The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years. We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 21 years as well as the record from the last 5 years with grades ('09, '10 & '12-'15).

NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS.....GRADE: B

OFFENSE 374 ypg (#7) Patriots: +35.0 ypg (#8) DEFENSE 339 ypg (#9) SCORING 29.1 ppg (#3) +7 TO's +9.4 ppg (#3) SCORING 19.7 ppg (#10)

Offense: It appears that the Patriots will be a little shorthanded early on with Brady's suspension looming for the 1st 4 gms. They did address the QB position in the 3rd Rnd for depth during his absence while the FA additions of Washington and Bennett in the passing game are solid. More add-ons via the draft have this unit earning an even grade for '16. Grade: EVEN

Defense: While the Pats do part ways with a few starters from a season ago, the additions in both FA and the draft appear to balance it out. This group is on par compared to last year. Grade: EVEN

Overview: The Patriots' dominance against their mediocre AFC East opponents (79-23, .775 win percentage) since 2001 has helped them claim 13 division titles over the past 15 seasons. The schedule gets more difficult than last year as NE draws both the AFC North and NFC West (4 combined playoff teams) along with fellow AFC division champs DEN and HOU.

MIAMI DOLPHINS.....GRADE: C

OFFENSE 332 ypg (#26) Dolphins: -44.5 ypg (#27) DEFENSE 376 ypg (#25) SCORING 19.4 ppg (#27) -2 TO's -4.9 ppg (#27) SCORING 24.3 ppg (#19)

Offense: While the loss of RB Miller is substantial, MIA does have plenty of offensive talent coming from the draft including 3rd Rnd DC RB Drake and 1st Rnd OL Tunsil. With just 2 other starters departing in FA, MIA could surpass LY's lower than expected numbers. Grade: EVEN

Defense: There are plenty of big names coming and going on the MIA defense this season via FA. With many of the additions having proven track records at their prior stops, the Dolphins' defensive unit should also be near their numbers from a season ago. Grade: EVEN

Overview: There are plenty of new faces on both the coaching staff and the roster this season as Adam Gase enters his rookie campaign. The schedule features a brutal beginning to the season as MIA heads on the road to take on SEA, NE and CIN over the first 4 wks (34-14 combined record in '15) and a 4-gm tilt w/ARZ and all 3 AFC East foes to close out the year. This once highly productive franchise will miss the postseason for an 8th consecutive year.

NEW YORK JETS.....GRADE: B-

OFFENSE 370 ypg (#10) Jets: +51.7 ypg (#4) DEFENSE 319 ypg (#4) SCORING 24.2 ppg (#11) +6 TO's +4.6 ppg (#8) SCORING 19.6 ppg (#9)

Offense: While RB Ivory moves on in FA and OL Ferguson opted to retire, the Jets made some solid moves in the offseason to fill those holes with Forte taking over at RB and Clady coming in to handle the OT duties. Assuming that Fitzpatrick does return to the tm (hasn't as of presstime), the Jets will be close to LY's fine production. Grade: EVEN

Defense: The Jets lose a quartet of starters on the defensive side of the ball for 2016. While they add a pair of starters on an already solid DL, the additions of 1st Rnd DC Lee and 3rd Rounder Jenkins will be key for them to stay within the Top 10 of the defensive rankings. Grade: EVEN

Overview: The Jets head into '16 with some confidence following LY's 10-6 ssn under 1st year HC Bowles. The biggest issue they may be facing however is a tumultuous sked to start the yr as they will likely find themselves as a dog in each of the first 6 wks (face 5 playoff tms from '15 as well as a trip to BUF). With that being said, Bowles & company should have enough fight to get through the early trials and tribulations & push for a playoff spot.

BUFFALO BILLS.....GRADE: B-

OFFENSE 361 ypg (#13) Bills: +4.5 ypg (#14) DEFENSE 356 ypg (#19) SCORING 23.7 ppg (#12) +6 TO's +1.3 ppg (#13) SCORING 22.4 ppg (#15)

Offense: The Bills got much more than they expected out of QB Taylor a ssn ago. That should be a substantial bonus for the tm as they head into '16. The additions and subtractions via FA and the draft won't effect the overall offense either way this season. Grade: EVEN

Defense: While BUF does part ways with DE Williams after he failed to fit into Ryan's defensive schemes, their overall additions in the draft (Top 3 picks made on defense by BUF) should have them challenging LY's lower than expected numbers. Grade: EVEN

Overview: After a fairly aggressive and expensive offseason in '15 that saw BUF post just an 8-8 record, things were a bit quieter in Orchard Park heading into '16. The sked is obviously tougher with the AFC North & NFC West replacing the AFC South & NFC East of a yr ago. While Ryan does have some previous history of leading teams to the playoffs (AFC Championship gms in '09 & '10 with the Jets), his overall record since has been mediocre to say the least (54-58 career record).
