4★ ARIZONA ST over San Diego St - These schools last met in '07. AZSt enters off 2 extra days of prep/rest after having a tougher than expected game vs NMSt. Leading 37-13 4Q, they all'd 18 unanswered. The extra rest will be needed as all 11 of their str's on D ply'd the entire 1H in 100 degree weather. RB Richard had only 1 carry before inj (CS), but Kalen Ballage is a bruising 6-2 227 pound Sr with plenty of experience. SDSSt enters fresh off an FCS foe as they led 38-3 before all'g 2 td's in the 4Q. They do have a home game vs in-state rival Stanford on deck. The Sun Devils are much more exp'd & Aztec HC Long's tms tend to struggle in non-conf AG's (3-8 ATS) as he tends to keep his players healthy for MW play. AZSt HC Graham is on the hot seat this year and this gm is far more important to them than SDSSt. The Sun Devils are 5-1 as a HF. **FORECAST: ARIZONA ST by 16**

3★ Tcu over ARKANSAS - This is just the 2nd mtg since their SWC days (ply'd every year from 1930-'91). The Frogs are out for revenge. LY TCU led 28-20 w/2:05 left 4Q but QB Hill took an immature penalty for a throat slashing gesture and Ark tied the gm then won 41-38 (+7) in 2OT. Both tms enter fresh off non-competitive FCS wins. TCU is one of the most experienced teams entering the ssn, while Arkansas is one of the least experienced. The Horned Frogs will have the edge in all three phases. TCU finished #26 in our pass eff D rankings LY & return the entire 2 deep, while the Hogs are breaking in a new set of WR's. TCU is 13-2 as an AD, while Ark is 8-13 as a HF. **FORECAST: TCU by 7**

3★ MICHIGAN ST over Western Michigan - While both tms enter the ssn among the least exp'd in the nation, MSU is clearly far more talented with edges on OFF & D. WM has a new HC & is adjusting to new schemes, while also on the 2nd of B2B AG's after travelling all the way to USC LW. They exerted a ton of effort in 99 degree heat & were tied at 28 mid 4Q! While new st'g QB Wassink struggled hitting just 11-22-67-0-1, the run gm picked up the slack, rushing for 263 (5.5). The D held Heisman fav QB Darnold w/o a td pass for the 1st time in the L10 gms. Sparty got a confidence building win LW following their disappointing ssn LY as they held Bowling Green to just 67 (2.8) rush, 9 FD's & 212 ttl yds. QB Lewerke compl 67% w/a 3-0 ratio. MSU is 13-6 as a DD fav & will prove a point to their in-state rival. Adding to our point is that the Broncos are 7-11 ATS vs B10 foes. **FORECAST: MICHIGAN ST BY 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ OHIO ST over Oklahoma - OSU was a young team LY, but ended up beating OU on the road in convincing fashion. The Bucks are much more exp'd TY & are at home. OSU survived a slow start in a rare B10 road opener at Indiana LW, but ended up w/nearly 600 yds & true frosh RB Dobbins set a schl frosh rec w/281 (6.2) rush yds & showed Barry Sanders-like cutting ability. The Bucks did allow 420 pass yds, but most of those were in the 1H and the inexp'd DB's won't see a much better WR corps. OU had no trouble dispatching an overmatched UTEP squad as QB Mayfield hit 19-20-329-3-0 & the Sooners had 40-10 FD & 676-167 yd edges! The OFF's are even, while OSU has the edge on D & OU on ST's. This is new OU HC Riley's 1st road gm, while Bucks HC Meyer is 43-16-1 ATS vs non-conf foes. **FORECAST: OHIO ST by 14**

2★ Louisville over NORTH CAROLINA - The home tm has won 3 str in this series. NC lost the L/mtg in '12, 39-34 (+3) on the road. UL found itself down early 4Q LW vs Purdue as they lost had 2 fumbles near the goal line & mismanaged the clock going into HT. QB Jackson followed up his Heisman ssn w/485 ttl yds incl 378 through the air. AA CB Alexander was inj (CS). UNC was stunned as they couldn't hold onto a 10 pt lead late 1H at home vs a Cal squad with a new staff in a gm that started at 9 am on the west coast. New st'g QB Harris proved his inability to be a college QB wasn't just an LSU problem (grad transfer) as he was benched after hitting 7-16-60-0-2 and missing a wide open td pass. The Tar Heels are 1 of the least exp'd tms in the nation. UL has a big revenge gm on deck vs Clemson, but this is a big enough gm that they won't look ahead. NC is 12-6 as a dog, but 0-2 as HD. UL is 3-0 SU/ATS in ACC openers. **FORECAST: LOUISVILLE by 17**

OTHER GAMES

WK 2 FRIDAY SEPT 8

Ohio at PURDUE - This is the first home game for new PU HC Brohm. The Boilermakers led LVille in the 4Q LW before falling by a td. QB Sindler got the start, was replaced by LY's st'r Blough, only to be re-inserted after 2 int's. They were outg'd 524-344 & benefitted from forcing 2 TO's near their own end zone. OU had no trouble dispatching an FCS foe LW, finishing w/a 420-108 yd edge. PU has a trip to MO on deck & has the exp edge despite the same number of ret'g str's.

Oklahoma St at SOUTH ALABAMA - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. OST's triplets were already in midssn form LW in their win over in-state rival Tulsa as QB Rudolph hit 20-24-303-3-0, RB Hill had 132 (8.8) rush & WR Washington had 145 (24.2) incl a 77 yd td. USA trailed by just 3 at HT LW at Ole Miss, but couldn't keep up as they were outg'd 531-374 including all'g 429 thru the air (4-0 ratio). They had just our #92 ranked pass eff D LY & early indications appear they haven't improved. The Pokes are vastly more exp'd with a huge edge on OFF, a slight edge on D & the ST's even. SA pulled off 2 huge outright upsets LY over Miss St & SDSSt, so OST won't be caught off guard. One thing to note, however, is that OST is in a Tulsa (in-state rival)/Pitt sandwich. OST is 18-12-1 as an AF, while USA is 5-8 as a HD.

