4★ Florida St over WAKE FOREST - WF has been held w/o a td in 5 of the L/7 in this series incl 2 shutouts. FSU true frosh QB Blackman made his first career start LW in a home loss to NCSt and while he did show poise and toughness, at 6'5" 170 lbs, you have to wonder how long he will last. WR Tate had 9-138 but was inj'd (shoulder, CS). WF was outgained 494-344 & out FD'd 27-18 in a 1 pt win at App St. FSU is #4 on D in the FBS, holding foes to 206 ypg less than their avg while WF is #50 on OFF, avg 50 ypg more than their foes allow. That's even more impressive when you take into the fact that FSU has ply'd our #1 toughest sked so far compared to WF having ply'd just our #107 toughest! This is a great bounce back game for the 'Noles to gain some much needed confidence. After back to back losses we feel FSU will show why they were one of the top four teams entering the season. FORECAST: Florida St by 14 3★ TEXAS A&M over South Carolina - A&M has won all 3 series mtgs (1-2 ATS). The Aggies HC Sumlin's job for another week with their OT win over Ark LW. QB Mond finally showed his dual threat capabilities with 216 pass yds & 109 rush yds. SC's OFF continued to struggle LW as they trailed 13-0 4Q vs LT before rallying to win. A&M has the edge on OFF & ST and don't be surprised if Christian Kirk gets another KR as SC has issues in their kick coverage game. SC has been outgained by 60 ypg and their OFF is #108 in the FBS, avg 59 ypg less than their foes allow. HC Sumlin is a master of September (18-2 SU/13-5-1 ATS) and the Gamecocks are 4-8 ATS on the road. This is A&M's 4th str game in the state of Texas.

FORECAST: Texas A&M by 13 3★ Oklahoma St over TEXAS TECH - OKSt has won 8 in a row SU and is on a 9-3 ATS run in this series. The Pokes will be in a bad mood this week after getting handled by TCU, while Tx Tech is off an emotional win over an in-state rival. This game should feature plenty of OFF firepower as both schools avg 575+ ypg. OKSt will have the edge on D. The Pokes had a ssn low of "just" 499 yds LW and Tx Tech is #94 in the FBS on D all'g 39 ypg more than their foes avg. The Red Raiders are all'g 64% completions and Mason Rudolph will have plenty of opportunities thru the air this week. The Pokes have a bye on deck and will be completely focused here. OKSt is 20-12-1 as an AF and 15-6 ATS vs Big 12 foes.

FORECAST: Oklahoma St by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ AUBURN over Mississippi St - MSU has won 3 of the L/5 mtgs SU (4-1 ATS) but LY Aub led 35-0 at the half with 335-91 yd & 17-5 FD edges and won 38-14 (-3). The Tigers finally got their OFF going LW vs Mizzou, putting up 51 pts & rushing for 263 (5.0) despite not using RB Pettway (cch's decision). MSU will have to find their confidence again after getting beatdown vs Georgia as they were outgained 404-280. Aub has held foes to 98 (2.6) rush ypg and has 16 sks. The Tigers D is #1 in FBS, holding foes to 240 ypg less than their foes avg. MSU rush D is skewed due to the fact that their game vs LT featured an 87 yd loss due to a bad snap. This is the 3rd straight physical game for MSU and Auburn will wear them out here.

FORECAST: Auburn by 16

2★ Akron (+) over BOWLING GREEN - This is the MAC opener for both schools. BG has won the L/8 mtgs between these two and UA has lost their L/4 trips to BG by 27 ppg (L/won in '05), but these are different times. BG is 0-6 as a HF including a 35-27 loss (-3) to FCS South Dakota and are 0-4 SU & ATS TY. Akron showed life in their loss at a respectable Troy team last week. The Zips led 17-16 late 4Q before allowing a GW td w/1:06 left. BG never got closer than 8 pts in the 2H at MT and their only "lead" of the season was 3-0 in the season opener at Mich St. Akron has Ohio St transfer Warren Ball at RB and BG has all'd all 4 foes to rush for over 200 yds incl FCS South Dakota! The Falcons are #128 on D all'g foes an amazing 194 ypg more than their avg. We feel Akron won't even need the points in this one.

FORECAST: Akron by 5

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 28TH

Texas at IOWA ST - Iowa St is on a 3-1 ATS run in this series. Both enter fresh off a bye and this is the 'Clones Ione HG in a 4 week span, while Texas HC Herman is making his B12 debut. Both feature plenty of OFF firepower, while Texas is far superior on D. The 'Horns have not only finished with the most yards allowed by each of their F/3 foes, but have also held all 3 to their ssn lows in yards. Iowa St is #107 in the FBS allowing 84 ypg more than their foes avg. The 'Horns are 3-8 ATS in true road games. The 'Clones are 3-5-1 ATS off a bye, but on an 8-3-1 overall ATS run.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 29TH

Miami, FI by 8 over DUKE - UM is 11-1 SU in this series. LTH Duke appeared to have the gm won, but UM used an 8-lateral KR that the ref's decide to let stand despite a players knee down to win the game 30-27. The Canes looked rusty LW, coming off their long layoff and trailed Toledo 16-10 at half. QB Rosier accounted for four 2nd half td's as UM won by a deceiving 22 pts (only 38-30 mid 4Q). The Blue Devils have won B2B gms as fav's (both covers) & now are in a role they are more accustomed to, being the home dog. Miami is a well rested team due to their layoff, but has Florida St on deck. The Canes are 25-3 ATS when they win SU away.

