conf foes, but MSU is 11-7 as a HF.

UMASS by 10 over Kent St - UMass HC. LY was the schools first mtg. Kent St lost 40-17 (E) and was outgained 482-341 & outFD'd 24-19. We cashed a 3★ LPS play on Saturday going against KSU as part of our 5★ weekend where we finished 5-1 on our side selections! KSU lost 38-7 (+14) at Toledo as they were outg'd 518-257 & outFD'd 27-13. Their lone td was on a fumble ret as their offense has failed to score at din half their gms this ssn. HC Haynes would not commit to a st'g QB following their latest setback as they are completing under 50% of their passes as a team and are avg just 154 pass ypg. UMass is off a 62-38 (+13') loss at BG as they al'd a ssn high 725 yds, but also gained a ssn high 516 yds. UMass is in a tough BG/UT MAC sandwich but Kent St just got done playing #24 Toledo. KSU is on a 10-24-1 overall ATS run while UMass is 8-3 off a SU loss.

OHIO by 7 over W Michigan - OU is 4-14 incl 1-4 SU/ATS s/00. LY WM won 42-21 (-10) w/a 530-372 yd & 24-18 FD edge. LTH ('06) OU pulled the outright upset 27-20 (+4). The Bobcats are off a 34-3 (-14') homecoming win over rival Miami, Oh in the "Battle for the Bricks." OU had 25-12 FD & 428-253 yd edges and the D had 4 int's. WM is also off a rivalry win, as the "Battle for the Cannon" was at stake in their 41-39 (-5) home win over CM. The Broncos were up 27-16 at HT, but had to infuriate their backers as they had a 1&GL from the 1 with a chance to get ahead of the number, but instead kneeled 2X. OU is 5-1 ATS TY and is 4-1 as a HF, but just 8-14-1 as a conf fav, while WM is 9-3 as an AD & 3-0 as a conf dog.

Northern Illinois by 21 over MIAMI, OH - NIU has won 6 str reg ssn gms but Miami has covered 5 str incl a 26-21 (+17') outright upset in the MAC Title gm in '10 at Ford Field. LY the Huskies had a 658-514 yd (30-25 FD) edge in the 51-41 win (-13'). NIU snapped a rare 3 gm losing skid with a 59-41 (-10) home win over over rival BSU in the "Battle for the Bronze Stalk." The Huskies spotted BSU a 10 pt lead, but led 28-20 at HT and had a 636-503 yd edge. Miami lost their "Battle for the Bricks" rivalry to Ohio 34-3 (+14') to remain winless vs FBS foes this ssn as they were outg'd 428-253 & outFD'd 25-12 while also throwing 4 int's. NIU is 19-5 ATS away, but the RedHawks are 8-3 as a DD dog. Air Force by 3 over COLORADO ST - AF is 6-2 ATS. LY AF got revenge after CSU snapped their

