COLLEGE SELECTION TEAM IN CAPS

4★ MISSISSIPPI ST over South Carolina - The last mtg was in '13 in Columbia & SC (-12) won 34-16. SC is 7-0 SU/6-1 ATS in this series. The HT is 3-4 SU/4-3 ATS. Interesting that new SC HC Muschamp never faced Mullen while at Fla. It was a tale of 2 halves for SC LW in their 13-10 (+4) win at Vandy. SC trailed 10-0 at HT w/just 88 ttl yds, but gained 220 in the 2H, scoring 13 str capped off by a GW car long 55 yd fg w/:35 left. QB Orth st'd, but struggled, & QB McIlwain repl'd but didn't fare much better & Orth was re-inserted. Frosh WR Edwards (8-101) may prove to be a viable replacement for Pharoh Cooper. The post-Dak Prescott era couldn't have started worse for the Bulldogs after losing to South Bama LW, 21-20 (-28). The Bulldogs led 17-0 in the 2Q but missed a 26 yd fg that would've won the gm. MSU is an outstanding 13-4 SU vs SEC East foes & HC Mullen is 15-9 as a HF. The public will be overreacting to LW's results which gives us added value here. MSU is clearly the better team and will take their frustration from LW out on SC this week. FORECAST: MISSISSIPPI ST by 14

3★ Kentucky (+) over FLORIDA - LY was a pivotal game as both tms were trying to establish themselves as bowl contenders. Patrick Towles completed just 8 passes and UF won its SEC home opener for the 11th consec ssn. UF has now won 29 in a row in this series, the longest active streak in the FBS and is 8-1 ATS in the series. LY UF was on the road (-3') and held a 245-241 yd edge. They led 14-3 into the 4Q but only up 14-9, they needed an int at the 23 yd line with :33 left to hold on for the win. LW UF came out flat vs UMass, led just 10-7 at HT and won 24-7 (-36'). The Gators did have a 363-187 yd edge. KY jumped out to a 35-10 lead LW vs SM in the 2Q but was outscored 34-0 & outg'd 332-22 from that point on and lost 44-35 (-6). The Wildcats were outg'd 520-409 & out FD'd 32-14! QB Barker did look much improved, going 15-24-323-4-1. The Gators are just 7-16 as a HF & UK is 3-0 ATS in road openers. We'll look for UK to play a complete gm for both half's & they have the OFF & ST's edge & will keep FORECAST: FLORIDA by 10

3★ ARIZONA ST over Texas Tech - The only mtg between these two was in the 2013 Holiday Bowl. ASU was #16 but lost 37-23 (-14) in a game they trailed 27-6. Todd Graham is from TX, but they came up short LY vs another TX school losing to TX A&M by 21 in the opener. ASU is off a 44-13 (-26') home win over FCS foe. New st'g soph QB Wilkins threw for 180 (74%) & ran for 89. TT is off a 69-17 (-38) home win over an FCS foe. TT's questionable run D wasn't tested LW, while ASU is off a 276 (6.0) rushing performance. Graham is 15-9 as a HF. ASU is off an FCS foe with UTSA on deck so this game has been circled & was a main focus in Aug. FORECAST: ARIZONA ST by 10

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SOUTH ALABAMA (+) over Georgia Southern - This is the 3rd mtg between these two and GS is 2-0 SU/ATS. LY GS outg'd SA 542-136 and held a 20-9 FD edge in a 55-17 (-21') win. In the 2 mtgs, GS has run for 412 rush ypg (7.6). SA is coming off a program defining win at Miss St, 21-20 (+28). The Jags controlled the clock (36:41-23:19) despite just 94 (3.2) rush yds while all'g 239 (7.0) rush. LW the Eagles won 54-0 (-55) vs an FCS foe in new HC Summers debut. SA had lost badly to MSU in '12 & '14 & rebounded to win LW. Similarly, the Jag's haven't fared well against GS the L2Y. The Eagles are traveling for the 1st time under a new HC & we'll FORECAST: Georgia Southern by 3 take the home dog to keep this one close.

2★ MIAMI, FL over Florida Atlantic - UM has won both mtgs prior. In 2013 they won 34-6 at home (-31') and last year they were -18' on the road and it was just 20-20 w/9:44 left in the 3Q but UM scored the final 24 pts. The schools are just 51 miles apart and the visitor is 2-0 ATS. New HC Richt didn't mess around in his UM debut as the Canes won easily, 70-3 (-55') over an FCS foe. FAU also won versus an FCS, albeit much closer, 38-30 (-6') despite being outg'd 530-457 & out FD'd 26-19. UM is 8-2-1 as a HF and 9-4-1 ATS overall. HC MR took care of business against overmatched foes at UGA, going 86-45-2 ATS in SU wins! Look for that trend FORECAST: MIAMI, FL by 31 to continue here. **OTHER GAMES**

FRIDAY September 9th

Maryland at FIU - MD is 4-0 SU/2-2 ATS in this series, winning by an avg of 17 ppg. MD travelled here in '07 winning 26-10 (-24). The last mtg was '13 in HC Turner's FIU debut (went 1-11) & MD (-21) had 576-171 yd & 26-9 FD edges in the 43-10 blowout. FIU (+10) led Indy 13-12 4Q LW before all'g 22 str pts. They were outg'd 486-331, outFD'd 26-16 & all'd 2 int ret td's & Indy was w/o 6 susp plyr's incl 3 str's. Ret st'g QB McGough had a rough night going 23-46-263-0-3 while FIU was limited to 63 (3.0) rush. MD HC Durkin had a successful debut LW vs a weak FCS foe, winning 52-13 (-50). MD scored on its F/4 poss, had a PR td & the D forced 5 str 3&outs. MD led 35-0 at HT. This was not a gm to gauge strengths/weaknesses from. While MD is on a 5-1 ATS run vs FBS, they are just 1-12 ATS off a SU win. FIU is on a 14-9-2 ATS run vs FBS foes. MD is improved from LY & could resemble '14 squad which had road wins at Syr, Ind, Penn St and Mich and do have the better OFF, D, & ST's.

Louisville at SYRACUSE - ACC opener for both schools. UL is 5-1 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, but the HT is 5-2 SU. UL has won both ACC mtgs, winning in the Carrier Dome 28-6 (-2') & winning at home LY 41-17 (-14) holding SU to 245 and 286 yds. UL QB Jackson got off to a sensational start, accounting for a schl rec 8 ttl td's & 405 ttl yds (119 rush) & the Cards had 405 1H yds in the 70-14 (-38') home win over an improved Charlotte tm. Syr enters off a 33-7 (-24) Fri home win over an FCS schl. New HC Babers up tempo OFF produced the F/gm with 2 Orange rec's having 10+ rec's. QB Dungey hit 34-40-355-2-0 while WR Etta-Tawo had 12-210 & a 43 yd td rec. Babers wants the rush attack to improve after having just 117 (3.3). The Cards are 11-4 ATS away/neutral & 5-2 as an AF. 'Cuse was 4-0 as a HD LY & are 13-3 as a HF off a SU DD win.