Nebraska by 7 over ILLINOIS - This is the 5th straight year that the Illini opens B10 play against Nebraska. IL has covered the L/2 in this series as B10 rivals. IL is fresh off a bye, while the 'Huskers enter on a short week off their tougher than expected B10 opening win vs Rutgers. Nebraska finished w/21-12 FD & 306-194 yd edges, but QB Lee continues to struggle w/int's & the Huskers didn't take the lead for good until late 3Q. Issues remain on OFF for IL & early indications are that Jeff George Jr will start, while UCF grad trans DiNovo was added to the team last week. Nebraska

is 15-6-1 ATS away from Lincoln, HC Riley is 9-16-1 as a reg ssn fav. The Illini is 3-6 as a HD. Byu by 3 over UTAH ST - These schools are just 125 miles apart. While BYU is off a bye week, their offense has been missing all ssn having scored just 19 pts in their 3 FBS matchups in '17 (22 pt avg loss). The Aggies meanwhile picked up an easy conf victory LW in San Jose with a 51 pt win and a 589-162 yd edge. Although Utah St has to be riding high following their most complete game of the ssn, it's worth mentioning that the visitor is 6-2 ATS in this series with 3 outright upsets in the past 7 ssns.

Usc by 10 over WASHINGTON ST - The Trojans have had their fair share of success recently in Pullman with 5 straight wins by 33 ppg. The Trojans are on the 2nd of B2B AG's after getthe edge there.

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ting by a mistake-prone Cal squad LW in Berkeley (USC outgained 416-356, +4 TO's), The Cougars meanwhile are ply'g their 5th str HG and easily dispatched of Nevada LW in a 38 pt win (560-151 yd edge). USC has been battle tested having taken on our #4 toughest sked thus far compared to Wazzu taking on just our #118 sked. Although the Trojans are 12-23 ATS as an AF, we'll go ahead and back QB Darnold and company in this one against a Cougars secondary that has our #42 ranked pass eff D.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 30TH

FIU by 12 over Charlotte - FIU is 2-0 SU in this series but actually trailed 26-13 LY before getting 2 td's in the L/4:21 to win 27-26 (-4'). The 49ers are still looking for their 1st ever home win over an FBS opponenent after they were shutout LW by lowly Georgia St 28-0 (Pk). FIU got their 1st CUSA win under new HC Butch Davis LW. The 49ers have been outgained by by 130 ypg and are #126 on D, allowing 66 ypg more than their foes avg. FIU is #95 on OFF, avg 24 ypg less than their foes allow and they've only scored 3 td's all ssn. CU, in 3 gms vs FBS foes has just 14 pts and is on an 0-7 ATS run.

PITTSBURGH by 24 over Rice - This is a much needed step down in competition for Pitt after ply'g Penn St/OKSt/GT the L/3 weeks. The Panthers switched to bkp QB Ben DiNucci LW but the results were no different as Pitt was outgained 484-235 vs GT in their 35-17 (+9') loss. Rice is banged up (QB Glaesmann DNP LW, CS) & the most traveled tm in the country, having already traveled to Australia vs Stanford, El Paso and now to the ETZ in Pittsburgh. The Owls are 6-10-1 as an AD and 9-17-1 ATS vs P5 foes. This is already Rice's 4th game away from home.

Usf by 26 over EAST CAROLINA - USF is on a 4-0-1 ATS series run. EC enters off a rare Sunday game due to having their sked adjusted b/c of the effects of Hurricane Irma. This will be the Bulls first Saturday game in 4 weeks. They enter off their best game of the ssn, a total dismantling of Temple last Thurs, finishing w/22-7 FD and 408-85 yd edges! This is the 1st AAC AG for HC Strong, but after a slow start, USF appears to have adjusted to their new HC's systems, especially on D. The Bulls are on a 18-9-1 overall ATS run, while EC is on just a 5-15-1 overall ATS run.

Memphis by 7 over UCF - This game was originally sked for Sept 9th but had to be postponed due to the effects of Hurricane Irma. UCF had 21 days in between games before beating MD LW. The Knights were fortunate to be defending against a 3rd string QB, but that won't be the case this week. Memphis was due for a letdown against an FCS foe LW following their emotional win over UCLA the week prior. Tigers QB Ferguson is 1 of the AAC's best and UCF has 4 new DB starters. UCF is 4-7 ATS at home.

NC STATE by 14 over Syracuse - NC St is 3-1 SU/ATS in ACC mtgs. There have been 4 upsets in the L/6 mtgs with the L2Y being the exceptions. The dog and visitor are both 5-1 ATS. LY Cuse ply'd w/o QB Dungey & were held to 28 rush yds in the loss. NCSt enters off an emotional win at FSU while Cuse enters off a physical and closer than expected 35-26 (+21') loss at LSU. The Orange trailed 28-26 mid 4Q & was only outgained 414-384. NCSt has a strong D led by DE Chubb, but their OFF has been surprising, avg 121 ypg more than their foes allow (#20 in FBS) while Cuse's D is #62, all'g 15 ypg less than their foes avg. NCSt is 13-7 ATS as a fay. Cuse is 10-16 as an AD and 1-3 SU/ATS in ACC openers. NCSt is in an FSU/L'ville sandwich, while Cuse is ply'g B2B road gms.

KENTUCKY by 17 over Eastern Michigan - First mtg. EM is 1-3 ATS vs SEC foes (avg loss by 43.3 ppg). Kentucky was on the verge of finally beating Florida LW, leading 27-14 4Q but allowed 2 td's & missed a GW fg. EM is coming off an OT loss vs Ohio. Surprisingly, the Eagles have the numbers edge. The Cats' are allowing 270 pass ypg and the Eagles avg 277. EM has outgained foes by 46 ypg while KY has been outgained by 13 ypg. The Cats' OFF avg just 316 ypg vs FBS foes and are #104, avg 52 ypg less than foes allow while EM's D allows 326 ypg and is #57, allowing 21 ypg less than their foes avg. KY has the talent edge and we feel will get the win by over 2 td's.

