KEY SELECTIONS 4★ Lsu over Wisconsin († Green Bay) - These two met in the 2014 opener in NRG-Stadium in Houston and Wisconsin dominated the F/3Q's of play but their D-line and RB Gordon suffered some attrition and LSU was able to rally with a strong 4Q from a 24-13 deficit to pull out a 28-24 (-5) win. This is being played in Green Bay, Wisconsin so it is far from a neutral site and many of the Badgers have dreamed of playing in Lambeau. LSU has a large advantage of DC Dave Aranda coming over from Wisconsin as he knows the Badgers personnel inside and out. Both teams have top ten defenses but LSU rates a large edge on offense. Wisconsin has been winning 10 games per year due to a softer schedule and LSU is a legitimate National Title contender.

FORECAST: Lsu by 17 3★ Boston College (+) over Georgia Tech († Ireland) - Second time BC will play in Ireland. The first time was vs Army November 1988 in the Emerald Isle Classic. In that visit, BC earned a 38-24 victory at Lansdowne Road Stadium. BC & GT have played each other 8 times, with Tech winning 6 of them. These two last met in 2012 with GT winning 37-17 at home (-14). This is the Yellow Jackets first ever game played overseas (Ireland) in Aviva Stadium, a 49,000 seat venue. Both teams were 3-9 last year and GT has just 11 returning starters while BC has 15. BC has had extra time to work on the option in August. Only once the last 8 years has GT opened the season vs an FBS school and they were held to 17 points in that game. BC had the nation's top rush D last year allowing just 83 ypg and 2.4 ypc and has 7 starters back on D. GT has a large offensive edge (#48 vs #111) but has just 5 starters back on D and BC has the edge on that side (#7 vs #51). We will call for BC to pull the upset. FORECAST: Boston College by 4 3★ Oklahoma over HOUSTON - This game is being played in NRGStadium in Houston. The Sooners are 15-3 SU in their road openers and UH will have their attention after beating Florida St in the bowl game. UH has just 11 returning starters while OU has just 13. Stoops is on a 6-2 ATS run as an AF. Tom Herman may be the hottest non Power 5 coach in the country and did a great job getting Houston to 13-1 and #8 in the final poll. Their two biggest wins were against teams they had the situational edge. Louisville was off a huge opener vs Auburn with Clemson on deck. They were a large underdog in the bowl vs Florida St and played their A+ game while FSU played a B or C game and got their QB injured in the 1Q. That success will have Oklahoma fully focused for this and there should be very little crowd edge for Houston as OU travels well. The Sooners are more talented and deeper and fully focused, they get the win.

FORECAST: Oklahoma by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Missouri (+) over WEST VIRGINIA - These 2 last met in 1998. WV is 16-1 SU in home openers with 12 straight wins by 30 ppg. MO is 9-2 SU in road openers. The last Missouri HC to have a debut winning season was Warren Powers back in 1978. WV QB Skyler Howard was poor most of 2015 but exploded for 532 pass yards in the bowl. Missouri QB Lock hit 21-28 in his first start but just 44% after that and averaged 138 ypg in his 7 starts (3-7 ratio). Both figure to be improved this year but WV has a good sized edge on offense. Missouri has the edge on defense (#12 vs #41). Missouri is 12-5 ATS as an AD while Holgorson is 9-15 ATS as a HF. We will take the points with the **FORECAST: WEST VIRGINIA by 4** SEC Dog that has the defensive edge.

2★ UL LAFAYETTE (+) over Boise St - These two met in 2014 and UL was on their 2nd straight road trip coming off a trip to #14 Ole Miss & trailed 31-3 into the 4Q. UL had 2 scoring drives & outside of that had just 91 yards on 39 plays. UL has won 8 straight home openers but the last 5 have been vs FCS foes. The average Sept temps in Boise are 65° and in Lafayette 80° with much more humidity. Hudspeth is 2-0 ATS as a HD (just twice in 5Y!) and Boise is 29-14 ATS as an AF. Last year Boise won at UVA by 42, Colorado St by 31, UNLV by 28 and SJSt by 17 and also away from home destroyed NIU 55-7. UL lost at home to Akron by 21 last year and to Troy by 24. While both teams are stronger this year look for UL to keep this one within 2 td's.

