4★ Miami, FI over GEORGIA TECH - In '08 GT ran for 472 yds on the Miami D, embarrasing them on a chilly night in the ATL & since then UM is 6-1 SU/ATS in this series. The HT is 6-2 SU & GT did win the LTH (14) 28-17 (-11). LY GT (+21) scored atd on their opening drive but then UM scored 31 str to win going away 38-21. UM's sked sets them up perfectly here as they are fresh off a bye & beat another option tm AppSt 45-10 (-3'), all'g just 126 (2.6) rush the wk prior. UM is avg 514 ypg incl 272 (7.7) rush, while all'g just 217 ypg incl 65 (1.6) rush ypg. GT enters off an embarrasing perf in a 26-7 (+10) home loss to Clem last Thurs as they were held to just 95 (2.5) rush & were outg d 327-30 at HT! UM is 22-3 ATS in SU away wins & HC Richt is 89-45-2 ATS in SU wins. GT is on a 2-11 ATS run, but is 7-3 as a dog. UM is +297 ypg, while GT is -18 ypg on the ssn! HC Richt is very familiar with GT as he prepared for them every yr while the HC at UGA and will give the Yellow Jacket fans more ammunition as they're getting tired of HC Johnson. FORECAST: Miami, FI by 14

3★ Western Michigan over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - 87th mtg in the 'Battle for the Cannon.' CM is 6-2-1 ATS, but the visitor is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS. CM had won 5 in a row SU, but WM has now won 4 of 5. LY WM (-5) led 34-16 3Q but CM got within 2 w/8:24 left & WM ran out the clock on a 15 pl drive to LY WM (-3) led 34-16 32 but CM gibt Williniz ZW, 24-161 & WM ran out the clock or a 1s pl intrive to win 41-39. LTH ('14) WM (pick 'em) trailed 14-0 2Q, but led 22-17 HT & up 25-20, CM fumbled a punt at the 2 & WM got an easy td to clinch it. We easily cashed our 4★ LPS (our top LPS & part of a 5-1 overall day!) & our revenge play on these pages on WM in their 49-31 (-7) win over Ga Southern. In LY's mtg WM all'd 413 (7.9) rush & improved that to 202 (4.0) TY! WM is avg 469 ypg incl 245 (4.9) rush ypg while QB Terrell is compl nearly 70%. CM enters off a 49-35 (-4') loss at UVA, getting outg'd 569-495. The Chipp's are avg 476 ypg w/QB Rush throwing for 350+ yds in 3 str & are all'g just 53% completions. WM is 6-0 SU/ATS, 10-3 ATS on the road, 7-1 SU on the MAC road & already has road with the control of wins over B10 NW & Illinois TY, while CM is 3-9 as a HD. The Bronco's have a HC date vs a weak NIU (have lost 7 str) on deck. The Chipp's are off a physical gm vs UVA & have a HC date w/BSU on deck. WM wins the Cannon for the 5th time in 6Y! FORECAST: Western Michigan by 8

3★ Arizona St (+) over USC - LY we used a 5★ Sept GOM, which we gave away free to all our subs, on USC on the road and they rolled to a 35-0 halftime lead before bringing in the bkps for the 2H and won 42-14 (-5'). LTH USC had the game won but AZSt would score 3 td's in the final 3:53 incl a 46 yd Hail Mary pass on the final pl of the gm to pull out a 38-34 (+12) win. HC Helton's seat is getting warm after their 1-3 start. LW USC lost at Utah 31-27 (+3') as we went against the Trojans on our Friday Night Marquee. USC was -8 FD's in the gm but benefitted from a 100 yd KR td. We also won a 3★ Key Selection on these pages on AZSt as they beat Cal, 51-41 (-4'). AZSt scored 41 2H pts in the win and QB Wilkins threw for 290 yds and a td and added 72 (3.1) rush yds and 3 tds. The Sun Devils' OFF avg 508 ypg while USC avg 359 ypg. AZSt is on a 9-4 ATS run & USC has already had to play Bama, Stanford & Utah away from home and are looking weary. 2★ FLORIDA ST over North Carolina - These two last met in '10. The Tar Heels are 2-15-1 SU in this series and 1-7-1 SU at Tallahassee but did win LTH in '10, 37-35 (+10'). A week after getting embarrassed by Louisville, FSU bounced back, beating a solid USF team 55-35 (-4). USF had no answer for RB Cook who put up a car high 267 (9.5) rush yds and added another 62 rec. FSU finished w/647 yds which was the most USF has all'd TY. NC enters off a wild & physical 37-36 (-7) win over Pitt. The Heels trailed 36-23 4Q when their D finally made some stops, holding Pitt to three 3 & outs and a fg, then went 63/17pl for the GW td on the final play. NC is 10-5 SU on the ACC road, but just 4-7 ATS as an AD. NC was 11-3 LY but only faced 2 ranked foes all ssn and dropped both SU/ATS & Fedora is just 1-5 vs Top 25 teams SU. FSt must play to impress the voters & UNC's D was on the field for 41 grueling minutes LW & now has to stop the 'Noles OFF?

