4★ Alabama over MISSISSIPPI ST - The Tide have won 9 str (6-3 ATS) in this series, holding the Bulldogs to 7 total td's in those 9 mtgs (10 pts or less in all but 1). Bama's D swallowed up QB Fitzgerald last year, holding him to just 15 rush & 145 pass yds as the Tide won 51-3. The Tide enter off a 24-10 (21) home win over LSU but did lose 2 LB's incl #2 tk'r Hamilton and CB Fitzpatrick -got banged up. Miss ST was obviously looking ahead to this game LW as they trailed UMass 20-13 at the before pulling out an 11 pt win. Fitzgerald failed in his 2 toughest tests this year, being held to 52 (4.5) rush ypg & 120 pass ypg (43% completions, 1-4 ratio) vs Aub & UGA and now faces the nation's #1 D, which holds foes to 158 ypg below their ssn avg. The Tide are 16-6 ATS away from Tuscaloosa and this is their first road game in a 5 week span. **Way back in '92 we picked up a GOY winner in this rivalry. Could we go back to it with the Tide this year?**

FORECAST: ALABAMA by 24

3★ Arkansas St over SOUTH ALABAMA - ASt is on a 4-0 ATS run in this series, covering by an avg of 12 ppg. The Red Wolves enter fresh off a bye. The Red Wolves are 14-7 as an AF, while the Jags are 5-10 as a HD. After upsetting Troy & beating ULM in B2B wks, ASt has dropped 2 str both as a fav incl a 19-14 loss to Louisiana LW, a game they trailed 19-0 and scored their final td w/59 left in the gm. ASt beat Louisiana earlier this ssn 47-3 and have won their 4 SBC gms by 28 ppg. While ASt surprisingly only has a slight edge on D (#70-#73) they have a huge edge on OFF (#66-#127). The Red Wolves focus on conf play and have now won 20 of their last 21 conf gms (17-4 ATS) and should continue that trend here.

FORECAST: ARKANSAS ST by 18

3★ MISSOURI over Tennessee - MO had won the F/3 of this SEC east rivalry but UT has won the L/2. The Vols started 3 frosh OL which naturally led to QB Guarantano getting banged up and he sat the 2H with an inj in their 24-10 (-6) home win over SM (easy 3★ LP Totals winner on Under 48, Totals 6-2 L/2 weeks!). The Vols put up just 210 yds vs SM, were outgained by 69 yds & they've been held to 253 yds or less in 4 of their L/5. The Tigers have avg'd 55 ppg & 565 ypg during their 3 game win streak. QB Lock has a 21-3 ratio in his L/5. MO has covered their L/5 gms and this is their home finale while Tenn is just 2-7 ATS on the season. With MO's resurgence and UT's OFF struggles, we see every reason to back the Tigers. **We are 3-0 when our GOY involves Tennessee, going with them in '84 & '86 and against them in '11 so this will certainly be in the mix!**

FORECAST: MISSOURI by 16

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Kentucky (+) over VANDERBILT - Vandy is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS in the series. Last week we picked up a College Totals GOY winner with the OVER (63) as KY fell to Ole Miss 37-34 (Top Totals play has now won SIX consec weeks!) We also used Vandy as a 3★ LPS vs WKU & the 'Dores got us another winner, 31-17 (-11'). Vandy needs to win 2 of their L/3 to become bowl elig & with MO & Tenn on deck, that is entirely possible. Vandy is #110 on OFF, avg 56 ypg less than their foes allow but KY is not much better at #100, avg 38 ypg below what their foes allow. Vandy is -252 ypg vs SEC foes but that number is skewed by poor performances vs Bama & UGA. KY is only -69 ypg in the SEC but they've had the pleasure of not playing any of the upper echelon SEC teams. Also, the 'Cats have still been outgained by every FBS foe they've faced! In 2010 we used this rivalry as our College GOY and given our success in LW's Total's GOY involving KY, it's possible we could come back to this game as we've won 6 GOY's using dogs!

FORECAST: KENTUCKY by 3

2★ SYRACUSE over Wake Forest - Cuse had won 4 str in this series until LY when WF got a 28-9 (-4) home win. The Home tm is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS overall. The Demon Deacons are in a brutal stretch which includes 4 road games in their L/6 incl trips to Clem, GT & ND. Last week they trailed the Irish 48-23 in the 4Q before adding 2 garbage td's, getting the backdoor cover with :51 left. WF allowed a ssn high 710 yards (3rd most allowed in school history) and while they did put up 587 yds, much of that came with the outcome decided. This is a battle of two under-rated QB's with WF's Wolford throwing for 1,991 yds (17-3 ratio) and Cuse's Dungey throwing for 2,495 (14-9 ratio) & rushing for 595 (4.2). Cuse is +165 ypg in the Carrier Dome incl a win over Clemson. WF is -104 ypg on the road.

FORECAST: SYRACUSE by 7

WEDNESDAY 9/8

W MICHIGAN by 23 over Kent St - The home tm is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS in this series. WM lost st'QB Wassink to inj and Goddard got his 1st car start in LW's emotional loss as the Broncos twice let 2 td leads evaporate. Looking at his numbers you would think he struggled (6-18-42) but he was let down by several drops on perfectly thrown balls in the rain. KSU is #129 on OFF avg 159 ypg less than their foes allow. WM is on a 29-16-1 ATS run in the regular ssn, while the Flashes are on an 8-13 overall ATS run. Broncos RB Franklin has run for 100+ in five of their L/6 gms incl 4 str & is off a ssn high 228 (8.8) and KSU is all'g 224 (5.5) rush ypg. In 5 road games, the Golden Flashes have scored zero td's and a ttl of 12 points. WM is 1 win away from bowl elig and will easily achieve that here while NIU waits on deck.

Toledo by 6 over OHIO - It's Sr day in Athens & this is Toledo's 1st trip here s/10. The Rockets are in revenge mode after having their 12 gm series winning streak stopped despite being more than 2 td chalk at home! This game could be a prelude to the MAC Champ gm. Look for the Rockets and their #9 OFF that avg 106 ypg more than their foes allow to take advantage of an OU D that ranks just #101 all'g 40 ypg more than their foes avg. QB Woodside became the schools car pass leader, while RB Woodson became the 7th ply'r in school history w/3,000+ yds in their win over NIU LW. The Rockets are 8-1 as an AF and we'll call for them to remain in contention for the MAC Champ game.

