A win for Kentucky gives them their first winning SEC record since 1977! The 'Cats are off their best performance of the year in their 44-21 win at Vandy, which gave us a 2★ winner on these pages as well as a 3★ LPS winner on the Over (8-3 L3W!). RB Snell became the first KY player to have B28 1,000 yd seasons and also broke the school's career rush td record (28) as just a soph. We'll side with UC by a td. **Georgia Tech by 6 over DUKE** - It's Sr day in Durham. GT won 10 straight in this series from '05-'13 then Duke won 2 in a row but GT won LY. HC Cutcliffe is 6-2 ATS vs triple option teams and has the added advantage of having a bye week, then ply'g Army prior to this gm (3 wks to prep). After starting the season 4-0, Duke has now lost 6 straight, but 4 of those came by a td or less. The Blue Devils held Army to a ssn low 226 (4.0) rush yds LW. GT is off an upset win at VT where they held the Hokies to their lowest tly ards of the ssn (172 yds below their avg). The Jackets are 1 win away from bowl eligiblity and they have UGA on deck, making this a must win. Against 5 common foes, GT is +14 ST in home finales but Pitt is 6-2 SU/ATS in this series, having pulled 5 outright upsets the L/8. Pitt gets extra rest coming off a surprising Thurs night home loss to NC. The Panthers held a 43 yard edge but allowed a KR td and lost at dby fumbling as they crossed the goal line. RB Hall has gone over 100 yds in 3 straight and he could find some room against VT's D that has allowed 240 (5.2) rush ypg their

LOUISVILLE by 10 over Syracuse - It's Sr day in Louisville but the Cards are just 3-6 SU and 0-9 ATS in home finales! These two were Big East rivals from '05-'12 and L'ville has won/covered all 3 as ACC foes. The Orange led WF 38-21 2Q last week despite ply'g w/o QB Dungey (inj'd, CS) and 43-40 4Q when things fell apart. They allowed a school record 734 yards and allowed points on all 7 of WF's 2H possessions. L'ville became bowl eligible by beating UVA last week. The Cards finished with a +116 yd edge and held the 'Hoos to 115 2H yds. Both teams struggle defensively, with L'ville allowing allowed 102 ypg more than their foes arg in ACC play and they are #103 in our pass eff D rankings. Syracuse has allowed 24 ypg more than their foes allow and are #82 in our pass eff D. With the Cards 0-5 as a HF and Cuse 4-0 as an AD we will happily take the points here. **NORTHWESTERN by 7 over Minnesota** - It's Sr day in Evanston. NW is home for the fourth time in 5

NORTHWESTERN by 7 over Minnesota - It's Sr day in Evanston. NW is home for the fourth time in 5 weeks, while MN is on the road for the third time in 4 weeks, but the Gophers are on a 9-3 ATS series run. MN is fairly easy to handicap. They're strictly 1 dimensional and cannot run on the physical B10 teams. While not known as historically being physical, NW's run D has been dominant as they're allowing just 89 (2.8) rush ypg in conf play and that includes some of the best RB's in the B10 from Wisc, PSU, Iowa, and MSU! RB Jackson is the schools career rushing leader and will have a great opportunity to bounce back from last weeks subpar game as the Gophers allow 189 (5.0) rush ypg in B10 play. The 'Cats are 7-3 as a HF, but MN is 15-6-2 as a B10 dog. While this is the Gophers best chance to become bowl eligible, we can't overlook their issues in the trenches and we'll favor NW by a td.

MICHIGAN ST by 14 over Maryland - It's Sr day in East Lansing. While MSU is off PSU and OSU, MD is in the middle of a tough 3 game stretch as they're off Michigan with PSU on deck. Sparty is playing with revenge after squandering a 4Q lead last year and losing for the first time as B10 rivals. MSU was in control of their own destiny to reach the B10 title game before getting squashed by an angry OSU squad, while the Terps are 1 loss away from staying home for the holidays. MD was down to a fourth string 5'8" walk-on QB last week as Bortenschlager was out (shoulder, CS). While Sparty has struggled to run the ball, look for RB Scott to end his 4 game skid of being held under 100 rush yards as the Terps allow 184 (4.5) rush ypg in B10 play. MSU is 13-6 as DD chalk, while MD is 5-12 as a DD dog and we'll call for Sparty to win by 2 td's.