FORECAST: Boise St by 13

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY 9/1

Indiana by 10 over FIU - Last year was the first meeting. Indiana was -7 at home. FIU led 22-19 early 4Q. Down 7, FIU was at the IU 4 yd line when on 1&gl were int'd and returned 96 yds for a td with 3:58 to go. IU has not traveled to the Sunshine state since 1966. FIU hosted Power 5 teams Pitt and L'ville in 2014 losing by 17 and 31 (1-1 ATS). IU did have the benefit of bowl practices. Kevin Wilson is just 6-20 SU on the road but 3-2 ATS as an AF. Ron Turner is 6-8 ATS as a HD and 7-12 SU at home. The defenses are close. FIU does have the veteran QB in Alex McGough but Indiana still rates a large edge on offense. They avg 504 ypg playing in the Big Ten and FIU just 348 ypg playing weaker foes.

LOUISVILLE by 27 over Charlotte - This is the first all-time meeting. Petrino is 35-17-1 ATS as a home fav in his career. Charlotte has faced just one Power team and they lost to Kentucky 58-10 last year (+24) allowing 415 rush yds. This is a greatly upgraded Charlotte team with Miami, Florida transfer QB Kevin Olsen and Syracuse transfer RB Robert Washington, who was going to be given the #44 jersey for the Orange. The Cardinals do have a pair of ACC games on deck and may let up some in the 4Q. We will take the generous points with an under the radar Charlotte team here.

WAKE FOREST by 14 over Tulane - These two last met in 1995. Both teams were 3-9 last year but Wake Forest is in the 3rd year under Dave Clawson while Tulane has a brand new HC and are travelling in the opener. WF has 16 returning starters and Tulane has 13. Tulane is 3-7 in road openers SU and 0-9 SU vs current Power 5 schools. WF is 12-3 SU in home openers. WF has a large defensive edge (#41 vs #102). WF is 35-29 at home the last 10 years while Tulane is just 11-48 on the road. Clawson does have just 4 wins vs FBS foes here at WF and each has been by exactly 3 ppg but Tulane was

outscored on the road last year by avg of 44-17. Tulane is installing the option which may take some time to get rolling (usually hit stride in 2H of year) while WF shut down Army last year holding them to 11 FD and 240 total yds. We like WF to win the game but they have not been a DD favorite vs an FBS team since 2009.

WKU by 14 over Rice - Rice is just 5-19 SU in road openers with their 5 wins by 4 ppg. Last year these two met for the first time. WKU was -7' on the road but had no troubles winning 49-10 leading 35-10 at half with a 401-261 yd edge. Last year's WKU team had 16 returning starters including QB Doughty while Rice was very inexperienced with 9 starters back. This year WKU loses Doughty and has just 12 returning starters while Rice has 16. The last time Rice opened the season with a CUSA game was in '09 when they lost to UAB 44-24. Rice had been 6-1 ATS in 2012 and 2013 as an AD but are 2-5-1 ATS in that role the last 2 years. Brohm is 7-3 ATS as a HF.

VANDERBILT by 7 over South Carolina - SC is 21-4 all-time and have won the last 7 SU by an avg of 11 ppg. They opened up here in '12 on a Thursday night and South Carolina barely escaped with a 17-13 win. VU is 3-1 ATS the last 4. SC only won 48-34 (-21') their last trip here. Last year Vandy led 10-6 in the 3Q and were just a 1' point road dog but SC got a 78 yd td pass and VU's final 4 drives ended on 2 int's, a fumble and SOD. Vanderbilt is in the 3rd year under coach Mason and made major strides on defense last year improving from allowing 33.3 ppg to just 21.0. They have one of the top LB corps in the country. South Carolina has just 10 returning starters and loses 26 lettermen (Vandy loses just 15) and have a new head coach and are learning new schemes. Vandy has a large edge on defense and is 11-10 at home the L3Y while SCar is 2-8 SU on the road the last 2 years.

