Wyoming enters off an easy victory against New Mexico as their defense forced 7 Lobo TO's while allowing just 3 pts & 184 ttl yds. While WY QB Allen is the much more talked about QB, CSU's Stevens has put up far better numbers, throwing for more yards with a higher completion % and a 22-9 ratio! The Rams won't have any trouble putting up points and the Pokes are #128 on OFF averaging 133 ypg less than their foes allow. With revenge on their mind after their 21 pt home loss a year ago as 6 pt chalk, we'll gladly take an angry CSU squad here as they've now covered 6 of their past 7 MW road matchups.

FORECAST: COLORADO ST by 10

3★ MICHIGAN over Minnesota - These rivals first played in 1892 and the winner is awarded the Little Brown Jug. UM is on a 6-2 ATS series run. MN enters having lost 4 of 5 and it's worth noting that HC Fleck indicated they didn't have the horses up front to compete with the more physical B10 teams and that has played out to be true. The first word that comes to mind regarding UM is "physical" and they enter off season highs in rush and total yards and have the #5 D, holding foes to 140 ypg less than their average. RFR QB Peters provided a spark after leading the OFF to td's in his F/3 drives. The Gophers are on a 7-12-2 overall ATS run, enter off a physical trip to Iowa, and are on the second of B2B away games so we won't mind laying the double digits with UM.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 20

3★ ARIZONA ST over Colorado - While it appeared that the Sun Devils had turned their ssn around with a pair of wins vs Wash & Utah, they were unable to make it 3 in a row LW as USC went into the desert and left with the easy 31 pt victory (outgained 613-366). They now face off with a Buffs squad that had no issue getting the victory last year, but ASU was extremely banged up. The 2017 campaign has been much different for Colorado however as they sit at just 2-4 SU & ATS in the P12 despite LW's 16 pt win over Cal (QB Montez 347 pass yds, 3 TD). With the home team having covered 3 of the past 4 in this series and the Buffs having failed to cover 6 of their L/8 overall, we'll call for ASU to get back on track (21-11 ATS as P12 HF) in this one. **FORECAST: ARIZONA ST by 11**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Stanford (+) over WASHINGTON ST - Following a scary trip to Corvallis where they needed a TD pass with just :20 left to survive by 1 (OSU 264-222 yd edge), the Cardinal are back in the Pacific NW for a 2nd consecutive week to take on a Cougars squad that's off a loss in Tucson where QB Falk was benched early for ineffectiveness (b/kp Hilinski 509 pass yds but 4 int). WSU allowed Arizona to rush for 310 (9.1) LW and don't match up well against a physical Stanford squad. While the Cougars have covered 6 of their past 8 as P12 home chalk, we'll ride with the away dog Cardinal here as Bryce Love (1387 rush, 10.3 ypc) should be ready to return following a 1-gm absence with an ankle injury (Stanford avg 258 ypg rush with him in lineup).

FORECAST: STANFORD by 7

2★ Florida (+) over MISSOURI - LY MO QB Locke had his worst career gm, going 4-18-39-0-2 in a blowout loss vs Florida. The Gators are off an embarrassing loss to rival UGA which resulted in HC McElwain being let go. Former Miami, FL head coach Randy Shannon is serving as Interim HC. MO enters off B2B non-conf wins by a comb'd score of 120-33. While this might seem impressive, MO is known for blowing out non-P5 foes and now they step back into SEC play vs a much tougher opponent. The Gators are +13 ypg in SEC play while MO is -95 ypg. QB Zaire could get his chance here after coming in late last week. It's been smart money to play on a team after a coaching change and despite their struggles the Gators will feel very disrespected to be a dog against a Tigers squad that is 1-4 ATS at home.

FORECAST: FLORIDA by 6

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 1ST:

Central Michigan at WESTERN MICHIGAN - It's the Battle for the Victory Cannon! WM is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in the series. The favorite is 8-2-1 ATS, while the visitor is on a 4-0 ATS run. LY the Broncos put up the most pts (49) and had the largest MOV (39) since they both became FBS members. CM has held each of their L/3 foes to season lows in yards, but WM has gained the most yards 2 of their L/3 foes have allowed. A win here makes WM bowl eligible. The Broncos are avg 252 (4.9) rush ypg in MACtion, while the Chipp's are allowing 190 (4.3) in conference play including 310 (5.5) 2 games ago while hosting Toledo. CM is 11-4 an AD. WM is on a 29-15-1 ATS run in the regular season.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 2ND:

TOLEDO by 6 over Northern Illinois - Toledo snapped a 6 game series losing streak last year. The visitor is 5-0 ATS and there have been 8 upsets in the L16Y. NIU has uncharacteristically struggled running the ball, but QB Childers has been solid since replacing the injured Santacaterina, completing 61% w/a 9-1 ratio. The Rockets have a balanced offense that relies on the run, but could have trouble finding open running lanes as NIU is allowing just 2.7 ypc. The Huskies are 28-9 ATS on the road and 19-5 as an AD. Those trends as well as series history has us leaning with NIU.

E MICHIGAN by 26 over Ball St - Ball St was 10-1 in the series until last year's meeting when EM overcame a 21-0 deficit to win. Sure the Cards are in revenge mode, but there's no way we can back them. Since the injury to QB Neal they've lost 4 straight by an average of 50-8! EM enters losers of 6 straight, but a closer look reveals they've lost those by a combined 23 points including 3 in OT! The Eagles are on a 16-3-1 overall ATS run and 9-3-1 ATS in MACtion, while BSU is on an 0-6 overall ATS run. EM still has bowl aspirations and with a favorable sked down the stretch look for them to get a confidence building win as they're much better than their record suggests.

Navy by 7 over TEMPLE - Temple is 5-1 ATS in this series. Both schools enter off byes. Navy is in revenge mode after losing last years AAC Title game as they were also flirting with a NY6 bowl bid. Navy QB Abey has rushed for 100+ yards in a school record 8 straight games & recovered from his head inj during the bye. Temple defended the option in their last game and allowed Army to rush for 278 (5.0). QB Nuttle compl 69% for 290 yards in his first career start for an injured Logan Marchi (CS) vs our #101 pass eff D & Navy is even worse at #118. The Middies are 31-19 ATS away, but the Owls are 18-8-1 as a HD.

