4★ TCU over West Virginia - ESPN Gameday is on hand. Both schools enter fresh off byes. TCU had been 10-0 ATS off a regular season bye until losing and failing to cover both instances last year. While each has high potent offenses, TCU has a huge edge on D, as they've held all three of their FBS foes to their season low in yards including Oklahoma St. Horned Frogs RB Hicks has been banged up, but Soph Anderson has filled in nicely and had a career high 160 (6.2) in the outright upset at OSU. HC Patterson said they wouldn't be where they are without him. WV is allowing 226 (5.3) rush ypg including 367 (7.3) at Kansas two weeks ago! TCU is 12-8-1 ATS at home, while the Mountaineers are 1-3 as an AD. We'll go ahead and back the Horned Frogs here as they are legit contender to with the B12 and should have no problem at home here.

3★ San Diego St over UNLV - The Aztecs are off to their first 5-0 start since 1975 following their 6 pt win over NIU although it's worth mentioning that the Huskies had 23-10 FD & 429-263 yd edges. The Rebels were able to get some home redemption (lost opener to FCS Howard outright as 45 pt chalk) LW against SJSt with a 548-462 yd edge (28 pt win). SDSt had its letdown game last week and still won and take their conference games much more seriously. With the Aztecs on a 9-2 SU run in this series (avg win by 19.9 ppg, all 9 wins by more than 7 pts), we'll call for the visitor to get one step closer to a NY's Day Bowl Bid!

The 'Noles are off a hard fought win over WF where QB Blackman struggled for 3Q but threw a 40 yd GW td pass w/:53 left. FSU's OL has allowed 9 sks the L/2 weeks and faces one of the top D's in the country, which has 9 sks of their own in the L/2 wks. Miami has put up the most yds allowed vs their last 2 opp's. FSU is a disappointing #86 in our pass eff D ratings. UM is 5-1 as an AF & on a 19-9-1 ATS run. The Canes are ply'g B2B road gms but are 26-3 ATS when they win SU on the road.

2★ Michigan St (+) over MICHIGAN - This is the 109th meeting for the Paul Bunyan Trophy. Michigan St is on a 9-0 ATS series run! The situation favors Michigan at home off a bye, while Sparty is off physical games vs Notre Dame and lowa and travelling for the first time. This figures to be a defensive struggle as the Wolve's are #2 in the FBS on D allowing 210 ypg less than their foes average, while MSt is #6, allowing 163 ypg less than their foes average. Michigan is just 1-5 as a HF, while Sparty is 6-2 as an AD. It's not known who will be the QB for Michigan as Speight was injured last game and O'Korn filled in admirably. Michigan's OFF hasn't shown any type of consistency to make them a near 2 td fav.

2★ Marshall over CHARLOTTE - Marshall is in revenge mode after LY's 27-24 (-13) home loss. Charlotte HC Lambert promised changes on OFF after he fired OC Mullen last week. The results were much better as UC led FIU 26-7 2Q but lost 30-29 (+10). UC held 504-475 yd & 23-20 FD edges. The Herd is off a 38-21 (+4) win at Cincy LW and although they had just a 17 yd edge, a closer look shows Cincy put up 207 of their 349 yds in the 4Q with the game already decided. The 49ers are #126 in the FBS on OFF avg 65 ypg less than their foes allow and #125 on D, allowing 88 ypg more than their foes average. UC is 0-12 SU/2-9-1 ATS at home vs FBS foes.

Arkansas St at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - This is the SBC opener for each. Both enter fresh off byes. GS will be in revenge mode after letting a 26-17 4Q lead evaporate LY as the Red Wolves scored the GW td w/:09 left. Arkansas St is avg 472 ypg and is #24 in the FBS avg 99 ypg more than their foes allow, while GS is allowing 425 ypg and is #124 in the FBS allowing 114 ypg more than their foes avg. The Eagles are on just a 2-9-1 overall ATS run, while ASt is on an 8-3 overall ATS run & is 12-4 ATS vs SBC foes.

THURSDAY 10/5:

Louisville at NC STATE - NC State is 1-4 SU/ATS in recent mtgs. The Wolfpack will look to have a better showing than LY when they trailed 44-0 at halftime. UL is fresh off B2B games vs lesser opponent's. NCSt has won 4 straight and is 2-0 in ACC play for 1st time s/'06. QB Finley is a big reason for their good start, hitting 72% w/a 9-0 ratio and L'ville is #91 in our pass eff D ratings. both teams have put up the most yds allowed on 3 of their 4 opponent's. UL is 25-13 ATS on the road and 10-3

as an AD. NC State is 0-4 as a fav this ssn. FRIDAY 10/6:

Memphis at CONNECTICUT - The home team is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series, winning by an average of 33 ppg and covering by 23 ppg. Memphis is extremely banged up on defense and on the second of B2B away games following their blowout loss at UCF where they allowed 600+ yards for the second time in 3 weeks. UConn exherted a lot of energy in their loss at SMU last week as they were tied at 28 4Q, before allowing three straight td's. QB Shirreffs has thrown for 400+ in B2B games. The Tigers are 9-2 ATS away vs a foe off a SU loss, but on just a 4-9 overall ATS run. The Huskies are on just a 15-37-1 overall ATS run, but is 23-12 as a HD.

