4★ NORTH CAROLINA over California - Cal is making a rare trip to the eastern time zone and hasn't won there s/'02 (1-3 SU). Cal is vastly inexp'd, while also breaking in a new st'g QB and a new HC in Justin Wilcox. NC also enters the ssn inexp'd and is replacing a #1DC QB, but HC Fedora is in his 6th yr at the helm & his tms fare better when entering the ssn under the radar. While NC has just 5 ret str's on OFF, they do have transfers from LSU, USC & Fla to fill the gaps. The Tar Heels have a huge edge on D, and this game is being ply'd at 9AM PT, so the Cal players will have a tough time to adjust. With L'ville on deck, NC will look to get all their players up to spd and won't be overlooking an overmatched Cal squad here. The Tar Heels are 8-4 as a HF while Cal is 2-8 as an AD.

FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA BY 21

3★ MARSHALL over Miami, Oh - Marshall is 10-2 SU in home openers and the 2 losses came to ranked tms. Miami has lost 9 str road openers, but this game is at a pick? These two L/met in '14 with Marshall winning 42-27 (-24). Sure Miami is the more exp'd tm w/17 ret str's, but Marshall added some key P5 transfers. The Herd were just 1-5 ATS vs FBS foes at home LY, but 13-5-1 the prev 3Y. After winning just 3 gms LY after 3 str DD win ssn, we think the Herd are in for a bounce back ssn and will start off with a win to build confidence.

FORECAST: MARSHALL BY 8

3★ FAU (+) over Navy - FRIDAY. The only prior mtg was in '12 & FAU kept that gm much closer than expected as well. This is their 1st time facing the option since then, but they enter as the most exp'd tm in the nation & have had all of fall camp to prep. New HC Kiffin has 9 str's ret on OFF incl their QB (17 total) while Navy returns just 12 str's. The Middies have large edges on D & ST's, but their OFF takes time to gel & isn't the same in early ssn road gms. The dog is 21-9-2 in FAU gms & we'll call for the Owls to keep this game competitive.

FORECAST: NAVY BY 3

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NOTRE DAME over Temple - ND needs a confidence builder here after winning just 4 gms LY with UGA on deck. TU has just 10 ret str's with a new HC. Not only are the Owls breaking in new schemes, but will have rFR QB Russo making his 1st car start in a hostile environment. The Irish has large edges on OFF & D, while the ST's are even. ND is under the radar and will be 1 of the most improved tms in the country TY. The Irish has covered 3 str home openers & we'll call for them to make it 4 str with a solid win over a vastly inexp'd Owl squad.

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME BY 23

2★ Troy (+) over BOISE ST - 1st mtg. These schls are on opposite ends in terms of experience returning in '17. Troy has 14 ret str's compared to just 9 for BSt. Trojans QB Silvers & RB Chunn each earned 1st Tm SBC LY, while the Bronco's finished just #60 in our pass eff D rankings & their 177 rush ypg all'd was the most s/'96! Troy is 7-1 as an AD, while BSt is 12-27 as a HF & the visitor in Bronco gms is 11-4 ATS. BSt has a trip to Wazzu on deck & will be more focused on that gm. We're not calling for Troy to pull the outright upset, but we will call for the Trojans to keep it closer than expected (almost beat Clemson in Death Valley LY!).

FORECAST: BOISE ST BY 3

THURSDAY AUGUST 31ST

Ohio St by 24 over INDIANA - While IU is 14-1 SU in home openers, they've lost 22 str vs OSU. The Bucks are again 1 of the top teams in the nation and will have major edges in all 3 phases. OSU does have a huge gm with OU on deck, but have a new OC in Kevin Wilson, who was the Hoosiers HC the L6Y & knows the personnel inside and out. Sure the Hoosiers are on a 6-0 ATS series run, but Bucks HC Meyer is an outstanding 11-3 ATS in road openers and OSU will open the ssn with a statement win.

MINNESOTA by 28 over Buffalo - The PJ Fleck era gets started against a tm he beat 38-0 (-35) late LY. MN is an inexp'd tm TY and must learn new schemes. UB returns 14 str's & is in the 3rd yr under HC Leipold. Gopher RB Smith should find open running lanes as the Bulls all'd 253 (5.1) rush ypg LY & lost 2 st'g DL. MN does have a road trip to P12 country next wk, but the Bulls lost their AG's by an avg of 27 ppg LY. Fleck won just 1 gm in his 1st yr at WM, but steps into a better situation here and fans should be chanting 'Row the Boat' often.