SATURDAY SEPT 9

WISCONSIN by 27 over Fau - 1st mtg. UW st'd slowly LW, tied at 10 at HT in their 49 pt blowout win over UTSt, giving us another 'Early Bird' winner (free every Monday on button 9). The Badgers' 1-2 RB punch of Taylor & Shaw led a unit that finished w/234 (5.2) rush. FAU apparently forgot that they were defending the option LW as they all'd 416 (6.1) rush yds in a gm that featured not 1, not 2, but 3 lightning delays!! UW has the edge in OFF, D & ST, but FAU is the most exp'd team in the country with 17 ret st'rs back and 96% of their yds returning. UW has a heavier OL which will take advantage of the smaller Owls' DL (265 lb avg), but FAU

won't have to worry about the cut blocks from the option here. We won't forget LY when UW won by just six over Ga St despite being a 5 td fav. FAU is 19-7 as an AD.

ARMY by 14 over Buffalo - Army is out for revenge after blowing a 20-6 4Q lead and losing in OT LY. Buf kept the score closer than expected vs an inexp'd MN squad LW, all'g just 3.3 ypc, but was still outg'd 408-262. Buffalo is ply'g their 2nd str road gm while Army is ply'g their 2nd str at home & had no trouble destroying an FCS foe as they didn't even need to complete a pass while scoring 64 pts. They held FCS AA RB Edmonds to just 42 (2.8) rush. Army is 1 of the most exp'd teams in the nation entering the ssn with 16 ret st'rs and 85% of their yds ret'g. The Bulls enter with a couple of extra days to prep for the triple option and Army is on just a 2-6 FBS run and is 1-3 as a HF vs FBS foes.

RUTGERS by 7 over Eastern Michigan - RU showed improvement from their 2 win ssn LY against UW last week. While RB Edwards only avg 3.3 ypc LW, he showed toughness against 1 of the top DLs & should find more running room here as EM all'd 4.7 ypc in their win over Charlotte LW. The Eagles are the more exp'd team and got the added benefit of bowl practices at the end of last year. We do give EM the edge on OFF & ST's, while the D's are even. EM is just 12-18-1 ATS away & RU should feel disrespected being such a slight fav at home.

Old Dominion by 3 over MASSACHUSETTS - This is the 3rd series mtg with ODU going 2-0 SU/1-0 ATS. LY UMass only trailed 22-16 3Q and lost 36-16 on the road (+8). HC Wilder faced UMass every ssn when he was at Maine ('90-'06), going 5-12. This is actually UMass' 3rd gm, having already lost at home vs Haw & on the road against FBS newbie Coastal Carolina. The Minutemen did have slight yd & FD edges LW & TE Breneman continues to be a nightmare matchup as he's had B2B gms w/9 catches, while going over 100 yds each time. ODU is fresh off an FCS foe as they led 24-3 4Q. UMass does have the experience edge, while the Monarchs have the edge on OFF & ST's. ODU is on a 7-2-1 overall ATS run and is 3-0 as an AF.

Northwestern by 5 over DUKE - NW is 10-2 SU/7-5 ATS in this battle between scholarly institutions. The LTH NW pulled the upset 19-10 (+4) and LY NW won 24-13 (-4) at home. Duke enters fresh off a blowout win over an FCS foe as they scored the most pts ever under HC Cutcliffe, while NW trailed Nevada at home until scoring 2 td's late 4Q. The 'Cats have the edge on OFF & D along with the exp edge (16 ret st'rs to 12). NW is 7-0 SU/5-1-1 ATS in road openers.

Usf by 21 over CONNECTICUT - This is the AAC opener for both tms with 1st yr HC's although both are veterans as Edsall was the HC here from '99-'10 & Strong was the HC at LVille & Texas from '10-'16. USF enters with a GUB edge, but is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks. Both struggled vs FCS foes LW. UConn needed 2Y st'g QB Shirreffs to come off the bench late 3Q down 20-7 to lead the comeback, while USF found itself tied in the 4Q. The Bulls have had punts blk'd in each of their games. While both are close in terms of experience, the talent gap is wide as USF has the edge in all 3 phases. USF has failed to look like the team they were supposed to be entering the ssn, but we feel this is the wk that everything starts to click for them.

WEST VIRGINIA by 31 over East Carolina - Neither team entered the season with much experience and EC is travelling for the 1st time, while WV is in its home opener with an FCS foe on deck. That inexperience showed for the Pirates as they lost to FCS James Madison, getting outg'd 614-373! WV is off a thrilling loss to VT in a game they had a 592-469 yd edge in. New QB Grier (Florida trans) was 5-0 as a st'r for the Gators & while he lost his 1st career start for the Mountaineers, he hit 31-53-371-3-1. WV has the edge in all 3 phases. The Mountaineers are 6-1 as a DD fav in home openers vs FBS foes, while the Pirates are 1-6-1 as an AD.

MICHIGAN by 28 over Cincinnati - This is the 1st meeting between these schools. UM is in a Fla/AF (prep for option) sandwich, while UC has had 2 extra days of prep off an FCS foe, but does have their Victory Bell rivalry against Miami, Oh on deck. The Wolves trailed at HT LW & scored 13 pts off TO's. QB Speight threw 2 int's that were ret'd for td's, but UM did finish w/a 433-192 yd edge as Florida had trouble w/o their leading rusher & receiver from LY (susp). UC was unimpressive vs an FCS foe LW, getting outg'd & outFD'd. New 'Cats HC Fickell is very familiar with the Wolves, spending the L15Y at Ohio St and he would like nothing more than to give UM a little scare. UM is 1 of the least exp'd tms in the country with only 5 ret str's. The Wolves are 1-3 as a HF, while UC is 12-8 ATS away.

