KEY SELECTION

3★ New England over MIAMI - With their OT loss a week ago vs the Jets (outgained 428-284), the Pats (8-1 ATS off a SU loss) now find themselves needing a win to earn the #1 seed in the AFC for the 4th time in the past 6 ssn. They now head down South to take on a MIA squad that dropped their 5th gm in the past 6 wks (0-6 ATS) a wk ago vs IND despite a 361-268 yd edge and having the ball inside the 10 in the final seconds trailing by 6. In their previous meeting this ssn on Thur Night in NE, the Pats dominated from the start in the 29 pt win as they held MIA to just 7 pts and 270 tl yds. Backing the Dolphins (CS on QB Tannehill) in DIV contests doesn't appear to be a wise decision at this moment as they are on just a 4-14 ATS run vs AFC East foes. **FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 14**

OTHER SELECTION

2★ BUFFALO over NY Jets - After getting back into the win column a week ago against the Cowboys behind a nice performance from their ground game (236 yds) and defense (all'd just 6 pts, 14 FD's & 307 yds), BUF HC Rex Ryan welcomes his old team with the goal of earning the ssn sweep following their turnover-aided road victory earlier in the ssn (NYJ 318-280 yd edge, -4 TO's). The Jets meanwhile delivered their 5th consec win LW in OT over NE (428-284 yd edge) behind yet another big outing from QB Fitzpatrick (296 pass yds, 3 TD's). While the Jets are within reach of clinching a playoff spot with a win here, we expect Ryan and company to play spoiler here as they are an impressive 12-5-1 ATS vs their DIV opponents. **FORECAST: BUFFALO by 1**

OTHER PLAYS

CAROLINA by 10 over Tampa Bay - The Panthers 18-gm regular ssn winning streak came to a screeching halt a week ago in ATL as the Falcons had a 373-268 yd edge and held QB Newton under 200 yds of tll offense for just the 2nd time this ssn. They now play host to a scuffling Bucs squad that dropped their 3rd straight contest LW vs the Bears as HC Smith moved to 0-2 against his former team despite a 389-327 yardage edge (TB 3 TO's). In their previous meeting this ssn way back in Wk 4, CAR went into TB and came away with a 37-23 win thanks in part to 4 int's thrown by QB Winston (Bucs had 25-17 FD and 411-244 yd edges). While we feel pretty confident that the Panthers will get the outright victory this weekend with significant home edges TY in both points (32-18) and yardage (396-315), we'll let Vegas decide which way we lean as far as the spread is concerned.

CINCINNATI by 13 over Baltimore - The Ravens ended a 3-gm losing skid LW at home against the Steelers behind Ryan Mallett (274 pass yds, 1 TD) who became the 4th different QB to start for BAL in the past 6 gms (swept PIT for 1st time s/11). They now head to Cincy to take on a Bengals team that returns home following their MNF clash with Denver. In their previous meeting in BAL with a then healthy QB Flacco, RB Forsett and WR Smith, the Bengals were able to survive 28-24 (CIN led 14-0 at HT). With CIN posting a very solid 11-2-1 ATS mark this ssn and still able to improve their playoff positioning no matter what their outcome is against the Broncos, we'll lean with the home squad to get it done in this one.

ATLANTA by 7 over New Orleans - The Saints head to ATL fresh off of their relatively easy win over the Jags in the Superdome (led 24-0 in 2Q) behind a 412 yd, 3 TD performance from QB Brees. They now take on an ATL team that pulled out one the bigger upsets of the ssn LW at home against the undefeated Panthers as WR Jones posted a 9 catch, 178 yd outing while the defense held CAR to just 268 yds (106 yds under their ssn avg). In their previous meeting back in Wk 6, a 5-0 ATL team went into the Superdome and left with their 1st loss of the ssn thanks to a plethora of 1H miscues that saw them down by 7 at half despite a 242-169 yd edge. While the Falcons have endured quite the collapse as the year has wore on and were eliminated from the playoffs following MIN's win LW, keep in mind that they've actually outgained their opponents by +67 ypg TY at home. The Saints meanwhile continue to have no solution on their defensive side of the ball (#31 in tll defense, DEAD LAST in scoring defense) which doesn't bode well against an ATL squad that's not only searching for revenge from their early ssn loss, but for some much-needed momentum as they head into the offssn.