MINNESOTA by 14 over Oregon St - Gary Anderson was 2-0 SU vs the Gophers but 0-2 ATS. These two teams last met in '81. Minnesota only has Indiana St and a bye on deck while OSU has an awkward bye in the 2nd week. Oregon St's 2 most recent trips to B10 country they lost 35-0 to UW +20' in '11 and 35-7 to Michigan last year +14'. We used UM as a 4★ LPS winner in that one. UM is 10-6 ATS as a HF while OSU is on a 2-7 ATS run as an AD. UM coach Claeys feels this is the best team since he arrived at UM (6th year) and they are installing a new offense brought over from ULL with new OC Jay Johnson. Oregon St will be much improved in Anderson's second year and have a new QB in Darell Garretson who was impressive in the spring and started 11 games for Utah St. Minny has a slight edge on offense but a large edge on D (#47 vs #102), has the home edge (OSU rare trip to Midwest and allowed 562 ypg on road LY) and the angles support the Gophers.

TENNESSEE by 21 over Appalachian St - This is the first all-time meeting. Appalachian St lost to Clemson by 31 (+19), Michigan by 38 (+32) and Georgia by 39 (+40) in the last 3 years. UT does have the much anticipated game in Bristol vs Virginia Tech on deck in front of the largest crowd in College Football history (roughly 150,000) so there may be some look ahead. Appalachian St is 4-3-1 ATS as an away dog. Appalachian St is on a 17-2 SU run and has 15 returning starters including QB Lamb and RB Cox who are both 1st Team Sun Belt. Tennessee is the most experienced Power 5 team in the country (17 returning starters) but are just 8-14 ATS as a home favorite. The Vols did handle eventual MAC champ Bowling Green 59-30 in the opener last year and in the 2014 opener beat an eventual 10 win Utah St team 38-7. We will call for the Vols to win by 3 TD's with that big game on deck.

FRIDAY 9/2

GEORGIA ST by 3 over Ball St - Last year was their first meeting. Ball St was -13 at home and led 10-7 early 2Q but GSt scored 17 straight points. GSt had come in just 1-4 SU. This was a game that would spur them to a bowl. Trailing by 5, Ball St punted twice and was intercepted at their own 44 on their final 3 drives. GSt had a 445-372 yd edge as Nick Arbuckle hit 28-39-412 yds. BSt is just 2-18 SU in true road openers losing their last 7 by 17 ppg including a trip to N Texas in '13 where they were -3 and lost by 7. Most of the other road openers were vs Power 5 teams. Georgia St has 16 returning starters but does lose Arbuckle. They did benefit from bowl practices which Ball St has not had for two years. Ball St has 15 returning starters but has a new head coach. Georgia St has very little home field edge at just 3-16 SU under Miles. Ball St does have the edge at QB experience and Special Teams (#23 vs #127).

TEMPLE by 10 over Army - TU has won 6 in a row in this series by 21 ppg. They last met in 2013. Temple is 6-0 SU/ATS in this series and their avg cover has been by 14.5 ppg. In 2013 Temple was pick 'em at home and won 33-14 despite only having a 368-338 vd edge. Army is 3-25 SU in road openers. This is a veteran Army group with 16 returning starters while TU has just 12. Temple has never gone to bowl games in B2B seasons in their history and the last time they were off a bowl game they went 4-7. Army had been 1-12 ATS as an AD but were 3-0-2 ATS last year. Army did lose at Connecticut by just 5, Penn St by 6 and Rice by 7 as well as Navy by 4, however, Temple as a DD favorite last year won their games by 39, 14 and 24. Temple had extra time to prep for the option and Army is just 2-11 ATS in season openers with that disadvantage.