Saturday September 10th

Boston College by 17 over MASSACHUSETTS - BC is 19-2 SU (8 str by 21 ppg) in this series with both losses being in Amherst, however this gm will be ply'd at Gillette Stadium. BC won here in '14, 30-7 (-17) not punting until 1:21 was left in the game. BC is off a trip to Ireland and has

another ACC game on deck vs Virg Tech which will be their 3rd road game in 3 wks making this quite a flat spot. BC backers deserved better LW as the Eagles finished w/a dominant 352-240 yd edge, holding GT to 121 (2.8) rush in their 17-14 (+3) loss. BC all'd the gw 4 yd td run w/:35 left, had 3 TO's & missed 2 fg's (43 & 35 yds). UMass is off a 24-7 (+36') loss at Fla. Sure Umass was outg'd 363-187 & outFD'd 22-10, but a positive can be that they all'd just 107 (3.7) rush. New st'g QB Comis (repl'd #3 all-time Umass QB Frohnapfel) hit just 9-17-141 & had 1 td run. BC is on a 3-8-2 ATS run vs FBS, but Umass is just 12-19 as a DD dog & is 2-5 ATS off a SU loss.

TCU by 9 over Arkansas - TCU has not lost a non-conf HG s/99. These 2 schools haven't ply'd s/both were SWC members from 1930-1991 with Ark being 30-3 SU in the series. Both tms survived closer then expected ssn openers LW as Ark never led in the 2H until scoring what would become the GW td on 4D w/6:37 left in the 21-20 (-24') home win. New st'g QB Allen threw 2 int's & the Hog's OL w/3 new str's rushed for just 106 (2.7) & all'd 4 sks. Ark was also facing a bkp frosh QB (st'r Higgins susp). TCU meanwhile, needed a fg w/:02 left 1H to be tied at 24 at HT at home vs an FCS foe. TCU was up by just 4 in the 4Q before scoring 14 str in the L/8:36 to win 59-41 (-35'). New st'g QB Hill hit 33-49-439-2-2 w/3 rush td's & his fav targest was VHT JC trans WR Williams (11-158), who appears to be poised to fill the vacancy left by car leader Doctson. The Hogs are just 2-10 SU in their road openers dropping 5 str by an avg score of 39-18, but they are 7-4 ATS vs non-conf, on a 17-8-1 ATS run vs FBS & 7-1 as an AD. TCU counters w/a 18-8 ATS run vs FBS & 12-2 ATS run at home incl 10-2 vs FBS foes. Ark does have a young QB making his first road start.

ARMY by 6 over Rice - Rice is 4-0 SU/2-1-1 ATS & the visitor is 3-0-1 ATS in the series. Army's last win over Rice was their F/mtg in '58, though they've met just 5X since. LY Rice (-7) won 38-31 at home scoring the GW td w/:24 left, but Army had its 2nd most rush yds (378) on the ssn. LTH ('14) Rice (-1') rolled to a 41-21 win. Army had one of the biggest upsets in wk 1, winning at Temple 28-13 (+15). It was no fluke as Army held 25-16 FD & 344-251 yd edges. LB turned RB Davidson gashed a solid Temple D for 22-121 w/2 td's. Rice was embarrassed at WKU LW, 46-14 (+16'). They were outg'd 649-288, but did allow just 97 (3.2) rush. Rice is on a 1-6 ATS run vs FBS foes, while Army is 7-4-2 ATS vs FBS. This is Rice's 2nd str AG, while Army is ply'g its home opener & didn't travel far LW.

Ohio by 1 over KANSAS - The last mtg was in '67. KU HC Beaty got his 1st win LW as the Jayhawks won for the F/time in 665 days (11-8-14) beating an FCS foe 55-6 (-28) & the fans stormed the field. It was their most pts s/'07 (76 vs Neb). QB Cozart st'd (18-25-199-3-1) but Willis also took plenty of snaps (7-9-144-2-0) as there still isn't a clear cut st'r. Whoever becomes QB1, will have a great option to throw to in A&M VHT trans WR Gonzalez (PS#22), who had the best night according to Willis. OU was the victim of one of the biggest upsets in wk 1, falling at home to TXSt 56-54 (+20') in 3OT. There was a ttl of 38 pts scored thru 3Q, but 39 pts alone were scored in the 4Q w/TXSt sending the gm to OT w/a 27 yd fg w/no time left. OU did finish w/a 630-546 yd edge incl 250-106 rush. OU is just 8-16-1 on the FBS road, but KU is just 3-10 ATS vs FBS. OU took Minn to the wire on the road LY and have recent wins at Penn St and at Marshall.

MICHIGAN by 35 over Ucf - 1st mtg. It's amazing how things change. From '13-'14, UCF was 21-5 SU & was a top 10 tm in '13, while UM was just 12-13 SU. LY UM was 10-3, finishing #12, while UCF finished 0-12. UCF won't finish winless TY as they're off a 38-0 (-27) home win over an FCS foe. UM dominated a Haw tm that had traveled to Australia the wk prior & was ply'g at 6AM Haw time, 63-3 (-38'). It was their most lopsided win s/75 (69-0 vs NW). QB Speight was named the st'r just before gametime & threw an int on his F/att, but settled in and finished 10-13-145-3-1 & UM added 2 pick 6's, finishing w/29-16 FD & 512-233 yd edges. The Wolves had 306 (7.8) rush & UCF all'd nearly 200 rush ypg LY. UM all'd just 4.6 ppg in non-conf HG's LY & even in UCF's 0-12 ssn LY their avg road loss was just 39-18 and they only lost to Stanford by 24. UM is just 4-8 ATS off a SU win, while UCF is 22-13 as an AD, but the record drops to 2-4 as a DD AD. While UCF is 6-3 ATS in gm 2, they're on a 2-11 overall ATS run vs FBS.