Oklahoma by 35 over KANSAS - It's Sr day in Lawrence. OU is on an 8-3 ATS run in this series and has covered the L/3 by 14 ppg. KU is near the end of a brutal stretch where they've played ISU, TCU, KSt, and Tx all in the L/5 weeks and have a trip to Stillwater on deck. QB Mayfield is the clear leader in the Heisman race as he enters having thrown multiple to passes in 23 straight games and the Sooners are 1 win away from clinching a spot in the B12 title game. The Sooners are 18-10 ATS away and on an 11-5 overall ATS run, while the Jayhawks are 1-3 as a HD this year and on an 11-23-1 overall ATS run. OU can name the score here and we'll call for them to win by 5 td's. Fresno St by 1 over WYOMING - The Cowboys were able to get the job done at AF a week ago, giving us our 3rd straight outright upset winner in our Underdog POW (6-1 ATS L/7 wksl) despite the loss of star QB Allen to injury. The Bulldogs meanwhile had a 31-0 combined run in the 20/3Q to escape

Fresno St by 1 over WYOMING - The Cowboys were able to get the job done at AF a week ago, giving us our 3rd straight outright upset winner in our Underdog POW (6-1 ATS L/7 wks!) despite the loss of star QB Allen to injury. The Bulldogs meanwhile had a 31-0 combined run in the 2Q/3Q to escape the islands with a 10 pt win (a game ahead of SDSt in the the West Div). UTAH ST by 12 over Hawaii - Following a 10 pt home defeat to front-running Fresno where they had a 401-272 yd deficit, the Warriors take on an Aggies squad that has won 3 in a row in the series including the last time here back in '13 (47-10 win as 24 pt chalk). Utah St is off a late season bye which refreshes them while also boosting their alitude advantage. With this is also expected to be a cold weather contest in treacherous Logan, we expect the warm weather Warriors to have their share of issues in this one (Hawaii outscored by 16 pcg in L/4 road matchups). OLD DOMINION by 9 over Rice - Rice is making their first ever trip to Norfolk. ODU has won B2B

OLD DOMINION by 9 over Rice - Rice is making their first ever trip to Norfolk. ODU has won B2B games and now needs to win their L/2 to become bowl eligible. Rice enters off a 43-34 (+13') loss vs S Miss. This is a battle between two very similar teams. Both have strong running games with ODU averaging 161 (4.1) ypg while Rice averages 183 (4.6). Both teams are starting true frosh QB's. ODU is -89 ypg on the season while Rice is -100 ypg. The edge goes to the Monarchs who are 2-0-1 ATS in home finales, have added motivation from chasing a bowl game and although they are are -39 ypg at home, Rice is just -129 ypg on the road.

SOUTHERN MISS by 16 over Charlotte - It's Sr day in Hattiesburg and the Golden Eagles are 9-3 SU/ ATS in home finale's. This is the 2nd straight ssn that SM has hosted Charlotte after being upset 38-27 (-19') LY. SM was 13' point chalk LW at Rice and led by just 2 until they added a td w/2:55 left. QB Griggs got his first start since week 4 and threw for a career high 331 yds and 3 td's. Charlotte has been outgained by 164 ypg on the road while SM is +106 ypg at home. Look for another big game from Griggs as the 49ers bring our #118 pass eff D. SM is #26 on D, holding foes to 53 ypg below their season average. SM has failed to cover their L/3, with two of those being DD chalk, so despite their advantages we will lean with the dog. **Massachusetts by 3 over BYU** - It's Sr night for BYU. Both enter with just 3 wins but they've been playing better lately. BYU has won 2 of their last 3 (3-0 ATS) and finish the ssn at Hawai'i. UMass has won 3 of their last 4 (3-1 ATS) and has a bye on deck. While this is a long trip for the Minutemen, they've covered 3 straight true road gms, including only losing to then #21 MSt by 11 as a 33 pt dog. BYU lost to that same MSt team by 25 as a 23' pt AD. BYU is just 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS at home. After losing QB Mangum for the ssn, true frosh Critchlow made his first start LW (14-22-160-1-0). UMass QB Andrew Ford returned LW and had his fourth 300+ yd gm (21-31-355-4-0). While BYU has the D edge (#62-#93), UMass has the OFF edge (#62-#115), the more experienced QB, and should pull the outright upset. Louisiana Tech by 21 over UTEP - It's Sr day in El Paso. The Miners have won 3 of their L/4 home