Eastern Michigan by 4 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - EM ended a 4 gm series losing streak LW w/a GW 24 yd td pass w/:21 left. The Eagles easily snapped their 6 gm losing streak LW as they ran for a ssn high 225 (5.6) and CM all'd a ssn high 315 (5.8) rush yds in their emotional come-from-behind Victory Cannon win LW. The Eagles are far better than their record indicates as they haven't lost a game by more than td. EM is ply'g their 5th road gm in 7 wks, however they must win out to become bowl elig. The Eagles are 10-1 as an AD & on a 17-3-1 overall ATS run, while CM is on a 6-12 overall ATS run.

THURSDAY 9/9

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 33 over Ball St - NIU has won 8 str in this series by 15 ppg (6-2 ATS). The Huskies won't have any trouble getting back on track following their loss at Toledo as BSU is among the worst tms in the nation, entering on a 6 gm losing streak incl 5 str losses by an avg score of 51-9! The Cards have all'd 272 (6.9) rush ypg their L/3 gms while NIU is avg over 200 rush ypg in MACtion! NIU is 15-6-1 ATS vs MAC foes, while BSU is on a 0-7 overall ATS run. There's no way we can back the Card's until they show some type of pride and will continue to play against them during their struggles.

APPALACHIAN ST by 23 over Georgia Southern - These schools have played every year s/'93 as both were FCS members before joining the SBC. ASt had been playing games much closer than expected and it caught up with them last week in their first SBC loss, while this will be the third game for GS with an interim HC. The Mountaineers are averaging 217 (5.6) rush ypg at home, while the Eagles are allowing 299 (6.9) rush ypg away. This is the lone home game in a 5 week stretch for ASt and they have a bye on deck. GS is on the road for the third time in 4 weeks and enter off an emotional loss to rival GA St where they gave up the GW td w/2:31 left. Neither team can really be trusted as the Mountaineers are 6-12 as a HF, while the Eagles are 3-7-1 as an AD.

PITTSBURGH by 17 over North Carolina - NC has won the last 4 of this series SU (3-1 ATS). Each of the L/6 have been decided by a td or less (4 ppg MOV). LY Pitt led 36-23 in the 4Q but NC got the GW td w/:02 left. It's been an injury plagued season for NC (18 players OFY) who enters fresh off a bye having lost 6 straight by 20.3 ppg while being outgained by 131.3 ypg. The starting QB job is totally up in the air for the Heels, as they used 4 different QB's in their L/2 games. Pitt also enters fresh off a bye, having won 2 straight prior. The Panthers must win this game then pull an upset over either Miami or VT to get to a bowl game. The Tar Heels are -145 ypg in ACC play while Pitt is -78 ypg. Pitt has covered both games they were a HF this year while NC failed to cover both games as an AD, losing by 52 & 26 pts.

FRIDAY 11/10

Temple by 3 over CINCINNATI - Temple is 3-1 ATS as AAC rivals. The Owls enter off an extra day of rest, but Cincy is home for the lone time over a 4 week stretch. It took a little time, but Temple appears to have acclimated to new HC Collins' schemes. They're +138 ypg their L/4 gms and would be even higher, but allowed over 100 yds in the 4Q after having a 34-13 lead over Navy. QB Nuttle has been a great replacement for Marchi hitting 71% w/a 5-1 ratio in his 2 starts and Cincy is #120 in our pass eff D rankings. The Owls are 21-9 ATS away, while the 'Cats are 1-4 as a HD and we'll call for Temple to win by a fg.

Washington by 7 over STANFORD - While Stanford is on a 9-3 overall run in this series, the Huskies were in a great situation a ssn ago as they caught the Cardinal off a last second win at UCLA and traveling again without its top 2 CB's. The Huskies held the Ducks offense to just 3 pts & 278 yds in their 35 pt win a week ago (1st series home win s/'03). The Cardinal had limited success in QB Costello's 2nd career start (3 pt defeat in Pullman) as RB Love was held to a ssn-low 69 yds on 16 att in his return from injury. Although the Cardinal should be charged up being listed as a HD for the 1st time in 4 yrs, we'll go ahead and give the Huskies the 7 pt edge here as they've covered 4 of their past 5 P12 AG's.

UNLV by 7 over Byu - The Cougars are a perfect 8-0 against the Rebels in Las Vegas and their fans always travel well to this venue. Following a smackdown of SJSU 2 wks ago, the BYU offense came back to reality LW against Fresno as they were held to just 13 pts in the 7 pt defeat (Cougars did have a 336-310 yd edge). QB Mangum is OFY (Achilles). The Rebels meanwhile overcame a shaky 1H (led 7-6) with 3 TD's in the 3Q in the eventual 8 pt win (Hawaii at UNLV23 as time expired). While UNLV had dropped their previous 2 home matchups by a combined 93-38 vs SDSt & Utah St before Hawaii, the Cougars have covered just two games so far this ssn and should have trouble matching up with the Rebels OFF.

SATURDAY 11/11

Michigan by 24 over MARYLAND - UM has dominated the L/2Y, winning by 42 ppg and covering by 20 ppg. We mentioned UM's physicality would be too much for Minny on these pages and we easily cashed our 3★ as the Wolves had a 427-164 yd edge incl 371-90 (RB's Higdon & Evans comb'd 391, 13.5 ypc) on the ground! MD was leading Rutgers before QB Bortenschlager inj his shoulder (CS) and they could be forced to start 5-8 182 lb soph w/o Ryan QB. No matter who starts for the Terps, there's no helping a run D that has allowed 5 of their L/7 foes 215+ yards! MD HC Durkin was the Wolves' DC in '15 and UM has a trip to UW on deck, but the Terps are on a 5-12 ATS run and are 5-11 as a DD dog and the Wolves have found a spark with new starting QB Peters.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 10 over Florida - HC Muschamp gets his 2nd shot to beat his former school after LY's 20-7 (+11) loss. Florida has dominated this series, going 21-5 SU (13-9 ATS). Florida has allowed 42+ points in B2B games for the first time since 1917 and they've dropped 4 straight, making this a must win to become bowl eligible. It was Randy Shannon's first game as Interim HC last week and the Gators were outgained 455-349 & outFD'd 26-17. QB Zaire got his first start of the season but failed to lead a single td drive and once again the QB job is up for grabs. The 'Cocks got 2 OL starters back in their closer than expected 24-10 (+23) loss at UGA. The Gators are 2-6 ATS on the season incl 0-4 ATS away from the Swamp and they're playing B2B on the road.

