LSU had a 304-144 yd edge at the half & won 35-25 (-7). LSU got off to a good start in the post-Miles era LW, crushing Missouri 42-7 (-12'). With a more wide open OFF & a breath of fresh air, LSU put up a ssn high 634 yds despite not having RB Fournette, LSU raced out to a 21-0 lead at the half & Mizzou didn't score until the 4Q. RB Guice went for 163 (9.6) & 3 td's while RB Williams added 130 (6.2) & 3 td's. They also held Mizzou to a ssn low 265 yds, 305 yds below their ssn avg! Air Force by 10 over WYOMING - The HT is 4-7 SU/ATS. AF is 4-13 SU on the MW road the L4Y. WY has been to 1 bowl gm this decade & AF 5 so it's surprising that WY is 3-2 SU/7-0 ATS in the series. LY AF led 28-3 w/14:18 left, but WY got a couple late td's to 'only' lose 31-17 (+21'). LW AF led rival Navy just 3-0 at HT but caught a break when Navy LB Gonzales was inj & the Falcons scored have Clem on deck, but may be more excited for this rare trip by the Irish. **OHIO by 17 over Bowling Green** - BG is 4-0 SU/14-3 ATS incl 5 str covers. LW we came away with an easy winner as we went against Stanford on our Friday Night Marquee. In a gm that likely decided the P12 North Title, Stan was blown out 44-6 (+3) at Wash as the Cardinal were completely dominated from the onset, trailing 23-0 at HT. Stan was outg'd 424-213 & outFD'd 22-14 and the -211 yd deficit was Stan's worst since their '09 bowl gm. Wash St enters after pulling an outright upset, beating Oregon 51-33 (+2').