Boise St at BYU - The Cougars were a turnover machine last Friday in Logan as they coughed up the ball on 7 occasions in the 16 pt loss to the Aggies. The Broncos meanwhile come in after a much needed bye week as their previous matchup against Virginia at home saw them hammered by 19 pts as 13 pt chalk. LY BYU led 27-21 4Q but the Broncos went 90/10pl for the gm-deciding TD w/10:37 left to win 28-21 (-7). Although both teams could have injury concerns at QB coming in (check inj reports), BYU has already been tested TY with meetings against LSU, Utah & Wisconsin while Boise is on a 10-4 ATS run in road contests.

SATURDAY OCT 7

IOWA by 16 over Illinois - It's homecoming weekend in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes got their first shutout s/2010 in last years meeting. Illinois is averaging just 267 ypg and is #118 in the FBS avg 93 ypg less than their foes allow, while Iowa is #39 allowing 56 ypg less than their foes average. Iowa RB Wadley has failed to crack 100 yards rushing in three straight games, but has a great chance to do so here as the Illini is allowing 180 rush ypg. The Hawkeyes have a bye on deck and are 15-10-1 ATS as a favorite, while Illinois is 6-16 as an AD. 18 points feels a little steep for us however as Iowa is off B2B physical games.

Notre Dame by 14 over NORTH CAROLINA - These two haven't met since 2008 and ND owns this series w/a 17-2 SU record. The Tar Heels have allowed 222 (5.0) rush ypg and LW in their 33-7 (+9') loss at GT they allowed 433 (6.1) rush. Brian Kelly said he wants to change the focus to being more physical and running the FB and that's exactly what the Irish have done, avg 301 (7.1) rush ypg but

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their top 3 RB's are all ? this week (CS). ND's OFF is #8, avg 160 ypg more than their foes allow and have put up the most yds allowed on 4 of their opponents while NC's D is #95, allowing 40 ypg more than their foes avg. The Tar Heels are 0-4 ATS vs FBS foes TY with an avg non cover of 10.5 ppg. ND has already covered twice as an AF and has a bye on deck. Despite all the advantages listed above, we still don't feel comfortable making ND more than a 2 td fav.

W Michigan by 8 over BUFFALO - It's Homecoming in Buffalo. The Broncos have won the L/11 SU vs MAC foes and are 5-1 as an AF. UB is 6-12 ATS vs the MAC. Both are coming off MAC Opener wins but from very different perspectives. Returning MAC Champ WM is used to this spot and off a dominating home win, while UB is off a win at Kent St, but were actually outgained 444-377. WM put a scare into USC in the opener (28-28 in 4Q). WM has large edges on Off, Def & especially ST's and could be facing a Bulls team without starting QB Tyree Jackson (missed LW). Even if he returns the Broncos should be able to run over the Bulls.

TOLEDO by 10 over E Michigan - It's Homecoming in Toledo. The Rockets have dominated this series, going 16-1 SU with 10 str wins (11-3-1 ATS). EM is 7-1 ATS as an AD including an outright 16-13 win (+5) at Rutgers. UT is just 3-8 as a HF vs MAC foes. The Rockets are off a bye while EM is ply g their 2nd str road gm and are off a heartbreaking 24-20 loss at Kentucky as a 14.5 pt AD, where a blocked punt set up Kentucky for a 12 yd gw td "drive". This is the Rockets conf opener. Toledo has the OFF edge but EM has the D edge. EM isn't getting the respect they deserve and we look for the Eagles to keep it closer than expected.

OHIO by 10 over C Michigan - It's Homecoming in Athens. CM is 7-1 SU/ATS in the series and has won the L/2 on the road. This is the Chippewas 2nd straight road gm after their 28-8 (+10) loss at BC where they were only outgained 309-296, but struggled on punt coverage allowing a 32 yd avg on 4 PR's. The Bobcats are off a 58-50 (-6) shootout win over UMass where they were outgained 550-473 (+2 TO). CM is 10-4 as an AD and we'll lean with the dog.

AKRON by 9 over Ball St - It's Homecoming in Akron. Ball St was 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in the series until LY's 35-25 (-3') home loss. The visitor is 4-1 ATS. Akron is 13-22-1 ATS vs MAC foes. BSU is 5-0 as an AD. The Cards are ply'g their 3rd straight road gm, but have a bye on deck. They are off a 55-3 beating by WM only making it into WM terr 3 times (missed FG, FG, Int). The Zips trailed now 0-5 BG 23-20 in the 3Q before scoring the final 14 (incl 38 yd IR td) to pull out the 11 pt win as a 2.5 pt AF. The teams are close on both sides of the ball, but the Ball St QB injury gives the Zips an advantage.

MIAMI, ŎH by 14 over Bowling Green - The home team is just 1-6 SU/ATS and there have been 5 outright upsets in the L/10 mtgs, including LY when Miami won 40-26 as a 1.5 AD. This is BG's 4th road gm in the F/6 wks. MU is 15-7-1 ATS vs MAC foes incl a 31-14 win (+1.5) at CM TY. That is Miami's only ATS win TY and have they've lost outright in both FBS gms they were the favorite and were run over last week (52-17, +20.5) by a ND team looking to move up in the rankings. BG is 0-5 SU & ATS TY. They actually had a 23-20 3Q lead LW vs Akron, their 1st since being up 3-0 in their opener but they allowed the final 14 losing 34-23 as a 2.5 HD.