† Colorado by 13 over Colorado St (Denver) - Colorado is 6-2 SU here in Denver with their average win by 13 ppg and average loss by 10 ppg. Last year CSU led 14-0 into the 2Q but CU rallied for the 27-24 (-3) win. This year CSU has just 10 returning starters and CU has 18. A big question in the spring was would QB Sefo Liufau be ready for the season and he is still a ? for the opener. The offenses are close but the Buffs have a big edge on defense (#50 vs #96). Colorado has not been to a bowl since 2007 and this is a pivotal game. There have been 5 outright upsets the last 7 years in the series and the dog is 13-6-1 ATS. We will side with the more talented team that only has Idaho St on deck.

STANFORD by 14 over Kansas St - First meeting. Stanford has won 8 straight home openers by 27 ppg. Snyder is 20-8 ATS as an AD including 10 outright upsets. Kansas St does have just 10 returning starters and the last time they opened the season vs an FBS foe was back in 2010 when they beat UCLA 31-22 at home. Stanford finished 2015 as #3 AP and returns a Heisman favorite in RB Christian McCaffrey. Their defense goes from 3 returning starters to 6. They have large edges on offense (#22 vs #94) and defense (#11 vs #49). Both teams have elite Special Teams. Stanford is 9-4 ATS as a home fav and has a bye on deck but are 0-3 ATS in openers vs FBS schools losing to Northwestern last year. We will call for the Cardinal to win by 14 and let the linesmaker decide who we like.

ARKANSAS ST by 4 overToledo - Toledo has dominated their 2 recent meetings winning their 2014 bowl game 63-44 and last year at home whipped Arkansas St 37-7 (-7). Last year ASU was w/o QB Freddie Kitchen and Toledo led 24-0 early with ASU's only score a 92 yd KR td. Toledo had a 477-209 yd edge and 29-11 FD edge. ASU is 10-1 SU in home openers but only lost last year to Missouri. ASU has the biggest difference in home and away records of any FBS team going 44-12 SU at home and just 23-41 SU on the road. With road trips to Auburn and Utah St on deck Arkansas St needs a win here for 3rd year HC Andersen and added 4 key Power 5 grad transfers. Toledo has a slight edge on offense and defense but ASU on Special Teams and the home edge plus this is Candles first game as a HC.

SATURDAY SEPT 3

MICHIGAN by 38 over Hawaii - Michigan is 2-0 in this series with both wins on the Islands and they last met in 1998. Last year UH faced 2 Power 5 teams on the road getting shutout by both Ohio St 38-0 and UW 28-0. UM, meanwhile, had 3 consecutive shutouts at one point last year and allowed just 4.6 ppg in 3 non-conf HG's. Hawaii has a new HC in Rolovich and had their most productive offenses in the last 8 years in the two he was OC. They avg just 17.6 ppg on offense but will be more potent with a veteran QB and RB Paul Harris. Hawaii only lost by 38 at #1 Ohio St and 28 at Wisconsin last year and should stay within the inflated number.

IOWA by 28 over Miami, Ohio - These teams last met in '03. Miami is 8-4 ATS as an AD the last 2 years. Last year Miami lost to UW 58-0 on the road. Miami lost their other non-conf road game 56-14 but in Martin's first year, they only lost to Michigan by 24 and Cincinnati by 7. Iowa traditionally struggles early in the year and is just 8-17 ATS as a HF. In the first 3 games of the year lowa has been favored by an average of 9 points the last 14 games yet the average score has been 25.6-20.6 (5-9 ATS, 4 outright upsets). Miami's QB's, top 5 RB's, a TE and 2 starting OL were all frosh last year and they should be much more potent but did only avg 17.9 ppg in 2015 and lowa has 8 returning starters on defense and a top 20 defense overall.

