## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ NORTHERN ILLINOIS over UNLV** - LY in their only recent meeting NI was -10 on the road and jumped out to a 17-5 lead and led 31-19 in the 4Q. UNLV would score 2 td's to tie it at 34 with 9:18 left. NI got a 54 yd td pass and UNLV on 1&g from the 7 was int'd in the EZ. NI then went 80/10 with a spread covering td with 1:51 left, 48-34. That was on the road now NI is at home and this is the first game for UNLV's new HC, Tony Sanchez and the first road trip for a lot of freshmen which Sanchez figures to be playing this year. LV is just 1-14 in road openers and their last 7 they've lost by 26 ppg. In their only 2 trips to Dekalb they led 42-24 in '89 and 62-14 in '95. NI is 13-2 SU in home openers with 7 str wins by 27 ppg and they only have Murray St on deck. Rod Carey is just 3-7 ATS as a HF but they could be playing with a chip on their shoulders this year as they have played in the MAC title game 5 straight years but were picked THIRD in their division this year by the media. Look for an under the radar NI team to open the year with a dominating win vs a team with a 1st time head coach and just 10 ret str.

**FORECAST: NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 34**

**3★† Alabama over Wisconsin** - (Arlington). These two last met in 1928. LY UW opened the season vs LSU in NRG Stadium. UW led 24-7 in the 3Q with a 290-136 rush edge but lost numerous DL to injury and RB Gordon didn't play in the 4Q and they came up short, 28-24. UW beat Auburn in the Outback Bowl, 34-31 with a 521-435 yd edge. The same Auburn team that outgained Alabama 630-539 LY. Bama has just 11 returning st's and the Badgers have 13. Alabama has question marks at QB and Wisconsin was #1 in the FBS in total defense at the end of the regular season LY and has 6 ret str on D as opposed to just 3 from last year. Alabama, however, has our #1 rated defense in the country and plenty of talent on offense that needs to get up to speed. They beat #8 Michigan in 2012 by a 41-14 margin and Ohio St did beat UW 59-0 in the Big Ten title game. Wisky has a new HC and UA has the edges on offense, defense and ST's and is not even the pick to win the SEC and is off a loss (can you say motivated?). **FORECAST: Alabama by 17**

**3★ Penn St over TEMPLE** - PSU has now won 31 in a row vs Temple with their last loss being 1941. TU is on a current 3-2 ATS run. PSU's last trip here was in '11 and they were -7 and only won 14-10. They had a 308-197 yd edge but didn't lead until a td with 2:42 left. LY these two were tied 6-6 late 3Q. PSU got an 8 yd drive for a td after an int and a 30 yd IR td to go up 27-13. PSU went on to a 30-13 home win with a 366-248 yd and 19-8 FD edge. PSU could very well have the crowd edge in this game as they are 106 miles away and playing in the major Philadelphia market. Last year Penn St was in a Big Ten sandwich and this year they only have Buffalo on deck. Temple has our #37 rated D but Penn St comes in at #8. Both QB's had unexpected off years last season but Penn St's Hackenberg is a potential 1st rounder and 6'1" PJ Walker may have overachieved back in '13. Temple has a big conference game on deck vs Cincy so we look for Penn St to grab the road win. Despite their 6-6 record last year Temple was actually -64 ypg. **FORECAST: Penn St by 15**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Oklahoma St over CENTRAL MICHIGAN** - CM has won 8 str home openers but the L7 have been vs FCS schools. The last time they opened vs a P5 team was '06 and they lost to BC 31-24 (+11). OSU has won their L3 AG by 21+ vs non-P5 conf schools and they only have C Ark on deck. Okla St is one of the most improved teams in the country as they were the least experienced team in '14 but now have 16 ret str and LY took the RS off talented true frosh QB Mason Randolph late and he led upset wins vs Okla and in the bowl. Central is on the other end of the spectrum as they went 7-5 and got to a bowl last year but have a new head coach and they go from 18 ret str down to just 10 and look to be in a rebuilding mode. Gundy was 11-1 ATS as an AF but is on a 2-6 run. CM is 1-8 ATS as a HD. Gundy is 15-9 as a DD non conf favorite and after barely making a bowl LY will want to get their feet on the ground running. Last year a 3-9 Syracuse beat a much more experienced CM team 40-3 here and OSU is much better than that team. **FORECAST: Okla St by 31**

