UM is 39-4 SU (6-1 ATS) but LY had their 6-gm series win streak snapped. UM was a 13' pt HF & lost 30-14 being outg'd 373-171 & outFD'd 20-12 (yds/FD both ssn lows). LTH ('12) UM won 35-13 (-10'). Both are coming off byes and losses prior but UM still might be thinking about the unbeleivable end vs instate rival MSU (lost 27-23 -7', up 23-21 w/:10). Minn lost outright as well 48-25 (-2') against Neb. Gophers strength lies in the run gm (177 ypg 4.1) but Wolverines have only all'd 54 ypg rush (1.9) over L6. 4★ Minnesota over CHICAGO - The Vikings continue to roll following yet another big win at Detroit (1st DIV road win in 3 yrs) as they are now on a 13-3 ATS run and have given us consecutive LP Winners as well as a Top Play 4★ Victory in LW's newsletter! They now head to CHI to take on a Bears team (off a bye) that has struggled against DIV foes with just a 6-14 ATS mark and are in a battle with the Lions to stay out of the NFC North cellar (lost in OT to DET 2 wks ago). While the Bears have been much better than we expected on the defensive side of the ball (345 ypg all'd, #10 NFL), their 10-18 ATS run as a dog and the Vikings' hot hand may be too much to pass up for us in this one!

FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 10
3★ NY Jets over OAKLAND - The Raiders return home following their upset victory of the Chargers, a game that they actually led 37-6 before 23 unanswered pts by SD in the 4Q. They now take on a Jets squad that narrowly dropped their 2nd contest of the ssn LW in NE (led in 4Q, held Pats to 70 ypg under their ssn avg). Despite their loss to the Patriots, the Jets are still on a solid 7-1-1 ATS run and have one of the top defenses in the entire league (#4 scoring, #2 total). OAK on the other hand is just 21-36-1 ATS as a HD and have failed miserably following a SU win the past 4 ssns w/a 2-11 ATS mark.

### **OTHER SELECTION**

2★ Arizona over CLEVELAND - The Browns shot themselves in the foot from the opening drive on LW against the Rams as 4 TO's and 11 drive-killing penalties saw them lose 24-6 despite a 364-308 yard advantage (trailed 10-0 despite not all'g a single FD!). CLE now returns home to take on a Cardinals squad traveling on a short week (MNF vs BAL) in the final leg of a 3-week matchup against the AFC North. With a bye week on deck for ARZ and impressive ATS marks against NDIV foes (21-6-1) and in road contests (13-6), it's hard to pass on leaning with a line of less than a TD, especially if QB McCown's shoulder inj becomes significant (CS).

### **OTHER GAMES**

Miami at NEW ENGLAND -TNF - Despite trailing the Jets heading into the 4Q, the Patriots prevailed with 2 late TD passes in a 7 pt win to remain undefeated on the year (NE just 9 rush att compared to 54 pass att). The Dolphins meanwhile have flourished under new HC Campbell as they throttled the Texans (led 41-0 at HT) with a ssn-best 503 ttl yds (164 ypg more than ssn avg). LW Houston had 3 yards in their first 7 drives and in Miami's first 7 drives, they had 399! While MIA has actually won 2 of their L/3 meetings against the Patriots and are on a 31-16-1 ATS run as an AD, keep in mind that TNF has seen Brady go 8-0 SU all-time with a 20-2 ratio during that span. We'll have one of our Red-Hot NFL Marquee selections (19-10, 66%) available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee Packs.

† Kansas City by 6 over Detroit - London - This is a 9:30 am EST start. These squads head across the pond with a combined 3-11 mark as injuries and late-game miscues have cost them dearly. The Chiefs were fortunate LW to take on a Steelers squad featuring a 3rd string QB making his 1st career start as they knocked off PIT by 10 in Arrowhead snapping their 5-gm losing streak. The Lions meanwhile let another early lead slip from their hands (led 14-3) as they were outgained (425-274) and outFD'd (25-14) by substantial margins along with being sacked a ssn-worst 7 times against the Vikings. The Chiefs are now riding a bit of momentum coming in which should allow them to prevail here against a Lions team that just cannot find their footing after dropping 9 of their past 10 contests ATS.