FORECAST: FLORIDA ST by 17 & now has to stop the 'Noles OFF?

2★ Northern Illinois over BALL ST - NI is 7-0 SU/5-1 ATS in this series, winning SU by 16 ppg, while the home tm is 4-3 SU/2-5 ATS with NI 3-0 ATS their L/3 trips here winning by 21.3 ppg. LY BSt led 10-0 2Q, but NI (-10) came back & led 59-34 before BSt got a td w/2:05 left in the NI 59-41 win. LTH ('14) it was 14-14 HT, but NI (-3) won 35-21. NI is 0-4 SU/ATS TY following their 28-23 (-7) loss vs an FCS foe. They are all'g 517 ypg incl 271 (5.4) rush ypg vs FBS foes. BSt enters off a 31-27 (-3') win over FAU, getting the backdoor cover w/1:47 left. The Cards are avg 436 ypg incl 221 (4.8) rush ypg & are all'g just 97 (2.9) rush ypg. NI is 22-7 ATS away incl 15-5 as an AF & 18-1 SU on the MAC road. BSt is 4-0 ATS TY, but 3-6 as a HF. This is BSt's 1st HG vs an FBS foe. NI has had 4 disappointing losses in non conf play, but we love playing on teams that are coming off SU losses vs FCS foes & series history tells us to back NI here. THURSDAY SEPT 29

Kansas at TEXAS TECH - The HT is 4-7 SU/3-7-1 ATS w/KU 3-1-1 ATS their L/5 trips here incl an outright upset in '01. LY TT led 20-7 HT, but up just 3 w/5:00 left, got a 27 yd IR td w/4:07 left to seal the 30-20 (-32") win. LTH ('14) TT led 27-21 4Q & got a td w/13:21 left to win 34-21 (-13). Both enter fresh off byes. KU lost at Memphis 43-7 (+20") the wk prior. They're all'g 235 (4.9) rush ypg & are #114 FBS avg 81 ypg less then their opp's allow on avg. TT beat La Tech 59-45 (-10") at home the wk prior. They are avg 679 ypg (#2 in nation avg 218 ypg more than their opp's allow on avg), but are all'g 531 ypg (#124 in the nation all'g 17 by 50-30-3 HE their opp's avg). KU is 1-7 ATS off a bye, 16-29-1 as an AD & are on a 4-13 ATS run, while TT is 5-0 as a HF. Connecticut at HOUSTON - UH ply'g w/revenge. LY was the 1st mtg & the situation fav'd CT & they held UH to a ssn low 318 yds. UH was ply'g their least important gm of the month off 2 close wins vs Cincy & Memphis & had 2 big games vs Navy & Temple on deck & were w/o QB Ward. CT was py'g its home finale & most important gm of the month as they needed a win to get to a bowl. We used CT (+10) as the Big Dog POW & they won outright 20-17. UH is 4-0 SU (3-0 ATS vs FBS) & is off a 64-3 (-33) route of TXSt, finishing w/563-142 yd & 30-8 FD edges. QB Ward (shoulder) did ply & hit 20-26-289 w/3 til td's. CT is off a 31-24 (-3) loss vs Syr. WR Thomas had 14-111. CT is 3-10 SU on the AAC road & 7-12 ATS as a dog. UH is 33-19 ATS as a fav & on a 31-14-1 ATS run, but is just 3-7 as a HF.