**2★ SOUTHERN MISS (+) over Miss St** - SM is 10-5 SU vs Miss St but LY was their first meeting s/'90. MSU was -30 at home and rolled to a 49-0 win with a 550-283 yd edge. MSU does have a huge game vs LSU on deck but Mullen is 8-4-1 ATS as an AF. Monken is 1-6 ATS as a HD and there should be plenty of cowbells and Miss St fans for this fairly close trip (183 miles). Miss St has just 7 ret str this year and SMiss brings back 15 and brings in some great transfers including 3 Power 5 DLs that were not on the roster in the spring. SMiss has lost 9 games the last two years by over 3 td's (losing by avg of 42.6 ppg) so this is scary but we really feel they are a much improved team and can keep this closer than expected. **FORECAST: Mississippi St by 14**

## OTHER GAMES

### SEPT 3 (THUR)

**† South Carolina by 7 over North Carolina (Charlotte)** - Just the 3rd meeting between these schools s/'91. This will be played at Bank of America Stadium (home of the NFL Carolina Panthers & CFB's Belk Bowl). NC ply'd here in '13's Bowl win over Cincinnati 39-17 (-2). This marks the first neutral site mtg s/'55 (Norfolk, Va). Despite being played in NC, it's a true neutral field as the schls are equal distance from Charlotte. L/gm ('13) SC led 17-0 2Q. 2x's NC cut it to 10 but SC answered incl the gm's L/score, a 75-yd td run w/7:38 3Q in the 27-10 (-12) win in Columbia. SC HC Spurrier is 9-1 SU in his opening games (6-4 ATS) but LY was -10 vs A&M and were crushed at home 52-28. Dating back to his days at So Miss, NC HC Fedora is 5-2 SU/3-4 ATS in his opening games. While both teams had similar records last year SCar blew 3 double digit 4Q leads and could easily have been

10-3 while NCar's 7 losses were by 20.3 ppg so they deserved to be 6-7. NC does have the experience edge with 17 returning starters vs 12 but South Carolina has the stronger defense and we will take Spurrier over Fedora in an important game for both teams.

**UTAH by 16 over FIU** - FIU upset UCF in their first meeting in '11 and in '12 were +17 here and trailed 23-0 but still covered, losing 33-20. In their last meeting ('12) UCF dominated leading 38-0 with 3:04 left in the 3Q and winning by that score (-24) and that was on the road. UCF is 20-10 ATS at home but does have just 9 ret str's where FIU has 16. In the past 3 yrs, cch George O'Leary amassed a 12-0 record on Thursday night games. Knights are 7-1 in BHNS openers (7 str wins). UCF has a big trip to Stanford next week. FIU has a solid defense and is 4-1 as an AD with that lone loss by a half point.

**UTAH by 7 over Michigan** - These 2 have met 3 times recently. Each was in Ann Arbor and Utah is 3-0 ATS with 2 outright upsets. LY UM was -3' at home and had a 2' hr rain delay. UM never entered the RZ and only tied it at 10 with 5:01 left 2Q thanks to a 7 yd IR td. After that they had 135 ttl yds but still finished with a 308-286 yd edge (Utah 66 yd PR td) and UM had a 19-13 FD edge. Harbaugh was at Stanford from '07-'10 and Utah did not join the P12 until he left in '11 so he has not faced Whittingham. Harbaugh was just 5-9 ATS as an AD at Stanford. Michigan is 3-8 SU in non conf AG's. Utah is loaded with NFL caliber talent but did have 4 conf wins last year by 4 pts or less. Michigan is changing schemes and LY their D allowed 376 ypg on the road and 265 ypg at home. Utah will be sky high for this game and they have an added altitude advantage being home the entire month. We will call for the Utes by a TD and let the linesmaker decide who we like.