Virginia Tech by 1 over GEORGIA TECH - There have been 4 straight outright upsets in this series after VT, who was a 2 td fav, lost at home 30-20 LY. The home team is just 1-6 ATS. Both teams enter off losses. The Hokies are playing their 2nd straight on the road and enter off a physical beatdown vs Miami. They were held to a season low 299 yards while allowing 429 yds which is the most they've allowed in ACC play. QB Jackson has a 17-6 ratio, but against teams with an above .500 record he has only a 3-5 ratio. We went against GT last week as a 3★ LPS and they lost outright 40-36 (-7'). The Hokies have been solid against the rush but did allow 219 (6.3) last week and 309 (5.3) in LY's mtg vs the Jackets. GT is 6-1-1 ATS overall incl 3-0 ATS at home in ACC play and 12-5-1 as a dog while VT has failed to cover their L/5 ACC road tilts.

Tulane by 9 over EAST CAROLINA - The home team is on a 6-0 ATS series run, but this is EC's first time defending the option this year and in their lone game last year (Navy) they allowed season highs of 66 points and 480 (7.1) rush yards. Tulane needs to win out to become bowl elig, while the Pirates are simply playing for pride. The Green Wave's option has been held in check their L/2 games, but will have no problem getting back in gear vs an EC squad that is allowing 240 (5.6) rush ypg and is #128, allowing 135 ypg more than their foes average. Pirates' QB Minshew did set an AAC record w/52 completions in their blowout loss at Hou and Tulane does have our #95 ranked pass eff D. The Green Wave are just 13-56 SU away and lost by DD's despite being DD chalk at FIU, while EC is 15-10-1 as a HD.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 3 over Nc State - BC is 8-4 SU/7-5 ATS as ACC rivals. The Eagles have won 3 straight, all by outright upsets. The Wolfpack have dropped B2B physical games to ND & Clemson. QB Finley has hit 66% w/a 15-3 ratio but the Eagles come in with our #1 ranked pass eff D. BC's D is ranked #38, allowing 36 ypg less than their foes avg and they've held their L/2 foes to a ssn low in yards. With NCSU coming off their 2 toughest foes and BC coming in fresh off a bye, we see no reason to go against the hot Eagles who have covered 6 straight by an avg of 19.8 ppg.

UCF by 31 over Connecticut - UCF is the lone undefeated Group of 5 sch'l and remain in contention for NY 6 bowl. QB Milton, 1 of the most under appreciated QB's in the nation, is off a car high 412 pass yard effort, and UConn counters with our #124 ranked pass eff D! UConn QB Sherriffs was inj LW (CS). The Knights are 5-1 as a HF and on a 12-5 overall ATS run, while the Huskies are 9-19-1 as an AD and on a 18-39-1 overall ATS run. UCF has huge edges across the board and should be able to name the score here.

PENN ST by 32 over Rutgers - It's Homecoming weekend in Happy Valley. PSU is off a brutal 3 week stretch vs UM, OSU and MSU and are eliminated from the playoffs after last weeks last second defeat. Don't look now, but RU has won 3 of 4, though they've still been outgained by every FBS on their sked. RB Barkley was held w/o a td for the first time in 15 games last week and has been limited to under 100 rush yds in 4 of his L/5. Luckily he will oppose a Scarlet Knight D that's allowing 225 (5.6) rush ypg in B10 play. PSU is 11-4 as a HF and we feel will bounce back in a major way vs an RU squad that's not nearly as good as its record indicates.

Duke by 4 over ARMY - Duke is 9-2 SU/8-3 ATS in this series. LY Duke's 2 td drives tt'd just 41 yds and they won 13-6 (-6), holding Army to their 2nd lowest rush yds of the season (165, 3.8). HC Cutcliffe has covered 6 straight vs the option, winning 5 outright. Army shutout Air Force at home for the first time since 1980 last week. Ahmad Bradshaw put up a car high 265 rush yds, which is the most ever by an Army QB. Duke has lost 5 straight but they do get extra time to prep for the option as they enter fresh off a bye. The Blue Devils allow 142 (3.9) rush ypg and they hold opponent's to 30 ypg below their season avg. Army has held foes to 20 ypg below their season avg. The Black Knights are just 1-9 ATS at home vs FBS foes and Duke is 18-4 ATS vs non-conf foes.

OHIO ST by 14 over Michigan St - MSU is on a 3-1 ATS series run and the visitor has won each of the L/6 regular season games SU. After their shocking loss OSU now finds itself on the outside looking in for the Playoff. The winner of this game will be in the drivers' seat for the B10 Champ game. After arguably his best game ever, QB Barrett followed up with what was likely his worst ever game after throwing 4 int's. The resurgent Sparty enters off an emotional win over PSU after hitting the GW 34 yd fg w/no time left. The Bucks were held to a season low 163 rush yards and while MSU is allowing just 70 (2.4) in B10 play, they did allow 182 (4.6) vs Notre Dame. Logic would say to play on OSU following a loss, but the fact that they're just 7-14 as a HF, while MSU is in their preferred role (7-2 AD) we're not comfortable enough to make the Bucks more than 2 td chalk.

Indiana by 14 over ILLINOIS - These B10 rivals haven't met s/13. While Indy enters having lost 5 of 6 including 4 straight, they remain in contention for a bowl if they win out and they have the sked to do so. They're much better than their record indicates and despite taking on our #25 toughest sked, are +21 ypg. IL enters having lost 7 straight and is -97 ypg against our #53 toughest slate. The Hoosiers have had difficulty running the ball, but should find success vs an Illini D that is allowing 217 (4.9) rush ypg in B10 play. IL uses a 2 QB system and has allowed 28 (10.4%) sacks, while Indy has 22 (8.7%) sacks themselves. IL is 4-7 as a HD and on a 4-10 overall ATS run and we'll like the Hoosiers to gain some confidence with a 2 td win as they look to become bowl elig on the stretch.

Troy by 20 over COASTAL CAROLINA - 1st mtg. Troy, who is 12-4 ATS away, enters with 2 extra days of prep/rest & have a bye on deck. CCU is off a surprise almost upset of Ark. LW the Trojans again hung on to win 24-21, but that was as an 18 pt HF, as we won our Marquee GOY with Idaho and the easy cover! Troy has OFF (#95-#119) and D (#65-#125) edges. The question here is whether the Chanticleers will be reinvigorated or worn out by their near upset. We'll go with the latter as we've been spot on in Troy games this season knowing when to play on or play against them.