FRIDAY SEPT 30

Toledo at BYU - 1st mtg & both schls have new HC's. UT is 1-6 SU when travelling to Mtn & PT zone. Their last gm in this area they lost to UTSt in the '12 Idaho Potato Bowl, 41-15 (+10'). UT is 3-0 SU/ATS, are fresh off a bye & a 52-17 (-21) win over FSt the wk prior. UT is avg 564 ypg incl 230 (5.2) rush ypg, while all'g just 252 ypg. We won a 2★ on these pages in BYU's 35-32 (+7) loss to WV LW. BYU finished w/a 521-481 yd edge, but couldn't overcome 4 TO's. Driving w/a chance to win from the WV28, QB Hill's pass was tipped & int'd at the GL w/1:00 left. BYU has lost 3 str to P5 tms by a comb'd 7 pts & this is their 1st non P5 tm TY. BYU is 53-9 SU at home, had won 8 str by 30 ppg prior to their 3 pt loss to UCLA 2 wks ago & went 4-1 as

a HF LY. UT is 16-6 as an AD, but are making a rare trip to the altitude.

Stanford at WASHINGTON - Stan is 9-2 SU/8-4 ATS in this series. The HT is 4-1 SU/ATS. LY RB McCaffrey had 300 ttl yds & Stan won 31-14 (-16') w/478-231 yd & 25-11 FD edges. LTH ('14) we won a 3★ LPS going against Stan in their 20-13 (-7') win. Stan was fortunate in their 22-13 (-3) win at UCLA LW. They trailed 10-3 HT & 13-9 4Q, but took a 3 pt lead w/:24 left, then got the backdoor cover when they ret'd a fumble 42 yds for at dw/no time left. UW is off a 35-28 (-13) OT win over Ariz as they had a 214-64 yd edge in the 2H before all'g 2 td drives late. RB Coleman had 181 (16.5)! Stan is on a 15-5 ATS run, but UW is 17-9 as a HF & 5-2 as a conf fav. This is the 2nd of B2B AG's for Stan on a short wk w/Wazzu on deck, while UW is at home for the 4th time in 5 wks w/a trip to Autzen on deck.

MARQUEES ARE 6-3 67% ON THE

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BOSTON COLLEGE by 14 over buffalo - These schls haven't met s/'06, when BC won 41-0 (-34) w/a 349-92 yd edge. BC enters off a 42-10 (-34') win over an FCS foe. They're avg just 276 ypg, but all'g just 279 ypg vs FBS opp's. Buff is off a 23-20 (+13') outright upset in OT at Army. Buff trailed 10-0 HT & 20-6 mid 4Q, but tied the gm w/2:26 left after a 62/13pl drive & Army's 34 yd fg w/:03 left in regulation was no good. Buff was outg'd 444-265 & outFD'd 21-13. Buff is all'g 291 (5.3) rush ypg & are #119 FBS on D all'g 104 ypg more then their opp's avg. BC was 3-9 LY & is 2-2 TY & won't take Buff lightly. BC is 1-7 ATS at home, but 8-5 as a HF vs the FBS. Buff had lost 7 str ATS until LW.

UM avg 468 ypg and they are almost a perfect balance (230 rush, 5.4, 238 pass) while their D is #4 in the nation, holding foes to 200 ypg less than they avg on the ssn. UW avg 411 ypg and their D is

#20 in the nation, holding foes to 110 ypg less than they avg on the ssn. UW is 10-1 SU/6-4 ATS in B10 road games and HC Chryst is 3-0 as an AD. HC Harbaugh is 5-2 as a HF and this is Mich's 5th str HG. CLEMSON by 3 over Louisville - These 2 have met twice in ACC play & CU is 2-0 SU/0-2 ATS. LY we used used a 3★ LPS & our Sept Marquee GOM on UL. Trailing 20-17 the Card's missed a 38 yd fg w/2:28 left & their final drive ended on a deep pass int at the CU3. CU enters with a couple extra days to prepare, coming off a 26-7 (-10) Thurs night win over GT, their 1st in the ATL s/03. CU had a video-game like 327-30 yd edge at HT! QB Watson ret'd to the scene where he suff'd a torn acl & hit 32-48-304-2-1 &the Tiger D limited GT to just 95 (2.5) rush. LW UL was in a major sandwich gm, coming off their big win over FSU with Clem on deck. The situation didn't affect UL as they beat Marshall (who was w/o st'g QB Litton who was scratched late), 59-28 (-30'). QB Jackson continued his Heisman campaign, throwing for 417 and 7 ttl tds. They held 690-207 yd & 32-16 FD edges. UL is avg 682 ypg and they are #1 in the nation on both OFF & D, avg 303 ypg mor than their foes allow and holding foes to 232 ypg less than their foes avg. Clem is #2 in the nation, holding foes to 209 ypg less than they avg but their OFF has been a underwhelming, avg 51 ypg more than their foes allow (#51 in nation). ÚL is 10-2 as an AD. CU is 18-9-1 as an ACC fav & 28-16-1 as a HF.