**Tcu by 14 over MINNESOTA** - LY TCU was -16' at home and held Minn to 126 yds below their ssn rush avg (99, 2.5). TCU led 24-0 at half and 30-0 in the 4Q in a 30-7 home win with a 427-268 yd edge. TCU is 7-3 SU in road openers with their wins by an avg of 19 ppg. TCU only has SF Austin on deck. Kill is 7-6 ATS as a HD and TCU is just 3-8 ATS as an AF. This is the Gophers best team yet under Kill and they have added speed on defense and an excellent secondary. They do have just 12 ret str's while the Frogs have 15 including QB Boykin. This will be closer than last year's game but the Frogs should still get the win by a couple of TD's.

**Duke by 3 over TULANE** - Two recent meetings. In '11 TLN was +27 at Duke and covered, losing 48-27. LY Duke was -17 at home again and this time TLN had a 28-23 FD edge with Duke having a slim 437-391 yd edge. Five TO's incl 2 IR td's helped Duke to a 47-13 win. Duke has not travelled here s/'64 (TLN won 17-0) and is 5-15 SU in road openers but Cutcliffe has them 4-2 SU in road openers. Cutcliffe is 2-1-1 ATS as an AF in his 8 yrs and while Curtis Johnson opened 8-2 ATS as a home dog he was 0-4 in that role LY. Duke only has NCCentral on deck but has just 12 ret str's while Tulane has 16. We like the misleading final from last year, the fact Tulane is more experienced and will be highly motivated for this home opener.

**Ohio by 6 over IDAHO** - ID has lost 4 str home openers SU, 3 vs MAC and 1 vs an FCS foe. LY ID went to Ohio (+13') and while they trailed 17-0, they pulled within 29-24 with 6:34 left. OU got a td with 2:09 left to win only by 12. OU's last trip here was 1972. The Bobcats are 7-2 SU vs SBC teams. Ohio has Solich's most experienced team ever with 18 ret str's and his next closest was 2006 and that team went 9-3 and got to the MAC title game. Ohio does have their home opener on deck vs a powerful Marshall squad that beat them last year. Idaho has just 12 ret str's but Petrino went the JUCO route and feels they have upgraded size and speed this year and it is his 3rd season. Idaho should be an under the radar team as they were 1-10 last year but only outgained by 45 ypg. They have hosted a pair of MAC teams under him and vs NIII & WMich squads that finished a combined 20-7 only lost by 10 & 12. We will side with the home dog here.

**ARIZONA by 31 over Utsa** - These 2 meet for a 3rd str yr. In '13 UTSA travelled here (+24') and lost 38-13. Three of their final 5 poss ended in AZ terr and they scored just 7 pts in gbg time for the final. LY UTSA was at home with a veteran team (+7) and almost pulled the upset. TY UTSA has just 5 ret str's making their first road start while AZ is coming off a bowl loss and now has a veteran QB for the first time under Rich Rod. Arizona does have the talent to turn this into a blowout and RR is 4-1 ATS as a favorite of 20+. Last year's close game will keep them from overlooking the Roadrunners. UTSA still figures to be a value play this year if they remain healthier as despite the inexperience they actually have a talent upgrade.