MISSOURI by 24 over Eastern Michigan - Only prior mtg took place in '97 & MO won 44-24 (-16'). This is MO's home opener & they're 10-0 SU, winning by 32 ppg. MO lost their ssn opener LW for the F/time s/01, ironically in former HC Pinkel's debut. Soph QB Lock didn't appear to be imprv'd from LY under new OC Heupel, finishing 23-51-280-1-0 against a D featuring 8 new str's The yds & FD were nearly even, but MO trailed 26-3 before a late td pass w/1:49 left. EM had no trouble dismantling an FCS foe at home 61-14 (-39'). EM led 28-0 at HT, scored on every 2H poss, & got its F/safety s/'05. RB Vann led the way w/20-156 & 2 td's. While MO is on a 3-9 reg ssn ATS run vs FBS, they are 8-3 off a SU loss. EM is just 10-17-1 ATS away & are on a 10-25-1 ATS run vs FBS. EM did cover at LSU LY, but were thrashed at Mich St & Fla by a comb'd 138-14 2Y ago. It's the home opener for brand new MO HC Odom and this is a must win.

APPĂLACHIAN ST by 17 over Old Dominion - LY was the 1st mtg. ODU ply'g w/revenge after getting destroyed at home 49-0 (+7'). This is App St's home opener (19-3 SU). LW vs top 10 ranked Tenn, the Mountaineers nearly pulled off an upset reminiscent to their '07 win over Mich. They never trailed until OT, missed a potential GW 42 yd fg w/5:24 left 4Q & their final drive before OT ended at the Tenn 30 w/HC Satterfield butchering his TO situation. App St was only outg'd 319-292 & outFD'd 19-17 & RB Cox is on his way to a 2nd str 1,000 yd ssn, finishing w/24-115. ODU had their opener pushed back a day (weather) but showed no ill effects in their 54-21 (-25') win over an FCS foe. ODU is on a 3-8 FBS run ATS, but App St is just 1-6 as a HF vs FBS.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Psu - It's good to see this rivalry renewed. These instate rivals are just 142 miles apart & it's their 2nd mtg s/2000. In that '00 mtg, Pitt won 12-0 (+5'), snapping a 7 gm series losing streak. One of the best sights of wk 1 was seeing Pitt RB Conner back on the field following his Hodgkins Lymphoma diagnoses L/Nov. Conner, now cancer free, scored twice as Pitt won their home opener vs an FCS foe 28-7 (-26'). 2nd yr st'g QB Peterman will have to improve upon his 19-32-175-2-0 performance if Pitt wants to compete in the ACC. PSt's revamped up tempo OFF got off to a slow st in their 33-13 (-22') home win over Kent St. They led just 16-13 at HT & got a 30 yd pick 6 to open the 2H, finishing w/just 18-15 FD & 354-279 yd edges. New soph QB McSorely, taking over for #1 car passer Hackenberg, hit just 16-31-209-2-0 & RB Barkley ran for 22-105 w/1 td. Pitt is 4-9 as a HF, but PSt is 0-4 as an AD. While HC Franklin is 16-10 ATS vs non-conf, he's just 1-4 SU/ATS in FBS road openers. Pitt is 3-8 ATS vs non-conf foes.

Cincinnati by 8 over PURDUE - This is UC's first trip to West Lafayette. In the last mtg (13) UC easily won in the ssn opener 42-7 (-10). UC survived a scare LW against an FCS foe. They didn't score until :19 left 1H & trailed 7-6 at HT before scoring 15 2H pts & adding a pick 6 late 4Q in the 28-7 (-34') home win. They only had 400-323 yd & 22-20 FD edges & PK Pasley missed a 24 yd fg & a PAT. UC also all'd 177 (3.6) rush yds. PU enters off a 45-24 (-16') home win over an FCS schl. PU led 28-18 at HT despite being outg'd 284-243 thanks to 2 pick 6's (both against former SEC st'g QB Mauk). UC is just 2-8 ATS vs non conf FBS foes, but is 10-5 ATS away. PU is 5-2 ATS before a bye, but just 4-14 as a HD. Sked edge favors PU as UC is 3-9 SU in road openers & have a big conf gm Thurs vs Hou on deck while PU has a bye. PU is 25-12 SU hosting non-conf foes since '03 & did upset Neb (in conf) at home LY.

INDIANA by 17 over Ball St - IU has surprisingly been outright upset in this series the L/3 mtgs ('08, '11, '12)! The last gm featured 8 lead changes in BSt's 41-39 (+2') win. Despite finishing w/26-16 FD & 486-331 yd edges, IU trailed at FIU 13-12 4Q, but scored 22 str to pull away 34-13 (-10) LW. IU was w/o 6 susp ply'rs incl 1,000 yd WR Cobbs, st'g DB Dutra & DT Green (11 car st). QB Lagow taking over for IU car leading passer Sudfeld finished 18-27-240 w/2 ttl td's while RB Redding is on pace for B2B 1,000 ssns after finishing 22-135. IU had 2 int ret td's (F/time in same gm s/66). BSt loves the road & pulled off an outright upset LW at GSt, winning 31-21 (+5) in HC Neu's debut. The gm was tied at 14 at HT, but BSt scored 17 str in the 2H before all'g a late td w/2:24 left. BSt finished w/a 455-272 yd & 35:56-24:04 TOP edges as they rushed for 325 (5.6), led by soph RB Gilbert (29-160, 2 td). BSt did hold GASt to just 195 pass yds, after the Panthers avg 336 LY. IU is 13-1 SU in home openers, 6-2 ATS vs non-conf FBS & 7-3 as a fav. The IU Sr's still remember the home loss in '12 & will look to get revenge on their in-state rival.

OKLAHOMA by 45 over Ulm - OU not surprisingly won the L/mtg 34-0 (-21') in '13. While this is a large sandwich game for OU, fresh off their big gm vs Hou w/OHSt on deck, they must put their entire focus on this gm after their devastating letdown to the Coug's LW, 33-23 (-12). OU was down just 19-17 at HT & were att'g to take the lead mid 3Q, but their 54 yd fg fell short & was ret'd 109 yds reminiscent of Aub's 'Kick 6' vs Bama in '13. OU added a late td w/2:05 left. The Sooners were outFD'd 25-16, but the yds were nearly even. QB Mayfield was constantly under duress, but hit 24-33-323-2-0, while OU had just 77 (3.0) rush. ULM was up just 14-12 at HT, but pulled away in the 2H to win 38-21 (-14) at home over an FCS foe. ULM all'd 239 (5.2) rush so OU should be able to rebound from LW's weak rush perf. ULM was 18-17 ATS as an AD under former HC Berry & this is new HC Viator's F/gm in that role. ULM did lose at UGA by 37 & Bama by 34 LY. OU is 35-23 as a HF vs FBS, is on a 6-3 ATS run, and must win big to regain their mojo w/Top 5 Ohio State visiting next wk.