Middle Tennessee by 20 over CHARLOTTE - These 2 have met twice, and the competitiveness of those 2 gms have been polar opposites. MT put up a school record 659 yds along with 73 points LTH, but LY they barely escaped w/ 7 point win. Charlotte was held to just 8 FD's & 231 yds in their 6-0 loss to ODU last week. QB Stockstill hadn't played since week 2, but returned last week & led MT to a 30-3 (+17) win over UTEP, holding the Miners to a season low 137 yds. The 49ers OFF is #117, being held to 96 ypg below what their opponent's allow. MT's D is #32, holding foes to 41 ypg below their season avg. Charlotte is 4-10-1 ATS at home. MT is 7-3 as a DD fav.

NEVADA by 21 over San Jose St - Following a rough home matchup against SDSt where they were held to just 7 pts, 8 FD's & 200 yds (45 pt loss), the Spartans are back on the road for the 3rd time in the past 4 gms (another AG at Colo St on deck) to take on a Nevada squad that was shutout in the 2H of their loss at Boise. If you throw out the 2H of LW's matchup vs Boise it's safe to say that Nevada has strung together some consistent outings over the past 4 gms with a 3-1 ATS mark. With SJSJ being outscored by 31 ppg (-196 ypg) on the road, the smart money is on the home team here.

Texas Tech by 14 over Baylor † - This is the ninth straight season this game is being played on a neutral field including the seventh straight in Arlington at AT&T Stadium, home of the NFL's Cowboys. BU is in revenge mode after having their 5 game series win streak snapped LY and the Bears are on a 6-3 ATS series run. TT enters having lost 5 of 6 including 4 straight, while BU won their first game over lifeless KU. QB Shimonek threw for 405 w/a 4-1 ratio last week and the Bears have our #111 ranked pass eff D. BU is travelling for the second straight week and while HC Rhule is 16-5 as a dog of 7' or more, he's 3-3 in that role this year. We'll go ahead and give TT the nod by 2 td's.

West Virginia by 4 over KANSAS - KST is 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS in this series as B12 rivals and will be in revenge mode after blowing a 16-3 4Q lead last year. Third string QB Thompson's (Delton & Ertz inj, CS) td w/42 left sent the game into OT where his 8 yd td pass won it, cashing yet another outright winner on our Underdog POW on these pages! WV QB Grier bounced back from his subpar game vs OSU by hitting 80% for 316 yards vs ISU and the Cats have allowed 3 straight QB's to throw for 400+ yards. KST is 2-6 as a HF and we'll call for the Mountaineers to pull the outright upset.

OKLAHOMA by 10 over TCU - The visitor is 4-1 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. We cashed a 4★ LPS on OU in their wild Bedlam shootout as QB Mayfield enhanced his Heisman stock after throwing for a schl record 598 yds! Making that more impressive was the fact he did it against what was our #4 pass eff D. TCU rebounded from their first loss by handing state rival TX HC Herman his first ever ATS loss as a dog. The determining factor for this game will be the Sooners OFF vs the Horned

Frogs D and while OU's OFF has yet to be slowed down, TCU has allowed 490 ypg vs SMU. OSU & WV. The Sooners are 42-25 as a HF and on a 10-5 overall ATS run, while the Horned Frogs are on an 8-12-1 overall ATS run and we'll call for OU to remain in the playoff hunt with a DD win.

Oklahoma St by 3 over IOWA ST - It's Sr day in Ames. OSU is on a 5-3 ATS series run, but the home team is 4-2 ATS. The Pokes enter off an emotional Bedlam loss and are travelling for the third time in 4 weeks, while ISU nearly came back after falling behind 20-0 at WV. ISU has been the feel good story of the B12 as HC Campbell has them believing behind a D that ranks #17, holding foes to 85 ypg less than their average. OSU could be without leading WR Washington (CS) and the Clones have already beaten OU and TCU. ISU is 7-2-1 as a HD and we'll call for them to keep this game closer than expected.

LOUISVILLE by 5 over Virginia - All 3 meetings between these two have been decided by a td or less. LY UL barely escaped as an almost 5 td fav, pass with :13 left. The Hoos were just over a td underdog LW and pulled the outright upset over GT 40-36, giving us another 3★ LPS winner! QB Benkert has thrown for 2,278 w/a 20-6 ratio and Lville has just our #115 ranked pass eff D. Lville enters fresh off a bye, having lost 3 of 4 with each loss being an outright upset. The Cards D has really struggled, allowing 82 ypg more than their foes avg and they've allowed 3 of their L/4 opponent's to reach a season high in yards. The Cards are on a 2-11 ATS run incl 0-6 at home and are just 13-25 as a HF! UVA is 19-12 as a dog.

Notre Dame by 7 over MIAMI, FL - This will be the most hyped meeting between these two since the "Catholics vs Convicts" game in 1988. These 2 picked their rivalry back up LY with ND getting a 30-27 (+1) upset in an otherwise disappointing ssn. Miami will have to be up for a big game in B2B weeks after beating VT 28-10, holding the Hokies to a season low 299 yards. ND was a 2 td fav LW vs WF and led 48-23 before allowing 2 garbage td's, getting backdoored with :51 left. RB Adams has 1,191 (8.7) rush yds but missed the 2H LW (inj, CS). The Canes allow 170 (3.9) rush ypg but did allow 200+ rush yds in 3 straight earlier this year. Both QB's have a tough test w/ND ranked #23 in our pass eff D and UM ranked #6. QB Rosier has completed just 44% of his passes in the L/2 gms. ND CB Julian Love has 3 int's and set the school rec for car PBU's w/14. ND has won/covered all 3 road gms TY & is 7-2 ATS overall. Miami hasn't been a HD since '15.

NAVY by 12 over Smu - It's Sr day in Annapolis and Navy is on an 8-2 ATS series run. These schools met in last year's finale and SMU was trying to become bowl eligible, but allowed season highs in points and yards including an astonishing 10.3 rush ypc! The Ponies are already bowl eligible this year, but haven't seen the option since and are allowing 241 (5.6) rush ypg their L/4 games! If Navy QB Abery can't go here (shoulder inj, CS) the more than capable Jr Garret Lewis will take over. The Middies are 9-6 as a HF and on a 22-14 overall ATS run, while SMU is on a 1-4 ATS run. A win here will make Navy bowl eligible and we'll call for them to end their 3 game losing streak with a DD win.

