KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Tampa Bay over NEW ORLEANS - A tale of opposite strengths clash in the Superdome as the Saints (31 ppg, 454 ypg at home TY) take on a Bucs squad that's all'd fewer than 20 pts in 4 of the past 6 gms (29 ppg over the F/8 wks). Tampa's defense got the upper hand in the previous meeting a few wks back as they held the Saints to just 11 pts & 294 yds in the 5 pt win. The Saints offense was able to get back on track LW in Glendale as they put up 48 pts and 488 yds in the 7 pt victory (+3). While the Bucs do head to the "Big Easy" following their 1st loss in 6 tries a week ago to DAL (4-1 TO deficit in 6 pt loss), a win here (6-1 ATS away from home TY) could do wonders for a potential playoff berth in the NFC.

3★ Atlanta over CAROLINA - The Falcons and their #1 scoring offense (33.5 ppg) continued their tear through the league a week ago against the 49ers as they put up 550 yds in the 28 pt win while moving back into sole possession of 1st place in the NFC South after TB's loss to DAL. They now head to Charlotte to take on a Panthers squad that they had no issue handling earlier in the year in the 48-33 (+3) win. With the Panthers on short rest following their MNF trip to D.C. to face the Redskins and their 5-10 ATS run overall, we'll go ahead and call for the Falcons to get the job done by double digits in this one.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Tennessee over JACKSONVILLE - Following a crucial come-from-behind win in Arrowhead where they scored the final 12 pts incl the GW 53 yd FG as time expired, the Titans are back on the road for a 2nd consec wk to take on a Jags squad that they were able to thoroughly dominate earlier in the yr with a 36-22 victory (494-370 yd edge, led 27-0 at HT). With 8 consec losses heading into their final HG of the ssn (blew 20-8 lead in 3Q), it appears that JAX will be going through the motions in the final 2 wks following HC Bradley's firing. While TEN has historically struggled against their DIV foes with a 7-25 ATS record, we expect them to get into the win column again here to set up a showdown with HOU in Wk 17 for the AFC South crown.

NY Giants at PHILADELPHIA - Thursday - Following another stellar defensive effort against the Lions where they surrendered just 2 FG's in the 11 pt victory, the Giants head back into DIV play looking to earn the ssn sweep of Philly. The Eagles meanwhile have fallen on hard times after their hot start with losses in each of the past 5 (1-4 ATS) incl LW's defeat at the hands of the Ravens where they went for and failed the 2 pt conv w/:04 left that would have given them the 1 pt win. While the Giants have covered 7 of their past 9 overall, the Eagles did have a dominating 443-302 yd edge in the previous matchup and could keep this game within range of the cover. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System (credit never expires) or through the Marquee 7-pk (expires Super Bowl Sunday).

Washington by 7 over CHICAGO - Following a 3 pt defeat at home against the Packers where they stormed back from a 17 pt hole in the 4Q, the Bears remain at Soldier Field in this one to take on a Redskins squad traveling on short rest following their MNF meeting with the Panthers (WAS 8-2 ATS streak in AG's). With the Redskins winning each of the previous 6 matchups in this series (5-1 ATS) and needing to win out for a potential playoff berth, we'll go ahead and give them the TD edge here as they're on an impressive 13-4 ATS run overall

BUFFALO by 4 over Miami - After an easy victory a week ago against the winless Browns where RB McCoy posted another big performance (153 yds, 2 TD's), the Bills are back at home for the final time this ssn in search of revenge from a 3 pt loss earlier in the ssn at South Beach (MIA 454-267 yd edge). Despite having starting QB Tannehill on the sideline with a knee inj (expected to miss here as well), the Dolphins took advantage of some key 3Q miscues by the Jets in the 34-13 victory (NYJ 360-303 yd edge). With cold weather and potential snow to deal with for the Dolphins (7-15 ATS vs DIV foes) and the Bills potentially playing for Rex Ryan's future, we'll go ahead and give the home team the 4 pt edge in this one.

GREEN BAY by 14 over Minnesota - After getting past the Bears a week ago in Soldier Field (blew 17 pt lead in the 4Q only to kick the GW FG as time expired, GB did have a pair of TD's dropped by WR Adams in the game!!), the Packers return to Lambeau seeking revenge from a 17-14 defeat in the Vikings' first regular ssn gm in their new stadium (GB ssn-low 263 yds). MIN on the other hand was unable to get any footing in their blowout home loss to the Colts a week ago as they trailed 27-0 at HT with a 281-69 yd disadvantage. With the Packers now controlling their own destiny in the NFC North, we'll go ahead and side with them in this one as they do have solid overall success inside of the division with a 22-11 ATS mark despite LW's non-cover.