Louisiana Tech by 21 over UTEP - It's Sr day in El Paso. The Miners have won 3 of their L/4 home finales but it's unlikely that trend continues considering how their season has gone. UTEP is winless on the season losing by an average of 26 ppg. Interim HC Price hasn't been able to fix the mess, even saying the rebuild will be tougher than he originally thought. LT is off B2B losses and must win out to become bowl eligible. The Bulldogs actually outgained FAU by 97 yds & held a 32-19 FD edge in their 48-23 (+4') loss last week. LT is 30-15 ATS on the road while UTEP is 2-5 as a HD. The Miners' are also -189 ypg in CUSA play and -159 ypg at home, giving us absolutely no reason to back them here. South Alabama by 7 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - It's Sr day in Statesboro. GS has won/covered all 3 mtgs by an avg of 25/12 ppg. SA has a bye on deck. Against 3 common foes, GS went 0-3 SU & 1-11 ATS, -15 ppg, but +3 ypg. SA is 2-1 SU & ATS, +6 ppg, but -23 ypg. SA still has a shot at a bowl, while GS is 0-9 SU (1-6-2 ATS) with an interim HC. While their OFF are equally bad (SA #125-#126), SA does have a huge D edge (#63-#118). While SA upset SBC leader ASt LW (+ 5 TO), SA is just 2-3 SU & ATS as a favorite this sm. We expect SA to win & cover, but there are better options this week.

To u by 6 over TEXAS TECH - It's Sr Day in Lubbock. TT is 4-1 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. The Red Raiders were fortunate to snap their 4 game skid vs Baylor as despite winning by 2 td's, they were outgained by 186 yards and benefited from their first KOR td to open a game s/73 and a +3 TO margin. TCU has by far the best D in the B12, but had no answer for Baker Mayfield in their loss to OU last week and may have lost RB Anderson for the season (CS). Despite the setback, the Horned Frogs remain in control of their own destiny to reach the conference title game, while TT is 1 win away from becoming bowl eligible. With TCU being just 7-14 as an AF, while the Red Raiders are 13-7 as a HD, we'll call for TT to keep this closer than expected, losing by just under a td.

We'll call for TT to keep this closer than expected, losing by just under a td. **IOWA by 7 over Purdue** - It's Sr day in lowa City and the Hawkeyes are on a 4-2 ATS run in this series. Iowa shocked the CFB world with their dominating performance 2 weeks ago vs OSU as they are an average at best team and while no one expected them to follow up that emotional win with another at Wisconsin, getting held to just 66 yards and outgained by 316 yards was eye opening. Against 4 common B10 foes, the Hawkeyes are -79 ypg, while Purdue is +18 ypg! With QB Blough OFY, the Boilermakers are forced to go to the air more often and Sindelar set career highs in attempts, completions, and yards last week, but he better be careful as lowa has arguably the best CB in the nation in Josh Jackson who followed up his 3 int performance vs OSU, with 2 IR td's last week and leads the nation in PD's! lowa is 12-21-1 as a HF, while Purdue is 17-7 as an AD and we'll give the Hawkeyes the edge by a td.

Arizona by 1 over OREGON - The Wildcats had no problem with the Beavers LW in Tucson as they jumped out to a 28-0 HT lead in the the eventual 49-28 victory (602-360 yd edge). They now head to Eugene looking for their 2nd consec win on the Ducks' home turf after getting the 7 pt road upset (+24) back in '14 against the #2 ranked team in the nation. While the Ducks did return the favor later that year in the P12 Championship (51-13 win, -14'), the 2 haven't met in each of the past 2 ssns. With guestions at

the QB position for the Ducks coming in (CS on whether Herbert returns from inj) and Oregon fresh off a bye, we'll go ahead and call for Arizona to win by the slightest of margins, as there's no line at presstime. **OHIO ST by 40 over Illinois** - It's Sr day in Columbus and OSU is on a 6-2 ATS series run. This game will feature arguably the best team in the B10 versus without question the worst team. An angry Bucks squad obliterated an MSU team that entered ranked #13 as they went back to a dominant ground game that they turned away from in their upset loss at lowa. IL counters with a rush D that is allowing 267 (5.3) on the road and QB George is back solo under center after the injury to Thomas. Sure OSU is in an MSU/ UM sandwich and is 1-6-1 ATS the week prior to "The Game," but the Illini is just 7-18 as an AD and the Bucks won't take any chances in a game that they can name their score in with no backdoor potential.