TROY by 12 over Idaho - This is Troy's third home game in 4 weeks. No Jordan Chunn, no problem for Troy as Josh Anderson has filled in nicely for the injured RB (CS) and ID is allowing 187 (4.7) rush ypg away. The Vandals gained a season high 518 yards last week, but the Trojans are holding their foes to 33 ypg below their average. In last years matchup ID was held to a season low 255 yards. While the stats favor Troy, it's hard to ignore their home struggles as they're 11-22 as a HF. The Vandals counter with a 12-0 run as a conference AD and you have to respect those recent trends.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 3RD:

Marshall by 4 over FAU - Marshall is 4-0 SU but FAU is 3-1 ATS in the series. FAU is the last remaining undefeated team in CUSA play and enters on a hot streak w/4 straight wins all by at least 2 td's. Last week we used them as a 3★ LPS vs WKU (-7) and they dominated the 4Q for a 42-28 win. RB Singletary went for another 244 (6.8) and 4 td's, giving him 1,053 (6.6) rush yds on the season. Marshall comes in after being outright upset by FIU but the Herd actually held 505-401 yard & 29-21 FD edges. FAU avg 296 (6.3) rush ypg but Marshall only allows 124 (3.5). The Owls are +125 ypg in CUSA play while the Herd is +141. Marshall has covered their L/3 as a dog and are 7-3 as an AD while FAU is 4-10-1 as a fav. A few weeks back we used Marshall as our Friday Marquee (also rare 3★ LPS) in their blowout win at MT. Could we use the Herd as our Friday Marquee again?

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Memphis by 13 over TULSA - While Tulsa has covered 3 of the L/4 meetings, Memphis is 4-1-1 ATS away in this series. The Hurricane is playing a 10th straight week and this is their lone home game in a 5 week span, while the Tigers are on the road for the fourth time in 6 weeks. The Hurricane has alternated good and bad performances the last 7 weeks so this is their week to perform below expectations. Memphis is averaging 50 ppg their L/4 games and Tulsa is #125 on D allowing 111 ypg more than their foes average. This is the Tigers' third straight weekday game so they're used to this role and Hurricane RB Brooks, a perfect compliment to Brewer was injured LW (CS). Memphis is 11-2 ATS vs a foe off a SU loss and Tulsa is 3-8 as a HD.

UTAH by 4 over UCLA - Following a 21 pt blowout loss to the Huskies where they were outgained by a 424-232 yd clip, the Bruins are back on the road for the 3rd time in a 4-wk span. The Utes meanwhile have dropped 4 straight since their bye week (4-0 prior) as Oregon ran for 346 yds on the ground en route to their own 21 pt victory. In their matchup a ssn ago, the Utes jumped out to an early 14-0 lead before having to hold on late as a 6' pt dog. While the visitor has now won 4 in a row SU & ATS in this series, keep an eye on whether Bruins QB Rosen will be under center here after leading LW with injury. Although the Utes are clearly struggling, trips to the elevation and potential cold temps of SLC during November is never easy for teams that reside in the South.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 4TH:

Baylor by 13 over KANSAS - Baylor is on a 6-1 ATS run in this series. Something has to give as these schools enter with a combined 0-14 record vs FBS foes! Despite losing their ninth straight Sunflower Showdown, KU played their best game of the season, while the Bears OFF struggled mightily vs Texas as QB's Smith & Brewer continue to alternate. While neither school has done anything to make us have faith in backing them, recent trends don't give us much faith either with Baylor being 4-12-1 as an AF, while the Jayhawks are on a 10-22-1 overall ATS run.

Clemson by 10 over NORTH CAROLINA ST - Last year Clemson was extremely fortunate to escape NCSt as the Wolfpack missed a GW fg at the end of regulation, then Clem won in OT. Clem had won the prev 4 in this series by DD. QB Bryant looked healthy in the Tigers' win over GT last week, throwing for 207 & rushing for 67 (5.6). NCSt is in the midst of a rough schedule stretch that finds them coming off a 21 point loss to ND with a resurgent BC on deck. Clem is only +16 ypg on the road while NCSt is +66 ypg at home. The last time Clem went on the road they suffered an outright upset to Cuse but Bryant missed the 2H of that game and NCSt is 4-7 as a HD.

PURDUE by 17 over Illinois - These rivals have played since 1890 and the Purdue Cannon has been on the line s/43. Purdue is on a 4-2 ATS series run. The Boilermakers had been using a 2 QB system, but Blough took every snap in their loss vs Nebraska. IL enters off their best D performance of the season, and a large part of Purdue's resurgence has been the play of their 2, which is holding foes to 35 ypg less than their average. The Illini have used a 2 QB rotation their L/2 games with George & true frosh Thomas, but the duo combined to hit 29% last week. We feel IL's closer than expected game vs Wiscy last week had more to do with the Badgers in a flat spot and aren't ready to trust a team starting the most true frosh in the country. IL is 7-17 as an AD and on a 4-9 overall ATS run, while Boilermakers HC Brohm is 12-4 as a HF and on a 20-10-1 overall ATS run.

Mississippi by 3 over KENTUCKY - These two haven't met since 2011. Rarely does a team win while being outgained 445-371 and also -4 TO's but KY managed to do that LW in their 2nd win over Tenn in the last 33 years. Playing w/o QB Patterson for the first time, Ole Miss blew a 31-7 2Q lead and lost on a GW fg with :04 left vs Ark. QB Ta'amu was impressive in his debut, throwing for 368 yds. The Wildcats are -79 ypg in SEC play, -35 ypg at home and have been outgained by every FBS foe they've faced. The Rebels are -88 ypg in SEC play but has also faced a much tougher sked that includes Bama, Auburn & LSU. UK is 15-27-1 ATS vs SEC foes and are 0-5 as a fav this year. Ole Miss is 15-8 as an AD.

FLORIDA ST by 6 over Syracuse - Florida St was a National Title contender coming into the season while Cuse was in year 2 of a rebuild. Now Florida St is just hoping to reach a bowl after dropping to 2-5 while Cuse needs 2 wins to reach their first bowl since '13. The Noles were held to their lowest yards output since '11 in their embarrassing loss to BC LW. QB Blackman is coming off his worst performance of the season against BC's #1 ranked pass eff D but Syracuse is only #61. The Orange is +87 ypg on the season and +42 ypg vs ACC foes. FSU is only -12 ypg on the season and -11 ypg vs ACC foes. The Noles can no longer afford to look ahead to Clemson while Syracuse is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago put up the most yards Clemson has allowed all season, but FSU is in a must win situation and has the talent edge.

NEBRASKA by 6 over Northwestern - NW is 4-2 ATS in this series as B10 rivals and the visitor is 5-1 SU/ATS. This is Nebraska's lone home game over a 5 week stretch. We cashed our Underdog POW on these pages as well as a 3★ LPS on the Huskers. Sure they scored the GW td w/14 left, but they also had a 471-363 yd edge as QB Lee has rebounded from a poor start to the season (9 int's F/135 passes) and had a career high 461 pass yds (1 int L/155 passes). NW enters off a misleading final as they beat MSU in 3OT despite being outgained 490-357 thru 4Q's. While its concerning that Nebraska has no running threat, the Cats have our #70 ranked pass eff D. The Huskers do struggle in this role as they're 5-12-1 as a HF, while NW is 23-9 as an AD.