KANSAS ST by 36 over Charlotte - This is the 1st ever meeting between these schools. KSt HC Snyder is in his 26th yr here and has one of his most exp'd squads. Conversely, Charlotte is on the opposite end with an inexp'd squad & travelling for the 2nd str wk. The Wildcats didn't have to expend much energy in their win over an FCS foe LW as QB Ertz threw for 333 w/a 4-0 ratio & will have a huge edge on ST's here. KSt is just 1-6 as an FBS HF, but that win was over an CUSA foe, FAU 63-7 LY. UC is just 3-10-2 as a DD dog & the 49ers have been beaten 128-24 (0-2 ATS) in their only 2 mtgs vs P5 foes.

Iowa by 6 over IOWA ST - The Cy-Hawk rivalry has been decided by 6 pts or less in 4 of the L6Y. The HT in this series is just 12-25 ATS. Iowa enters off a misleading final score LW as they finished w/just a 263-233 yd edge. 10 pts came off TO's incl a 27 yd td pass the 1st pl following Wyoming's punter completely missing the ball. ISU was aided by 2 IR td's as they finished w/ just a 405-378 yd edge vs an FCS foe. Both return about the same in terms of experience to the field. The 'Clones have the edge on OFF, while the Hawkeys have the edge on D & the ST's are even. UI RB Wadley is 1 of the best in the B10 & ISU all'd 218 (5.0) rush ypg LY & lost 3 str's on their DL. They all'd 5.4 ypc LW.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 6 over Wake Forest - BC is 7-3 SU/6-4 ATS in the series. LY BC held on for a 17-14 win. WF's L/2 drives ended in a 40 yd missed fg & int at BC45. Eagles' QB Brown was the 1st frosh st'r '09, threw the GW td pass w/2:13 left & BC survived going to OT as NIU's 39 yd fg fell short last week. WF enters fresh off an easy win over an FCS foe w/a couple of extra days rest. This has been a defensive struggle, going UNDER the total 7 str yrs (avg ttl 31.7 ppg). WF is just 1-7 SU/ATS in road openers.

NEW MEXICO by 14 over New Mexico St - This is the 108th Rio Grande Rivalry & these schools have met every year since 1946. The visitor is on a 9-4-1 ATS run. NM will have revenge on their mind after having their 4 gm series win streak snapped, blowing a 9 pt 4Q lead in the process LY. They're fresh off an FCS win & over half the yds they all'd came on 2 drives. NMSt was down 37-13 mid 4Q LW at AZSt, before 3 late td's vs the bkps. After just 12 sks all of LY, the Aggies had 7 LW. NMSt does have the experience edge, but this is their 2nd of B2B AG's (0-4-1 ATS in that role) with their SBC opener on deck. NM has a trip to Boise on deck, but the Aggies are just 8-15 as an AD.

UTEP by 4 over Rice - The home tm has dominated this instate rivalry, going 7-1 SU/ATS. Rice is 9-2 SU/12-2 ATS. LY the Owls led 34-3 at half and won 44-24 (-1). Rice is off a much needed bye wk after travelling to Australia for their opener vs Stanford when they were outgd' 656-241. UTEP didn't fare any better in their opening gm, getting dominated physically by Oklahoma as they were outgd' 676-167! Rice has the edge on OFF & ST's, while the Miners have the edge on D. The Owls have lost their L/4 'true' road openers (1-3 ATS) and UTEP prefers a power brand of football that we are not sure Rice can handle just yet.

COLORADO by 35 over Texas St - 1st mtg. CU enters off a misleading final in the Rocky Mountain showdown and this is their home opener. The Buff's benefited from THREE questionable OFF PI pen's either inside or close to their EZ that would have completely changed the landscape of the game. TXSt was outgd' 290-258 in their win over Houston Baptist LW. The Buff's lost a lot of experience off their P12 South Championship squad & this gm should help prepare the youngsters for the tougher sked that awaits. RB Lindsay earned 1st tm P12 LY & got off to a great start w/140 (7.4) LW & TXSt all'd 222 rush ypg LY & are breaking in a new rFR NT that only weighs 260 pounds. CU is 10-2 as a HF, while the 'Cats are 3-9 as an AD. We had TXSt dead last in our power ratings to enter the ssn & this gm will be over by halftime.

BALL ST by 14 over Uab - This is the 1st mtg between these schools. UAB has actually never faced a MAC opponent. They were up just 10-3 at HT, but pulled away in the 2H LW in their 1st game s/14 in front of their largest home crowd in program history. BSt had 24-14 FD & 375-216 tkl yds edges, but all'd the GW td w/2:06 left & had their 54 yd fg blk'd w/no time remaining at IL last week. 1st Tm MAC RB Gilbert had to be helped off the field after his 3Q td (CS). The Blazers have lost 11 str road openers and are 2-8 ATS in non conf road gms, having lost 23 in a row SU. Ball St has won 7 str home openers by 16 ppg. BSt has the edge on OFF & ST's, while UAB has a slight edge on D.

SYRACUSE by 10 over Middle Tennessee - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. MT DC Shafer was the 'Cuse HC from '13-'15. The Orange wasn't tested in their blowout win over an FCS foe LW, while MT was hosting SEC Vanderbilt in a game they felt good about going in and while they lost 28-6 on the scoreboard, they only all'd 367 yds. WR James set a schl rec with his 15th 100 yd rec game. MT is 3-19 SU in road openers, but 13-5 ATS. Cuse has the experience edge as well as the OFF & D advantages. The Blue Raiders have another P5 road trip on deck & are just 11-21 ATS vs non conf foes.