AUBURN by 35 over Ulm - HC on the Plains. The last mtg between these schls was in '12 & Aub needed OT to pull out a 31-28 (-15) win. In the prev 3 mtgs, ULM had scored a ttl of just 3 pts. ULM is 3-0 ATS & enters fresh off a bye & a 23-21 (+26') loss at Ga Southern the wk prior. Aub is coming off a big outright upset over LSU, 18-13 (+3') despite not scoring a single td in the gm. K Carlson accounted kicked 6 fg's and Aub barely held on as it appeared LSU won the gm w/a td pass on the final play but after a review, it was determined time ran out. Aub was +50 yds & + 4 FD's for the gm. ULM is all'g 477 ypg incl 291 (5.3) rush ypg. Aub avg 439 ypg incl 235 (4.6) rush ypg. LY ULM lost by an avg of 19 ppg on the road (34 vs Bama, 37 vs UGA) & they have a new HC & lost at Oklahoma by 42 pts TY. Aub is in

an SEC sandwich and the Tigers are 1-9 as a HF.

AIR FORCE by 7 over Navy - There've been 8 outright upsets the L13Y in this series. Navy is 10-3 SU/10-2-1 ATS & had won 7 in a row SU, but the series is 3-3 the L/6 mtgs. LY AF had 3 TO's in 4 poss, staking Navy to a 27-0 lead early 3Q & the Middies won 33-11 (-6) w/a 386-277 yd edge. LTH ('14) the gm was tied at 14 at HT, but AF pulled off the outright upset, 30-21 (+3'). AF has the exp edge w/14 ret str's, while Navy has just 8. Navy enters fresh off a bye & a 21-14 (-6) win over Tulane the wk prior. AF comes off a 27-20 (-4') win over conf foe Utah St. The Falcons led 27-13 in the 4Q and UTSt added a td w/just 0:32 left. Despite the convincing win, AF was actually outg'd 414-326 & outFD'd 22-17 but the difference was 2 UTSt TO's that led to AF td's. Navy is avg 316 (6.0) rush ypg, but did allow the TU option OFF to rush for 240 (5.1). AF is outrushing tms by an avg of 359-52 and is +172 ypg TY. Navy is 26-9 as an AD & is on a 12-5 ATS run. AF is 10-2 ATS at home vs FBS foes and 13-5-1 ATS off a SU win.

SOUTHERN MISS by 28 over Rice - Rice is 4-2 SU and 4-2 ATS in this series. Rice won 41-23 (-8') here in '14. LY they brought SM in for homecoming and the Golden Eagles had a ssn high 682 yds and led 58-0 in the 4Q, routing Rice on the road 65-10 (-7'). LW Southern Miss won easily, 34-7 (-12') at UTEP. SM finished w/+120 yd & +8 FD edges. Rice lost 42-35 (-7) LW at home vs NT. The Owls finished with +52 yd & +10 FD edges but were -2 TO's and was SOD on 4&1 in OT. For the ssn, Rice is -202 ypg and their D is #121 in the nation, as they have all'd 120 ypg more than their foes avg. SM was 4-1 as a HF LY (avg MOV 29.8) but is 0-2 TY. Rice is 1-7 ATS overall and 2-7-1 as a AD.

COLORADO ST by 7 over Wyoming - WY had won 4 str in this series but CSU has now won 3 in a row SU (by 21 ppg), 2-1 ATS. The visitor is 5-3 SU/ATS. LY the Rams led 26-0 on the road until a Cowboy TD with 2:24 left and WY gained 31% of their yds on that final drive. LTH CSU led 31-3 mid-3Q. The Cowboys, down big, would go 75/13, 92/11, 74/3 with the game already decided to make the stats misleading. WY was upset LW on the road vs EM on a Fri night, 27-24 (-3'). The difference in the game came on the ground as WY was outrushed 239-79. The Cowboys benefitted from 2 int's ret for td and actually led 24-20 late 4Q. LW CSU lost 31-24 (+17) at Minnesota. CSU was outg'd 417-369 but did hold a 24-21 FD edge. On the Rams final drive, they were SOD at the Minn45. CSU has all'd 410 ypg incl. 262 pass yds. WY has all'd 444 ypg 298 pass yds. This is the MW opener for both tms and WY is 9-15 ATS vs MW foes. CSU is 13-5 as a HF while WY is 24-12 as an AD.