NEW ENGLAND by 14 over NY Jets - Following a successful road trip in Mile High against the Broncos where they clinched a 1st Rnd bye in the 16-3 win, the Patriots return home to Foxboro for the final time this season with the #1 seed in the AFC potentially on the line. Standing in their way is a rival Jets squad that comes in following a rough 2H performance a week ago against the Dolphins where they surrendered 21 pts in the 3Q (outgained MIA 360-303, 4-1 TO deficit incl having a punt blk'd for a TD). In their previous meeting this ssn the Patriots needed some late game heroics by QB Brady to steal away a win at MetLife by a 22-17 score (-8). While NE has won 5 of the past 7 matchups overall, they've yet to cover during that span with an 0-6-1 ATS mark which could bode well for the Jets (16-5 ATS run as a DIV AD) to keep this one within the spread.

San Diego by 1 over CLEVELAND - Following another subpar performance a week ago against the Bills where they were held to just 14 ED's and 269 vids the Browns (0-8 ATS run) return home for the

San Diego by 1 over CLEVELAND - Following another subpar performance a week ago against the Bills where they were held to just 14 FD's and 269 yds, the Browns (0-8 ATS run) return home for the final time this ssn and still in search of their inaugural win of '16. The Chargers blew their 7th 2H lead of the ssn a week ago against the Raiders as they were held to just 263 yds in the 3 pt loss. While we'll go ahead and call for the Browns to get one step closer to the 2nd 0-16 ssn in NFL history, the potential for severe cold and snowy conditions could slow the warm-weather Chargers (5-10 ATS as a NDIV AF) down enough to give CLE the cover.

OAKLAND by 7 over Indianapolis - After getting back on track a week ago in comeback fashion against the Chargers (GW FG w/2:40 left), the Raiders earned their 1st playoff berth since 2012 while moving ahead of the Chiefs in the AFC West in the process. The Colts meanwhile head to the Black Hole after blasting the Vikings on the road a week ago (27-0 lead at HT, 411-282 yd edge). While the Raiders have gone just 2-8 ATS in their home contests dating back to last ssn, the pressure is all on the Colts in this one as they come in a game back of HOU and TEN in the AFC South with just 2 contests remaining.

LOS´ ANGELES by 6 over San Francisco - While the Rams' 24-3 loss to the Seahawks last Thur (1st gm without HC Fisher, outgained 299-183) was their 5th consec defeat, the 49ers come into this meeting having lost their past 13 following another blowout loss in ATL (outgained 550-271). In their previous meeting back in Wk 1 it appeared that the 49ers had all the right answers for the visiting Rams as they delivered the 28-0 win while allowing a ssn-best 185 yds in the process. Although LA could be missing QB Goff in this matchup following LW's concussion (CS), a Rams defense that's allowed less than 300 yds in 6 of their past 8 is worth backing in this one against a 49ers squad that's DEAD LAST in the NFL in total defense (31 ppg, 425 ypg).

SEATTLE by 7 over Arizona - Following an easy 21 pt win a week ago against the Rams (299-183 yd edge) where they earned their 3rd NFC West Title in the past 4 ssns, the Seahawks return

PITTSBURGH by 6 over Baltimore - Following a comeback (trailed 20-6 in 2Q) road win a wk ago against DIV rival CIN where they connected on 6 FG's and had a 382-222 yd edge, PIT returns to Heinz Field for the final 2 gms of the regular ssn (28 ppg, 409 ypg at home TY). BAL meanwhile comes into this matchup sitting a game back in the division after their narrow home victory over the Eagles (PHI failed on GW 2 pt att w/:04 left, key int late in Eagles territory with BAL up by 10 kept Philly in the gm). In their earlier matchup in BAL, the Ravens jumped out to a 21-0 lead as a 3 pt dog before having to hold off a late PIT charge (2 TD's in final 8 min) in QB Roethlisberger's return from inj (still hobbled). With the Steelers having covered 5 straight overall along with 10 of their past 13 contests as a HF, we expect them to continue that trend here while claiming the AFC North in the process.

Denver at KANSAS CITY - SNF - Tough situation for the Broncos here as they head to Arrowhead following consec losses to TEN & NE (just 13 combined pts the L/2 wks for DEN). The Chiefs mean-while come into this matchup after being upset at home a week ago against the Titans who scored the final 12 pts of the game and nailed a 53 yd FG as time expired (TEN 20-13 FD & 386-317 yd edges). In one of the more entertaining gms of the '16 ssn a month ago, the Broncos and Chiefs went down to the wire in Mile High with KC coming out victorious (banked in the FG as OT expired). While the Chiefs are just 4-15 ATS as a DIV HF, the pressure will likely fall on the defending SB Champ Broncos in this one as a 3rd loss in a 4-wk span could potentially end their playoff aspirations.