MEMPHIS by 28 over Ulm - These schls haven't met s/2000. Both are in the top 25 in terms of experience returning, but UM got the extra benefit of bowl practices. UM has the edge in all 3 phases incl large edges on OFF & ST's. Tiger's QB Ferguson is 1 of the best in the AAC, while ULM had our #115 pass eff D LY & must replace 2 st'g DB's incl an all-conf CB. UM takes care of business before the AAC sked arrives as they're 12-3-2 vs non-conf foes, while ULM is on a 3-6 overall ATS run.

ARIZONA STATE by 27 over New Mexico St - AZSt lost their last 6 gms LY & HC Graham is on the hot seat, so the Sun Devils will be treating this game as an important one. QB Wilkins returns for AZSt & NMSt finished #120 in our pass eff D rankings LY. The Sun Devils are 5-0 as a HF, while the Aggies are 7-15 as an AD & 13-32-3 vs non-conf foes. NMSt has the Rio Grande rivalry on deck and will look to remain healthy in this one so they can perform better next wk.

UCF by 17 over Fiu - FIU has a new HC in Butch Davis and 1 of the most exp'd tms in the country, returning 77% of their lettermen incl 15 str's. Not sure if that matters however as the talent returning rates near the bottom of CUSA on our OL & DL position ratings. UCF will have edges in all 3 phases, but the Panthers were embarrassed at home LY by the Knights & will be ply'g with revenge against their in-state rival. UCF has won 8 of their L/10 home openers since opening BHN Stadium. FIU is 9-4-1 as an AD.

OKLAHOMA ST by 17 over Tulsa - This is the 73rd mtg between these in-state rivals, but 1st s/'11. OSU is much more exp'd & TU QB President is making his 1st car st in a hostile environment. The Golden Hurricane finished #28 in our pass eff D rankings LY & lose just 1 str in the secondary, but will have a tough time defending the Rudolph to Washington attack. The Pokes will have the edge on OFF & D, while we give the ST's edge to TU. OSU is 29-16 as a HF & the Golden Hurricane failed to cover in each of their non-conf AG's LY.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 17 over Charlotte - LY was the first time the Eagles were a fav to win a road gm s/'05 and they led 34-6 3Q and won 37-19 (-3). EMU has large edges on OFF, D, ST and are the more exp'd team with 16 ret str's. CU has just 12 ret str's back and must replace their leading rusher, receiver & tkl'r. EMU has a lot of buzz after their bowl ssn and should carry a solid home field edge and were 4-2 ATS at home LY. EM is 7-2 ATS vs non conf foes while CU is 2-5.

Washington by 31 over RUTGERS - Despite the fact that RU has 14 ret str's & UW has 13, the Huskies are vastly more exp'd. UW will have large edges on OFF & D, while the ST's are even. Huskies QB Browning is a Heisman candidate after throwing for 3,430 (62%, 43-9) LY & the Scarlet Knights finished #97 in our pass eff D rankings. UW HC Petersen is 27-12 ATS as an AF, while RU is 2-5 as a HD. We'll call for the Huskies to start off with a statement win.

WISCONSIN by 35 over Utah St - UW has won 21 str Camp Randall openers by 24 ppg. The Badgers have 15 ret str's, while UTSt returns just 10 from a 3-9 ssn. UW has significant edges in all 3 phases. New st'g Badger RB James (Pitt trans) should be able to run wild against an Aggie D that all'd 203 (4.4) rush ypg LY & is breaking in 3 new st'g DL. UTSt is on a 4-13 ATS run and UW won't have any problems in this one.

Boston College by 1 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - The Huskies have won their L/4 (3-1 ATS) when hosting a P5 foe. BC is making their 1st trip to DeKalb, having won the prev 2 mtgs incl 17-14 (-5) in '15. BC has a huge edge on D behind DE Harold Landry and are the more exp'd tm. NIU does have the sked edge with an FCS foe on deck, while BC starts ACC play vs WF next wk and we'll call for the Huskies to keep it closer than expected as NIU is 9-2 as a HD.