AF (played w/out its string QB & #1 rusher) won outright 27-24 (+7') but was outgained 472-377 (-7 ED). LTH CSU won 58-13 (-16') but AF held 516-441 yd & 24-22 ED edges (AF's worst series loss s/63). The Falcons are off a win in their "Front Range Rivarly" gm over Wyoming 31-17 (-21'). AF led just 7-3 at HT and held just a 379-307 yd edge as Safety Brodie Hicks had 2 int's and a fumble recovery. The Rams have lost B2B gms for the 2nd time this ssn after their 41-10 (+14') home loss to Boise as they were outg'd 597-256 & outFD'd 27-14. AF is on an 8-3 ATS run & is 3-0 as an AF. CSU does have the schedule edge with a bye on deck, whereas AF just completed B2B rivarly games. **LSU by 7 over Florida** - LSU is 4-1 SU/ATS L5Y. LY was the first time s/'03 both schools DN come in ranked, in fact the higher ranked tm is on 4-1 SU/ATS run. LY LSU won 30-27 (E) w/a 21-13 FD edge (-1 yds). LTH the Tigers held the Gators out of the EZ, 17-6 win (-7) w/a 327-240 yd edge. UF's undefeated (5-1 ATS) run under new HC McElwain continued LW as they defeated Mizzu 21-3 (-5') in Columbia. The Gators had 337-257 yd & 23-12 FD edges in a gm where there was no offensive pts scored after the 1Q. LSU hosted SC as a late sked change due to flooding in Charleston and after leading just 17-10 at HT, pulled away for a 45-24 (-19') win in an odd looking half empty Tiger Stadium. RB Fournette reached the 1,000 yd mark in just their 5th gm (just the 10th player ever to do so) & QB Harris threw for a car high 228 yds as LSU had commanding 624-283 yd & 29-12 FD edges. The Gophers led just 10-6 at HT, but scored four 3Q td's to blow the gm open as they finished with a 408-275 yd edge and benefitted from +3 TO's. The hits keep coming for the Huskers as they again lost in heartbreaking fashion, this time 23-21 (-2') vs Wisconsin as they all'd a 46 yd fg w/:04 remaining as we cashed another star rated play on these pages LW, finishing 5-1 on our star rated plays (13-5 the L/3 wks). After scoring the go-ahead td w/3:38 left, the Blackshirts all'd UW to drive down the field, but they missed a 39 yd fg. NU could not run out the clock however, going 3&out and then all'd the Badgers to go 42/6pl with under a minute left to pull off the shocker. The Huskers were outg'd 469-325 & outFD'd 25-13 and after yrs of not being happy with 9 wins and firing Bo Pelini, now must win out just to get to 9 wins this ssn under new HC Riley. Their 4 losses have come by a combined 11 pts/NU is now 1-4-1 ATS on the ssn, but are 4-1 as an AD, while Minn is just 2-5 ATS, but his 9-5 as a HF & 13-5 ATS vs conf foes.

The Bulldogs will be without the services of star RB Chubb for the remainder of the ssn as he suffered a gruesome knee inj on the 1st play from scrimmage in last weeks 38-31 (-1') loss at Tenn. Ironically it was also against Tenn when RB Gurley was inj'd & OFY LY. UGA appeared to play with emotion and ran out to a 24-3 2Q lead, but then all'd 2 td's in under a minute to close the 1H and the loss of Chubb clearly had an effect on the outcome of the gm. LTH GT had a 360-228 yd edge in the 21-10 win (-10'). After a promising start to the ssn with B2B 60 pt gms following LY's 11 win ssn highlighted by a bowl win, GT has now lost 4 str. In their 43-24 (+7') loss at Clemson, the Yellow Jackets were down 33-10 at HT and were held to 230 ttl yds & 12 FD's, both ssn lows. Pitt is off a 26-19 (-8) home win over UVA. The Panthers are all'g just 85 (2.9) rush ypg on the ssn and are #4 in the FBS holding their foes to 178 yds less then their ssn avg! GT is on a 9-4 ATS run, but have lost 4 str, while Pitt is just 2-5 as an AD & just 3-8 as an ACC dog.

MIAMI, FL by 8 over Virginia Tech - Miami has covered 3 of the L/4 incl a 30-6 (-3) win LY. UM led 24-0 at HT and had a 456-262 yd & 22-15 FD edge. LTH #14 UM was outright upset 42-24 (-6, -197 yds). VT has had an extra day to prepare as they are coming off a Friday night 28-13 (-2) home win over NCSt that snapped their 2 gm skid and cashed us another Friday night Marquee winner. After spotting the Wolfpack 10 pts, it was all Hokies from there as they led 21-10 at HT & had a 358-270 yd edge for the gm. LW UM played in their annual rivalry vs FSU. UM trailed 21-20 but came back to take a 24-23 lead. FSU scored the GD td but missed a 2PC. Miami went on to lose 29-24 (+7) as we cashed just our 2nd str 5 \star of the ssn! VT's pass D has been strong TY, all'ing under 50% comp and 150 ypg. UM has avg'd 310 pass ypg. VT is 4-1 as an AD but 6-11-1 ATS as a visitor. Miami is 5-2-1 as a HE.