Ohio St by 21 over IOWA - OSU has won 13 of the L/14 (7-3-1 ATS run) with the last meeting in '13. While we're disappointed our GOM on the Bucks didn't cash for us, a look inside the numbers show OSU finishing w/a dominant 529-283 yard edge while holding RB Barkley to 44 (2.1) rush. Fans & media in CBUS were questioning QB Barrett following the loss to OU & all he's done since is hit 75% w/a 22-0 ratio and appears to have solidified a seat in NY for the Heisman. Iowa is allowing 162 (4.7) rush ypg at home and the Bucks average 268 (6.0) in conf play led by true frosh Dobbins (7.6 ypg)! Both enter off emotional wins (Iowa kept Floyd of Roseedale), but OSU dealt with adversity extremely well and with this game being played during the day we'll lean with the Bucks.

WEST VIRGINIA by 4 over Iowa St - ISU covered the F/2 meetings as B12 rivals, but WV has covered the L/3. Don't look now but the Clones control their own destiny for a B12 Title as they've beaten both OU and TCU with a D that is #14, holding foes to 99 ypg below their average! WV was +102 yds in their loss at TCU and QB Grier threw 4 int's LW vs our #4 ranked pass eff D, but ISU counters with our #44 unit so look for a bounce back performance from the likely future #1DC. The Clones have a huge game w/OSU on deck and we wouldn't be surprised if they are looking ahead as they're in uncharted territory.

MIAMI, FL by 6 over Virginia Tech - This game likely decides the ACC Coastal Title. Miami is just 5-9 SU in this series, covering just 6 of the last 17. There have been 6 upsets in the L/14 mtgs. VT comes in off an easy home win over Duke while Miami enters off a closer than expected win over NC. The Hokies D has held 4 of their foes to season lows in yards but the Canes have also put up the most yards 3 of their foes have allowed. QB Rosier has completed 57% with a 17-4 ratio but faces our #6 pass eff D. VT only allows 114 (3.1) rush ypg but against their 3 toughest foes (WV, Clem, BC) they allowed 177 (4.8). HC Richt has the Canes playing well, having won 13 consecutive games (9-4 ATS) so we will lean with the hot team who is 13-6 as a fav.

Maryland by 6 over RUTGERS - This game was originally scheduled to be played at Yankee Stadium in the Bronx, but was moved during the MLB playoffs. MD's win last year made them bowl eligible. Rutgers OFF woes continued in their loss at Michigan as they're #122, averaging 81 ypg less than their foes allow. That is just what the Terp's D needs after allowing 440+ their L/4 games. If MD wants to return to the postseason this is a must win game. While the Terps are 2-16 ATS off a SU win and on a 5-11 overall ATS run, the Scarlet Knights are on just a 12-18 overall ATS run.

VIRGINIA by 4 over Georgia Tech - GT is 7-2 SU/6-2-1 ATS in this series. The fav is 11-3-1 but UVA did pull an outright upset the LTH. HC Mendenhall was very successful vs the option while at BYU, going 7-1 SU/ATS with an avg MOV of 19.7 and an avg cover of 15.9. LY UVA was a 10' pt dog and held GT to 111 yds at HT (led 10-7) but trailed 24-17 4Q then GT got a 24 yd IR w/4:03 left to put it away. UVA finished with a 409-321 yd edge. The 'Hoos are stuck on 5 wins after losing B2B gms and with a tough closing sked, they will be hungry to get bowl elig. The Jackets are ply'g B2B road gms and are 0-4 as an AF (1st time in that role TY). UVA is 20-12 as a dog.

BOISE ST by 12 over Nevada - Following a solid victory LW in Logan where they became bowl eligible with a 27 pt win (533-279 yd edge), the Broncos return home to take on a well-rested Nevada squad that covered 3 consec conf matchups prior to their bye (5-2 ATS run as MW AD). While the Broncos are 14-1 in this series including wins in each of their L/8 on the blue turf against Nevada, we cannot lean too much in their direction in this one as they've dropped each of their past 10 contests as home chalk overall.

New Mexico St by 13 over TEXAS ST - It's homecoming weekend in San Marcos. Last week fresh off a bye TXST ended a 6 game losing streak with their 1st win vs an FBS foe at Coastal Carolina. They had their best performance of the ssn on both OFF (507 yds) & D (183 yds). NMST ran into conference juggernaut Arkansas St last week and lost as expected. The Aggies actually had a 21-17 4Q lead before allowing 20 pts in a 4:13 span. The Aggies have a huge edge on OFF (#73-#128). They are avg 342 pass ypg (60.9%) and will be facing TXST with our #117 pass eff D which gives us confidence with the DD fav.

Georgia St by 8 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - After crushing GST in the first mtg in '14, GSU took an infamous picture with the entire team holding a banner declaring the Georgia Dome another GSU home. Since then, GST has won the last 2 outright, despite being a dog in both. This is the lone HG in a 4 gm stretch for the Eagles, while the Panthers enter with 2 extra days prep/rest. The Panthers are on a 4-1 SU & ATS run TY (loss vs Troy) and a win here & next week at 2-6 Texas St next week would make the bowl eligible. GSU let their HC go after opening 0-6, but lost by 22 LW (+25 1st ATS win TY). While neither tms offense is impressive GST does have the Def edge (#90-#122) & put up 670 yds on ULM (#130 DEF) earlier this ssn.

Appalachian St by 14 over ULM - App St is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks & is on the 2nd of B2B AG's. ULM is ply'g a 10th str wk, but has a bye on deck & is home for the lone time in a 5 wk stretch. LY the Mountaineers had a ssn high 637 yds & RB Moore avg 10.4 ypc on 13 carries! The Warhawks are 2-6-1 as a HD, while ASH is 8-4 as an AF. While ULM has the Off edge (#54-#94) App St has a bigger Def edge (#65-#130) as ULM has allowed over 400 ypg in 7 of their 8 gms incl 500+ in 5. After a 3 gm winning streak, ULM has now dropped 3 straight. Two of App St's 3 non-conf losses TY were by 1 to WF & by 3 to a better than their record UMass team that beat GSU by 35 the week prior. They are however 4-0 in SBC play and should take care of business here.