UTAH by 3 over Washington St - The Cougars have won the past 2 meetings in this series but they last played in '14. WSU held the Cardinal to just 9 FD's & 176 yds LW but needed a TD with 6:56 remaining to claim the 3 pt victory (QB Falk set P12 career passing mark!). The Utes meanwhile had no issue disposing of the Bruins (no QB Rosen) with a 506-249 yd edge and a 31 pt victory. **With 3 successful Game of the Year Winners against the Cougars in our history including our very first 2 selections way back in 1982 & 1983**, go ahead and call us superstitious but Utah is a valid selection here in all home in SLC, especially with WSU dropping their past 2 conf road games by a 95-40 margin!

NORTHWESTERN by 10 over Purdue - NW is on a 4-2 ATS series run. The 'Cats enter off a tough 3 game stretch (Iowa, MSU, Neb) that saw them become the first team in FBS history to win 3 straight OT games! Purdue snapped a 3 game slide in their win over IL, but it was costly as starting QB Blough is likely OFY. Sindelar has started 4 games this year. Against two common B10 foes (UW, Neb) NW is +76 ypg, while Purdue is -191 ypg! NW is 6-3 as a HF, but the Boilermakers are 17-6 as an AD.

MISSISSIPPI by 10 Louisiana - Ole Miss is 4-0 in this series with the avg score 36-18. The Rebels have struggled on D, allowing 102 ypg above what their opponent's average. With that knowledge, last week we went with OVER 63 in Ole Miss vs KY and got a winner in our 4.5★ College Totals Game of the Year! The Rebels scored with just :05 left to give Ole Miss the outright upset. QB Ta'amu threw for 382 w/a 4-0 ratio, filling in nicely for inj'd QB Patterson who is OFY. LA is only -16 ypg on the road & earlier TY they led SEC's A&M at halftime with a +100 yd edge before falling apart in the 2H in a 24 pt loss. We see no reason to back the Rebels who are 0-3 ATS vs non conf foes TY, just 1-5 ATS vs SBC foes, have no bowl hopes and are in an SEC sandwich game.

MINNESOTA by 3 over Nebraska - These schools first played in 1900 and the \$5 Bits of Broken Chair Trophy has been on the line s/2014. NU is 4-2 ATS in this series as B10 rivals. With each team entering with 4 wins, this game is extremely important in terms of becoming bowl elig. MN has been worn down vs teams known for their physicality and while that has historically been the case for the Huskers, the Mike Riley version is more finesse. QB Lee had appeared to put his int issues behind him, but threw 3 more in last week's loss and the Gophers are a respectable #41 in our pass eff D rankings. NU is dreadful at defending the run (204, 5.1 v B10) and MN has proven capable of being able to run when in the right opportunity. This is the lone home game in a 4 week stretch for MN and HC Fleck is on a 26-14-1 overall ATS run.

FAU enters off a 30-25 (-6), Owls took safety on final poss) home win over Marshall. The Owls got 4 int's including 3 from All-CUSA S Jalen Young. You can expect a boatload of points in this game. FAU has put up the most yards that 3 of their L/5 opponent's have allowed. On the flip side, FAU's D is #116, allowing 62 ypg more than their foes avg while LT allows 26 ypg more than their foes avg. No one in CUSA has stopped Singletary and the Bulldogs don't seem to be the team to change that trend as they allow 196 (4.6) rush ypg in CUSA play. The Owls are on a 6-2-2 ATS run. **Southern Miss by 13 over RICE** - Rice is 4-3 in the series but has B2B losses by 36 ppg. LTH SM led 58-0 .06 into the 4Q. While Rice finished with the yards edge last week vs UAB, in actuality, they trailed 49-7 in the 4Q before adding 2 garbage td's which accounted for their 463 yards. They did give up 3 TO's which turned into 21 1st half points for the Blazers. SM enters having lost 2 straight and are playing their 2nd of B2B road gms. QB Howard hit just 7-22-100 with an int then was benched in the 4Q last week in their loss to Tenn. The Golden Eagles hold foes to 46 ypg below their season avg. Rice's OFF avg 67 ypg below what their foes allow. The Owls are 2-7 ATS and have failed to cover all 3 at home. SM is 15-8 as an AF and still needs 1 win to become bowl eligible.

Usc by 16 over COLORADO - Following a dismal loss in South Bend 3 wks ago, the Trojans have been able get up off the canvas with solid victories in Tempe against the Sun Devils and LW at home versus Arizona where RB Jones had a field day with 194 rush yds & 3 TD's (USC 642-380 yd edge). The Buffs meanwhile blew a 10 pt lead in Tempe with the Sun Devils ending the game on a 24-3 run in the 4Q. Although the Buffs have the altitude and potential cold weather edge against the boys from SoCal, keep in mind that the Trojans (1994 Game of the Year Winner) are a perfect 11-0 in the series with a 22 pt avg MOV (+130 ypg).

WISCONSIN by 17 over Iowa - The first meeting took place in 1894 and the Heartland Trophy has been on the line s/2004. The visitor has won 6 in a row SU and Iowa is on a 9-4 ATS series run. It was a shock to see Iowa score 55 points in their rout of OSU after averaging just 14 ppg in 4 of their L/5 games! UW turned a 24-17 4Q lead into a 45-17 route over Indy as they continue to rely on true frosh RB Taylor, an efficient pass game from QB Hornibrook and a D that is #8, holding foes to 116 ypg less than their average. UW is 21-12-1 ATS in B10 home games and we've won our GOY (28-7 all-time!) three times when using the Badgers!

AUBURN by 3 over Georgia - This is the 121st mtg of the Deep South's oldest rivalry. UGA is 9-2 SU/8-3 ATS, having pulled off B2B upsets. The Dawgs were in an obvious look ahead situation last week as a 23' pt fav vs SC. Now they must get up for their biggest test since beating ND on the road earlier TY. Auburn appears to have righted the ship, winning their L/2 by 32 pts over Ark & last week by 15 pts over A&M (Aub +153 yds, allowed td for backdoor push w/3:11 left). This game features two stout run D's. The Tigers allow 126 (3.3) rush ypg while UGA allows just 89 (3.1) rush ypg. Both tms run the ball well with UGA avg 279 (5.8) ypg behind RB's Chubb & Michel who have comb'd of for 1577 (6.9). Aub rushes for 237 (5.0) ypg w/RB Johnson leading with 868 (5.2). With these teams so similar and even, we give a slight edge to the home team with a veteran QB & Aub was 2-0 as a HD last year.