FLORIDA by 6 over Uab - After starting the season 3-1, Florida has lost 5 straight and for the second time in 5 seasons, will not reach 6 wins. The Gators continued their QB carousel last week, starting Malik Zaire, but he was hurt so they went back to Feleipe Franks despite Zaire being cleared to return. Florida has been outgained by 139 ypg in their L/3. UAB HC Clark has done a magnificent job, and last week in a letdown situation, having already reached 6 wins and on the road, found a way to pull yet another outright upset (5th of the season!!!). RB Brown has gone for over 100 yds in 5 of the L/6. UAB averages 216 (4.1) rush ypg while Florida allows 178 (4.6). We see every reason to back a Blazers' team in their preferred role with a legit chance to take down an SEC foe and we see no reason to back a Gators' team that is 2-7 ATS on the season.

MEMPHIS by 13 over Smu - Memphis has dominated the L/3 meetings, winning by 48 ppg and covering by 33 ppg! The Tigers are in a great situation as they're fresh off a bye, while SMU enters off Navy and is on the second of B2B away games. While both feature potent OFF's, the Ponies are just #111 in the FBS on D, allowing 57 ypg more than their foes average along with our #106 pass eff D. Memphis controls their own destiny to reach the AAC title game and also is just behind UCF in the rankings for the group of five NY6 bowl bid. Tiger RB Henderson has B2B 100 yard games and SMU has allowed 5 straight foes 203+ rush yards! Memphis is just 1-4 as a HF, but we aren't afraid to back them here as we'll call for a DD win.

MIANI, FL by 13 over Virginia - The 'Canes extended their nation long winning streak to 14 games with a shocking 41-8 (+3') home win over Notre Dame. Miami is at home again and this time it's Senior day. Virginia was coming off their sixth win last week and were held to just 277 yds against a weak L'ville D. In UVA's 6 wins, QB Benkert has a 17-4 ratio, but in their 4 losses he has just a 4-3 ratio and Miami brings our #3 pass eff D. The 'Canes are +147 ypg at home and +65 ypg in ACC play while UVA is -53 ypg on the road. Miami is clearly the better team here, and UVA is playing B2B road games but this is a major letdown spot for the 'Canes off B2B physical games against ND & VT and they also failed to cover their L/2 as DD chalk. UVA is 21-12 as a dog.

Iowa St by 10 over BAYLOR - It's Sr day in Waco, but ISt is on a 3-1-1 ATS series run. With wins over 2 top 5 programs in the span of 4 weeks the 'Clones became 1 of the most talked about programs in the nation, however they enter off B2B losses for the first time this year and may be without QB Kempt (inj, CS). Baylor backers deserved better as the Bears had 523-337 yard and 31-18 FD edges but still lost by 2 td's vs TT last week. Despite opening w/8 straight losses, Baylor has shown a ton pride down the strech, which is no surprise considering their new HC Rhule. While ISt is 8-12 ATS on the B12 road, they're on a 12-6-1 overall ATS run, but Baylor is 6-1 as a HD. The 'Clones still have an outside shot of getting to the B12 title came & we'll call for a DD win.

getting to the B12 title game & well call for a DD win. **Mississippi St by 7 over ARKANSAS** - This has been a high scoring affair the L2Y with these 2 combining for 201 pts and 2,304 yds! The visitor is 4-0 ATS and the L/4 mtgs have been decided by a comb'd 19 pts. Miss St enters off a closer than expected 7 point loss to Bama where they were outgained by 114 yds. Ark must win out to become bowl eligible. The Razorbacks are +31 ypg at home, though they outgained their 3 weaker foes at home (Florida A&M, NM St, & Coastal Car) while they were outgained by their 2 tougher foes (TCU & Aub). While the Bulldogs do have edges on OFF & D, they are off a physical game vs the Tide and we don't feel comfortable laying DD's against a Razorbacks team that is 14-9-1 as a dog.