W MICHIGAN by 7 over Ball St - MAC opener for both. WM has won/covered the L/3 of the series with an avg MOV of 27.6 ppg. This is the middle of 3 str road gms for Ball St while WM is ply'g their 3rd str home gm and is off a 49-14 win (-33) over an FCS foe. The Broncos are on a 29-18 ATS run and 12-5 as fav. Ball St suffered a heart break loss LW at WKU. They led 21-20 (+10.5), before allowing a td with 1:38 left and then threw an Int that was ret'd 34 yds for a td:25 later to lose by a deceptive 33-21 margin. With a new HC & QB WM is leaning a bit more on the run, avg 219 ypg (4.9). With the edges on Off, Def & ST we will side with the home team.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 10 over Central Michigan - BC is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in this series with the L/mtg in '09. BC is moving to an up-tempo OFF but have yet to find their rhythm as they avg just 15 ppg. CM has already played two P5 foes, beating Kansas and losing to Syracuse. LW the Eagles were at Clemson (+34) and had the game tied 7-7 4Q before Clemson pulled away 34-7. BC has been outgained by 122 ypg and their normally strong D is just #74, allowing 3 ypg more than their foes avg. The Eagles avg just 178 pass ypg, QB Brown has already thrown 7 int's, and CM has our #21 pass eff D. The Eagles are 17-0 SU/11-5-1 ATS vs MAC foes. CM is 10-3 as an AD. This is the Chips' 3rd road gm in 4 wks. BC is in a Clem/VT sandwich although this is the much more winnable game.

Ohio by 5 over MASSACHUSETTS - UMass 0-2 SU/1-1 ATS when they were both in the MAC. UMass is 1-5 as a HD incl an upset 38-35 loss (-3) in their ssn opener vs Hawaii. Ohio has huge edges on D & ST's. UMass is off B2B covers as a DD dog including a 17-13 loss at Tenn as a 28 pt AD but did allow 7 sks (OH avg 2.7 sk/gm). Ohio is 7-1 ATS on the road and is off an 27-20 OT win (+2.5) at EM. The Bobcats are in a MAC sandwich, while the Minutemen have a double bye on deck due to USF recheduling their game due to Hurricane Irma. With that in mind we look for an all out effort from UMass vs their former conf foe making it close than you would expect.

Buffalo by 12 over KENT ST - This is the MAC opener for both tms. The home tm is 0-7 in this series with 4 of those being outright upsets. The Bulls have won 2 straight for the first time s/14. LW UB never trailed in the 2H vs FAU & pulled out a 34-31 win (-3) despite losing starting QB Jackson in the 2Q. Backup QB Drew Anderson hit 7-9-109 (1 td) in the 2H. Kent lost starting QB Holley (OFY) 2 weeks ago. QB's Bollas & Crum comb to hit just 2-5-11 (1 int) LW vs Louisville. While they have faced a tough schedule Kent has scored just 6 pts vs 3 FBS foes. If Jackson can not return it will be the battle of the backup QB's and UB looks to have

Houston by 15 over TEMPLE - Houston is 3-0 SU/ATS in the most recent meetings with the last game taking place in the '15 AAC title game. This is the 1st conference HG for new Temple HC Collins. The Owls have had a tough time adjusting as they have been blown out twice and outgained by an FCS foe and UMass in their 2 wins. This is the 1st conference game for new Cougars HC Applewhite. Houston had their 16 game home win streak snapped in their loss to Tx Tech last week and QB Allen was benched as he now has 6 TO's in 3 games, but Temple has just our #80 pass eff D so look for a bounce back effort here. Temple is on an 0-5 overall ATS run, while Houston is 17-4-1 ATS away.

CINCINNATI by 3 over Marshall - Cincy is 3-1 ATS in the series, winning the last 3 by an avg of 22 ppg. The last meeting took place in 2008. Marshall enters fresh off a bye following their shutout over Kent St, which was our Sept 5★ winner given away for free to all our customers! The Bearcats had no clue how to defend Navy's triple option last week, but they're OFF came alive w/a ssn high 439 yds. The run gm is still an issue and st'g RB Boone DNP (CS) and Marshall allows just 3.5 ypc. The Bearcats are on a 7-11 overall ATS run, 5-12 ATS in non conf play and are just 1-6 ATS at home. Marshall is 4-0 ATS vs non-conference FBS foes and on a 4-2 overall ATS run.

KANSAS ST by 14 over Baylor - Kansas St is on a 6-2 ATS series run. The Wildcats enter fresh off a bye and this is their B12 opener. Baylor showed a lot of life in their loss to Oklahoma as they actually led late 3Q and were only outg'd 625-523. Kansas St should own the trenches as they're avg 230 (5.9) rush ypg & all'g just 3.5 ypc, while the Bears are all'g 237 (5.3) rush ypg & only avg 127 (4.0). The Wildcats are 9-0 ATS off a bye & 46-22 ATS vs conf foes.

MINNESOTA by 16 over Maryland - Last year was the first game between these schools s/77 and just the second overall. This is Minnesota HC Fleck's B10 debut and he has the undefeated Gophers already believing in the 'Row the Boat' mantra. Minn uses a ball control OFF and an aggressive D as they're avg 214 (4.1) rush ypg while holding their foes to 157 ypg below their avg (#13 FBS). MD is down to the bkp of the bkp at QB after Kasim Hill was inj in the 1Q last week in their uninspired home loss to a team that hadn't played in over 3 weeks. The Terp's were shredded for 250 (6.4) rush yds. The Gophers enter fresh off a bye (Fleck 5-1 ATS at WM). MD is on just a 3-8 overall ATS run vs FBS foes.

Ohio St by 35 over RÚTGERS - Ohio State is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series as B10 rivals, winning by an avg of 46 ppg & covering by 20 ppg. Rutgers HC Ash was the Bucks co-DC in '14-'15. The Scarlett Knights will have trouble moving the ball (276 ypg vs FBS foes), while OSU is #17 in the FBS holding their foes to 133 ypg below their avg. The Bucks have held their L/3 foes to ssn lows in ttl yds. Rutgers all'd nearly 200 rush yds to Neb LW & the Bucks are avg 230 (5.9) rush ypg despite LY's 1,000 yd RB having just 7 carries due to a hamstring inj, but is getting close to being 100%. Rutgers is on just a 9-17 overall ATS run.