TEXAS A&M by 16 over New Mexico - A&M is 3-0 vs NM with the avg MOV by 35 ppg. The L/mtg was '09's opener, a 41-6 win. The Lobos have dropped 13 straight vs P5 foes and are 1-6 ATS. QB Mond was benched in favor of Starkel during A&M's 15 pt loss to Aub. The Aggies were outgained by 153 yds & trailed 42-20 before getting a td w/3:11 left to avoid the ATS loss. NM has lost 4 straight, and in 3 of those were held to 10 pts or less. The Lobos must win out to be bowl elig which is extremely unlikely. They are -39 ypg on the road and have surrendered 11 TO's in their L/2 games. A&M has allowed 228+ rush yds in each of their L/4. NM is 7-1 as a DD dog.

Arizona St by 6 over UCLA - If you take out a subpar performance against USC a few weeks back at home in Tempe, it's becoming clear that the Sun Devils are heading in a positive direction following another solid performance (especially in the 4Q) LW against Colorado where they had their most rush yds (381) in a conf game in 10 yrs. While the Bruins get an extra day of rest and are back at home in the Rose Bowl, they were unable to get anything going in their trip to SLC without QB Rosen (CS) with the Utes finishing with a 506-249 yd edge in the 31 pt victory. With the Sun Devils having won the past 2 years outright as 10 & 12' pt dogs and the visitor on a 4-1 overall ATS run, we see no issue riding ASU again this weekend.

Georgia St by 7 over TEXAS ST - It's Sr day in San Marcos. GST is on the 2nd of B2B AG's & has a bye on deck. The Panthers have won the L2Y by an avg of 21 ppg and had a ssn high 536 yds LY. QB Manning threw for a then car high 340 yds. TXSt is 4-9 as a HD. The Panthers are tied for 2nd in the conf at 4-1 (only SBC loss vs Troy), while TXSt is 1-4 in conf play. After a 3-9 ssn LY, the Panthers are 1 win away from bowl eligibility, while the Bobcats are playing for pride and we'll call for GST to win by a td.

NORTH TEXAS by 27 over UTEP - UTEP has won the L/3 but has never gotten to 4 str vs NT. NT will be out for revenge after losing their season finale LY. The Mean Green have reached 6 wins for the first time S/13 after upsetting LT last week. RB Wilson went for 165 (8.3) and got the go-ahead td with 6:04 remaining. The Miners were once again dreadful last week as they were held to 137 yds & 3 points. UTEP has been held under 300 yds in every game this season (which is a big reason we have won on the Under in their L/2 games for 3★ & 4★ LP Totals plays!). NT is +170 ypg at home and are coming off their D is coming off their best performance of the season, holding LT to a ssn low 315 yds. UTEP is 2-7 ATS on the season. In '14 we used this rivalry as our College GOY and got a winner. This time could we use the Mean Green vs an overmatched Miner's squad?

TEXAS by 35 over Kansas - TX will be playing with ultimate revenge after losing to KU for the first time s/38 last year! The 'Horns are on a 10-4 ATS series run and this is their lone home game in a 4 week stretch. HC Herman wasn't able to cover the spread as a dog for the first time vs TCU as QB Ehlinger remained out (concussion, CS). KU meanwhile was dominated by a Baylor squad (otgd by 178 yds vs TX wk prior) that hadn't won a game all season and it appears to be just a matter of time before a new face will be roaming the sidelines in Lawrence. TX is on a 6-2 overall ATS run, while the Jayhawks are not only on a 10-23-1 ATS run, but are also 18-35-1 as an AD. It won't matter who is under center for TX here as the Jayhawks are #115 on D allowing 64 ypg more than their foes average and the 'Horns need to win 2 of their L/3 in order to become bowl eligible and won't take any chances against an overmatched foe.

MARSHALL by 17 over Wku - Marshall will be out for revenge after getting waxed on their home field LY & they get to host for a 2nd straight yr. Last wk we used the Herd as our Fri night Marquee and while we certainly were fortunate to cover thanks to FAU taking a late safety, Marshall did outgain & outFD FAU but K Vedvik missed a PAT and a short fg. The 'Toppers enter off a loss at Vandy and to make matters worse, QB White was inj on the final series (CS). This is WKU's 2nd consecutive AG and they're -35 ypg away while Marshall is +60 ypg at home. The Herd's D is #35, holding foes to 41 ypg below their avg while WKU's D is just #106, allowing 48 ypg more than their foes avg. Marshall is 18-11 ATS at home, while WKU is on a 2-6 ATS run including 0-4 away. We hope you took advantage of the free Sept 5★ on Marshall & also hope you jump in on our College GOY this wknd!

FIU by 7 over Old Dominion - ODU is 2-1 SU/2-0-1 ATS in this series. The home tm has won all 3 mtgs. HC Butch Davis has the Panthers bowl eligible for the first time since 2011! They come in having pulled off 3 consec outright upsets. They won 2 of those by DD's as a DD dog. ODU got their first win over an FBS foe LW, beating lowly Charlotte 6-0 (-8'). The Monarchs are -52 ypg in CUSA play but FIU isn't much better at -35 ypg. ODU is just 4-13 as a dog. Though FIU has played better lately, they've also failed to cover their L/5 as a favorite and we will need to see them prove they can do that before we put our faith behind them.

UTSA by 3 over Uab - UAB is undoubtedly one of the most interesting stories in CFB this year. After the program's two year absence, UAB returned this year and with last week's win over Rice, they became bowl eligible. The Blazers are +24 ypg. UTSA is stuck on 5 wins after their 7 point loss at FIU last week. The RoadRunners are +129 ypg on the season. QB Sturm is hitting 65% of his passes w/a outstanding 14-2 ratio. UAB's QB Erdley has also been impressive hitting 20 of 21 passes last week and he has a 12-2 ratio on the season. True Frosh RB Brown now has 1,046 (5.8) rush yds on the season. UTSA counters with our #22 pass eff D. UTSA has failed to cover their L/5 as a HF vs FBS foe and UAB has 4 straight covers as a dog incl 3 outright upsets.

CLEMSON by 16 Florida St - It's fitting that we are releasing our GOY this wknd as LTH FSU came through as our 5★ GOY Winner. Clemson's D had their toughest test last week, allowing a ssn high 491 yds. The Tigers got off to a slow start, but led 38-28 before giving up the cover w/1:51 left. FSU got a much needed win last week, but were still outgained by 120 yds & outFD'd by 8. The 'Noles are -26 ypg in ACC play, but their D is #14, allowing 96 ypg less than their foes avg. Clemson is +76 ypg in ACC play and their D is #6, allowing 136 ypg less than their foes avg. FSU has still yet to cover this year (0-6-2) but Clemson hasn't covered in their L/4 (0-3-1). When was the last time FSU was a DD Dog? It just happens to be that same '15 meeting with Clemson we mentioned earlier.