Indiana by 4 over VIRGINIA - UVA has won both mtgs (1-1 ATS) in '09 & '11. Indiana was impressive for 2.5 quarters against Ohio State, but didn't have the horses to keep up and lost 49-21 (+20) last Thursday. The Hoosiers' WR's consistently made highlight catches & that unit is supremely talented. Simmie Cobbs missed all of LY (ini) but has elite size (6'4) and hands. UVA wasn't tested through the air in their easy win over an FCS foe LW. Kicking continues to be an issue for the 'Hoos as after missing badly on a 42 yd attempt, they ended up going for it on four other 4th down attempts. IU has the edge in all 3 phases & is 3-1 as an AF.

PENN ST by 20 over Pittsburgh - This is the 98th mtg. This rivalry ret'd LY (L/mtg s/00) with Pitt (-5) jumping out to a 28-7 2Q lead. PSU cut the deficit to 42-29 pts but Pitt got an int in the EZ w/1:15 to clinch. Pitt hasn't won at PSU since 1988. LY Pitt had the exp edge, but TY it goes to PSU as they're 1 of the most exp'd in the nation, while Pitt is among the least exp'd. That lack of exp showed LW for the Panthers as they let a 21-0 lead vs an FCS foe (YSU ply'd in FCS title gm LY) slip away & needed OT to survive. New st'g QB Browne (USC transfer rated as the #1QB out of HS) threw for just 140 yds (71%). PSU kept their dominant ATS streak alive (10-0) as they finished w/a 569-160 yd edge LW vs Akron. The str's got plenty of rest. Pitt is 2-5 ATS in road openers, while PSU is 11-6 ATS as a HF to go along with their overall ATS run.

ALABAMA by 42 over Fresno St - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. Bama has won 15 str home openers (5-10 ATS). The Tide has all'd just 26 pts in the L/7 home openers incl 3 shutouts. Bama is off their huge 24-7 (-7) win vs FSU. The score was a bit misleading as the Tide was held to just 269 yds & 13 FD's as they benefitted from a stretch of 4 TO's in 5 plays. FST is fresh off an easy FCS win. This is HC Tedford's 1st road gm at FST and he was on an 11-21 ATS run on the road prior to leaving Cal. FST DC Steinhauer is just getting used to fielding 11 men after ch'g his entire career in Canada. FST has lost their L/3 road openers by 41.3 ppg and are 0-9 ATS vs P5 foes.

NAVY by 10 over Tulane - Both schools run the triple option. This gm came down to the wire LY w/ Navy scoring the GW td w/2:57 left. TU is much more exp'd TY, in the 2nd yr of the new OFF & is off an easy FCS win over a solid FCS foe. Normally it takes a few games for the Middies' option attack to get into full swing, but apparently that memo went out the window for Lane Kiffin & FAU as the OFF looked in midssn form LW on the road w/QB Abey rushing for 235 (7.3)! The Middies will have the edge in all 3 phases incl slightly on D. With TU defending the option every day in practice, we don't feel Navy will be as productive in this one. The Green Wave is 5-3 as a DD dog.

Wku by 6 over ILLINOIS - WKU is an AF vs a P5 team in new HC Sanford's 1st road gm. LY WKU was a fav at Vandy, but lost 31-30 (-8). The Illini enter off a 24-21 home win over Ball St despite being outFD'd 24-14 & outgd' 375-216. They scored the GW td w/2:06 left & blk'd a 54 yd fg attempt w/no time left. WKU had a tougher than expected time w/an in-state FCS rival as they were only up 10 in the 4Q. QB White is still under center, but the OFF is vastly different from former HC Brohm's style. The 'Toppers have the edge on OFF & D, as well as a huge ST edge and entered the ssn as the more experienced team. WKU's last win vs a P5 foe came in '15 over Vandy, but they are 0-5-1 ATS vs P5 foes.

BAYLOR by 14 over Utsa - This is the first ever meeting between these instate schools. UTSA has lost all 5 road gms SU vs P5 foes by 27 ppg. While Baylor enters with a GUB advantage, they would rather forget it as they were stunned at home by FCS Liberty (moving up to FBS next yr) in HC Rhule's debut, all'g 585 tkl yds incl 447 through the air! AZ transf QB Solomon got the start, but RB Hasty was inj (CS). They've now lost 7 str gms dating back to LY & had their 19 gm winning streak vs non-conf foes end. Ironically Baylor also lost their 1st gm under Art Briles. UTSA had their opening gm at Houston cancelled due to Hurricane Harvey. UTSA is our 2nd most exp'd tm entering the ssn, while the Bears are among the least exp'd. Baylor has the edge on OFF, while the schools are about even on D & ST's. UTSA is 2-3 SU, but 5-0 ATS in road openers and were 2-0 ATS vs P5 foes LY.

UCLA by 24 over Hawai'i - This is the first meeting between these schools s/1993! UH enters with a GUB edge off an FCS foe, while UCLA is off a highly emotional comeback win over Texas A&M last Sunday night. The Bruins were down 34 pts late 3Q, but managed the improbable comeback as QB Rosen hit 35-59-491-4-0 and they finished w/a 554-471 yd edge. The Warriors are breaking in 3 new str's incl both CB's from a unit that finished just #118 in our pass eff D rankings & all'd UMass QB Ford 70% completions 2 wks ago. The Bruins are 5-11 as a HF, while UH is 6-3-1 as a dog.