**Colorado by 10 over HAWAII** - LY CU was a Top Wkly LPS and were -8 at home and won 21-12. The key was CU holding UH to 4 fg's. CU did have a 405-286 yd edge and the Buffs led 21-6 at the half. UH is 6-3 in Aloha Stadium openers but on a 2-7 run vs FBS foes. Last time UH was -6' in '11 they lost 34-17. LY Colorado was -18' in their true road opener and escaped 41-38 which broke a streak of 9 str true road opening losses by 24 ppg. CU is 0-3 ATS as an AF the last 8 years although Chow is 5-8 ATS as a HD. Both teams fall into the much improved category as Hawaii has USC transfer Max Wittek (PS#8) at QB and 14 ret str's, while MacIntyre is in his 3rd year and has 16 ret str's including underrated QB Sefo Liufua. UH took both Washington and Ore St to the wire at home LY losing by 1 & 8.

**VANDERBILT by 7 over Wku** - Check out this week's system play for a strong reason to like Vanderbilt in this one. WKU is 1-13 SU in road openers, but is 11-5 ATS vs non-conf and does have explosive QB Brandon Doughty ret from their 8-5 Bahamas Bowl champ win. VU is 1-4 SU in home openers but 16-3 SU in non-conf games (3-6 ATS). It's an important game for Derek Mason's 2nd season after going 3-9 LY after having been to bowls 3 str yrs. If his team is to have any hope of a successful season they must win here and the SEC team is under a FG favorite at home! WKU did knock off #19 Marshall on the road LY as a 23' AD. Vandy has 18 ret str's compared to LY when in Mason's 1st year with new schemes they had just 10. No doubt WKU has the more explosive offense but their stats were compiled vs a light schedule while Vandy faced a rugged SEC slate of defenses. Both played ODU last year with WKU being outgained 601-643 and Vandy having a 524-336 yard edge. Vandy has the large edge on defense (#47 vs #113).

**Baylor by 38 over SMU** - BU and SMU used to be in the SWC until 1995 but have had 4 recent meetings, and BU is a perfect 4-0 SU and ATS. The margin gets bigger each year as BU won by 3 in '03, 5 in '05, 35 in '12 and LY BU was -34 at home and won 45-0. SMU is 6-3 SU in home openers but 4 came vs FCS teams. BU has won 11 in a row SU in this series and BU has not travelled here since '05 when they only won by 5. BU only has Lamar and a bye on deck and while Briles opened 3-6 as a AF he went 2-1-1 ATS LY. These schls are only 96 miles apart so you can expect a good amount of BU fans here for their top 5 team although this is the home debut for new HC Chad Morris. LY in the shutout SMU's longest drive covered just 27 yds w/their deepest penetration to the BU36. The L3Y Baylor is +27 ppg in HG and just +3 ppg in road games but with 18 ret str vs a team with a new head coach and schemes and a national TV audience they should roll. Last year SMU was 0-6 at home losing by an avg of 35 ppg.

**GEORGIA ST by 4 over Charlotte** - While GSt has won only 1 game since becoming an FBS member 3Y ago and that was LY when they got by FCS foe AB Christ (-4, 38-37), Charlotte just started playing football in '13 and is 9-10 in their history. This situation is really unique as Charlotte is from CUSA (stronger conf) but in their first year of FBS ball and GSt has shown how recent startups have fared when making the very quick move up. Georgia St is now in their 3rd year of FBS and has 17 ret str and add in a ton of JUCO's so now have 3 FBS recruiting classes. Charlotte has 17 ret str including a 1436 yd RB and 1373 yd WR and LY their 3 road losses were by 7, 3 & 7. Georgia St should win this HG but can you trust them in just their 2nd favorites role ever?

**Mich St by 13 WESTERN MICHIGAN** - MSU is 9-0 SU (last lost 1919) in this series but 3-2 ATS. Their last meeting in '13 MSU was -28 at home but it was 7-7 at half and MST only had a 297-204 yd edge in a 26-13 win. This is the first game in the 14 game series to take place at WM and Mich St is 2-5 SU in road openers and has a huge game vs Oregon on deck. Many of the WM players will be fired up for this, having not been recruited by MSU. WM is on a current ATS streak of 10-2 but while 8-3 ATS as an AD, they are just 1-4 ATS as a HD under Fleck. The Spartans have a large edge on defense and Spartan fans should make up a decent part of the crowd. Still WM has weapons in QB Terrell, RB Franklin and WR's Davis and Braverman to get in the back door if necessary when MST thoughts start to turn to Oregon in the 4Q.