NORTHWESTERN by 3 over Western Michigan - These two have met once and that was in 2013 when NW (-28') won 38-17 vs a Western Michigan team that finished 1-11. This WMich squad is far superior to that getting to bowls each of the last 2 years. Northwestern is 8-1 SU in home openers and upset #21 Stanford last year. They do only have Illinois St on deck. PJ Fleck is an outstanding 8-2 ATS as an AD. Meanwhile, Fitzgerald is just 13-24 as a HF making this the TECHNICAL PLAY of the week! WMich has 14 returning starters including their QB Zach Terrell and 2 RB's that have topped 1,000 yds in a season. WR Corey Davis will be an NFL draft pick. WM has the edge on offense (#25 vs #86). NW has the edge on defense (#17 vs #81) as they have 6 starters back on D and gave up 44.2 ppg in road games vs Power 5 teams the L2Y. Lou Holtz is being inducted into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame and will be recognized at the half and his son is head coach of the opponent. Projected starting QB Ryan Higgens is suspended for LT so the starter will either be rFr J'Mar Smith or soph Price Wilson.

FLORIDA by 35 over Massachusetts - UF has now won 26 straight season openers. Expectations were low for Florida and last year they jumped out of the box with a 61-13 (-35.5) win over NMSt. UMass lost by 34 to Colorado and 35 to ND last year on the road and to Penn St by 41 in 2014. This is the first meeting for these two and Massach from a defense that allowed just 319 ypg.

OHIO ST by 28 over Bowling Green - BG has a brand new HC and while OSU has just 6 returning starters, Bowling Green only has 10. Last year's OSU team was just 1-6 ATS as a home fav but were laying large numbers as the consensus #1 preseason team and defending national champ. BG lost to Tennessee by 29 but upset MD on the road and beat Purdue by 7 and in '14 they beat Indiana by 3 and were crushed by Wisconsin by 51 with UW being the only ranked Power 5 foe the L3Y. BG also loses QB Matt Johnson and top RB Travis Green and are #68 on my experience chart and making their first road trip. Ohio St will want to get their inexperienced players up to speed quickly with Oklahoma in just 2 weeks.

PENN ST by 21 over Kent St - Penn St is 4-0 in this series including B2B shutouts in '10 and '13. In '13 PSU was -21' at home and won 34-0. PSU does have a renewal of their series vs Pittsburgh next week. The Lions are 7-4 ATS as a HF under Franklin while Haynes is 4-7 ATS as an AD and lost at Illinois last year 52-3 but did almost upset Minnesota only losing 10-7. In 2014 vs Power 5 teams Kent St lost 66-0 to Ohio St and 45-13 to Virginia so they are 4-7 ATS. Kent St has 18 returning starters but PSU has 14. On the road last year Kent St avg just 5.33 ppg and Penn State has one of the best LB units in the country. Penn St is switching to an Oregon style offense with a mobile QB. Kent St is the 12th most experienced team in the country and Penn St is #81.

UTEP by 12 over New Mexico St - The Miners were in a bowl game in 2014 but lost their star player RB Aaron Jones in the opener last year and slipped to 5-7. This year they go from 10 returning starters to 13 and get Jones back. NMSt closed out last year winning 3 of their last 5 and have 13 returning starters and add in TCU transfer Tyler Matthews at QB. They have a star RB of their own in Larry Rose. The home team is 13-6 SU in this "I-10 rivalry" but 2-7-2 ATS. UTEP has now won 7 in a row SU in the series (5-0-2 ATS) but last year on the road trailed 44-30 with 4:07 left and got a TD w/:42 left to force OT and won it there. Kugler is 5-2-1 ATS as a HF. Martin was 1-9 ATS as an AD his first 2 years at NMSt but was 4-2 ATS in '15. RB Larry Rose is injured and might not play for NMSt and that would be a big blow to the Aggies chances.