LSU by 14 over Arkansas - The Golden Boot is up for grabs in this rivalry. LSU reclaimed "The Boot" in LY's road win. Ark pulled outright upsets in the prev 2 mtgs incl LTH 31-14 (+6'). The one thing HC Bielema couldn't afford was a poor performance against a lesser foe, yet that's exactly what we saw last week in their near loss to Coastal Carolina (also apologies to our customer's who had a 3★ LPS on Ark -23'). LSU is off a solid effort vs Bama, holding the Tide under 300 yds while also having a slight yds edge (+7). LSU is +88 ypg overall and +21 ypg vs SEC foes. Ark is -33 ypg on the season and -150 ypg vs SEC foes despite having faced an easier schedule. The Razorbacks are 8-2 as an AD, 8-2 ATS in this series, and they likely get QB Allen back from inj this week so we will lean with the dog here.

ARIZONA by 27 over Oregon St - While the Wildcats erased a 22 pt deficit with 4 TD's in roughly 11 minutes LW against USC, they were unable to get the victory as the Trojans would score the game's final 14 pts (USC 642-380 yd edge). Arizona now returns home to take on a Beavers squad that were outright by a 475-299 yd clip in their 14 pt loss to Cal. The past 2 meetings in this series have gone in favor of the home team in blowout fashion with Arizona winning 44-7 in '15 and OSU returning the favor, 42-17 a year ago. With the Wildcats averaging 43 ppg & 546 ypg in their P12 HG's and delivering winners in each of our very first 2 Game of the Year Winners back in 1982 & 1983, could they be in the mix once again this weekend?

Boise St by 8 over COLORADO ST - The Broncos FINALLY ended their home game ATS skid (8 in a row!) LW against Nevada by holding them scoreless the entire 2H of their 27 pt victory. The Rams meanwhile dropped their 2nd straight outright as a favorite in the rain & snow of Laramie (CSU 345-292 yd edge). In their meeting a ssn ago the Rams trailed 28-3 in the 4Q before scoring 20 straight (recov 2 outside kicks) in the backdoor cover on the blue turf. With Boise having won all 6 meetings including a 41-10 win here in '15, we'll go ahead and lean in their direction with CSU now failing to cover in each of the past 4 wks.

Fresno St by 14 over HAWAII - The Warriors had 181 of their 400 yds in the 4Q LW in Las Vegas but fell just short in the 8 pt defeat (ball at UNLV23 as time expired). While the Bulldogs did fail to get the cover LW against BYU in the 7 pt win, they still currently reside atop the West division (bowl eligible for 1st time in 3Y). In their meeting a ssn ago, Hawaii had a 76/12pl drive getting the GW TD w/59 remaining. With Fresno having won on the islands in their past 2 trips by 5 & 28 pts, we'll go ahead and call for them to continue their surprising ssn as a conf AF for just the 2nd time in the past 3 ssn (pushed at SJSt earlier TY).

TUESDAY 11/14
OHIO at AKRON - Ohio has won 9 str in this series (5-3-1 ATS), but the dog is 4-1. Akron will enter this game off a Tuesday contest, while OU will enter off a Wed game. As of this writeup, this game could determine the MAC East champion! The Bobcats have the edge on OFF & D. OU is led by RB Ouellette as they avg 233 (5.5) rush ypg, while the Zips allow 206 (4.8) rush ypg in MACtion. The Bobcats are 9-2 ATS in true road games, while Akron is 7-21 as a HD.
C Michigan at KENT ST - It's Sr day in Kent. CM is in revenge mode after giving up a 14 pt 2H lead & all'g the GW fg w/no time left as over 2 td chalk LY. CM will enter this game off a Wed tilt vs EM, while KSU will also enter off a Wed gm at WM. Before their EM matchup, CM was holding foes to 29 ypg below their average, while the Flashes were nearly last in the FBS at #129, being held to 156 ypg less than their foes allow before the WM game. KSU is on an 8-13 overall ATS run, while CM is 14-4 as an AF vs MAC foes.

4★ TENNESSEE over Cincinnati - This is the 2nd of 3 consec road contests for the Bengals with an always treacherous trip to Denver on deck. CIN is in must-win mode as they sit at just 3-5 following their road defeat to the Jaguars a week ago where they were held to just 7 FD's & 148 tll yds. The Titans meanwhile earned a win following their bye week, with the Ravens getting the backdoor push with :46 remaining (BAL did have solid FD & yardage edges). With the Bengals on just an 8-17 ATS run and covering just 1 of their past 7 overall as an AD, we'll lean with the Titans in this one as QB Mariota continues to get healthier from a nagging hamstring injury.

FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 13

3★ Dallas over ATLANTA - The Falcons and Cowboys were the top 2 teams in the NFC a ssn ago with a 24-8 combined record. This is the only HG in a 5-wk span for ATL as they enter play having dropped 4 of their past 5 overall following LW's 3 pt loss to the Panthers in Charlotte as 2.5 pt chook (ATL 355-330 yd edge). The Cowboys meanwhile delivered a big home win against the Chiefs holding one of the league's top offenses to 13 pts under their ssn avg. With DAL a solid 11-5 ATS in NDIV matchups and the Falcons posting just a 5-16 ATS mark as a HF, we'll call for DAL to go into Atlanta and get the outright upset in this one as they attempt to keep pace in the NFC East with the front-running Eagles.

FORECAST: DALLAS by 3

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ LA Chargers (+) over JACKSONVILLE - The Chargers return to action having covered just 1 of their past 6 following their bye week. They have however strung together wins in 3 of their past 4 including a pair of outright upsets on the road against the Giants and Raiders. The Jaguars meanwhile had no issue disposing of the Bengals in their bye week return behind yet another dominating defensive performance (all'd just 7 pts, 7 FD's & 148 tll yds). The Chargers have clearly owned this series dating back to 2010 with a perfect 6-0 SU/ATS mark (19 pt avg MOV) including an easy 24 pt win (-3) LY in San Diego (JAX 388-357 yd edge). With the Jaguars just 4-14 ATS as a NDIV HF and the Chargers having plenty of narrow misses on the scoreboard over the past 3 yrs (10 losses by a FG or less), a 1 pt edge is all that we can give in this one.