† Colorado by 3 over Colorado St - This gm is being ply'd at Sports Authority Field at Mile High, home of the NFL Broncos. CU is on a 6-3-1 ATS run in the Rocky Mountain Showdown. They were vastly more exp'd coming into LY's opener, but the opposite holds true TY as the Buff's are just #88 on our exp chart, while CSt is #22. The Rams also enter with a GUB advantage. CSt was on a 35-20 overall ATS run heading into their wk 1 gm vs Oreg St.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND

MICHIGAN ST by 20 over Bowling Green - BG was pummelled early on the road vs a B10 foe LY. MSU only returns 8 str's from a 3-9 tm (4-8 ATS) & are 1 of the least exp'd tms in the nation. Sparty will have the edge on OFF & D, but we actually give the Falcons the edge on ST's. HC Dantonio needs his squad to gain confidence after LY's dismal ssn. MSU is 12-6 as a DD fav and we feel Sparty gets a comfortable opening ssn win.

IOWA by 10 over Wyoming - Exp-wise both tms are about the same. Each return 14 str's, but WY does return QB Allen, who is a legit NFL prospect. IO must replace both st'g CB's incl 2x AA Desmond King. The Hawkeyes will have large edges on D & ST's. IO has in-state rival IOST on deck and hasn't covered the L/3 gms the wk prior to that, while the Pokes are 25-12 as an AD.

CLEMSON by 42 over Kent St - Kent St is ply'g the defending Nat'l Champs for the 2nd str ssn. They've lost 9 str road openers (3-6 ATS) by 33 ppg. CU has just 12 ret str's, are #108 in experience and must replace #1 DC's QB Watson and WR Williams. Kent has 13 ret str's and is #68 in experience. Kent's OFF was one of the worst in the nation LY while CU still has a top 5 D. The Tigers have huge gms vs Aub and L'ville on deck. Kent is 13-24-1 ATS vs non-conf foes.

Massachusetts by 10 over COASTAL CAROLINA - 1st mtg. CC will be ply'g under immense pressure, hosting their 1st ever FBS foe in their 1st gm as an FBS member. UMass enters with a GUB edge, which is huge as teams normally make a large improvement between gms 1-2. QB Ford should be able to take advantage of a secondary breaking in 3 new starters. This is just the 2nd time the Minutemen have been an AF in the L10Y! CC is #129 in our Power Rankings entering the ssn.

PENN ST by 35 over Akron - These schls actually have a recent mtg, with PSU winning just 21-3 (-14) at home in '14. UA was pounded at Wisconsin in the pre-conf sked LY 54-10 (+23) & this gm could have similar results. The Nittany Lions are one of the most exp'd tms in the nation w/17 ret str's & have huge edges in all 3 phases. The Zips are 3-6 ATS vs non-conf foes, while PSU HC Franklin is 18-11 in the same role. Add in the fact that the Nittany Lions are on an outstanding 10-0 overall ATS streak & we'll call for a blowout victory.

† Louisville by 28 over Purdue - This gm is being ply'd at Lucas Oil Stadium, home of the NFL's Colts. UL returns just 11 str's & is the less exp'd tm entering this gm, but will still have large edges in all 3 phases. Reigning Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson had 8 td's in the 1H of LY's opener & PU has a new HC in Jeff Brohm, breaking in new schemes. Brohm was a former QB for the Card's, so the emotions will be high here. Tech edges favor UL as they're 5-0 ATS in ssn openers, 13-7-1 ATS vs non-conf foes & 14-8 ATS away from Louisville, but they do have B2B ACC gms on deck vs UNC & Clem.

NEBRASKA by 21 over Ark St - Neither tm has a lot of exp coming back as each ret just 10 str's. Ast HC Anderson would rather keep his guys healthy for SBC action as the Red Wolves are just 1-8 ATS as a non-conf AD. On the flip side, NU has an important non-conf gm on deck, travelling to Oreg and could pull their starters with a big lead. New NU QB Lee is a better fit for Riley's OFF & will have a great start to the ssn. IThe 'Huskies are 10-2 ATS in ssn openers vs FBS foes.

NORTHWESTERN by 28 over Nevada - This is a tough spot for NV opening up on the B10 road with a new HC & learning new schemes on both sides of the ball. NW has 16 ret str's from a bowl team and is vastly more exp'd. 'Cats RB Jackson is the schls #2 car rusher & needs just 357 yds to take the top spot. The Wolf Pack all'd 298 (6.1) rush ypg LY, so look for Jackson to have a monster game here. NW is 5-2 as a HF & will get a solid home opening win.

ILLINOIS by 3 over Ball St - Both tms are vastly inexp'd with 2nd yr HC's. IL will have the edge on D, but surprisingly we give BSt slight edges on both OFF & ST's. The Card's won just 4 gms LY, but did fare well on the B10 road, losing by just 10 at Indy. The Illini is just 1-4 ATS hosting non-conf FBS foes, while BSU is 9-2 ATS away vs the B10.