SM has had an extra day to prepare for this game as they are coming off a Friday night 31-10 (+3) loss at Marshall despite having 439-277 yd & 26-14 FD edges as they had 5 TO's. SM had 7 2H possessions, all of which ended with a fmbl, int, or SOD. UTSA is off a 34-31 loss to LT (+12). UTSA fought back from 14 down to tie it in the 4Q but LT kicked a GW

ÚLM lost their 5th str vs an FBS tm LW vs Tulsa 34-24 (+9). ULM was outg'd & outFD'd 563-404. Against 4 FBS foes, ULM has been outg'd by 195 ypg and beaten by 25 ppg. L/time that SC faced Vandy unranked was in '06, a 31-13 win (-3'). SC is coming off a "home" loss to LSU 45-24 (+19'), after the gm had to be moved to Baton Rouge due to the flooding in SC. SC had to play without QB Nunez (Ankle, CS). LSU outg'd & outFD'd SC 624-283 & 29-12. Spurier is 0-4 in SEC play for the 1st tm in his car. VU is off a bye (VU is 6-1 ATS off a bye). Prior to the bye, Vandy had a come from behind victory over MT. VU trailed 13-3 in the 4Q and scored 2 tds to win 17-13 (+2). Vandy is 5-1 ATS, and 11-3 as an AD. SC is 2-6 as a HF and 0-7 as a Fav in SEC play.

WASHINGTON STATE by 15 over Oregon State - WSU HC. Cougars are 3-8 and the HT has dropped 6 str ATS (incl '11's mtg in Seattle). LY WSU won outright 39-32 (+8') w/a 33-23 FD edge (+50 yds). LTH OSU dropped 52 forcing TO's on 6 str WSU drives, won 52-24 (E). OSU is 3-0 SU/ATS seeking revenge in this series (+26 ppg, +130 ypg). WSU is coming off an emotional win at Oregon, 45-38 in 2OT (+16'). That was the 1st win over the Ducks in 9 tries for WSU. QB Falk was outstanding, going 50-74-505-5, and led WSU to the GT td with :01 left in the 4Q. OSU is coming off a 44-7 loss to Arizona (+10). OSU was outg'd 644-249 and the Beavers' QB's combined for just 12-35-98-0-1. OSU is 2-12 ATS, 0-5 as an AD and 2-9 ATS in P12 play. WSU is 4-8 ATS and 1-4 as a HF.

NO meanwhile was unable to capitalize on LW's OT win over DAL as QB Brees turned the ball over 3 times and PHI finally got their offense clicking with substantial FD (34-19) and yardage edges (519-388). While the Saints have performed well in this series the past 9 yrs with a 13-5 SU mark, a win here for ATL could potentially see them at 9-0 heading into their Wk 10 bye week with matchups against TEN, TB and SF on deck. We'll have one of our Red-Hot Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk (NFL marquees are 17-6 74% on the ssn!).

Denver by 7 over **CLEVELAND** - It's hard to believe that it's been nearly 30 years since DEN and CLE's memorable playoff battles that ended with the Broncos heading to a pair of SB's thanks in part to "The Drive" and "The Fumble". In fact, this once promising rivalry has turned into a one sided affair w/CLE's last victory coming way back in 1990 as DEN has now taken each of the past 10 contests outscoring the Browns by 14 ppg. The Broncos are very fortunate to be undefeated heading into this one (no offensive TD's for 2nd time TV) as they were once again saved by a defense that's #1 in the league in sks (22) and TO's at 14 (CB Harris 74 yd IR TD in 4Q). The Browns on the other hand delivered a big road win at BAL LW in OT against the Ravens as QB McCown (36-51-457-2-0) became the 1st CLE QB to pass for 300+ yds in 3 str gms. CLE has had trouble sustaining consistency under Petitine as they are just 2-6 ATS off a SU win incl a home flop against OAK a few wks back. DEN meanwhile has gone 31-15 ATS as a favorite and should head into their bye week with continued success in this matchup (NDIV AF's w/a bye on deck are 11-2-1 ATS).

with continued success in this matchup (NDIV AF's w/a bye on deck are 11-2-1 ATS). **Houston by 4 over JACKSONVILLE** - Not much has gone right for the Texans so far in '15 as while they have been able to outgain their opponents in 4 of their 5 gms, large HT deficits have seen opposing defenses play a bit of a bend but don't break scheme over the final 2 quarters (may somewhat skew their final numbers). A late charge by QB Hoyer and the HOU offense fell just short against a Luck-less Colts squad who escaped TNF with a 7 pt win. JAX fell victim to the Bucs LW in TB in an unexpected shootout that saw QB Bortles toss for 303 yds and 4 TD's. The Jags have struggled over recent years as a HD (6-18-1 ATS) while the Texans have gone 7-3 as a favorite (if applicable) and may have found some offensive consistency under Hoyer who has guided HOU to 41 pts over 10 drives the past 2 weeks in relief of Mallett.