MICHIGAN ST by 5 over lowa - The last meeting between these conf rivals was the '15 B10 Championship game with MSU scoring the GW td w/:27 left. The visitor has covered the L/3 regular ssn meetings. Both enter off misleading finals as Sparty had a 496-355 yd edge yet lost by nearly 3 td's while lowa was outg'd 579-273 yet only lost by 2. MSU is #11 in the FBS on D holding their opponents to 171 ypg less than their avg while avg 221 (5.2) rush ypg. The Hawkeyes were held to just 82 (3.6) rush & all'd 295 (5.8) to PSU LW. Sparty is in a N Dame/Michigan sandwich. WISCONSIN by 10 over Northwestern - The home team had covered 6 straight in this series, but the visitor has now won/covered the L/2. Both enter fresh off byes and this is also the B10 opener for each. On paper this appears to be a complete mismatch. UW is avg 511 ypg (#15 FBS 146 ypg more than foes allow), while all'g 248 ypg (also #15 FBS 141 ypg less than foes avg). They're averaging 275 (5.6) rush ypg & compl 69% of their passes, while all'g 91 (3.1) rush ypg & are #19 in our pass eff D rankings. NW is #61 in the FBS avg just 43 ypg more than their foes allow & #100 FBS on D all'g their foes to avg 47 ypg more than their avg. NW HC Fitzgerald tends to have his team rise above expectations in games like this and the 'Cats are 22-9 as an AD. This game will be closer than expected.

PENN ST by 17 over Indiana - Indy is 6-4 ATS in this series. The final score didn't indicate it, but PSU dominated at lowa last week to the tune of 29-11 FD & 579-273 yd edges. The Nittany Lions are avg 214 (6.4) rush ypg & the Hoosiers have all'd two of their three foes to gain 240+ rush yds. Indiana is using a 2 QB rotation & PSU has our #16 pass eff D. PSU is 14-5 ATS at home vs B10 foes. The Hoosiers have a bye on deck & are 0-6 ATS in that role vs FBS foes, while also just 8-13 as an AD.

Navy by 6 over TULSA - Last year we used Navy as our "Underdog Play of the Week" on these pages and they pulled the outright upset. The Middies are 2-0 SU/ATS in this series as AAC rivals. Navy finished w/their 2nd most rush yds in school history after finishing w/569 (7.9) last week and Tulsa is all'g 295 (6.9) rush ypg including allowing 338 (5.7) against New Mexico's option OFF last week. The sked edge does favor Tulsa, who are on the 2nd of B2B home games, while Navy is off their AAC opener w/rival AF on deck. The Golden Hurricane is just 9-17 ATS at home, while Navy is 29-19 ATS away.

SMU by 22 over Connecticut - SMU is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series as AAC rivals. This is SMU's conference opener & HC Morris feels this is his best squad yet. The Ponies avg 500 ypg and are #12 in the FBS avg 174 ypg more than their foes allow, while saying that UConn struggles on D is a major understatement. UConn is off an extremely rare Sunday game due to having their sked adjusted due to the effects of Hurricane Irma. The Huskies are just 9-18-1 as a dog and on just a 15-36-1 overall ATS run.

WYOMÍNG by 17 over Texas St - The Cowboys are at home for a 4th straight week although they are lucky to be sitting at 2-2 coming in after surviving their matchup LW against Hawaii (23-11 FD & 450-269 yd deficits). TXSt is making the trek to the altitude following 3 consec losses including a 30 pt defeat LW at home against UTSA (outgained 569-198). With Pokes QB Allen still 1 of the MW's best despite early struggles & the Bobcats having 3 new str's in the secondary, we'll call for them to find more consistency in this one with a solid 8-2 ATS run at home.

UCLA by 10 over Colorado - The Buffs are on a 3-1 ATS series run although they come in with some questions after their offense mustered just 10 pts LW at home against the Huskies (4★ Newsletter Winner on Washington!). We also benefited in going against UCLA LW (2★ Newsletter Winner) as Stanford earned a 24 pt victory despite a 480 yd, 3 TD outing from Bruin QB Rosen. With UCLA in revenge mode after seeing their 5 gm series win streak snapped a ssn ago vs CU and being able to go all out with a bye on deck, we'll back them here as this marks the Buffs' 1st true away gm of the ssn.

OREGON by 17 over California - Big spot for the Ducks in this one as they come in following their first defeat of the ssn LW in Tempe (ASU GW FG w/2:33 left) and seeking revenge against the Bears after having their 7 gm series win streak snapped LY in Berkeley. Cal also dropped their 1st contest of the '17 campaign LW vs USC although it was a 2nd half of errors that helped the Trojans get the 10 pt win (Cal 416-356 yd edge, 4 TO's, a SOD & Missed FG in final 2 quarters). With the Bears on just a 2-7 ATS run away and the Ducks needing to get back on track, we'll give the home team the 17 pt edge in this one.

Washington by 35 over OREGON ST - The Beavers are off of a much needed bye week following an 0-3 SU/ATS start against FBS foes where they've been outscored by 31 ppg. The Huskies are on an 8-5 ATS run in Corvallis and have covered 4 of the past 5 overall (failed to cover LY as a 36 pt HF). Following an early 7-0 deficit LW in Boulder, UW rattled off 37 of the gm's final 40 pts en route to a 4★ Newsletter Winner over Colorado! The Huskies have our #8 ranked OFF vs an OSt D that is ranked just #60. With UW HC Peterson now a solid 28-13 ATS as an overall AF and OSU appearing to be the bottom-feeder of the P12, we'll back the Huskies by 5 TD's in this one!