Ucf by 6 over CINCINNATI - The home team is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series, winning by an average of 33 ppg and covering by 15 ppg. UCF appears to be a complete team as they're #11 in the FBS on OFF averaging 143 ypg more than their foes allow and #9 on D, holding their opponents to 144 ypg below their average. A closer look shows that the Knights have benefited their last two games by taking on a third string QB and a Memphis team that was dealing with sizeable inj's on defense. Cincinnati is on the second of B2B home games and were a victim of ST miscues in their loss last week, but both are about even in that phase of the game. We'll back the home dog.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 1 over Georgia St - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. Both teams have lost to an FCS foe TY. This is the lone HG for CC in a 4 wk span. GSt is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks but enter off a bye. The Panthers are an AF for the 1st time ever & they're 3-12 SU on the road all time in SBC play. They did beat a struggling Charlotte team 28-0 (pk) in their last game. CC enters off a 51-43 (+8) loss at ULM but only trailed by 2 before a final desperation multiple lateral play ended in a FR td for ULM with no time left for the push. GSt has slight edges on both sides of the ball but CC did upset UMass as a HD in the ssn opener. With the home field edge we'll call for CC by 1.

Penn St by 14 over NORTHWESTERN - It's Homecoming weekend in Evanston and this is North-

Penn St by 14 over NORTHWESTERN - It's Homecoming weekend in Evanston and this is Northwestern's lone home game in a four week stretch. Penn St is 5-2 ATS in this series, but Northwestern has won and covered the last two. The Nittany Lions enter off a misleading final as they finished with just a 370-352 yard edge in their win over Indiana, benefitting from a 1Q KOR and fumble return td's as well as a short td drive after a turnover. The 'Cats are off a physical loss at Wisconsin where they finished with a 23-15 FD edge. PSU RB Barkley was held in check on the ground last week, but should find success against a Northwestern D that gave up 233 rush vs Duke. Look for an all out effort game from the Nittany Lions as they have a bye on deck and are on a 10-1 ATS run vs B10 foes, while NW is 1-3 as a HD.

E CAROLINA by 3 over Temple - Temple is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series as AAC rivals. East Carolina trailed by just 7 mid 3Q vs USF last week before allowing 24 unanswered and their 414 yards was the most the Bulls have allowed. The Pirates D continues to struggle as they are #125 in the FBS allowing 134 ypg more than their foes average, but Temple is averaging just 296 ypg and is #122 in the FBS averaging 103 ypg less than their foes allow. Pirates QB Sirk has B2B games throwing over 300 yards and Temple has just our #80 ranked pass eff D. EC is 14-9-1 as a HD and we'll gladly take the points. Duke by 1 over VIRGINIA - Duke had won 6 of 7 and covered 7 of 8 (1 tie) before B2B losses in this series and the home tm is 11-5-1 ATS. Duke is in double revenge mode after throwing 5 int's LY (tied UVA schl rec). HC Mendenhall got his best win at UVA 2 weeks ago at Boise St and the Cavs enter fresh off a bye. Duke has outgained foes by 155 ypg and their D is #10, allowing 143 ypg less than their foes avg. QB Benkert avg 312 ypg with a 10-1 ratio and faces Duke's #10 pass eff D. Duke is 13-6 as an ACC dog, while UVA is 2-4 as a HF. We'll back the Blue Devils in their preferred role.

SYRACUSE by 6 over Pittsburgh - Pitt is 13-2 SU/11-4 ATS in this series with both of Cuse's wins coming at the Carrier Dome. LY was the highest scoring gm in FBS history as Pitt won 76-61 (-24'). Cuse was actually +18 FD's in the gm! Last week we went with Pitt as a 3 * LPS and got another winner (4-0-1 on College LPS's on Saturday!) as the Panthers jumped out to a 21-0 1Q lead behind QB Max Browne who finally looked like the top recruit he was billed as (28-32-410-4-0). Browne has a much stiffer challenge against Cuse's #36 ranked pass eff D and it doesn't help that Pitt doesn't run well (114 ypg, 3.1). Cuse has covered their L/3 incl B2B road losses that they kept closer than expected Cuse avg 317 pass ypg and Pitt has our #109 pass eff D

expected. Cuse avg 317 pass ypg and Pit has our #109 pass eff D.

Virginia Tech by 13 over BOSTON COLLEGE - It's homecoming on Chestnut Hill. BC has been held to just 10 ttl pts and 171 ypg in the L/2 mtgs. The Eagles actually won the 2 prior mtgs and are 11-7 ATS in the series. BC has our #4 ranked pass eff D and has played the much tougher sked (#6 vs #78). While VT did hold a 10 yd edge vs Clem last week, the stats were misleading as the Hokies trailed 24-3 going into the 4Q & was outplayed until adding 2 td's after the game was decided. BC was tied with Clemson 2 wks ago into the 4Q. VT was upset LY as a DD fav vs Cuse & are 7-13 ATS in ACC road gms.