OLD DOMINION by 9 over Charlotte - ODU has won both mtgs between these 2 (1-1 ATS). Last week we picked up an easy 3★ winner on the Over (61) in ODU's 45-38 (+11) loss to NT. The Monarchs got 2 KR's from Isaiah Harper and actually led 38-35 4Q. QB Williams continues to struggle with int's, throwing 2 more, giving him 11 on the season but faces our #121 pass eff D. Charlotte comes in fresh off a bye and full of confidence after getting their first home FBS win in program history. The 49ers have allowed 463 ypg in CUSA play and are -112 ypg. ODU has rushed for 201 (4.8) ypg in CUSA play and they've had a 100 yd rusher in 3 of the L/4. UC is 1-5 ATS on the road while ODU is 5-0-1 as a HF but in that role for the first time this year.

TENNESSEE by 6 over Southern Miss - These two haven't met since '07 and Tenn is 5-0 SU with an avg MOV of 29 ppg. Tenn enters after an emotional loss at KY where they outgained the 'Cats 445-371, had a +4 TO edge and led late 4Q but gave up the GW td w/3:31 left. QB Guarantano did show growth, hitting 18-23-242. SM was in a letdown spot last week off their emotional win at LT and was upset at home vs UAB 30-12 (-12) although the score is a little deceiving as SM only trailed 13-12 4Q. SM did win at Kentucky in the '15 opener and is 6-3 ATS vs SEC foes. They also outgained the 'Cats by 110 yds in their 7 pt loss TY. Tenn is -92 ypg on the season while SM is +110 ypg on the road, though the Vols faced a much tougher sked. With their bowl hopes deteriorating and HC Jones likely on his way out, we will lean with the more motivated Golden Eagles who will be hungry to take down one of the Blue Bloods.

Auburn by 17 over TEXAS A&M - There have been 4 straight outright upsets in this series incl LY and Aub is out for revenge. Last week A&M was fresh off a bye at home vs Miss St. The mistake prone Aggies allowed MSU to run away to a 35-7 4Q lead before qb QB Starkel added a garbage td (Mond benched late). HC Sumlin could decide to stick with Starkel this week since he did name Starkel the starter for the opener before he was inj'd. Aub enters fresh off a bye and the Tigers are +160 ypg. The Tigers D is #10, allowing 121 ypg below their opponent's season avg. Aub's OL has struggled at times this season, having allowed 22 sacks. This will be their stiffest test since they gave up 11 sks to Clem-

son as the Aggies come in with 30 sks of their own. Aub's does have Georgia on deck but HC Sumlin is just 7-18-1 ATS at home and 3-13 ATS in November games so we don't mind laying the points here. **AIR FORCE by 1 over Army** - The Falcons have clearly dominated this series over the past 28 ssn with a 25-3 overall SU mark including a 17 pt avg MOV over the L/4 yrs. They come in with some confidence as well following a 17 pt outright upset (+10) of Colo St LW on the road (30+ pts in L/5 gms). The Black Knights meanwhile come in sitting at 6-2 SU on the year although their spread record hasn't been nearly as impressive (2-6 ATS). With extended rest following their 1st bye week of the ssn, we'll go ahead and call for the Black Knights to stay within the line here as AF has covered just 1 of their past 5 at home vs FBS foes.

Wisconsin by 13 over INDIANA - UW has won 9 in a row SU (7-1 ATS) in this series. This is IU's lone home game in a 4 week stretch, while the Badgers are on the second of B2B away games with rival Iowa (Heartland Trophy) on deck. UW was held to a season low 303 yards last week as 1,000 yard true frosh RB Taylor was inj (CS). It's a little eye opening that the Badgers have been forced to use a walk-on QB in Garrett Groshek as Shaw and James have been banged up. The Hoosiers enter off a misleading loss as they had 483-345 yard and 35-18 FD edges. Keep an eye on the status of starting QB Ramsey as he was shaken up on a late hit and while he returned, it was Lagow that took most of the 4Q snaps. UW is 6-1 as an AF and IU is 2-6 as a dog.

TULANE by 10 over Cincinnati - It's homecoming weekend in New Orleans. Going back to 1990, Tulane is 6-2 ATS including 4-1 at home in this series. Sure Cincy has had an extra week to prep for the option off a bye, but we don't think that's enough time to help a run D that was shredded for 569 (7.9) vs Navy! The Green Wave won't face a 35 point deficit like they did last week at Memphis which forced QB Banks to throw a season high 30 passes. TU is on a 6-3 overall ATS run. Cincy had played in a bowl game 9 of 10 years including 5 straight, but this loss will keep them home in B2B years for the first time s/'98-'99.

GEORGIA by 17 over South Carolina - UMass has won 3 of the L/4 SU/ATS in this series with all 3 wins coming by DD's. The home tm is 4-1 SU/ATS. The Bulldogs are 8-0 for the first time s/'02 and have dismantled their SEC competition, with +32 ppg & +240 ypg edges. We gave our customers a relaxing 2★ winner on these pages with UGA (-13) smoking Florida 42-7! The 'Cocks are winners of three straight and back to their preferred role as an underdog, though they did cover as 6' pt chalk LW vs Vandy. SC is 5-0 as dogs this year, having pulled an amazing 4 outright upsets. SC is -39 ypg on the season while UGA is +195 ypg against similar sked strength. Against 3 common foes (Tenn, Vandy & MO), UGA is +32 ppg & +311 ypg while SC is +10 ppg & -16 ypg. We fully expect UGA to win easily but HC's Muschamp & Smart are long time friends so we don't expect the Dawgs to pour it on.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 20 over Massachusetts - UMass is 6-0 ATS vs SEC foes incl LY in these two schools' first mtg. MSU (22) actually trailed 14-6 late 2Q then led just 41-35 w/4:59 left before putting the gm away. After starting the season 0-6, UMass has since won B2B games incl LW's 30-27 2OT (+3) home win over App St. QB Ford has a 13-3 ratio on the ssn, completing 64% of his passes but was injured last week (neck) and is a ? (CS). Miss St has reached bowl elig after their 35-14 (-2) win at A&M. QB Fitzgerald had his 3rd straight 100-yd rush gm and now has 666 (6.7) rush yds on the ssn. The Minutemen are +54 ypg on the season and earlier this year only lost at Tenn by 5 pts. We like UMass who is 6-2 as an AD but our lean is contingent on QB Ford playing.