**ILLINOIS by 17 over Kent St** - First meeting. While as HC of Toledo, Beckham beat Kent St 34-21 in '10 (-3' home). KSU is 1-14 SU vs the B10 and 2-24-1 SU in road openers with 7 str losses by 33 ppg. Each team has an FCS team on deck. IL is 4-7 ATS as a HF and KSt is 5-6 ATS as an AD under Haynes. IL does have the benefit of bowl practices for the first time since 2012 when they opened up vs W Mich at home and won 24-7 (-10). Golden Flashes are 2-24-1 in road openers incl 7 str losses by 33 ppg. Illinois has won 17 straight home openers by an average of 24 ppg and we will call for that streak to continue.

**BOISE STATE by 17 over Washington** - In '12 these two met in the bowl and we won with a 4★ on UW +5 and they covered with Boise winning 28-26 although UW had a 447-407 yd edge. The very next yr ('13) UW was -3' at home and we used a 4★ LPS on the Huskies and they destroyed #19 Boise, 38-6 with a 592-346 yd edge. Boise has won 13 str home openers by 33 ppg and this is the return of Chris Petersen to Boise where he had 8 remarkable years from '06-'13. Petersen went 48-2 as a HC on the blue surface. UW is 2-11 SU in home openers and keep in mind, many Boise players were recruited by Petersen and will play with a little extra incentive and the fans have been talking about this since Petersen left 2 years ago. Harsin was 4-1 ATS as a HF LY but won every single one of his HG's by DD with an avg score of 40-22. Now throw in the fact that Boise has 18 ret str and UW has just 8 and Boise always gets fired up for Power 5 teams and it will not be a happy homecoming for Petersen here with a young QB and O-line making their first road starts at night in a hostile environment.

**SEPT 5 (SAT)**

**Old Dominion by 6 over EASTERN MICHIGAN** - These 2 have only met once and that was LY. The real winner of the game was the weather as a torrential downpour limited both offenses as EM held ODU to 367 yds and Heineke to 17-30-187. ODU was clinging to a 10-3 lead when they got a 46 yd PR td with 7:43 left but ODU also fmbld at the EM14 and was SOD at the EM1 in the 2Q. EM is 10-6 SU in home openers but is just 11-21 as a HD and ODU has been an AF once in their history and won at Idaho (-14), 59-38 with a lot of late points. ODU is the stronger team but can't lay too many points as EM is a much improved team and will be fired up for their home opener.

**FLORIDA by 31 over New Mexico St** - NMSt last played UF here in '94 and the #1 Gators put up 70 pts. Since upsetting Minn in '11 (28-21, +20'), NMSt is 0-5 SU and ATS on the road vs P5 conf tms losing at UGA, 63-16 (+34'), at Auburn (42-7, +22'), at LSU 63-7 (+42'), at UCLA 59-13 (+42') and at Texas 56-7 (+3'). UF has won 25 in a row SU in ssn openers and actually has a bowl rematch vs E Carolina on deck. This is Jim McElwain's first HG in The Swamp and maybe he can reverse a trend that's seen the Gators go 5-13 ATS as a HF. NMSt is just 2-13-1 ATS as an AD. While the Gators should be pumped up, they are working in a new offensive system and this is a matchup of a top ten most experienced team (NMSt) vs one that ranks in the bottom 10 and we will take the points.