KANSAS by 7 over Central Michigan - Both schools enter off FCS foes, but CM surprisingly needed 3OT to pull off the win. CM has the experience edge & benefited from extra bowl practices. KU has the edge on OFF & ST's. New Jayhawk st'g QB Bender was a 2nd Tm Juco AA LY after transferring from Wazzu, was named the st' morning of LW's game & hit 23-37-364-4-2 in his 1st gm for the Jayhawks. The Chips finished LY with our #95 pass eff D & are replacing both st'g safeties. The tech edges favor CM as they're 16-6 ATS away, while KU is on a 9-16-1 overall ATS run, but we still like an improving KU squad here.

OREGON by 3 over Nebraska - These schools are in totally opposite situations as LY when NU was off a down year & needed to have a statement win early in the ssn at home. Now this year, UO is off a down yr, at home, but also with a new HC. NU had a much tougher time than expected with Ark St LW as the Red Wolves had a chance to win on the games final play. New st'g QB Lee had a solid debut hitting 19-32-238-2-0 & new st'g RB Bryant ran for 192 (6.2). UO enters fresh off a 77 pt performance over an FCS foe in HC Taggart's debut. The Huskers are vastly inexp'd entering the ssn, while the Ducks have 17 ret str's incl QB Herbert. UO has the edge on OFF & ST's, while NU has the edge on D. Ducks RB Freeman is #2 in schl hist in rush yds, is off a 150 yd perf vs a solid FCS foe and the Blackshirts have a new DC & are breaking in 2 new DL str's from a unit that all'd 148 (4.4) rush ypg LY. NU is 14-6-1 ATS away from Lincoln and despite all the advantages that point in UO's favor, we think this game will be closer than the experts think.

Auburn +6 over CLEMSON

Auburn had won 14 in a row SU in this series but Clemson has won the L/3 incl LY's 19-13 (-9) home opener. Both enter off easy wins as Clemson had its way vs Kent St, finishing with 665-120 yd & 35-5 FD edges. New st'g QB Bryant compl 73% while adding 77 rush yds. Despite ply'g w/o bulldozing RB Pettway (will return this wk) and seeing Johnson inj (CS) after 136 rush, 3rd string RB Martin also added 136 rush as Aub finished w/a 535-78 yd edge over Ga Sthrn. New st'g QB Stidham (Bay transfer) hit 14-24-185-2-1. These teams are on opposite ends in terms of experience returning as Aub is near the top, while Clemson is near the bottom. Aub has a significant edge on ST's with K Carlson despite 2 misses LW (53 & 46 yds). We are well aware that Aub is just 6-10 ATS vs non conf foes and on a 15-25 overall ATS run, but that gives us value here. We give the defending Nat'l champs the edge by a fg, but wouldn't be surprised at an outright upset making this our Underdog Play of the Week.

Miami, Fla by 20 over ARKANSAS ST - UM is 2-0 SU/ATS in the series, having won the L/mtg in '14, 41-20 (-15). ASt is 0-6 SU/4-2 ATS hosting current P5 schools. LY UM traveled to SBC member App St in their biggest home gm ever. UM was only fav'd by a fg but won in a blowout 45-10. The 'Canes enter fresh off an FCS foe, tying their schl rec of 11 str home opener. Ark St exerted a ton of energy in their near upset at Nebraska. QB Hansen hit 46-68-415-3-2 as the Red Wolves had a chance to win the game at the end, but the pass on the games final pl was overthrown in the EZ. UM is more experienced & has edges in all 3 phases. Ark St has just an FCS foe on deck while the 'Canes have a big rivalry gm with FSU next, but HC Richt is 95-42-2 ATS in SU wins. UM is also 8-4 ATS on the road.

TEXAS by 24 over San Jose St - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. TX had huge expectations entering the ssn, but was stunned at home in their opener LW. The yds were about even (473-482), but the 'Horns had a fg blk'd & ret'd for a td, had trouble running the ball (3.2 ypc) & all'd 263 (6.1) rush yds. They did score 3 non-OFF td's incl a 91 yd PR & Buechele hit 34-52-375-2-1. SJSt also has a new HC, enters with a GUB edge & had little trouble dispatching an FCS foe after leading by just 1 at HT. TX does have USC on deck. The 'Horns have edges in all 3 phases incl large ones on OFF & D. HC Herman is now 2-7-1 as a HF & the Spartans have backdoor potential here.

TULSA by 10 over Louisiana - Both have inexp'd tms entering the ssn & new LA st'g QB Davis will be making his 1st car road start. That will be a stark contrast to what the Golden Hurricane saw LW when they ran into OSU's triplets. While RB Brewer struggled (22-33), Air Force trans Taylor had 20-111. The Ragin Cajuns had all they could handle w/an FCS foe LW as they ret'd a fumble on a 2 pt conv try 98 yds with under a minute to play for the 3 pt MOV. They were outgd 514-363! TU has the edge on OFF & ST's. LA is 23-10 as an AD, while TU is 6-10 as a HF.

NC STATE by 23 over Marshall - These schls haven't met on the field s/'95. This is the battle of the misleading finals from LW. NCSt deserved better in their loss at South Carolina as they had dominant 33-13 FD & 507-246 yd edges. They all'd a KOR td & 2 TO's set up short td drives for SC. QB Finley hit 45-64-415-2-2. Marshall enters off a win over Miami, Oh but were fortunate as they were outFD'd 26-15 & outgd 430-266. The Herd had not 1, but 2 KOR td's & a 72 yd IR td. They were outFD'd 26-15 & outgd 430-266. MU is 1-16 SU/4-13 ATS in road openers (only win in '14 vs Miami, OH). NCSt entered the ssn full of confidence as 1 of the most exp'd in the nation. The Wolfpack will have a huge edge on OFF & in the trenches. Marshall was held to just 63 (2.4) rush LW & it won't be any easier here. The Herd was 0-5 SU on the road LY, losing by 17 ppg. NCSt is 12-5 as a fav.