APPALACHIAN ST by 7 over New Mexico St - It's homecoming weekend in Boone. The only prior mtg was LY & NMSt was held to a ssn low in yds, while all'g a ssn high 384 (8.0) rush yds. The Aggies are on the 2nd of 3 str AG's & enter off the physical rush attack of Arkansas. They did see the option 4 wks ago against NM & have another option team on deck in Ga So. App St enters fresh off a bye. The Mountaineers are 4-13 as a HF & 4-9 ATS vs the SBC. NMSt is just 9-16 as an AD but are 2-1 TY incl an upset win at NM. The Aggies have accomplished 2 of their 3 goals for the ssn, beating rivals NM & UTEP with their final goal being to end the longest bowl drought in the FBS (1960). This is their last ssn in the SBC and they only lost to Troy 27-24 as a 7.5 pt HD in their conf opener. Prior to allowing 230 yds rush LW to a much bigger SEC tm, NMSt was allowing just 143 rush ypg (3.8) an improvement of over 100 ypg from LY. Look for the Aggies to keep it closer than expected.

OHIO ST by 29 over Maryland - Last year we used Ohio St as the Early Bird play of the Week and the line moved from -27 to -19.5 with Ohio St winning 62-3 (did you call for the Early Bird play on the comp tapes on Monday?) OSU is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in this series as B10 rivals. This is the Bucks homecoming and they enter off an easy shutout over Rutgers where the starters got plenty of rest, while Maryland is on the second of B2B away games and enter off an emotional win at Minnesota where they scored the GW td w/2:44 left. The Terp's are down to their third string QB & Ohio State has held their last three foes under 100 pass yards. The Bucks are #2 in the FBS on OFF averaging 221 ypg more than their foes allow, RB Weber is healthy, and MD allowed 250 (6.4) vs UCF two weeks ago. The Bucks are just 8-13 as a 20+ fav and 6-13 as a HF.

CLÉMSON by 21 over Wake Forest - It's homecoming in Clemson & the Tigers have won the L/8 in this series but WF has 3 str covers. Clemson has played our #4 toughest schedule this year but 2 weeks ago they were off a big win over L'ville & a DD fav vs BC yet found themselves tied 7-7 into the 4Q. WF has ply'd our #77 toughest schedule. HC Clawson isn't satisfied with their close loss vs FSU LW. The Deacons held a 370-296 yd edge but lost 26-19 (+7). WF has outgained foes by 102 ypg but Clemson has dominated, holding a 225 yd edge and held 4 of 5 foes to their ssn low in yards. HC Swinney is 21-13-1 as a HF vs ACC foes. WF is 6-1 as an AD. WF has a bye on deck. PURDUE by 4 over Minnesota - Purdue is on a 4-2 ATS run in this series and enters fresh off a bye. Emotions will also be high after the passing of their legendary former coach Joe Tiller. This figures to be a defensive struggle as the Boilermakers are #20 on D in the FBS holding foes to 100 ypg below their avg, while Minnesota is #18, holding foes to 104 ypg below their avg. The Boilermakers had B2B games of 200+ rush yds before facing Michigan, while the Gophers allowed 262 (5.6) in their first loss to a Maryland team last week that is down to their third string QB. Purdue QB Blough suffered a sprained shoulder in their last game, but had the bye week to heal, while Minnesota's star on defense, DB Winfield was inj 1H and didn't return (CS). This is Gopher HC Fleck's first B10 away game and new Purdue HC Brohm is 11-3 as a HF.

UTSA by 13 over Southern Miss - The home tm has won all 3 CUSA mtgs (2-1 ATS). SM travels to UTSA again after being upset there LY 55-32 (-16'). The Golden Eagles were also upset last week at home vs N Texas 43-28 (-8) as QB Griggs hit just 45% completions. Both tms have solid pass D's with UTSA only allowing 38% completions and SM did allow 366 pass yds LW. SM is 15-27 ATS vs CUSA foes but are 6-10 ATS overall. UTSA comes in off a bye and this is their CUSA opener.

Wku by 20 over UTEP - It's homecoming in El Paso. WKÚ has hardly resembled the team we knew since HC Brohm left for Purdue and new HC Sanford's system appears to have stunted OB White's growth (37-7 ratio last year, 2-3 this year). The Toppers avg 184 ypg less than they did a year ago and are being outg'd by 23 ypg. UTEP has made a claim to be the worst team in the country, being outscored by an avg of 45-14 & outg'd by 281 ypg! HC Kugler resigned shortly before we went to press. WKU is 20-8 ATS in CUSA road gms. UTEP is 14-26-1 as a dog. WKU is 8-2 ATS when fresh off a bye.

Stanford by 7 over UTAH - It's Homecoming in Salt Lake City. The Utes are fresh off a bye with a trip to USC on deck while the Cardinal come in following a 10 point victory over Arizona St (RB Love school-record 301 rush yds). The Utes have won and covered both matchups as P12 rivals in this series despite being a dog in both including a 2OT win on The Farm back in '14. While Stanford is traveling for the lone time in a 5 week stretch, we'll side with them as they are 22-12 ATS an AF and 22-7 ATS in P12 AG's.