**TULSA by 7 over Florida Atlantic** - FAU is 1-9 SU in road openers with their 1 win by 1 pt (UAB in '10), their avg loss by 35 ppg. LY FAU was 0-7 SU on the road with their avg loss 36-14. LY the game was pick at FAU and FAU rolled to a 50-21 win. TU is 8-1 SU in home openers and in their first game for new HC Philip Montgomery. Even though the two teams were in CUSA thru '13, that was actually their first meeting. FAU did have two 1 point losses on the road last year (Wyoming, MTSt) and are in the 2nd year under HC Charlie Partridge while Tulsa has a brand new coaching staff.

**UCLA by 15 over Virginia** - Virginia nearly upset UCLA +20 at home (Big Dog POW) LY as they had a 286-258 yd edge and lost 28-20. UCLA had a 2Q def td with 27 and 37 IR's and a 75 yd PR td to lead 21-10 at the half. UVA was SOD at the LA17 with 3:20 left. UVA beat L'ville, Pitt and Miami FI at home LY with 2 of those upsets. UCLA is 15-2 SU in home openers and UVA has not won an AG since '12 dropping 10 straight. UCLA has 18 ret str but is breaking in a new QB. They only have UNLV on deck and will be focused after last years tougher than expected game. Virginia only has 11 ret str but did bring in some top notch transfers.

**Stanford by 13 over NORTHWESTERN** - These two high academic institutions last met in '94 (41-41 tie). NW had won 7 home openers in a row SU until LY's loss to another P12 tm (Cal). NW was 2-1 as a HD LY and even upset a similar style UW (big OL, solid D). David Shaw opened up 8-1 as an AF but is 3-6 ATS since. This is a dangerous NW team but it will have a young QB going against an excellent Stanford LB corps. We originally were thinking of this as a 7 to 10 point game but Power Plays has Stanford winning by 13 and we will agree with the PP computer.

**† Auburn by 7 over Louisville (Atlanta)** - These two last met in 1974. Incl bowls, AUB has played here in ATL 4 times going 3-1 SU but did lose the '12 opener to Clemson 26-19 (+2'). Auburn only has JAX St on deck. UL has just 9 ret str's but brings in some big time transfers including 2 Georgia DB's and LB Devonte Fields (Big 12 Def POY in '12). Louisville ended '14 getting whipped by Georgia in the bowl game 37-14 and only played one other ranked team LY and lost that one by 11. Auburn should have a much improved defense with Will Muschamp calling the shots and 8 starters back plus the return of DE Carl Lawson. The offense will be the normal potent Malzahn group with QB Johnson a better passer than Marshall was last year. Petrino is high on his defense and Auburn did lose 33 lettermen from '14 and we expect Louisville to keep this one closer than expected.

**NEBRASKA over BYU by 7** - First meeting. Riley and Mendenhall faced each other in '12 and Riley's Oregon St (+6) pulled the road upset, 42-24 over #10 BYU. This is Riley's first HG with the Huskers and they only have S Alabama on deck. BYU is 4-9 SU in road openers but 3 of the last 4 have been decided by 7 ttl pts and they did win on the road at Miss in '11. Nebraska has not lost a home opener since 1985! By the way, we had Florida St as a 3 Star Key Selection on these pages and a 4★ Late Phone play that year and they were +6 and won outright over the Huskers. Both teams are without a key offensive player as Nebraska does not have WR Pierson-EI for the start of the year and BYU RB Williams is OFY. Nebraska has option personnel and brings in a pass minded coaching staff. Nebraska has just 12 ret str and BYU has 13. Nebraska will be playing with a lot of enthusiasm and have 79% lett returning while BYU has just 63%.

**NC STATE by 28 over Troy** - This is the first game for new Troy HC Neal Brown who had been the OC at Kentucky, TTech and Troy in the last 6 years. Troy is 3-10 SU in road openers. NCSt did struggle with GSthrn from the SBC LY only winning 24-23 (trailed 17-3) but only has EKentucky on deck and does have the benefit of bowl practices and this being the 3rd year for their HC while it is Troy's first. With Jacoby Brisset back at QB their offense figures to be explosive and the Wolfpack have 15 ret str from their St Petersburg bowl win. Troy has 14 ret str and good talent at QB, RB and WR but LY lost their road games by an avg of 37-15. After a couple of close wins as a big favorite to open '14, Doeren who was 3-0 ATS as a 20+ fav at Nill, won his last 2 as a big favorite LY by an avg of 42-6.