OKLAHOMA ST by 14 over Central Michigan - In LY's initial mtg, OSU was -23' on the road but it was 1 score game for 3+ quarters and OSU won 24-13. CM is off an expected 49-3 (-37') home win over an FCS squad. Ret'g st'g QB Rush threw 2 int's, but RB Spalding led w/15-135 rush. OSU also won big as expected, 61-7 (-49) at home vs an FCS foe. Most of the str's were on the bench in the 2Q after OSU took a 31-0 lead. The Pokes were, however, limited to just 3.8 ypc (37-142) & 392 ttl yds. CM is 11-2 ATS away, incl 8-1 as an AD (Syr & Mich St LY), while OSU is 27-13 as a HF vs FBS.

WISCONSIN by 28 over Akron - UW is 2-0 SU/0-2 ATS all time vs AU ('03 & '08). UW has won 20 str Camp Randall openers by 23 ppg. LY in their 3 non-conf HG's under HC Chryst, they all'd a total of 3 pts, scoring 38 ppg. While there were bigger upsets ATS LW, none may have been more of a surprise than UW beating LSU outright 16-14 (+11) at Lambeau Field. UW led 13-0 late 3Q, then all'd a pick 6 & fumbled on their ensuing drive to give LSU a short field & found themselves down by 1. They hit the GW 47 yd fg w/3:47 left. UW finished w/21-15 FD & 339-257 yd edges & did a solid job of containing RB Fournette (23-138). Akron enters off a 47-24 (-27) home win vs an FCS foe. AU led just 26-21 4Q, but scored 21 str to close the gm. QB Woodson had car highs in pass yds (407) & pass td's (6). After all'g just 93 (2.9) rush ypg LY, AU began just as strong, all'g 86 (1.9). UW is just 3-9 ATS its F/3 FBS HG's. AU is 10-6 as an AD, but lost at OK by 38 LY.

Nc State by 4 over EAST CAROLINA - NCSt lost their LTH ('10) 33-27 (-7') in OT, trailing 21-0 2Q. Last mtg was in '13 & EC (-6') won 42-28. NCSt is off an easy 48-14 (-24) home win over an FCS foe. Boise trans QB Finley hasn't locked up the st'g job & both he (17-21-174-2-0) & McClendon (6-9-88-0-1) had success. RB Dayes is on his way to becoming the F/1,000 rusher s/'02 after having 23-138. EC had no trouble in their opener, a 52-7 (-17') home win over an FCS foe, giving new HC Montgomery a win in his F/gm. Minn trans QB Nelson set car highs w/398 pass yds & 5 td's. NCSt is 10-4 SU in non-conf AG's incl 5 str wins. After an 0-9 run as an AF, they're now 5-0, 7-2 ATS away & 7-1 ATS as a fav vs FBS. They are however, also on just a 2-7 overall ATS run vs FBS. EC counters with a 13-6-1 (5-2 under former HC McNeil) mark as a HD & is 11-3 ATS vs non-conf FBS foes. This is NCSt's most important Sept gm off an FCS foe w/ODU & a bye the next 2 wks so EC won't have their normal advantage of catching an ACC foe between conf action.

OHIO ST by 31 over Tulsa - 1st mtg. OSU is 28-3-1 SU all-time vs current AAC members w/ their L/loss in '50. OSU maybe the least exp'd tm in the nation, but their still among the most talented & that showed early & often in their 77-10 (-27') beatdown of in-state rival BG. QB Barrett, not having to look over his shoulder, set a schl rec w/7 ttl td's, hitting 21-31-349. New frosh RB Weber, taking over for #1DC Zeke had 19-136 & HB Samuel added 261 ttl yds. OSU set a schl rec w/776 ttl yds & finished w/43-16 FD & 38:35-21:25 TOP edges while all'g just 244 yds. TU also looked good in their 45-10 (-5) home win over SJSt. The veteran squad (15 ret str's) was up 38-7 at HT & finished w/28-13 FD & 512-287 yd edges. TU has proven a tough out, losing by only 14 to Ok & Hou LY, 2 tms that finished in the top 10. OSU HC Meyer is 41-15-1 ATS vs non-conf foes, 8-5 as a non-conf fav of 27+ pts, & on a 6-2 ATS run, but is just 2-8 ATS at home vs FBS. Tulsa counters w/a 9-1 ATS rec away incl 7-1 as an AD & are on a 11-5 overall ATS run vs FBS, but are 5-9 ATS vs non-conf. While OSU has a huge AG on deck in Norman, Meyer still needs to get keep his young team up to speed & full of confidence.

CLEMSON by 35 over Troy - The last mtg was in '11 w/CU winning 43-19 (-14'). CU had al they could handle in their opener at Aub LW. Despite a commanding 233-38 vd edge at HT, they only led 10-3. Up 19-6 late, they all'd an Aub td w/3:22 left & Aub had a chance to win the gm from the CU 40 but their final 2 passes were incomplete, the last w/no time remaining. CU could've put the gm away their prev drive but elected not to kick a fg from the Aub 17. CU finished w/a 399-262 yd edge & Heisman Hopeful QB Watson hit 19-34-248-1-1. RB Gallman was the workhorse, finishing w/30-123 & a td. Troy was down 14-13 early 2Q, but finished the gm on a 44-3 run, dominating an FCS foe 57-17 (-37'). Troy used a balance attack finishing w/383 rush & 323 pass yds, while all'g just 254. CU used high effort LW, but does just have an FCS foe on deck. Troy avg just 15 ppg in their F/5 FBS gms LY, but after getting used to HC Brown's system, avg 36 ppg their L/6 gms. CU is 27-18-1 as a HF, but Troy is 5-1 ATS away vs FBS.

USF by 10 over Northern Illinois - Last mtg was in the '10 Int'l Bowl w/USF winning 27-3 (-6'). USF is off a 56-20 (-27) win over an FCS foe. 2X AAC rush champ RB Mack was held under 100 yds for the F/time in 6 gms as he sat out the 2H after fumbling following a shoulder inj but he indicated after the gm that he's fine. NIU is off a 40-34 (-9) 3OT loss at Wyo that was delayed by lightning nearly 2 hours & didn't KO until after 11PM CT. QB Hare, coming back from a torn Achilles, hit 24-39-329 w/4 ttl td's. NIU was outFD'd 28-19 & lost the TOP battle 35:39-24:21, but was only outg'd 488-462. NIU all'd 243 (4.3) rush. USF had been 4-14 as a HF but are 3-0 vs FBS the L2Y USF is also 5-0 ATS gm 2, on a 6-0 ATS run at home & on a 10-3 ATS run overall vs FBS. NIU is 15-4 as a AD vs FBS & on a 9-4 ATS run. LY they only lost at Ohio St by 7, BC by 3 and beat Toledo, but are on B2B road trips now.