IDAHO by 1 over Louisiana - LA is 3-2 SU but the L/mtg was back in '04. ID is just 9-19 ATS in the Kibbie Dome incl 0-2 TY. LA enters off a bye after a 2OT 56-50 loss to rival ULM. Idaho has covered 2 straight (both on the road) incl a 29-23 upset (+3.5) at SA. After LA allowed a ssn high of 45 pts LY, that 45 pts is their ssn low TY as all 4 gms have been high scoring shootouts. Despite that ID only has a slight egde on D (#108-#120) & LA has a bigger edge on Off (#85-#110). The Cajuns are 23-12 as an AD.

Colorado St by 5 over UTAH ST - The home tm has won the L/4 in this series while posting a 4-1 ATS run. LY the gm was tied at 24 and CSU went 90/5pl for the gm deciding td w/10:33 left. The Rams got points on their F/7 full drives a week ago in their 30 pt win in Hawaii. The Aggies meanwhile took advantage of 7 BYU TO's in their home victory. While CSU is ply'g their 3rd str road gm (w/a bye mixed in), we feel that the line is a tad high to back them here and will lean with the home dog.

TULANE by 4 over Tulsa - Tulsa has dominated this series to the tune of an 11-1 ATS run! Tulane enters fresh off a bye, but the Golden Hurricane have the advantage of just having faced the option each of the last two weeks vs New Mexico and Navy. This figures to be an intriguing matchup as Tulsa has the #37 OFF avg 62 ypg more than their foes allow, while Tulane is #28 on D, holding foes to 71 ypg less than their avg. On the flip side, Tulsa is #123 on D, allowing 104 ypg more than their foes avg, while Tulane is #109 on OFF, avg 58 ypg less than their foes allow. The Green Wave is on a 4-2 overall ATS run and Tulsa has yet to show they can stop the option.

Army by 14 over RICE - Army has had success ply'g in Texas, going 12-3-1 ATŚ in the Lonestar state. Rice had won 4 str in this series until LY when Army pulled out a 31-14 (-8') home win. LW we knew Rice was a beat up team ply'g at Pitt so we went against the Owls for a 3★ LPS and the Owls were outgained 479-277 as we picked up another winner! Rice has been solid vs the run allowing 122 (3.7) ypg. Army is just 1-8 as an AF and this is their 3rd road game in 4 weeks. Rice has a bye on deck.

NAVY by 8 over Air Force - Navy is on a 13-4-1 ATS run in this rivalry including 7-1-1 at home. The straight up winner of this game has gone on to win 20 straight Commander-In-Chief trophies! Air Force is on their second of back-to-back away games and third in 4 weeks, while Navy has travelled just once the last four weeks. The Middies are averaging an incredible 400 (6.2) rush ypg and the Falcons allowed New Mexico's triple option to run for 363 (8.9) and score 56 points! The Middies are 9-5 as a HF and are on a 21-11 overall ATS run. The Falcons are 5-2 as an AD We'll lean with the dog in this rivalry.

Ark is ply'd their first true road om and are 6-2 ATS as a visitor.

The Red Raiders were held to a ssn low 384 yards in their loss to Oklahoma St last week, but the Jayhawks are #119 on D, allowing 99 ypg more than their foes average. Kansas has our #120 pass eff D and Tx Tech QB Shimonek has thrown for over 300 yds every game with a 12-2 ratio. Tx Tech is battle tested having taken on our #21 toughest sked, while the Jayhawks have faced just our #119 toughest. The Red Raiders are 8-3 as an AF, but Kansas is 3-1-1 as a B12 HD. We don't feel comfortable laving more than two td's with the Red Raiders.

WASHINGTON by 19 over California - After a sputtering start in their trip to Corvallis LW where they led just 7-0 at HT, the Huskies' offense exploded with a 35-7 run in the final 2 quarters to get the win over the Beavers (509-184 yd edge). The Bears meanwhile were smacked on the road against the Ducks with the Cal running gm held to just 8 rush yds on 29 att. The Huskies are ply'g their lone HG over a 5 wk stretch, while Cal is on the 2nd of B2B AG's & off Ole Miss, USC & Oregon, with Wash St on deck. Cal has shown overall improvement under new HC Wilcox and we'll back the dog

Washington St by 10 over OREGON - Following a home upset of the Trojans (+4') LW behind a 340 yd passing day from QB Falk, the Cougars journey on the road for the 1st time in 117 riding a 7-0 ATS run in the series including 3 straight covers in Eugene. The Ducks are off of an impressive yet costly home effort LW vs Cal (21 pt win) holding the Bears to just 8 rush yds on 29 att while losing QB Herbert (broken collarbone) and a handful of other starters in the process (CS). The Ducks had won 8 in a row in this series but have now lost each of the past 2 incl LY when the Cougars rushed for 280 yds & 6 td's (651-416 yd edge, 18 pt win). With WSU at 5-0 for the 1st time since 2001 and getting the benefit of taking on a wounded Ducks squad, we'll go ahead and give them the double-digit edge here.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 7 over Fiu - It's homecoming in Murfreesboro. MT is 8-3 SU but FIU has covered the L/3. MT never trailed LY but with the score tied at 35, got a GW 48 yd IR with 1:22 left. QB Stockstill & WR James were out again for the Blue Raiders & although QB Urzua did throw for 359 yds, he also threw 3 int's in their loss to FAU LW. MT actually held a 454-313 yd edge. FIU trailed 26-7 at home vs winless Charlotte LW before rallying for a 1 pt win. MT has ply'd a much tougher sked (#50 vs #126). MT is 10-4-1 at home ATS vs CUSA foes. FIU is on a 5-13-1 ATS run but is 10-5-1 as an AD. The status of QB Stockstill makes a huge difference here.