**OKLAHOMA by 31 over Akron** - The Sooners are just 8-11 ATS as a HF and do have a big game at Tenn on deck but need to get the taste of that 40-6 bowl loss to Clemson out of their mouths. They figure to be an under the radar team this year and a solid value play much of the year as they finished #1 and #6 the last two seasons they came into a season not ranked in the top 10. They are switching their offense to more of the Texas Tech style pass attack after relying on RB Perine and the ground game last year. Akron was stronger than their 5-7 record last year and have 12 starters back and a lot of Power 5 transfers. They are a solid 8-4 ATS as an AD under Bowden despite being 11-25 SU in that span and did upset Pitt last year and they have Pitt in their home opener on deck. A couple of "Play On" teams this year and our number is right at the spread.

**† Tennessee by 14 over Bowling Green (Nashville)** - This is the first meeting between the two and is played at LP Field (Ten Titans, Music City bowl site). In their last gm vs the SEC, BG only lost to Florida 27-14 (+29). Butch Jones was a coach in the MAC from '07-'09 beating BG in his final year, 24-10. UT does have a large HG vs Okla on deck. BG did get steamrolled at Wisconsin last year but that was the first road start for a young QB who was forced into action when Matt Johnson was OFY in week one. Johnson is back and BG has 10 ret starters on offense and push the tempo. This is Baber's 2nd year and he loses just 14 lett. BG was also better than their final record LY as they clinched the MAC East and rested players in 2 losses. Tennessee is fully loaded this year with 18 ret str and went 4-1 down the stretch last year. The 4Q could be the key. Babers will be trying to score every possession and UT may start to look ahead to the huge game with the Sooners leaving the back door wide open.

**GEORGIA by 31 over Ulm** - These 2 have met 3 times and UGA has won by an avg of 47 ppg but they last met in '05. UGA does have a pair of SEC games on deck. ULM is 12-9 ATS as an AD and almost upset Auburn in '12 and only lost to A&M by 5 last year and ULM had a 347-243 yard edge. UGA is 1-3 ATS in openers. This is a dangerous game for Georgia in the fact they have a young QB and he is going up against a gambling blitzing defense much like Ohio St encountered vs VTech LY at home and they lost. That Ohio St team also had a young O-line while Georgia has a veteran group. ULM figures to keep this closer than expected.





# UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over 33 years this play has been a reader favorite. The last 16 years the Underdog Play of the Week has recorded numerous **OUTRIGHT UPSET WINNERS (52!)** to the incredible record **INCLUDING 4 in '13 incl 3 straight outright winners AND TWO in 2014!!!!** Here is TW's Underdog Play:

## ARIZONA ST (+) OVER TEXAS A&M

This game takes place in Houston. A&M figures to have a slight crowd edge. ASU is just 3-9 SU vs SEC teams and 1-6 SU in road openers. Arizona St had just 2 ret str on defense last year but this season have 9 str back and will be much stronger on that side of the ball. This is Todd Graham's best team yet and they were 10-3 last year and they were 4-2 vs ranked teams with one of the losses coming with their QB injured and out. A&M also figures to be a much improved team with John Chavis as the new DC and they have 8 starters back on that side including Myles Garrett. This is also an important game for the SEC and Pac 12. The Sun Devils are loaded this year and a legitimate national title contender and the better team is actually a dog here.