ALABAMA by 42 over Kentucky - These 2 last met in '13 and Bama (-26') won 48-7. UK has never won in Tuscaloosa going 0-9 SU but the LTH was '08 vs #2 Bama when they only lost 17-14. The visitor is 5-0 ATS. After losing their F/2 gms, KY has bounced back and won their L/2 incl LW's 17-10 (-2') home win vs SC. With QB Barker hurt, KY turned to bkp QB Johnson who threw for 135 in the gm. This was KY's 3rd str victory over SC. The KY DL made their presence felt w/a ssn high 4 sks. The 'Cats finished w/351-268 yd & 23-16 FD edges. HC Saban is a Kent St alum and he did his alma mater a favor by pounding them 48-0 (-43) while also giving them a nice fat check in exchange for the beat down. Bama led 41-0 at HT and finished +336 yds & +21 FD's. KY is 3-9 as an AD and 7-18-1 ATS vs the SEC. Bama is 28-17-1 ATS vs the SEC. Tennessee by 7 over GEORGIA - UGA is 11-5 SU in this series but UT is 4-0 ATS. LY UGA lost RB

Chubb on the 1st ply of the gm but still led 24-3 late 2Q. UT got 2 late td's at the end of the half and went 78/8 for a td with 5:48 left to win 38-31. Vols fans felt deja vu LW in the 1H as UF jumped out to a 21-3 HT lead thanks to UT's failure to catch passes and convert on the goal line. However, the Vols OFF got going in the 2H and Tenn's Def forced 5 3&O's and an int to start the 2H. WR Jennings made a juggling tip toe grab on the sideline before taking it into the EZ, giving Tenn their 1st lead and they didn't give it back. QB Dobbs threw for a car high 319 and 4 tds and added 80 (4.7) rush yds. LW we won an easy 4★ LPS going against UGA in their 45-14 (+7) loss to Ole Miss. The Dawgs were outg'd 319-165 in the 1H as Ole Miss jumped out 31-0. RB Chubb was inj'd late in the gm (CS). UGA avg 413 ypg and is +30 ypg on the ssn. Tenn avg 388 ypg and is +35 ypg on the ssn. Tenn is 7-1 ATS away from Neyland but this is their 1st true road gm TY. UGA has 3 str non covers and hasn't been a HD s/11.

APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over Georgia St - ASt has dominated as SBC rivals (2-0 SU/ATS), winning by a comb'd score of 81-3 w/a 1,065-287 yd edge! LY even with GSt making a bowl, ASt (-15') rolled to a 37-3 win. LTH ('14) GSt (+13) was ply'g in snow for the 1st time in schl hist & trailed 27-0 at HT en route to a 44-0 loss. GSt enters this gm fresh off a bye & a much closer then expected 23-17 (+34') loss to Wisc the wk prior. App St is coming off a 45-38 (-5') win at Akron (won Top LP Ttl's, covered by 26 pts!). RB Cox sat w/an inj but App St didn't notice he was gone as bkp RB Moore ran for a car high 257 (6.6). App St led 31-14 at HT. UA scored w/5:55 left in the 4Q but never got close to tying. GSt is avg just 248 ypg incl 46 (2.2) rush ypg, while all'g 462 ypg incl 325 (5.3) rush ypg. New st'g QB Manning is coming off the best effort of his car (20-29-269-1-0) vs the Badgers. App St avg 212 (4.5) rush ypg but also allows 275 pass ypg and 145 (5.8) rush. GSt is 7-1 ATS away incl 15-4 as an AD. ASt is 6-2 SU home vs SBC opp's.

Florida by 14 over VANDERBILT - UF had won 22 str in this series but were upset 34-17 (-10) Fat home in '13. The Gators got revenge in '14 here, 34-10 (-10'). LY UF was off their big win vs Georgia and were trying to wrap up the SEČ East. VŬ led 7-6 into the 4Q with UF having just 57 yds in the 2H. After a 12 yd VU punt, UF hit the go ahead 43 yd fg with 2:22 left for a 9-7 win (-20"). LW it appeared UF would extend their win streak over Tenn to 12 gms as they led 21-3 at HT. LW we used Utah as our Friday Night Marquee and the Utes came through with a 31-27 (-2') home win vs USC. Utah was +8 FD's for the gm and got a big perf from QB Williams who threw for 270 yds and had for 3 ttl tds. LW we went against Cal as a 3★ Key Selection on these pages against as the Golden Bears lost 51-41 (+4'). Cal's OFF has been impressive TY, avg 595 ypg and putting up the most yds allowed on all of their foes. The Utes are +114 ypg on the ssn le Cal is +103 ypg. Utah is an impressive 6-3 SU on the P12 road incl wins at UCLA, Stanford, Oregon and Washington L2Y. Cal HC Dykes is just 3-10 ATS vs opp's off a SU win.