DUKE by 6 over Wake Forest - ACC opener for both schools, who ply'd in the ssn finale LY. WF had won an amazing 12 in a row SU in this series but now Duke has won the L/4. The dog is 10-7-1, but WF is 0-4-1 ATS. Eight of the L/10 have been decided by a comb'd 36 pts. LY Duke never trailed in the 27-21 (-4) home win. LTH WF got within 6 in the 3Q & Duke got ahead ATS w/a td mid 4Q. WF is off a 7-3 (-16') home win over Tulane despite being outg'd 280-175 (59 2H) & outFD'd 14-10 (3 2H). WF uses 2 QB's & they comb'd for just 12-21-96. Duke is off a 49-6 (-34) home win over an FCS foe. New st'r rFr QB Jones (Sirk OFY Achilles) had a great debut, hitting 10-15-189 w/3 ttl td's. Duke did have 5 TO's, 3 in the 2H mostly w/3rd & 4th stringers on the field. DT Wolf's 3 sks were the most by a Blue Devil s/'03. Duke had been 12-3 as a HF from $^{\prime}$ 12- $^{\prime}$ 14 but was just 1-4 LY. WF is 14-24 ÅTS as an AD & 0-7 SU/ATS in their 1st road gm.

NAVY by 4 over Connecticut - The visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series winning by 24 ppg. LY was their 1st mtg s/'06 & 1st AAC mtg. Navy (-7) was up 14-10 on the road & got a td with :02 left 1H & led 28-10 before all'g a CT td at 7:30 4Q. Navy was limited to 343 yds, the 4th lowest ttl of the season. LTH ('02) CT won 38-0 (-4'), their only win in the 8 mtgs. CT survived an FCS foe LW, hitting the GW 37 yd fg w/:11 left to win 24-21 (-27). CT did have 362-309 yd & 23-16 FD edges & blk'd Maine's 47 yd fg w/1:48 left. Navy is coming off a 52-16 (-21') win over an FCS foe but lost QB Smith in the process (Likely OFY). The Middles actually pulled their 3rd stg QB Perry from the stands (was in his dress white's) to ply in the gm. Navy is 12-5 ATS as a HF and CT is 6-12 as a dog incl 4-9 as an AD. CT is just 3-9 SU on the AAC road and 6-20 SU the L7Y in conf AG's.

TEXAS by 24 over Utep - The last time these 2 met here was '09 and #2 TX won 64-7 (-36'), the same season they played for a Nat'l Title. They had a 639-53 yd edge. LW we rolled with TX as both our Underdog POW on these pages (7 outright upsets the L2Y) and our Sunday Night Marquee and the Horns came through with an outright upset, 50-47 (+4') in 2OT! HC Strong went w/a 2-QB system, and it worked wonders early as TX jumped out to a 31-14 lead but a botched PAT attempt lead to eventual overtime. VHT true frosh Buechele (PS#12) was as advertised, hitting 16-26-280-2-1 & RB Foreman added 131 (5.5) rush. TX finished with 517-444 yd & 26-22 FD edges. UTEP was a 3★ LPS winner for us LW as the Miners beat NMSt 38-22 (-9'). UTEP led 38-16 in the 4Q and held 518-345 yd & 29-18 FD edges. After missing the L/10 gms LY due to an ankle inj, RB Jones went for a car high 249 (8.0) yds in his 1st gm back. Fresno grad trans QB Greenlee added 3 td passes. HC Kugler is 5-13 as an AD while HC Strong is 6-3-1 as a Fav overall.

AUBURN by 21 over Arkansas St - Aub is 3-0 SU in this series and 1-2 ATS. In their last meeting in '13 Auburn was just -10' at home coming off a 3-9 season but destroyed Ark St 38-9. Gus Malzahn was the Red Wolves HC in '12. Aub is coming off a hard fought loss at home to Clemson, 19-13 (+9). The Tigers were outg'd 233-38 at HT but trailed just 10-3 with Malzahn deciding to use 3 different qb's (all 3 on the field at the same time once). Aub trailed 19-6 but scored a late td, got the ball back and had 2 shots from the CU40. Ark St lost their home opener to Tol LW, 31-10 (-4). The Red Wolves were outg'd by 290 yds and new stg QB Voytik (Pitt transfer) struggled mightily, going 11-24-124. Now Ark St faces a hungry Aub def that held Clem to 178 yds less than they avg'd LY. Aub is 3-13 as a fav, on an 0-8 run as an AF & just 11-23 off a SU loss.

AIR FORCE by 20 over Georgia St - These 2 last met in '14 with AF on the road (-12) and were dominating GSt 31-10 at the half and led 45-24 in the 4Q but GSt got 2 TD's incl one with 5:03 left for the backdoor cover, 48-38 (+12). AF is off a 37-21 (-42') win over an FCS schl. The gm wasn't as close as the score appears as AF held 602-360 yd & 29-16 FD edges. GSt lost their opener at home to Ball St, 31-21 (-5). GSt actually trailed 34-14 and added a garbage time td, being outg'd 455-272 for the gm. After going just 2-33 SU from '12-'14, GSt made tremendous strides under HC Miles to make a bowl LY and are an incredible 15-3 as an AD. They also beat GSo and their option LY 34-7, holding them to 135 rush yds (3.1). AF is 9-3-1 ATS at home.

COLORADO ST by 10 over Utsa - LY was their first meeting. CSU was -10 on the road and trailed 17-16 at the half but escaped with a 33-31 win. We had an easy winner LW in our Friday night Marquee as we went against the Rams and they were blown out by their rival Colorado 44-7 (+8'). St'g QB Stevens struggled (6-20-31-0-2) and was replaced by QB Bauta in the 2H. The job appears to be up in the air at the moment. UTSA won 26-13 (-24') vs an FCS foe LW. The Roadrunners have just 10 ret str's and a brand new HC making his first road trip. CSU is 12-4 as a HF while UTSA is 12-5 ATS off a SU win.

We feel that the home team winning streak in this series will come to an end with Cal having extra time to prepare to stop the run & will go for B2B Underdog POW winners on these pages! FORECAST: California by 1 over SAN DIEGO ST

NOTRE DAME by 31 over Nevada - In their only prior meeting in '09, ND was -14' at home and got the shutout win in the season opener, 35-0. NV has not been shutout in a game since. Notre Dame is coming off an outright upset loss at Texas LW 50-47 (-4') as we won our Underdog POW on these pages LW going against the Irish (7 outright winners L2Y)! ND trailed 31-14 3Q, but rallied behind QB Kizer who threw for 5 tds and ran for another. ND were fortunate to get to OT after they ret' a blk'd PAT to tie the gm. Nevada barely escaped with an OT win against an FCS foe in their opener, 30-27 (-17'). NV actually led 24-10 going into the 4Q. The Wolf Pack are 2-18 SU in road openers but are 3-1 ATS their L/4. NV is 6-1 ATS as an AD, 10-2 ATS on the road overall and has 14 ret str's. ND is off a big gm vs TX with Mich St on deck.

