#### HANDICAPPING NOTES FOR THIS WEEK'S NFL CONFERENCE FINAL GAMES

Q&A about this upcoming round of the playoffs and our researched answers: How do the home teams fare in this round? You would expect the home teams to have an edge and they are 42-31-1 58% ATS in the Finals since 1977. Vegas has been giving some extra compensation for the home field advantage in this round. From 1977-'89 the home teams were 15-7 ATS. Since 1990 they are just 27-26-1 ATS. There have been only 3 seasons when a #1 seed didn't advance which were 2008, 2010 and 2012. Remember, these teams do not have the advantage of an extra week of preparation like they did in the Semi's last week.

How often are the spreads over a td in the Finals? There have been 25 teams that have been favored by 7 points or more since 1990 in the Conference Final round. The big favorites are 11-14 ATS in that span, including just 5-10 ATS the last 15 occurrences (Seattle failed to cover versus Green Bay in '14).

Is covering in the Semifinal round an advantage when your opponent failed to cover? Actually, it is just the opposite. There have been only 22 times since 1987 when a team has won in the Semifinal round but did not cover. The public has a short term memory and those teams usually fall out of favor and the spread compensates for their loss. These teams have actually gone 13-7-2 ATS in the finals including a 2-gm sweep by DEN and SEA in '13 as both failed to cover in their DIV matchups. How do teams fare in this round following an OT win in the Semifinal round? There have been 7 occurrences dating back to 2001 when a Semifinal round game went into OT. Arizona was in that role a year ago and were hammered against CAR a week later. In '03 both CAR and PHI won their respective Semifinal matchups in OT before meeting in the NFC Championship a week later (14-3 CAR win).

How do teams with the better SU record fare in this round? In the last 22 years, teams with the better SU records are 26-23-1 53% ATS. However, in the last 4 years the team with the better record has gone 6-1 ATS and won all 7 outright.

How do home underdogs in the AFC/NFC Title game rounds fare? Talk about RARE. Since 1986 there have been a grand total of 8 home dogs in this round (28 years!!!). Amazingly in 1997 there were TWO and both lost as DEN and GB won as AF's. The NYG were a HD as a #1 seed in 2000 and won while PIT lost as a #1 seed HD in 2004. In the L8Y it has happened 4 times with Arizona winning in '08, w Chicago losing to GB in 2010, Atlanta losing to SF in '12 & Denver knocking off NE a ssn ago.

No #1 seeds - Since 1990 when the NFL made the switch to 6 playoff teams the only 2 seasons when a #1 seed did not advance to the Conf Finals was 2008 and 2010. Both #1 seeds have advanced to the SB in 3 of the past 4 ssns. Prior to that, both teams reached on just 3 occasions since 1990. Over/Unders - In the L16 years the Conference Finals has gone Over 20 of 32 games (push in '14 between IND/NE). Since 1988 when both teams went Over in their DIV round they are 9-4 Over in the Conf Finals. Also of note is that in the 5 games since 1993 when both teams went Under the total in the DIV round, they also are a perfect 5-0 Over in the Finals. In 2011 and 2013 both Conf Finals went Under the total which was the first time since 2003.

## OVERALL PATRIOTS by 7 V's

The Jaguars and Patriots meet for the 12th time in NFL history with NE holding a commanding 10-1 record. This also marks the 5th playoff matchup (NE 3-1 SU) and 2nd AFC Championship (Patriots 20-6 win in '96). In their most recent meeting back in 2015, the Patriots throttled the Jags in Foxboro 51-17 with massive FD (35-15) and yardage (471-293) edges. On the ssn JAX has gone 6-4 SU/ATS away from home (+8 ypg) while NE is now 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS at home with a 45 ypg edge.

After going down to the wire a week prior against BUF in a defensive struggle, the Jaguars went into Heinz Field and delivered an upset victory for the 2nd time this ssn behind a big day from rookie RB Fournette who rushed for 109 yds with 3 TD's. The Jags are in the AFC Championship for the 3rd time in franchise history with their last matchup coming at home in the '98 playoffs against the Titans (33-14 loss). JAX is now 6-3 SU/4-5 ATS vs foes with

a winning record (+13 ypg, +4 TO's).
Following an easy victory LW at home against the Titans where they finished with a 438-267 yd edge, the Patriots are back in the AFC Championship for the 7th consec ssn (3-3 SU/2-4 ATS). In LY's Conf final, the Pats had no issue getting past the Steelers in the 36-17 win (431-368 yd edge). NE moved their record vs foes w/a winning record to 7-2 SU & ATS on the year (+43 ypg, +3 TO's).

While the Jaguars' defense was exposed in the air a week ago against the Steelers, the unit has been one of the more dominant in the NFL all ssn long. The Patriots meanwhile had their offense firing on all cylinders LW against the Titans making this matchup one to keep an eye on. While it's clear that NE has the coaching edge and playoff pedigree, we expect the Jags to come out and try to control the clock on offense behind Fournette and the running game while keeping Bortles out of 3rd and long. With 43 being the highest total for any Jags game this ssn, the UNDER looks like the best option here

### OVERALL EAGLES by 1

The Vikings and Eagles meet in the postssn for the 4th time with PHI owning a perfect 3-0 mark ('08, '04, '80). In their matchup a ssn ago, the Eagles hosted a 5-0 Vikings squad in a sloppy contest that featured a combined 8 TO's (4 apiece). PHI would earn the 21-10 win despite a 282-239 yd deficit. On the ssn MIN has gone 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS on the road (+25 ypg) with PHI posting an 8-1 SU/6-2-1 ATS mark at home with a 59 ypg\_edge

The Vikings earned a miracle victory LW against the Saints (61-yd TD pass on final play) although it should have never come to that as they led 17-0 at the half and appeared to be on their way to an easy win. This is MIN's 10th trip to the NFC Championship although after making it to the Super Bowl on their 1st 4 attempts, they have lost each of their L/5. On the ssn, MIN has gone 6-3 SU/5-3-1 ATS vs foes w/a winning record (+69 ypg, +4 TO's).

The Eagles utilized a valiant defensive effort LW against the Falcons in the 15-10 victory (3★ LP Winner on UNDER 41) allowing ATL just 281 ttl yds. They are making their 7th trip to the NFC Championship with a pair of victories in their history (2004 & 1980). On the ssn, PHI has gone 5-3 SU & ATS vs foes w/a winning record (+64 ypg, +1 TO).

The Vikings have a chance to make NFL history by becoming the 1st home team to play in the Super Bowl with a victory. The Eagles may have something to say about that however as they have a defense capable of keeping bkp Foles within reach of yet another home victory. With the Eagles undefeated as a HD in their all-time playoff history incl LW's upset against the Falcons, we'll take the points and call for PHI to be heading to MIN to play in the "Big Game."