ULM by 14 over Coastal Carolina - 1st mtg. This is the 1st SBC gm for CC. The Chanticleers are off a 52-10 loss as a 3 pt HF vs a ranked FCS foe. They were outgained 510-307 and were -4 TO. The Warhawks are off a 56-50 2OT upset (+6.5) win over in-state rival Lousiana. CC is 2-4 as an AD. This is the first time that ULM is a DD fav over an FBS team s/14 (2-0 SU, 0-2 ATS), but they are 2-0 ATS in that role vs FCS teams the L/2 yrs. ULM QB Caleb Evans hit 82% for 343 yds vs UL's #128 pass eff D and now faces CC's #126 pass eff D.

LSU by 21 over Troy - LSU is 2-0 SU, but 0-2 ATS in this series with the avg MOV just 6.5 ppg. The Tigers were over 3 td favs LW yet only led 26-24 4Q vs Cuse before winning 35-26. Troy needed a td w/1:06 left to beat Akron 22-17, but finished w/a 489-367 yd edge. QB Silvers avg 273 pass ypg, but only has a 2-2 ratio & is facing his biggest test. LSU has 3 straight non-covers while Trojan HC Brown is 7-1 as an AD and on a 6-0 run as a DD Dog. LSU has a revenge gm on deck vs Florida while Troy has a bye on deck.

The Huskies are making a cross country trip, but enter fresh off a bye following their 21-17 (+11') upset at Nebraska two weeks ago. The Aztecs pulled out a 4 pt win over Air Force (3★ Newsletter Winner) in a massive rain storm to stay alive for potential NY's Day Bowl bid. NIU's rush D is allowing just 98 (2.2) rush ypg including allowing Nebraska just 85 (2.4) and we feel will match up well against San Diego St's rush OFF. The Technical edges are overwhelming in favor with the Huskies as they're an extremely solid 25-7 ATS on the road and 17-5 as an AD, while the Aztecs are just 3-10 ATS vs non-conference foes in the regular season. ARKANSAS by 21 over New Mexico St - The L/mtg between these schools was back in '04. The Aggies are 0-21 all-time vs SEC foes w/the avg loss by 38 ppg. Ark is coming off yet another heartbreaking OT loss to rival A&M and HC Bielema will need a convincing win with his job status getting murky. NMSt has been one of the bigger surprises so far, covering all 4 gms, incl last week as a rare 19' pt favorite vs UTEP. QB Rogers now has a 12-4 ratio, but faces our #30 pass eff D. NMSt is 11-19 as an AD and 2-7 ATS vs SEC foes.

UNLV by 12 over San Jose St - This is the MW opener for the Rebels with their 1st home home game since their opener when they lost outright to FCS Howard as a 45 pt favorite! UNLV was outgained by a 664-264 yd clip LW in Columbus but was able to get the cover after OSU pulled their starters in the 3Q. The Spartans were also victims of a lopsided matchup LW at home against Utah St who finished with a 589-162 yd edge (51 pt victory). While SJSt is 6-0 SU/ATS in their MW road opener and have owned this series, with 7 str wins by 14 ppg, it's hard to lean with either squad at the moment.

ARMY by 28 over Utep - LY Army, ply'g with emotion after a player died in a car accident won and put up 66 pts vs UTEP, their most since 1958. It's been a disappointing ssn for the Miners, having been outscored by 35 ppg and outgained by 309 ypg and one has to wonder how much longer HC Kugler lasts. The Miners have allowed 248 (5.5) rush ypg. Army has edges on OFF & D and will be focused after giving up a game winning td with :23 left vs Tulane last week. UTEP is 8-17-2 as an AD and 0-8 ATS away off a previous away game.

FLORIDA by 7 over Vanderbilt - Florida is 25-1 SU in this series, but the only loss did come in the Swamp in '13. The visitor is 6-3 SU/8-1 ATS. Vandy had the unfortunate experience of running into an angry Bama team LW in their 59-0 (+18') home loss. The Gators, ply'g w/o their 9 susp players again (CS), continued their winning streak over KY despite trailing 27-14 AQ until bkp QB Del Rio led the gm winning td drive. Vandy has been outgained by 39 ypg on the season although that number is skewed by the loss to Bama (-599 yds). The Gators have been outgained by 83 ypg and their run D has allowed 173 (4.5) rush ypg (most since Pre-Spurrier), which is good news for a Vandy tm struggling to run the ball (88 ypg, 3.0). UF is 10-16 as a HF, while Vandy is 14-9 as an AD. UF has LSU on deck.

Georgia by 4 over TENNÉSSEE - Georgia is in a double revenge spot after blowing 17 pt leads each of the L2Y including losing on a 43 yard "Hail Mary" LY. Each of the L/4 games have been decided by a td or less. Tenn was clearly caught looking ahead LW vs UMass and the heat is on Butch Jones this week. The Vols will need another big game from RB Kelly (450, 5.6) but UGA's run D allows just 98 (3.0) and have faced 3 strong run teams. The Dawgs D is #2 in FBS, holding foes to 218 ypg less than their avg while the Vols D is #112, allowing 70 ypg more than their foes avg. The stats suggest UGA, but HC Jones has a knack for ply'g this game close.