WASHINGTON by 12 over Utah - Not only did the Huskies lose their footing for a potential playoff berth following their loss LW in Stanford (406-325 yd deficit) but they also lost their hold of the P12 North division in the process with the Cardinal and Wash St now in control. The Utes meanwhile have dropped 5 of their L/6 (3-3 ATS) since their bye week including an 8 pt home loss to WSU a week ago. In a back-and-forth matchup last year in SLC, the Huskies got a 58 yd PR TD w/3:25 left to earn the eventual 7 pt victory. We'll go ahead and call for UW to get back on track in this one and pick up a win in a game that's slightly closer than expected.

AUBURN by 30 over UIm - There couldn't possibly be a bigger sandwich game for Auburn than this one, off a physical win over Georgia with the Iron Bowl on deck. That's 2 teams ranked #1 and somehow the Tigers have to get up for a SBC foe! The Tigers are 0-3 ATS the week before playing Bama though they did beat ULM 58-7 (-33) last year. The WarHawks also get the added advantage of being fresh off a bye. ULM allows 505 ypg and is #127, allowing 122 ypg more than their foes average but their OFF is #17, avg 91 ypg more than their foes allow, making for some serious backdoor potential. Add in the fact that Auburn is just 5-13-2 as DD chalk and we see no reason not to take the points.

Continued from page 4.... OKLAHOMA ST by 20 over Kansas St - KSt is on the road for the third time in 4 weeks, but is on a 4-0 ATS run in Stillwater. We normally don't like to play against the Wildcats with Snyder at the controls, but felt that WV had too much firepower thru the air and delivered a 3★ LPS winner as KSt was outgained by 160 yards. If the 'Cats had trouble last week, we really don't like them this week against an even greater pass attack as OKSt has arguably the best QB to WR combo in the nation with Rudolph and Washington and while the latter is banged up, the fact he did see action last week has us thinking he'll be healthier here. We're well aware of KSt's 21-6 mark as an AD, but the Pokes are 31-18 as a HF, don't have a rFR potentially making his first ever road start in an extremely hostile environment, and remain in the B12 title game hunt. COLORADO ST by 35 over San Jose St - The Rams were unable to hold on to a 28-3 lead in the 2Q LW against Boise in the eventual OT defeat. The Spartans meanwhile couldn't get any footing in their trip to Reno a week ago as they gave up 59 points and coughed up the ball on 5 occasions in the 35 pt loss. Despite the differences in the elevation and climate the visitor has had surprising success over the past 20 yrs with a 4-1 SU/ATS mark including the Rams 38-31 win at San Jose back in '14 (most recent matchup). Despite the previously mentioned statement and CSU's 0-4 ATS run at home, backing a Spartans that's been outscored by DD's vs every FBS foe they've faced and 33 ppg in conf play this ssn would be an unwise decision. The SU winner in SJSt games is a remarkable 42-5-1 ATSI PENN ST by 25 over Nebraska - It's Sr day in State College and while Nebraska is 2-0-1 as B10 rivals, they're travelling for the third time in 4 weeks including the second of B2B away games. PSU enhas been absolutely shut down on numerous occasions this yr, but the cure is no doubt a Blackshirt D that is allowing 233 (5.7) rush ypg in B10 play! The Huskers run D is so bad they were run over for 409 (9.1) yards by a 1 dimensional MN squad that they're HC warned couldn't compete in the trenches with the more physical B10 schools! The Nittany Lions re-gained their confidence and despite coming up short of a B10 title, are playing for bowl seeding and won't take any chances against a Nebraska team that no doubt will have an entirely new coaching staff next season.