Smu by 4 over NORTH TEXAS - SMU lost their road games in 2015 by an avg of 29 ppg with their closest loss being 19. The HT is a perfect 7-0 SU in this series and have won the last 3 by 21.8 ppg. SMU travelled here in 2014 and was +2' and were destroyed 43-6 with their only score coming on a final play, 33 yd td pass. Last year North Texas led 13-10 after 3Q's but SMU (-5') took advantage of 2 TO's and won 31-13. North Texas is 3-1 their last 4 home openers winning by 33 ppg which includes that SMU game in '14. NT has a new HC and 14 returning starters while SMU has a 2nd yr HC and 16 returning starters. SMU is 1-2 ATS as an AF the last 4 years. North Texas is 4-2 ATS as a home dog.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 31 over South Alabama -These 2 last met in 2014 which was a big home sellout for South Alabama but loaded with Miss St fans. Miss St led 28-3 at half with a 283-168 yd edge. In their meeting here in 2012 Miss St won 38-10 (-34). SA is just 2-8 ATS as an away dog. Mullen usually takes care of business vs weaker foes and is 15-8 ATS as a home fav. He has a new QB and needs to give him confidence with an SEC game on deck vs South Carolina. Miss St is 4-0 ATS in home openers.

OHIO by 24 over Texas St - First meeting. OU is 8-3 SU vs the SBC but lost their last meeting in the 2015 Camillia Bowl to Appalachian St by 2. Ohio is 11-2 SU in Peden Stadium openers including 6 straight wins by 18+ and are 6-2 ATS as a HF. Texas St has just 10 returning starters and a 1st year HC. They were 0-6 as an AD last year with avg road loss by 30 points being outgained by 218 ypg. They lost to UL Lafayette by 22 which was their 2nd closest road game with the closest being a 7 point loss to 4-8 Idaho. Ohio does have a winnable game vs a Power 5 team (Kansas) on deck but flex their muscles early (6-0 start last year).

KENTUCKY by 6 over Southern Miss These 2 last met in 1986. Kentucky has won 10 straight home openers by 29 ppg and in Stoops first 2 years they took care of business vs non-conf foes going 6-1-1 but last year were actually 1-3 ATS. Southern Miss lost their HC just prior to the signing day and had the latest hire for a HC. They were 7-4 ATS as an AD under Monken. Last year they lost to SEC member Mississippi St by 18 (+21). SM does have the benefit of bowl practices. Southern Miss does have the solid edge in the fact its new OC is Shannon Dawson who was OC for Kentucky last year and knows the team inside and out and he was fired so may have an axe to grind. UK does have Florida on deck but has won the last 10 games SU that they have been favored in. Kentucky is an SEC team at home vs a CUSA team that lost its coach.

ARKANŚAS by 24 over Louisiana Tech - These two last met in 1997. Louisiana Tech is 6-1 as an AD under Skip Holtz but did lose to Oklahoma by 32, Auburn by 28 and Mississippi St by 25. Tech does have a young QB making his first road start and their 9 returning starters is among the fewest in the country. The Hogs have a big game at TCU on deck while Louisiana Tech only has an FCS foe. The Hogs defense may be comparable to their 2014 version which allowed just 8.6 ppg in Fayetteville (6 games). Louisiana Tech has just 3 starters back on D and gave up 44.2 ppg in road games vs Power 5 teams the L2Y. Lou Holtz is being inducted into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame and will be recognized at the half and his son is head coach of the opponent. Projected starting QB Ryan Higgens is suspended for LT so the starter will either be rFr J'Mar Smith or soph Price Wilson.

FLORIDA by 35 over Massachusetts - UF has now won 26 straight season openers. Expectations were low for Florida and last year they jumped out of the box with a 61-13 (-35.5) win over NMSt. UMass lost by 34 to Colorado and 35 to ND last year on the road and to Penn St by 41 in 2014. This is the first meeting for these two and Massachusetts after being one of the most experienced teams in the country last year with 19 returning starters has just 9 back this season. The Gators are just 4-13 ATS as a HF but Massachusetts was 1-4 as an away dog last year. Florida had a very poor finish to 2015 losing their last 3 by a an avg of 32-8. They have 12 returning starters and need to give their young QB some confidence. The Gators have the edge on offense and have massive edges on D (#10 vs #112) and ST's (#8 vs #70).