**FORECAST: Arizona St by 4 over Texas A&M**

**KENTUCKY over Louisiana by 17** - UK does great as a HF vs non-conf as they know the only way to a bowl is to take care of their games they should win and pull an upset or two. UK is now 8-1 ATS as a HF vs non conf teams and their avg cover is by 17 ppg. UL has now lost 4 str as a non-conf AD and have failed to cover by an avg of 11 ppg. Kentucky does have South Carolina, Florida and Missouri the next 3 weeks. ULL has just 12 ret str and lose their QB. Cats are the better team and take care of business in games like this and know they cannot overlook a team that has been to and won 4 consecutive bowl games.

**ARKANSAS by 35 over Utep** - LY UTEP gave up 5.24 ypc which is not good when taking on Ark's powerful running game. Ark has won both prior meetings ('89, '10) by an avg score of 49-14 and have won their last 8 home openers by an avg of 42 ppg. They only have Toledo on deck. UTEP has just 12 returning starters and their young QB is making his first road start. Ark's avg home score LY was 37-14 (+162 ypg) where they were 6-1 ATS at home. This may be reasonable at half but the Hogs huge Oline should wear down UTEP in the 2H and with RB Jonathan Williams OFY they will need to develop depth at backup RB so true frosh Rawleigh Williams may get some yards and scores late. Last year UTEP covered most of their games where they were able to control the line of scrimmage but lost those that they were not able to. What do you think happens here vs Arkansas' line?

**WEST VIRGINIA by 17 over Georgia Southern** - GS was 9-3 LY and did not make a bowl game. WV got off to a great start LY at 6-2 with a win over #4 Baylor and losses to #2 Alabama and #4 Oklahoma but then went 1-4 in their last 5 games. WV also has by far its best defense ever under Holgorson. GS upset Florida in '13 and only lost to NCSt and GaTech by 5 ttl pts LY on the road. GS did lose 4 starters off the offensive line (135 car sts) but do a good job of developing new ones. WV only has Liberty and a bye on deck so probably spent a good part of August concentrating on the option but have not faced one in years and GS's run game will shrink the clock. Georgia Southern has suspended their star QB Kevin Ellison for this game and that will make it tougher as this will be Favian Upshaw's 1st start.

**NOTRE DAME by 10 over Texas** - These 2 last met in '96 with #9 ND getting a 39 yd fg on the final play to beat #6 Texas, 27-24. ND is 8-2 all-time vs TX winning the last 4. LTH ND beat TX 55-27 despite both teams being ranked. ND did suffer some attrition to the defense in August but could very well be stronger than the 2012 version which made it to the national title game. Texas' defense kept them in plenty of games at halftime last year but they got rolled in a lot of 2H's and actually had 5 losses by 21 points or more. The D loses some key players but still should be top 15. Their offense has inexperience at WR and ?'s at QB and depth at RB. ND usually pays an extra price when they play and are just 18-31-3 ATS as a HF but that is reflected in this line. In that magical 2012 season they had home wins by 3, 7, 7, 3 and 3 so laying double digits gets a little iffy.

**FLORIDA ST by 35 over Texas St** - FSU is breaking in a new QB and the last 3 times they opened the season at home, they have won by an average of 54-3 although 2 of those were FCS foes. Texas St is 2-0 ATS vs ranked teams and only has Prairie View A&M on deck. They did lose at Texas Tech 33-7 two years ago. Florida St was a great under-achiever last year. This year they figure to have the type of hunger that propelled them to the national title in 2013. That Florida St team was a spread darling going 11-2-1 ATS on the season and winning their games by an avg of 51.6-12.1. Jimbo Fisher should be trying to recapture that attitude and that team beat Pitt by 28 in the opener on the road! They only have USF on deck, are off their first loss since 2012 and have a veteran QB in Everett Golson and some great true frosh and roll to an easy win.

**USC by 31 over Ark St** - First meeting. ASU is 2-4 ATS on the road vs Power 5 teams. USC is 4-2 ATS as a HF under Sark and beat Fresno St 52-13 in the opener LY (-20') even though