Lsu by 21 over TENNESSEE - The Vols will be playing their first game after firing HC Jones. Brady Hoke, who has been COY in 3 seperate conferences, was named Interim. LW we went against a beat up Vols' squad that was starting 3 frosh OL and they were decimated 50-17 (+11') by Mizzou. True Frosh QB McBride got his first career start (QB Guarantano inj'd, CS). Tenn finished -374 yds and had no answer on D, allowing 433 (8.2) rush yds. LSU has covered their L/5 after beating Ark 33-10 (-18). The Tigers only led 13-10 but pulled away and added a gbg time td w/3:46 left. RB Guice should have a field day against a Tenn D that has allowed 257 (5.5) rush ypg. The Tigers also bring the #11 D, hold-ing foes to 101 ypg below their avg while Tenn is #120 on OFF, avg 72 ypg less than their foes allow. The Vols have lost 13 straight vs SEC West foes (2-10-1 ATS) and between the injuries, the coaching change and the matchup, we see every reason to lay the points. NOTRE DAME by 16 over Navy - It's Sr day in South Bend and ND is playing with revenge after last

year's loss snapped their 5 game series winning streak. Navy is on a 3-1 ATS series run. The Middles enter after snapping their 3 game losing skid to become bowl eligible. Their option OFF became stag-nant under QB Abey and they made the switch to Soph QB turned to SB turned back to QB Malcolm Perry who responded with a career high 282 rush yards! HC Niumatalolo has said that Perry is the best athlete on the team, but unfortunately he sprained his ankle near the end of the game (CS). While the Irish are out of the Iplayoff picture, they still have a NYD bowl in mind and will look to rebound from their embarrassing loss. ND is 6-1 as DD chalk and 4-2 as a HF this year, but Navy is 27-11 as an AD. We'll call for an angry Irish mob to get their revenge by over 2 td's. Houston by 10 over TULANE - It's Sr day in New Orleans, but Houston is on a 6-0 ATS series road run.

While Houston hasn't seen the option this year, they've had extra time to prep after entering fresh off a bye. Tulane snapped a 4 game skid after their OT win at EC as RB Hilliard had a car high 189 (6.8). New Mexico St by 7 over LOUISIANA - NMSt is on a 3-1 ATS series run. The Aggies have won B2B which is used on the second standard and the second standard and standard s

for the Aggies to get one step closer to ending that bowl drought. **IDAHO by 7 Coastal Carolina** - It's Sr day in Moscow and with this being the first ever meeting CC will be experiencing the unique Kibbie Dome for the first time. These schools are heading in opposite directions with Idaho moving down to the FCS next year, while CC was in the FCS LY and is in their first ssn of SBC play. ID enters fresh off a bye. The Chanticleers have a bye on deck but are ply'g a 10th straight wk and may be getting worn out as after failing to hold onto a 4Q lead vs SEC foe Arkansas (lost 39-38 as 23.5 pt AD) 2 wks ago, they lost to Troy 42-17 LW as a 17 pt HD. The Vandals have struggled at home TY going just 2-3 SU & ATS but did win & cover their last HG vs ULM, although QB Linehan was inj (CS).. Against their 3 common foes ID was +8 ypg, while CC was -46 ypg. Idaho has a slight D edge (#103-#125) and will get our call to keep their slim bowl hopes alive.

ARKANSAS ST by 28 Texas St - ASt has won the L2Y by an avg of 30 ppg. The Red Wolves all'd a reg ssn low 237 yds LY. ASt is 24-13 as a HF, while TXSt is 3-8 as a DD AD. ASt after just 12 total TO's in their F/7 gms had 6 LW in their loss vs SA. They still have won 20 of their last 22 conf gms (17-5 ATS). LW TXSt did have 30-26 4Q lead as a 6' pt HD before losing by 3, but did pull off the an outright upset at CC in their last road trip. Against 3 common foes the Bobcats are 1-2 SU/2-1 ATS and +74 ypg. ASt on the other hand is a dominating 3-0 SU/ATS and +169 ypg. With the SBC crown still in their own control, look for ASt to take out their frustration of LW's loss on the lowly Bobcats.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC by 11 over Fiu - It's Sr day in Boca Raton and this gm has added juice with HC's Kiffin and Davis in it for the first time. FAU will be out for revenge after letting FIU get their first win of '16 in their first game after firing HC Turner. This appeared to be the deciding game for the CUSA East going into last week but FIU failed to do their part, getting upset by Old Dominion while FAU beat LT