Toledo by 7 over NEVADA - Toledo has struggled in trips to the Mountain/Pacific time zones, going 1-7 SU/3-4 ATS (only win at WY in '12). This is Nevada HC Norvell's 1st home gm and the Wolf Pack have won their L/4 home openers, but failed to cover the L/3 (all 4 vs FCS foes). NV nearly pulled the upset at Northwestern LW as they led before all'g 2 late 4Q td's. They were outgd 508-341. Tol enters w/a couple of extra days of rest/prep following their blowout home win over an FCS foe.

FLORIDA ST by 35 over Ulm - The 'Noles won the only prior mtg in '11, 34-0 (-29'). FSU enters off an emotional loss to Bama that saw QB Francois inj & OFY. The game wasn't as lopsided as the final score indicated. FSU all'd just 269 ttl yds & 13 FD's as TO's on their side of the field led their downfall. ULM was down 30-7 late 3Q, battled back on a rain soaked field, but all'd 319 (6.5) rush. This is the 2nd of B2B AG's for ULM, but the 'Noles are in a Bama/Miami sandwich. While the Warhawks have the experience edge, FSU naturally has large edges on both sides of the ball as well as the ST's advantage. The talent gap is so wide it won't matter who takes snaps under center for the 'Noles & this is the perfect game to make a 1st start.

MISSOURI by 1 over South Carolina - There's no clear series edge as SC is 3-2 SU/ATS in SEC mtgs, but there has been 2 upsets in the L/4. LY SC won 31-21 (-6') which eliminated MO from bowl elim. MO found itself in a dog fight early LW as they trailed mid 2Q vs an FCS foe before ultimately setting a schl rec w/815 ttl yds. QB Lock set schl records w/521 yds & 7 td's, but the D all'd 23 FD's & 492 ttl yds. Their biggest DL AJ Logan (325 lbs) will miss the F/6 gms (susp). SC got a misleading win over NCSt as they were held to just 13 FD's & 246 ttl yds, but had a KOR td & two short td drives following TO's. MO has the edge on OFF, while SC has the edge on D.

SMU by 14 over North Texas - SMU is 4-2 SU/ATS in recent mtgs. LY SMU led 21-0 1Q thanks to big plays and won 34-21 (-10). Both enter fresh off easy FCS wins. The Ponies' 31 pt HT lead was their largest s/'11. NT set a schl rec w/668 ttl yds (635 vs Navy '07). SMU entered the season as 1 of the most exp'd tms in the nation, while NT returned just 11 str's. The big edge in this gm goes to the SMU OFF, while the Mean Green does have the ST's edge. NT is 5-14 ATS on the road.

NOTRE DAME by 8 over Georgia - These two have just 1 prior meeting & that was the '81 Sugar Bowl which UGA won 17-10 and was crowned Nat'l Champs. HC Smart was the DC at Bama and beat ND 42-14 in the Nat'l Title in '12. UGA led 31-0 LW over a solid App St squad despite st'g QB Eason being injured in the 1Q (knee, out). True frosh Fromm hit 10-15-143-1-0

We elevated ND from a 2★ on these pages into our top LPS (4★) of the wknd & the Irish dominated Temple w/a 606-330 yd edge. ND had three 100 yd rushers led by Adams; 161 (8.5). This will be QB Wimbush's first big test and he faces a D that ret's 87% of their tkl's. UGA is the more experienced tm, but ND will still have the edge on OFF & ST's. ND is 2-4 as a HF and 0-5 ATS off a SU win, but UGA is 1-6 as an AD and 10-23 ATS off a SU win.

Mississippi State by 10 over LOUISIANA TECH - These two schools are only 278 miles apart. MSt won the L/2 mtgs incl in '15 when LT had a 14-0 lead 1Q but MSt took control and won 45-20 (-13'). LTH was in '08's opener and LT pulled the upset 22-14 (+8') which was also the L/time they hosted a P5 school. Both enter off FCS foes, but while MSt had no trouble allowing 2 FD's & 39 tl yds, LT found itself tied late 3Q. MSt does have LSU on deck, while LT also has a conf foe in WKU on deck.

Memphis by 3 over UCF - Both enter off wins last week. UM was up 37-14 before all'g 2 late 4Q td's, the last w/40 left. Tigers QB Ferguson is 1 of the AAC's best, but is coming off a 10-25-97-0-1 outing in inclement weather and will look to bounce back vs 4 new UCF DB str's. The Knights weren't tested at all LW as QB Milton threw for 360 w/4 td's. UM is the much more exp'd team and has the edge on OFF & ST's, while UCF has a slight edge on D. UCF is 4-7 ATS at home, while the Tigers are 7-2-1 as an AD & 4-1 ATS in their road opener.

USC by 10 over Stanford - Stanford has actually won 7 of 9 SU & is on a 9-4 ATS series run. USC QB Darnold didn't play in LY's mtg & failed to throw a td pass for the first time in 10 games LW in their opener vs Western Michigan. The Trojans were tied at 28 mid 4Q before pulling away. They all'd 263 (5.5) rush. Stanford is fresh off a bye & ran for 287 (8.0) in their opening win over Rice. We also have the Cardinal as our #4 rated set of DB's in the nation, but if Darnold is indeed the top QB in the nation he should still be able to find enough success through the air here. The Trojans are 24-12 as a HF.

IDAHO by 10 over UNLV - UNLV will have revenge on their mind after losing in OT at home LY as a 2 td fav. Both schls enter off FCS foes, but the Rebels were a part of history as they were upset outright despite being a 45 point favorite! Vandals QB Linehan is 1 of the SBC's best, got off to a fast start completing 74% of his passes LW & UNLV finished #66 in our pass eff D rankings LY & is breaking in an all new secondary TY. ID is 4-0 as a HF, while UNLV is 8-12 ATS in road openers.