SOUTHERN MISS by 9 over North Texas - SM is 3-2 SU/ATS in the series. LY SM ply'd w/o their st'g QB and NT led 20-0 2Q. SM came back and led 23-20 w/9:39 left then NT got the gm deciding td w/7:34. NT got 211 rush yds from RB Wilson LW in a win that should have been decided by much more than the 3 point MOV. The Mean Green held 548-395 yd & 28-16 FD edges. NT has a slight edge on OFF but SM has a huge edge on D. The Golden Eagles are +217 ypg on the ssn and their D is #8, allowing 177 ypg less than their opponent's avg and they have our #11 pass eff D. NT's OFF is #45, avg 67 ypg more than their opponent's allow. SM is 3-0 ATS TY. NT is 6-15 ATS on the road and 8-17 ATS vs CUSA foes. SM is off a bye while NT has a bye on deck. LOUISIANATECH by 15 over South Alabama - First meeting. South Alabama sat through 2 weather delays last week only to lose in OT to Idaho 29-23 (-3'). The Jags were outgained 417-350 & outFD'd 25-16. Last week LT actually led South Carolina 13-0 and 16-14 before allowing a game winning fg with no time left. The Bulldogs are -16 ypg on the ssn and are #108 on D, allowing 64 ypg more than their foes avg. SA is #117 on OFF, avg 87 ypg less than foes allow. SA is 4-7 SU/7-3 ATS in non conf road gms with wins at Tulane, Kent St, SDSt & Miss St in prev ssns. LT is 11-7 ATS vs non conf foes. The Jaguars are on an 1-8 ATS run vs FBS foes. NOTRE DAME by 21 over Miami, Oh - These schools are only 170 miles apart but haven't met since 1909! ND HC Kelly is familiar with the RedHawks from his days at CM & Cincy when he went 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. Miami HC Martin is 13-5 as an AD, including a 31-14 win (+1.5) at CM LW. ND is in a Mich St/NC sandwich, while MU returns back to MAC play next week. Miami is 3-1 ATS (0-4 SU) vs P5 tms s/14 incl a 1 pt bowl loss to Miss St (+14) LY. With some heat on his seat, don't look for Kelly to let the Irish look past a bowl team from LY, but we still like the RedHawks to keep it slightly closer than expected.

Middle Tennessee by 6 over FAU - MT is 9-0 SU/7-1 ATS in this series. LY MT put up schl records for pts (77) & yds (757) in their 77-56 (-14) win despite being w/o their top 2 QB's & went to a wildcat and racked up 495 rush yds. LW MT was again w/o QB Stockstill and WR James (both injured, CS) but it didn't matter as they still outgained BG 533-284. HC Kiffin isn't happy with FAU's downfield passing so he switched to bkp QB Driskel LW. The Owls are rushing for 212 (5.5) ypg but MT only allows 105 (2.6). Getting QB Stockstill back would be huge as FAU is #118 on D, allowing 79 ypg more than their foes avg. FAU is on a 10-19-3 ATS run. The dog is 22-11-3 ATS in FAU gms.

GEORGIA TECH by 13 over North Carolina - The home team is 10-4 SU/8-5-1 ATS. NC has won/covered the L/3 with GT 5-0 SU/ATS prior. GT is looking to get to 4-0 for the 1st time s/14, also the last year they won the ACC Coastal. The Jackets are off a strong performance vs Pitt & are putting up 394 (5.8) rush ypg and they have edges on OFF & D but NC has a big ST edge. The Heels enter off their Victory Bell rivalry loss vs Duke 27-17 (+1) and they've allowed 177 (4.5) rush ypg. The Jackets OFF is #6 in FBS, avg 189 ypg more than their foes allow while NC's D is just #102, allowing 50 ypg more than their foes avg. NC is 9-2 ATS in true road gms. The Yellow Jackets have a bye on deck and are on a 7-0 ATS run so we'll lean with the hot team.

Clemson by 7 over VIRGINIA TECH - ESPN's College Gameday will be on hand as this is the marquee matchup of the weekend. This is a rematch of LY's ACC title game that Clemson won by a td and the Tigers have won the L/4 mtgs. This is the Tigers 3rd big game in 4 wks, having beaten Aub & L'ville already. VT QB Jackson has an 11-1 ratio in 4 games and VT's OFF averages 97 ypg more than their foes allow (#20 in FBS). VT has outgained foes by 196 ypg while Clem holds a 283 ypg edge on their foes. Clemson's D has held each of their foes to their ssn low in yards and while both tms are strong on both sides of the ball, Clem does have the edge on OFF & D. One key factor could be the loss of Clem's K Huegel (ACL, OFY). VT is 0-7-1 in ACC openers but also 6-2 as an AD and 14-7 as an ACC Dog. Clem is 2-6 ATS vs ACC foes. Clemson has taken on our #8 toughest sked compared to VT having taken on just our #119 toughest sked.

NEW MEXICO by 3 over Air Force - Mother Nature may have cost the Falcons LW at home as they were handling the Aztecs relatively well early on in a monsoon before a 90+ minute lightning delay woke up the Aztecs in the eventual 4 pt SDSt win. The Lobos & 3rd string QB Gerhart had 24-16 FD & 446-286 yd edges but needed a 53 yd FG as time expired to get the road win over Tulsa. NM has won 3 of the L/4 and covered 5 straight with the L/4 mtgs having all been shootouts (avg 79 ppg with all 4 going over the total). With the Falcons D having trouble with the NM option all'g 392 (6.9) ypg the L/4 mtgs and AF 7-20 ATS off a loss, we'll give the home team the edge in this one.

ALABAMA by 30 over Mississippi - The Rebels are 9-3 ATS in this series. After beating Bama 2 straight years, the Tide got double revenge LY although it wasn't easy as they trailed 24-3 in the 2Q. Bama was out to prove something LW as they steamrolled Vandy 59-0 (-18'), holding a 599 yd edgel With no bowl possible for Ole Miss, they are approaching each game like a bowl, but it shouldn't matter as Bama has edges across the board. UM avg just 70 (2.8) rush ypg and QB Patterson has yet to see anything like the Tide's defensive front. UM's D is #81 in FBS all'g 11 ypg more than their foes avg while Bama's OFF is #11, avg 175 ypg more than their foes allow. Ole Miss enters fresh off a bye and despite their series edge, we feel the Tide will prove to be too much here.