KSt is 2-0 ATS vs FBS opp's TY & enters off a 35-0 (-51') gm shortened win (called at HT due to weather) 2-0 ATS vs FBS opps TY & enters off a 35-0 (-51') gm shortened win (called at HT due to weather) over an FCS foe. They're avg 214 (5.0) rush ypg & all'g just 242 ypg incl 94 (2.8) vs the FBS. KSt has held both their FBS foes to ssn lows in yds as they're #12 in the nation on D holding foes to 133 ypg below their ssn avg! We won a 2★ on these pages as well as our free Button 3 underdog POW (part of a 7-1 wk on college comps!) going against WV in their physical 35-32 (-7) win over BYU.WV was outg'd 521-481 & benefited from a pick 6. UCLA by 17 over Arizona - UA had actually won 5 in a row but UCLA has now won 4 str by 24 ppg. LY we had a 3★ LPS on UCLA who were down numerous inj'd players on D. The Bruins were on the road at Arizona but rolled to a 56-30 (-2) win in a game they led 42-14 at the half. AZ is coming off a closer than expected loss to Washington, 35-28 (+13) in OT. UA was down to their 4th string RB but QB Dawkins, filling in for inj'd QB Solomon, had a big game, throwing for 167 and rushing for 176 (13.5). UA benefited from 2 missed fg's and was outg'd 171-12 for part of the 2H but managed to stay in the gm thanks to UW mistakes. Baylor by 17 over IOWA ST - The HT is 6-1 SU/5-1-1 ATS in this series. BU is 6-2 SU/5-2-1 ATS. In BU's

last trip here they led 35-7 at the half (-21) but would only win 49-28 with ISU getting a 51 yd td pass with 4:42 left for the push. LY BU jumped out to a 35-0 lead again but ISU battled back within 35-20 and only lost 45-27 (+36') on the road. Prior to their last trip here, ISU had actually been 4-1 SU at home with BU's only win by 10 pts. LW we cashed in on a 3★ LPS as well as a Key Selection on these pages with Baylor as they got a home win vs OKSt 35-24 (-7'). OB Russell threw for 387 yds and 4 tds. We easily won on our B12 POW (Free on Button #9, CFB Comp plays finished 7-1 LW) on Iowa St in their 44-10 (-7) win over Iowa St. The Cyclones led 23-3 at HT & finished +171 yds for the gm. BU is +239 ypg on the ssn and avg 131 ypg more than their foes have all'd on the ssn (#22 in nation). ISU is -40 ypg on the ssn but did hold TCU to their lowest yds of the season earlier TY. BU is 5-10-1 as an AF. ISU was 0-3 ATS off a SU win LY and LW was their 1st of the ssn. Baylor is off OKSt but has a bye on deck.

Michigan St by 3 over INDIANA - The winner of this game is awarded the Old Brass Spittoon. MSU is 11-1 SU/10-2 ATS in this series. LY the game was a lot closer than the final score suggests as MSU only

led 28-26 in the 4Q and got td's off of a fmbl'd KO, SOD with IU taking chances at the end and won 52-26 at home (-16). Just one wk after upsetting ND on the road, MSU was upset themselves at home, 30-6 (-3') vs Wisky. Sparty actually finished +8 yds & +6 FD's. The score was just 13-6 in the 3Q when MSU fmb'd and it was ret'd for a td. IU enters off a 33-28 (-7) home loss to WF although the Hoosiers actually dominated the ydg, outgaining WF 611-352. IU trailed 24-7 in the 3Q and scored their L/td with just 0:11 left. QB Lagow threw 5 int's incl a pick 6. MSU is +81 ypg on the ssn and has held foes to -99 ypg less than they avg for the ssn (#27 in nation). IU avg 517 ypg and has avg 170 ypg more than their foes have all'd (#8 in nation). MSU had been 12-2 ATS as an AF but were 0-3 in that role LY and is just 3-10 overall as a fav. IU is 0-3 as a HF. TCU by 6 over Oklahoma - OU is 4-1 SU/3-2 in this series as B12 rivals. TCU hasn't been fav'd in any of their 7 recent mtgs. LY TCU was w/o QB Boykin & top WR Doctson so the line climbed to +17.