Chicago by 1 over DETROIT - The Lions remain the only winless team in the NFL following an embarrassing home loss to ARZ, a game in which they outFD'd (29-15) and outgained (436-345) the Cardinals but coughed the ball up on 6 occasions. They now take on a Bears squad that must have gotten one heck of a HT speech by HC Fox as they erased a 17-3 deficit to take home a 2nd straight win. Despite the Lions having swept the ssn series in each of the past 2 yrs and being on a 7-3 run as a DIV HF, the wrong team may be favored judging by TY's results as the Bears have a bye on the horizon and have now outgained 4 of their 1st 5 opponents while all'g just 305 ypg on the year (#4 NFL) despite plenty of attrition on the unit.

yg on the year (#4 NFL) despite plenty of attrition on the unit. **Washington by 1 over NY JETS** - The Redskins took the undefeated Falcons to the brink LW in Atlanta (Falcons 59 yd IR TD in OT) despite being outFD'd (29-18) and outgained (418-270) by substantial margins (1st time WAS outgained TY). The Jets have delivered some solid performances so far in their 3-1 start including a 13 pt win against MIA in London that had them outgaining the Dolphins by 199 yds. They come into this matchup against WAS well rested following a bye but with some rough ATS history against the NFC (5-13-2 ATS), it may be difficult for them to handle a Redskins squad that nearly pulled one of the bigger upsets in the NFL last weekend.

Arizona by 7 over PITTSBÜRGH - The Cardinals are back in the win column following a Wk 4 hiccup against the Rams as they erased an early 7-0 deficit in DET by scoring 42 of the final 52 points and delivering yet another 3★ LP Winner. PIT meanwhile returns home following their MNF tilt against the Chargers carrying a very impressive 9-1-1 mark as a HD. They will however be without QB Roethlisberger for a 3rd consec contest against an ARZ defense that has made a killing on capitalizing on offensive errors so far TY (forced 13 TO's, T#2 NFL). ARZ HC Arians (former OC here) has the Cardinals in the middle of some fairly impressive ATS marks as they have gone 21-5-1 vs NDIV foes, 12-5 on the road and 16-7-1 off of a SU win.

Miam¹ by 3 over TENNESSEE - The Dolphins laid an egg in their previous contest across the pond in England against the Jets as they were dominated from the start in a lackluster effort (outgained by 199 ydsl) that cost both their HC and DC their jobs during the bye week. The Titans (off a bye week) meanwhile held the Bills to just 13 FD's and 209 ttl yds in Nashville but struggled offensively as well with just 276 yds blowing a 10 pt lead in the 3Q in a 1 pt defeat (TEN now just 4-11 ATS vs NDIV foes). This will be a game to keep a close eye on to see just how the Dolphins ₆

adjust to interim HC Campbell and DC Anarumo who implemented plenty of drills during their wk off to create a much tougher and focused environment. If the MIA players buy in (MIA is 8-4 in NDIV AG's), which we believe that they'll do, then this could be a bad spot for a Titans squad that is just 2-13 ATS off of a SU loss under HC Whisenhunt.

SEATTLE by 3 over Carolina - The Panthers have been the hottest team in the NFL as they've delivered wins in 9 of their past 10 contests with the only loss in that span coming here during the playoffs a year ago (outgained SEA 362-348 but had a 3-0 TO deficit). They've been extremely fortunate with their sked so far in '15 however as their 1st 4 opponents have a combined 5-15 record while CAR has actually been outgained by 17 ypg. The Seahawks blew a 17 pt lead in their OT loss on the road against undefeated CIN as they were outFD'd by a 27-16 clip. SEA has been a solid 19-8 as a HF with the "12th Man" behind them but their lack of consistency on the offensive side of the ball (just 7 TD's in 1st 5 gms) has us leaning on the well-rested (CAR off a bye, LB Kuechly should return here) road dog in this one.