Ucf by 17 over SMU - It's homecoming weekend in Dallas. UCF is 4-2-1 ATS in this series as these schools were previously CUSA rivals. Knights QB Milton is one of the most improved in the nation. He compl 57.7% w/a 10-7 ratio last year and is compl 72.9% w/a 19-3 ratio this year! He should improve those numbers as SMU counters with just our #107 ranked pass eff D. Keeping it relative, Ponies QB Hicks was compl just 48.4% after 4 games, but has hit over 70% in 3 of his L/4 games. UCF however counters with our #57 pass eff D. The Knights have a huge advantage on the ground as they avg 243 (6.4) rush ypg vs FBS foes, while SMU has allowed 253 (5.6) their L/3. UCF is 4-1 as an AF, while SMU is 4-11 as a HD and 5-9 ATS on the second of B2B HG's.

VANDERBILT by 16 over Wku - WKU is out for revenge after being upset as a rare HF vs an SEC foe LY in 2OT. WKU comes in off a 2 td loss to CUSA rival FAU. The 'Toppers led 28-20 before being outscored 22-0 in the final stanza. QB White has now thrown 12 td passes in his last 3 games after throwing just 3 in his F/5. QB Shurmur had his best gm of the season LW, throwing for 333 and 4 td's in Vandy's 7 pt loss to SC (+6). WKU has allowed 295 (6.5) rush ypg the L/3 which is good news for a Vandy team that avg just 87 (3.2). The 'Dores did beat CUSA's MT (with a healthy Stockstill) by 22 pts on the road earlier TY. WKU is 0-7-1 ATS vs P5 foes and has faced our weakest sked in the country while Vandy has faced the #32 sked. At 3-5 on the season, Vandy has little room for error if they want to reach a bowl and with a weak closing sked they can't afford to mess around so we will back the home favorite.

TCU by 3 over Texas - TCU is 4-1 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. This is the lone home game over a 4 week stretch for the Frogs, while UT is on the second of B2B away games. TCU enters off their first loss, but don't blame the D, which has held each of their L/3 foes to season lows in yards. UT meanwhile, has held their L/2 foes to season lows in yards. TCU QB Hill enters off his worst game of the year and the Horns aren't the team he wants to see if he's lacking confidence as safety Elliot leads the nation w/6 int's & 2 IR td's. While QB Ehlinger was out last week, Buechele hit 79% and added a 28 yd run TD. TCU is 1-7-1 as a HF and UT HC Herman is 8-0 as a dog with 5 outright upsets!

Kansas St +4 over TEXAS TECH

KSU is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in this series. Texas Tech has lost 3 straight by double digits and enters off a trip to Norman, while the 'Cats are on the second of B2B away games and enter off the Sunflower Showdown. KSU HC Snyder pulled a fast one after saying he anticipated QB Ertz to be 100% but it was Delton who remained the starter and then when he was inj late 1H it was rFR Thompson who played the rest of the game. RB Barnes was frustrated after getting carries on 3 of the F/4 plays including a 75 yard td run vs OU and then not getting another carry until the 4Q. Apparently the staff realized it as well as he had 23-128 (both ssn highs) and the Red Raiders have allowed 3 B12 foes to rush for 208+. We won with KSU as our Underdog POW on these pages 4 weeks ago and were stunned to see them as a dog this week and will gladly take the points with HC Snyder in his preferred role as he's 20-6 as an AD.

LA TECH by 1 over North Texas - LT has won the L/3 in this series by an avg of 28.3 ppg (3-0 ATS). We were admittedly fortunate last week, using LT as a 2★ on these pages and while they did win 42-28 (-12), they were also outgained by 17 yards and needed a late pick 6 to cover. We didn't need nearly as much luck in our 3★ Totals LP play on the Over (61) in NT vs ODU as the Mean Green won 45-38 (-11). LT has been outg'd by 7 ypg at home and their D is #99, allowing 38 ypg more than their foes avg. NT is -97 ypg on the road, and their D is #114, allowing 62 ypg more than their foes avg. QB Fine has an 18-9 ratio on the season which is impressive considering he's faced the #14, #15, #32, #38, and #39 pass eff D's. LT has just our #58 in pass eff D and is 1-3 as a HF.

WASHINGTON by 20 over Oregon - The Ducks ended their 3-gm losing skid LW at home against the Utes behind 346 yds on the ground that included 100+ efforts from RB's Freeman & Brooks-James. They now head North to take on a Washington team that had no issue disposing of the Bruins LW behind a defense that held UCLA to 278 yds under their ssn avg. In LY's meeting in Autzen, UW QB Browning tallied 8 tll TD's in the easy 70-21 victory (broke 12 gm losing streak vs the Ducks). With Oregon mostly one-dimensional at the moment and with a frosh QB under center, we expect the Ducks offense to have a long day up in Seattle against a Huskies defense that's all'd just 13 ppg & 200 tll ypg at home so far in '17.

ARKANSAS by 31 over Coastal Carolina - This is CC's first gm as an FBS member vs a P5 foe and first ever mtg. CC is 0-5 vs P5 schools w/a avg score of 55-5 (being shutout 2x) incl the L/time in '13 at S Carolina, losing 70-10. Ark probably saved HC Bielema's job for the time being with LW's come from behind win over Ole Miss. QB Allen is still a ? (CS) and bkp Kelly threw for 189 yds and 3 td's last week. CC was outgained 507-183 by one of the worst teams in the country LW in their 27-7 (-9) loss at home vs Texas ST (one of two outright Big Dog winners LW, available for just \$9 every Thursday through the office!). We think the Razorbacks will look to impress their homecoming crowd with a dominant win over a much weaker foe.

Oklahoma by 4 over OKLAHOMA ST - Bedlam hasn't been ply'd this early s/'04. OU is on an 8-3-1 ATS run in this rivalry, but this is the lone home gm in a 4 wk stretch for OSU. OU's loss to ISU doesn't look bad at all & they've gained the most yds all'd by 7 of their 8 foes. QB Mayfield deserves to be in the Heisman discussion as he's hitting 73% w/a 23-3 ratio. We cashed w/the Pokes as a 4★ LPS winner over TT (SAT ★ & Marquess 8-4), but this wk will be tough. The Pokes have the edge on D, however the Sooners have found something in Soph RB Anderson as he's rushed for 328 (7.6) the L/2 gms as he's recovered from last years scary neck injury & OSU has allowed 3 foes to rush for 219+ yards. OU is on a 9-5 overall ATS run and we'll call for them to remain in the Playoff discussion with a close win.

NOTRE DAME by 11 over Wake Forest - ND is 3-0 SU but 1-2 ATS in this series. This is WF's 3rd road gm in the L/4 wks. The Deamon Deacons enter off an upset over Lville & also covered as a DD Dog vs Clemson. QB Wolford became the first WF QB in 19Y to top 400 pass yds & had 5 td passes w/4 going to WR Dortch (now OFY). WF's 625 tll yds was their most s/'68! This is ND's 3rd straight home gm and 2nd vs an ACC foe after beating NCSU 35-14 (-7). The Irish avg 318 (6.9) rush ypg behind RB Adams who has 1,169 (8.9). WF has put up the most yards that 2 of their foes have allowed while ND has held 2 of their foes to their ssn low in yards. QB Wolford will have much less room to throw against ND's #28 pass eff D. WF is 12-3-1 as a dog and ND is coming off B2B big games so this could be a letdown spot.