BC nearly pulled their 4th straight outright upset last week but fell by a fg to NCSt. QB Brown was inj'd (CS) and didn't return with bkp Wade finishing the game. RB Dillon has BC's frosh record with 1,039 (4.7) yds. UConn is #126 on D, allowing 116 ypg more than their foes avg. While BC has covered 7 straight, UConn has covered 4 out of their L/5 incl 3 as DD Dogs

Marshall by 5 over UTSA - It's Sr day in San Antonio. UTSA is 5-1 SU/4-1 ATS in their home finales. Marshall is making their first trip to the Alamodome. The Herd was cruising to an easy win last week, beating WKU 30-10 in the 4Q but gave up 2 late td's that cost Herd backers the cover. UTSA is stuck on five wins after suffering B2B outright upsets. In fact, UTSA has been favored in every game this season other than their opener vs Baylor, which they won outright. The RoadRunners are +118 ypg overall and +40 ypg in CUSA play. Marshall is +50 ypg overall and +93 ypg in CUSA play and has faced the tougher sked. The Roadrunners are 0-3 ATS at home this year while Marshall is 4-1 ATS on the road. **Texas A&M by 6 over MISSISSIPPI** - It's Sr day in Oxford. Akron enters off a Tuesday night game vs Ohio while Kent St enters off a Tuesday night game versus C Mich. The Golden Flashes have lost 3 straight by 34 ppg and are -101 ypg in MAC play. While the Steelers have gone 10-4 ATS as a NDIV HF and the Titans are 7-15 ATS as an AD, we'll have to wait until closer to kickoff as the Vegas line could be too steep for our liking in this one. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

Kansas City by 17 over NY GIANTS - Following yet another defeat LW to winless San Fran that may have cost HC McAdoo his job, the Giants are at home for the only time in a 4-wk span with a Thanksgiving Night trip to WAS on deck. The Chiefs head East after a week off having dropped 3 of their past 4 after starting off '17 with a 5-0 SU/ATS mark. While the Giants are a solid 8-3 ATS against the AFC, the Chiefs are an even better 14-3 as an AF. With HC Reid posting a 16-2 SU/13-5 ATS record after a bye during his coaching career with PHI & KC, we'll lay the points here.

MIÁMI by 3 over Tampa Bay - Rescheduled from Wk 1 due to Hurricane Irma. First of 3 consec AG's for the Bucs who head to MIA with franchise QB Winston still on the shelf with a shoulder issue (bkp QB Fitzpatrick 17-34 for 187 yds in 5 pt win LW vs Jets). While the Dolphins defense has posted some solid outings in '17 (all'g 280 ypg at home TY), their offense has been dismal (last in NFL in both scoring & total yds prior to their MNF trip to CAR). With MIA just 2-10-2 ATS as a HF and the Bucs on a 2-5-1 run at the moment, we'll go ahead and put our forecast right at the opening Vegas line while keeping an eye on the UNDER.

GREEN BAY by 1 over Baltimore - The Packers were able to get their 1st win since the loss of QB Rodgers to injury a week ago in Soldier Field behind a 18-25, 212 yd performance from bkp Hundley. The Ravens meanwhile return from their week off (7-2 ATS after a bye) needing a victory here to move back to 5-5 on the ssn while staying within reach of the front-running Steelers atop the AFC North. While it's difficult to back the Pack with their recent struggles and potential injuries at the RB position (CS on Jones & Montgomery), it's also worth mentioning that the Ravens have dropped 7 consec ATS versus NFC foes. We'll ride with the dog in this one! **MINNESOTA by 1 over LA Rams** - Only HG in a 5-wk span for the Vikings as they return from D.C. following an 8 pt win over the Redskins (QB Keenum 304 pass yds & 4 TD). The Rams meanwhile had some struggles against the Redskins earlier in the ssn but have rattled off victories in 6 of 7 since (5-2 ATS) including a 26 pt victory over the Texans (443-283 yd edge). Dating back to 2009 the Vikings have come away with SU/ATS victories in each of their 4 matchups against the Rams with an 18 pt avg MOV. Despite those gaudy numbers, we cannot lay more than a point in favor of the home squad in this one despite the Vikings' 12-3 ATS mark as a HF (Rams' high-octane offense #1 in NFL avg 33 ppg so far in '17).