OKLAHOMA by 45 over Utep - The Lincoln Riley era officially begins after Bob Stoops unexpectedly stepped down in June. All the key pieces were in order, so there won't be a big adjustment for the Sooners. QB Mayfield remains under center & UTEP finished #111 in our pass eff D rankings LY. While OU has a huge gm at Ohio St on deck, the Miners have their CUSA opener next & will likely want to remain healthy for a gm they have a better shot at winning. The Sooners are 39-24 as a HF & on a 5-1 overall ATS run, while UTEP is 2-8 as an AD of 24+ pts.

MISSISSIPPI by 24 over South Alabama - First mtg. LY S Alabama shocked Miss St in Starkville 21-20 (+28) for their 1st ever win over a P5 tm. Ole Miss is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS vs SBC foes with the avg win by 36 ppg. Ole Miss has a big edge on OFF, but USA actually has the experience edge. The Jaguars are 3-10 as an AD. HC Freeze was let go over the summer and new interim HC Luke has been here the L6Y as OC & knows the personnel. Ole Miss is on a bowl ban and is treating every gm like a bowl gm so they will be plenty motivated.

USC by 31 over Western Michigan - Both tms were a part of the NY6 day bowl gms last ssn. USC was one of the hottest tms in country at ssn's end, has 12 ret st'r's incl Heisman hopeful QB Sam Darnold and is a legit Nat'l title contender. WM also ret 12 st'r's but lost their QB and HC. The Trojans have won their L/3 home openers by an avg of 51-9, while the Broncos had lost 21 str road openers by 22 ppg until LY's upset at Northwestern. USC is 23-12 as a HF.

†Lsu by 13 over Byu - This is the 1st mtg. LSU has the location edge with this gm being ply'd in Houston (LSU 268 miles away, BYU 1,459 miles away). These two are relatively equal in experience. LSU has a large edge on OFF with small edges on D & ST. BYU was 4-1-1 ATS vs P5 foes LY, but their lone ATS loss vs an SEC foe (Miss St). LSU went 5-1 ATS as a fav under HC Orgeron. BYU does have a GUB edge, but the Tigers have an FCS foe on deck and after losing LY's opener to Wisky they will be plenty focused.

TEXAS by 21 over Maryland - UT hasn't been to a bowl the L2Y, but now have new hope after hiring Tom Herman away from Houston. The 'Horns ret 17 str's & are 1 of the most exp'd tms in the nation. UT will have the edge in all 3 phases & are 4-1-1 ATS in home openers. MD is 3-9 as a DD dog & on just a 5-11 overall ATS run. We'll call for the 'Horns to get a solid win in HC Herman's debut as UT builds their confidence in anticipation of their trip to USC in 2 wk's.

AUBURN by 38 over Georgia Southern - These two L/met in 1991. Auburn is 7-3 ATS vs SBC foes. Aub has huge edges across the board, is 1 of the most exp'd tms in the country & has ex Baylor QB Stidham (69%, 12-2 as true) to run Malzahn's potent OFF. The Eagles are 1 of the least exp'd teams in the nation & ret just 10 str's. GS is on just a 2-8 ATS run.

GEORGIA by 10 over Appalachian St - App St will open at the SEC East fav for the 2nd str ssn and nearly beat Tenn LY, holding the Vols to 135 yds below their ssn avg. They led 13-3 at half but missed a GW fg then lost in OT 20-13 (+20'). UGA won the only prior mtg in '13 45-6 (-40). Georgia is 1-4 ATS vs SBC foes and nearly was outright upset early LY vs an FCS foe. While not as talented, the Mountaineers are nearly as exp'd and are 9-3 ATS on the road. UGA is 0-4 as a HF and has a road trip to South Bend on deck.

Kentucky by 17 over SOUTHERN MISS - KY is out for revenge after blowing a 34-10 2Q lead LY. They all'd SM to score 34 unanswered and SM had a 399-19 yd edge during their run. Kentucky is the more exp'd team this year with edges in all 3 phases. While UK hasn't been a road fav s/'11, SM is breaking in a new st'g QB as they must replace their career leader Nick Mullens and is 3-6 as a HD. The Cats are 8-2 ATS in their 1st true road gm while SM is 1-6 ATS in home openers and Kentucky will get revenge and start the year off right in looking to achieve B2B bowl ssn's for the 1st time s/'09-'10.