UAB by 7 over Rice - Rice has pulled outright upsets over UAB in both of their more recent home mtgs. UAB is one win from bowl elig after pulling their 4th outright upset of the year LW over SM (another Big Dog winner at +420, just \$9 through the office). RB Brown has 906 rush yds (5.7) on the season. Rice comes in healthier and showed improvement in their 14 pt loss vs LT LW, outgaining the Bulldogs by 17 yards. UAB struggled as a fav a few weeks back and were upset at Charlotte. This is UAB's only home gm in a 5 wk period.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 5 over Louisiana - The Cajuns had a ssn high 512 tll yds in LY's mtg. LA enters fresh off a 9 day bye. LA is 24-13 as an AD but just 1-3 TY. Both tms come in with just 3 wins, so are fighting to keep their slim bowl hopes alive. With almost identical Off's (LA#120-#121) SA does have the defensive edge (#63-#117) but LA had shown improvement after bringing in a Defensive consultant (former LA DC) before running into SBC Power Arkansas ST (571 yds). The HT is 5-0 SU/ATS, winning/covering by an avg of 13/7 ppg so we will lean slightly with the home team but their are better options out there.

NEW MEXICO by 5 over Utah St - Following a huge 2H in Las Vegas a few wks back that saw them turn a deadlocked HT affair into a 52-28 rout, the Aggies couldn't continue that momentum LW at home against the Broncos who allowed just 14 pts & 279 yds in the 27 pt victory. They now head back on the road TW to take on a Lobos squad that's dropped 3 consec contests after their blowout loss to Wyoming a week ago in Laramie (7-0 TO deficit). While NM has failed to cover their past 3 matchups as a MW HF coming in, we'll go ahead and call for them to get back on track in this one after they were able to find success in this series in each of the past 2 yrs (1 pt victory in ABQ as a 16 pt dog back in '15).

FRESNO ST by 17 over Byu - This marks just the 2nd mtg s/'99 with BYU winning 52-10 in Provo in '15. The Cougars were able to get into the win column for the 1st time in their past 8 matchups vs SJST behind a 41 pt/583 yd outburst (BYU had avg just 12.1 ppg & 265 ypg coming in). The Bulldogs meanwhile suffered their 1st loss in cont play this ssn LW at home against UNLV (outgained 328-292). With Fresno still on a very impressive 8-1 ATS run at home and the Cougars having failed to cover each of their past 5 away from home, we'll go ahead and call for the Bulldogs to get back on track this weekend.

UNLV by 7 over Hawaii - Following a surprising 10 pt road win LW against MW leader Fresno ST (328-292 yd edge), the Rebels return home to take on a Hawaii squad that was held to just 7 pts & 195 yds a week ago at home against an angry SDSt squad. LY's meeting between the 2 featured 6 ties with neither school leading by more than 7 at any point (UNLV 41-38 win). While the home team has won 11 of the past 14 in this series dating back to '96 and the Rebels having covered each of the past 3 overall, we don't feel comfortable laying more than a td with the Rebels.

Utsa by 7 over FIU - The winner of this game will be bowl elig. The only prior mtg was in '14 when FIU lost 16-13 (+9) on the road. FIU enters off a huge 41-30 (+16) upset at Marshall, though they were outgained 505-401. QB McGough hit 14-18-177-2-0 and WR Owens had 7-114 and 2 td's. UTSA enters off a 31-14 (-15) win at UTEP, which we used as our 4★ Top LPS on the Under 47 (Our top Totals selection is 7-2 incl a 5-0 run and our Totals GOY is this weekend!!) The RoadRunners are +64 ypg vs CUSA foes and their D is #25, allowing 52 ypg less than their foes avg. FIU is -58 ypg vs CUSA play and their D is just #102, allowing 102 ypg more than their foes avg. UTSA also brings the #14 pass eff D and should be able to slow McGough down. UTSA is ply'g B2B road gms but we will go against FIU who is off the big upset win.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 17 over Utep - They split their 2 mtgs in '13-'14 with the home tm going 2-0 SU/1-1-1 ATS. MT enters fresh off a bye. UTEP comes in off a 31-14 (+16) loss at UTSA. The Miners are still struggling despite the change to Interim HC Mike Price. UTEP has been outgained by more than 150 yards by every foe they've faced except WKU. MT is +31 ypg at home and their D is #34, allowing 40 ypg less than their foes avg. UTEP's Off is dead last in the FBS, avg 178 ypg below what their foes allow. Despite their struggles, MT is actually 2-0 as a HF this year while UTEP is 8-18-1 as an AD. Last week we used the Under (47) in UTEP's loss to UTSA as our Top Totals play. Could we go back to the Miners again as our Totals GOY?

ALABAMA by 20 over Lsu - Bama has won the L/5 (5-1 ATS). As usual, both tms enter off a bye. The only time LSU was a reg ssn DD Dog since '01 was in '13 vs Bama and they failed to cover in a 38-17 (+11) loss. This is also the largest spot in this game since '93 (LSU +24, pulled outright upset). Bama has held 6 of 8 foes to their lowest OFF output on the season and their D is ranked #1, allowing 168 ypg below what their opponent's average. After battling injuries all year, RB Guice, finally 100%, rushed for 276 (12.5) vs Ole Miss prior to the bye but Bama has held LSU to 54 & 33 rush yds the last 2 yrs (with Fournette!). LSU is just 2-10 ATS when held under 20 pts which is almost a certainty when playing Bama but we just don't feel comfortable laying 3 td's in this rivalry so our lean is with the Tigers.

Penn St by 8 over MICHIGAN ST - MSU is on a 3-1 ATS series run and PSU enters off grueling stretch having just played UM and OSU and are on the second of B2B away games. Sparty had a 540-432 yard edge in their 30T loss at NW and have a dominant D that is allowing just 71 (2.3) rush ypg vs B10 foes, while the Nitnary Lions have been held to under 100 rush yds in 3 of their L/4 games. MSU QB Lewerke was thought of as more of a runner but the Soph is hitting over 60% and PSU is allowing 66% completions on the road. While Sparty is in their preferred role as a dog we would be happier if they were getting double digits so we'll lean with an angry PSU squad.