STANFORD by 20 over Arizona St - Big time win for Todd Graham and his job security LW in the desert against the Ducks (GW FG w/AZSt w/2:33 left). Their reward for the victory is a trip to "The Farm" to take on a Stanford squad that earned a 24 pt win over the Bruins a week ago. The Sun Devils are just 1-6 ATS in Palo Alto and have lost 4 of the past 5 overall in the series dating back to '09. While ASU does have a bye week on deck, we find it difficult to go against the Cardinal this week as they are on a solid 21-12-1 overall ATS run.

FRESNO ST by 11 over Nevada - The home tm is 3-3 SU/0-6 ATS in this series. Nevada has won the L/2 mtgs but are off of a 38 pt road loss to Wash St (outgained 587-146) to move to 0-4 on the yr. Fresno had an opportunity to take a breath LW during their bye week following matchups at Bama and Washington. With both tms having new HC's and ply'g their MW opener, this is a tough matchup to make a substantial lean with either squad.

Colorado St by 10 over HAWAII - The Rams come in off a well-timed bye week giving them time to prepare for the long trip to the islands. Hawaii meanwhile had 23-11 FD & 450-269 yd edges in Laramie but return home following a 7 pt defeat. With UH just 4-16 ATS in MW home matchups and CSU a perfect 5-0 SU/ATS in the series and having covered 4 consecutive conf road contests (incl a 63-31 win LY at SDSt as a 11' pt dog), we'll clearly back the visitor in this matchup.

4★ KANSAS CITY over Washington - MNF - The Chiefs are off to a magical start in '17 following their 3rd consec win LW at the Chargers (forced 3 Philip Rivers int's, KC RB Hunt 172 rush yds & another TD) delivering a Sept GOM Winner and the 2nd consec Newsletter 4★ Winner in the process! The Redskins meanwhile put together a dynamic all-around performance (16-6 ATS run) in their victory over the Raiders with 18-7 FD & 472-128 yd edges. While WAS does have a bye on deck, it's hard not to lean with the Chiefs at the moment having covered 8 of their L/9 and looking like the NFL's top overall team! FORECAST: KANSAS CITY BY 14

3★ Philadelphia over LA CHARGERS - After a pair of missed FG's cost them a chance to start the ssn at 2-0, the Chargers were part of an ugly performance (Rivers 3 int) LW against KC giving us a Sept GOM & Newsletter 4★ Winner on KC. Up next for the 0-3 home squad is a PHI tm that moved to 2-1 on the ssn a wk ago against the Giants thanks to a pair of late FG's incl a 61-yard GW as time expired (PHI outgained 415-354). While the Eagles have struggled mightily in road contests with a 3-7 ATS mark, we'll go ahead and give them the 3 pt edge here as the Chargers are on a terrible FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA BY 10 0-7-1 ATS run overall

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Cincinnati over CLEVELAND - While the Browns have earned a pair of convincing wins over the past 4 years (21 & 11 pt wins), the overall series in that span has clearly fallen in favor of CIN as they've outscored CLE by a 32-10 margin in their 6 wins. The Browns couldn't cash in as an away fav LW in IND as they trailed 31-14 in the 4Q before a pair of late TD's made things interesting (CLÉ 24-16 FD & 346-335 yd edges). After being held out of the EZ in each of their 1st 2 losses vs BAL & HOU, the Bengals nearly pulled the outright upset in GB (led 21-7 at HT) before an eventual OT defeat. Although the Bengals are on just a 6-14 ATS run overall, we're getting a cheap line here with the visitor against a Browns squad that's just 3-11 ATS run vs DIV foes.

OTHER PLAYS

Chicago at GREEN BAY - Thursday - The Packers have pretty much owned this series over the past 8 ssns with a 14-3 SU/12-5 ATS mark. After a tough outing the week prior in ATL where their defense was gouged for 34 pts, the Packers started off slowly LW again vs CIN (trailed 21-7 at HT) before holding the Bengals to just 3 pts in the 2H of their OT victory. The Bears moved their ATS home mark to 2-0 TY after their outright win over the Steelers in OT (306-282 yd edge) as a TD dog. While the Packers have done nicely as a DIV HF with a 12-5 ATS mark, keep in mind that the past 2 outright CHI victories in this series have occurred in Lambeau ('13 & '15). We'll have one of our

† New Orleans by 6 over Miami - London - Following an embarrassing road effort against the Jets where their offense was held scoreless until the game's final play (outgained 338-225), the Dolphins head to London for the 4th time (1-2 overall, plyd 1st ever gm here back in '07 vs the Giants). While the Saints aren't nearly as familiar in journeying across the pond, they did face the Chargers back in '08 (37-32 loss). NO took advantage of an inj-depleted Panthers offense LW in the 21 pt win. With the travel miles continuing to add up for the Dolphins as they play their 3rd consec contest away from home to begin the ssn (Wk 1 home vs TB rescheduled due to Irma), we'll back the Saints in this one

as they can go all out with a bye on deck.

NEW ENGLAND by 13 over Carolina - Rematch of SB XXXVIII (remember Janet Jackson?) as the Panthers head up North following a 21 pt home loss (Saints 362-289 yd edge) to take on a Patriots squad that's rattled off 2 consec victories (GWTD w/:23 left LW vs HOU) following their Wk 1 slip up against the Chiefs. While both teams clearly have playoff aspirations for '17 and NE is traveling to TB on Thur, it's hard for us to go against the Patriots during any matchup in Foxborough, especially when they're on a solid 14-5 ATS run overall.

DALLAS by 14 over LA Rams - DAL returns home on short rest (MNF vs ARZ) having covered just 8 of their past 18 as a NDIV HF. The Rams meanwhile have had extended time off following their shootout victory against SF where QB Goff threw for 292 yds & 3 TD and RB Gurley added 113 rush yds & 3 ttl TD's. With both tms having rough matchups on the horizon (DAL vs GB, LAR vs SEA), we find it difficult to lean with the Rams here as they're on a 2-11-2 ATS run overall and have been outscored by a 65-14 margin in their previous 2 visits to DAL ('11 & '13).