USC by 35 over Oregon St - The Trojans return from Pullman off of their 1st loss of the ssn and wounded to boot as they were down 3 starting OL by the game's conclusion (check injury report). The Beavers meanwhile were smacked at home LW against UW (held to just 8 FD's & 184 yds) and now now travel for the only time in a 6 wk stretch. While the Beavers have covered 5 of the L/8 in the series, they are just 1-4 ATS in LA and we expect them to continue their '17 struggles in this one as the Trojans have an extra day of rest (plyd WSU on Fri) and are 12-4 ATS off a SU loss. Ulm by 3 over TXSt - ULM finished w/an FBS ssn high 298 rush yds & tied their ssn high w/31

FD's in LY's mtg. The Warhawks are 9-3 as an AF, while TXSt is 4-7 as a HD. ULM has won 2 straight but have not won 3 straight since '13. The Bobcats only lost to App St 20-13 (+22) in their SBC opener, but are off B2B 30+ pt losses to UTSA & Wyoming. ULM is 2-0 in conf play but only led CC by 2 LW before a final play FR td on desperation final play multiple lateral play. While their D's are almost equal, ULM does have a big edge on Off (#79-#130) but are 0-3-1 ATS s/'13 as a 7+ pt fav.

Georgia by 20 over VANDERBILT - It's homecoming in Nashville. Georgia has dominated this series (46-6-1 all-time) but the Bulldogs are in revenge mode after losing LY 17-16 (-14) at home. Vandy is now 5-1 ATS vs the Dawgs. The Dawgs are coming off B2B dominating wins over Miss St & Tenn by a comb'd score of 71-3 and ply'g B2B road games. Georgia is clearly the better team and has the #1 ranked D in the FBS, holding foes to 213 ypg below their avg. Vandy is better than their numbers suggest (their blowout loss to Bama skews things) but they've allowed 305 rush ypg the L/3 & face another strong rush attack in Chubb & Michel. We will lean with Georgia in revenge mode as they've covered all 4 vs FBS foes by a comb'd 66 pts.

Louisiana Tech by 10 over UAB - It's homecoming in Birmingham. UAB is 0-5 SU/1-3 ATS vs LT. The Blazers are fresh off a bye. LT's 34-16 win over South Alabama is extremely deceiving considering they only led 17-16 4Q. UAB has been competitive in their rebirth. QB Erdley has a 6-1 ratio & true frosh RB Brown has been impressive, avg 5.2 ypc. UAB actually has the higher ranked OFF & D and has outgained foes by 41 ypg. HC Bill Clark has done a great job revitalizing the Blazers' program and we will back them as the home dog

N ILLINOIS by 21 over Kent St - It's Homecoming in DeKalb. NIU is 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS in this series. NIU is 15-4-2 ATS vs MAC foes incl 5-1 as a HF. This is Kent St's 4th road gm in just 6 wks. Both teams are off deceptive losses LW. KS had 24-18 FD & 444-377 vd edges over Buffalo but while UB got td's on their drives, KS settled for 2 short FG & were SÓD 4 times. NIU had a 152-36 yd edge in the 1Q vs SDSt but it was 14-14 after allowing a 96 yd KR td & a fumble that set up a 33/1pl td drive. They had 23-10 FD & 429-263 yd edges but were -4TO's. The Gators have gone back to QB Franks after st'g Del Rio last week (inj'd, OFY). LSU has our #25 pass eff D and Florida's D is actually #105, allowing 56 ypg more than their foes avg. HC Orgeron will get a maximum effort after LW's loss so we'll lean with the dog against UF who is 11-16 as a HF.

OKLAHOMA by 21 over lowa St - Oklahoma has dominated this series, winning 18 straight by an average of 27 ppg along with a 5-2 ATS run. The Sooners enter fresh off a bye and while they do have the Red River Rivalry on deck, they're 4-2 ATS in the game before. QB Mayfield is no longer the oddsmakers' favorite to win the Heisman after OU's shootout win at Baylor two weeks ago. He's completing 75% with a 13-0 ratio and Iowa St has just our #99 ranked pass eff D. The Sooners are 41-24 as a HF (2-0 this yr) and on an 8-2 overall ATS run, while the 'Clones are 6-11 ATS away vs B12 foes. It appears the number of last weeks blowouts have inflated a number of lines including this one. We'll go ahead and back the dog here.