Clemson by 3 over AUBURN - In their last meeting in the Georgia Dome (2012), Auburn led 19-16 with 12:50 left in the 4Q. CU went 75/10 for a td w/9:17 left. CU's last game was vs Auburn's main rival, Alabama. CU has not traveled here since '10, a game they led 17-3 at the half but lost in OT 27-24. Clemson has 8 returning starters on offense including Heisman frontrunner QB Watson and they put up 550 yards on Alabama's #1 defense in their last game. Auburn figures to be a much improved team this year now that they have a mobile QB again in John Franklin (St'g QB still not named). Clemson has a large edge on offense (#2 vs #54) but the D's are close and Auburn has the edge on ST's (#6 vs #77) and the home edge. Even in LY's run to the title game Clemson had 4 wins by just 4.5 ppg including 2 and 3 pt wins at home and this one is on the road.

TEXAS +4' over Notre Dame

Sunday Night. Last year these two met for the first time in nearly 20 years and it wasn't much of a contest. In the season opener for both teams, Notre Dame (-9) had 30-8 FD & 527-163 yd edges and won 38-3. Notre Dame is actually 9-2 all-time vs Texas winning 5 in a row SU but the Irish are just 5-14 SU in their first true away game. From '07-'09 Texas was 18-1 SU at home but since then are just 20-17 SU and 14-21-2 ATS. ND is just 4-9 ATS as an AF. Texas has a much improved team this year and ND has an ongoing QB battle and we saw what that did to Ohio State last year. Notre Dame has an inexperienced WR corps vs a veteran secondary which should allow UT to stack the box. Texas is a live home dog and our Underdog Play of the Week. FORECAST: TEXAS by 3

Ucla by 1 over TEXAS A&M - This is a key game for the Pac 12 and SEC for bragging rights for 2016. A&M should have the heat advantage and are playing before the 12th man at home but are just 3-11 ATS at home. Mora was 5-2 ATS as an AD with 4 outright upsets his first 2 years but last year dropped both in that role by 15.5 ppg ATS. The Bruins are switching from the spread to a pro style attack and have one of the nation's top QB's in Josh Rosen. They do have just 2 starters back on the O-line but do get back C Quessenberry (19 career starts) and they need him versus the DL Combo of Daeshon Hall and Myles Garrett. UCLA should have one of the most improved defenses in the country. A&M's new OC Noel Mazzone was the UCLA OC last year so he knows the personnel well. A&M waxed Arizona St in their opener last year but the Bruins rate the overall edge and pull the upset.

TULSA by 5 over San Jose St - These two last met in 2004 when they were both members of the WAC. Tulsa is 9-1 SU in home openers but just 2-8 ATS as a HF. SJSt is just 1-9 ATS as an AD. Both teams finished 6-7 last year and made it to a bowl but SJSt was invited despite being just 5-7. SJSt has dropped 13 str road openers by 34 ppg. Both have 15 returning starters. The Spartans do have to replace RB Tyler Ervin and 2 of their top 3 receivers but have a veteran O-line and QB. Tulsa has the edge on offense, San Jose has the edge on defense and the special teams are even. Tulsa does have Ohio St on deck. While Tulsa is just 2-4 ATS as a HF the last 2 years they have won 5 of those SU by an average of 9 ppg. The temps figure to be about 15 degrees hotter than the Spartans are used to.

WASHINGTON by 32 over Rutgers - This is the first meeting. RU is 6-5 SU in road openers but 4 of the 5 losses have come by a total of 8 points. The last time Rutgers started a season in Seattle was in 2014 when they upset P12 foe Wash St. UW is 25-5 SU in home openers and the last time they played a Power 5 school in that role was in '10 when they beat Syracuse 41-20. UW has won 11 straight hosting non-conf foes and only has Idaho and Portland St on deck. The Huskies had the P12's best defense last year and only lose 6 lettermen off that side. They had a true frosh QB and RB last year and get back their playmaker John Ross who missed last year with injury. Petersen is 6-4 ATS as a HF. Rutgers has a new head coach and are talented on both the O-line and D-line. UW has the edge on offense and has a massive edge on defense, special teams and is at home. The line is not cheap but Rutger's last 6 road losses have been by 32.5 ppg.