San Diego St by 26 over SAN JOSE ST - Following a pair of surprising outright home defeats against Boise (-6) & Fresno (-7) the previous 2 wks, the Aztecs were able to get back on track LW on the islands behind a career-best 253 rush yds from Rashaad Penny. The Spartans meanwhile were handled with relative ease LW in Provo as BYU doubled their ssn offensive averages with 41 pts & 583 yds. SDSt is perfect in their past 4 MW matchups winning the past 3 by 34.3 ppg (460-209 yd edge in LY's 39 pt victory). While the Aztecs could potentially be running on fumes with a 10th consec week of action and returning back from Hawaii (bye week on deck), the Spartans are on a 1-5-1 ATS run overall and are expected to struggle here.

CALIFORNIA by 7 over Oregon ST - After an 0-5 SU/ATS run to start the ssn, losing by an avg of 31 ppg, the Beavers have covered each of their L/2 following the departure of HC Andersen. In fact, OSU could have easily won vs Colorado & Stanford as each scored GW TD's with under 2 min left (OSU yd edges in both). The Bears are ply'g a 10th straight wk and come in after being hammered on the road against the Buffs (all'd 553 yds in a 16 pt loss). In their meeting a ssn ago, the Beavers snapped a 2-gm series losing skid by delivering the 3 pt OT victory in Corvallis as a 13' pt dog. While the Bears have covered each of their past 4 P12 HG's and are seeking revenge from LY, we cannot justify giving more than a TD in this one with the Beavers currently playing their best football of the ssn.

USC by 3 over Arizona - The Wildcats offense has clearly taken off over the past 4 wks with QB Tate now under center (49 ppg, 567 ypg) including their 58-37 home win over Wash St this past weekend (3★ LP Winner on OVER 63). The Trojans meanwhile ended a 6-gm ATS skid LW in the desert vs the Sun Devils behind their own offensive outburst (48 pts & 613 yds). USC is 13-2 in the series winning the last 4 but after wins of 7, 2, & 8 they finally got a blowout last year 48-14. While this will mark USC's 10th consec gm without a bye, it's worth mentioning that Arizona has covered just 2 of their past 11 when listed as an AD.

Ust by 24 over CONNECTICUT - This game was rescheduled from their original Sept 9 date due to the effects of Hurricane Irma. USF enters off an emotional first loss, allowing the GW to w/:11 left. They failed to score 30 points for the first time in a record 24 straight games, but will have no problem getting back on track as UConn counters with the #128 D, allowing foes to put up 139 ypg more than their average. The Huskies just allowed 52 points to an average at best Mizzou and have allowed 70, 49, 41, and 38 in their prior losses. UConn lost their leading playmaker on OFF in RB Newsome, QB Shirreffs struggled w/o him last week and the Bulls are holding foes to 39 ypg below their average. USF is on a 21-11-1 overall ATS run, while the Huskies are on a 17-39-1 overall ATS run.

HOUSTON by 22 over East Carolina - It's homecoming in Houston. The last meeting was in '12 as CUSA rivals. EC enters off a much needed bye as QB Sircoming his shoulder vs BYU (CS). Minshew began as the str, but didn't make it through the opener vs an FCS foe. QB isn't the only issue for the Pirates as they're #129 on D, all'g 152 ypg more than their foes avg. After all'g 80 2H points their prior 2 games, UH snapped USF's FBS rec of 24 straight gms w/30+ pts. QB/WR King provided the needed spark and he'll be their third different starter under center if he's given the job this week. The Cougars are on a 37-24-2 overall ATS run, while the Pirates are 2-8-1 as an AD and on a 6-18-1 overall ATS run, but we aren't comfortable laying that many points with a Hou team that has QB issues along with an EC squad fully capable of pulling the backdoor cover.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7th :
Akron at MIAMI, OH - Akron has won 4 straight in this series by 12 ppg, but won just 2 of the previous 14 meetings. The Zips are playing their fifth road game in the last 7 weeks. Miami will have an advantage of just having played a Tuesday game so their routine won't be affected. While Akron is #119 on D allowing foes 77 ypg more than their average, their games have gone UNDER the total 8 of 9 times this year as they're equally as bad on OFF at #120, being held to 78 ypg less than their foes allow. Miami's last game at OU was played after this issue went to press.
Buffalo at BOWLING GREEN - BG has won the L/6 in this series, but the home team is just 2-7 SU/1-9 ATS. UB enters off an emotional loss after allowing the GW td vs Akron w/4:46 left 4Q and then missing the potential GW 46 yd fg w/1:51 left. Bulls RB Reed did rush for 116 (4.1) and BG is allowing 272 (6.0) rush ypg in MAction! BG enters this game off a Tuesday contest so their game week prep won't be affected. The Falcons are on the second of B2B away games, but do have a bye on deck. This is 1 of 2 games to choose from for our Tuesday night Marquee and our College Marquees are on a 12-6 run! (Just \$15 after noon ET gameday at 1-800-654-3448).

4★ PHILADELPHIA over Denver - This marks the 3rd consec road contest for the Broncos (9-17 ATS as a NDIV AD) as they head East on short rest following a MNF battle with KC. The Eagles moved to 8-1 on the year LW at home against the 49ers behind a defense that all'd just 238 tl yds in the 23 pt win (PHI now on a 9-2 overall ATS run). While the Broncos have allowed fewer than 300 yds on defense in every game this year as of presstime and are on a 15-7 ATS run against the NFC, the Eagles (12-3 ATS vs AFC) can go all out in this matchup with their bye week on deck (6-3 ATS before a bye).

FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA by 14

3★ CAROLINA over Atlanta - The Falcons head to Charlotte after escaping NY with a 5 pt win over the Jets (still on a 9-3 spread run away from home despite LW's ATS loss). The Panthers meanwhile went into Tampa in a small underdog role and came out with the 14 pt win (3★ LP & Newsletter Winner) behind a defense that surrendered just 3 pts & 276 yds. In their matchups of a ssn ago, the Falcons took advantage of a struggling CAR squad with 15 & 17 pt victories. While the Panthers are on just a 2-8 ATS run at home coming in, we expect the Falcons to be sucking fumes here following their 3rd consec road matchup!

FORECAST: CAROLINA by 8

OTHER SELECTION

2★ SAN FRANCISCO over Arizona - Despite an 0-8 start to the ssn that includes a 23 pt loss LW in PHI (held under 300 yds for the 4th time TY), the 49ers could have some confidence here after taking the Cardinals to OT earlier this ssn in the desert. The Cardinals return from their bye week on a 4-14 ATS run that includes a 33-0 loss to the Rams in London where QB Palmer was lost to a broken arm. While ARZ is a solid 10-3 ATS in DIV AG's, we'll go ahead and call for the 49ers to get their 1st win of '17 as they've now covered 9 of their past 11 matchups inside of the NFC West (Cardinals bkp QB Stanton hitting just 52.7% of his passes w/a 14-20 ratio in his career, 13 previous career starts).