OREGON ST by 7 over Minnesota - This is a tough spot for MN in their 1st ever trip to Corvallis with a new HC & 1 of the least exp'd teams in the nation. The Gophers had a tougher than expected time LW vs Buf & are using a 2-man rotation at QB. OSU has a 3rd yr HC, is much more exp'd, has a GUB edge, but barely survived an FCS foe LW. Maybe it was the 11am KO (earliest in schl hist), but the Beavers were outFD'd 31-19 & outgd 515-376. They benefited from an IR td & scored the GW td w/1:08 remaining. OSU is also using a 2-man rotation at QB, although Garretson was strictly a runner LW. The Beavers will be in revenge mode after giving up a 4Q lead in LY's mtg in Minneapolis. HC Andersen is 22-12-1 ATS vs non-conf foes & MN HC Fleck went just 1-11 in his 1st yr at WM and his players are still in adjustment mode.

Utah by 3 over BYU - This rivalry game is better known as the Holy War. UT is on a 9-3 ATS series run, has won 6 in a row SU & is 9-2 ATS in Provo. The Utes enter fresh off an FCS foe w/2 extra days rest/prep, while BYU enters off a physical shutout loss to LSU in New Orleans (game moved from Houston due to Hurricane Harvey). They were limited to just 97 yds & 6 FD's after totalling just 365 yds the wk prior vs an FCS foe. UT entered the ssn as 1 of the least exp'd tms in the country & are breaking in a new OFF. The Utes are 8-2 as an AD.

ARIZONA by 3 over Houston - These tms are mirror images in terms of exp ret'g. UH does have a large edge on D, while the Off's are even. UA has a GUB edge as they exerted little effort in their easy win over an FCS foe LW, while UH had their game vs UTSA cancelled due to the effects of Hurricane Harvey. UA failed to make a bowl LY as inj's ply'd a huge role & the last time that happened they started the next ssn 3-0 and ranked in the Top 25. The Cats have a trip to UTEP on deck. AZ is 16-7-1 as a HD, while UH is on an 0-7 ATS run as a fav.

WASHINGTON ST by 14 over Boise St - WSt is 5-0 ATS all-time in this series, incl covering on the Blue Turf LY. BSt led Troy by just 4 pts LW before a late td w/2:12 left. There may be a QB controversy brewing as bkp Cozart (Kansas trans) led their only 2 td drives. Wazzu is fresh off an easy FCS win. The Cougars enter the ssn vastly more exp'd than BSt & the Broncos have their MW opener on deck on a short wk. WSt QB Falk is 1 of the nation's best & BSt is breaking in 2 new str's in their secondary after finishing #80 in our pass eff D rankings LY. They did hold Troy QB Silvers (3Y str, 1st Tm SBC LY) to just 139 pass yds. The Cougars are on a 15-8 overall ATS run, while the Broncos are 1-3 ATS off a SU non-conf win.

4★ HOUSTON over Jacksonville - The defending AFC South Champion Texans have dominated this series over the past 3 years with a 6-0 SU mark (4-2 ATS) and a 10 pt avg MOV. The Jaguars meanwhile come into '17 having dropped 9 consec road openers SU (2-7 ATS) while being outscored by 17 ppg in the process. With HOU posting a 9-2 ATS mark as a HF and 8-3 ATS vs their DIV, we'll go ahead and give them the 14 point victory here as JAX QB Bortles could have his work cut out for him against the Texans' #1 Def (301 ypg, 20.5 ppg) of a year ago.

FORECAST: HOUSTON BY 14

3★ Baltimore over CINCINNATI - The Bengals return to action following an unusual '16 campaign where they posted their 1st losing record in 6 ssn. While BAL finished just ahead of them in the AFC North at 8-8, it's safe to say that could have easily earned a playoff berth had it not been for some untimely inj's. With the Ravens having covered 8 of their L9 inside of their DIV and CIN on a 5-12 ATS run overall, we see no problem leaning with the AD in this one as QB Flacco should be ready to go after sitting out the preseason w/injury.

FORECAST: BALTIMORE BY 3

OTHER SELECTION

2★ SAN FRANCISCO (+) over Carolina - Following a 15-1 campaign and a trip to the SB in '15, the Panthers fell back to Earth a season ago finishing at just 6-10 thanks to a Defense that was ravaged with inj's. SF meanwhile is on a 4-11 ATS run overall and saw their only 2 SU victories come against an equally struggling Rams LY. While the 49ers are still in full rebuild mode with a substantial amount of changes to their roster for '17, they have shown some fight in their past 2 home openers with dominating performances against the Vikings (20-3 win in '15 as 1' pt dog) and the Rams (28-0 win LY as 2' pt dog). That could be enough for them to stay within the line here as CAR is on a porous 0-6-1 ATS run as an AF.

FORECAST: CAROLINA BY 1

OTHER PLAYS

Kansas City at NEW ENGLAND - Thursday - The Patriots enter '17 as the prohibitive favorite to claim yet another SB Title following LY's dominating run that featured a 13-3 ATS regular ssn. The Chiefs meanwhile have also had quite a bit of success during Andy Reid's 4-yr tenure with 3 ssn of 11+ wins. While NE has gone an impressive 11-4-1 ATS as a NDIV HF, it's worth mentioning that the Chiefs closed out LY's regular ssn by claiming SU & ATS victories in 5 of their final 6. **We'll have our Marquee selection available after Noon EST on gameday!**

BUFFALO by 10 over NY Jets - First time in 9 ssn that HC Rex Ryan won't be roaming the sidelines in this matchup. The Jets had quite a bit of success in LY's matchups with an early 6 pt win in BUF and a dominating effort in the ssn finale (20 pt win as a 3' pt dog). BUF enters TY with the Def-minded McDermott now in charge to go along with the NFL's #1 rush Off of '16 (164 ypg). While the Bills are on a 1-5 ATS run inside of their DIV, it's abundantly clear that the Jets lack of talent on their current roster (QB McCown named st'r, has lost 20 of L/22 sts) will result in a good amount of substantial defeats for 2017.