† Georgia by 4 over North Carolina (Atlanta) - This game is being played in Atlanta with UGA very familiar with the Georgia Dome and will have the crowd edge much like they do when they play in the SEC Title game. Both teams faced manageable schedules last year with just 2 games vs ranked teams in the regular season. Georgia only has Nicholls St on deck and North Carolina has a road trip to Illinois. North Carolina has the edge on offense, special teams and coach Fedora is in his 5th year. Georgia has the edge on defense but does have a 1st year head coach. NC had a tough loss in the opener last year outplaying SEC member South Carolina but came up short due to some int's in the end zone. South Carolina did finish last year 3-9 and Georgia was a 10 win team. Georgia does open with questions about the health of RB's Chubb and Michel and may have a true frosh QB.

NEBRASKA by 24 over Fresno St - These two last met in 2014. Fresno St was coming off an 11-2 season but had just faced USC and Utah on the road and were waxed by the Huskers 55-19 at home (+13). Surprisingly the last time here ('11) #10 Nebraska was -28' but only led 35-29 in the 4Q winning by 13. Fresno St has just 12 returning starters. The Huskers are just 7-12 ATS as a home fav but do only have Wyoming on deck and despite being in a bowl last year actually are coming in off a losing season Fresno St was 1-5 ATS as an away dog last year. Fresno St's 5 road losses last year were by 32.4 ppg. Fresno had been to a bowl in each of DeRuyters first 3 years and are coming off a season where if it could go wrong, it did go wrong. These two teams are both undervalued but we see the Bulldogs keeping this closer than the 29 point spread.

† Alabama by 14 over Usc (Arlington) - Since 1999 the Nat'l Champ from the previous season is 17-0 with an average win of 44-15 in its season opener. This is the 5th straight year Bama kicks off at a neutral site (4-0, win by 20 ppg, 3-1 ATS). Bama has the top defense in the nation and are loaded on the O-line and at receiver. They have a ton of success with first year starting QB's. USC is loaded at most positions with question marks at QB and the defensive line. The Tide has a solid coaching edge as Helton is 2-4 SU/ATS vs ranked teams and Saban has 4 national titles in the last 7 years. Bama also figures to have the crowd edge and Saban's great mark in openers has us saying, "Roll Tide."

† Byu by 3 over Arizona - These two last met in 2008 in the Las Vegas Bowl. This game is being played at the University of Phoenix Stadium which is home to the NFL Arizona Cardinals. Arizona has the edge on offense but BYU has an even larger edge on defense. The Cougars has a large veteran O-line matched up against a smallish Arizona D-line. While Arizona just has Grambling on deck, BYU has 7 straight tough foes lined up. BYU has a rookie head coach, while the Cats Rodriguez enters his 5th year. The special teams are even. This game rates as a toss up so we are taking the points.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 6 over Wyoming - This is the 1st meeting. NIU is 14-4 ATS as an AF and 27-13 ATS overall on the road the last 10 years. Wyoming is 19-3 in home openers but lost to an FCS team last year. Wyoming was also upset by Eastern Michigan last year 48-29 (-13) and lost to Toledo at home 34-31 (-3) in '12. NIU is 21-3 SU on the road with wins at Northwestern, Toledo, Iowa and Purdué in the last 3 years. Northern Illinois is the stronger team across the board including on special teams and both teams are experienced. Wyoming does have a heightened altitude edge staying at home the last month and figures to give the Huskies more of a battle than expected.

MONDAY SEPT 5 † Mississippi vs Florida St (Orlando) - This is the Monday Night game and a great one to kick off the season between two highly ranked squads. Ole Miss has a large edge at QB experience with Chad Kelly vs a rFr starter. Florida St probably has more overall talent and played their spring game in Orlando. Ole Miss has beaten Alabama the last two years so they will not be intimidated. These two have not met since 1961. This will be the

opening of Monday Night Magic (see below).