FORECAST: SAN FRANCISCO by 3

OTHER PLAYS

Buffalo at NY JETS - Thursday - Prior to LY the Bills had gone 7 yrs without being a DIV AF. In that role a year ago BUF would end up losing outright at MIA and against this very same Jets squad in the ssn finale (lost 30-10 as 3' pt chalk). The Bills were aided by 4 OAK TO's a week ago in their 20 pt victory (outgained 367-331). The Jets meanwhile stayed within the line yet again (17-7 ATS run as a HD) LW vs ATL in the narrow defeat. With the Bills and Jets on a combined 10-1-2 ATS mark, **check back on Noon EST on gameday for one of our Marquee selections.**

LA Rams by 1 over NY GIANTS - The Rams return from their week off (7-2-1 ATS off a bye) sitting tied atop the NFC West standings. Their previous matchup in London was arguably their most impressive as they held ARZ to just 193 yds in the 33-0 shutout. While the Rams have come out of nowhere to become one of the NFC's better squads, the Giants return from their own bye week as one of the league's most disappointing with significant injuries on both sides of the ball seeing them at 1-6 overall. With all of that being said, we'll lean with the HD in this one as not only are the Rams a NDIV AF for just the 3rd time in the past 10 yrs, but they've also clearly struggled in head to head matchups as the Giants have rattled off 7 consec SU & ATS (13 pt avg MOV) including a 7 pt win LY in England.

NEW ORLEANS by 10 over Tampa Bay - The Saints continue to be one of the hottest teams in the NFL following their 5th consec win LW against the Bears (14 pt avg MOV during win streak) while also helping deliver our Top Weekly 3.5★ LP Winner on the UNDER 46.5! They now welcome a struggling Bucs squad that dropped their 4th straight matchup LW at home against the Panthers with just 3 pts & 276 yds in the 14 pt defeat (3★ LP & Newsletter Winner!). While the Bucs have posted a decent 6-3 ATS mark as a DIV AD, not only have the Saints covered 8 of their past 10 overall, but they're also a very impressive 10-3 ATS in NFC South contests.

JACKSONVILLE by 7 over Cincinnati - Following a closer than expected home victory over the Colts a week ago where they needed an IR TD w/6:58 for the eventual GW score (IND 331-276 yd edge), the Bengals head to JAX for their first of 3 consec AG's. The Jaguars come in well rested after their week off (6-1 ATS after a bye) following a decisive win against the same IND squad (recorded 10 sks in 27-0 victory). While the Bengals have come out victorious in each of their past 4 meetings with the Jags (3-0-1 ATS) dating back to '08, keep in mind that they have only covered 1 of their past 6 as an AD entering this weekend.

HOUSTON by 17 over Indianapolis - Following a surprising narrow loss LW in Cincy where they finished with a 331-276 yd edge, the Colts head to HOU for their 3rd road game in a 4-wk span. While the Texans were on the losing side of a shootout LW in SEA (79 pts & 988 comb yds), they do enter play on a 9-4-1 ATS run inside of their DIV. In their 2 meetings a ssn ago the Texans came away with 3 & 5 pt wins en route to their AFC South Title. With IND posting just a 3-7-1 ATS mark as a DIV AD and HOU at 10-3-1 ATS as a HF, it's abundantly clear which way we'll be leaning in this one.

TENNESSEE by 10 over Baltimore - While the Ravens are off a convincing 40-0 home win last Thur against the Dolphins where they held MIA to just 196 yds, all of the news isn't positive for BAL as they travel to Nashville with QB Flacco in concussion protocol following a ? hit in the 1H. The Titans meanwhile are back in action following their week off (another week of rest for QB Mariota's hamstring) needing to string together a win streak to create some distance in the AFC South. With the Ravens covering just 1 of their past 5 prior to their own bye week and going just 4-13 ATS against NDIV foes, we'll gladly give TEN the 10 pt edge in this one.

SEATTLE by 10 over Washington - Following a 14 pt loss LW at home against the Cowboys (3★ LP Winner on DAL), the Redskins head to the Pacific NW having dropped 3 of their last 4 contests with their only victory coming by 2 over a 1-7 SF squad. The Seahawks are back at home for a 2nd consec week after barely getting by the Texans (GW

TD w/:21 left). With the visitor surprisingly winning each of the past 3 matchups outright dating back to '08, we would normally find it difficult to lean too much in the favor of the Seahawks. However, the Redskins do come in extremely banged up on the OL (potentially 4 starters out) which can always be an issue in front of the "12th Man."

DALLAS by 3 over Kansas City - After a solid 3★ LP road victory LW in D.C. behind the legs of RB Elliott (150 rush, 2 TD), the Cowboys return to Dallas for their only HG in a 5-wk span. They now welcome a Chiefs squad on short rest following their MNF matchup against DEN (KC on 2 gm losing streak as of presstime). Although the Chiefs are on a 10-3 overall ATS run and have been equally as impressive against NFC foes at 21-11 ATS (covers vs PHI & NYG TY), we'll go ahead and give the Cowboys the 3 point edge here as they're also on a pretty substantial run in non-conf play at 17-8-1 ATS.

Oakland at MIAMI - SNF - While the Dolphins all'd just 295 yds LW in BAL, their offense played the bigger role in the 40-0 defeat as bkp QB Moore hit just 25-44 for 176 yds with 2 int's ret'd for TD's (MIA held under 200 yds of offense for the 3rd time TY). They now welcome a Raiders squad that turned the ball over on 4 occasions in their 20 pt loss to BUF (OAK 367-331 yd edge). While OAK will be able to go all out with a bye on deck, keep in mind that QB Cutler (expected to return here) and the Dolphins have covered 7 of their past 9 as a NDIV HD. **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**
Detroit at GREEN BAY - MNF - Rare situation for both squads here as DET heads to Lambeau as a potential AF for just the 2nd time in the past 26 yrs (only other time came in Wk 17 of '11 when GB was resting their starters for the playoffs). Besides the previously mentioned '11 matchup vs DET, GB's last time listed as a DIV HD came in the '06 opener vs CHI. The Lions saw their spread run dip down to just 3-8 ATS following their SNF loss to PIT (482-392 yd edge but had to settle for 5 FG's). While the Packers are 9-1-1 ATS following their bye week, there's clearly some questions heading into this one after bkp QB Hundley (12-25 for 87 yds) struggled in his 1st career start against the Saints.