ATLANTA by 6 over Tampa Bay - After starting the season off with a perfect 5-0 mark, the Falcons nearly dropped a 2nd consec contest LW in Nashville (10-7 win, ATL 378-256 yd edge). The Bucs meanwhile all'd the Redskins to deliver their biggest comeback win in franchise history (trailed 24-0) as they were called for a franchise-worst 16 penalties in a 1 pt defeat (TB 479-355 yd edge). Despite LW's scoring troubles, the Falcons remain one of the more potent offenses in the NFL (#5 at 403 ypg). They have however trailed in all but one of their contests in the 2H this year giving the Bucs and their #5 ttl defense (328 ypg) some backdoor potential.

NEW ORLEANS by 7 over NY Giants - The Giants head into the Superdome following a fortunate victory over the Cowboys that saw them take advantage of QB Cassel's 1st start w/DAL (3 int's). They now take on a red-hot Saints squad that's won 3 of their L/4 including a big road win LW in Indy, a game in which they led 27-0 heading into the 4Q. It's been tough to gauge the Giants so far in '15 as they've had their share of struggles holding onto leads while having no resemblance of a pass rush thus far thru 7 gms (just 9 sks). The Saints on the other hand are 23-9-2 ATS at home vs NDIV foes and appear to be hitting their peak.

ST LOUIS by 4 over San Francisco - While the Rams 24-6 win against the Browns appears to look pretty solid, a further look into the contest tells a whole different story as they forced 4 CLE TO's (led 10-0 in 1Q despite no FD's) in the victory (outgained 364-308). The 49ers mustered up just 3 pts while actually punting (9) more times than they were able to achieve FD's (8) against the Seahawks (SF now on a 1-7 ATS run vs DIV foes). Over their 1st 7 gms of '15, the SF offense has been held to less than 200 yds and 10 or fewer FD's on 3 occasions. This is a bit of an inflated line in our opinion however after LW's outcomes, giving the road dog some value.

Cincinnati at PITTSBURGH - The carousel of starting QB's continued for the Steelers last wk as Landry Jones earned his 1st career start in Arrowhead against the Chiefs, a game in which he threw for 209 yds (1 TD) but with 3 costly TO's in the 10 pt defeat. They now take on an undefeated Bengals squad that has been a covering machine dating back to LY with an impressive 7-1-1 ATS mark. With PIT winning each of their L/3 against CIN and sitting at a solid 6-1 ATS as a HD (if applicable), the questions facing the Steelers QB position heading into presstime for this contest has us at a wait-and-see approach once again before we decide which way to go.

**BALTIMORE by 7 over San Diego** - The Ravens return home on a short week following their 4th trip West of the Mississippi already TY (MNF at ARZ). While their current record

is the worst in team history, it's worth noting that they've lost their 6 contests by just 22 total points. The Chargers meanwhile have been dealing with struggles of their own including LW at home against the Raiders, a game in which they failed to show up for in the 1st 3 quarters (trailed 37-6 before 3 late TD's cut it to 8 at the end). SD now heads East for their 3rd game of the ssn being played at 10am PST with the first 2 resulting in a 5 pt loss to CIN (+3') and 17 pt defeat at the hands of the Vikings (+1'). With a bye week on the horizon, the Ravens have a chance to return some much needed momentum to the lockeroom and improve upon their 26-13-1 ATS mark as a NDIV HF in the process.

HÓUSTON by 7 over Tennessee - The Texans have dominated the Titans at home the past 3 seasons outscoring them by 15 ppg in the process. Unfortunately they ran into a buzzsaw LW in Miami as they trailed 41-0 at the half and lost RB Foster for the ssn in the process. Despite a narrow 3 pt loss a wk ago to the Falcons, TEN has their own share of issues coming in following their 5th consec defeat (9th straight at home) as they were forced to go with bkp QB Mettenberger (22-35-187-1-2) for an inj'd Mariota. The situation clearly favors HOU as they are 6-3-1 ATS prior to a bye while the Titans have struggled as a dog (6-14-2 ATS). With Mariota questionable heading into presstime (CS), we feel comfortable in laying a TD in this one as the Texans are clearly the stronger squad despite LW's debacle in South Beach (Titans just 3-13 ATS off a SU loss).

Seattle by 7 over DALLAS - The Seahawks are off of their most convincing victory of the ssn last Thur against the 49ers as they all'd just 8 FD's and 142 yds in their easy 20-3 victory. They now take on a Cowboys squad that is still in the midst of injury issues as Matt Cassel (227 yds, 1-3 ratio in loss to the Giants) is expected to start again in this one after taking over for the ineffective Weeden last week (Romo still on short-term IR).