WASHINGTON by 42 over Idaho - These 2 last met in '09 and Washington won that game 42-23 (-20). When Peterson was at Boise St he went 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS vs the Vandals. The Huskies came through in wk 1 as our Early Bird POW (available for free on button 9 at 1-347-677-1700 every Mon), blowing out Rutgers 48-13 (-26). UW led 24-0 after 1Q and 48-3 after 3Q before Rutgers added 10 late pts. Idaho pulled out a 20-17 (-14') win over an FCS foe. ID was an outstanding 10-1 as an AD the L2Y, covering vs Aub & SDSt. HC Petrino is 6-14 ATS vs non-conf foes. UW is 11-6 as a HF and 5-0 ATS vs non-conf foes.

ALABAMA by 31 over Wku - These 2 last met in '12. Bama 35-0 (-38) but w/only a 17-14 FD and 328-224 yd edges in the game after playing #8 Michigan in the ssn opener. This time Bama comes off plyg #20 USC in the ssn opener and trailed 3-0 after 1Q but blew the Trojans doors open in their 52-6 (-12) victory. The Tide got a big performance from RB Harris (9-138, 15.3) and WR Stewart (4-113, 2 td). WKU got off to a solid start to their ssn with a 46-14 (-16') win over Rice. Hilltoppers' QB White threw for 517 yds in his debut but now must go on the road and face Bama's def. Bama is in a USC/Ole Miss sandwich. WKU is 3-0 ATS vs ranked tms the L5Y while Bama is just 2-5 when -20 or more, 1-5 ATS vs CUSA foes and 1-5 ATS overall at home vs FBS foes.

VANDERBILT by 4 over Middle Tennessee - This is the first time these two will meet in 3 consec yrs since 1920-22. MT as a dog actually won 3 str ('01, '02, '05) prior to LY. VU (+2') LY was on the road and MT was hyped for their instate SEC rival. VU trailed 13-3 4Q, but got 29 & 39 yd td runs to pull out the 17-13 win. VU (-4) lost 13-10 to SC last thurs after dominating the 1H, up 10-0 & all'g just 88 yds. VU all'd the GW 55 yd fg w/:35 left & missed out on numerous int opportunities. MTSt is coming off a blowout win over an FCS foe, 55-0 (-47'). VU is 18-5 SU vs non-conf foes. VU has 15 ret st'rs to MT's 12. VU does have GTech's option on deck but had a few extra days to prep after playing SC on Thurs. HC Mason is 2-5 as a HF. MTSt is 6-2 ATS in road openers.

OREGON by 21 over Virginia - The only mtg between these two was in '13. UO flew out to the East Coast in an early start for them and were -23' but rolled to a 59-10 win. The Ducks routed an FCS foe LW, 53-28 (-47'), but saw their 110 home game sellout streak end. UVA on the other hand suffered a loss to FCS Richmond, 37-20, which was the 2nd largest MOV by an FCS team over an FBS. UVA has lost 15 str away gms, their last win back in '12 but are 8-5 as an AD in that time. The Cavs are 12-6-1 as a DD dog and 14-4 as Dogs overall. Oregon has a trip to Nebraska on deck.

† Tennessee by 11 over Virginia Tech (Bristol) - These two last met in the 2009 Chick-fil-A-Bowl in Lane Kiffin's lone season as HC for the Vols and VT won 37-14 ('5). The last reg ssn mtg was in 1937. This gm is at the Bristol Motor Speedway in TN (125 miles from VT's campus, 110 from UT's) and a record 150,000 fans will be on hand. The Vols were fortunate to survive LW vs App St. UT trailed 13-3 at HT before rallying to win 20-13 (-20') in OT. The bounces went the Vols way as App St mismanaged the clock to end reg & UT recovered their own fmbl in the EZ to score in OT. VT won 36-13 (31') LW vs an FCS foe in HC Fuente's debut. VT is 2-5-1 ATS in neutral sites while HC Jones is 2-0 ATS at neutral sites. Fuente was 14-7-1 as a Dog in his previous stint at Mem.

BAYLOR by 31 over Smu - BU has won 12 str in this series with their last loss in '86. In their 5 recent mtgs BU is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS with their lone ATS loss LY by a half point. BU was -35' and only led 28-21 at the half but finished with a commanding 723-369 yd edge and won 56-21. After an offseason of turmoil, Jim Grobe led the Bears to an easy win LW against an FCS foe, 55-7 (-48'). SMU is coming off a 34-21 (-10) win at NTX and held a 572-394 yd edge. The Mustangs got a big performance from WR Sutton who had 4-162 and 3 tds. BU has won 16 str HG's by 41 ppg and the LTH won 45-0 w/a 574-67 yd edge! This is SMU's 2nd str road gm to start the ssn and LY lost their road gms by an avg of 33.6 ppg.

IOWA by 14 over Iowa St - When Hayden Fry was around Iowa always crushed Iowa St but ISU is actually 10-8 SU/13-5 ATS the last 18 meetings. North Carolina by 6 over ILLINOIS - LY was the only recent mtg between these two. IL trailed 13-7 but NC scored the next 35 pts and won 48-14 at home (-8). The Heels are coming off their big opener in a loss to Georgia, 33-24 (+3). NC led 24-14 in the 3Q but all'd 19 str pts to finish the gm. New starting QB Trubisky struggled, going just 24-50-156. The Heels were outg'd 474-315. Illinois started the Lovie Smith era with a 52-3 (-33) win over an FCS foe. This is by far IL's biggest gm of the month after facing an FCS tm and with WMich on deck while NC still has a conf gm coming up in 2 wks. The Illini are 8-5 as HD. HC Fedora is 20-15 ATS as a Fav.