Detroit by 1 over MINNESOTA - The Lions nearly delivered a 3rd consec outright upset victory to begin the ssn LW against the Falcons with WR Tate tackled inches away from the goal line on the game's final play trailing by 4. The Vikings meanwhile exploded on the offensive side of the ball for a 2nd time at home TY behind a 369 yd, 3 TD performance from bkp QB Keenum. In their 2 meetings of a year ago the Lions earned a pair of comeback victories including a 22-16 OT win here as a 6 pt dog (forced OT w/58 yd FG on final play of 4Q). Although it's unclear as of presstime about whether we'll see Bradford at QB for the Vikings here, recent series history has us giving the Lions a slight lean in this one.

HOUSTON by 3 overTennessee - Following a narrow road loss against the Patriots where NE needed a TD w/:23 left for the win (HOU 23-20 FD & 417-396 yd edge), the Texans return to HOU hoping for better fortune than their previous home matchup when JAX came in as a 5 pt dog and left with a 22 pt upset win. The Titans hung on late LW in their Nashville showdown with the Seahawks behind a 21 pt outburst in the 3Q (SEA clearly not used to the heat & humidity). While the Titans delivered a sound road win a few wks back against DIV rival JAX, the Texans showed us something in their loss to the Pats not to mention that they've won 8 of the past 10 in this series by 12 ppg.

Jacksonville by 7 over NY JETS - The Jaguars had an absolutely dominating effort LW in London

against the Ravens behind a def that all'd just 186 yds while forcing 3 TO's in the 44-7 victory. The Jets meanwhile earned their 1st win of the ssn LW against a road-weary Dolphins squad (NYJ 338-225 yd edge). The past 3 meetings have all gone in the favor of the Jets (s/11) with a 14 pt avg MOV. While the Jags are a road fav for the 1st time in 6 yrs, we'll back them here as their "Jet lag" may be minimal with the amount of times they've played across the pond.

BALTIMORE by 2 over Pittsburgh - Important matchup early in the AFC North with CIN and CLE potentially headed towards a battle for the division basement. The Ravens and Steelers have had quite the recent history of eventful meetings including Wk 16 of a year ago when PIT WR Brown narrowly stretched into the EZ w/:09 remaining to give the Steelers the win and DIV title. The Ravens return home following an atrocious outing LW in London where QB Flacco hit just 8-18 for 28 yds & 2 int. The Steelers also come in following a loss as CHI earned the narrow OT win (PIT outgained 306-282). While PIT comes in with a 9-4 ATS mark as a DIV AD, the Ravens have covered 9 of their past 10 inside their DIV and should be able to get the cover here as they look to avenge LW's blowout defeat. ATLANTA by 7 over Buffalo - The Falcons could easily be returning home with a 1-2 mark on the year after escaping the Bears in Wk 1 (CHI 2 dropped EZ passes in final minute) and the Lions a week ago (DET tackled inches from the goal line trailing by 4 on the final play). The Bills meanwhile ended the Broncos' perfect start LW in BUF behind a pair of int's of DEN QB Siemian in the final 19 minutes. The Bills have covered 6 straight against the NFC including a narrow loss just 2 wks ago in Charlotte. New HC McDermott is the former DC of the previously mentioned Panthers so he's quite familiar in facing the ATL defense with 2 meetings each ssn. While the Falcons do have a bye week on deck, we cannot justify laying more than a TD here as they've gone just 5-12 ATS vs the AFC and are on just a 10-19 ATS run as a favorite.

They're now on the road for a 3rd time in the 1st 4 wks to take on a Bucs squad that all'd 34 pts & 494 yds to bkp QB Keenum and the Vikings. The recent series history has clearly been owned by the Giants with 5 consec wins (4-1 ATS) and a 14 pt avg MOV (s/'06). While the Bucs are just 2-8 ATS as a HF, one of those victories came 2 wks ago in easy fashion vs CHI (22 pt win as 6' pt fav). With covers in of their past 10 overall, the Bucs get the call here to get back on track while the Giants' nightmare 17 campaign continues.

ARIZONA by 3 over San Francisco - Following a MNF matchup LW against the Cowboys in their 1st home contest of the ssn, the Cardinals welcome a winless 49ers squad that couldn't complete the comeback attempt LW against the Rams (2 pt NG after TD w/2:13 left, 421-418 yd edge). SF owned this series from '09-'13 with a 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS mark but the Cardinals have turned the matchup in their favor over the past 3 yrs with a 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS record. Although SF is still in the process of learning to win again under 1st yr HC Shanahan and a young roster, we expect them to stay within the line in this one as they are coming in with 4 extra days of rest while ARZ is on just a 4-10 ATS run in DIV HG's and have only covered 3 of their past 13 overall as of presstime.

DENVER by 3 over Oakland - Big early ssn matchup inside of the AFC West as the Broncos and Raiders attempt to keep pace with the hard-charging Chiefs. DEN was tripped up LW in their road opener in BUF thanks to a pair of 2H int's by QB Siemian (DEN 366-272 yd edge). The Raiders offense ran into a def buzzsaw LW against WAS being held to just 7 FD's & 128 ttl yds in the 17 pt defeat. DEN has clearly owned the recent series history with wins in 8 of the past 10 although OAK did earn the ssn split LY. Despite a solid 22-9 ATS run as a DIV AD for OAK, the favorite has covered

Indianapolis at SEATTLE - SNF - After a tough road loss LW in the heat & humidity of Nashville where they put up 27 pts & 433 ttl yds in defeat, the Seahawks return to the "12th Man" to take on a Colts squad that earned their 1st win of the ssn LW against the Browns (QB Brissett 259 yd pass yds, 3 ttl TD). While the Seahawks are clearly the stronger team in this matchup, we'll have to wait until closer to the weekend to see just how high this line climbs as the Colts are on a solid 7-3 ATS mark against NFC foes.