HOUSTON by 1 over Arizona - Only road contest in a 5-wk span for the Cardinals as they head to Houston with extended rest following their Thur loss to the Seahawks (24-14 FD & 290-287 yd edges). The Texans meanwhile are at home for the only time in 4 wks after being unable to get anything going during their 26 pt loss to the Rams LW (outgained 443-283). While HOU is clearly not the same squad with QB Watson sidelined for the ssn w/injury (QB Savage completed just 37 of 81 passes L/2 wks), we'll lean with the HD here as ARZ has covered just 2 of their past 9 against the AFC and will be starting 3rd string QB Gabbert in this one after a knee injury to Stanton. **NEW ORLEANS by 10 over Washington** - The Saints continued their winning ways LW in Buffalo (7th straight, 6-1 ATS) behind 47 pts & a 482-198 yardage edge. The Redskins meanwhile dropped a home contest to MIN in a shootout (comb 68 pts & 800+ yds). In their previous 5 meetings dating back to '06, the Redskins have come away with a 4-1 SU mark (5-0 ATS) while avg 32 ppg of offense. With the Saints defense steadily moving up the rankings (all'd just 14.3 pgg & 255 ypg since Wk 3 of the ssn) and WAS covering just 1 of their past 6 overall, we'll go ahead and give the home squad the 10 pt edge in this one.

LA CHARGERS by 1 over Buffalo - The Chargers nearly earned the outright road upset in their return from bye a week ago with JAX getting the tying FG in the final seconds of regulation and the GW FG in OT after a Rivers int ($3 \pm$ LP Winner on Chargers). The Bills meanwhile

dropped their 2nd consec contest at home against the Saints in blowout fashion (37 pt loss, outgained 482-198). While the Chargers have had some success in recent meetings (4-1 SU/3-2 ATS) dating back to '05, we can only lay a point in their direction here against an angry Bills squad as the new Los Angeles venue has routinely seen the visiting fans take over so far in '17. † New England by 3 over Oakland - Mexico City - The schedule makers didn't do the Patriots any favors in the 2H of the ssn as they head into Mexico City for their 2nd of 5 away games over a 6-wk span (home vs MIA next wk followed by trips to BUF, MIA & PIT). The tough slate of contests did get off to a solid start however as they went into "Mile High" and came away with an easy 25 pt win (Brady 266 pass yds & 3 TD's). The Raiders meanwhile head to Mexico City for a 2nd consec ssn following a week off (5-0 ATS run after bye week). Their 1st trip paid off in their favor against HOU in the 27-20 victory (-6) on MNF (erased a 7 pt deficit in 4Q). While we'll go ahead and give the Patriots the narrow edge on the scoreboard (playing in high elevation for a 2nd straight wk), a 3 pt lean is all that we can give as the Raiders will have a clear crowd advantage. Philadelphia at DALLAS - SNF - The Eagles head to Dallas sitting atop the NFC at 8-1 on the year with the league's #4 offense (31.4 ppg, 377 ypg). The Cowboys meanwhile ran into a defensive buzzsaw LW in ATL without the services of RB Elliott & LT Smith (DAL 8 sks all'd, most since 1991!). While the home team won and covered both matchups a ssn ago, the visitor dominated the series the 3 yrs prior with 6 consec SU victories (5-1 ATS)! Although the Eagles come in on a 6-0 ATS run following their bye week, AG's in 4 of the next 5 wks will show us just how good this squad can be. Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner! Atlanta at SEATTLE - MNF - The Falcons are back on the road for the 4th time in a 5-wk span following their domination of the Cowboys a week ago (DE Clayborn 6 sks, 336-235 yd edge). The Seahawks on the other hand come in with extra rest after their Thur matchup with the Cardinals, a game in which penalties (12-108) & def injuries (CB Sherman OFY) saw ARZ stay closer than expected. These 2 met on 2 occasions a ssn ago with the Seahawks (17-3 HT lead) holding off a Falcons comeback earlier in the yr in Seattle (GW FG w/1:57 left) and ATL returning the favor with a 16 pt playoff victory. While the Falcons are on a solid 8-2 ATS run as an AD, it's always difficult to lean against the Seahawks in primetime in front of the "12th Man". Bye Weeks: Carolina, Indianapolis, NY Jets, San Francisco