NEBRASKA by 28 over Wyoming - These two last met in '13 and NU (-30') only held a 602-

530 yd edge and escaped with a 37-34 win. Neb led just 14-10 LW in their opener against Fresno St. The Huskers pulled away in the 2H for a 43-10 (-29) win. The Huskers showed their new commitment to the run with 292 (5.7) rush yds and ran the ball on 20 of their first 21 plays. WY is coming off an upset win over NIU, 40-34 (+9) in 3OT. The Cowboys showed great balance (243 rush, 4.3 and 245 pass, 8.4) and new starting QB Allen was impressive, going 20-29-245-2-0. The gm ended at 2:30 AM Sunday morning & now they must travel. WY is on a 24-11 run as an AD while Neb is 2-7 as a HF. HC Riley is 4-11 as a reg ssn fav. WY is 6-0 ATS in road openers. USC by 17 over Utah St - The last mtg was in '13 in LA & USC (-6) won 17-13. UTSt is off a thurs 45-6 (-22') win over an FCS foe. The focus was on the ground as the Aggies finished w/428 (9.7) rush & 528 ttl yds. RB Mays had 18-208 & 3 td's incl a 68 yd'r. USC led Bama 3-0 after 1Q but was embarrassed on nat'll tv the rest of the way and lost 52-6 (+12). The Trojans were outg'd 465-194 and were held w/o a td for the 1st time s/'97 and 1st time in an opener s/60. The Trojans were also gashed on the ground for 242 yds (5.4). UTSt is 32-19 as an AD, but 4-6 under HC Wells. USC has won 15 str home openers. UTSt LY after a 10-4 ssn of '14, finished just 6-7 losing to Utah by 10, Washington by 14 and SDSt by 34 on the road. USC is in the middle of an Alabama/Stanford sandwich but are 18-10 as a HF.

New Mexico by 10 over NEW MEXICO ST - The Rio Grande Rivalry has been a series of streaks with NM having won their L/6 under Long as HC, lost all 3 under Locksey and now have won all 4 under HC Davie (2-1-1 ATS). The visitor is 9-3-1 ATS. LTH there were 8 lead changes and 3 ties. NM got a GW td pass with :27 left to pull out a 38-35 (-3) win. The Lobos won their debut 48-21 (-13') over an FCS foe, but did allow 2 long td drives in the 1Q. We won a 3★ LPS going against NMSt LW in their 38-22 (+9') loss to UTEP in which they all'd RB Jones to go for a car high 249 (8.0) and now they face the NM option. The Aggies all'd 454 (7.6) ypg in 2 gms against the option LY (vs NM & GA SO). Star RB Rose could return (CS). NM has rushed for 419 ypg (7.5) in the L/4 mtgs. NM is 2-0-1 as an AF under Long while NMSt is 6-11-2 as a HD. The Aggies are 0-7 ATS when opening at home against an FBS foe while Long is 2-0-1 ATS in road openers. NMSt is on a 14-30-1 ATS run and NM is 5-1 ATS and 11-6 ATS on the road.

UTAH by 4 over Byu - This is the 90th 'Holy War' after not ply'g in the reg ssn the L2Y. Utah is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in the series. Last mtg was LY's bowl gm & BYU (+2') turned the ball over on their F/5 poss & Utah led 28-0 running just 7 OFF pl's w/2 pick 6's & a 1 yd drive. BYU came back to lose 35-28, but had 386-197 yd & 21-14 FD edges. Utah is off a 24-0 (-28') thurs win over an in-state FCS foe. New st'g QB Williams hit 20-35-272-2-0, but Utah had just 138 (3.7) yds rush despite 4 ret OL str's. BYU needed a GW fg to survive LW against AZ 18-16 (-1'). RB Williams went 29-162 in his return after sitting out '15. Utah is 11-1 ATS vs non conf FBS foes & 11-6 ATS off a SU win. BYU is 10-4 as an AD. Utah is on a 2-6 ATS run. Utah has extra rest off a Thurs gm while BYU ply'd late Sat night.

BOISE ST by 14 over Washington St - WSU is 4-0 SU vs Boise St but they haven't met since 2001. The last time WSU travelled to the blue turf they led 41-13 into the 4Q. WSU will try to rebound after losing their opener to an FCS foe for the 2nd consec year. The Cougars were outg'd 606-515 in their 45-42 loss. After losing their opener LY, they travelled to Rutgers and pulled an upset 37-34 (+3') and will look to do the same here. The Broncos are coming off a 45-10 (-19') win over ULL in which they outg'd the Cajuns 584-267. Boise has won their L/3 against P5 squads, beating Washington at home LY (-11') 16-13, Virginia 56-14 (-2), and in the '14 Fiesta Bowl over Arizona 38-30 (+3). Leach is 12-3 as an AD while Boise is 28-14 ATS vs non conf foes

UCLA by 24 over Univ - LY was the first mtg. UCLA was -31 on the road and led 37-0 with 10:51 left with UNLV getting a 61 yd IR to set up their only score on a 32 yd fg. UCLA has to lick their wounds after losing 31-24 in OT (+3') at A&M. UCLA actually trailed 24-9 in the 4Q before rallying. The Bruins outg'd A&M 468-442 and controlled the clock but also had costly TO's. UNLY won easily over an FCS foe LW. QB Stanton was impressive, going 10-12-217-3-0 in his debut. Mora opened up 4-1 as a HF but is just 3-8 ATS since. While UNLV was just 1-5 SU on the road LY, their biggest loss was by 21 pts to Mich and they were only -8 ppg. UNLV is 7-12 ATS in road openers. UCLA is in an A&M/BYU sandwich.

Despite the Chargers' 4-12 SU record of '15, they were surprisingly able to handle the spread on the road against their AFC West Div opp's with a 3-0 ATS mark (+10', +5', +9'). It may be difficult for the Chargers to continue that trend to start 2016 however as the Chiefs clearly have some regular season momentum as they begin '16 following 10 consec SU wins to close out last season (7-3 ATS) by an avg margin of 15 ppg! FORECAST: KANSAS CITY by 14 3★ PHILADELPHIA over Cleveland - A pair of new coaches face off in this non-conf

matchup in CLE's Hue Jackson and PHI's Doug Pederson. While CLE is also breaking in a new starter at QB with the offssn signing of RG3 (WR Gordon out w/susp), not much has gone well in recent ssn openers as CLE has dropped 11 straight (2-8-1 ATS) heading into 16 (outscored on avg 26-14). With ssn-opening wins in 4 of the past 5 years and a 13-5 ATS mark as a HF prior to MNF, the Eagles & potentially rookie QB Wentz should be able to take advantage of a Browns squad that finished just 1-10 SU (2-8-1 ATS) to close out LY while being outscored by nearly 13 ppg within that span. FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA by 13 **OTHER SELECTIONS**

2★ Buffalo over BALTIMORE - The Ravens have dropped each of their L/3 ssn openers both SU & ATS while the Bills head in after winning outright as 6' & 2 pt dogs in their past 2 openers. With BUF's 10-5-1 ATS record the past 2 yrs as a dog and an even more impressive 9-2 ATS mark in ssn openers, the Ravens' lack of production as a favorite (0-10-2 ATS) may cause some issues in this one as they try to get back on track (QB Flacco coming off ACL inj) this early in '16 against a blitz-happy Ryan-led defense that's aiming for their first playoff appearance since 1999 (longest drought in the NFL). FORECAST: BUFFALO by 3

OTHER PLAYS Carolina at DENVER - Thursday - Rematch of SB 50, a game in which DEN came out victorious despite being held to just 194 ttl yds. While the Broncos return 9 of 11 starters from the NFL's best D (283 ypg all'd), the questions will come with a new QB taking on a CAR D that allowed just 323 ypg LY (#6). After losing 5 straight openers (0-4-1 ATS) from '09-'13, the Panthers have cashed SU & ATS in each of the past 2 ssns while also posting a solid 8-2 ATS mark LY vs NDIV foes. DEN meanwhile has won outright in their previous 4 openers but will be a HD for just the 4th time in the L/5 yrs (2-1 ATS) in this one. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee-Pack.