Smu by 1 over HOUSTON - Houston is in revenge mode after having their three game series winning streak snapped last year when SMU beat a ranked team for the first time in 5 years. The The Cougars are on a 5-3 ATS series run and enter more battle tested having taken on our #61 toughest sked, while SMU has taken on just our #107 toughest. The Ponies were tied at 28 early 4Q last week vs UConn before pulling away, while the Cougars led Temple 20-3 4Q and allowed 135 of 324 total yards in two 4Q scoring drives. Star DL Oliver was injured 2Q and didn't return (CS), while QB Postma started in place of Allen (Cch's dec). The Ponies have a bye on deck and haven't left the state of Texas in any game. UH is 4-10-1 as a HF, but on a 35-22-2 overall ATS run. SMU is 4-1-1 as an AD.

KENTUCKY by 10 over Missouri - Mizzou won the F/3 SEC mtgs between these rivals but Kentucky has won the L/2. LY KY (+6) led 35-7 4Q before Mizzou tacked on 2 gbg td's. KY got caught looking ahead LW & barely squeaked by E Mich (outgained 312-228!). MO is off a much needed bye and HC Odom vowed to turn things around. The 'Cats average just 294 ypg and is being outgained by 64 ypg vs FBS foes. MO avg 322 ypg and is being outgained by 117 ypg vs FBS foes. Both of these teams ply'd S Carolina this year with KY winning but being outgained by 5 yards while MO lost but held a 64 yard edge. Although MO is 0-6 ATS in true road games, this is the Tigers first this season and we are not ready to trust Kentucky who is 6-13-1 ATS at home as nearly a 2 td favorite.

Wisconsin by 10 over NEBRASKA - The winner of this B10 rivalry is awarded the Freedom Trophy. This game should be a defensive struggle as Wisconsin is #8 in the FBS holding foes to 157 ypg below their avg, while the Black Shirts have held their last three foes to season lows in yards and in their last 12 quarters the D has allowed just 30 total points. 'Huskers QB Lee has struggled with int's throughout his career and the Badgers have our #19 ranked pass eff D Wisconsin, led by true frosh RB Taylor had been averaging 275 rush ypg before being held in check last week and Nebraska has held four of their 5 foes under 100 rush yds. The 'Huskers are a HD for just the 4th time s/09 and we feel will keep it closer than expeted.

AUBURN by 28 over Mississippi - Last year this was our Oct Game of the Month and Auburn won on the road 40-29 (-4') with 307 yards rush. Aub is 13-4 SU/11-6 ATS in this series. Last week we used Auburn as our 4★ Top LPS and they smoked Miss St 49-10 (covered by 31 pts, perfect 3-0 weekend for our Top Play Trio members)! The Rebels don't get much of a break here after getting crushed at Bama LW 66-3 (outg'd 613-253). Aub has outg'd foes by 172 ypg and their D is #4, holding foes to 186 ypg below their avg. Ole Miss has outg'd foes by 6 ypg despite LW's blowout but their D is #109, all'g 64 ypg more than their foes avg. Aub avg 208 (4.5) rush ypg while Ole Miss has allowed 229 (5.3). Ole Miss is on the 2nd of B2B away games and their 3rd in 4 wks.

Alabama by 31 over TEXAS A&M - Bama is 4-1 in SU/3-2 ATS in SEC mtgs. LY A&M trailed 14-0 but bookended halftime with td drives. Bama shut them out the rest of the way and won 33-14 (-18). September is over so that means play against A&M as HC Sumlin is 3-14-1 ATS in the month of Oct. Bama is off the most dominant 2 game stretch of football HC Saban has ever had (won by comb'd 125-31). The Tide have ply'd the tougher sked (#16 vs #84) and have large edges on OFF & D. Bama is 8-1 as an AF, on a 18-8-1 ATS run, and is 10-1 ATS in SEC road gms. A&M is 6-17-1 ATS at home.

Fresno St by 13 over SAN JOSE ST - The Valley Cup is on the line in this rivalry with both tms having their share of struggles with their new coaching staffs. FSU jumped out to a 31-0 lead in the 2Q against Nevada in the 20 pt win. The Spartans meanwhile suffered a 28 pt loss at UNLV thanks to a trio of TO's. While SJSt is playing their only HG in the month of Oct and the home tm is 8-2-1 ATS in this series, it appears that the Bulldogs are a bit further along at the moment, however the price is a bit too steep for us.

Hawaii by 6 over NEVADA - The home tm has won 8 straight in this series (7 straight covers) which is understandable considering their different climates. Nevada trailed 31-0 in the 2Q a wk ago in Fresno in the eventual 20 pt loss. The Warriors also suffered a significant defeat LW at home vs CSU (30 pt loss) falling to get a FD on their F/3 drives and allowing CSU to get points on the Rams' F/7 full drives. UH HC Rolovich was the QB Cch/OC at Nevada for 4Y and lost his 1st mtg vs his former squad 38-17 (-3') a year ago. With revenge on his mind and Hawaii the better overall team at the moment, we'll go ahead and give them the 6 pt road edge in this one.