OTHER PLAYS

Seattle at ARIZONA - Thursday - Following a 10 pt win on the road against the 49ers in QB Stanton's 1st start of the ssn for the inj'd Palmer (15-30 for 201 yds & 2-1 ratio), the Cardinals return to the desert as a DIV HD for the 1st time in 3 ssn. The Seahawks meanwhile suffered a surprising home defeat to a banged-up Redskins squad (WAS GW TD w/:59 left, SEA 437-244 yd edge). In their Glendale meeting a ssn ago the Cardinals had massive FD (23-11) & yardage (443-257) edges but a late blk'd punt by the Seahawks set up the tying FG (SEA's offense had not crossed midfield prior to that play) with the game eventually ending in a 6-6 OT draw. While the Seahawks have gone just 3-8 ATS as a DIV AF, also keep in mind that the Cardinals have covered just 5 of their past 19 overall. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.

WASHINGTON by 3 over Minnesota - While a bye week is generally a good thing for NFL teams, the Vikings haven't seen much success following their week off with just a 1-6 ATS mark over the past 7 ssn including LY when they went on an epic collapse with 4 consec SU/ATS losses after their 5-0 SU/ATS start. They head to D.C. to take on a Redskins squad that earned the shocking comeback win in SEA with the GW TD w/:59 remaining (Seahawks had gone ahead :35 earlier with a TD of their own). Although the Vikings are on a 25-12 overall ATS run, we'll go ahead and give WAS the 3 pt edge in this one with some of their key OL expected to return to the lineup after missing the past 2 wks.

Green Bay by 2 over CHICAGO - The Bears are back at home following their bye week sporting a defense that's holding opponents to 39 ypg under their ssn avg. Although the Packers do come into Chicago on short rest after their MNF matchup against the Lions, they have won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) in the "Windy City" with a 9 pt avg MOV. While the Bears have been magical as a HD with an 8-1-1 ATS run, this will mark the 1st time that they're a DIV HF in 3 ssn. Despite Packers QB Hundley making his 1st career road start in this one, we'll call for them to continue their winning ways in Soldier Field this weekend.

Pittsburgh by 8 over INDIANAPOLIS - Following a 6 pt road upset in HOU LW behind a 175 yd, 2 TD performance from WR Hilton (371-297 yd edge), the Colts return home to take on a well-rested Steelers squad that's failed to cover 4 of their past 5 after their bye. PIT has had some recent success against the Colts dating back to 2011 with a 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS mark including a 28-7 win here a ssn ago (PIT just a 369-310 yd edge). While the Steelers are clearly ahead of IND in nearly every statistical category and are arguably one of the AFC's top teams, it's tough to lay double digits on the road at any time, especially with the Colts having won and covered each of the previous 4 yrs prior to their bye week including 3 times as a dog (IND 12-3 ATS run as a HD).

NY Jets by 2 over TAMPA BAY - Following another solid performance as a HD last Thur against the Bills where they recorded 7 sks (had just 11 all ssn coming in) & all'd just 307 yds, the Jets head South on a 6-0-1 ATS run. The Bucs meanwhile dropped their 5th straight LW in the Superdome (outgained 407-200 in 20 pt defeat) with QB Winston leaving yet another game with inj (CS here). While this is the only HG in a 5-wk stretch for the Bucs, their 3-10 ATS mark as a HF and the Jets recent run of success has us expecting the outright road win here.

BUFFALO by 3 over New Orleans - Two of the NFL's more surprising teams square off in this one as the Saints come in as winners of 6 straight (5-1 ATS) after their easy home win over the Bucs a week ago (all'd just 10 pts & 200 yds). The Bills meanwhile are sitting at 5-3 SU (5-2-1 ATS) following their road defeat against the Jets where their OL was dominated to the tune of 7 sks all'd. With the Saints having covered just 4 of their past 12 as an AF the past 5 yrs, we'll go ahead and back the Bills (11-4 ATS run as a HD) here in their only HG in a 4-wk span (BUF 7-0-1 ATS vs NFC).

DETROIT by 14 over Cleveland - While things can't get much worse with a 1-23 SU (6-18 ATS) mark the past 2 ssn, the Browns return from their bye week with 3 road trips in the next 4 wks. The Lions meanwhile are 9-4-1 ATS as a HF but do return to Ford Field on short rest after their MNF matchup in Lambeau. Dating back to the 2005 ssn the Lions have won all 3 matchups in this series (2-1 ATS). Although DET is on a rough 6-12 ATS run against the AFC including a home loss to the Steelers a few weeks back, it's tough to back the Browns (6-12 ATS as AD) in any situation, especially when they've failed to cover 8 of their past 9 vs the NFC.

LA RAMS by 14 over Houston - Following a 6 point home loss LW against the Colts in their first game without QB Watson (Savage completed just 19-44 passes), the Texans head out West to take on the NFC West leading Rams. LA surpassed the 40 pt mark for the 3rd time TY (473-319 yd edge) on the road LW against the Giants. With the Rams having the NFL's #1 scoring offense at 32.9 ppg, we'll go ahead and lean in their direction here as the Texans are on just a 4-8 ATS run as a NDIV AD.

NY Giants by 3 over SAN FRANCISCO - While the Giants and 49ers have been part of some memorable playoff meetings in the past (postseason series deadlocked at 4 apiece), the 2017 version is the weakest matchup on the Wk 10 docket as they come in at a combined 1-16 on the year. The 49ers were unable to get the job done at home LW against the Cardinals in what could be their final game before the Garoppolo era begins at QB (CS for this weekend). The Giants meanwhile were gashed on defense to the tune of 51 pts & 473 yds in their 34 pt home loss to the Rams. Although both teams are likely headed to the basement of their respected divisions, we'll give the lean to the visitor in this one as the 49ers have shockingly covered just 2 of their past 18 against NDIV foes.

New England at DENVER - SNF - Following some early ssn struggles on the defensive side of the ball, the Patriots have rebounded over their 4-gm win streak by all'g 17 or fewer pts in each. They now head to DEN after their bye week and sporting a 6-1 ATS mark as a NDIV AF. The Broncos return home following a 3-gm road trip that saw them outscored by 59 pts in losses to the Chargers, Chiefs and Eagles (4★ Newsletter & 3★ LP Winner on PHI, first time the Broncos all'd more than 300 yds on def TY). While DEN has covered 4 of their past 5 as a HD, that lone loss came to this very same NE squad a ssn ago (Patriots 16-3 win as 3' pt chalk). **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**

Miami at CAROLINA - MNF - The Dolphins continue to head in the wrong direction following a home loss to the Raiders a week ago (earned the backdoor push w/1:32 left).