HOUSTON by 14 over Jacksonville - Despite being forced to use 4 different QB's for significant time throughout the ssn, the Texans enter their ssn finale with a game lead on the Colts atop the AFC South standings following their easy road victory in Nashville a week ago (3★ LP Winner) behind QB Weeden and his 200 yd, 3 tl TD outing (HOU ssn-high 34 pts). They now play host to a Jaguars team that suffered defeat in the Superdome LW against the Saints as they were unable to come back from an early 24-0 deficit (JAX outgained 537-412). In their prior meeting this ssn back in Wk 6, the Texans (trailing by 7) rattled off 3 TD's in a span of 3:25 (final TD came on 31-yd IR) to leave JAX with a 31-20 victory. With HOU now at home and riding a solid defense that has surrendered less than 300 yds in 6 of their past 8 contests, we expect them to get back into the playoffs for the 1st time in 3 years.

Pittsburgh by 17 over CLEVELAND - The Steelers suffered a costly defeat a week ago in BAL as a streaking offense that had surpassed the 30+ pts in 6 straight was held to just 17 pts on 303 yds. They now face a Browns team that they have clearly dominated over the past 15 ssn with a 26-4 SU mark (14 pt avg MOV) including an easy 30-9 victory in Heinz Field back in Wk 10, a game that a hobbled Roethlisberger came off the bench to throw for 379 yds and 3 TD's. CLE nearly delivered a shocking upset in KC a week ago against the Chiefs as they finished with a 368-258 yd edge (QB Manziel 136 pass, 108 rush) but ran out of time in KC territory as time expired trailing by 4. With the Browns on just a 2-6 ATS run and the Steelers needing a win and some help here to clinch a Wildcard spot in the AFC, we expect them to improve upon their already impressive 14-7-1 ATS mark inside of their DIV.

KANSAS CITY by 10 over Oakland - While the Chiefs earned their 9th consec win (7-2 ATS run) LW against the Browns (tied franchise record for most consec wins), it wasn't easy as CLE finished with a 368-258 yd edge and had the ball in KC territory as time expired. They now welcome a Raiders team that survived LW in OT against SD in potentially their final gm in OAK despite recording just 1 FD in the 3rd and 4th quarters combined (SD 343-281 yd edge). In their previous meeting this ssn in the "Black Hole", the Chiefs overcame a shaky 1st 3 quarters (trailed 20-14) by closing out the 4Q with 20 unanswered pts in the 34-20 win (KC outgained 361-232). While the Chiefs are back in the playoffs as they remain alive for the DIV title in the AFC West following the Broncos' recent skid.

INDIANAPOLIS by 10 over Tennessee - Must win situation for the Colts as they still sit at a game back in the AFC South standings following their 18-12 victory in MIA a wk ago (3★ LP Winner!). IND now plays host to a banged up Titans squad that's just 1 more loss away from clinching the #1 overall pick for next year's Draft following their massive home beatdown (257 tl yds of off, 4 TO's) at the hands of HOU LW as they were without the services of Mariota under center (bkp Mettenberger 27-51-234 w/a 1-1 ratio, now 0-9 SU in career as a starter). In their previous matchup this ssn (Wk 3) at TEN, the Colts (trailing 27-14 mid 4Q) were able to string together 3 TD's over a 4 minute span to leave with a 2 pt victory (TEN backdoor cover w/47 left, 2 pt conv failed). While IND is a very solid 11-4-2 ATS vs DIV foes and the Titans are just 7-21-2 in their role as a dog, it appears that the Colts' ssn will now be on the shoulders of 3rd string QB and former Titan Charlie Whitehurst (9-14-78 vs MIA) who was thrown into action once again for the inj'd Hasselbeck (left w/inj for 4th consec gm).

DALLAS by 4 over Washington - These 2 squads met less than a month ago on MNF in D.C. with the Cowboys getting the GW 54-yd FG w/09 remaining in a defensive slugfest. A lot has changed since that matchup however as DAL has dropped each of their past 3 contests including a 16-6 loss LW in BUF in QB Moore's 1st career start (13-31-186, 1 int). WAS meanwhile is on a 3-gm winning streak that includes their DIV-clinching win LW in Philly behind yet another strong showing from QB Cousins (365 yds, 4 TD). While DAL is a porous 2-8-1 ATS inside of their home venue, it's unclear

as of presstime about just how much action the WAS starters will see now that they've earned the #4 spot. While we'll give the Cowboys the edge for now, we'll also reserve the right to adjust our line once we get further details on the Redskins' plans.