Tampa Bay by 1 over ATLANTA - The Falcons host the Bucs seeking revenge after a pair of narrow defeats a ssn ago that included a 3 pt OT loss in the dome (ATL on just a 1-6 ATS run vs NFC South foes). ATL's success as a HF has also been quite the issue with just a 2-8 ATS mark the past 2 yrs. While TB did drop 4 consec SU & ATS to end 15 and dropped each of their L/3 ssn openers (all as favorites), there is plenty to like as they enter 16 after Top 10 finishes in both offense and defense along with the promotion of OC Koetter to HC following his solid tutoring of QB Winston during his rookie campaign of a year ago. The final factor for us selecting the dog in this one comes from ATL's lack of success to close out LY as they failed to cover 10 of their L/12.

Minnesota by 7 over TENNESSEE - The Titans have delivered 3 consec ssn opening victories (all as AD's) including a 42-14 (+3) beatdown of the Bucs in Tampa a ssn ago. MIN meanwhile began LY on a sour note with a 20-3 beatdown by SF as a 1'pt AF. While the Titans do appear to have some solid offensive threats behind QB Mariota, their 8-23-1 overall ATS record the past 2 ssns and 7-22-2 ATS mark as a dog are quite a concern as they head into '16 against a Vikings squad that covered 13 of their final 15 reg ssn gms a year ago en route to the NFC North Title while also posting a very impressive 16-4 ATS record in NDIV play (L2Y). Although the loss of Bridgewater is significant at QB (traded for Bradford LW), MIN's bread & butter has always been a strong running gm and equally impressive D which matches up well here.

NY JETS by 3 over Cincinnati - CIN was one of the hottest tms in the NFL to begin last ssn as they rattled off 8 consec victories including a 7-0-1 ATS mark. They now head on the road in Wk 1 for the 6th consec ssn (3-2-1 ATS) to take on a Jets squad that was nearly as impressive to start 15 with a 4-1 SU/ATS record. Following their 31-10 victory a yr ago in the opener vs CLE, the Jets have now come out victorious in each of their L/5 battles in Wk 1 by 10 ppg while also posting a 7-2 ATS mark as a HD. With matchups vs PIT & DEN on deck and a very rough conf to fight through, it may be quite difficult for CIN to get off to the same fast start of a season ago. NEW ORLEANS by 4 over Oakland - After a dominating home ATS mark from '11-'13 that saw the Saints post a 19-4-1 record, a suspect defense (28 ppg '14-'15) has seen their overall Superdome success falter the past 2 years to 6-9-1 ATS. Although some pressn injuries on the questionable def side of the ball have the Saints at less than 100% coming in, it's fairly safe to assume that Brees and the NO offense are in line for yet another Top 5 performance in '16 after LY's #2 ranking (404 ypg). While the Raiders did deliver a 5-1 ATS mark as an AD a yr ago (Saints likely a small favorite on gameday), their recent struggles in ssn openers (0-4 SU, outscored by 9.3 ppg) has us leaning with the home squad in this one.

HOUSTON by 7 over Chicago - While QB Osweiler is set to make his regular ssn debut with the Texans, a familiar opponent comes to town in the Bears who he earned his very 1st career start against a ssn ago when he was with DEN (20-27 for 250 yds & 2 TD in 17-15 win). With HOU's 7-2 ATS run to close out '15 and CHI having gone just 2-7-1 ATS as an AD prior to MNF, the smart money is on the Texans in this one as they have won 5 of their L/6 ssn openers (4-2 ATS) with a 11 ppg avg MOV while also delivering an 11-3 ATS record as a favorite.

Green Bay by 10 over JACKSONVILLE - The Jaguars have struggled in the month of Sept in each of the past 5 ssns with a 3-15 SU mark (4-14 ATS) that includes ssn opening losses in each of the L/4 yrs by 14 ppg. They now play host to a Packers squad that rattled off 6 consec victories to start '15 (5-1 ATS) in which they outscored their foes by a 27-17 margin during that span. With GB's 9-4 ATS run as an AF and the Jags' lack of success as a non-div HD (5-13 ATS) and young defensive roster, it's abundantly clear who we're leaning with in this one.

SEATTLE by 17 over Miami - The Dolphins head to SEA with some recent success in ssn openers as they delivered SU & ATS in each of the past 3 yrs incl LY at WAS as a 3 pt fav. Even more impressive has been their work as a non-div AD in which they've posted a 19-7 ATS mark dating back to the midway part of '09. After going a remarkable 22-2 SU at home from '12-'14, the Seahawks struggled some LY in the Pacific NW with just a 5-3 SU showing. While the MIA San Francisco 49ers

fanbase is rejuvenated with new MIA HC Gase taking over, they clearly have their work cut out for them to start '16 with a pair of trips to take on the NFL's elite in the 1st 2 wks (at NE in Wk 2). With SEA's 6-1 ATS run as DD fav and covering 6 of the L/7 to close out LY's reg ssn, the lofty spread shouldn't be too much to overcome against a MIA squad that ended LY on a 1-6 ATS run.

NY Giants by 3 over DALLAS - These 2 have opened the ssn against each other in 3 of the past 4 yrs with the Cowboys coming out victorious in all 3 matchups (2-1 ATS) outscoring the Giants by 4 ppg within that span including a come-from-behind win LY in DAL (GW TD pass w/:07 left). Following yet another inj to QB Romo this preseason (3-1 SU LY w/Romo, 1-11 w/o), rookie sensation Prescott will get the nod in this one although the Cowboys will also be shorthanded on the def side of the ball to start '16 with quite a few players on susp. DAL is on just a 3-10-1 ATS run while also struggling in home openers by covering just 1 of their L/8! INDIANAPOLIS by 2 over Detroit - While the Lions did close out the '15 campaign with 3 consec SU/ATS wins, they have struggled in non-div play the past 4 ssns with just a 14-23-2 ATS mark. They now head to Indy to take on a Colts team that is in far better position healthwise after an inj-plagued 2015 that saw them miss out on the postssn for the 1st time in 4 years. The Colts haven't gotten off to promising starts as of late however coming out victorious in just 1 of their previous 6 ssn openers. 