Atlanta by 7 over CHICAGO - The Falcons head to Chicago for their 1st true action since blowing a 28-3 lead against NE in the SB. The Bears meanwhile have plenty of new faces at the QB position with Bucs FA Glennon expected to start here in front of rookie 1st rounder Trubisky. While ATL and their high-octane Off should be able to find some success in Soldier Field (33 ppg, 395 ypg on road LY), we find it difficult to back them by more than a TD here as they've gone just 8-18 ATS as a fav.

WASHINGTON by 3 over Philadelphia - The Redskins enter this matchup having won 5 consec (SU & ATS) in this series (6 pt avg MOV). The Eagles meanwhile have found some solid success as a DIV AD (gm currently at PK, check line on gameday) lately with a 15-5 ATS mark. With both the Cowboys and Giants earning postssn trips a year ago, this appears to be an important early NFC East matchup. We'll go ahead and call for WAS to continue their recent dominance this week against PHI as they are on a 14-5 overall ATS run while also covering 8 of their past 12 inside of their DIV.

DETROIT by 3 over Arizona - The Lions were one of the NFL's biggest surprises a year ago with a 9-7 mark and a WC berth in the NFC. The Cardinals on the other hand saw their record drop all the down to 7-8-1 following a 13-3 record the year prior (QB Palmer struggled throughout the year). While ARZ is on a 3-8 ATS run overall heading into '17, they have gone 8-1 ATS in road openers. Something will have to give here however as DET has proven to be strong as a NDIV HF (gm currently at PK, check line on gameday) with an 8-2 ATS mark.

TENNESSEE by 3 over Oakland - After rattling off victories in 4 of their final 5 contests a ssn ago, the Titans appear to be poised for another solid ssn behind an Off that now has the weapons capable for a Top 5 finish in the NFL rankings. The Raiders should also be back in contention in the AFC after finishing LY at 12-4 before being ousted early in the playoffs without QB Carr. While OAK is on an impressive 9-2 ATS run in AG's, the early start time (9am PST) and unfamiliar temps and humidity could allow the Titans to escape with a key victory here.

Tampa Bay by 4 over MIAMI - Both squads enter the '17 ssn after convincing turnarounds the year prior as TB climbed up to 9-7 and MIA did even better to 10-6 (WC berth). While the Dolphins do get the homefield edge in this one, keep in mind that they have 3 consec road trips on deck and are still in the process of working QB Cutler into the system. The Bucs on the other hand are on a 6-2 ATS run while also having covered 6 of their past 8 road contests overall. With a relatively easy home opener on deck for TB, we'll lean in their direction in this one.

Pittsburgh by 13 over CLEVELAND - The Browns have had their fare share of issues in ssn openers with their last win coming way back in 2004 (2-9-1 ATS, 12 pt avg SU defeat). The Steelers have been victorious on 2 occasions during the CLE skid with the most recent coming in '14 (30-27 win, -5'). With some rough spread marks for CLE (rookie QB Kizer making 1st career start) including 1-10 ATS inside their DIV and 2-10 ATS as a HD, PIT's 28-4 SU mark dating back to '01 (14 pt avg MOV over the L2Y) will have us leaning in their direction.

Indianapolis at LA RAMS - The Rams and new HC McVay head into the ssn having lost 11 of their past 12 reg ssn gms (15 pt avg loss). GREEN BAY by 7 over Seattle - Marquee matchup for Wk 1 with both teams enter '17 with SB aspirations. The Seahawks come in with a solid 10-3 ATS as a dog against a Packers squad that's had their own share of recent spread success with an 8-4 ATS mark as NDIV HF. With GB having shown dominance in home openers recently at 8-1-1 ATS along with the home team having covered 5 straight in the regular ssn (20 pt SU MOV) in this series, the Packers get the TD victory in this one.

NY Giants at DALLAS - SNF - The Giants and Cowboys meet in the opener for the 5th time in the L6 yrs. While DAL has won 3 of the previously mentioned 4, the Giants had their number LY with the ssn sweep (1 & 3 pt wins). Despite the potential loss of RB Elliott (susp) early on, DAL is arguably one of the favorites in the NFC for '17 but don't sleep on the Giants either as they also earned a playoff berth a ssn ago and are on a solid 8-3 ATS run overall. **Call the Northcoast offices on Sunday to purchase your Marquee Winner!**

New Orleans at MINNESOTA - MNF - The Saints have put together some nice spread marks over the past 1.5 yrs with a 15-6 overall ATS run along with a 9-1 ATS record on the road. The Vikings meanwhile are on a 21-9 ATS overall run but have struggled recently in home openers covering just 2 of the previous 9. While the Saints have one of the NFL's elite Off led by QB Brees & newly added RB Peterson (plyd for MIN from '07-'16), it will be interesting to see just how well they match up against MIN and their #3 ranked Def (315 ypg, 19.2 ppg) of a year ago. LA Chargers at DENVER - MNF - The Chargers and Broncos cap off Wk 1 with a showdown in "Mile High" between a visiting team that's on a 11-3 ATS run as a DIV AD and a DEN squad who has gone 19-11 ATS inside of their DIV. With their 1st regular ssn game on deck in their new home of Los Angeles, it will be interesting to see whether the Chargers can end their current 5 gm ATS skid in this one against the Broncos who enter the contest having covered 6 of their past 8 home openers.