Detroit by 3 over CHICAGO - While the beginning of the Lions ssn didn't go as expected with losses in 7 of their 1st 8 matchups, some changes on the coaching staff have seen them rattle off victories in 5 of the L7 including LW's 32-17 win over the 49ers, a game in which DET scored the final 17 pts (SF shutout in 2H). They now head to CHI to take on a Bears team that won for just the 2nd time in the past 6 gms LW in Tampa despite a 389-327 yd edge by the Bucs (TB 3 TO's). Ironically, the only win during DET's 1st 8 contests came against this very same Bears squad back in Wk 6, a game that saw the Lions connect on the GW 27-yd FG with 2:29 remaining in OT. The deciding factor in our decision to lean with DET in this one is CHI's surprising lack of success at home over their L10 matchups as they've come out victorious just once while going 2-8 ATS in that span.

Philadelphia by 1 over NY GIANTS - Both teams saw their playoff hopes dashed a week ago following the Eagles' 38-24 home loss to the Redskins on Sat night. The Giants and their #32 ranked defense suffered a fairly substantial beatdown at the hands of the Vikings LW as they were without the services of standout WR Beckham (NYG trailed 19-3 at HT). In their previous meeting in Philly on MNF in Oct, the Giants were able to jump out to a 7-0 lead before a slew of TO's and crucial penalties quickly turned the tide in favor of the Eagles (20 pt win, 425-247 yd edge). While the Giants do get the home edge in this one as they seek some revenge, it's tough for us to lean against the Eagles as a DIV AD where they've posted an impressive 14-3 ATS mark.

DENVER by 14 over San Diego - DEN is back at home for a 2nd consec week following their crucial MNF tilt against the Bengals. They now play host to a banged-up Chargers team that fell just short in their upset attempt LW in OAK (23-20 OT loss) despite a 343-281 yd edge. These two squads met less than a month ago in SD with DEN coming away with a 17-3 victory behind a splendid performance from their defense (#1 NFL) that allowed just 272 yds for the gm. With the Broncos' playoff picture still cloudy as of presstime with the Chiefs now just a half game back prior to their matchup with the Bengals, this could very well be must-win territory for DEN who has gone an impressive 17-6 ATS vs AFC West foes.

St Louis by 4 over SAN FRANCISCO - While the Rams are in the midst of a 3-game winning streak following their 1st victory in SEA s/2004, they have been outgained in each of their L2 including a 313-207 yd deficit a week ago. They now head back on the road for a 2nd consec weekend to close out their ssn against a 49ers squad that moved their current ATS run to just 6-15 following their defeat in DET vs the Lions (11 penalties for 2nd straight week, shutout 17-0 in 2H). In their previous meeting back in Wk 8 (final start by QB Kaepernick), the Rams jumped out to a 14 pt HT lead (27-6 victory, -7) while holding the SF offense to just 11 FD's and 189 tl yds for the game. While 3 of the 49ers' 4 wins have come at home, a porous 1-10 ATS run inside of the NFC West has us leaning with the visitor in this one.

Seattle at ARIZONA - The Seahawks head to the desert following just their 2nd defeat in their past 9 contests after being swept by the Rams on the ssn thanks to 3 TO's (SEA 313-207 yd edge). Ironically, their only loss prior to LW during that span came at home to this same Cardinals squad back in the middle of Nov as ARZ jumped out to a 22-7 HT lead (269-89 yd edge) and held off a late Seahawks charge to prevail by 7. The Cardinals (18-9 ATS run) clinched the #2 seed thanks in part to a monumental defense performance a week ago against the Packers as they recorded 4 TO's (2 ret'd for TD's), 9 sks and held GB to just 8 pts and 178 tl yds. With the results of the Panthers contest against TB playing a big part of how ARZ will handle this game (resting starters if CAR wins?), we'll pass on a projection for this matchup.

Minnesota at GREEN BAY - Flexed to SNF - After their solid 49-17 home victory on SNF over the Giants that saw them earn a playoff spot (forced 3 Manning int's), the Vikings head to Lambeau with revenge on their mind following a 30-13 loss to the Packers back in Wk 11 (MIN 342-320 yd edge). GB was dominated from the start a wk ago in ARZ as the Cardinals forced 4 TO's (2 ret for TD's), recorded 9 sks and held GB to 17 ppg and 167 ypg under their ssn averages.