Houston by 10 over UTSA - UTSA enters as our #2 most exp'd tm in the country and made it to their 1st bowl LY, getting additional practice time. UH has a new HC & while their OFF will remain the same, they are learning a new D. The Cougars have the edge on OFF & D, while the Roadrunners have a slight edge on ST's & are home. UTSA lost to AZSt by just 4 LY, despite being a 3 td dog & UH has a trip to AZ on deck. The Roadrunners are 4-0 ATS in FBS openers & are 5-2 as a HD, while the Cougars are 0-7 as a fav. We'll gladly take the points with the more exp'd team at home.

†North Carolina St by 6 over South Carolina - This is being ply'd at Bank of America Stadium, home to the Carolina Panthers. These two L/met in '08-'09, with SC going 2-0 SU/ATS and holding NCSt to just 3 t'l pts. NCSt has the edge in all 3 phases incl a huge edge on ST's. The exp edge also goes to NCSt as the Wolfpack have 17 ret st'r's. The Gamecocks have a veteran OL (98 car sts ret) but face one of the top DLs in the country. The Wolfpack is 15-5 as a fav and 11-2 ATS vs non conf foes.

Vanderbilt by 3 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - The visitor is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series with all 4 wins being outright upsets, but Vandy finds itself in the fav role here. The 'Dores have dropped 6 straight 'true' road openers by 15 ppg (all vs P5 schls). The OFF's are nearly even, but MT has a huge edge at the crucial QB spot as well as the ST edge. MT QB Stockstill and WR James are one of the top duo's in the country. VU is 3-6 as a fav.

†Alabama by 7 over Florida St - This gm is being ply'd at Mercedes Benz Stadium, home of the NFL's Falcons. These two storied programs L/met in HC Saban's 1st ssn at Bama with FSU getting the 21-14 win. Bama is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS opening at a neutral sites the L5Y. FSU is 8-0 SU/5-3 ATS in neutral site openers s/'91. Bama has a slight edge on OFF & D, while FSU has the edge on ST and is more exp'd. Both tms now have a veteran QB who started LY as a freshman. These teams are very close in terms of talent and this game features two of the top 3 D's in the nation. FSU is 4-0 as a dog. Bama is on a 15-6-1 overall ATS run and is 14-5 as a fav away from home.

SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 3RD

†Virginia Tech vs West Virginia - This gm is being ply'd at FedEx Field, home of the NFL's Redskins. WV actually ply'd on this field LY, winning but failing to cover vs BYU (35-32, -7). These former Big East rivals are mtg for the 52nd time, but 1st s/'05. Both have inexp'd squads TY, each losing their QB's, but new Mountaineer st'r Will Griet went 5-0 in 5 sts for Florida in '15 before transferring. We give WV the edge on OFF, with VT having the edge on D & ST's. The Hokies are on an 0-7 ATS run in ssn openers vs FBS foes.

Texas A&M at UCLA - This is a battle of cch's who could be on the hot seat. LY was the 1st mtg s/'97. UCLA trailed 24-9 4Q thanks to 3 int's by QB Rosen but forced OT w/B2B td drives then A&M won in OT 31-24 (-3'). The Aggies are 1 of the least exp'd tms in the nation, have just 12 ret str's & are breaking in a new st'g QB on the road. UCLA has 15 ret st'r's & QB Rosen is back healthy. The Aggies have a huge ST edge while the OFF & D's are about even. HC Sulmin is 15-0 SU/10-4-1 ATS in Aug/Sept gms but 3-7 as an AD. UCLA is 3-10 ATS at home.

MONDAY SEPTEMBER 4TH

†Tennessee vs Georgia Tech - This gm is being ply'd at Mercedes Benz Stadium, home of the NFL's Falcons. The Vols have won 8 str ssn openers (5-3 ATS). GT has the location edge as this is being ply'd in the Jackets' home town. The Vols D was gashed for 329 ypg rush in their L/6 vs FBS foes LY, although inj's ply'd a huge part in that. While GT has 15 ret st'r's and Tenn 14, the Vol's have the overall exp edge & return 4 str's on their OL. UT will have a huge ST's edge. HC Jones is 4-0 ATS at neutral sites and the Vol's had all Aug to prep for the option with an FCS foe on deck, but GT is 10-5 as a dog.

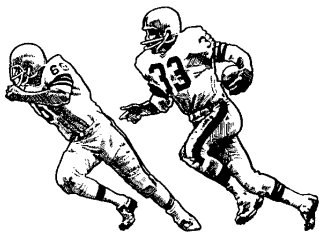