The Raiders have delivered a pair of outright upset wins against BAL over the past 2 ssns incl a 28-27 win (+3') LY on the road (BAL 412-261 yd edge). While OAK is just 11-25 ATS as a HF, they had no problem covering as 13' pt chalk a few wks back against the Jets. New England at TAMPA BAY - Thursday - The Patriots are in Thur night action for the 2nd time TY (lost Wk 1 at home to KC) following another home loss LW against the Panthers (NE all'g 33 ppg & 457 ypg TY). After a dismal performance the week prior in MIN, the Bucs got back on track LW at home against the Giants by the narrowest of margins with the GW 34 yd FG on the final play. With TB having covered 7 of their past 11, they could give the Pats (12-6 ATS vs NFC) a potential battle in this one. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

NY GIANTS by 6 over LA Chargers - It's been a rough start to the ssn for these squads as the Chargers and Giants enter Wk 5 action at 0-4! The Chargers dropped a 2 pt contest as small chalk vs PHI while the Bucs drilled a 34 yd FG on the final play to escape vs the Giants (2nd consec gm NYG has lost at end of regulation). While QB's Rivers and Manning will always be tied together after being traded for each other in the 2004 Draft, Rivers has gotten the best of their previous 2 head-to-head matchups ('09 & '13). Despite the Chargers' recent success in the series, they are playing in the Eastern Time Zone (10am PST kickoff) for the 1st time TY and are on a current 0-8-1 ATS run.

CINCINNATI by 6 over Buffalo - The Bengals return following their 1st win of the ssn in CLE where the Browns needed a TD w/1:54 left to avoid the shutout (CIN 24-15 FD & 350-215 yd edges). The Bills meanwhile sit at 3-1 after picking up the road win in ATL (+8) despite significant FD (23-15) and yard (381-282) deficits (+3 TO's). Last ssn BUF came into "The Jungle" as a 2 pt dog and left with the 4 pt outright upset win (342-300 yd edge). Although the Bengals have struggled recently ATS with just a 7-14 mark, their offense has been much better the past 2 weeks following the change at OC (9 pts 1st 2 wks, 55 pts L/2). We'll call for that success to continue here as CIN gets the win before both squads head into their respective bye weeks. CLEVELAND by 1 over Ny Jets - After being forecasted to be one of the NFL's worst tms prior to the ssn, the Jets have now rattled off 2 consec victories following their OT win over the Jags (471-311 yd edge). While the Browns were expected to be improved after LY's 1-15 campaign, they've begun the ssn 0-4 for a 2nd consec ssn (only team not to lead at any point so far TY) after CIN finished with a 350-215 yd edge in their 24 pt win. Although Jets' QB McCown was 0-7 in career starts at FirstEnergy Stadium as the signal-caller of the Browns (NYJ 4-10-3 ATS as AD), it's tough to favor CLE by more than a point here as they're on just à 3-11 ATS run overall.

PITTSBURGH by 7 over Jacksonville - The Steelers rebounded nicely following their OT loss a week prior against the Bears as they held BAL to just 9 pts and 239 yds in the 17 pt win (Bell 144 rush yds & 2 TD). The Jags meanwhile suffered an OT loss on the road to the Jets to move to 2-2 on the year. While the Steelers (10-3 ATS as NDIV HF) have been able to claim victories in each of the past 3 meetings in this series, their wins have come by just 8, 4 & 5 respectively. With JAX having covered 5 of their past 7 overall and looking for revenge from an unexpected loss a wk ago, a TD edge is all that we can give to PIT in this one.

Tennessee by 5 over MIAMI - The Dolphins are FINALLY getting a home game this week (1st

time since Wk 17 of LY) following a postponed home opener (Irma) and 3 consec road matchups. After being held scoreless until the final play a week earlier vs the Jets, MIA was blanked LW in London against the Saints (11 FD's & 187 ttl yds). The Titans (-2.5) meanwhile were dominated to the control of the saints (12 Marieta) and the saints of th from the start LW against the Texans in a 43 pt defeat (outgained 445-195, lost QB Mariota in 2H w/hammy inj). In their meeting a ssn ago TEN came in as a 3' pt dog and left with a 30-17 victory (398-200 yd edge). While the Titans are still likely the favorite (8-3-1 ATS as a NDIV AF) if Mariota is unable to go (CS, veteran Cassel is the bkp), we'll still back them here as they're steaming from a divisional blowout (MIA just 4-12 ATS in NDIV HG's). INDIANAPOLIS by 4 over San Francisco - While the Colts got some good news in the middle

of last wk with QB Luck returning to practice for the 1st time, their 2H results over the weekend at SEA were dismal as the Seahawks closed out the gm with a 36-3 run and a 28 pt victory (IND led 15-10 at HT). Although the 49ers suffered the same fate as the Colts a week ago, it came by the narrowest of margins with ARZ getting a TD w/:32 left in OT for the win. With SF back on the road for a 2nd consec wk and playing at 10am PST, we expect their 3-9 ATS run against the AFC to continue here as the Colts have done relatively well outside of their conf '-3 ATS) despite LW's slip up in the Pacific NW.

DETROIT by 1 over Carolina - Following some offensive struggles the first 3 wks of the ssn, the Panthers took advantage of a suspect NE defense in LW's victory (48 yd GW FG as time expired). They now head back on the road TW to take on a Lions squad that delivered an
